DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a display stand for dishware showing our new design; the broken line illustrating dishes are for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

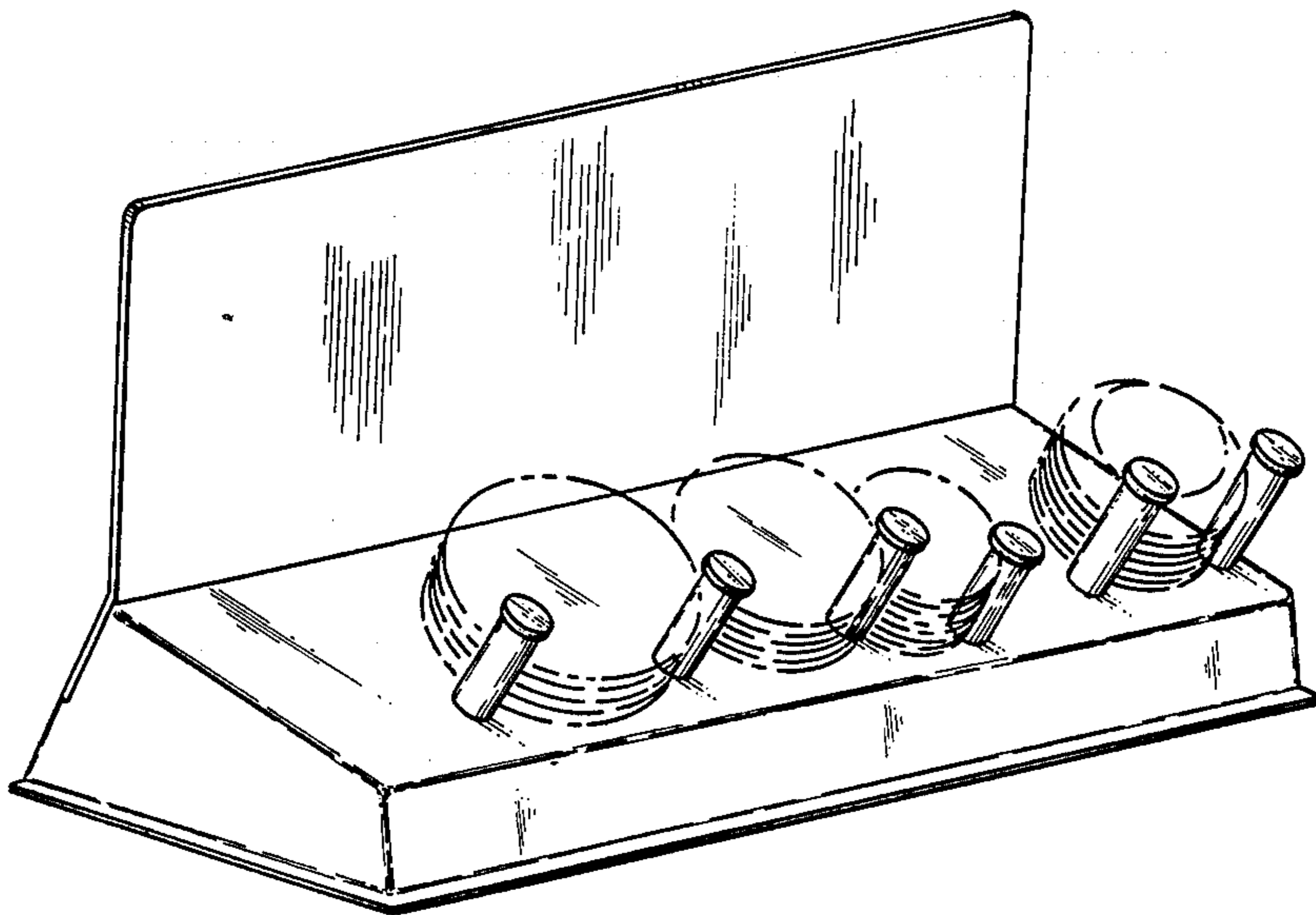
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof.



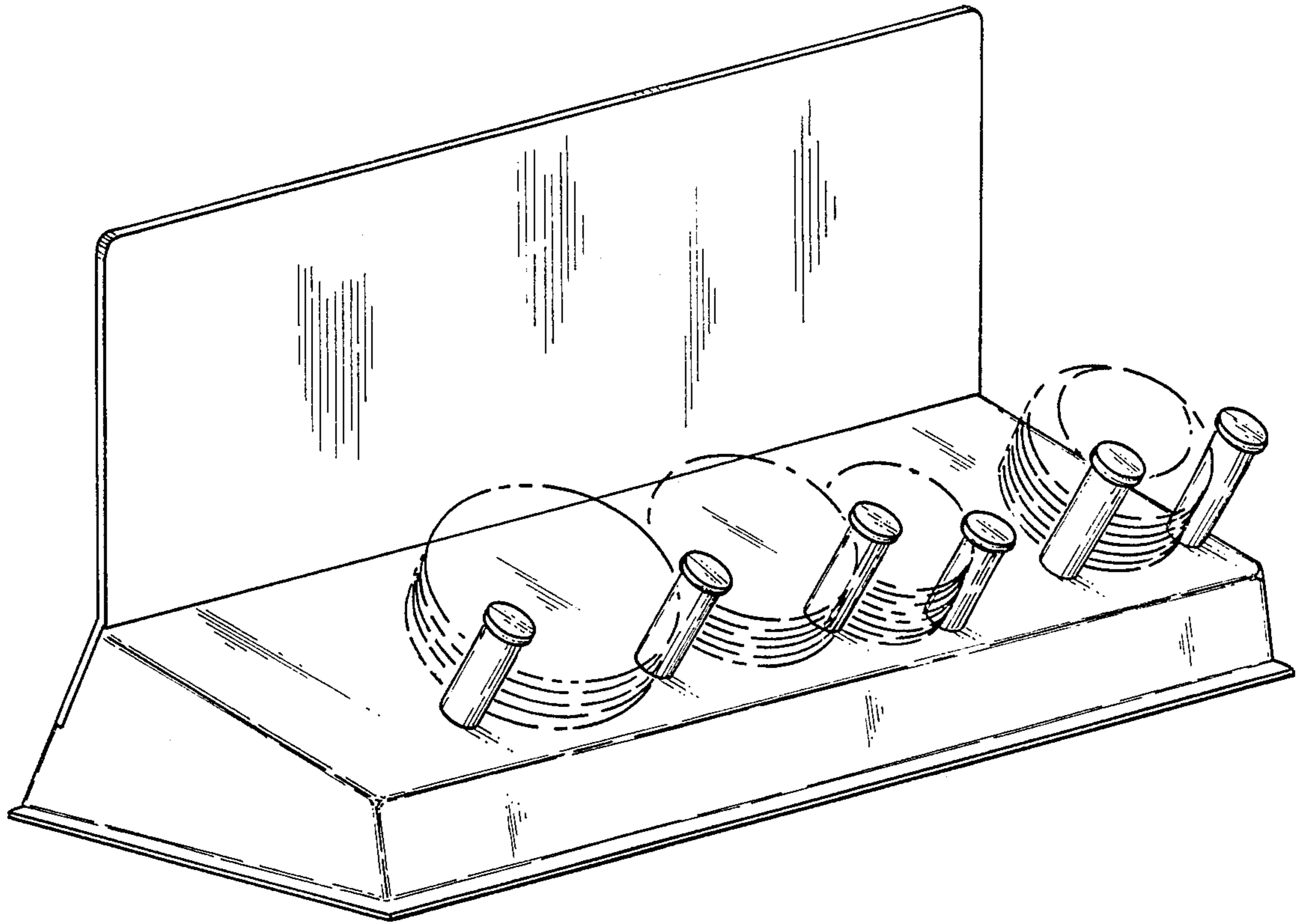

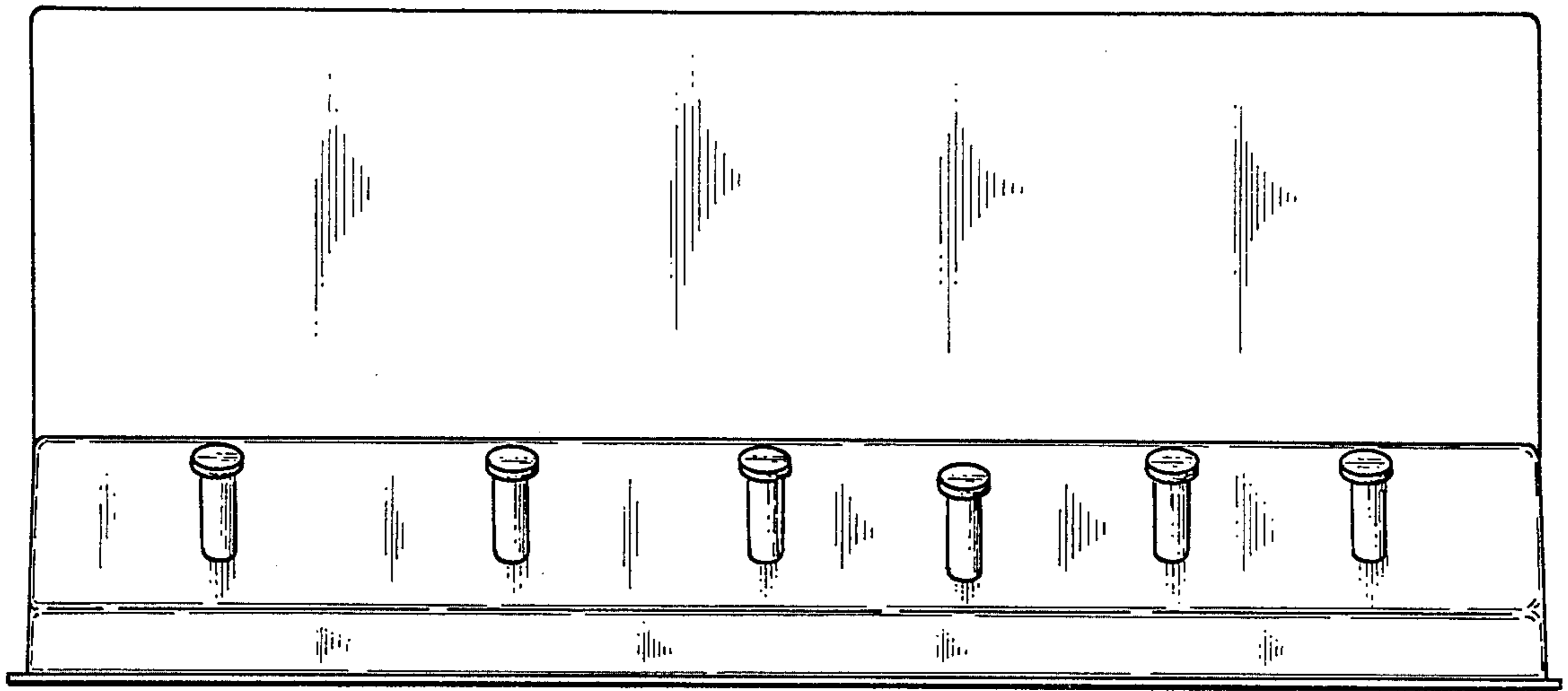

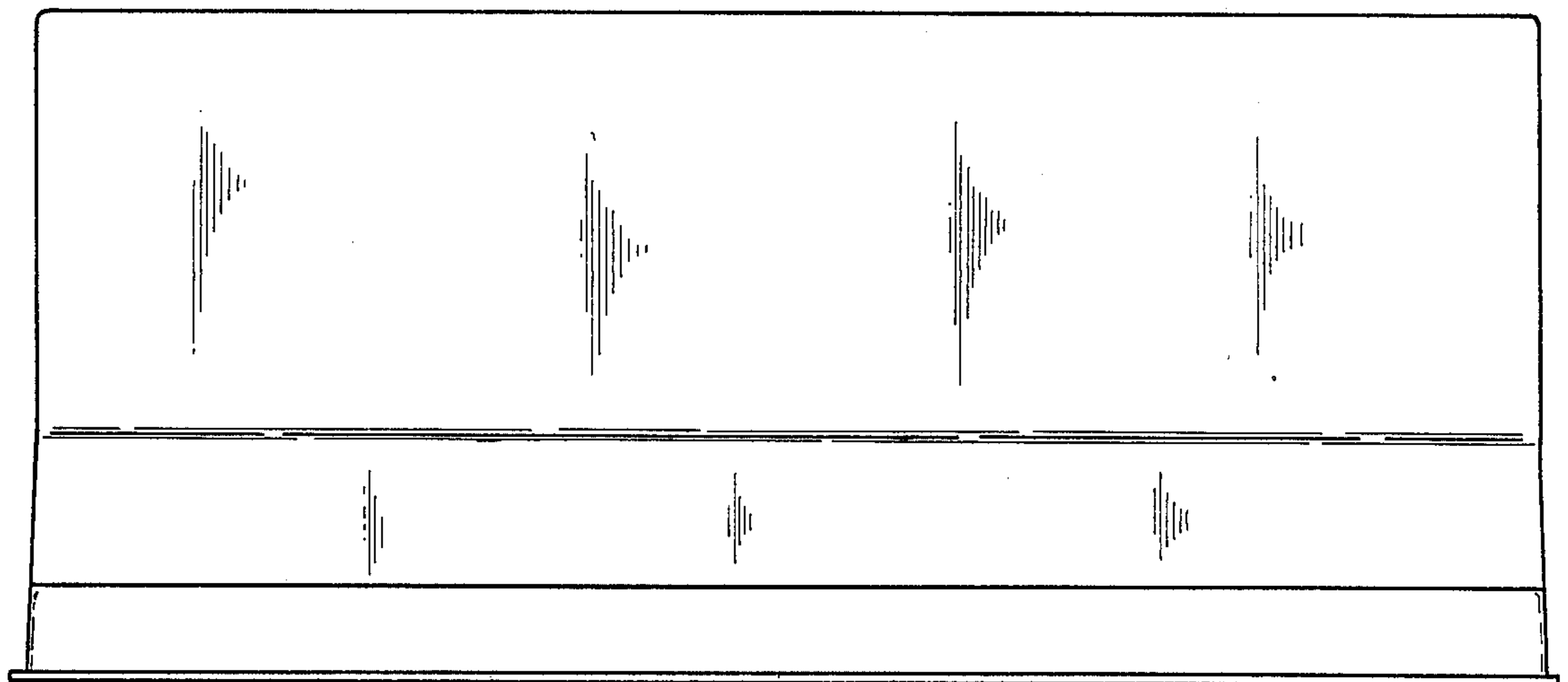

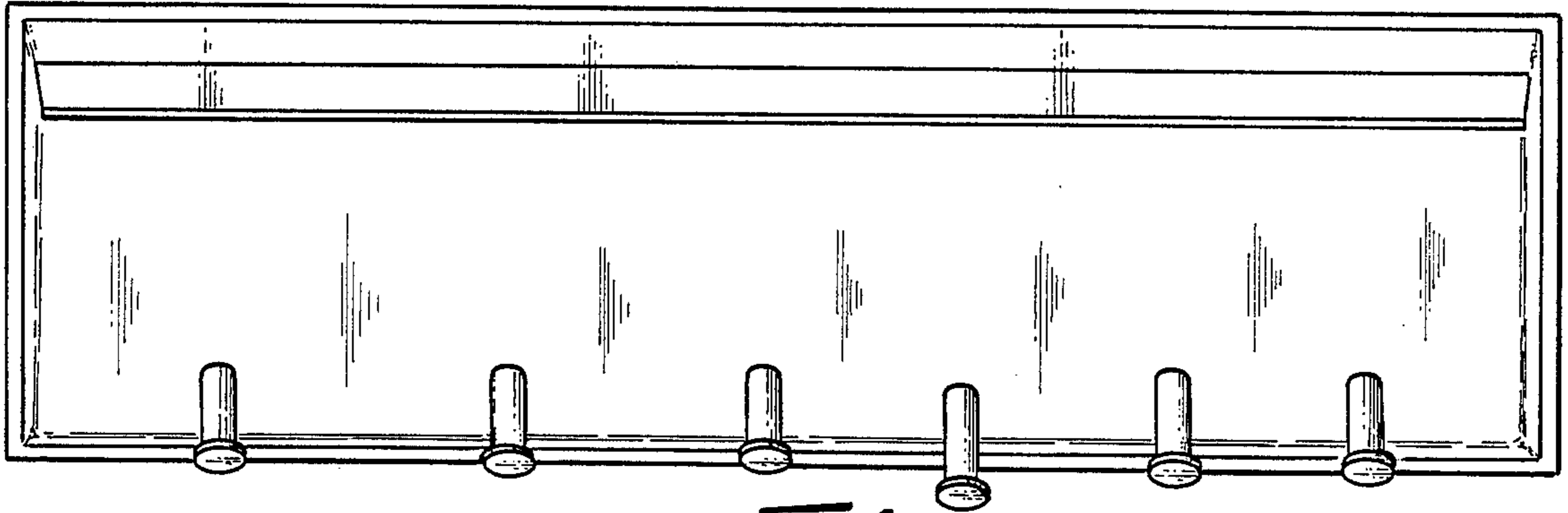

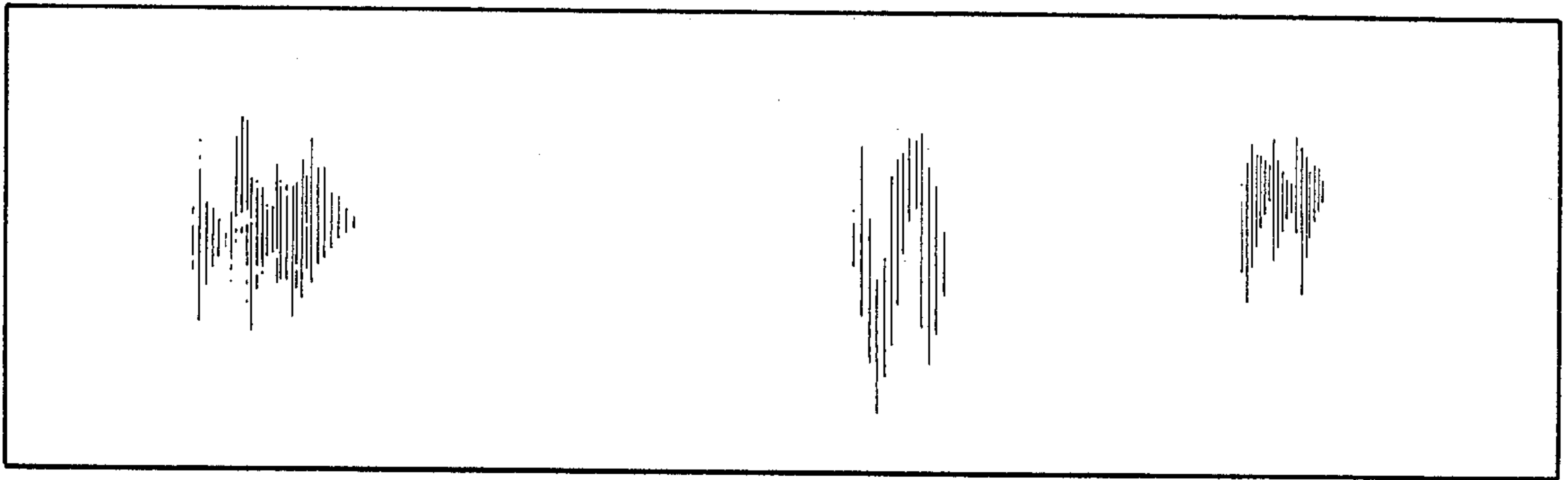

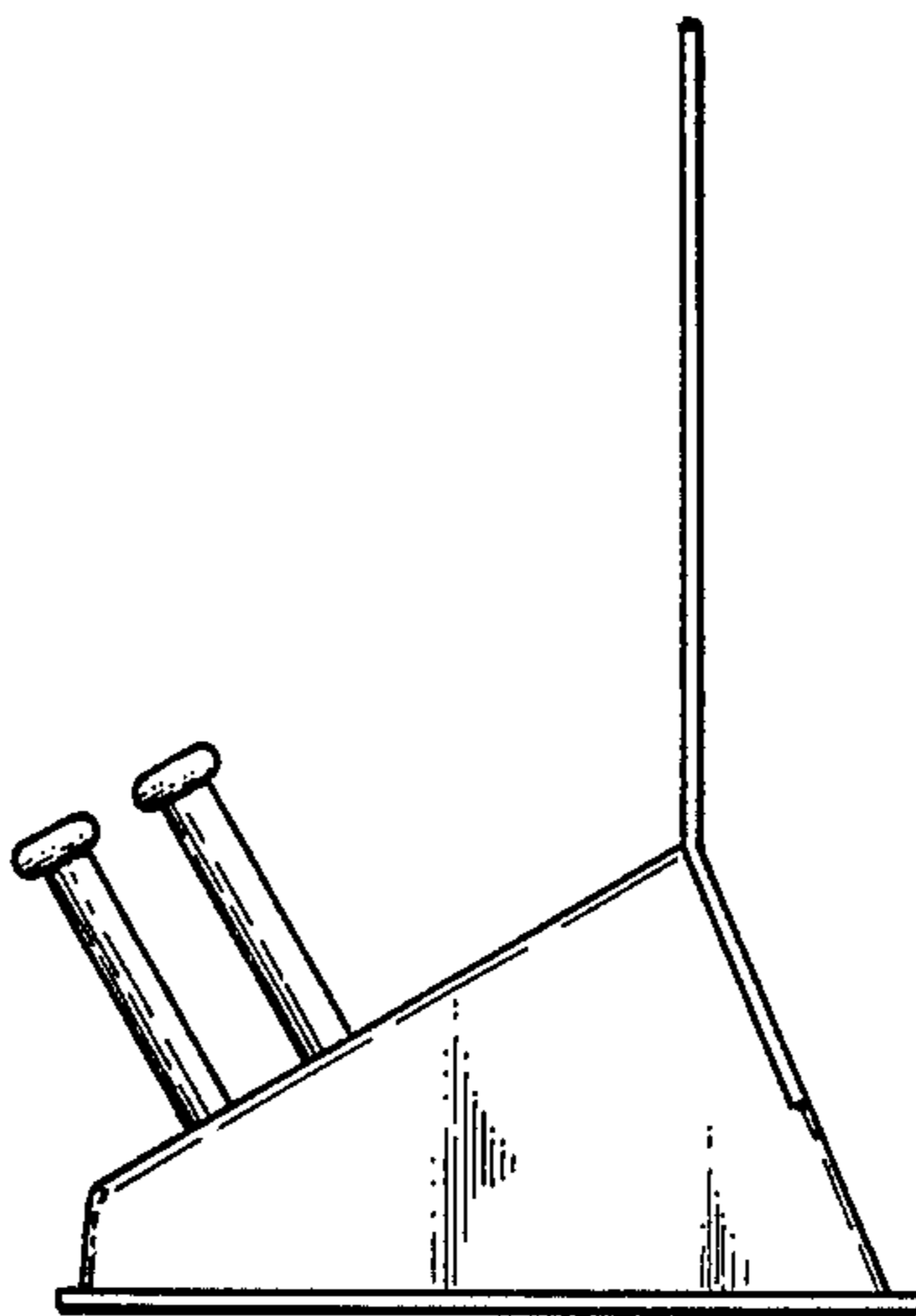
