described.

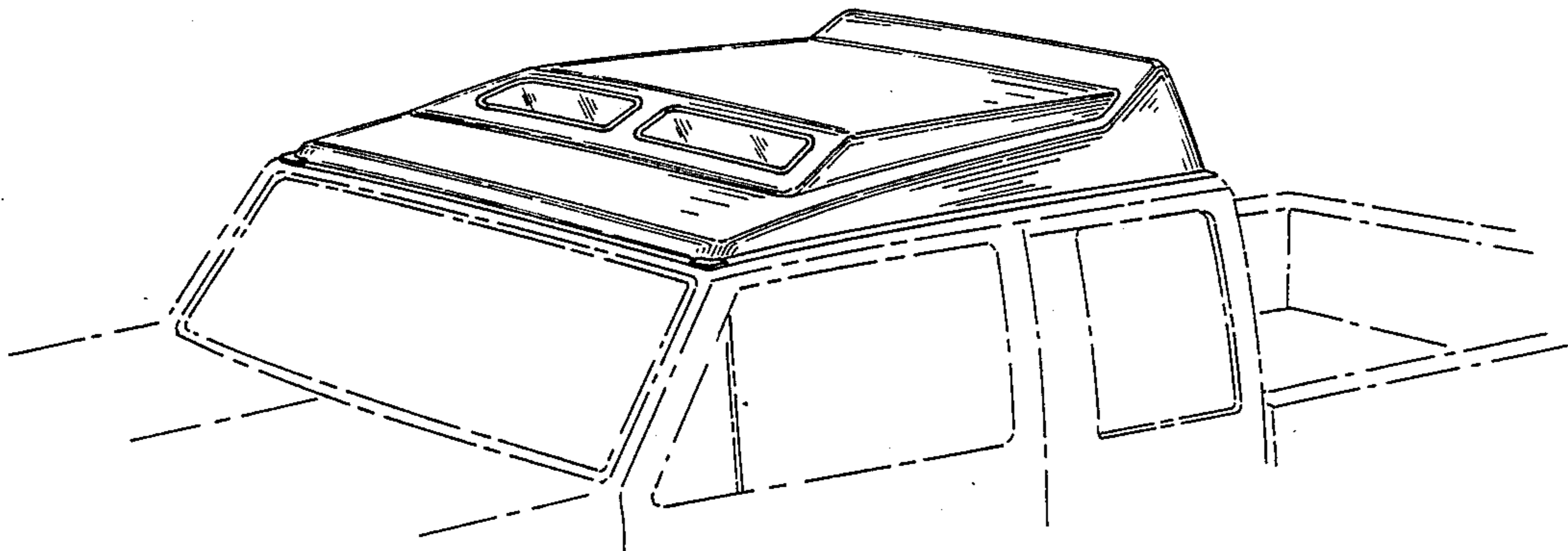
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the van top showing our
new design, it being understood that the portion shown
in broken lines is for illustrative purposes only and
forms no part of the claimed design.

right side being substantially a mirror image of that
shown;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



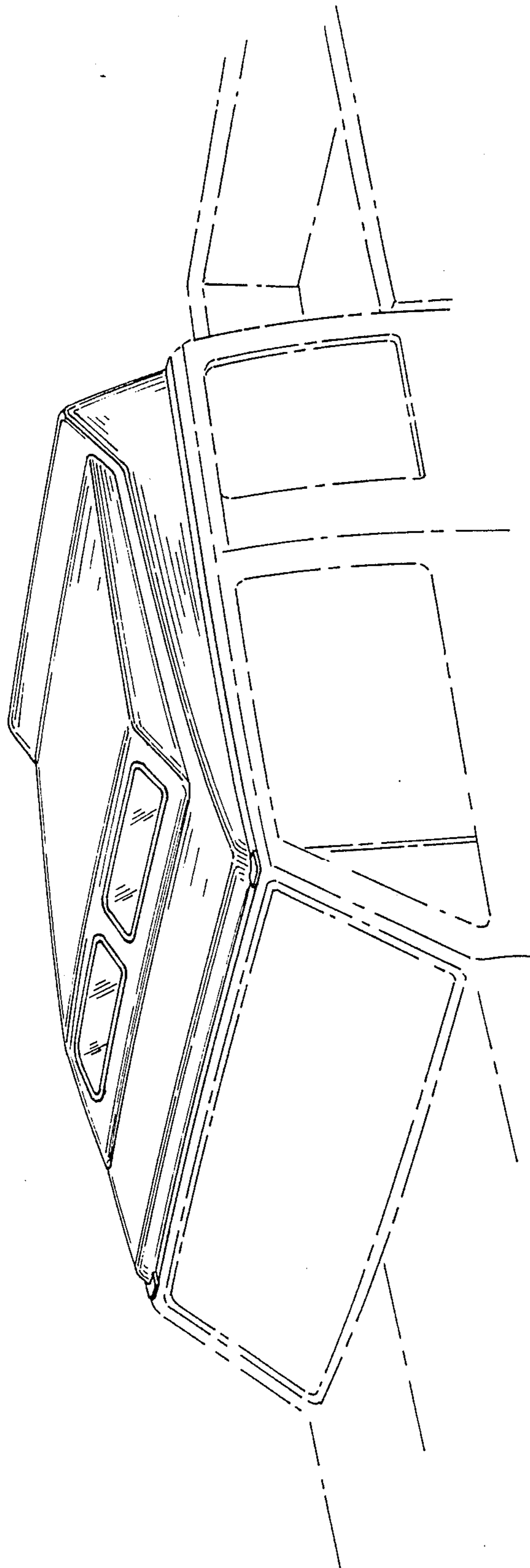

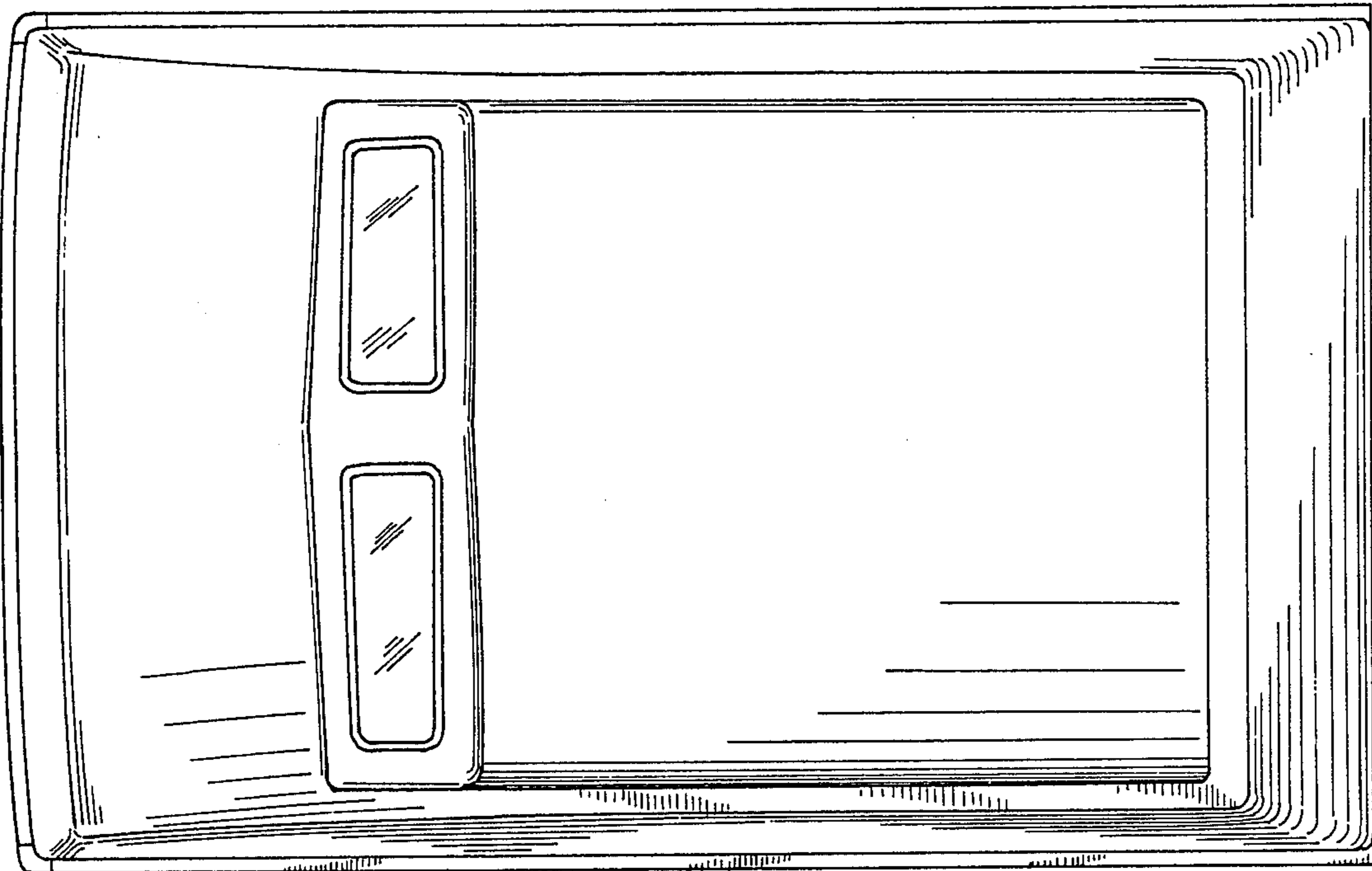

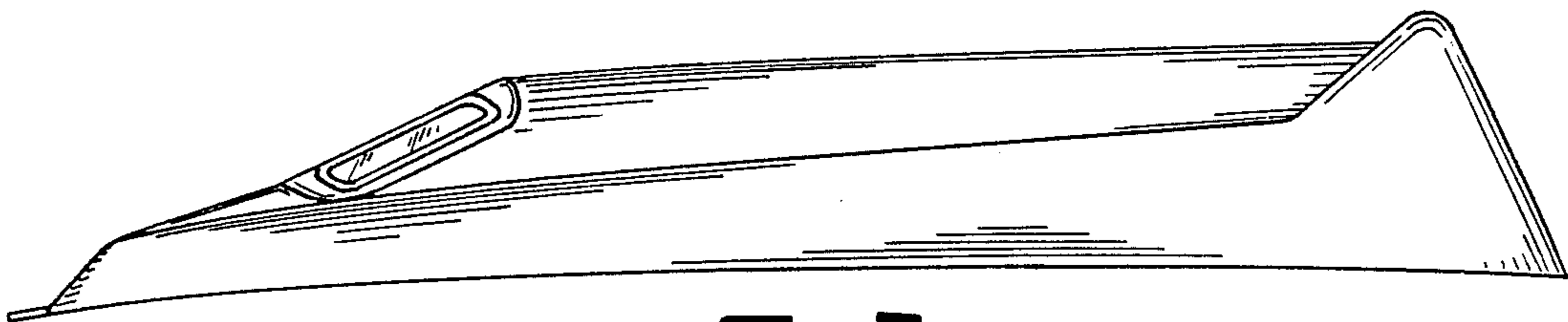

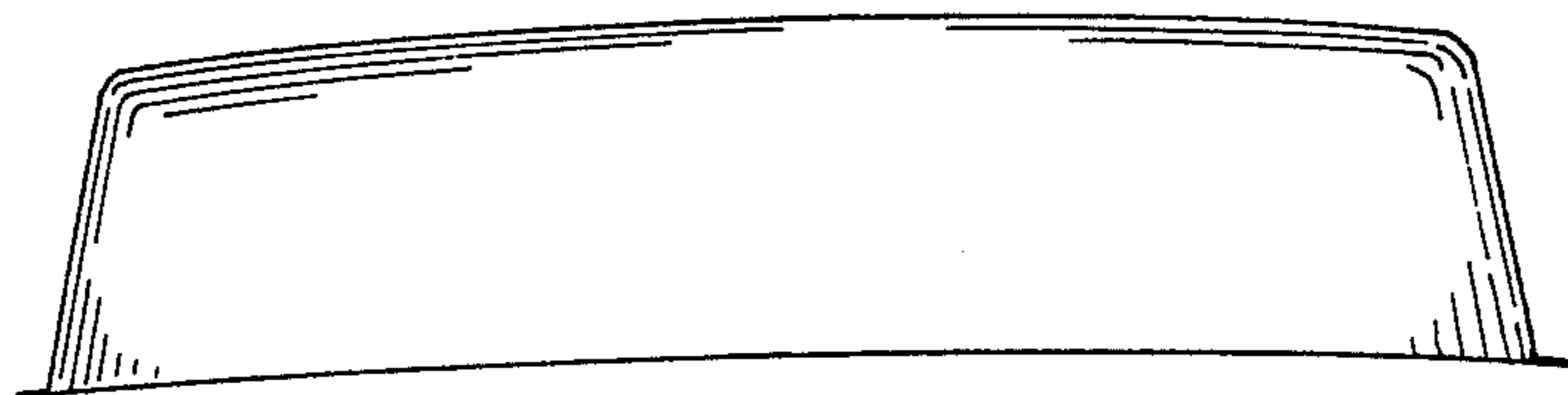
