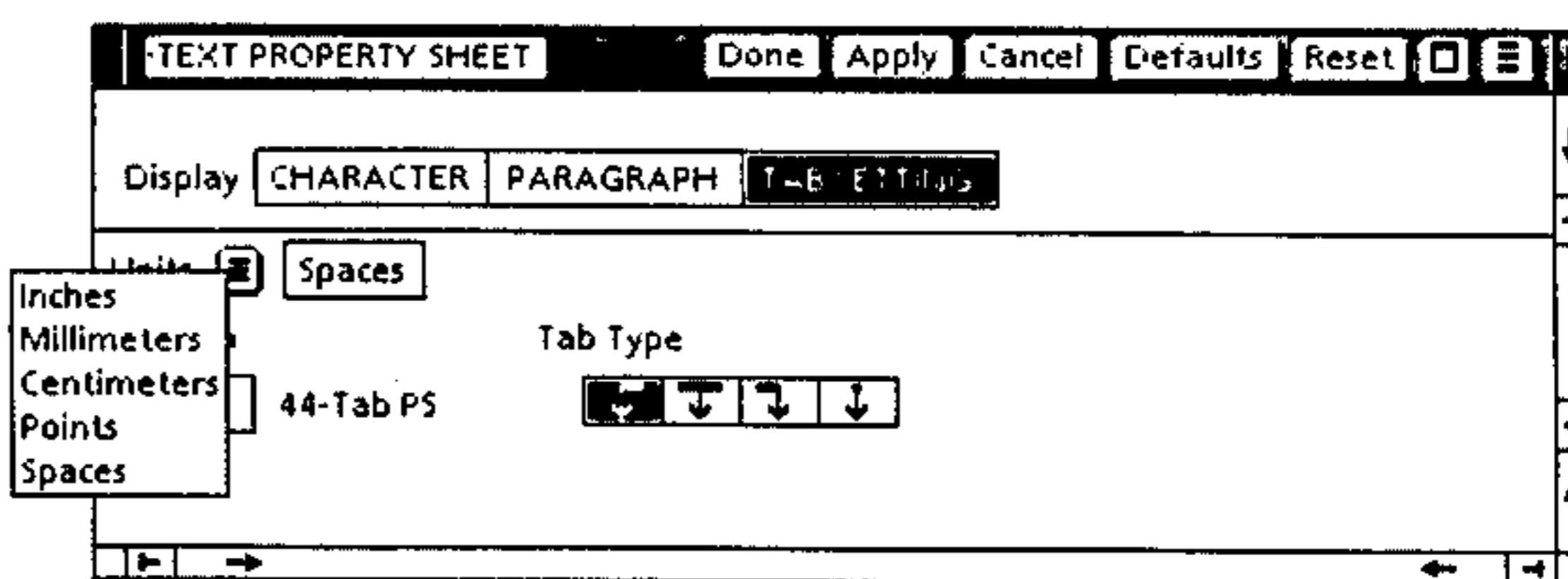
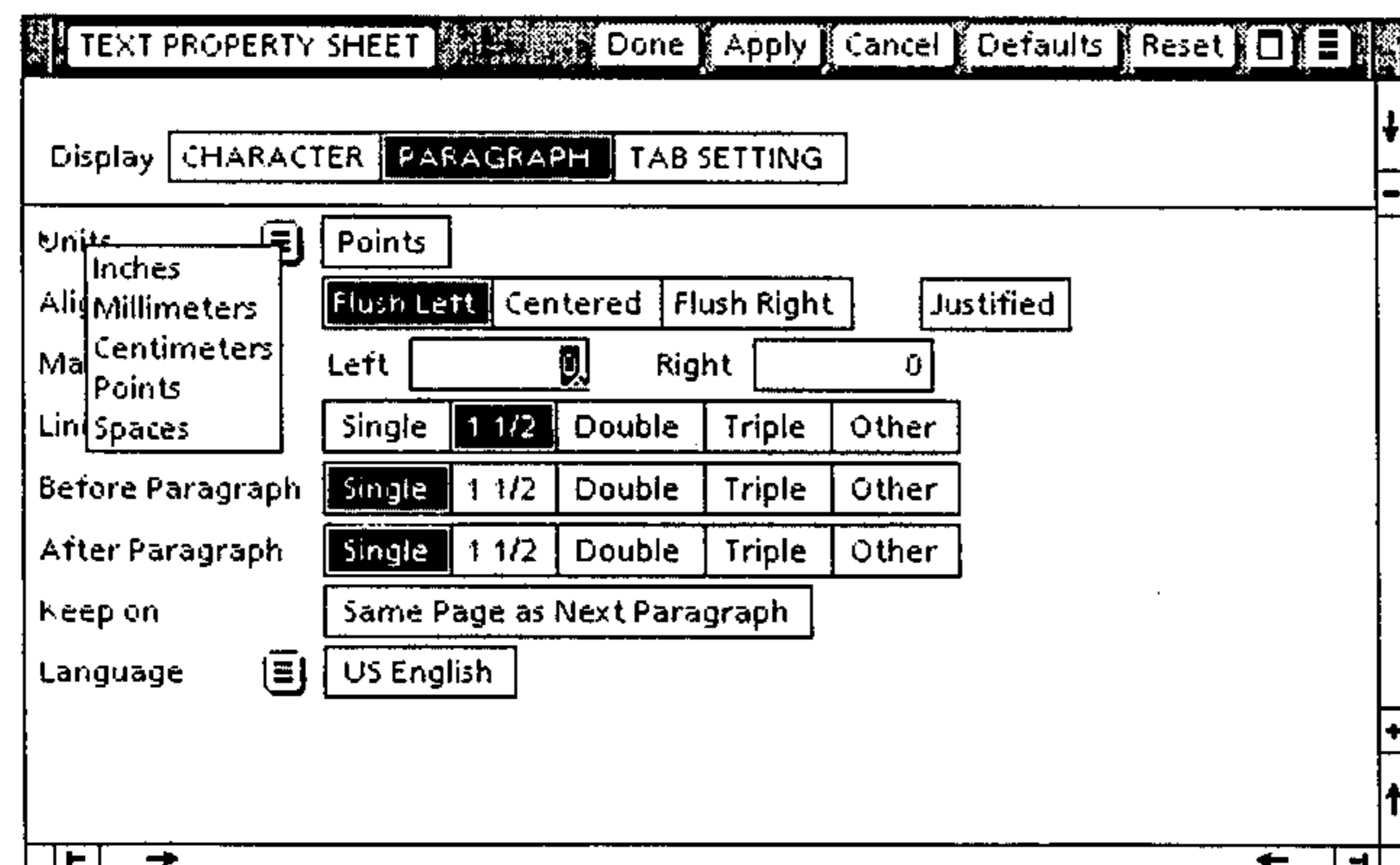
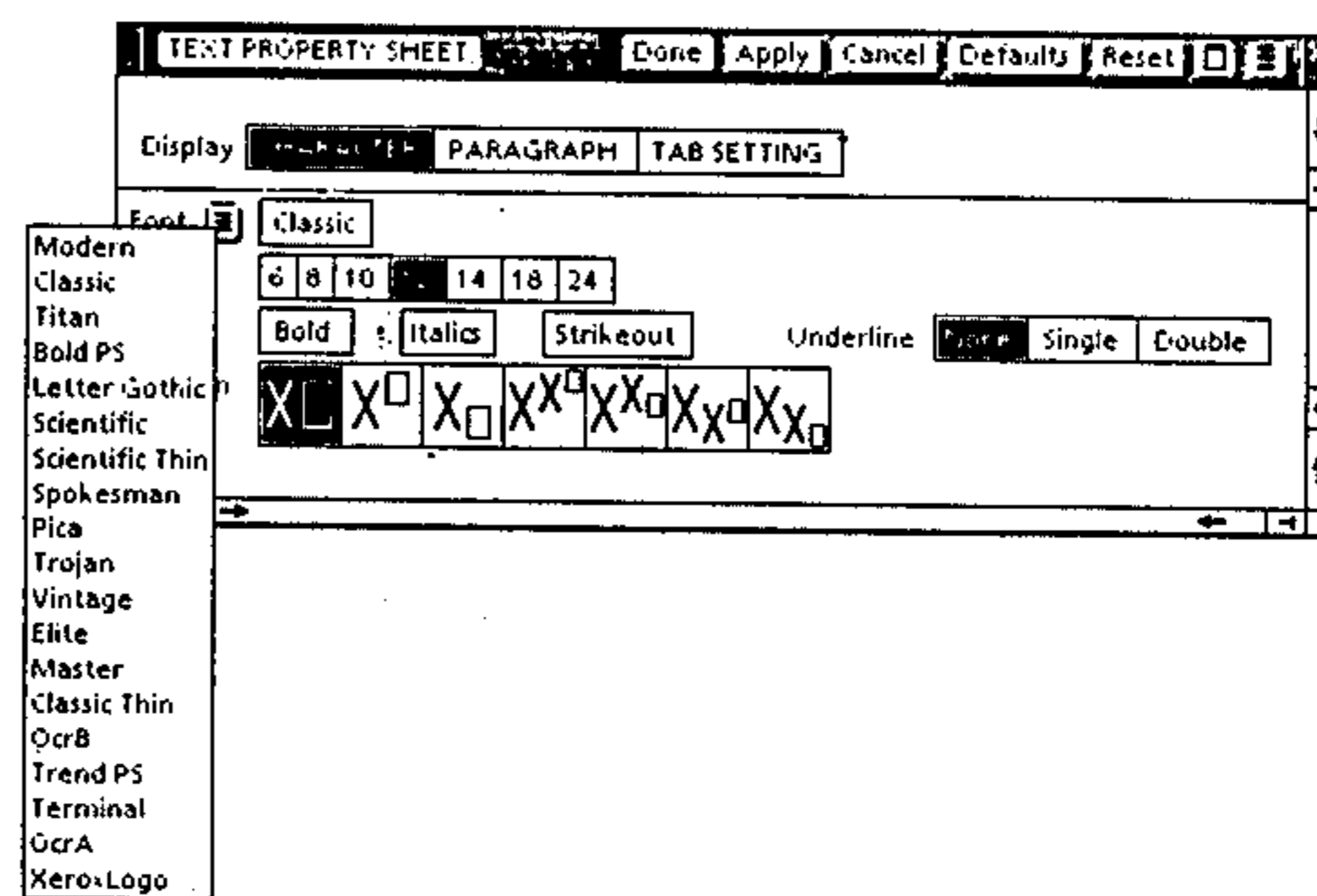
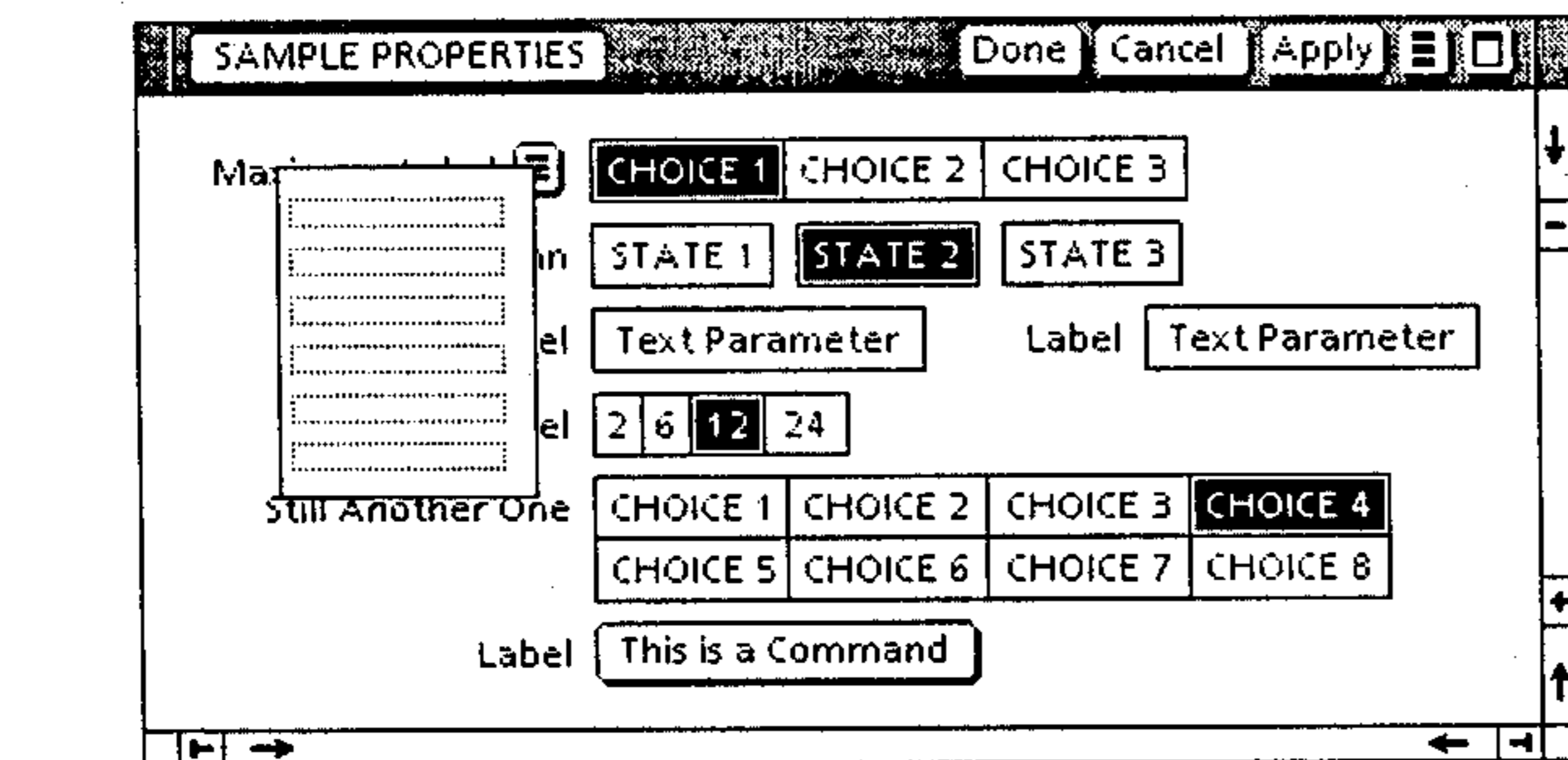

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an icon for a property sheet or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a face view of an icon for a property sheet or the like showing our new design in display position; FIG. 2 is a face view of the icon alone; FIG. 3 is a face view of the icon with pop-up screen; FIG. 4 is a face view of an icon for property sheet or the like showing a modified form of our new design in display mode; FIG. 5 is a face view thereof with pop-up screen; FIG. 6 is a face view of an icon for property sheet or the like showing a third embodiment of our new design in display mode; FIG. 7 is a face view thereof with pop-up screen; FIG. 8 is a face view of an icon for property sheet or the like showing a fourth embodiment of our new design in display mode; and FIG. 9 is a face view thereof with pop-up screen. The broken line showing of a partial display screen in FIG. 1 and regions for alphanumeric information within the pop-up screen in FIG. 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



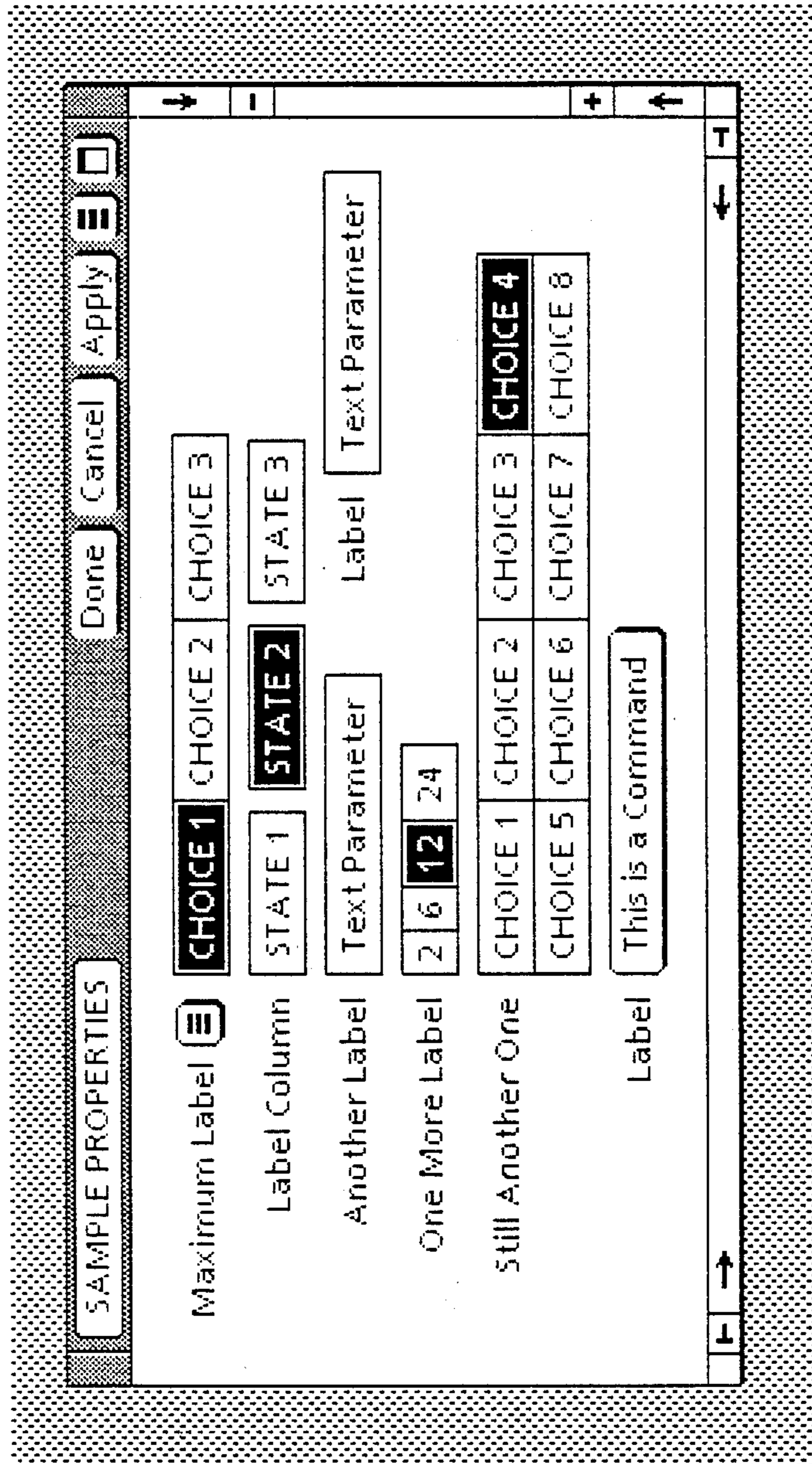

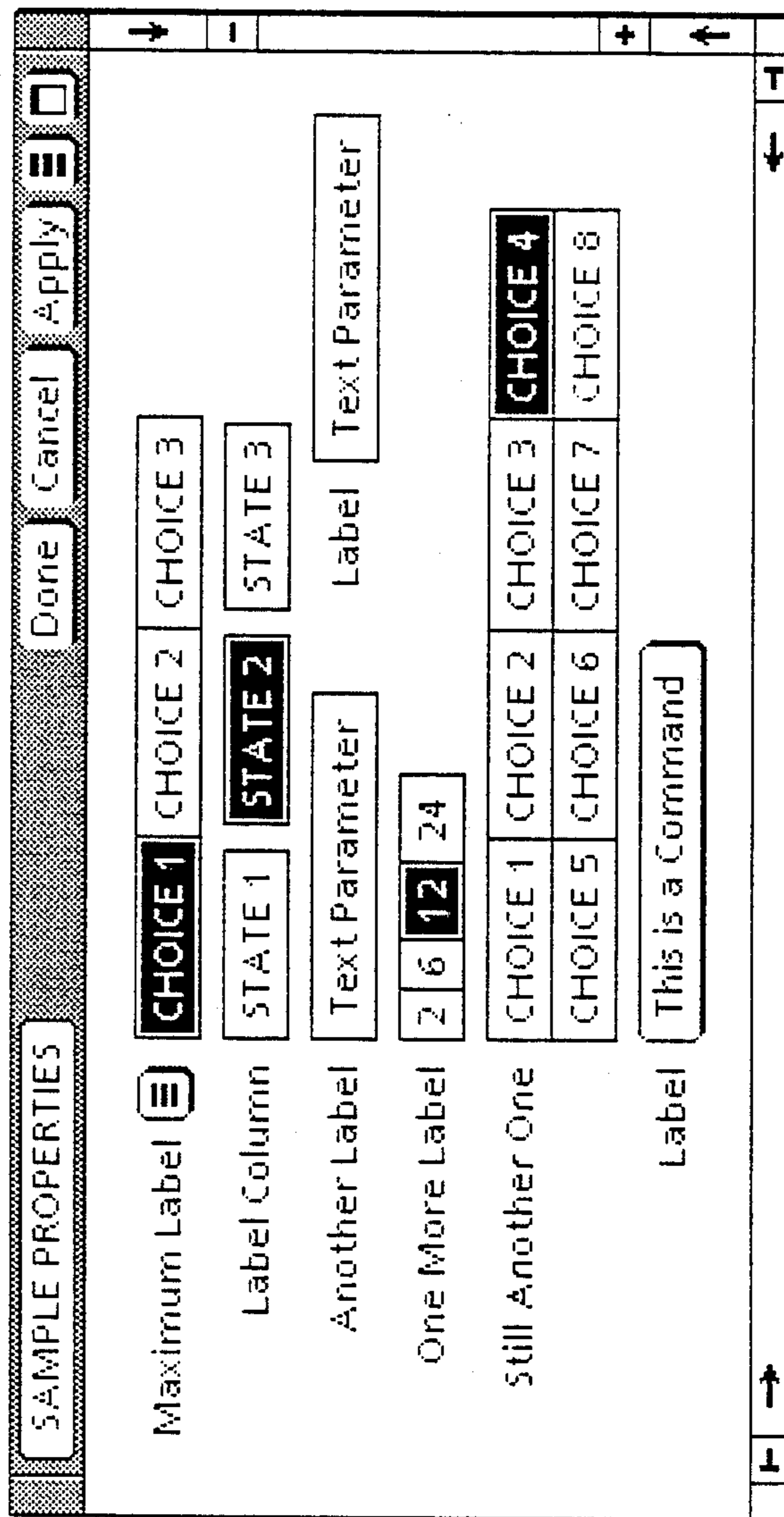

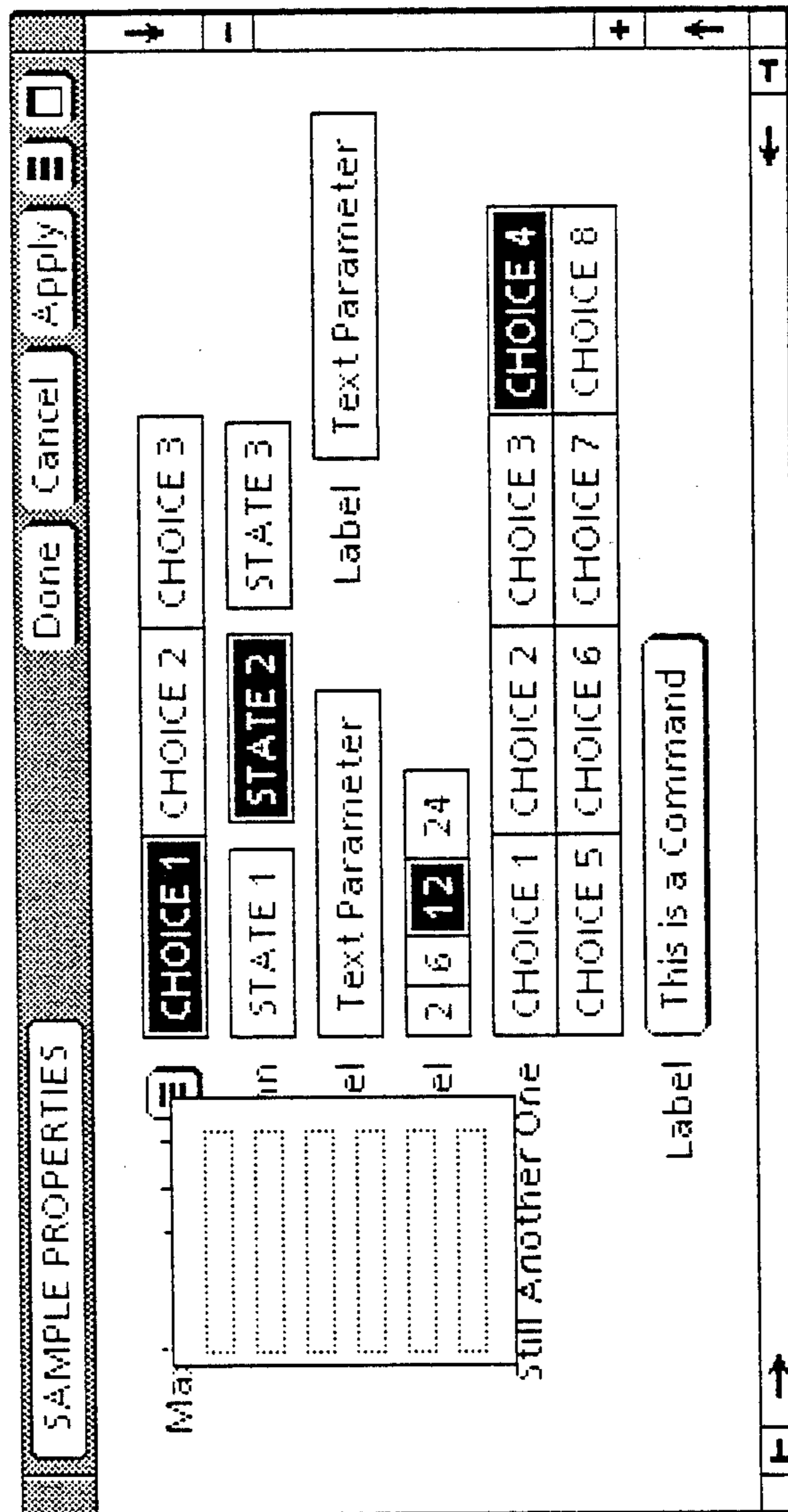

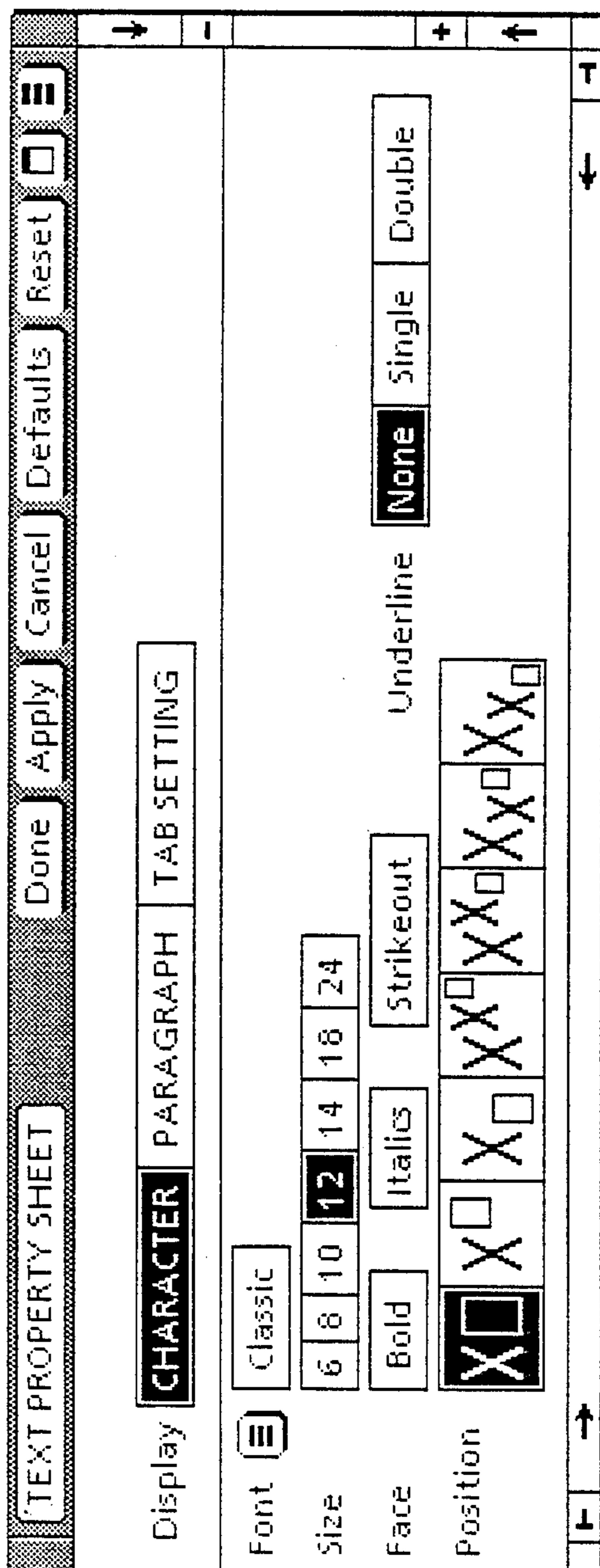

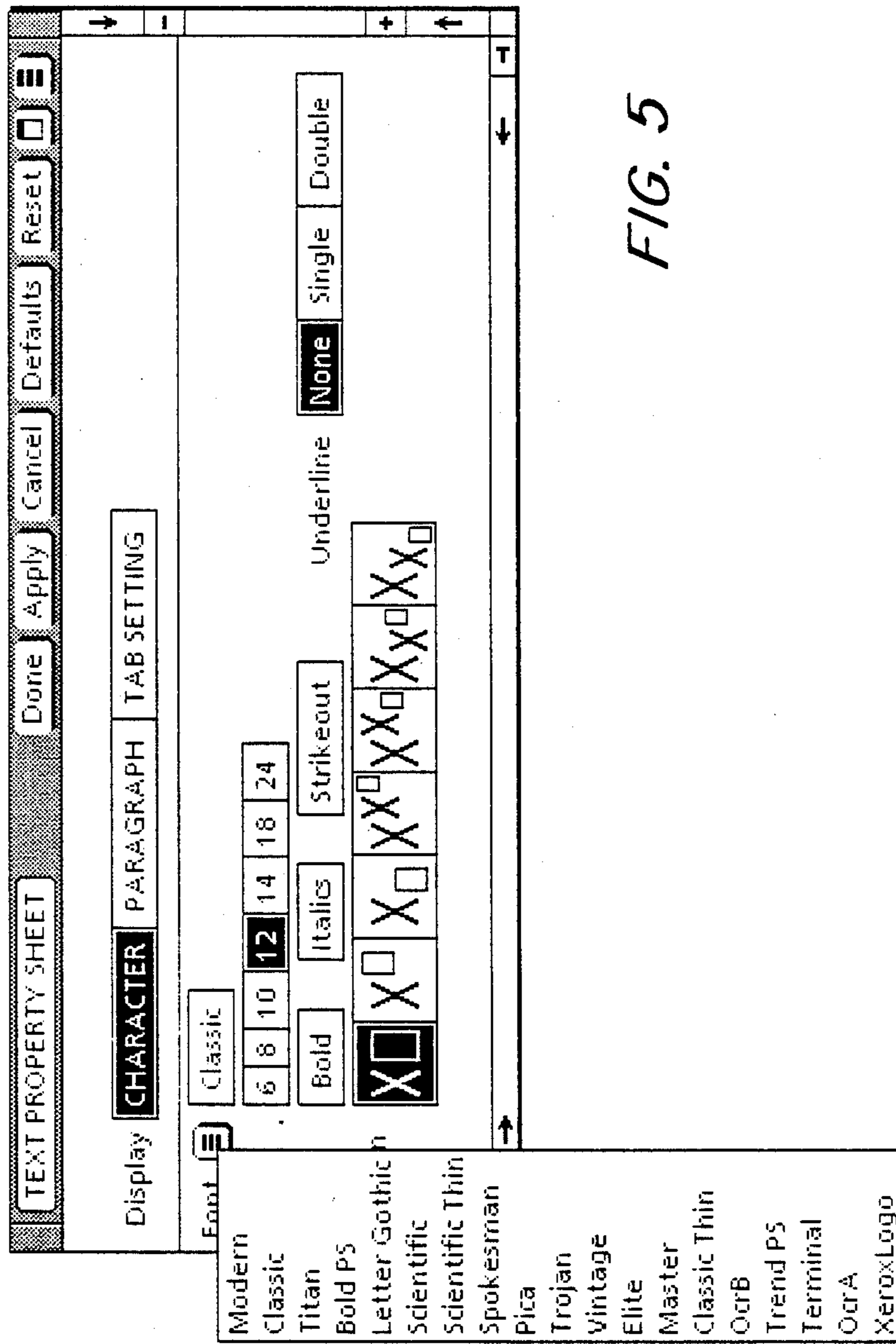

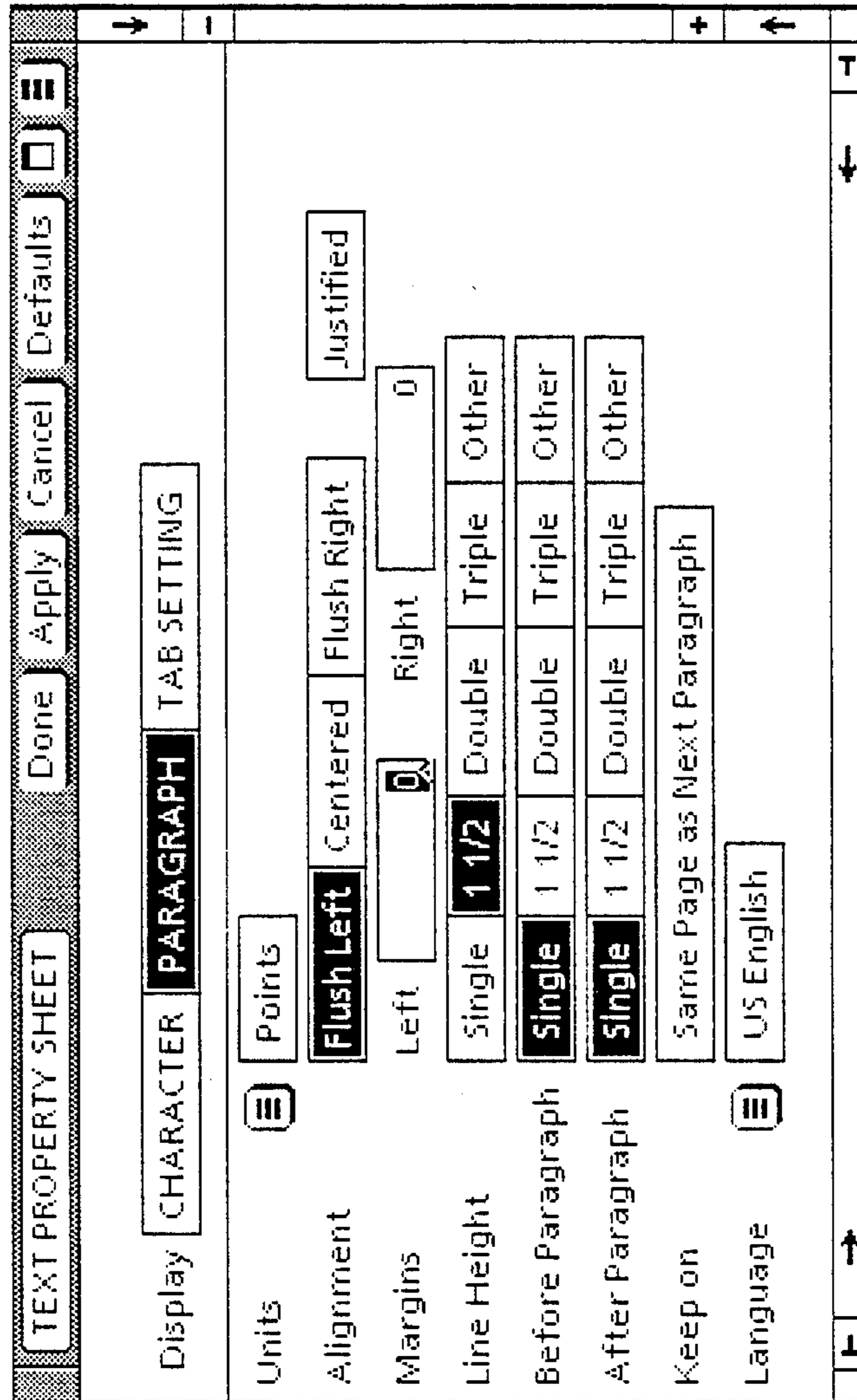

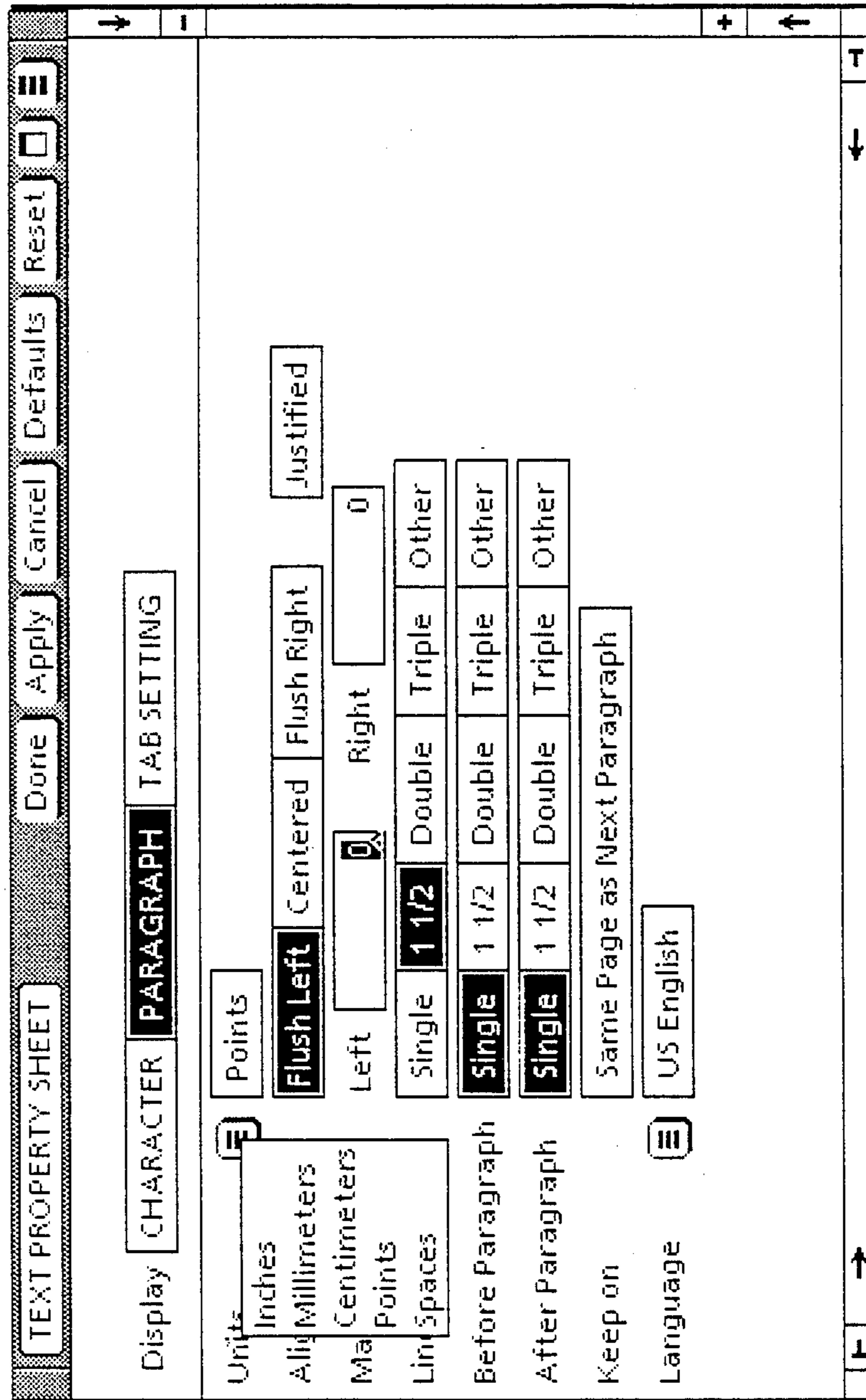

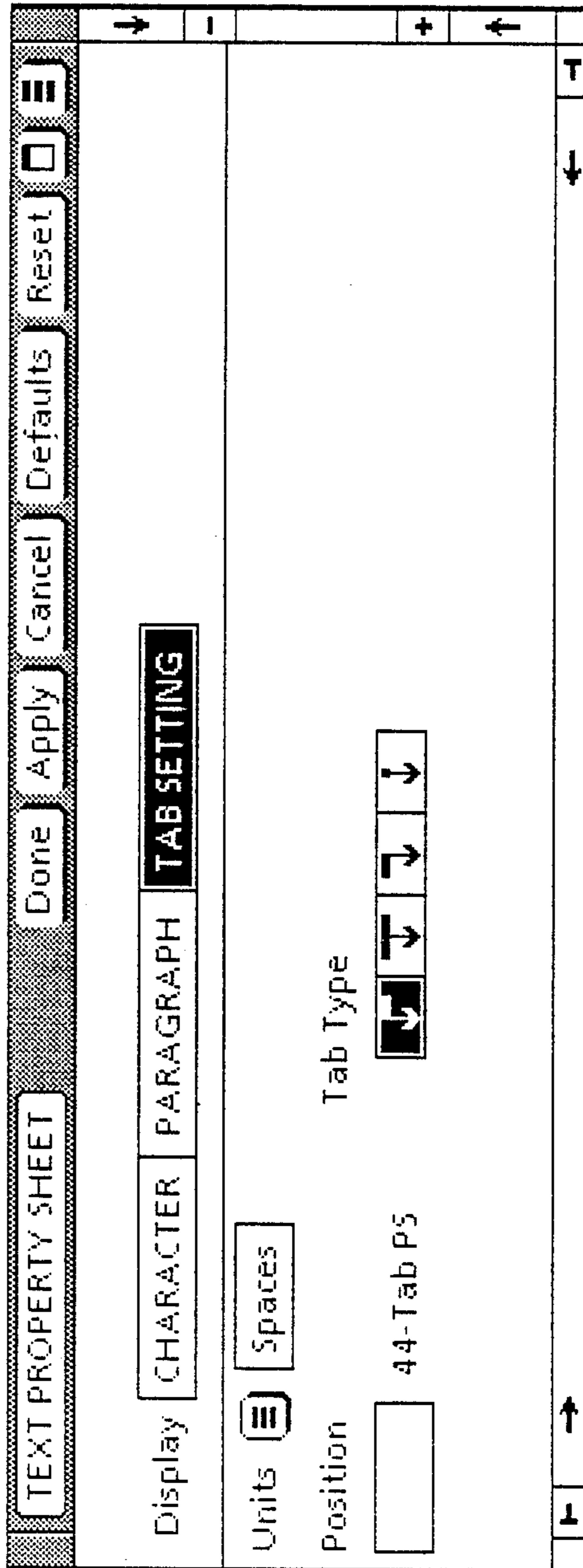

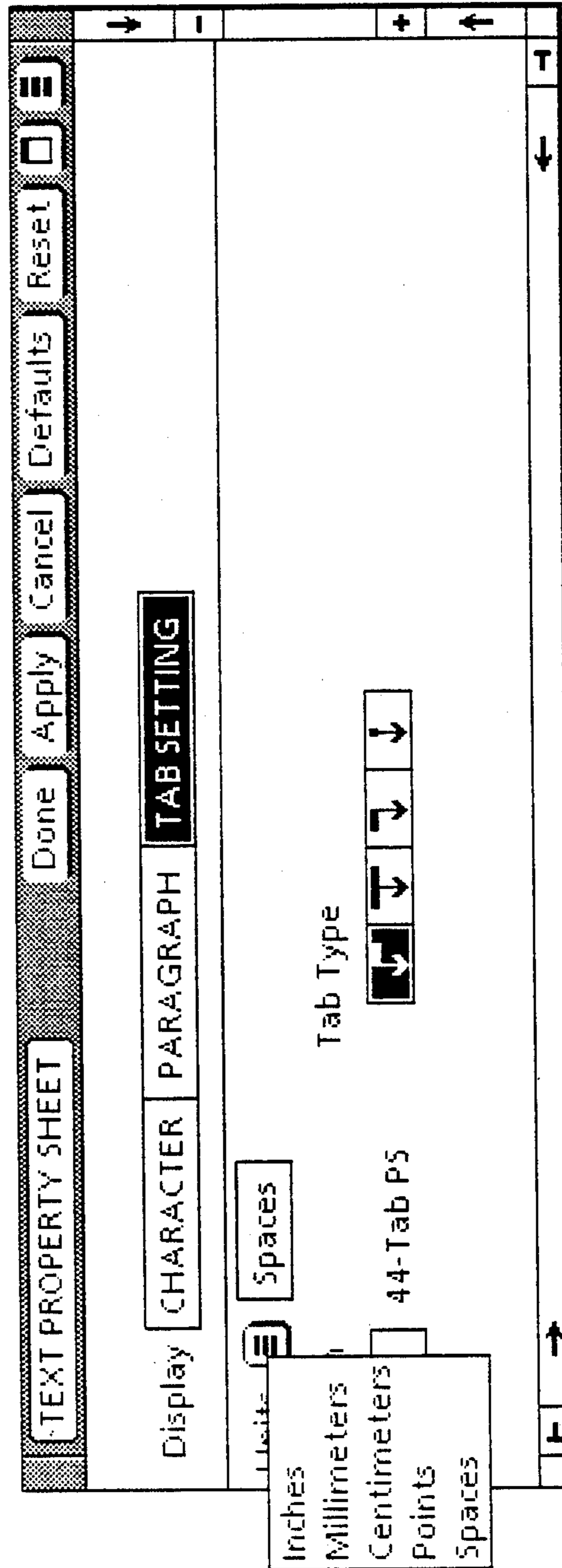
