FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the fishing hook of FIG. 1, where the hook of FIG. 3 is rotated to the right of FIG. 3 through an angle of 180 degrees.

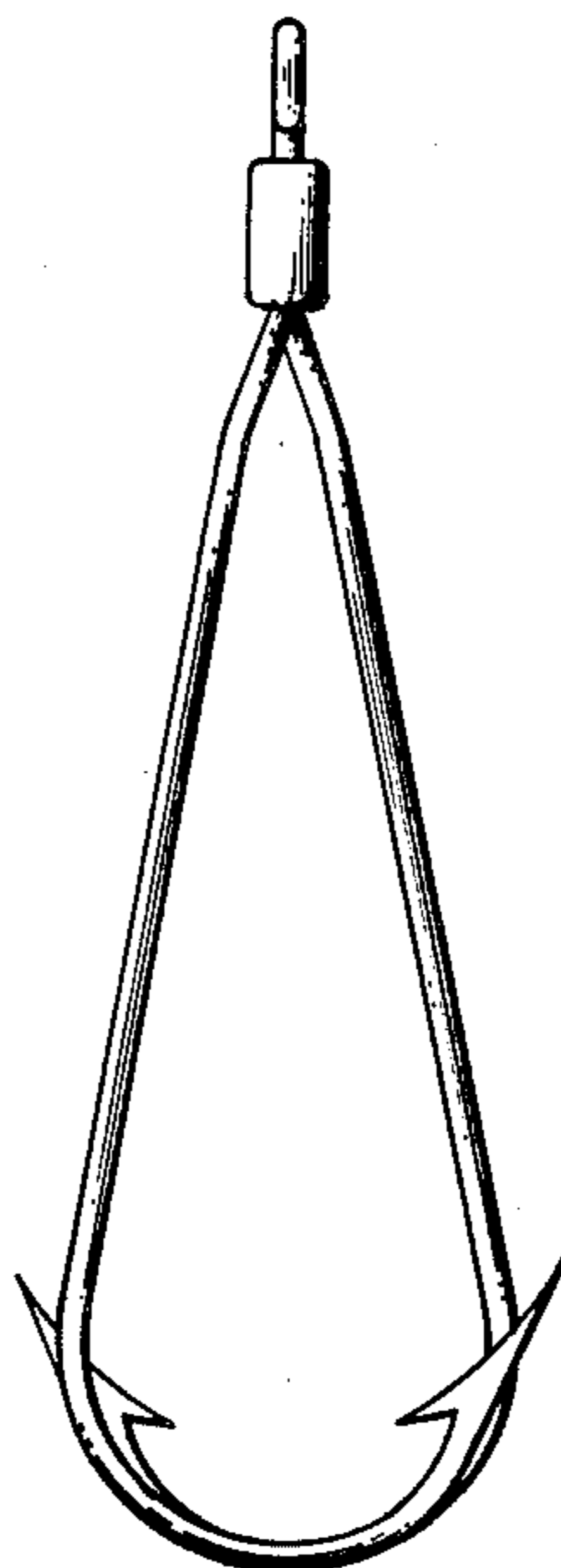

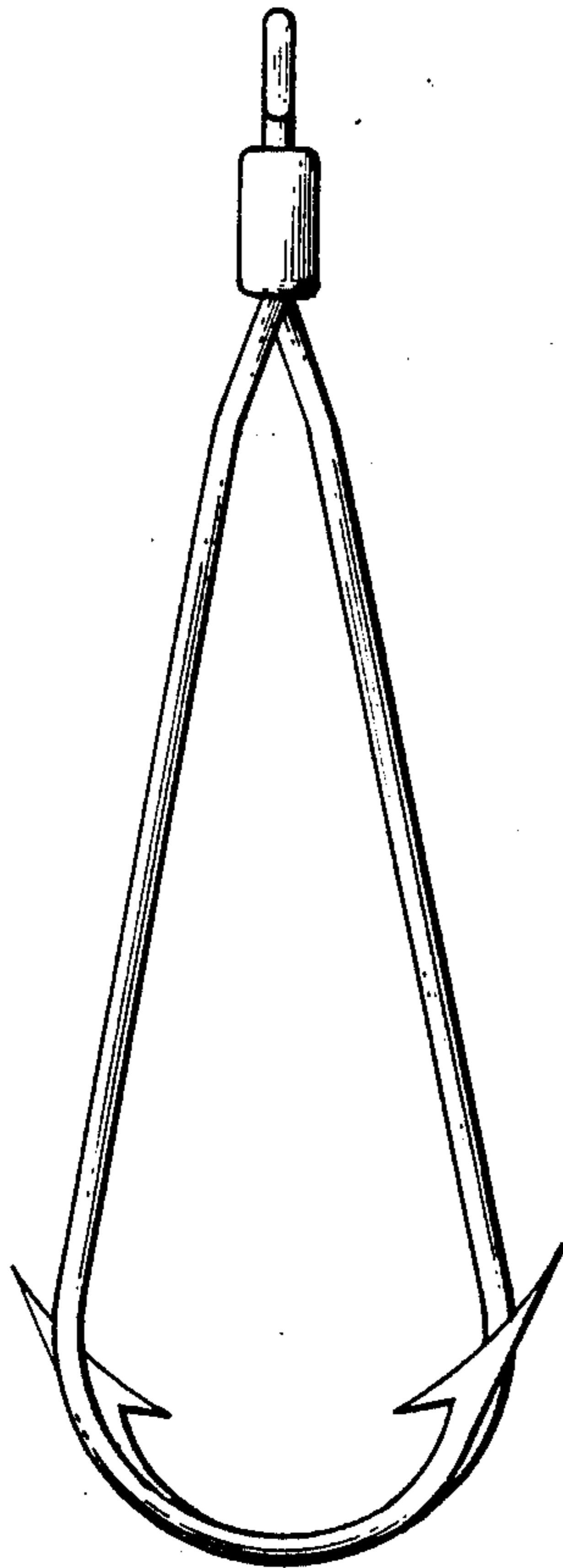

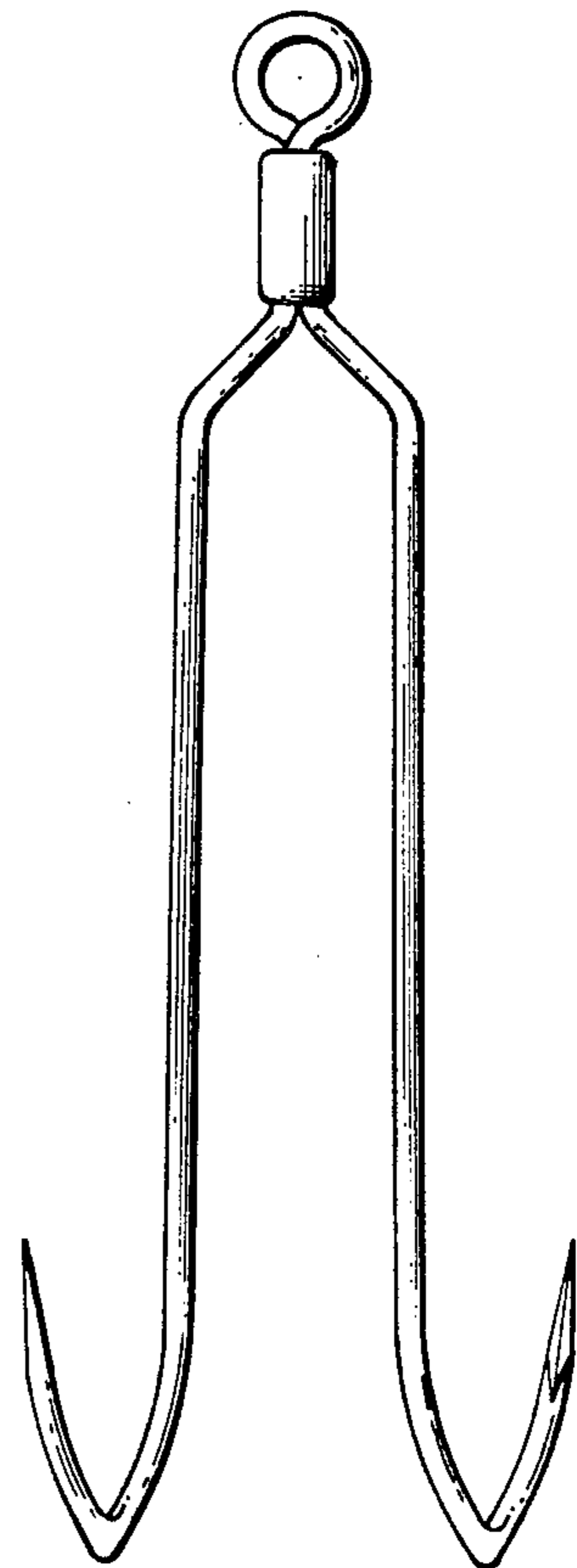

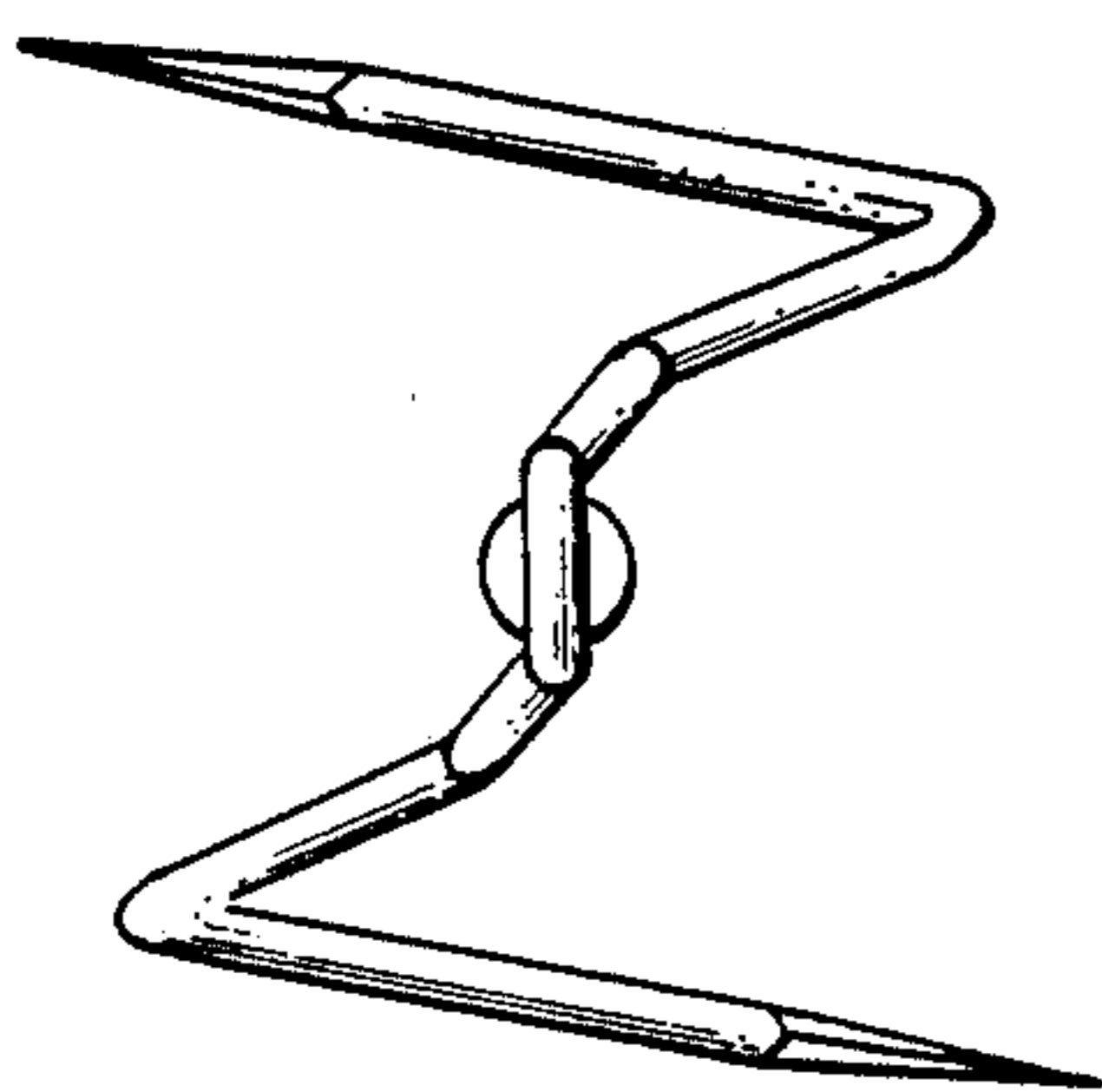
