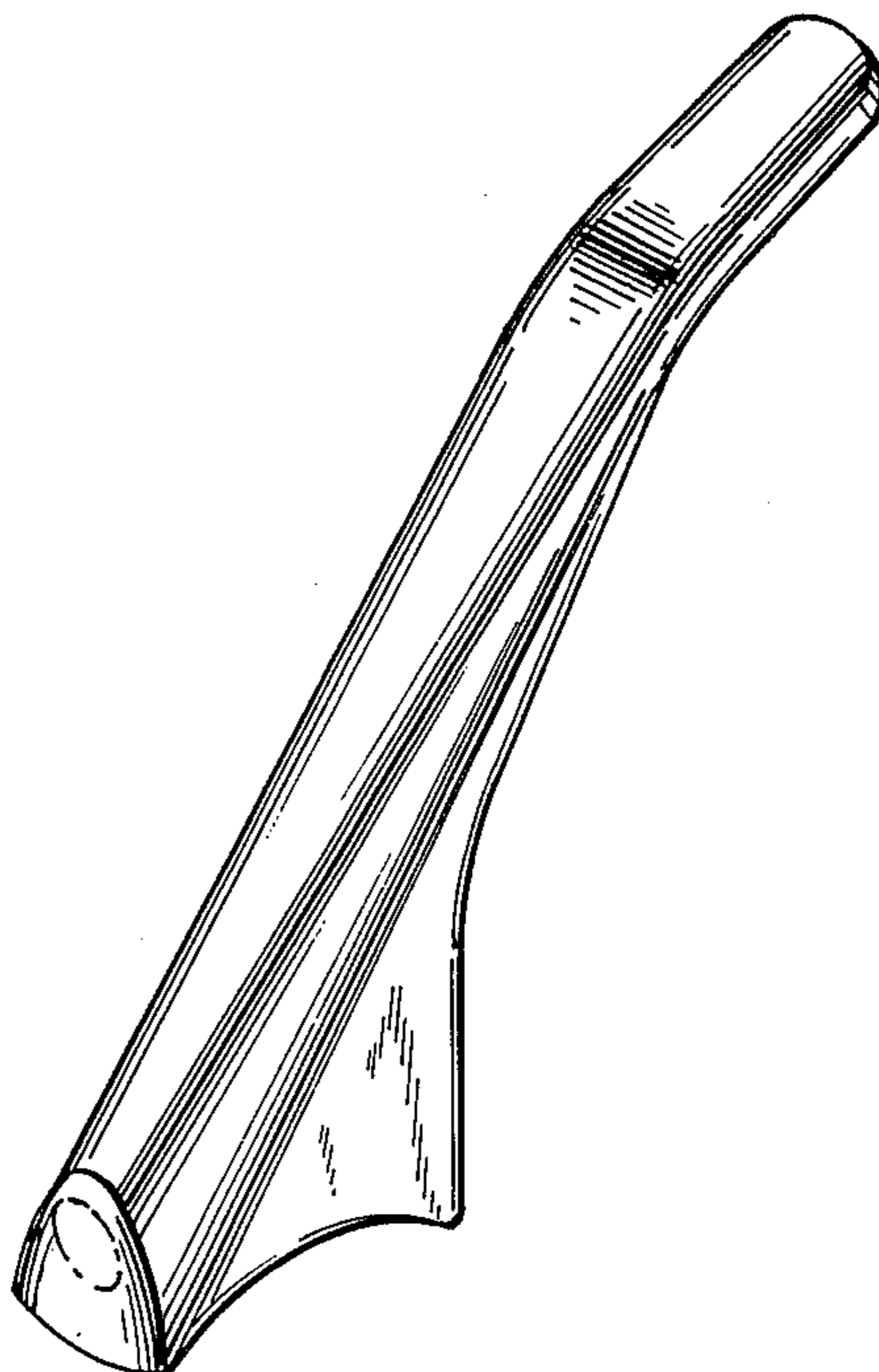

The ornamental design for a lever handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a lever handle showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being the mirror image of the left side; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken line representation of any opening in FIGS. 1 and 3 is purposes of illustration only.



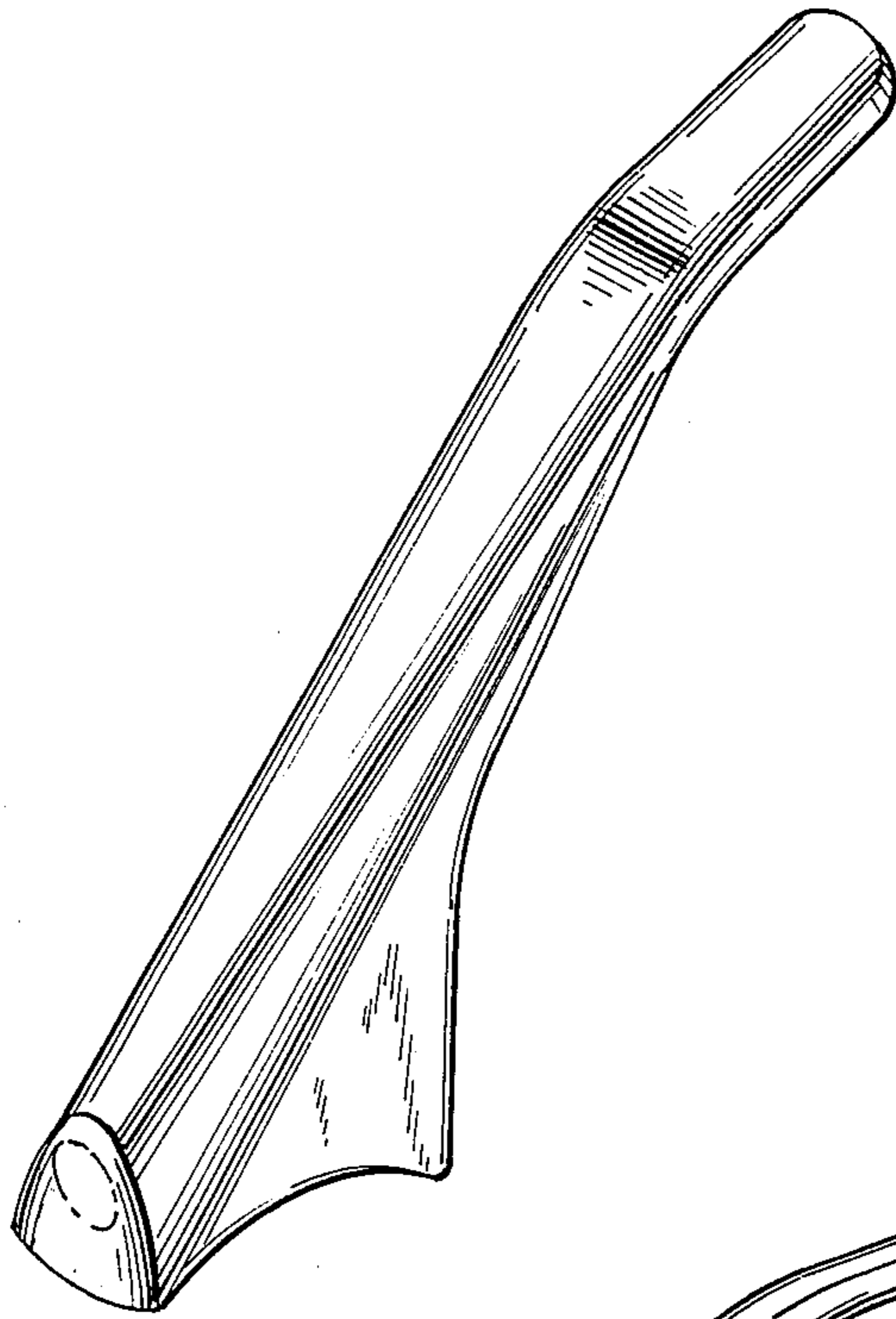

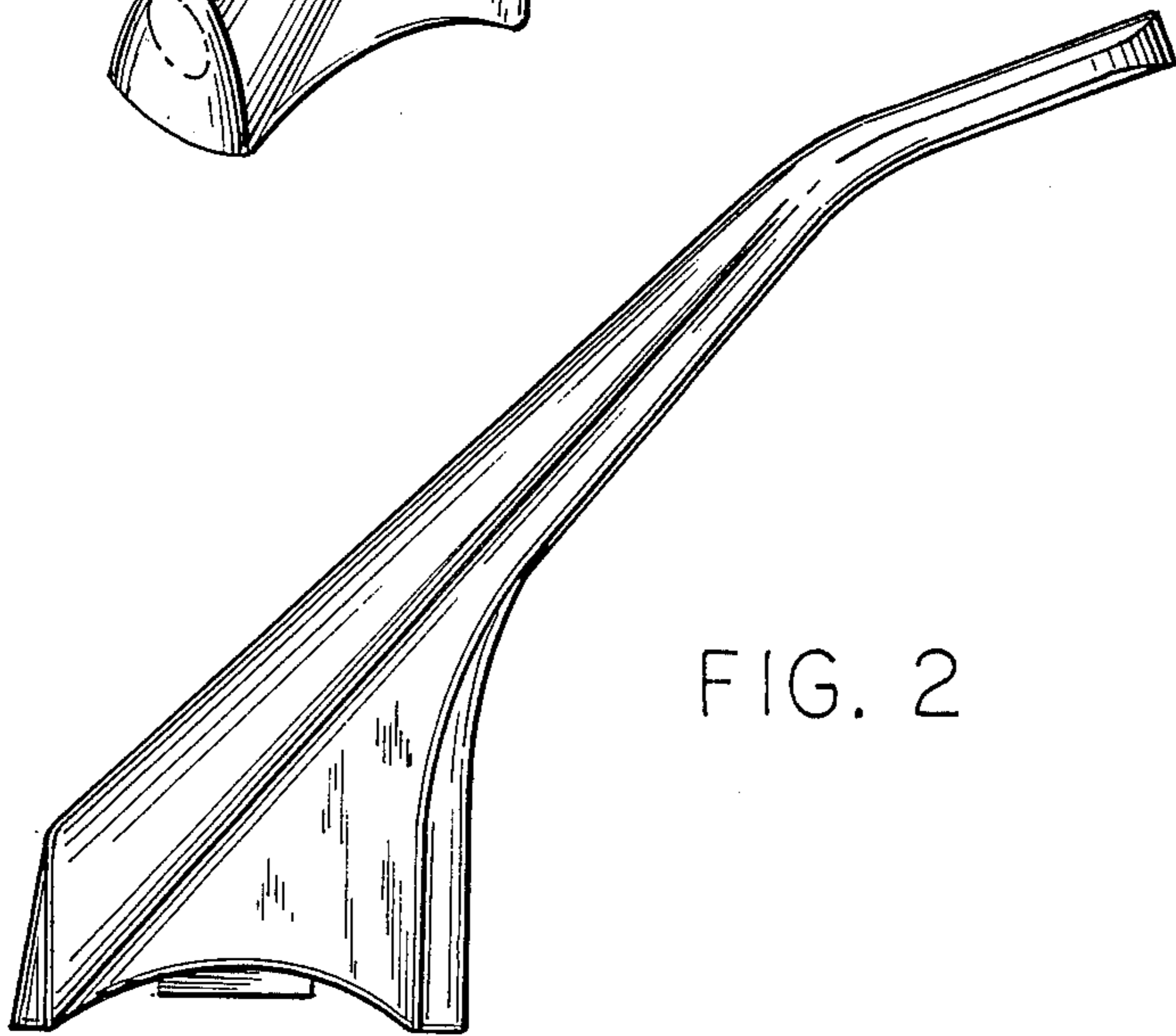

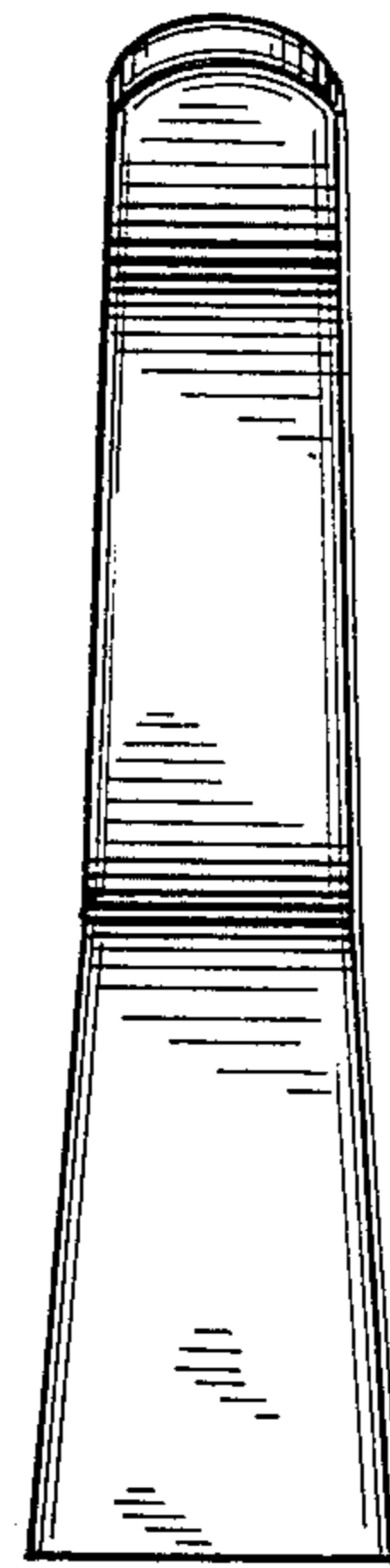

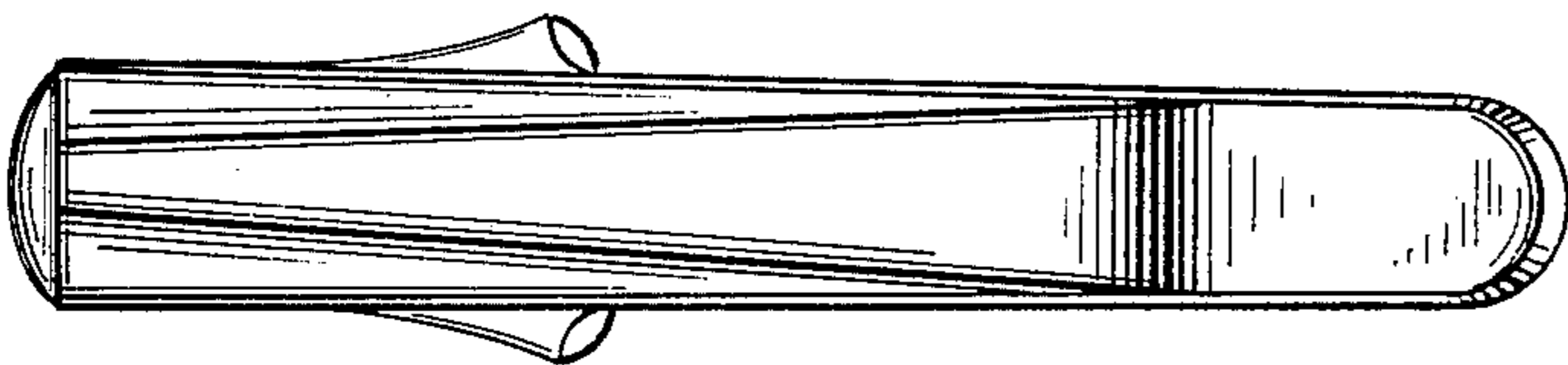
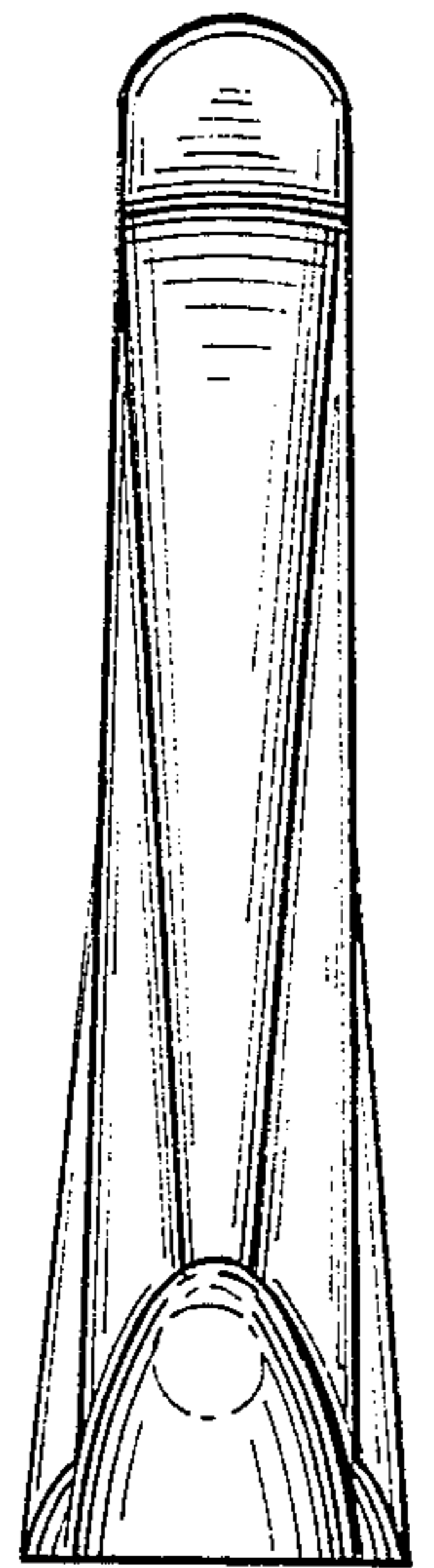

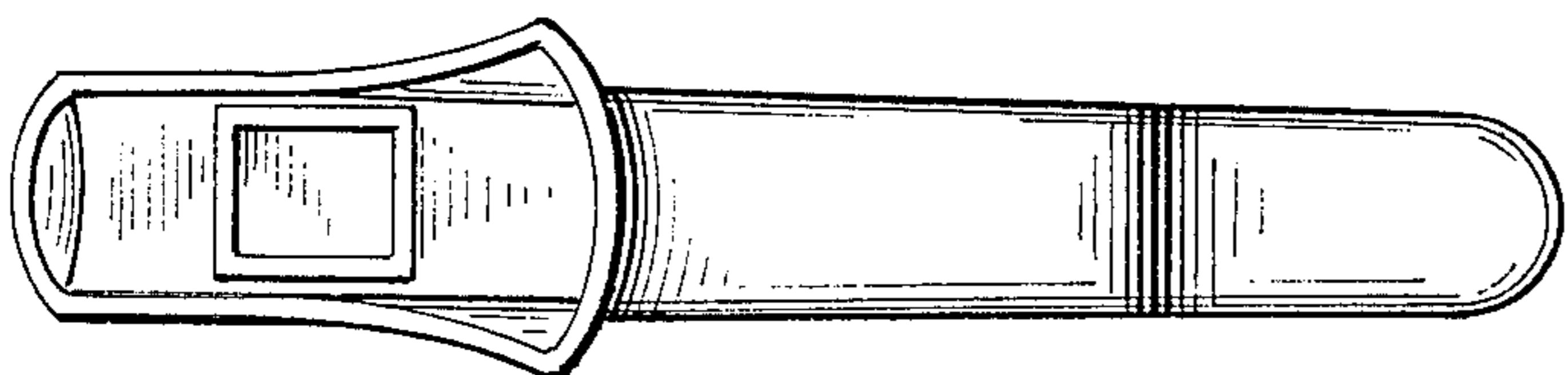
