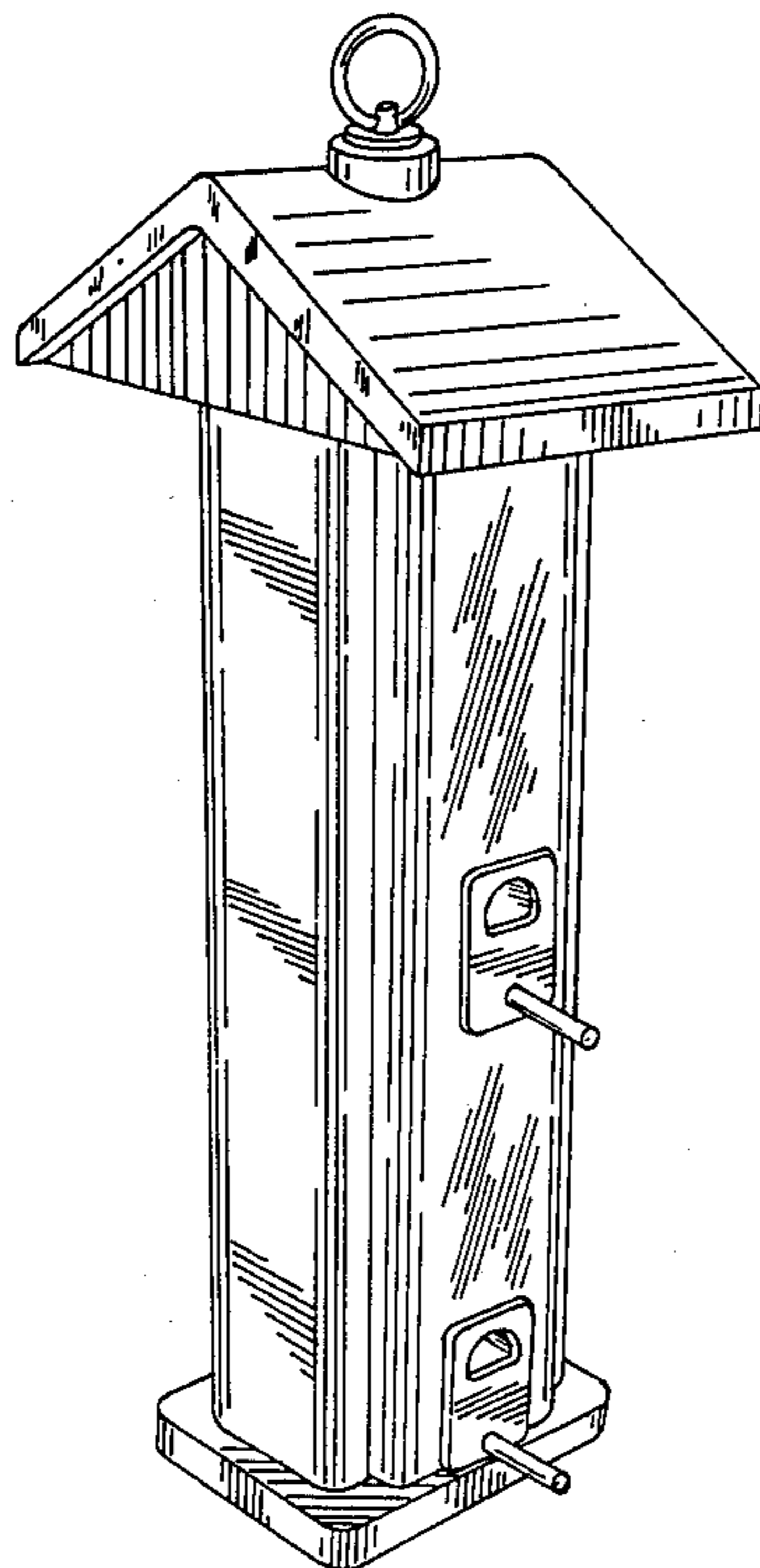

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hanging birdfeeder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a birdfeeder showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being essentially the same as the side shown;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from one end thereof, the opposite end being substantially the same as the end shown;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



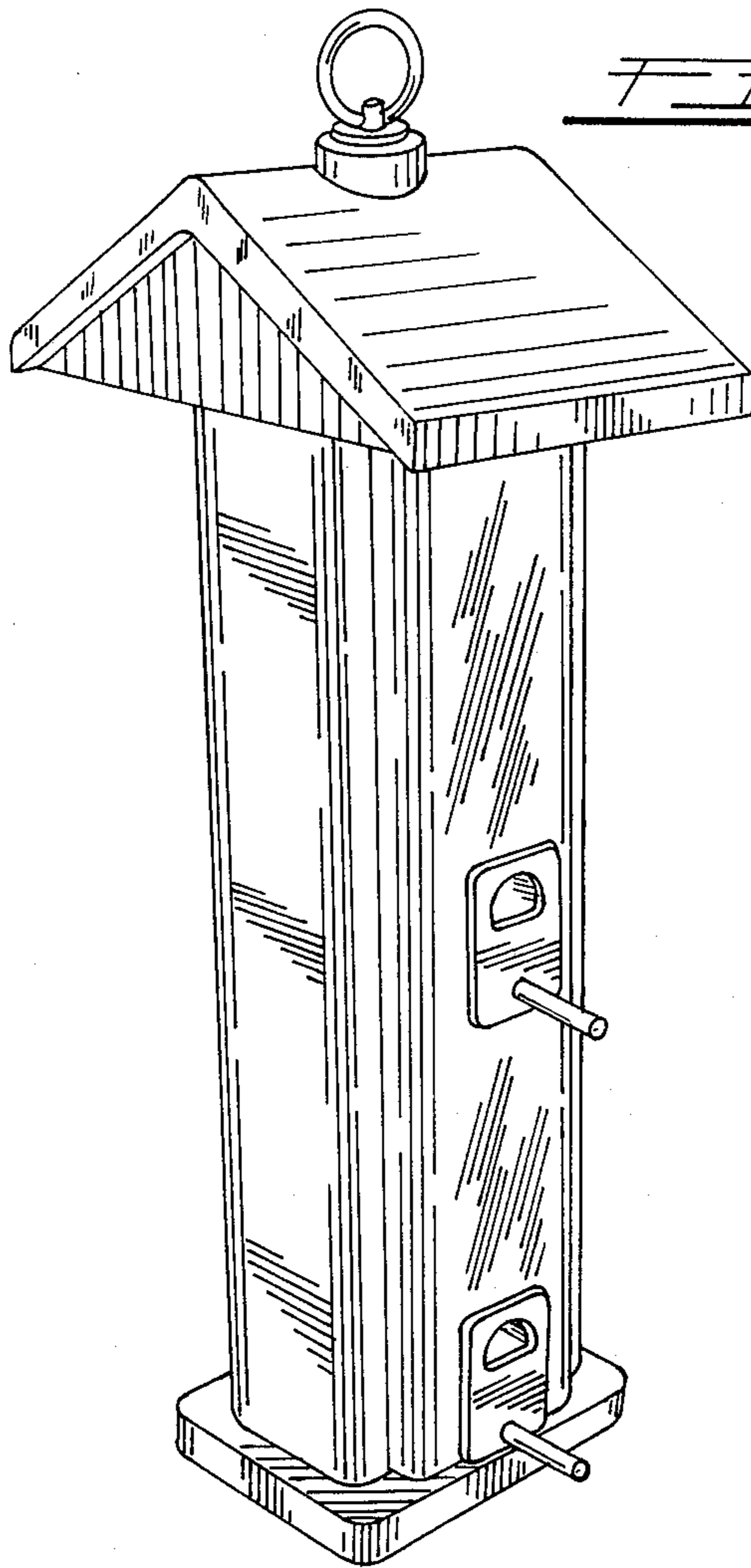

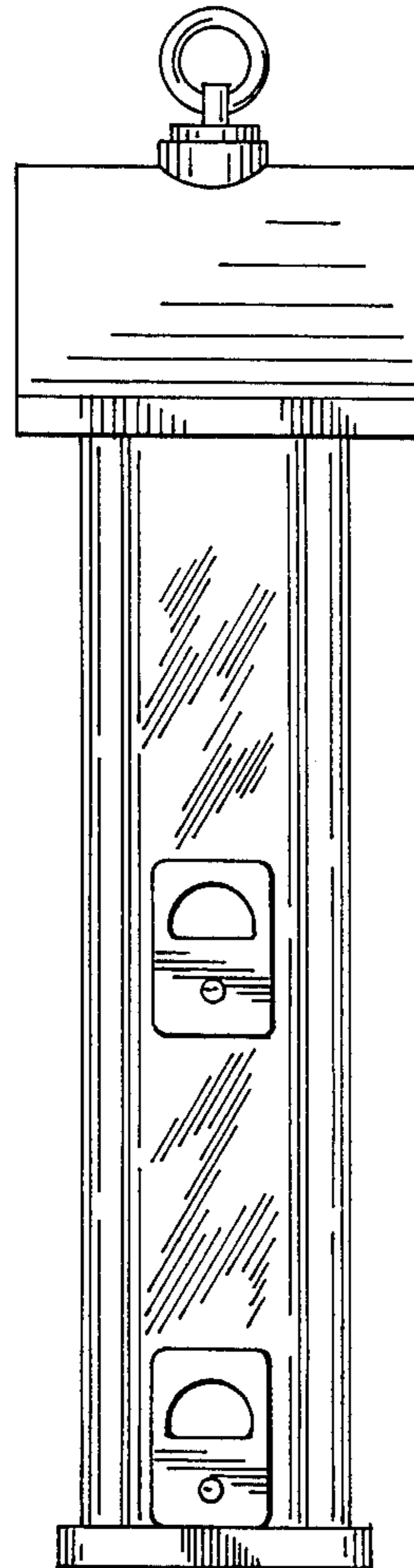

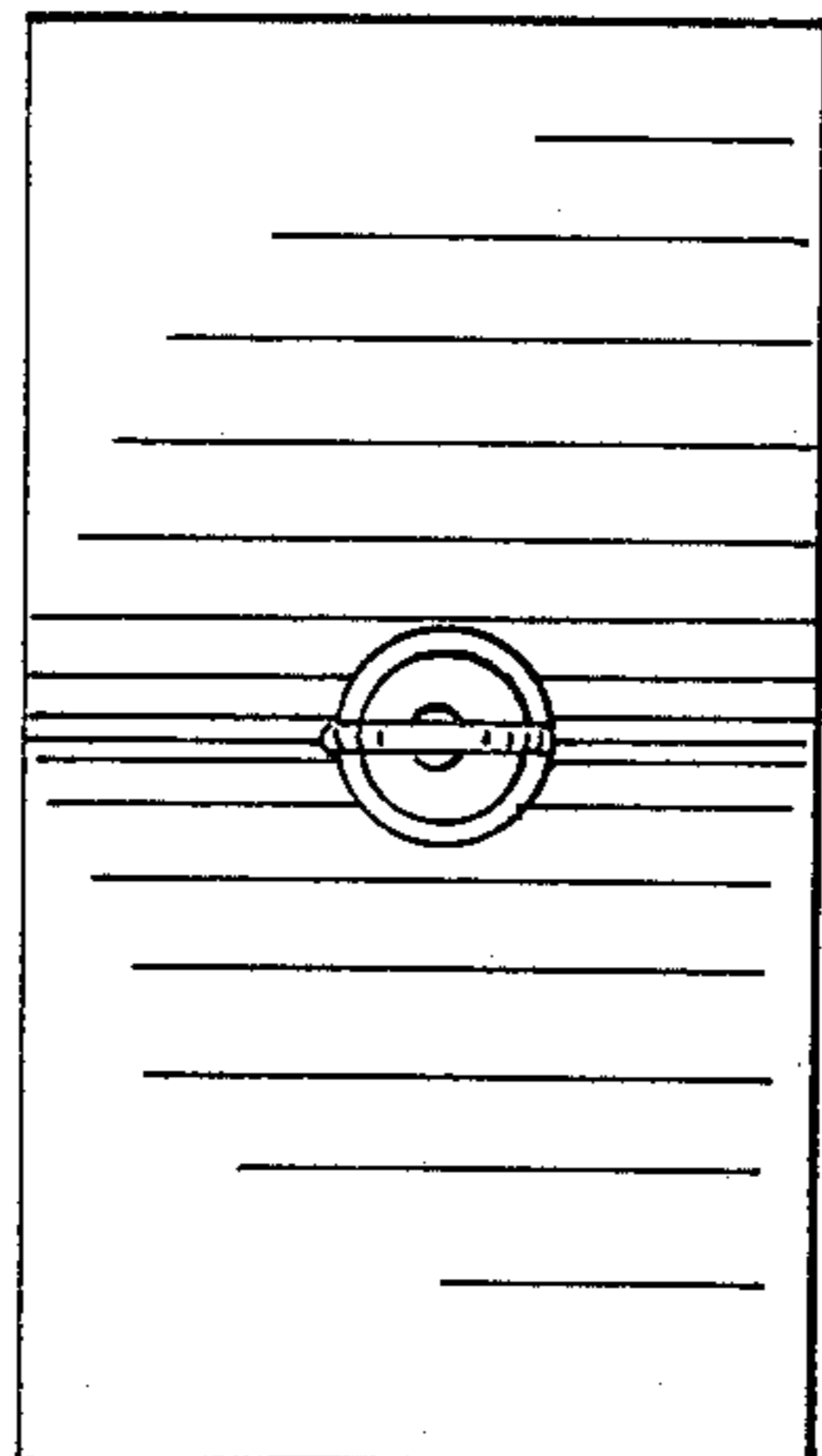

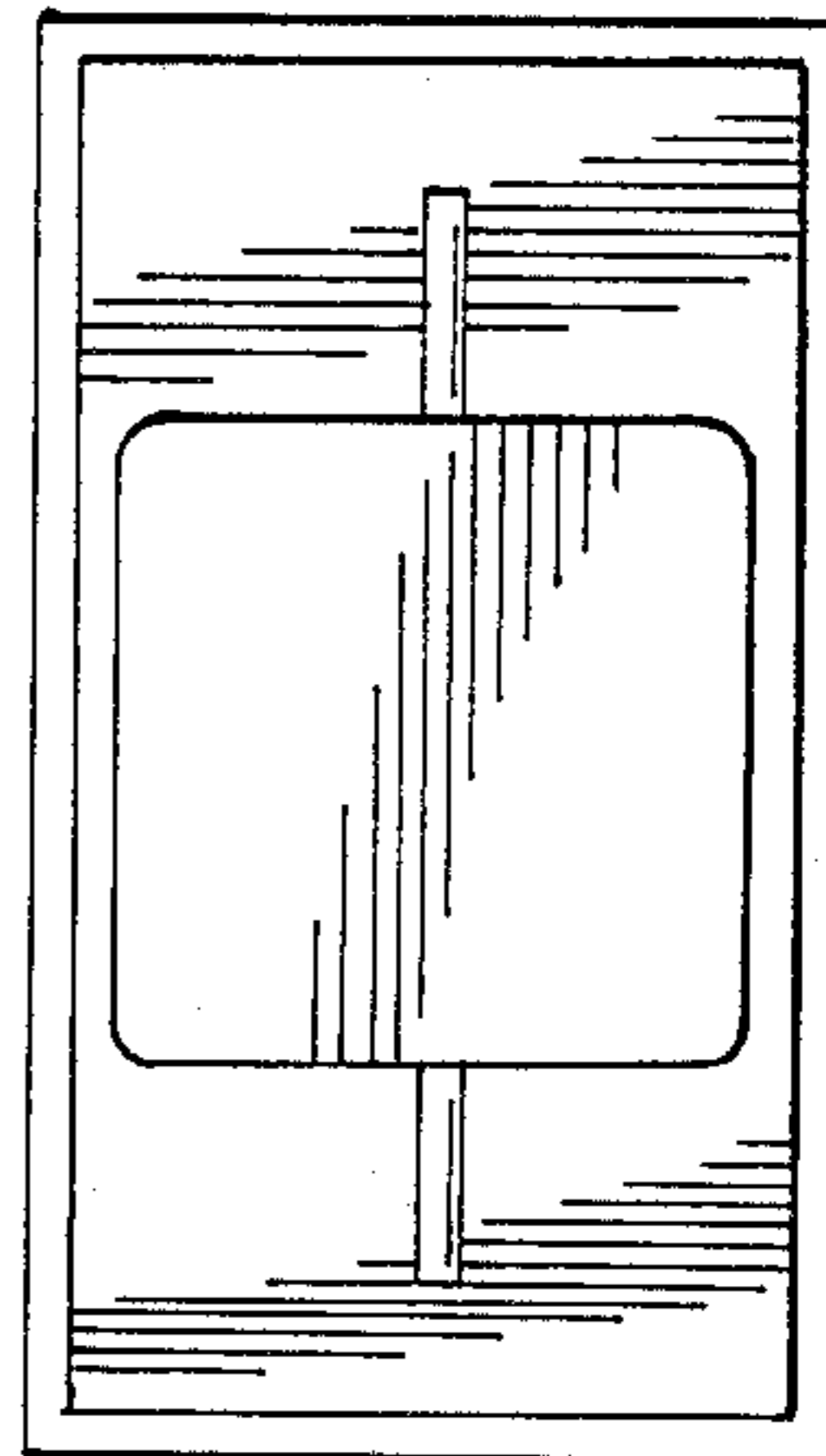
