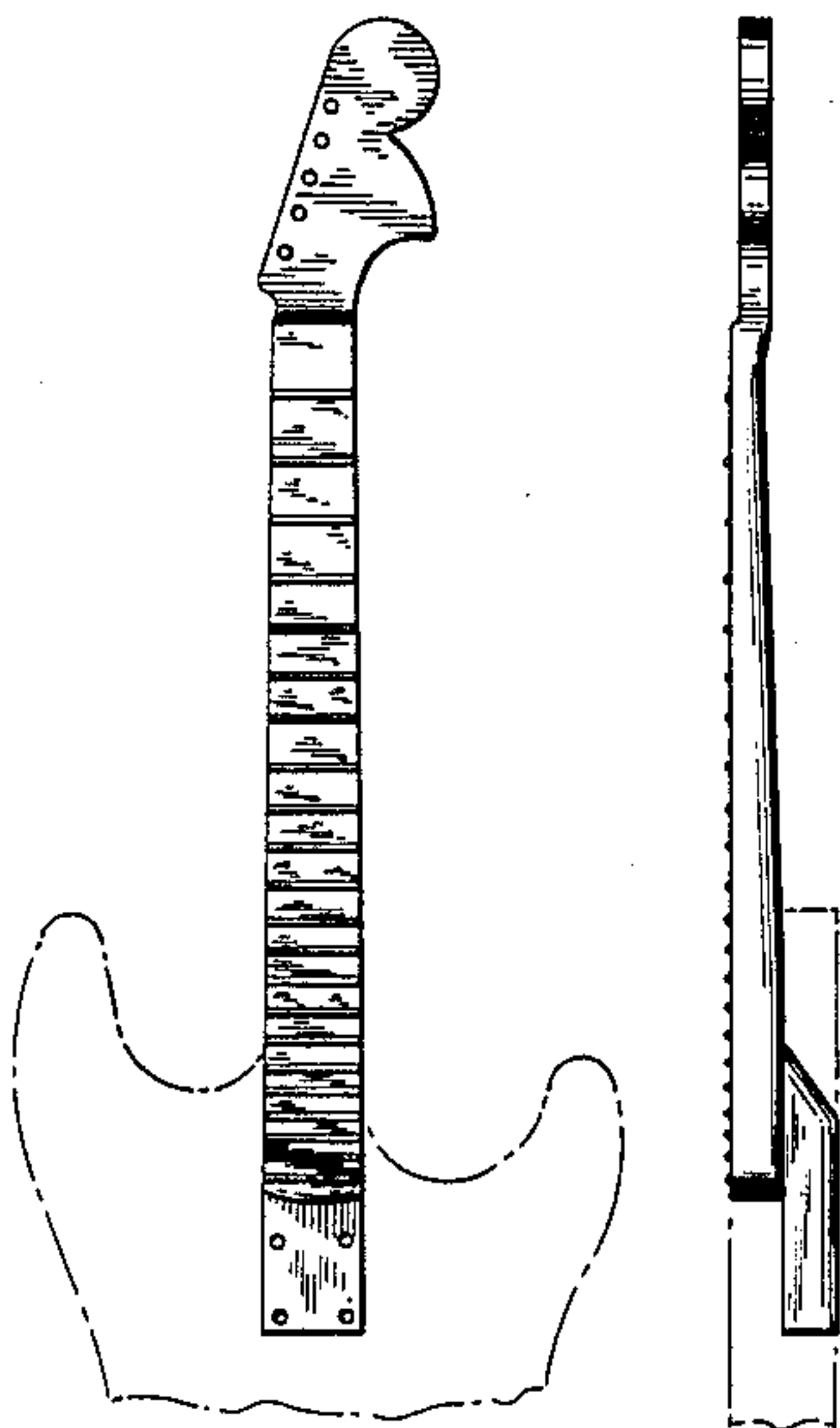

The ornamental design for a guitar neck, as shown.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a guitar neck show-
ing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of the guitar body is for illus-
trative purposes only and forms no part of the claim
design.
The characteristic feature of the design resides in the
shape of the guitar neck.



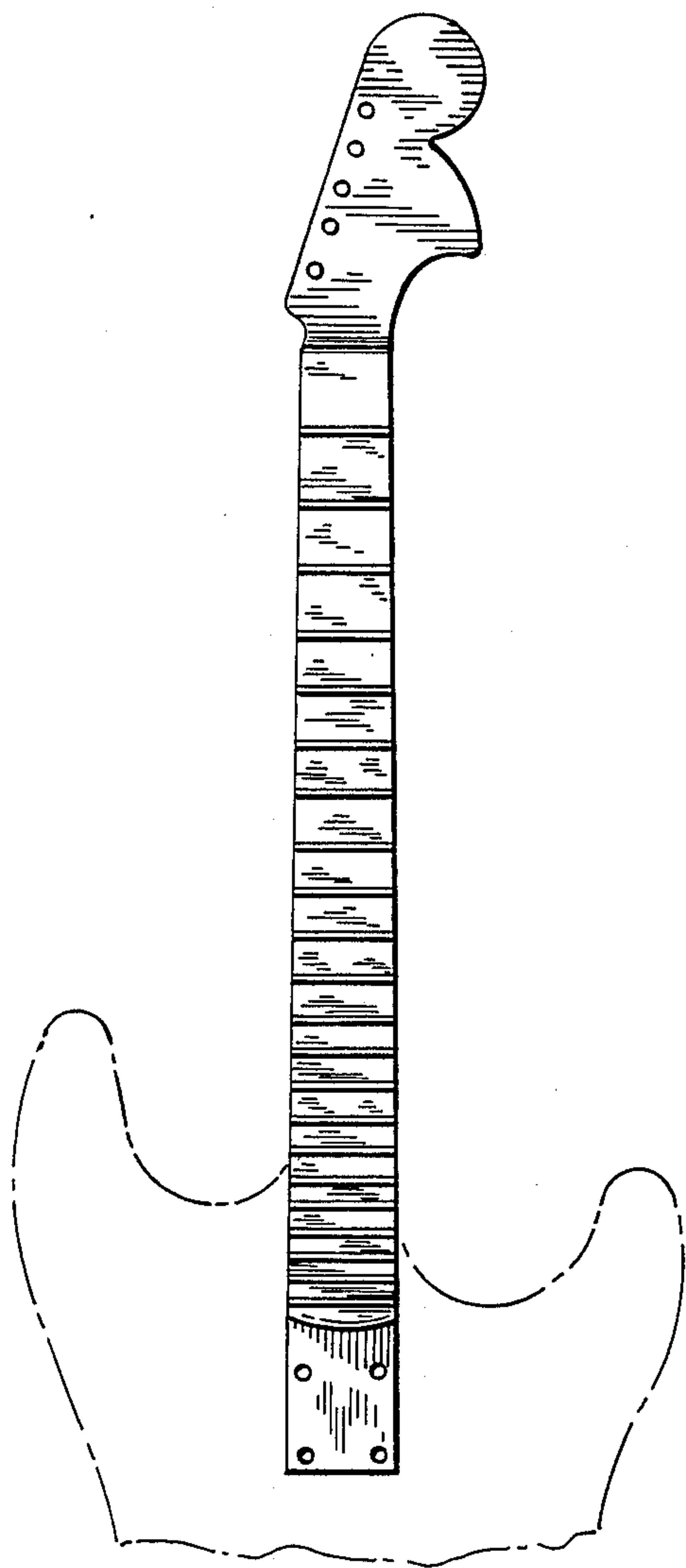

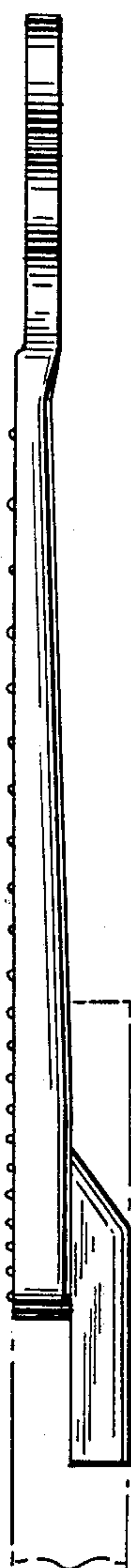

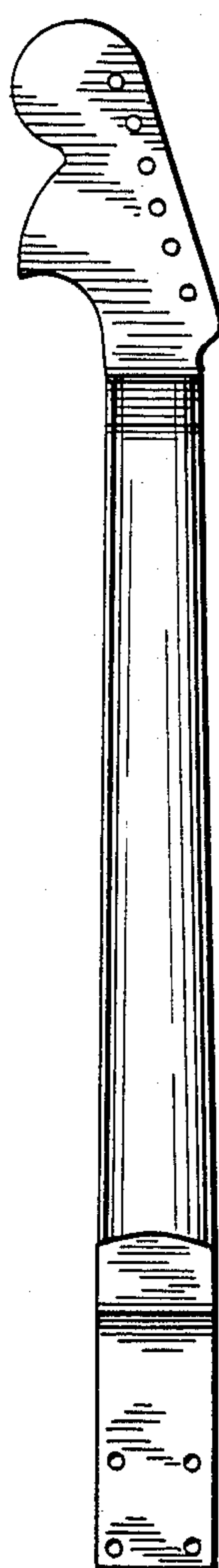

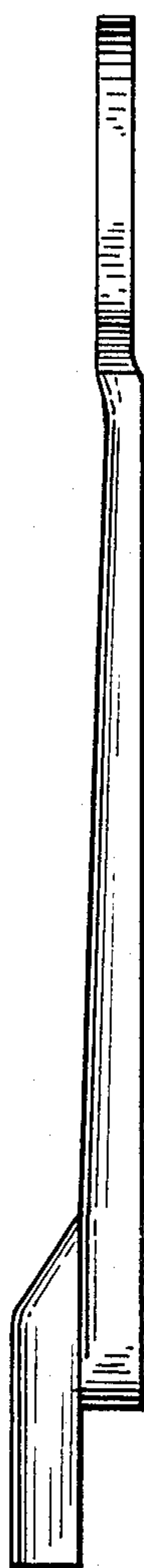
