DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a guitar neck showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

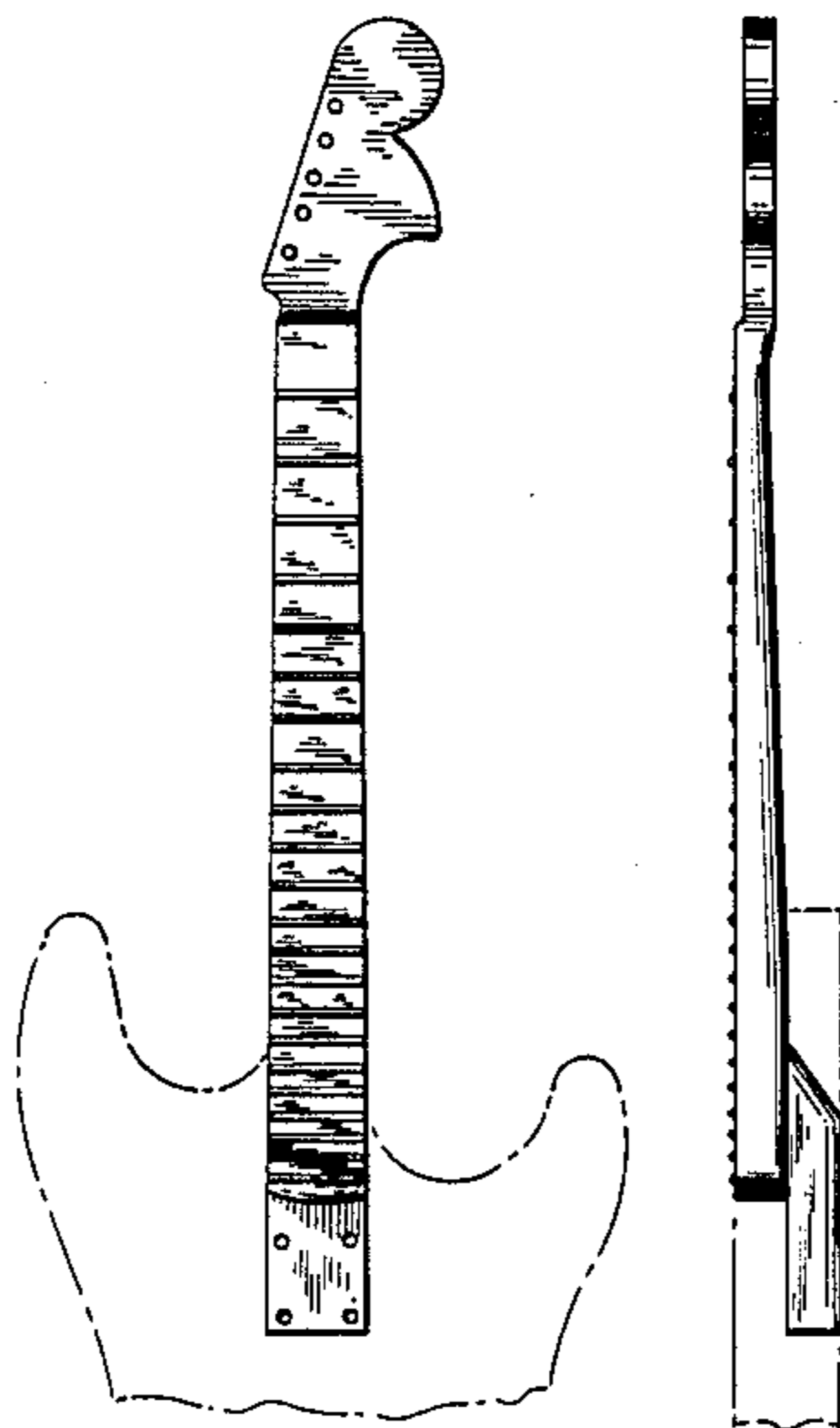
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of the guitar body is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claim design.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the shape of the guitar neck.



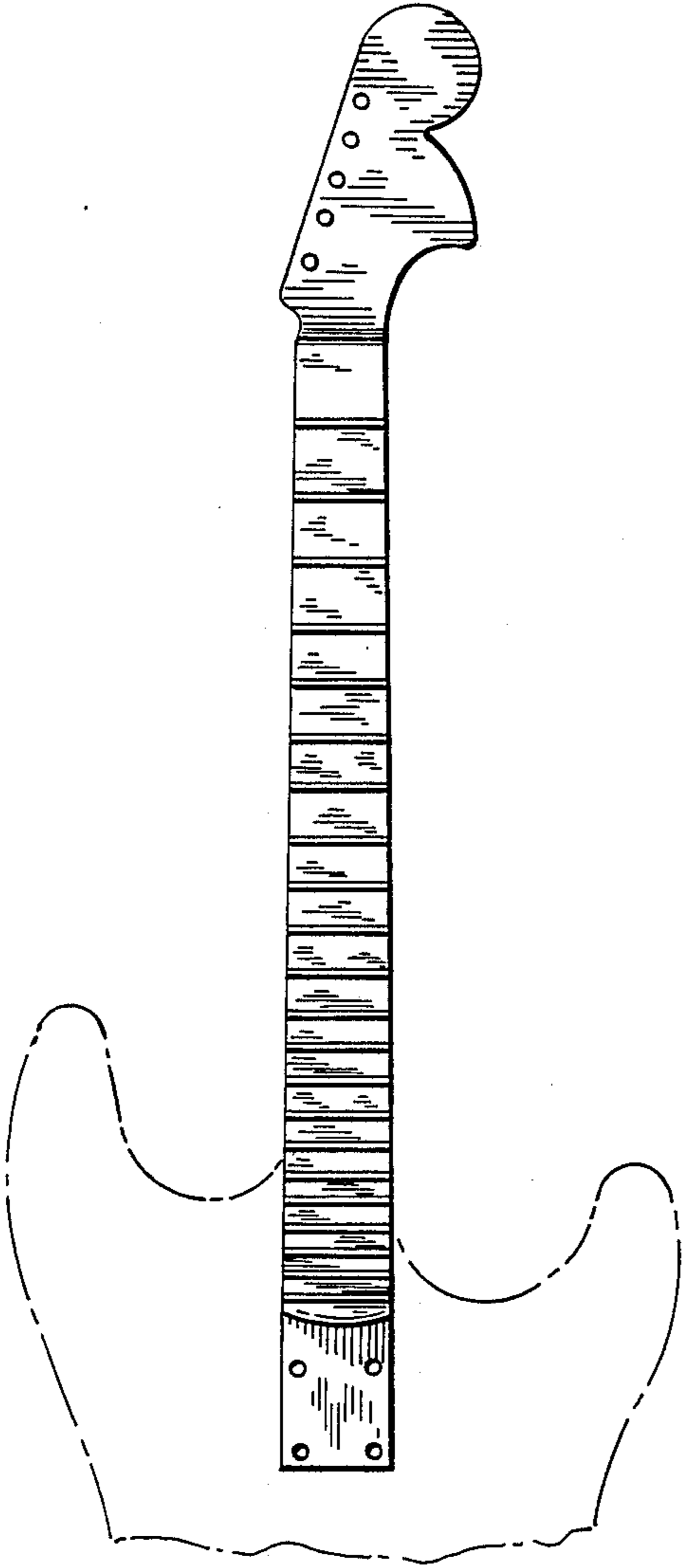

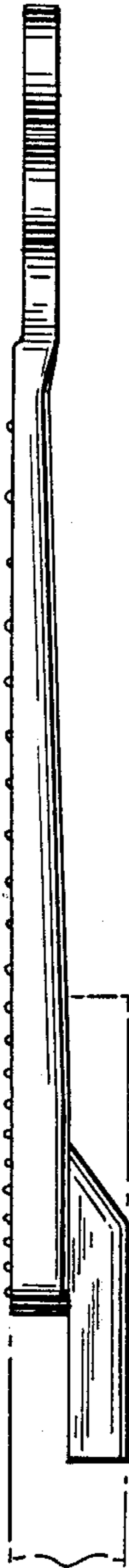

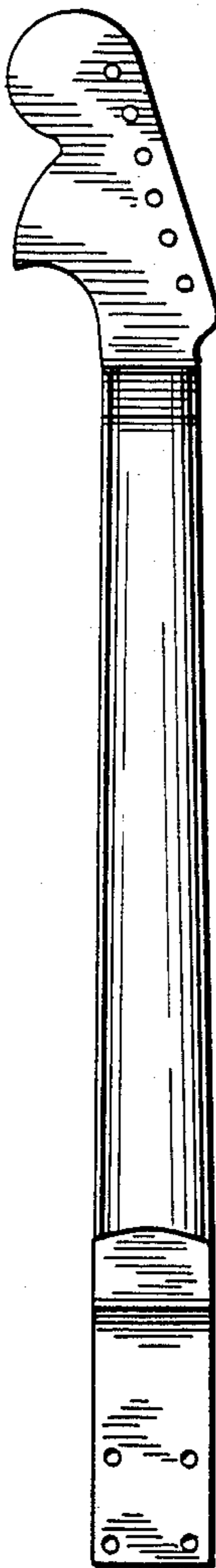

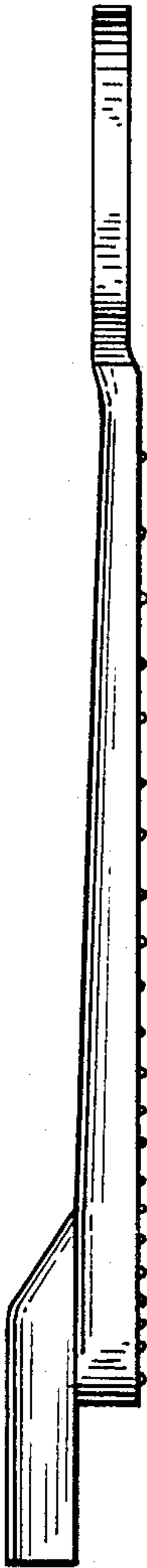

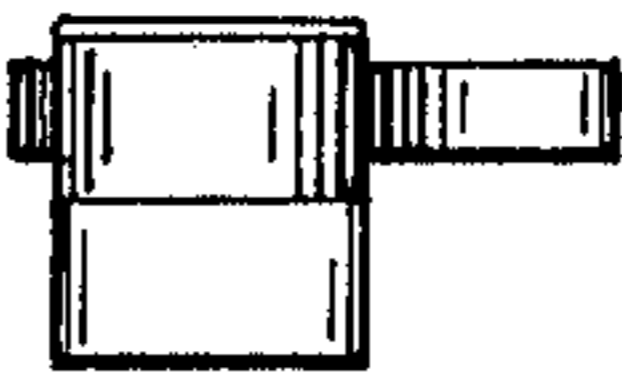
