FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

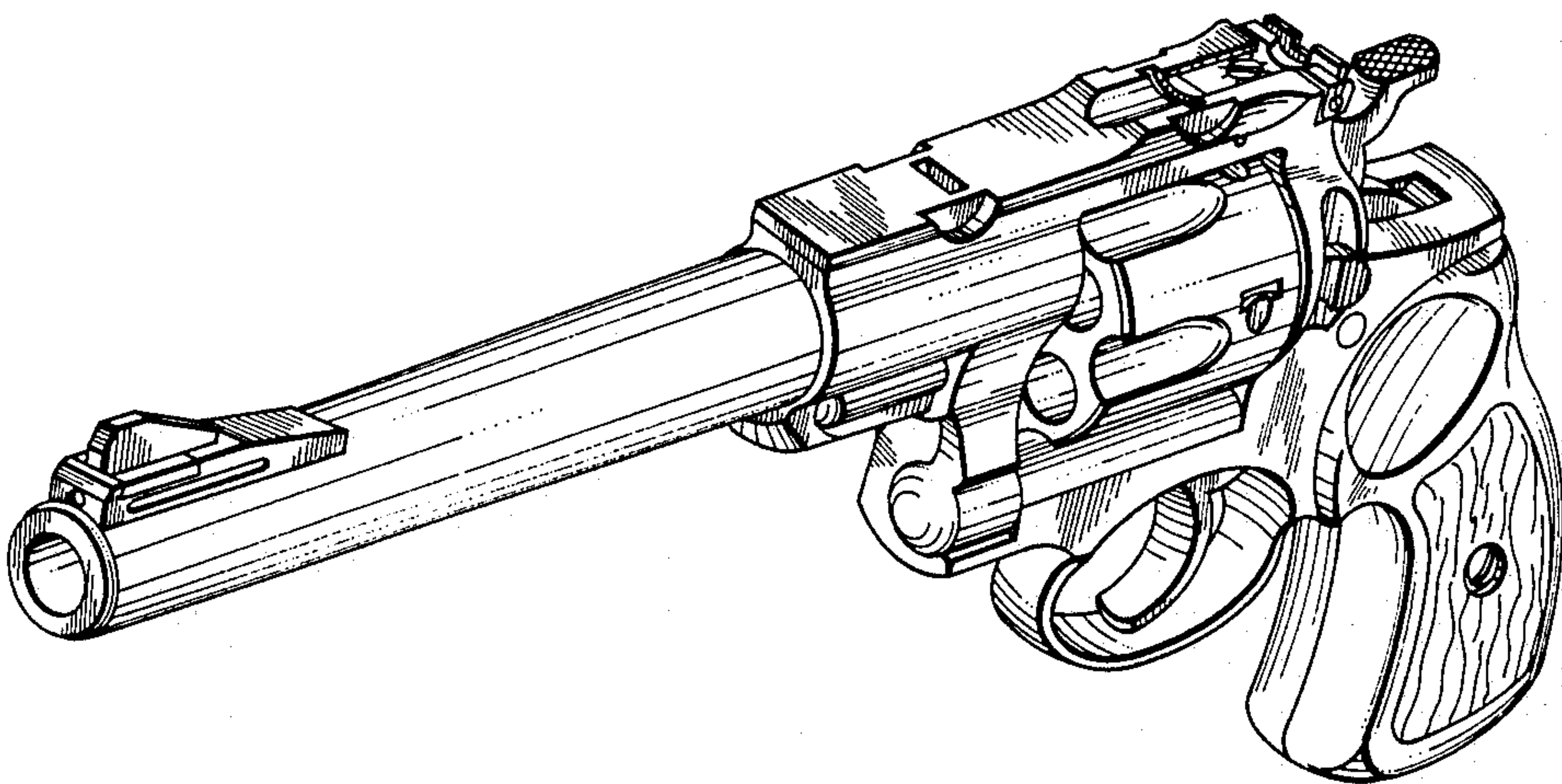
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of the scope is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



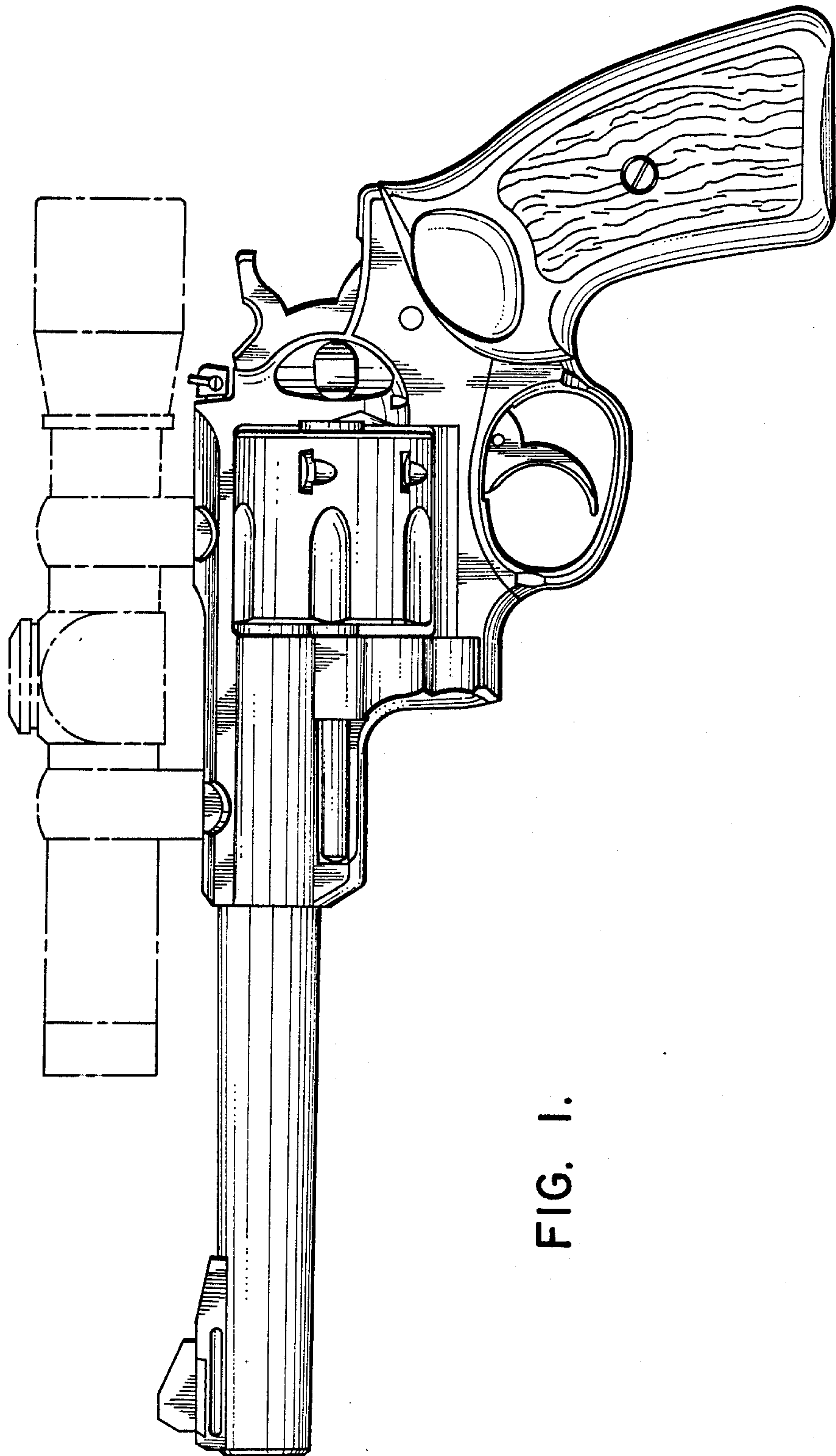

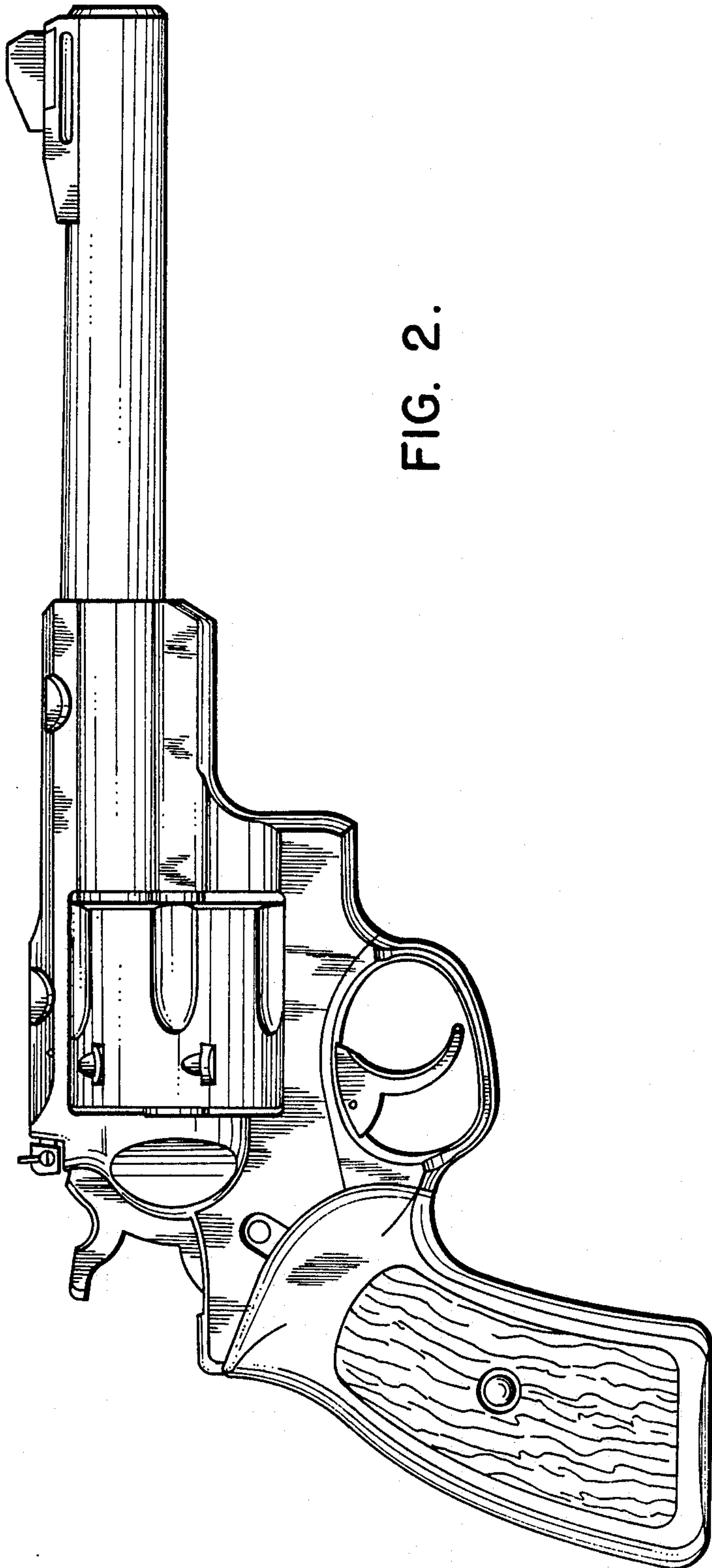

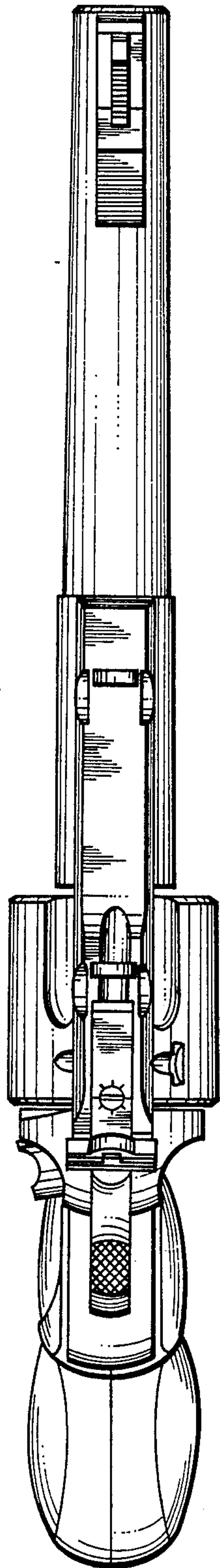

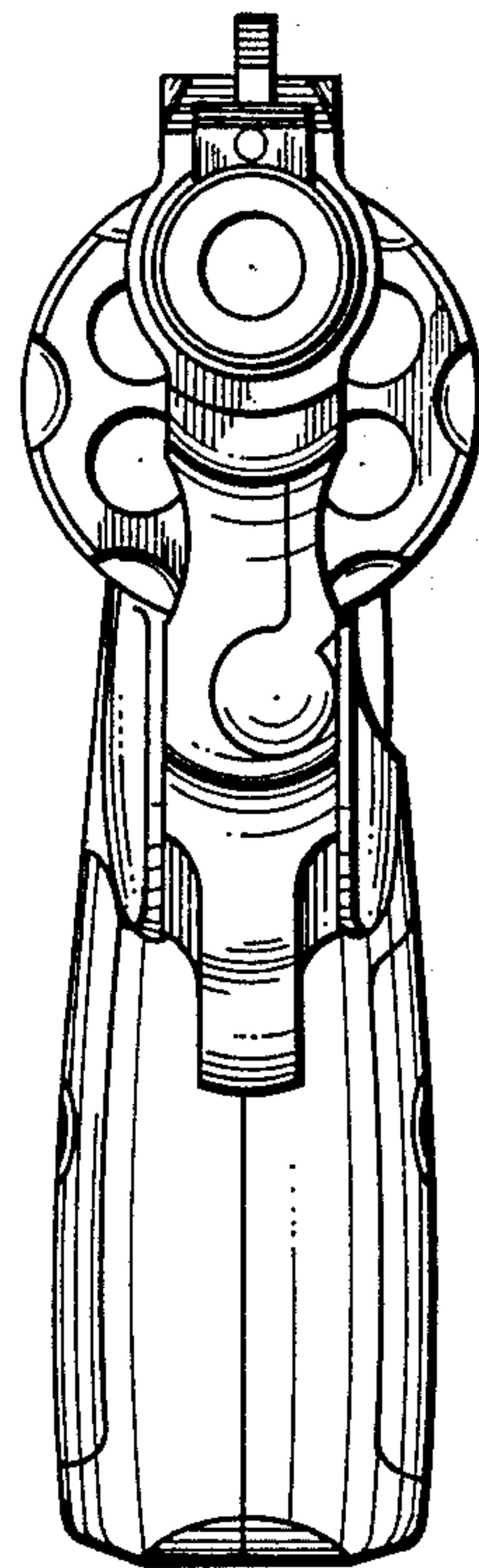

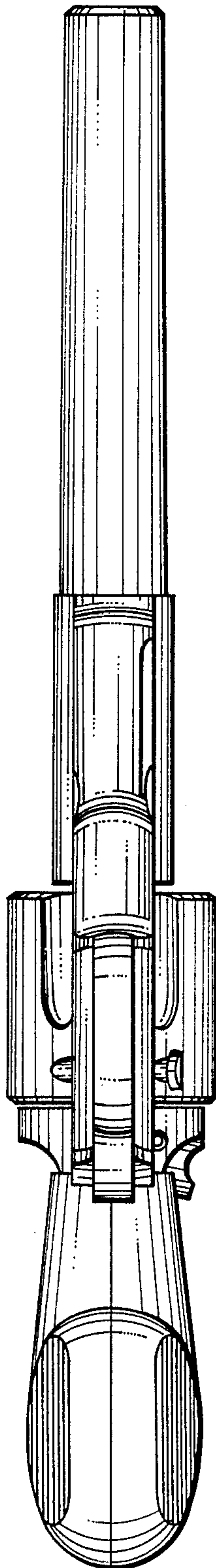

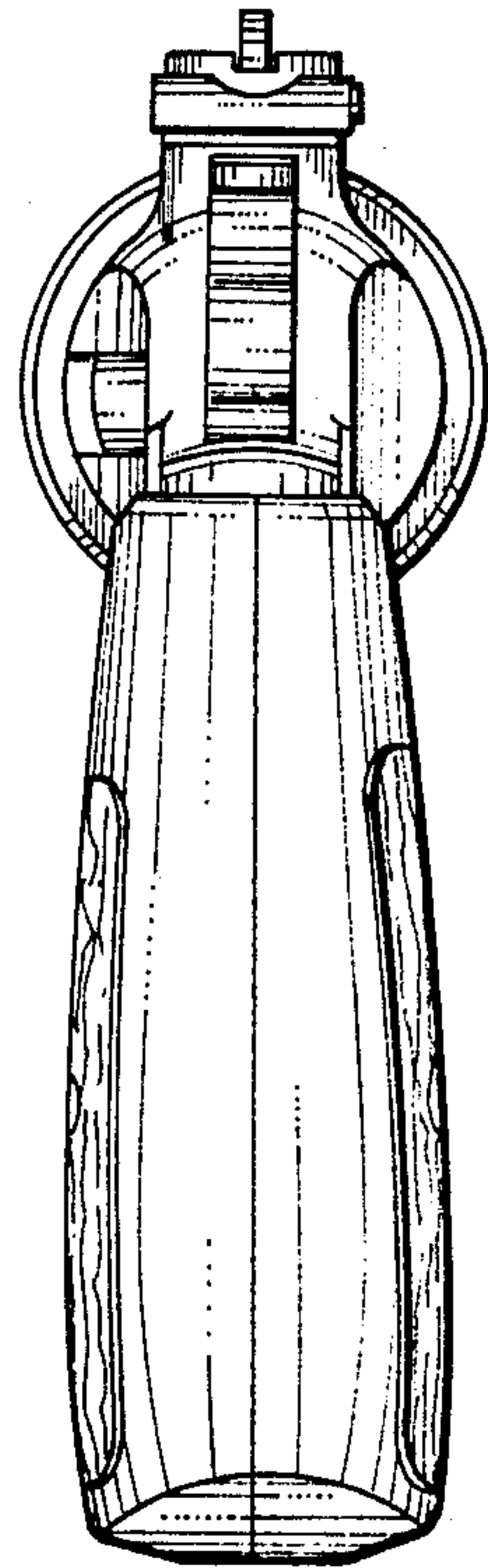

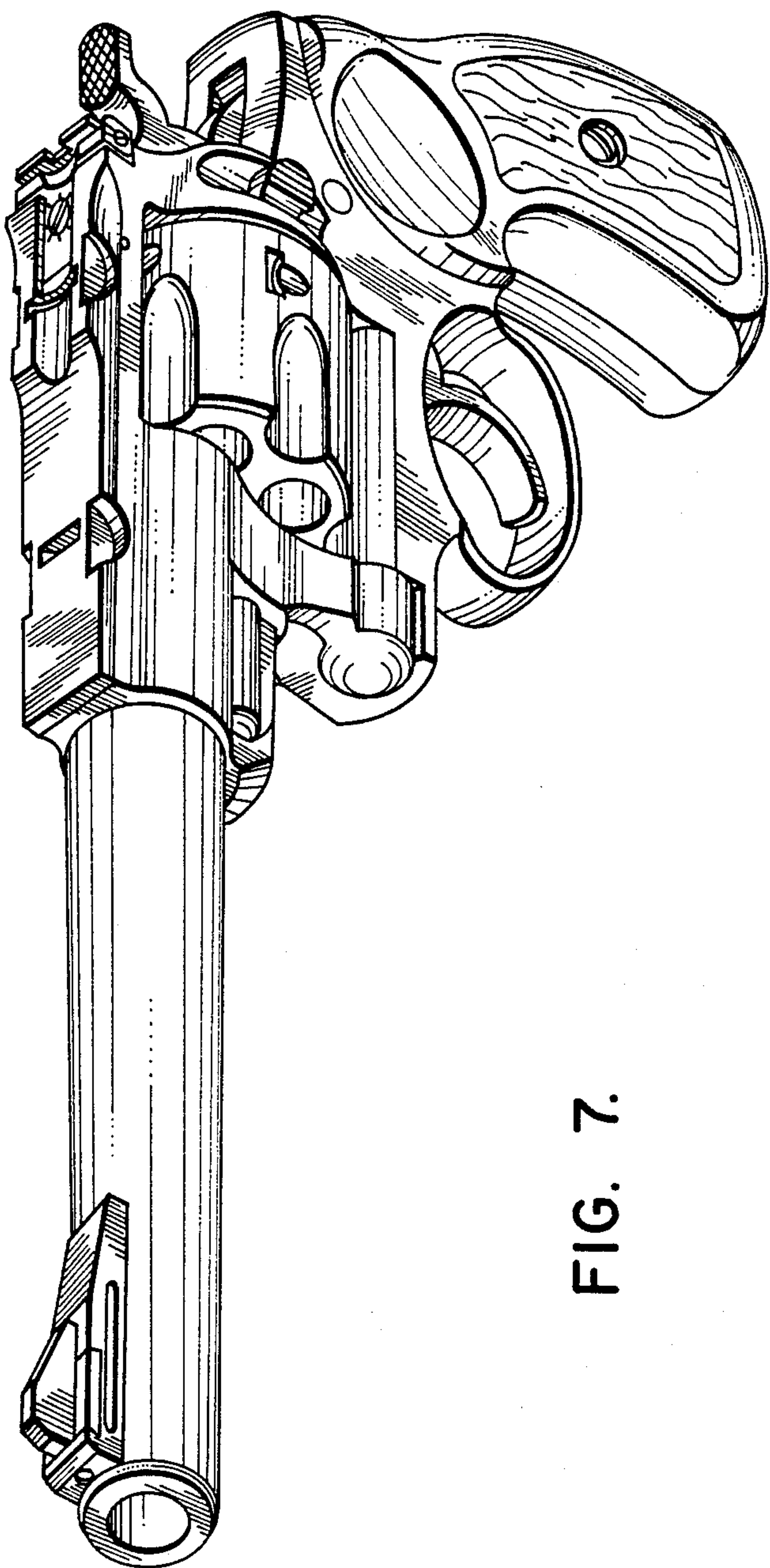
