[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a kitchen faucet handle, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a kitchen faucet handle
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left
side being a mirror image of the right side shown;
FIG. 3 is a plan view thereof taken on plane 3—3 of
FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on
line 7—7 of FIG. 2.
The broken line representation of a kitchen faucet in
FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no
part of the claimed design.

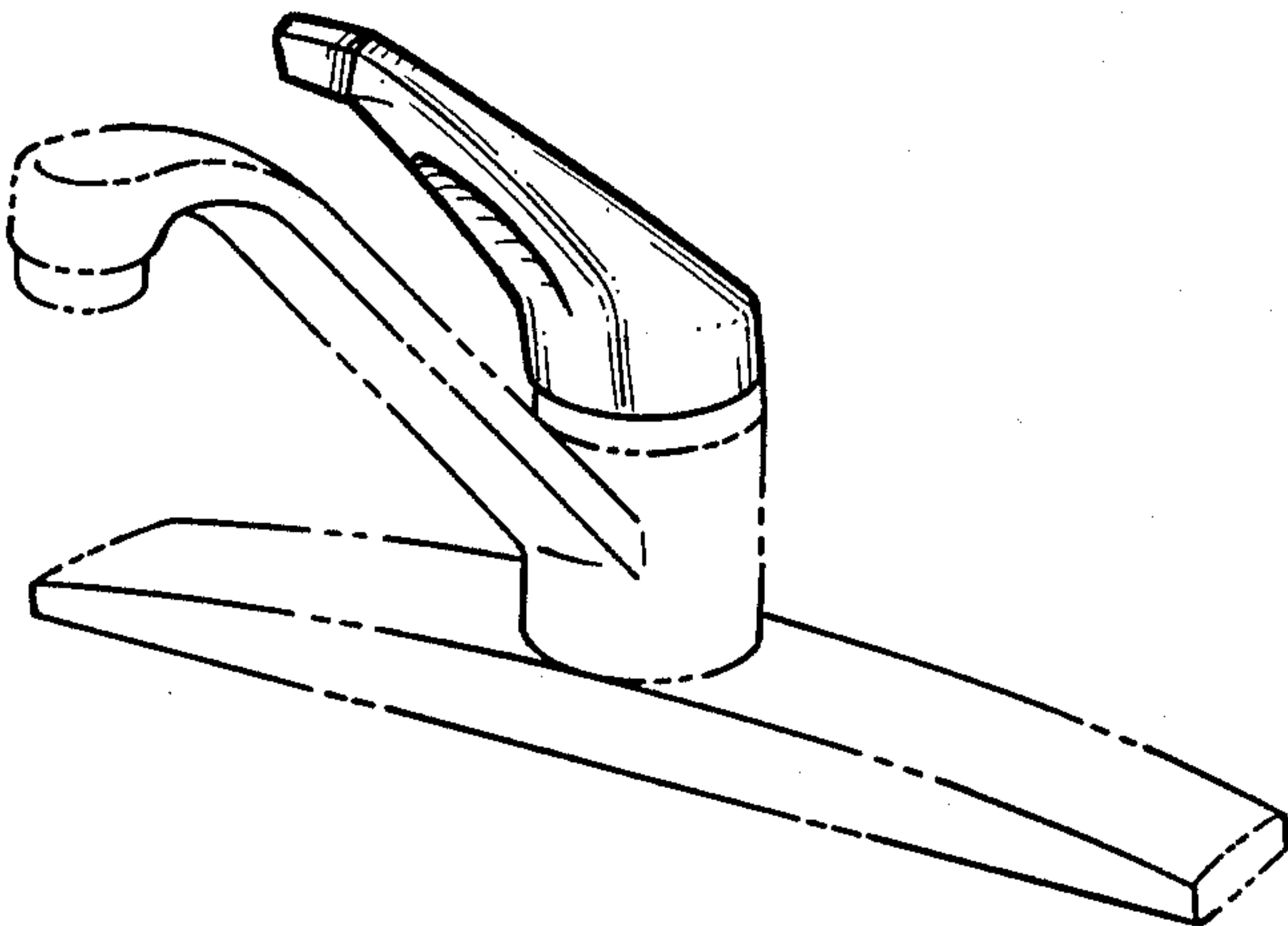

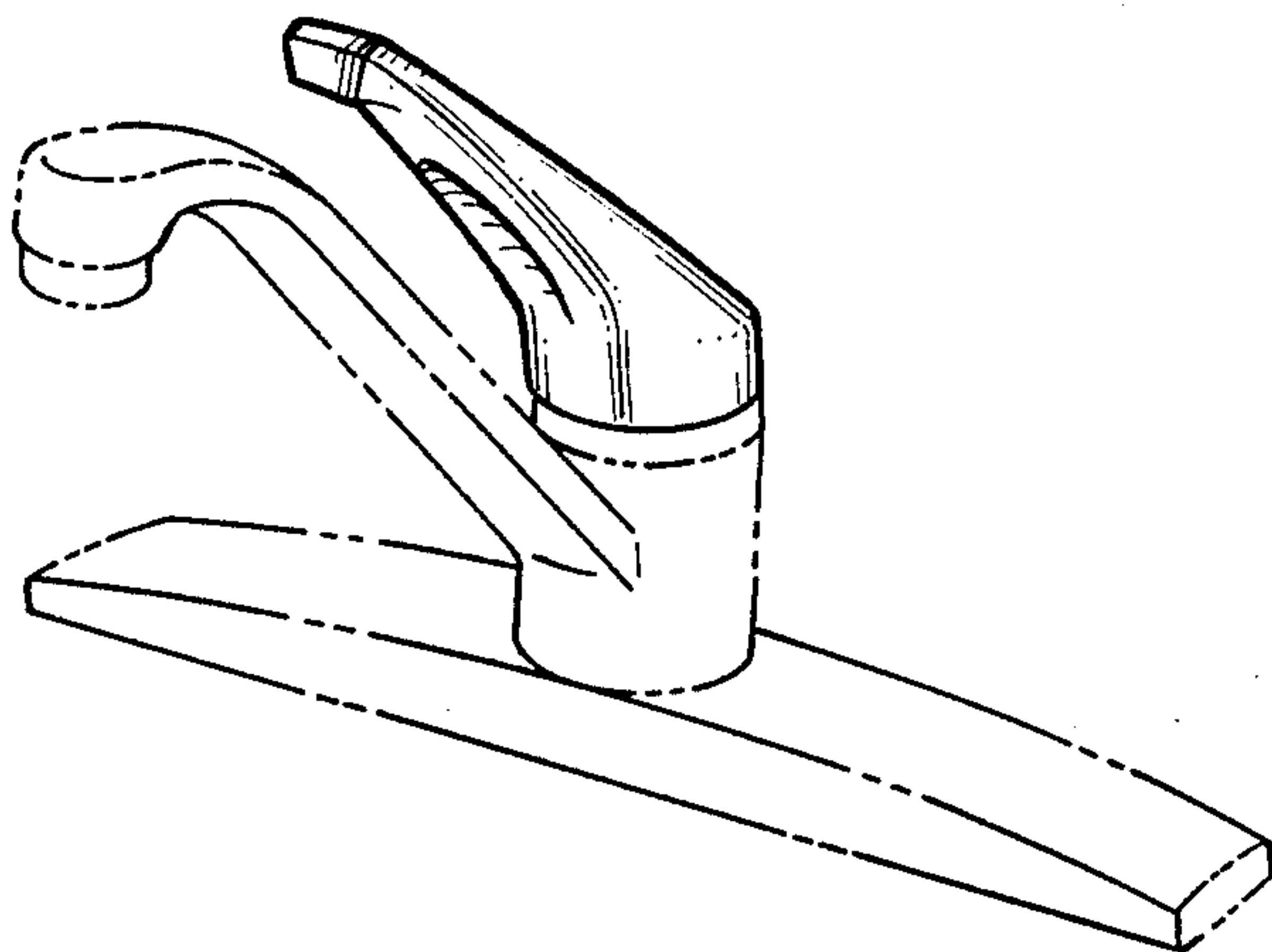

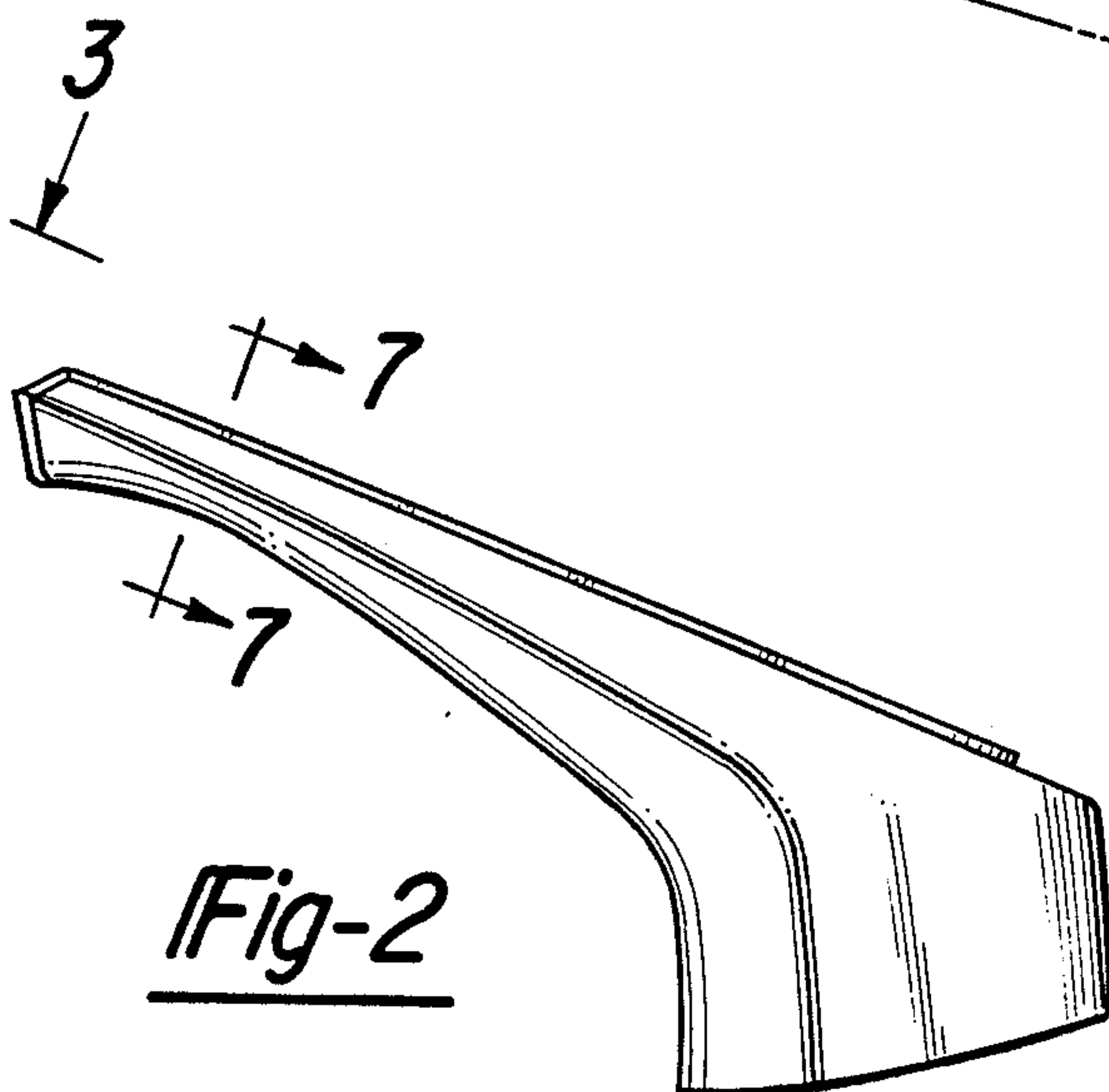

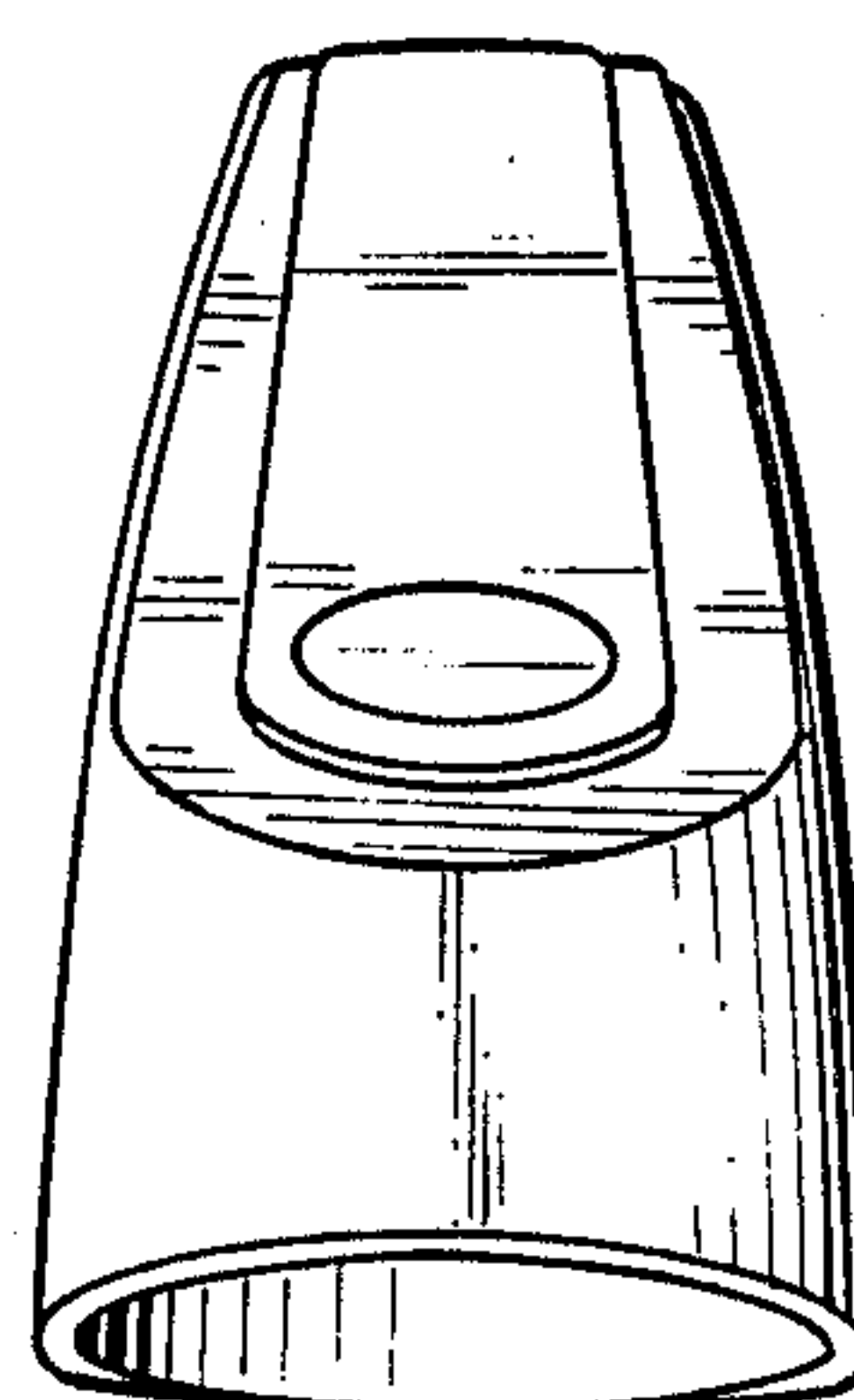

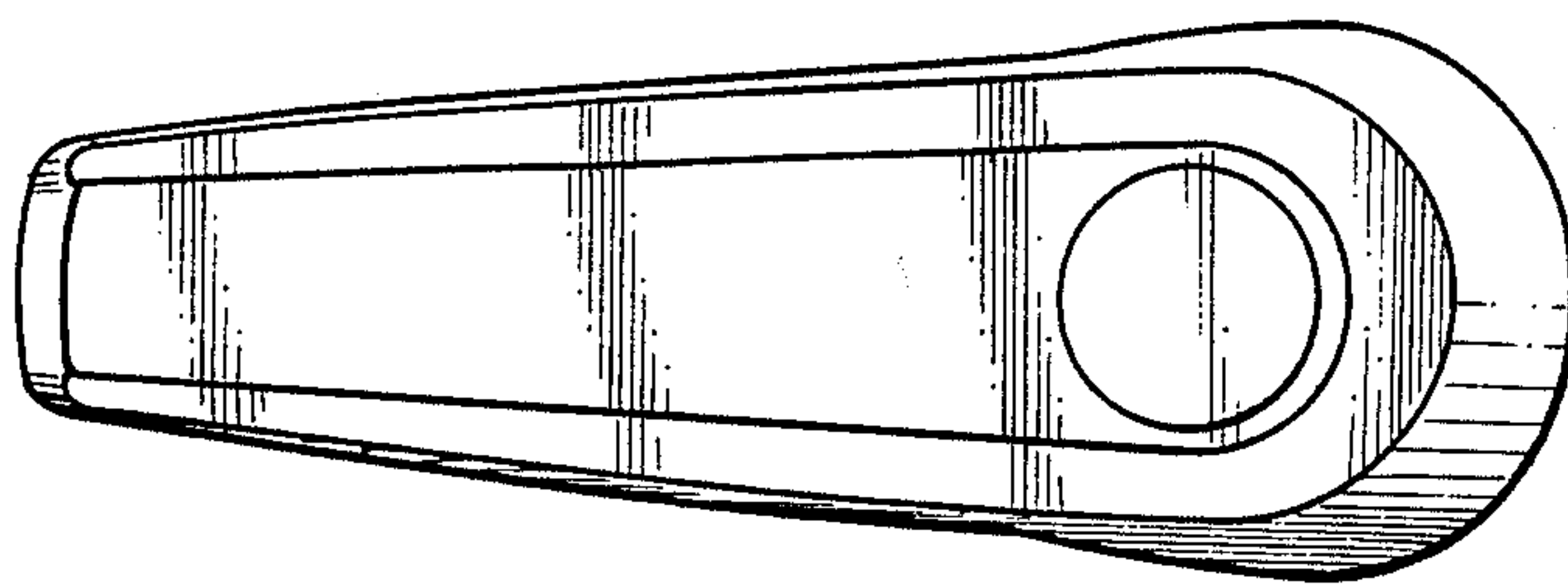

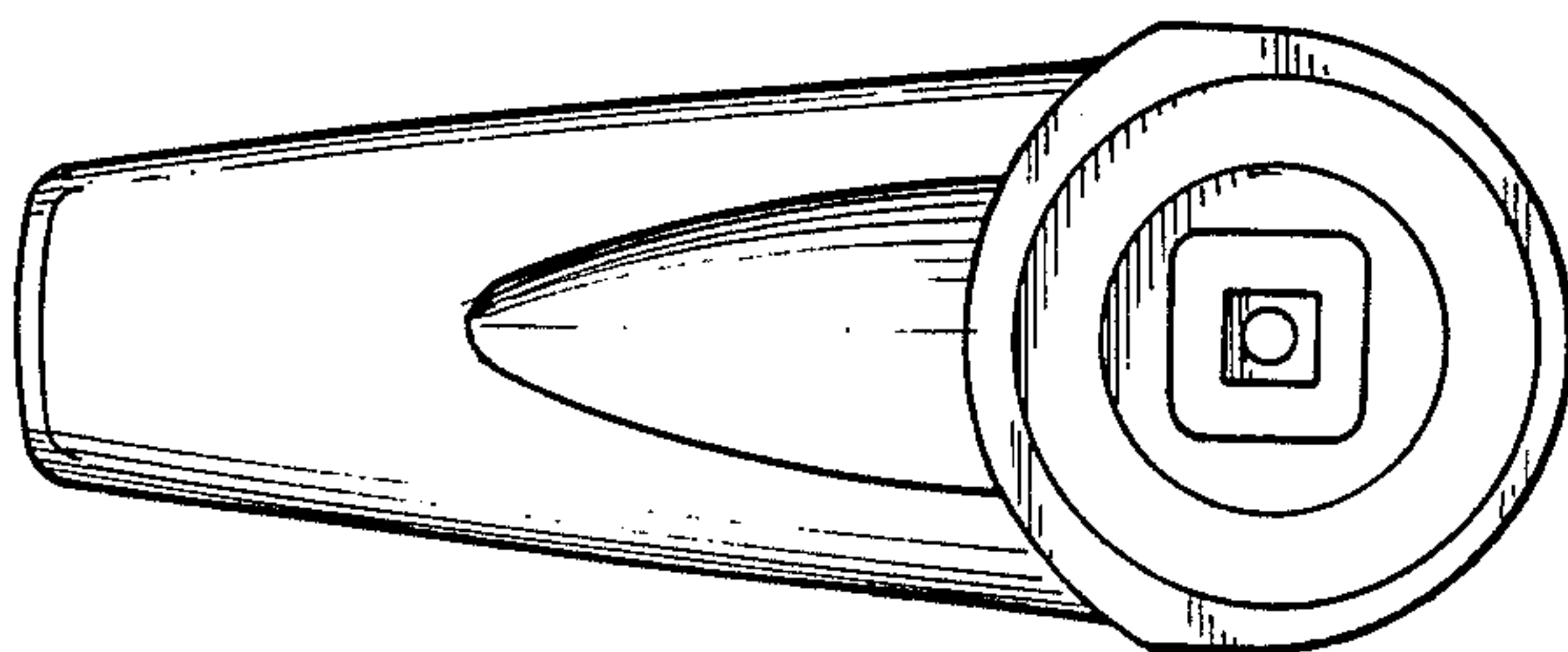

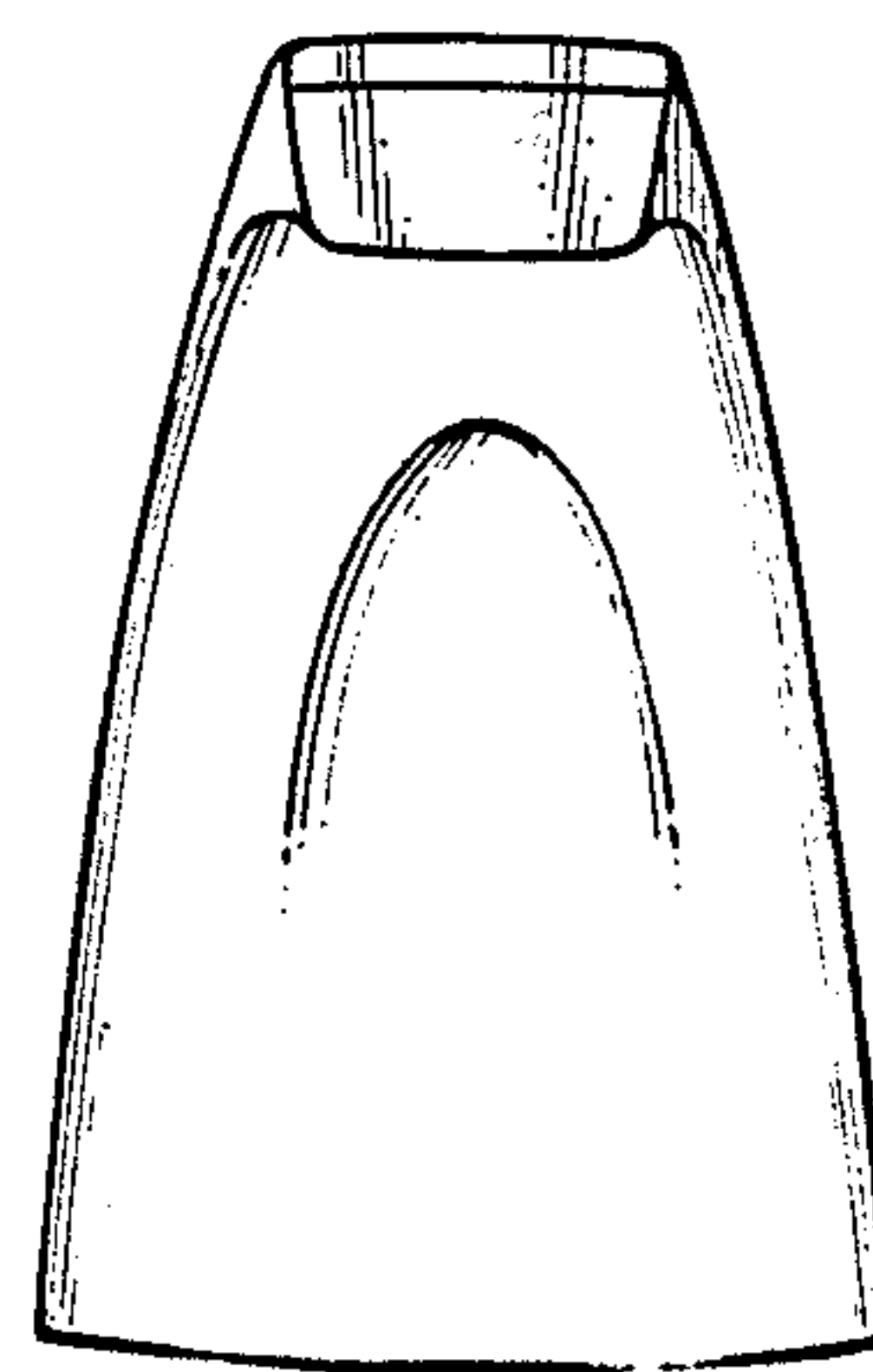
