[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tennis shoe or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a tennis shoe or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being flat, plain, and unornamented;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

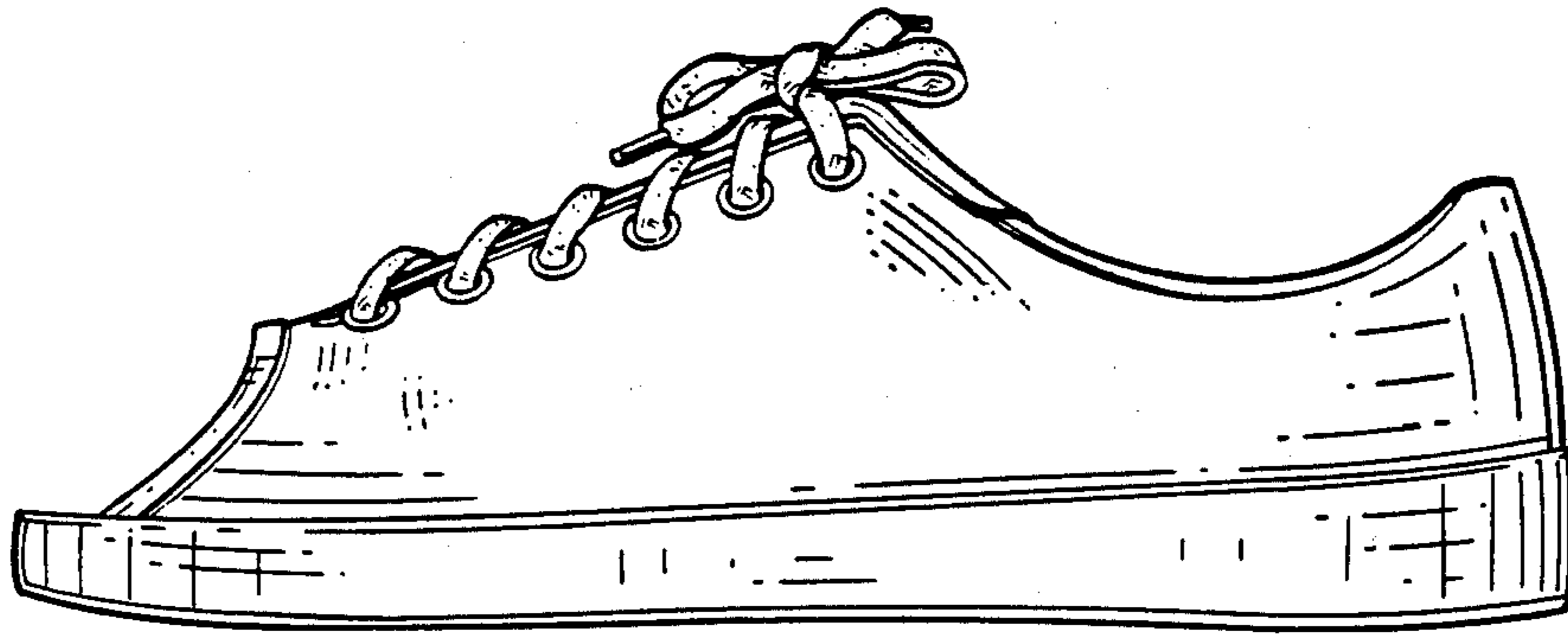

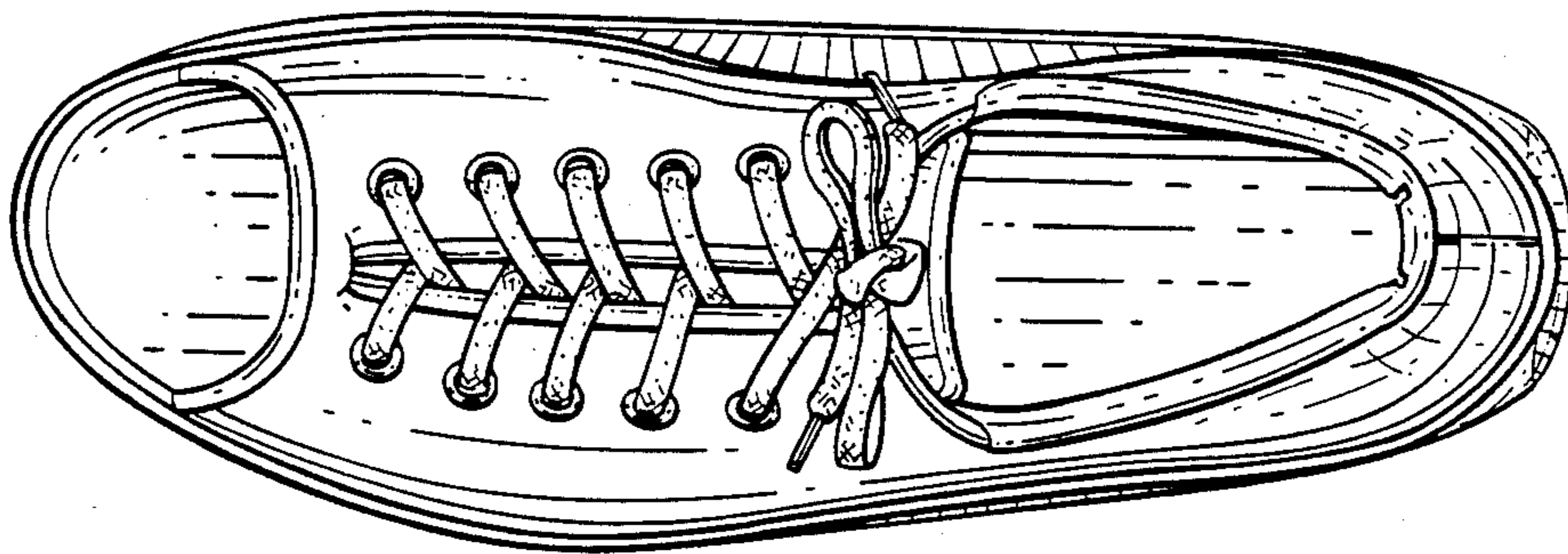

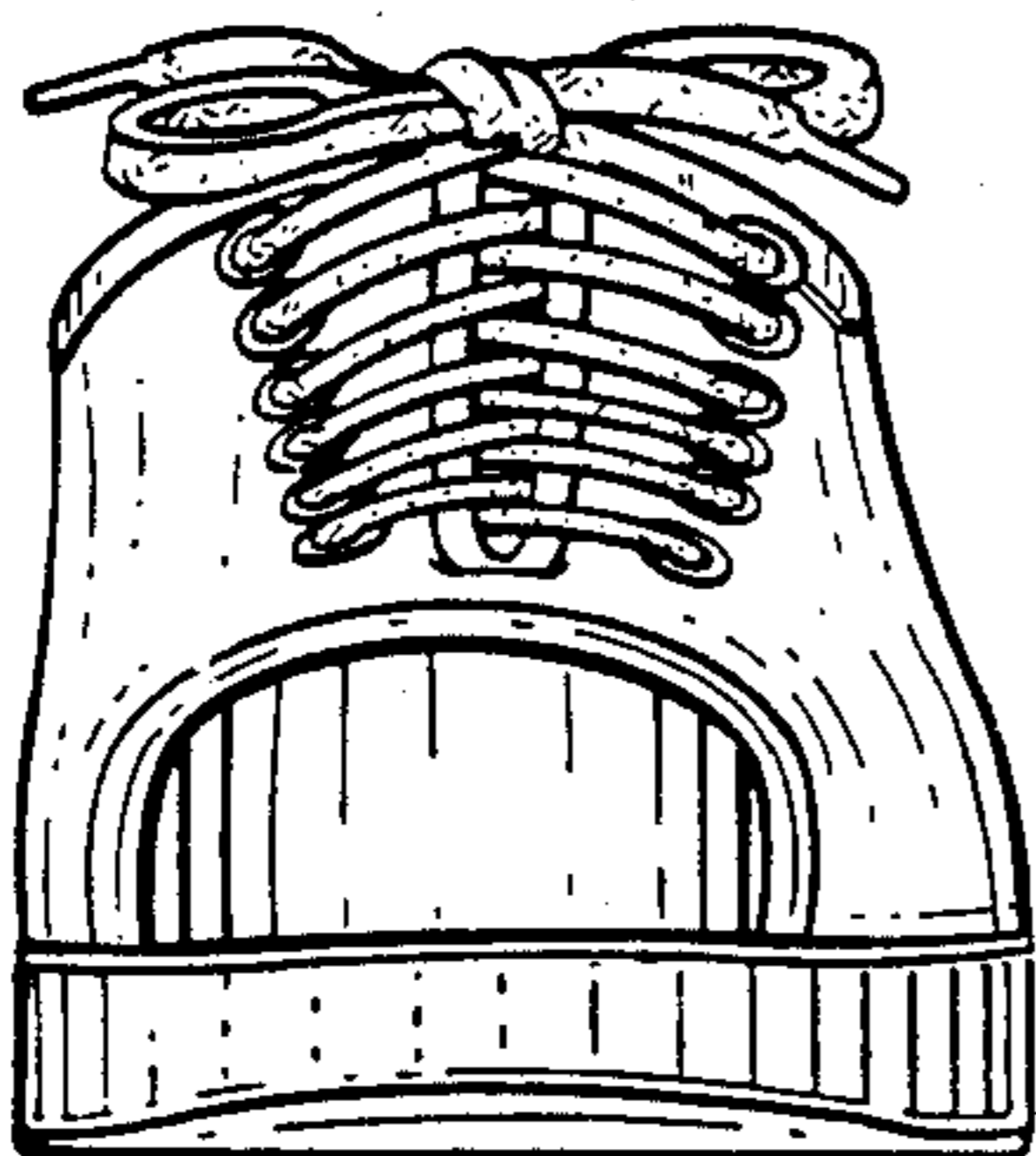

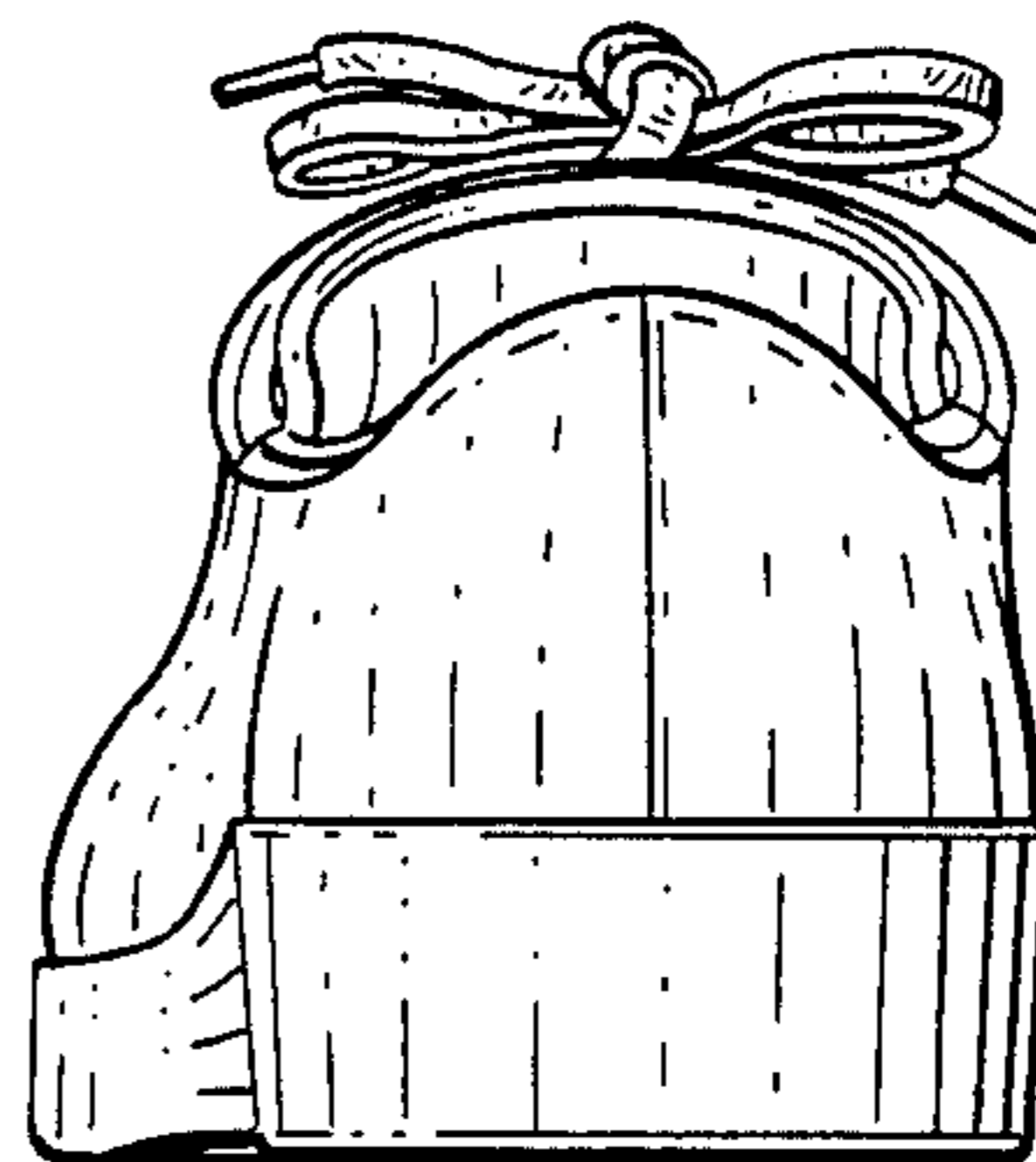
