[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe sole showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a shoe upper in FIGS. 1-5 is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.

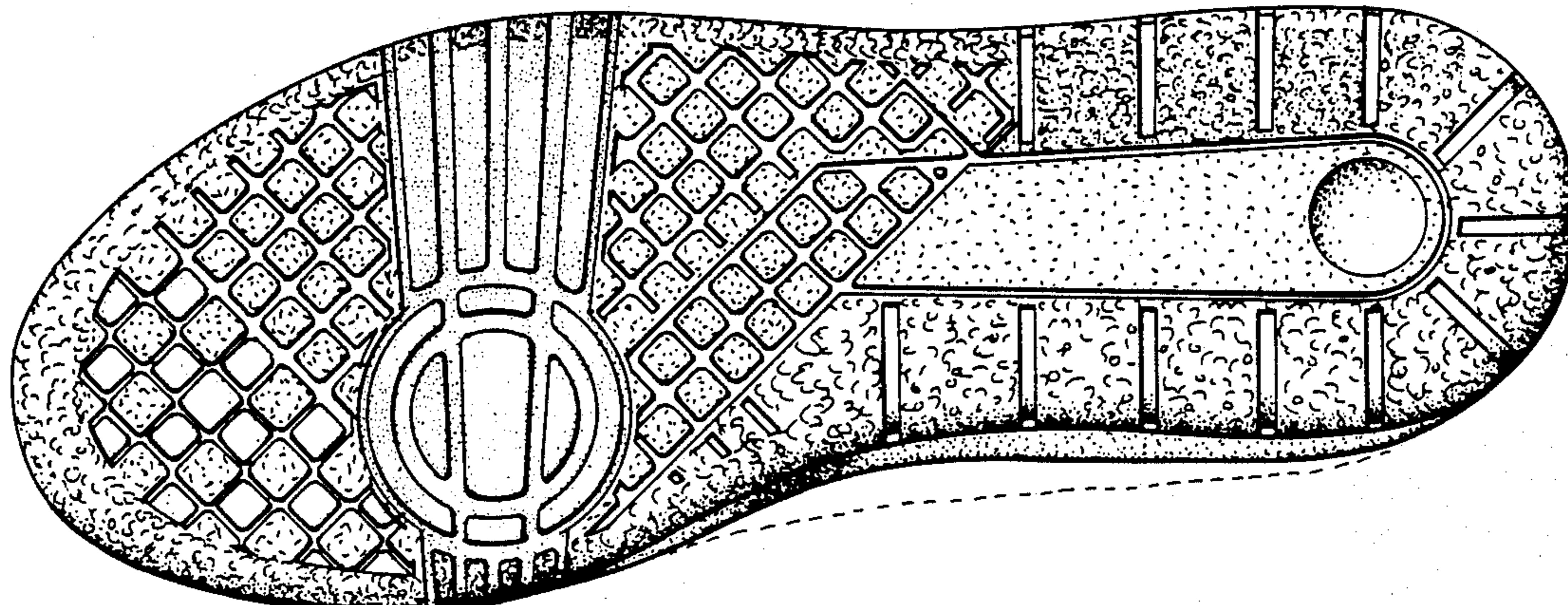
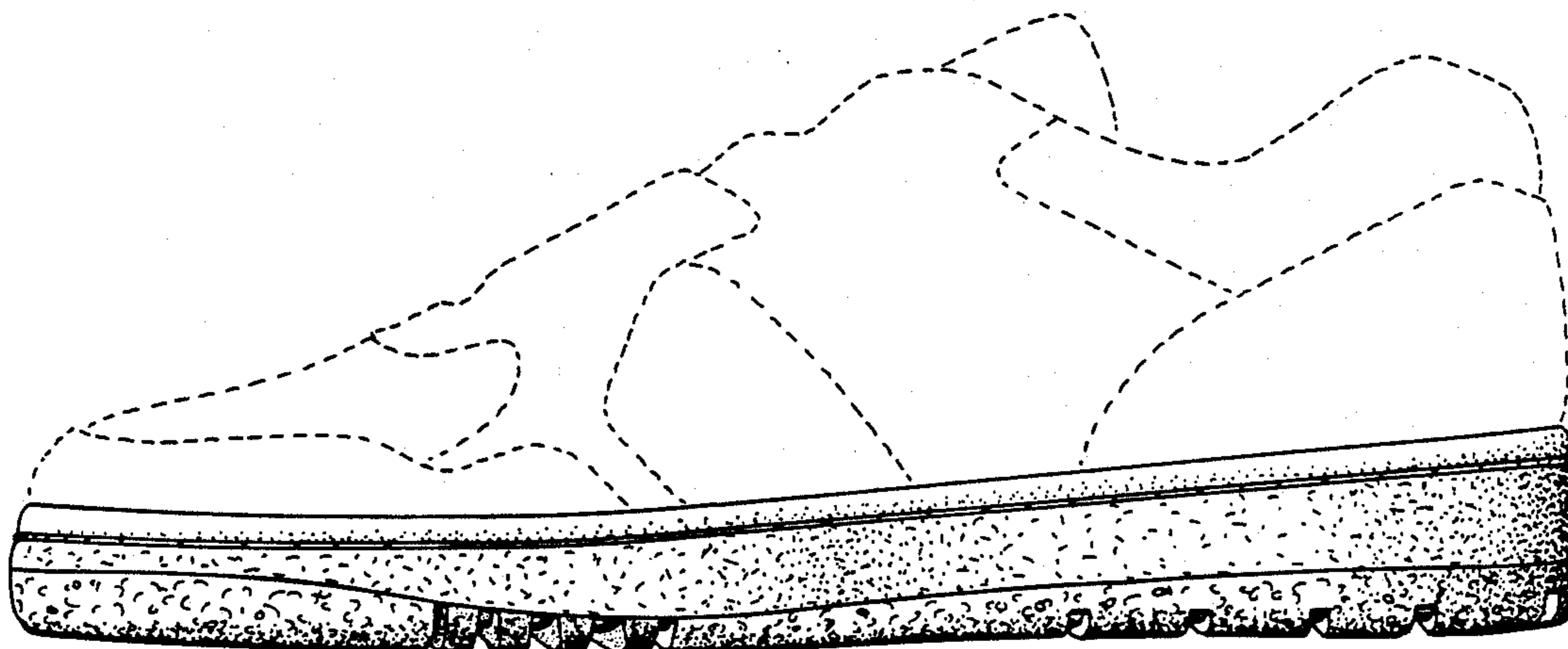

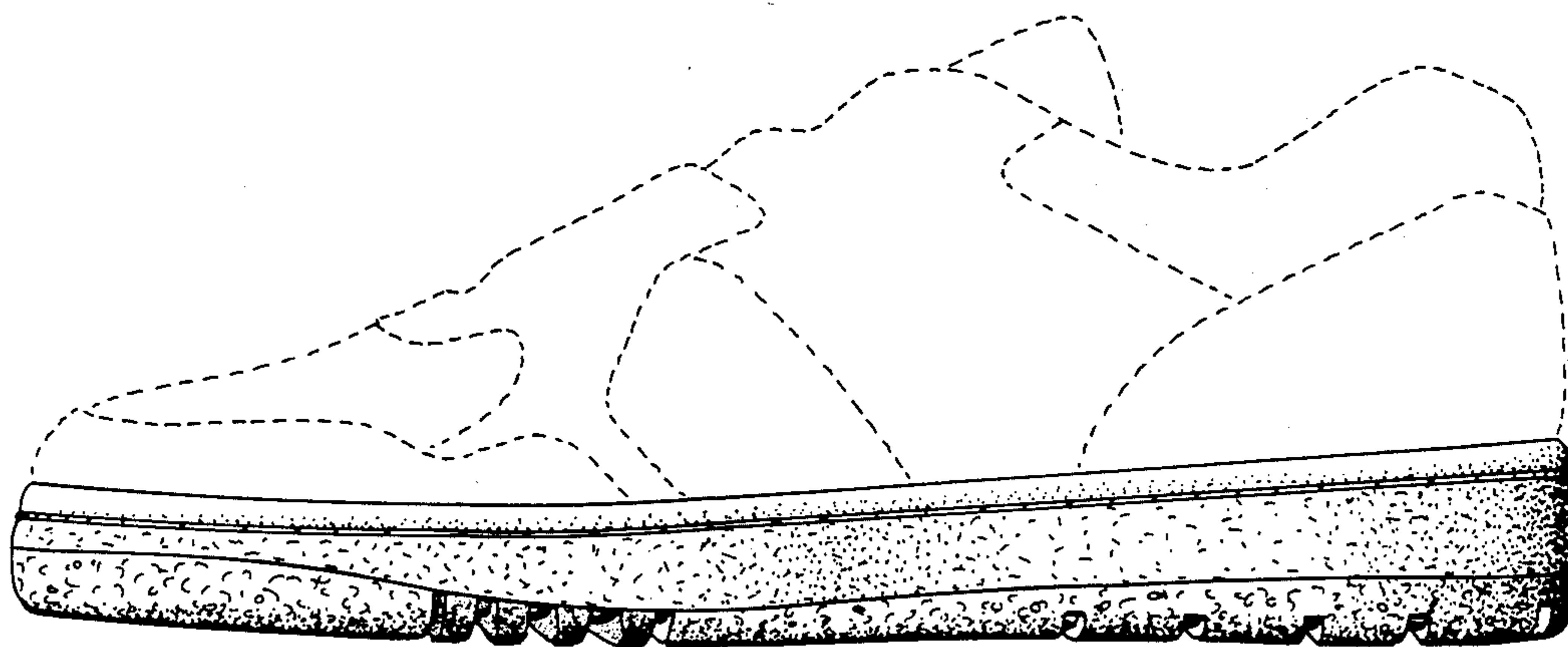
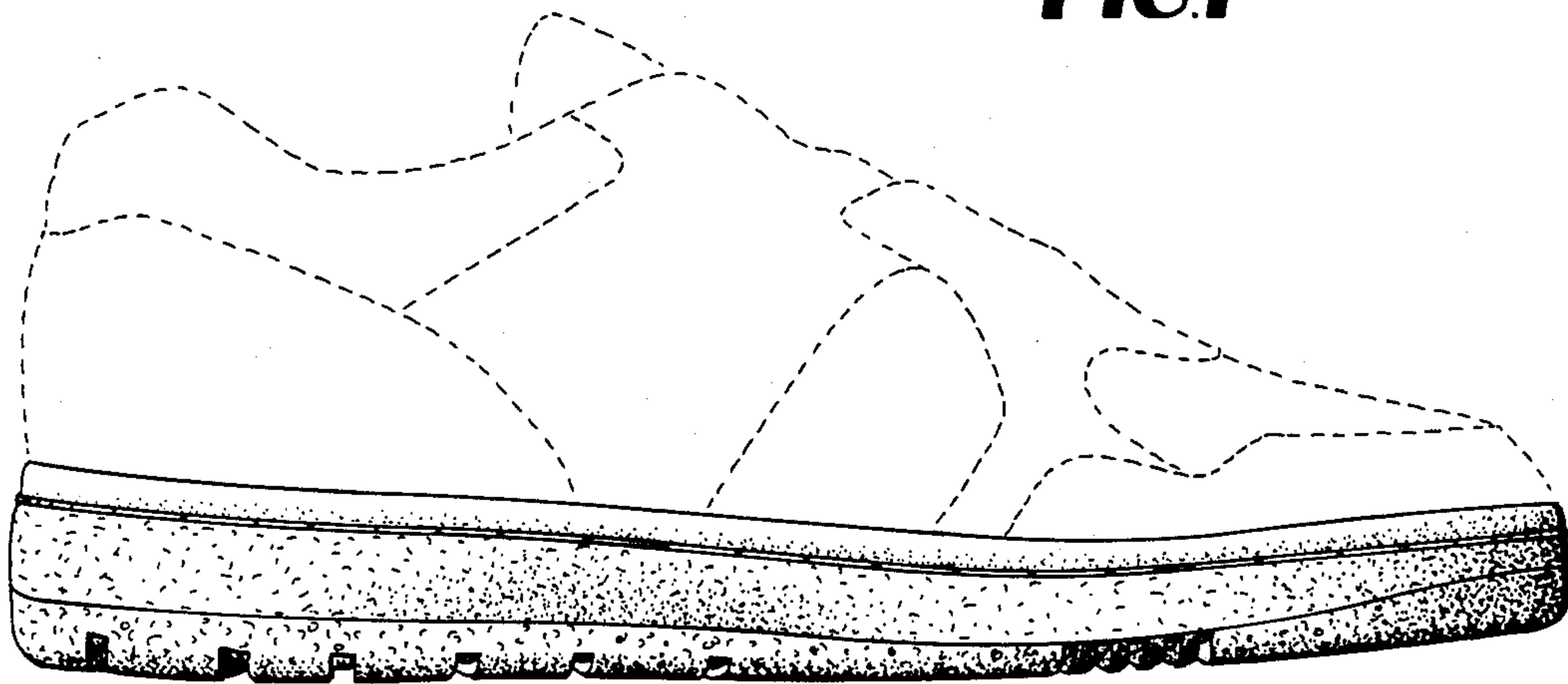

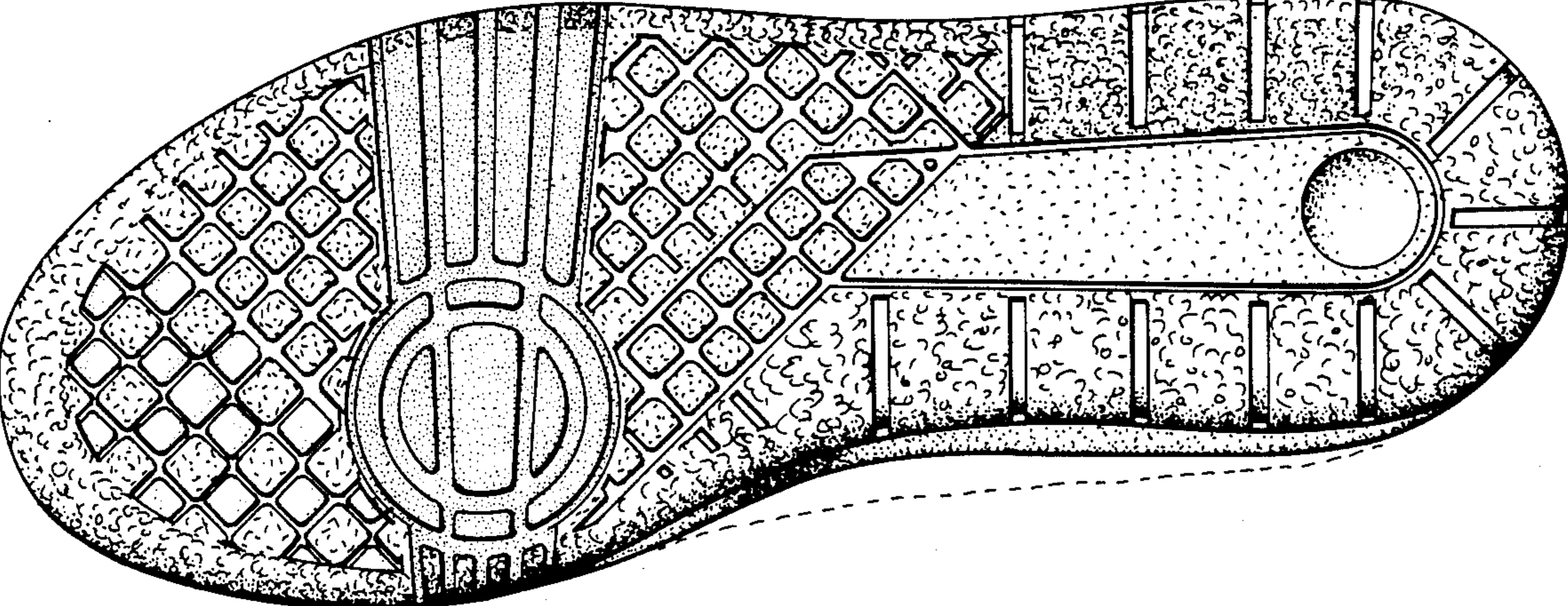

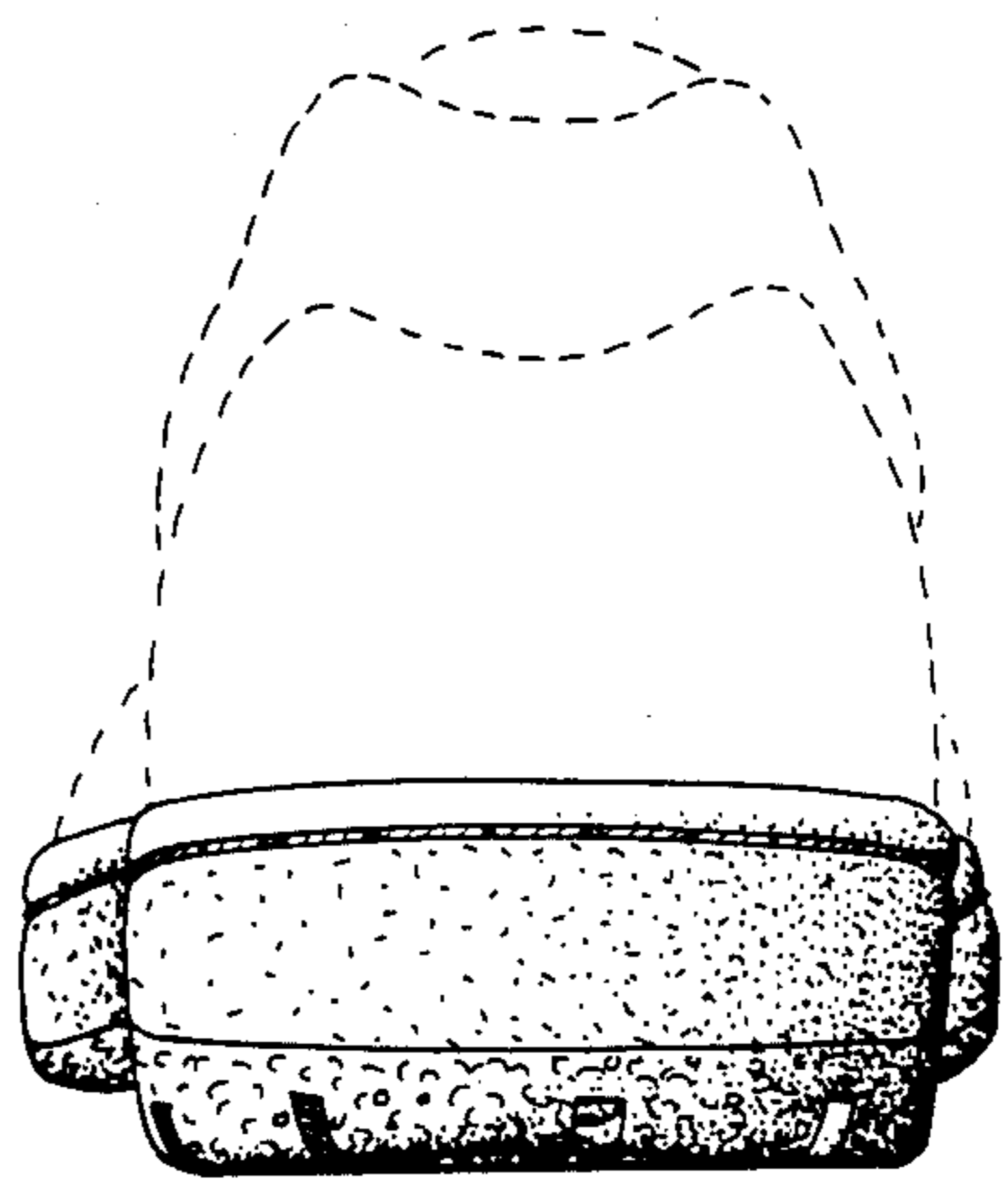
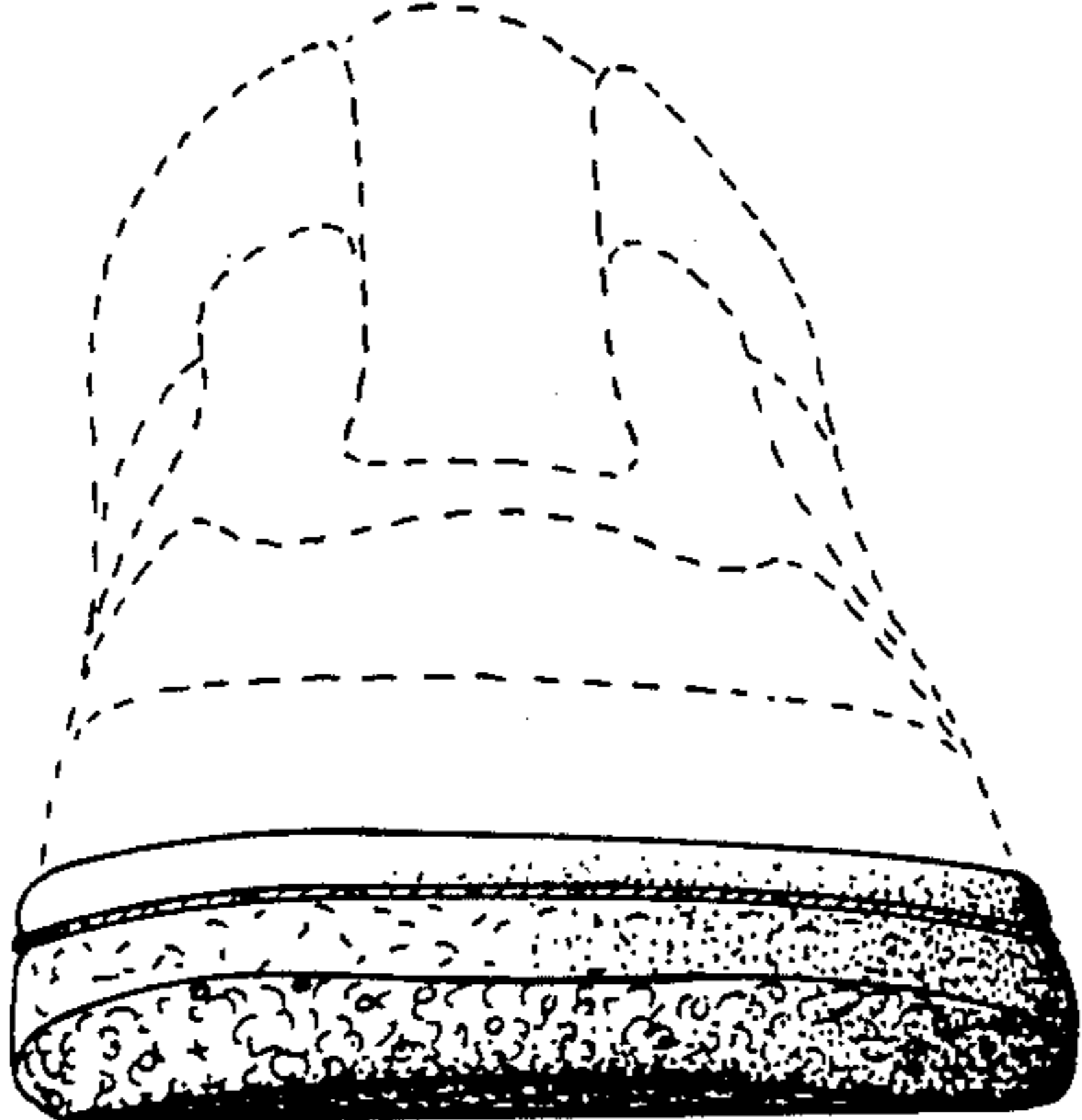
