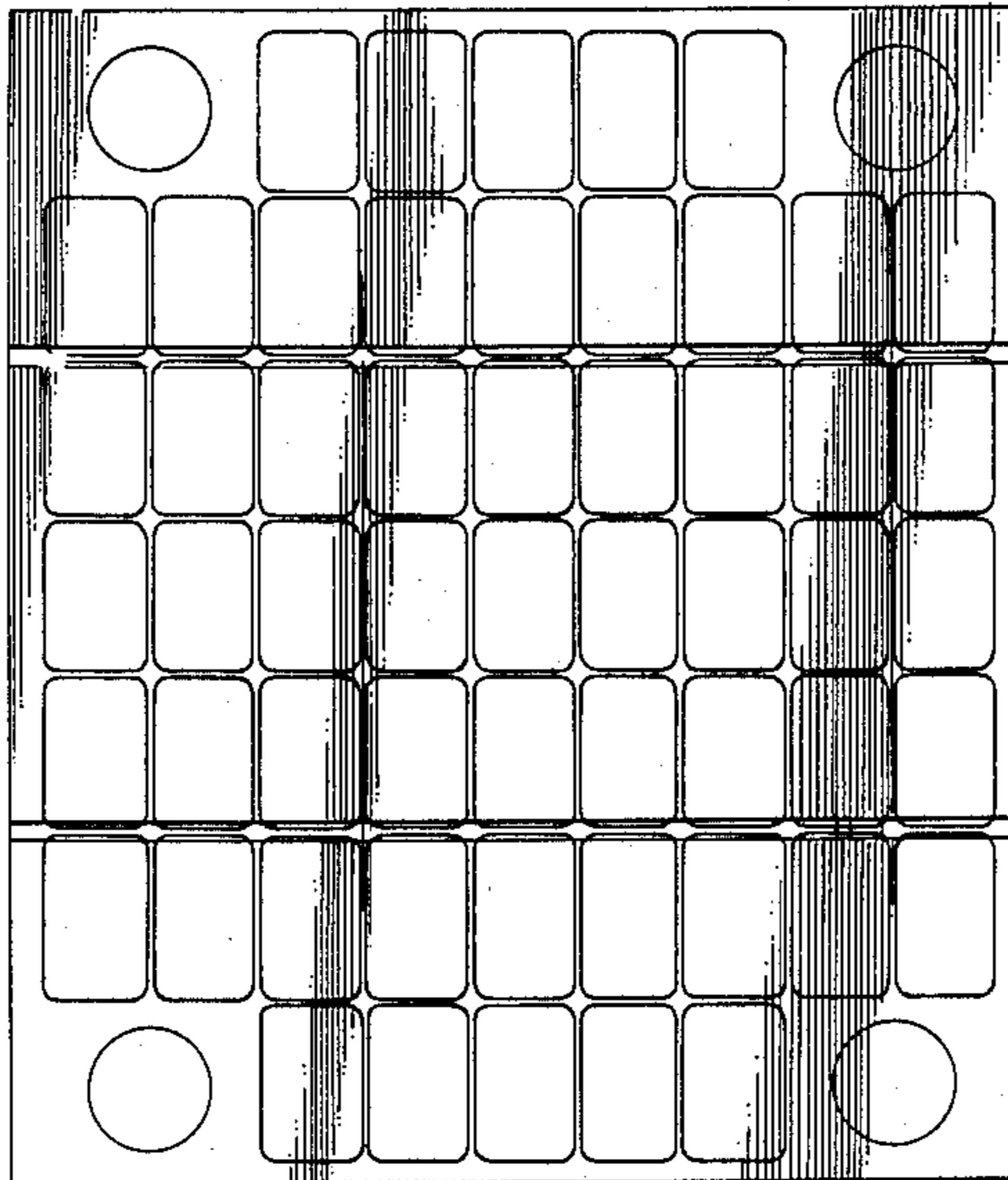

The ornamental design for game board, substantially as shown as described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a game board showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right hand side elevational view thereof, the left hand view being a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image; and  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



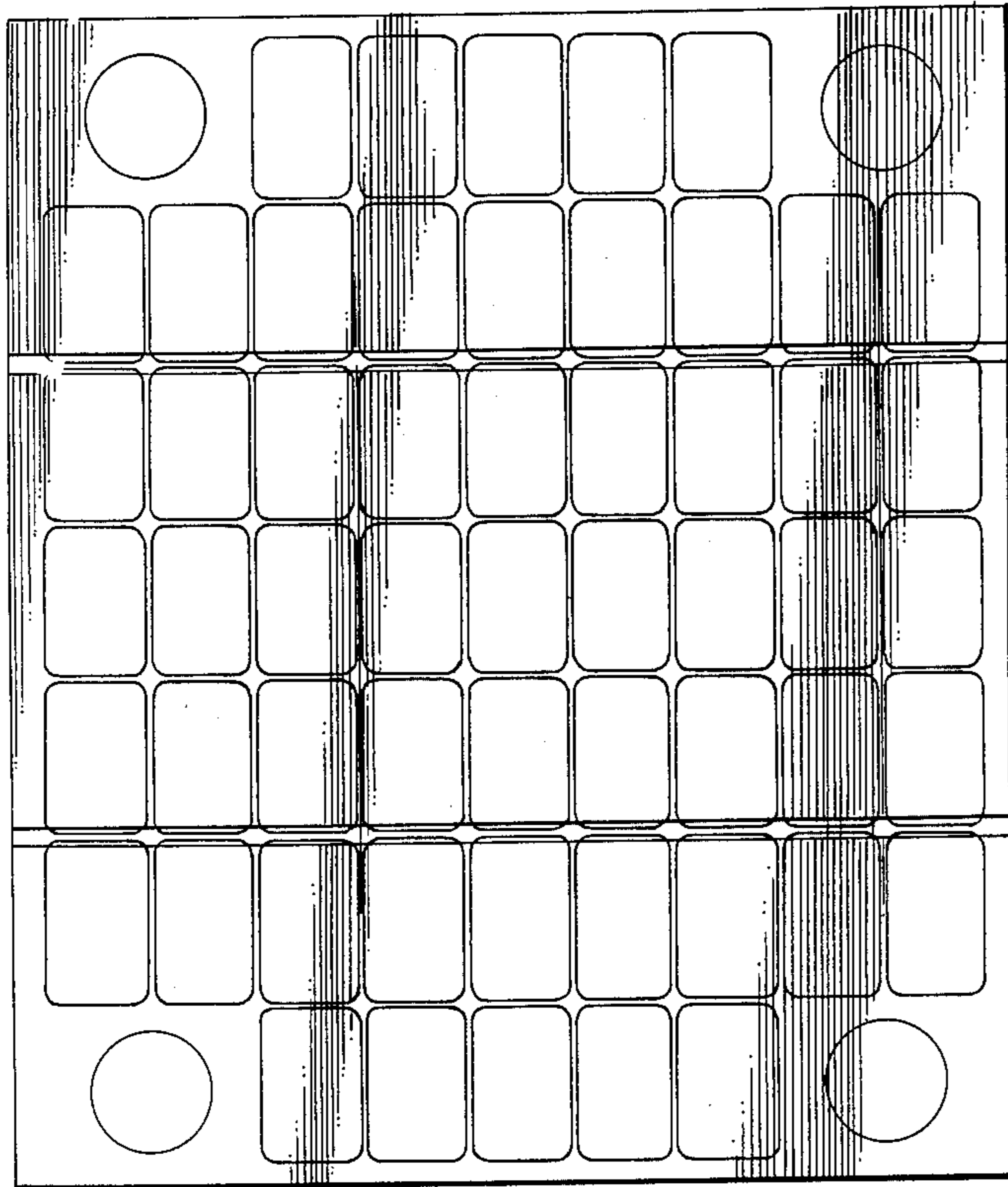

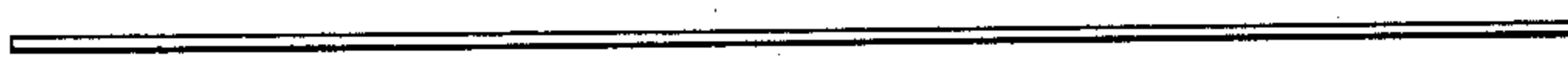

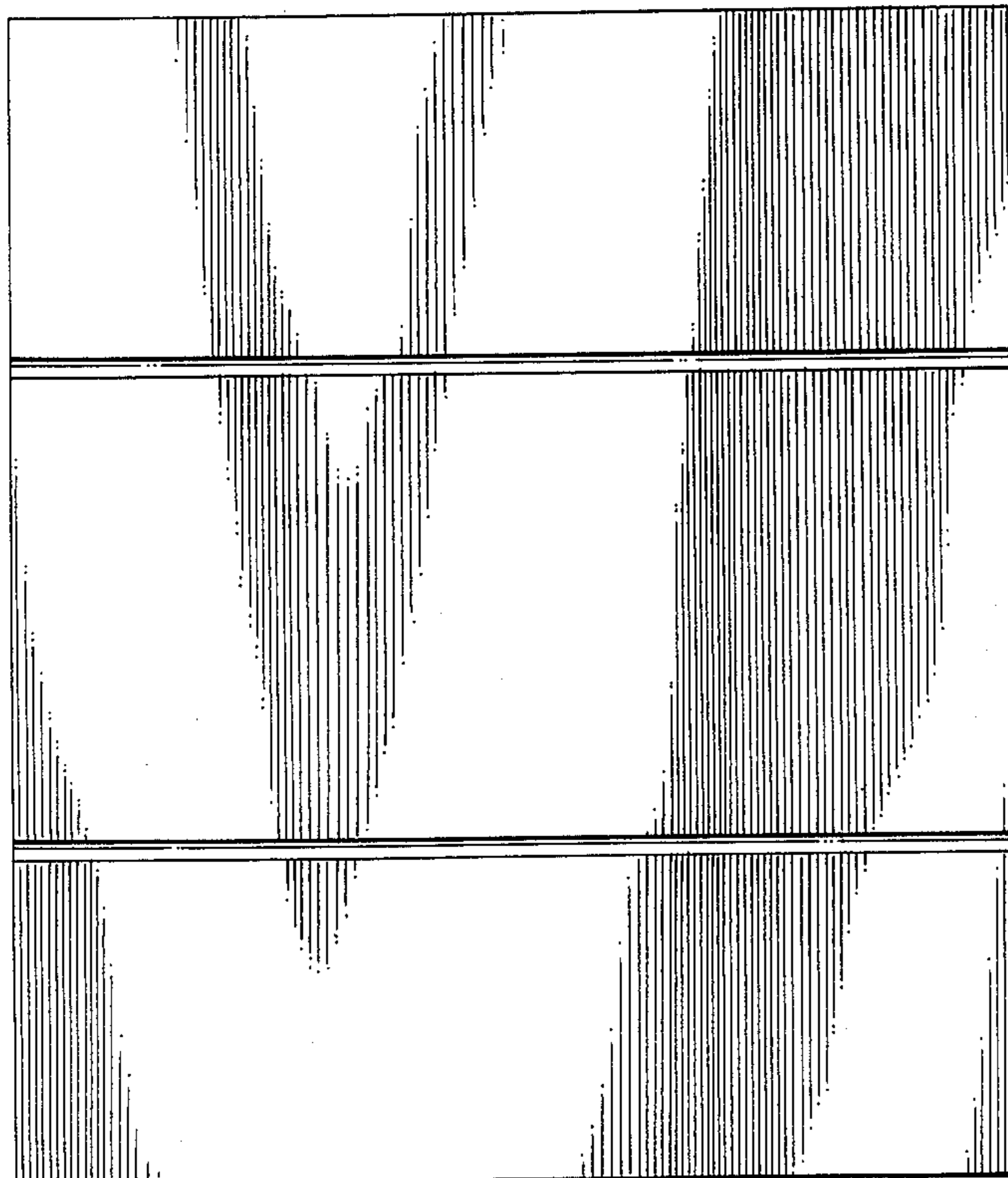
