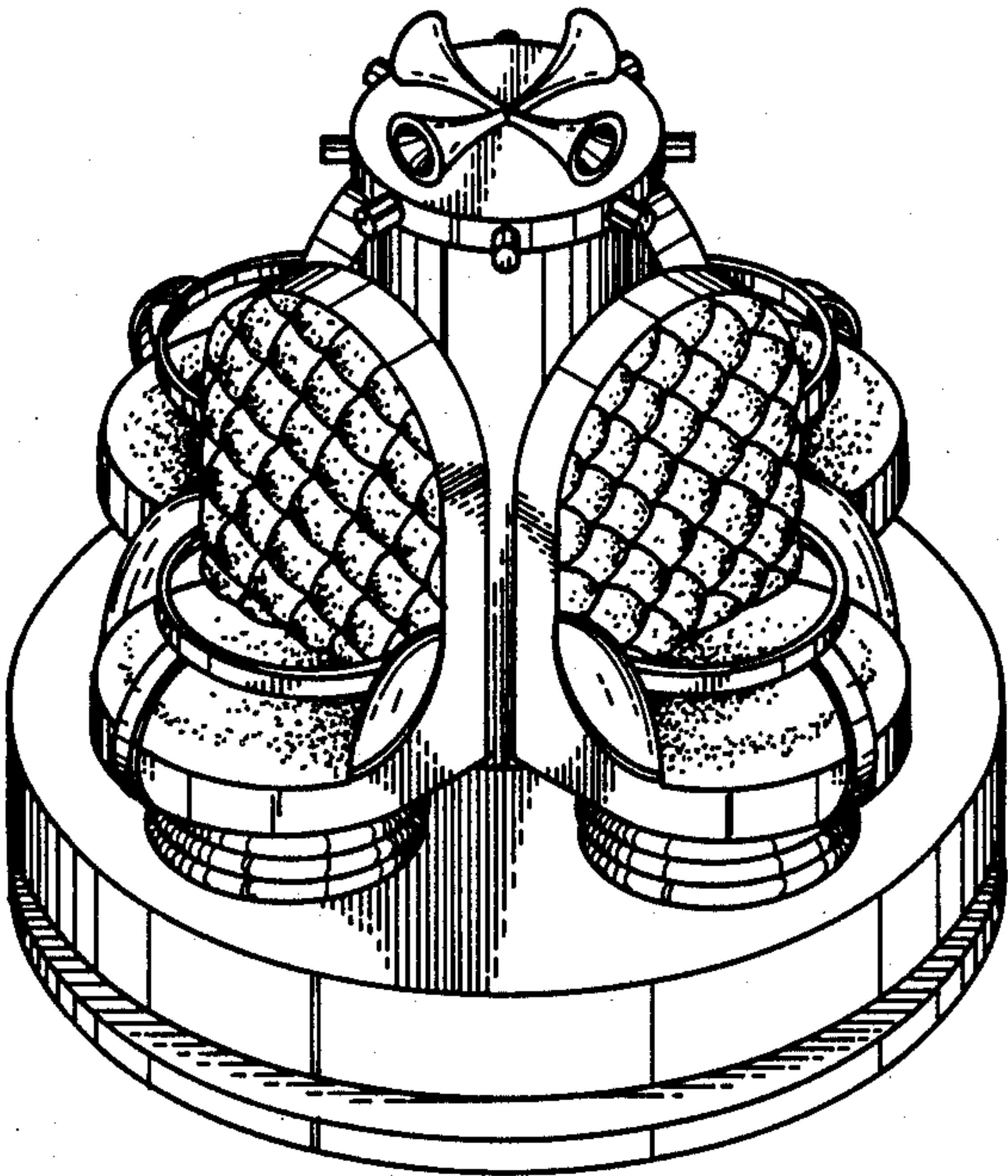

FIG. 4 is an elevational view showing one of the four identical sides.



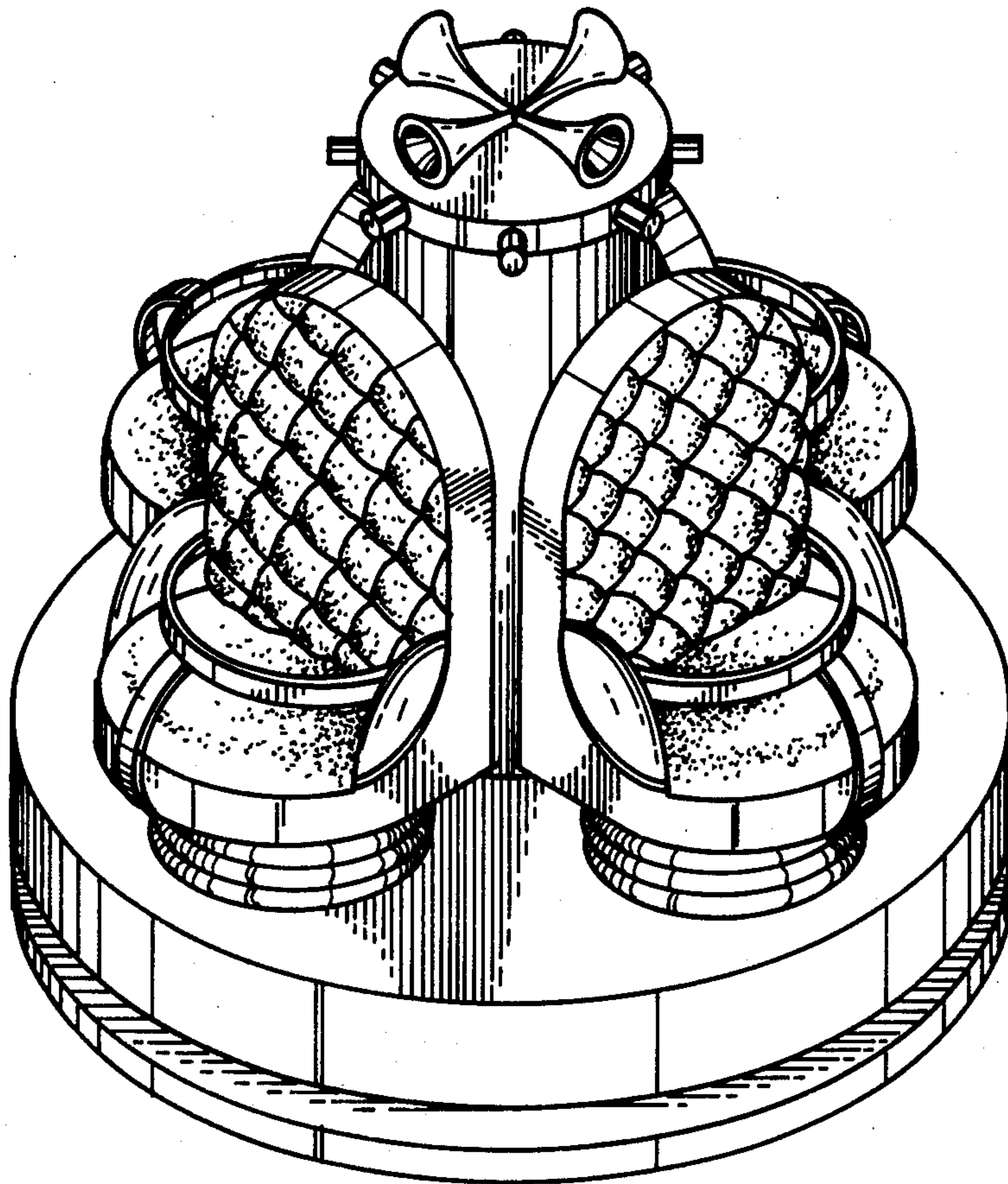

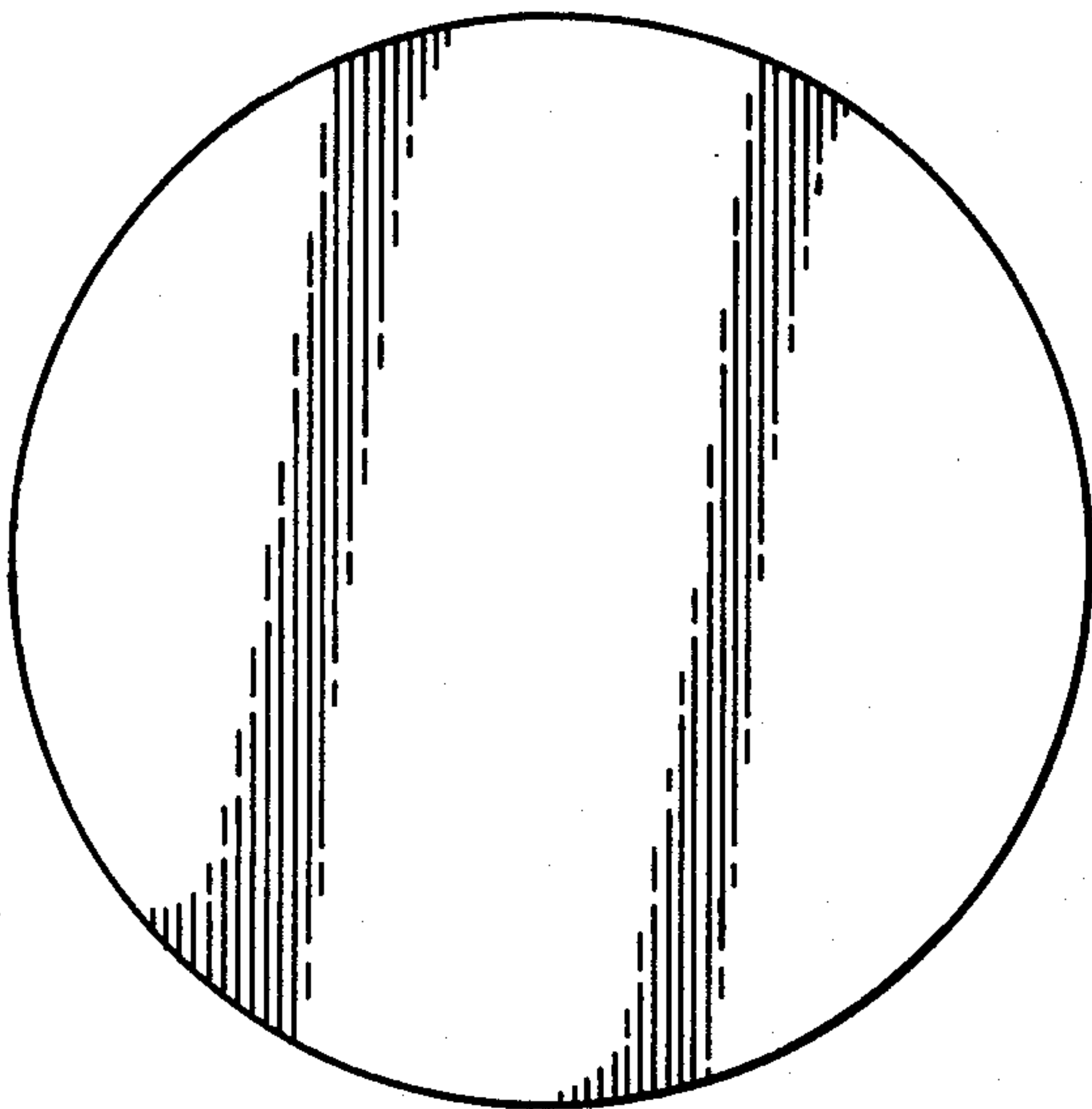

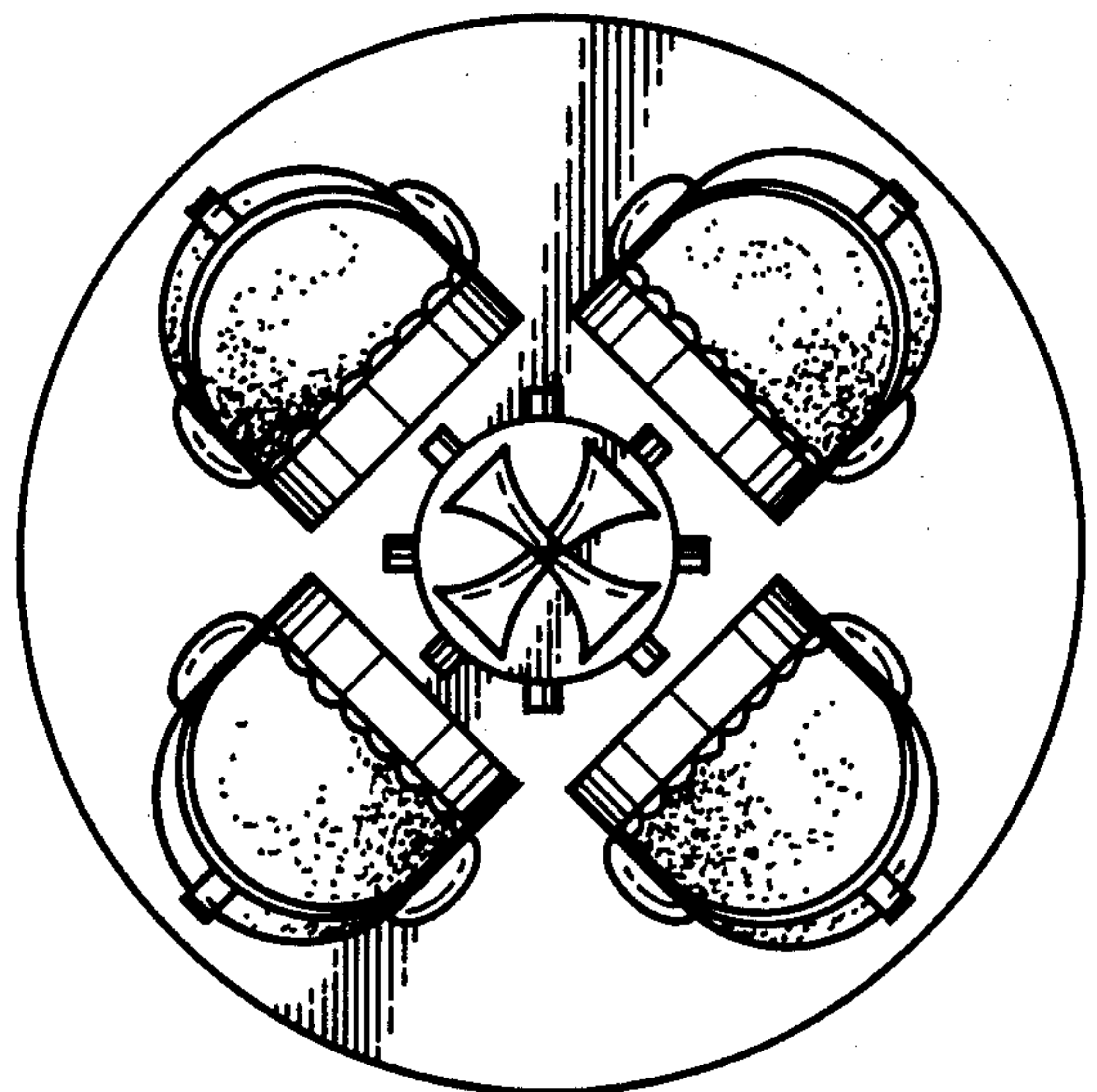

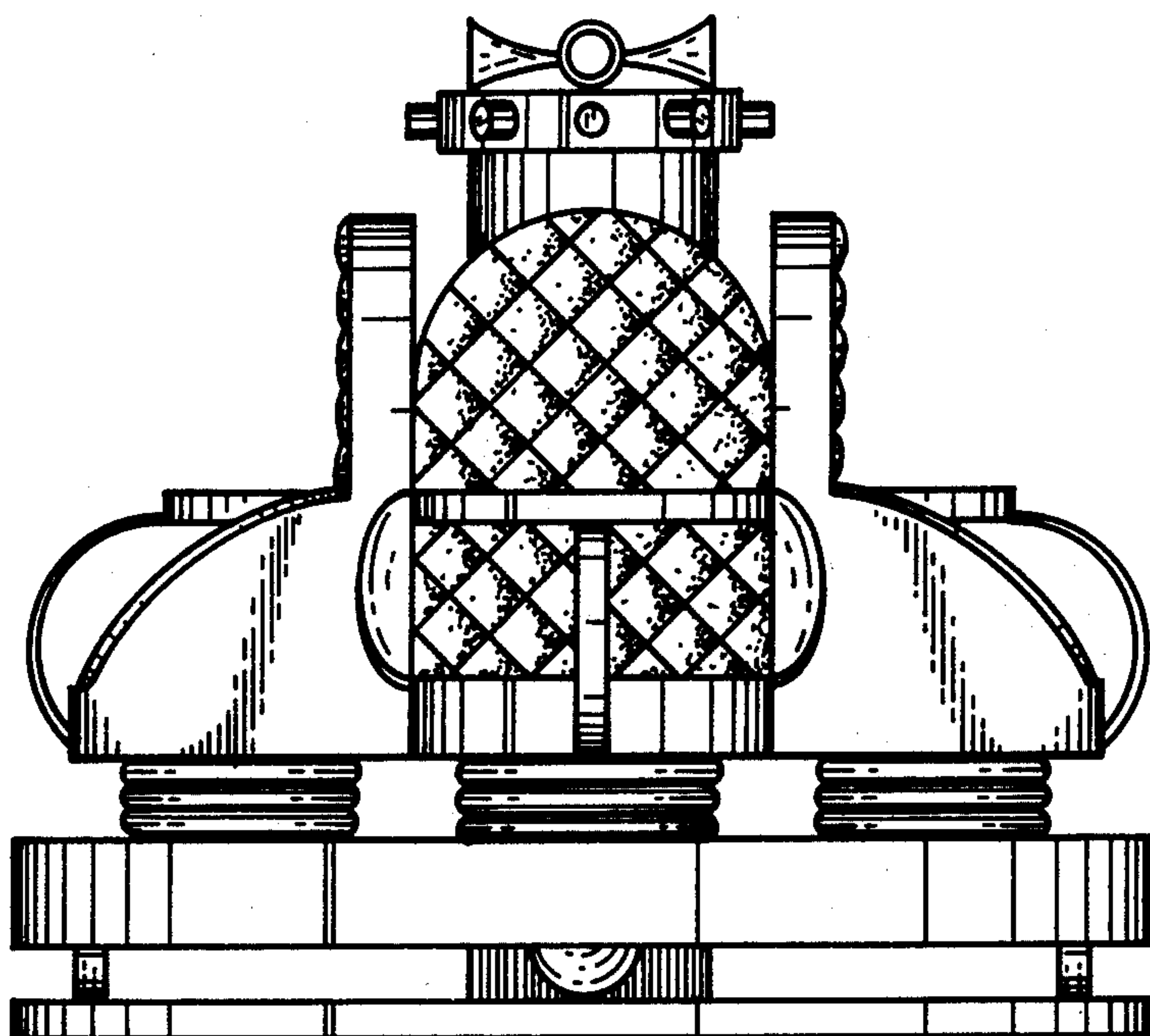
