[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a support clamp for holding door panels on edge, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the support clamp for holding door panels on edge showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being identical; FIG. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical; FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

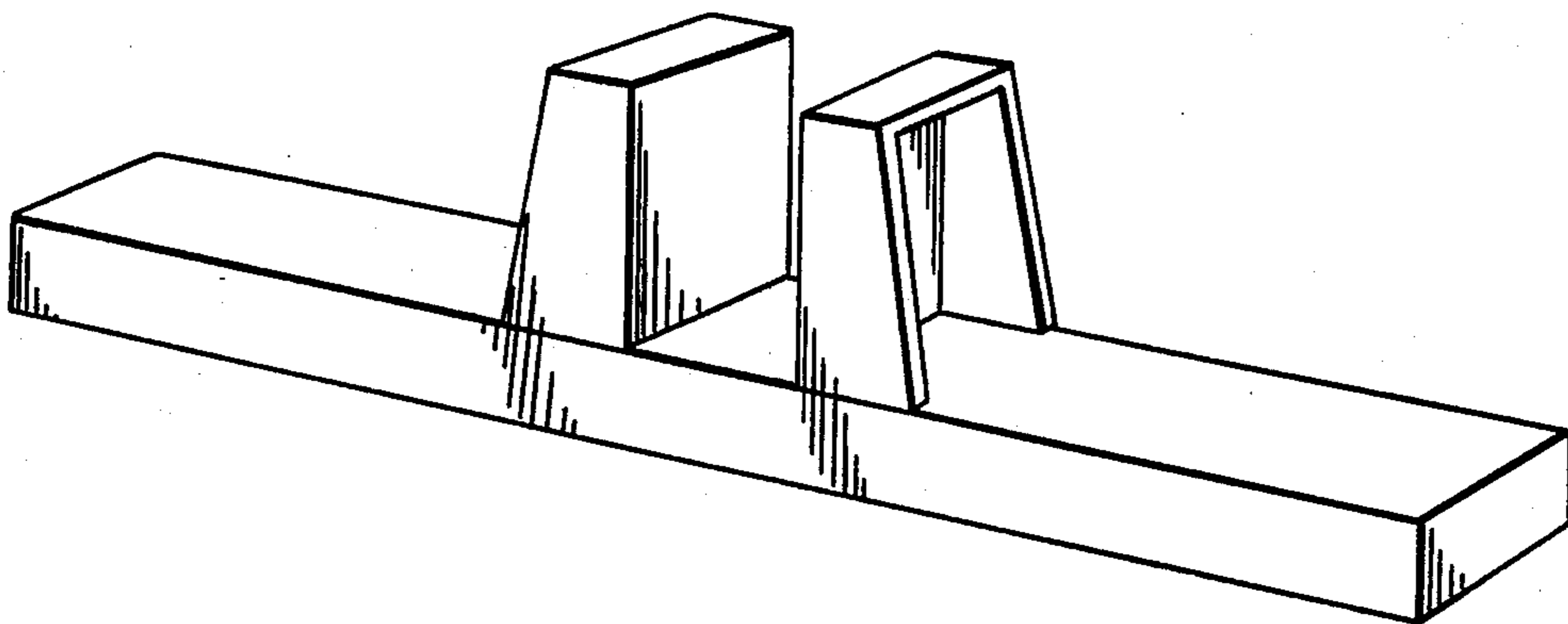

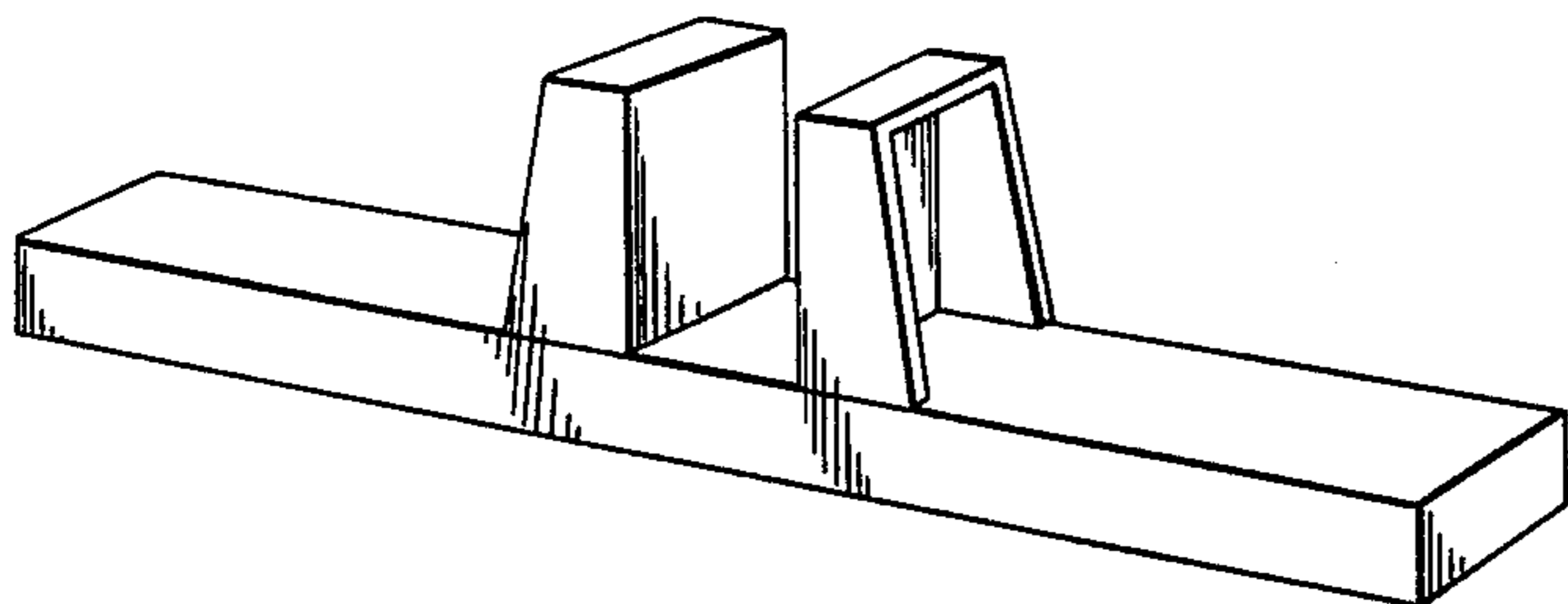

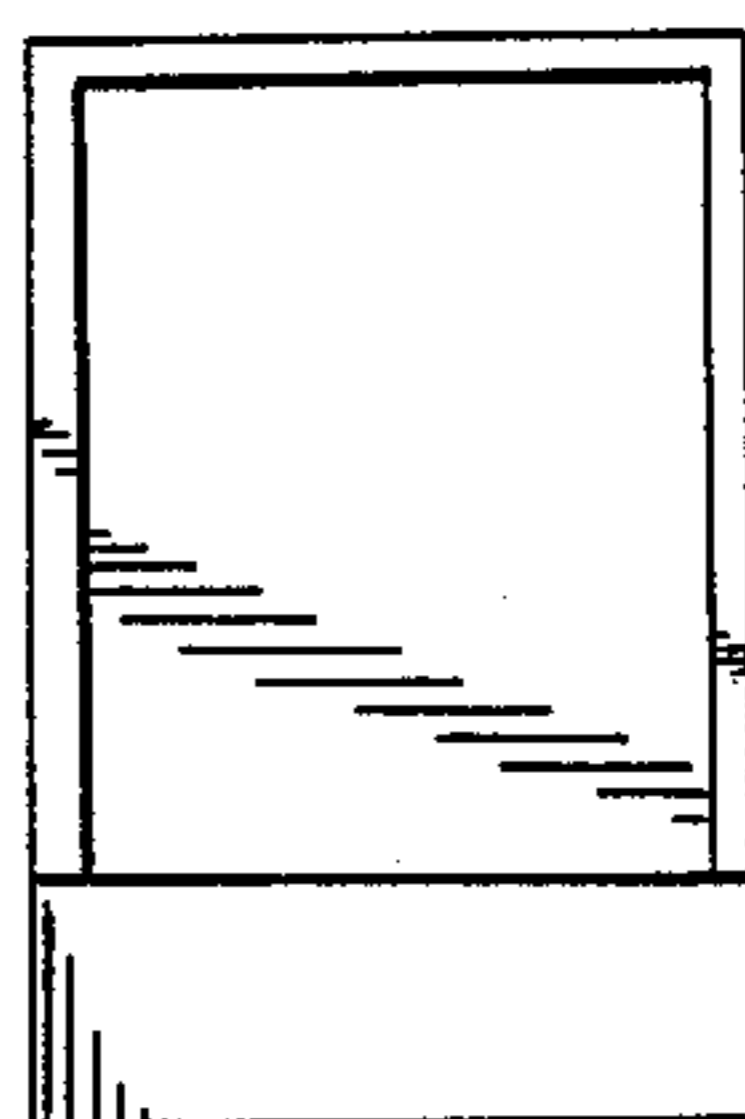

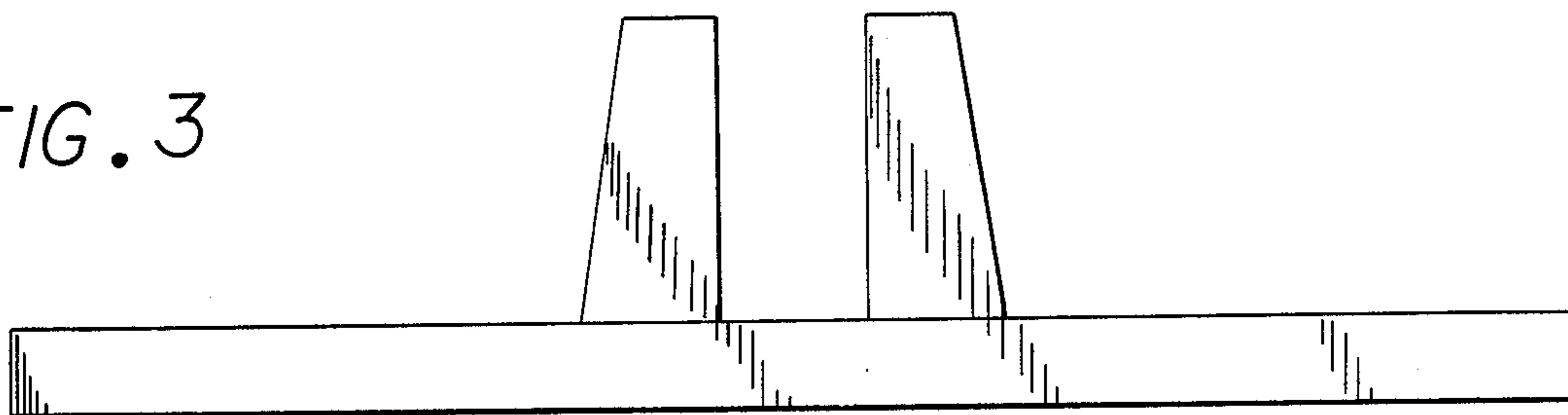

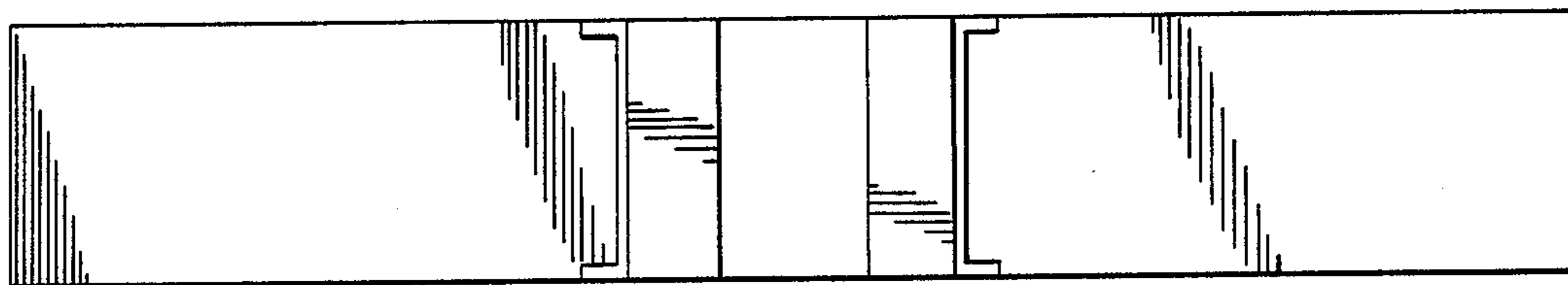
