[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wall mounted face plate for selectable level lighting controller, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a wall mounted face plate for selectable level lighting controller showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being unornamented;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

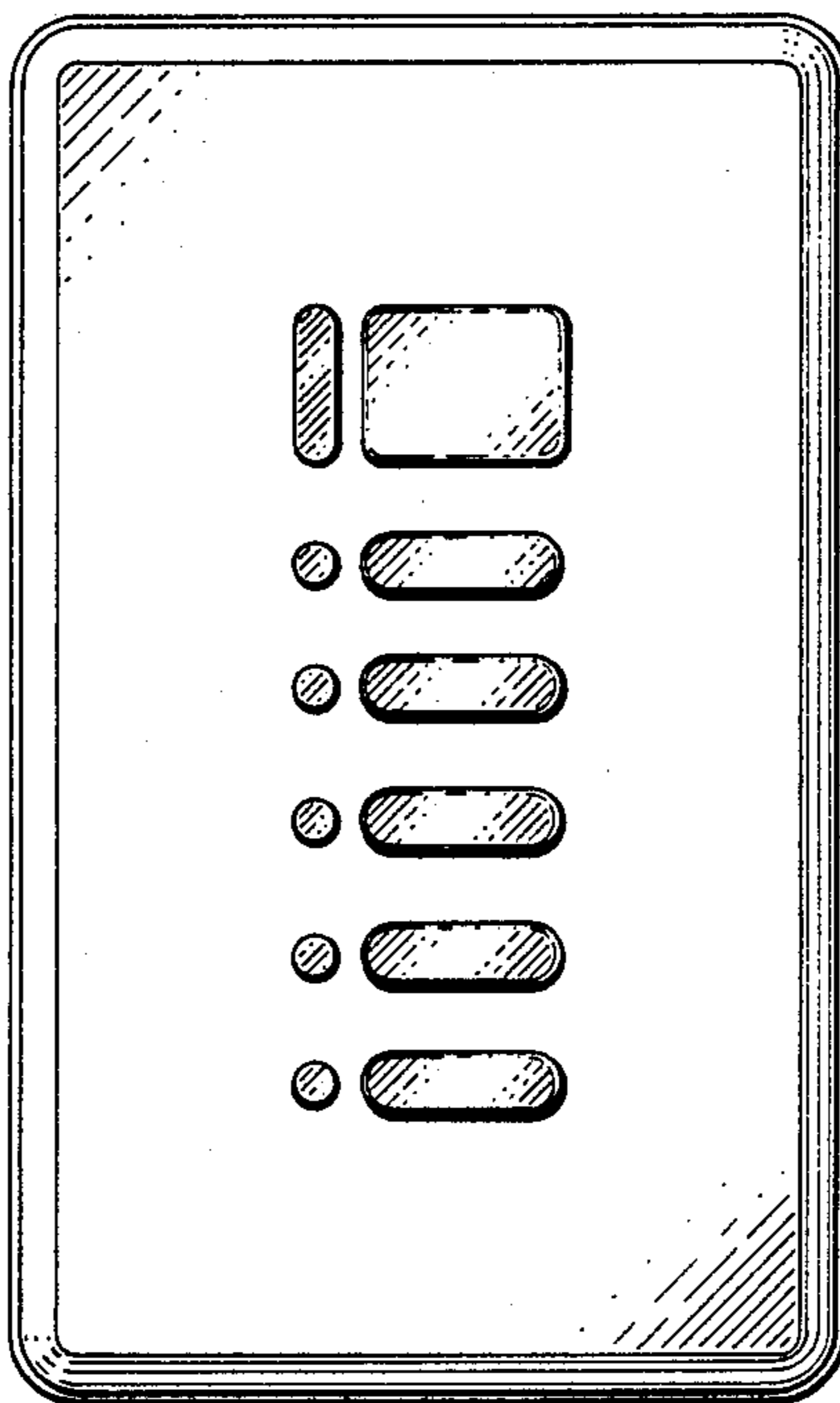
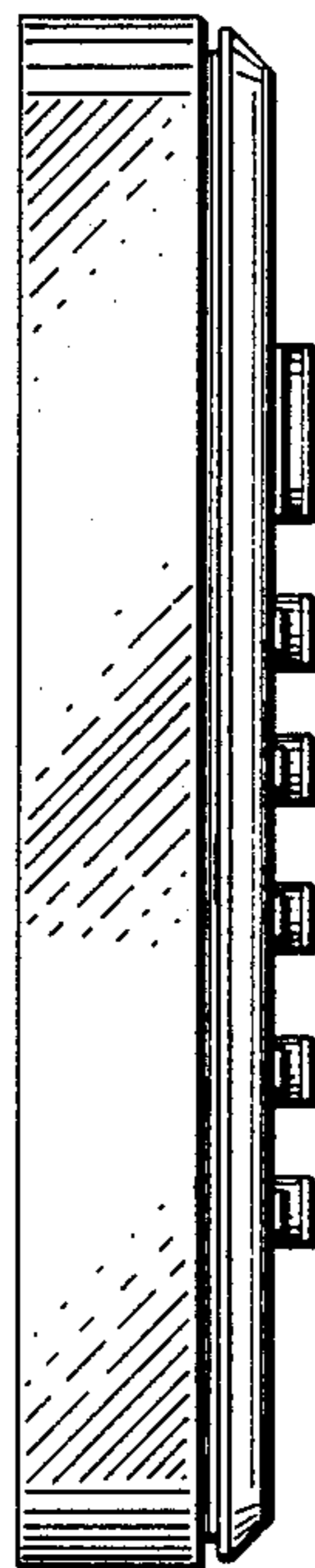

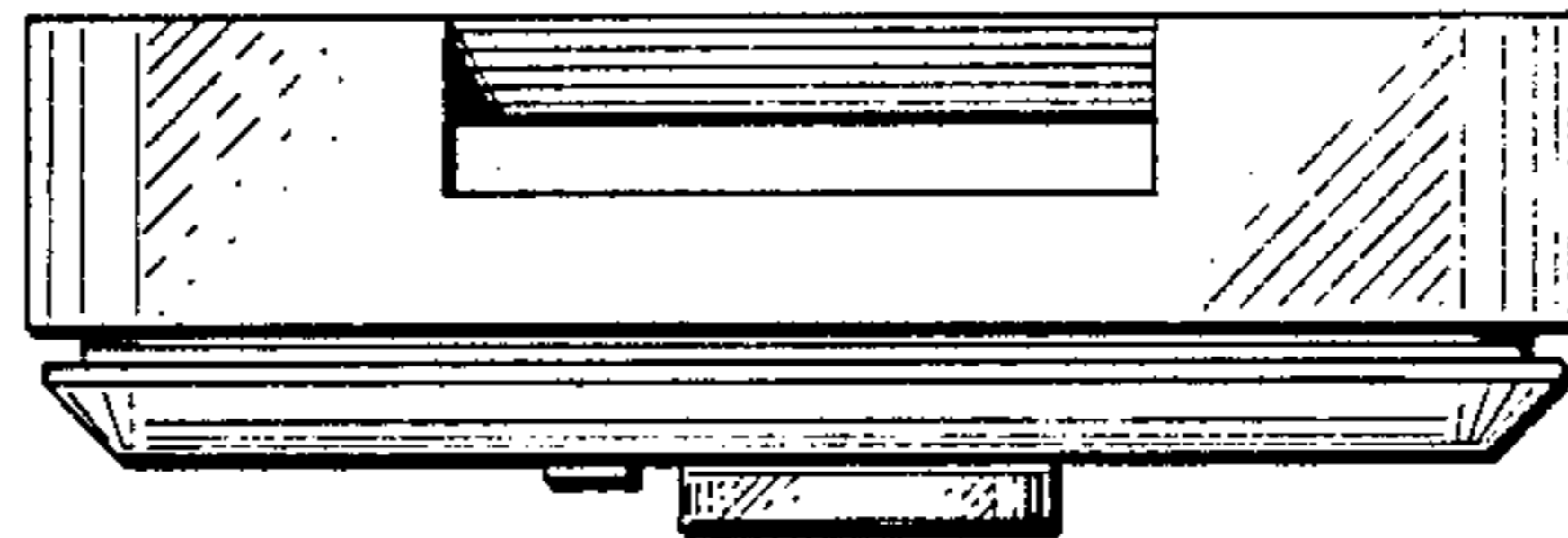

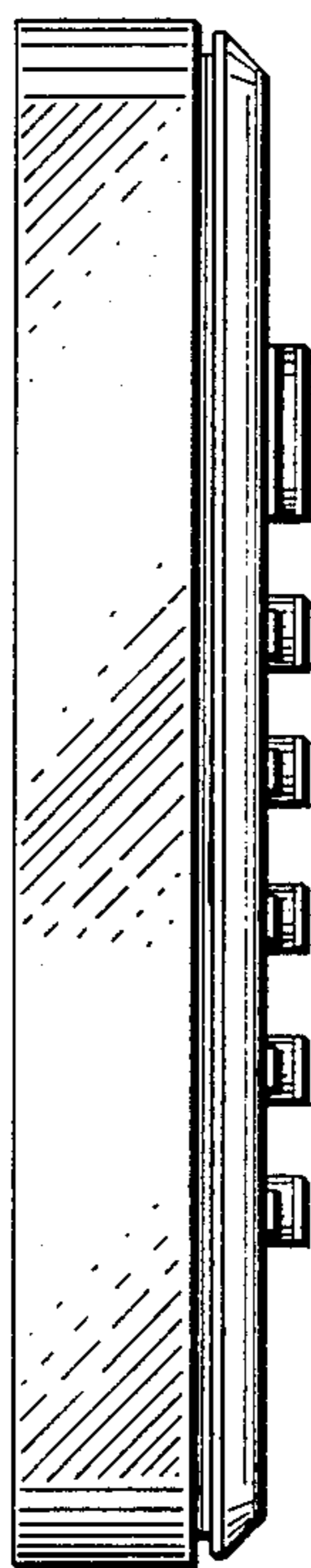

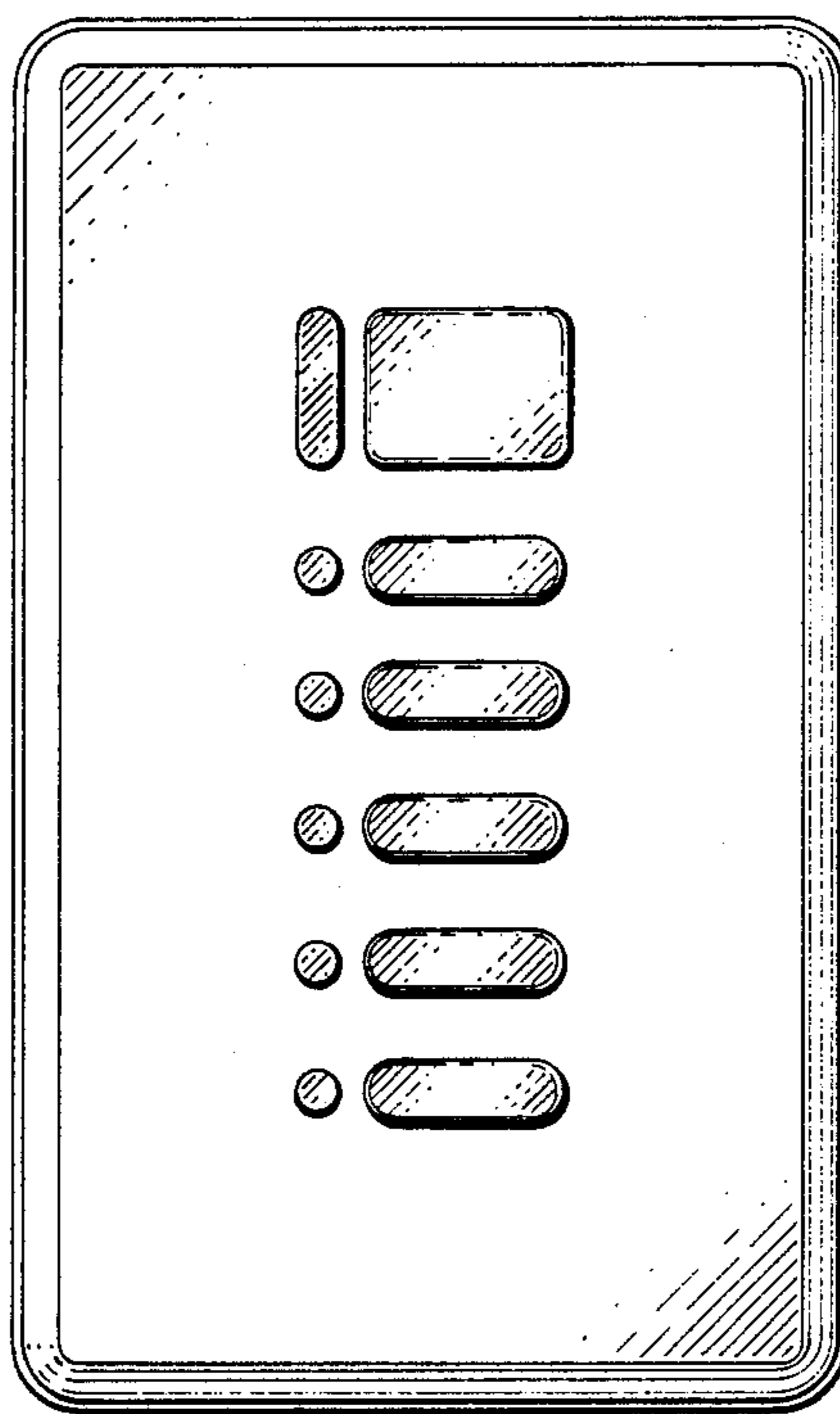
