DESCRIPTION

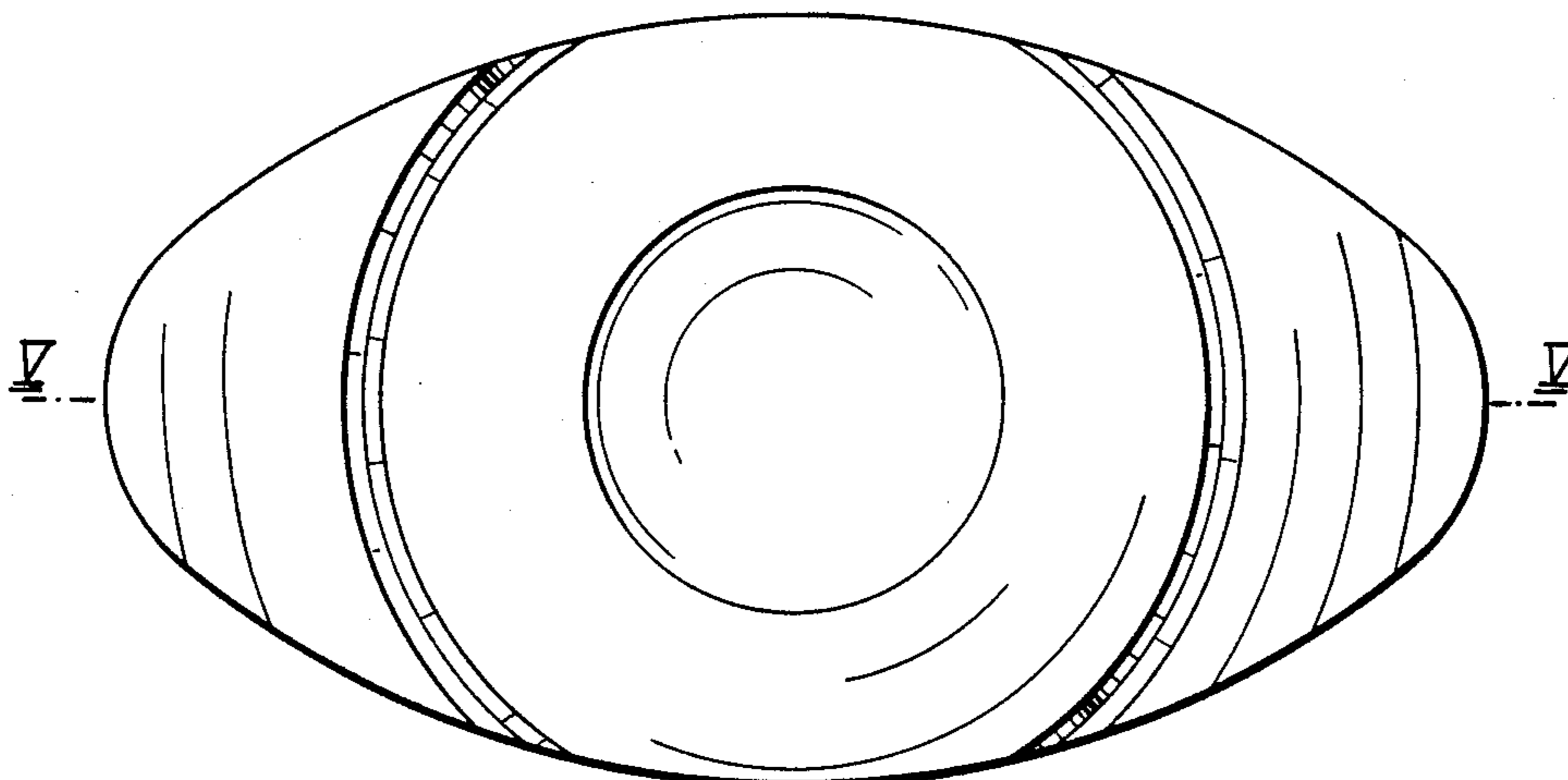
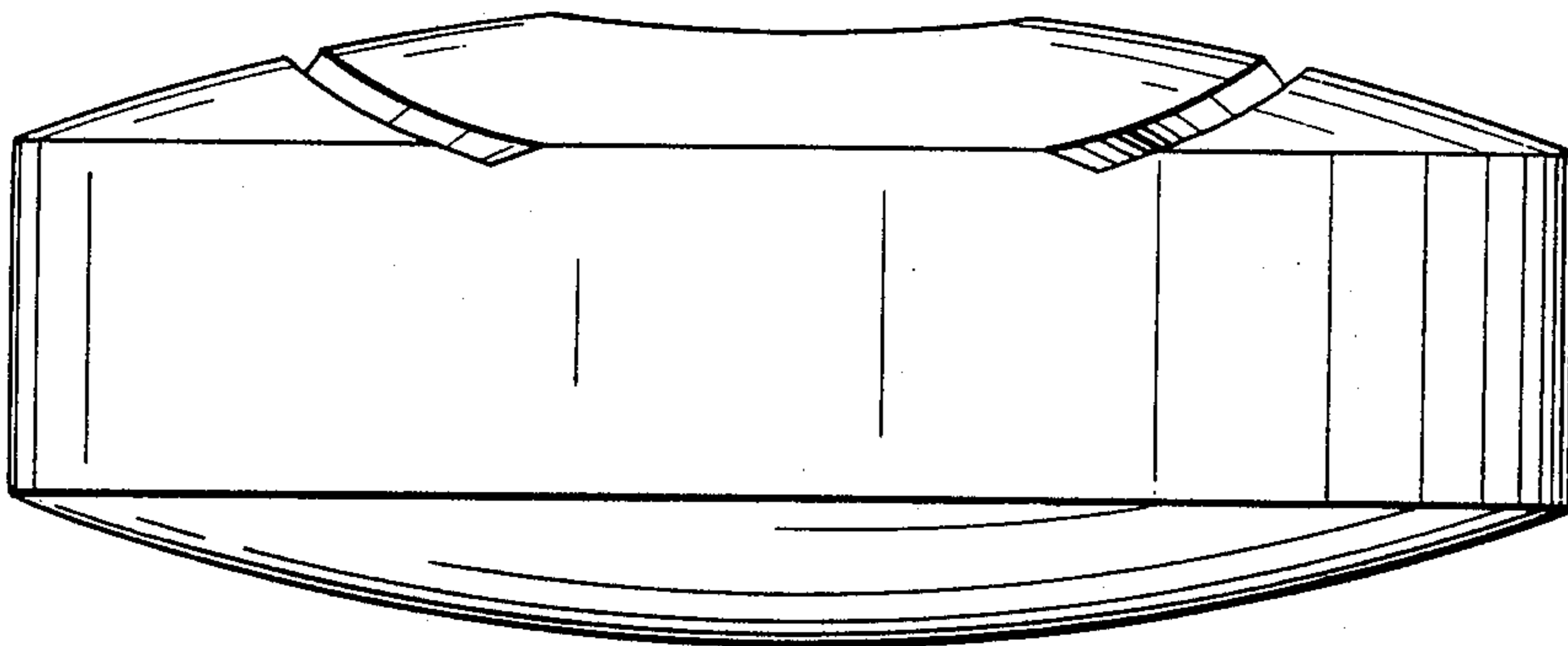
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a pharmaceutical tablet showing my new design, the opposite side elevational view being identical;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line V—V in FIG. 4.



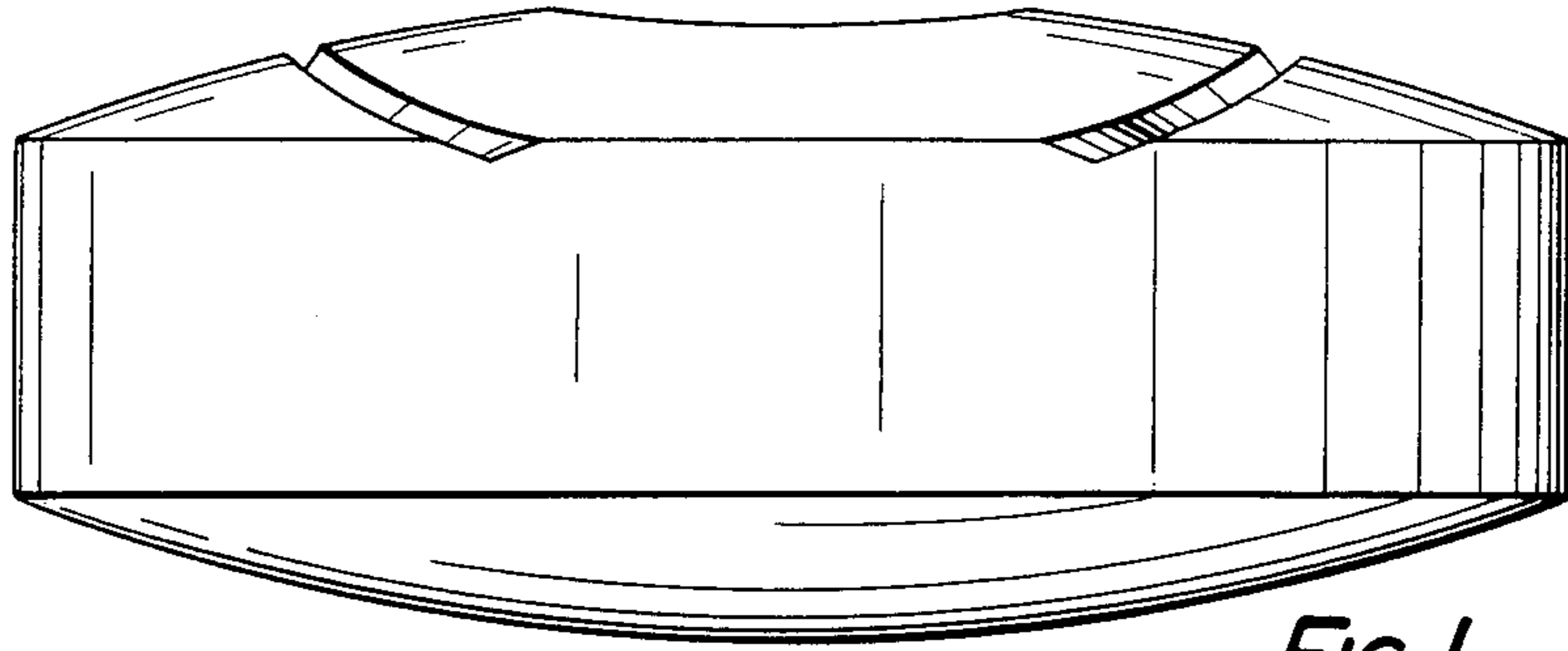

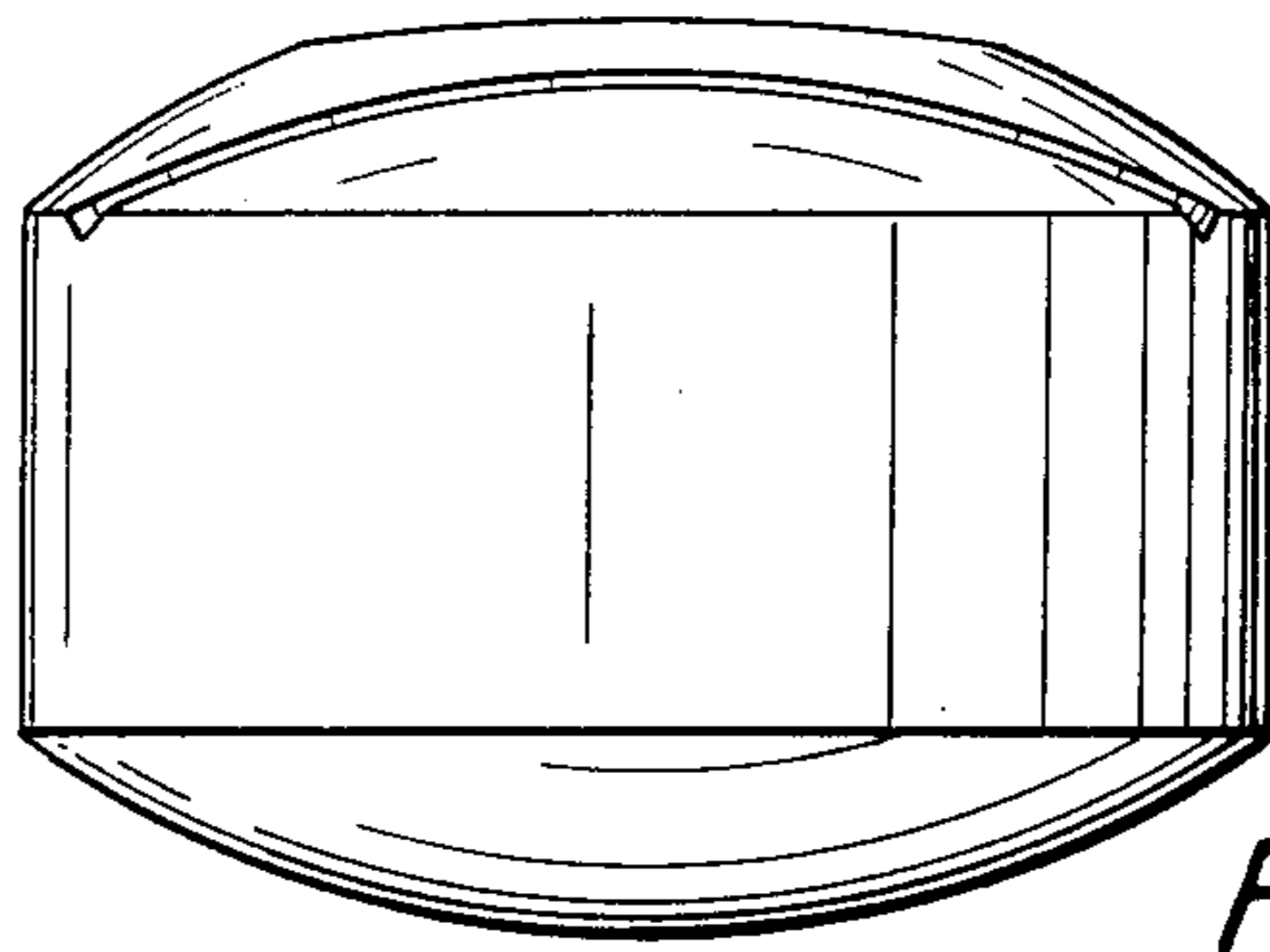

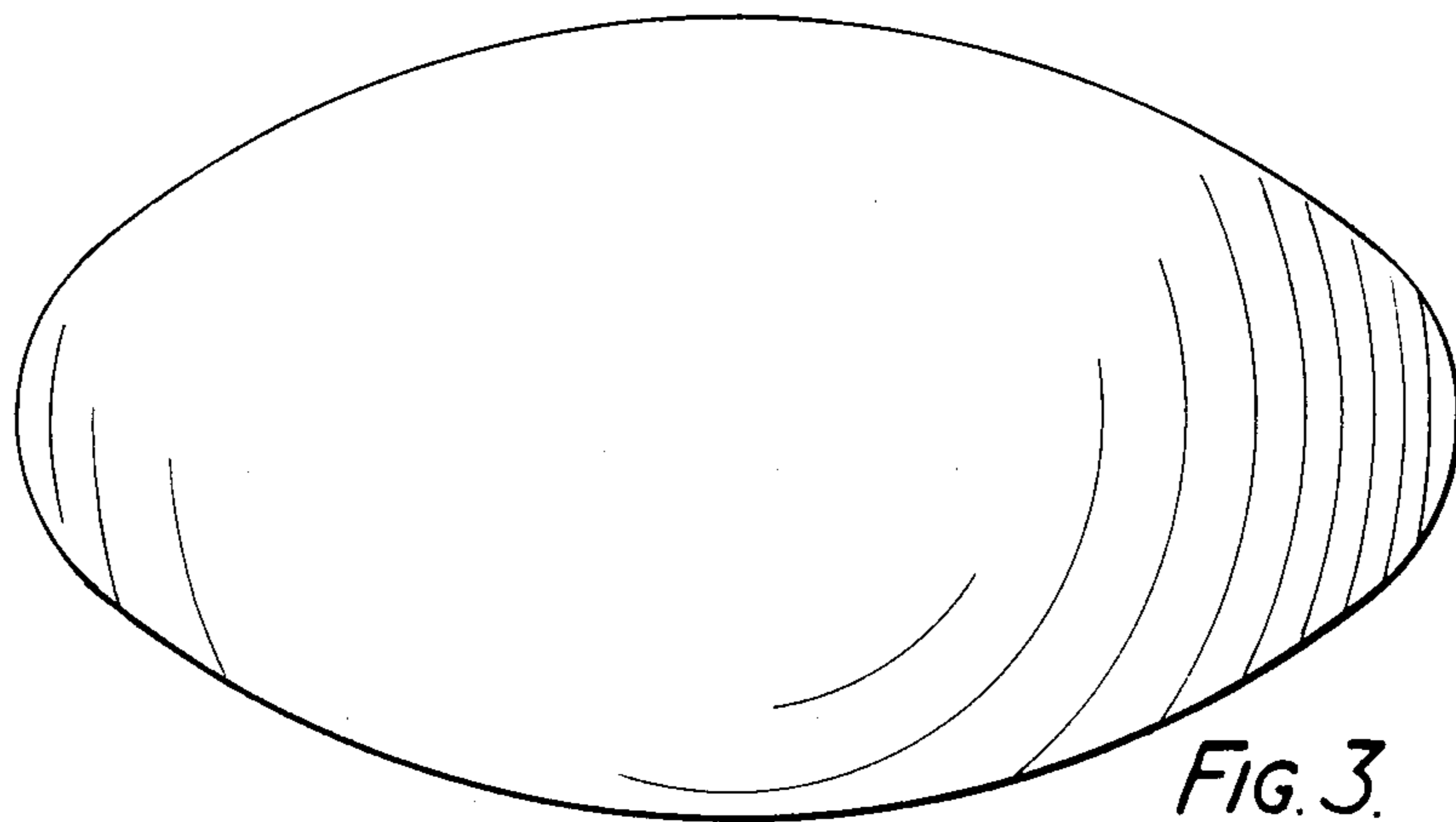

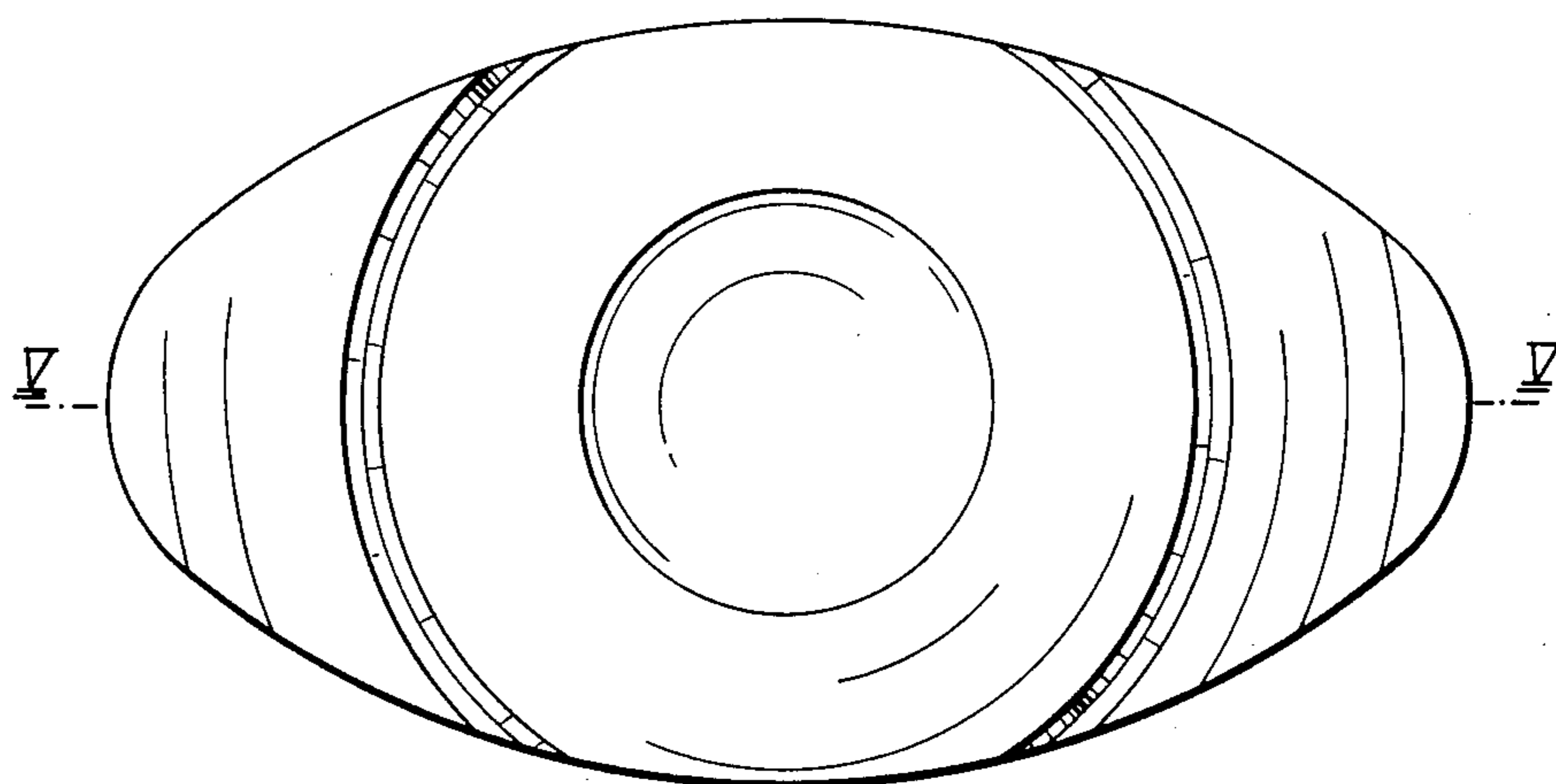

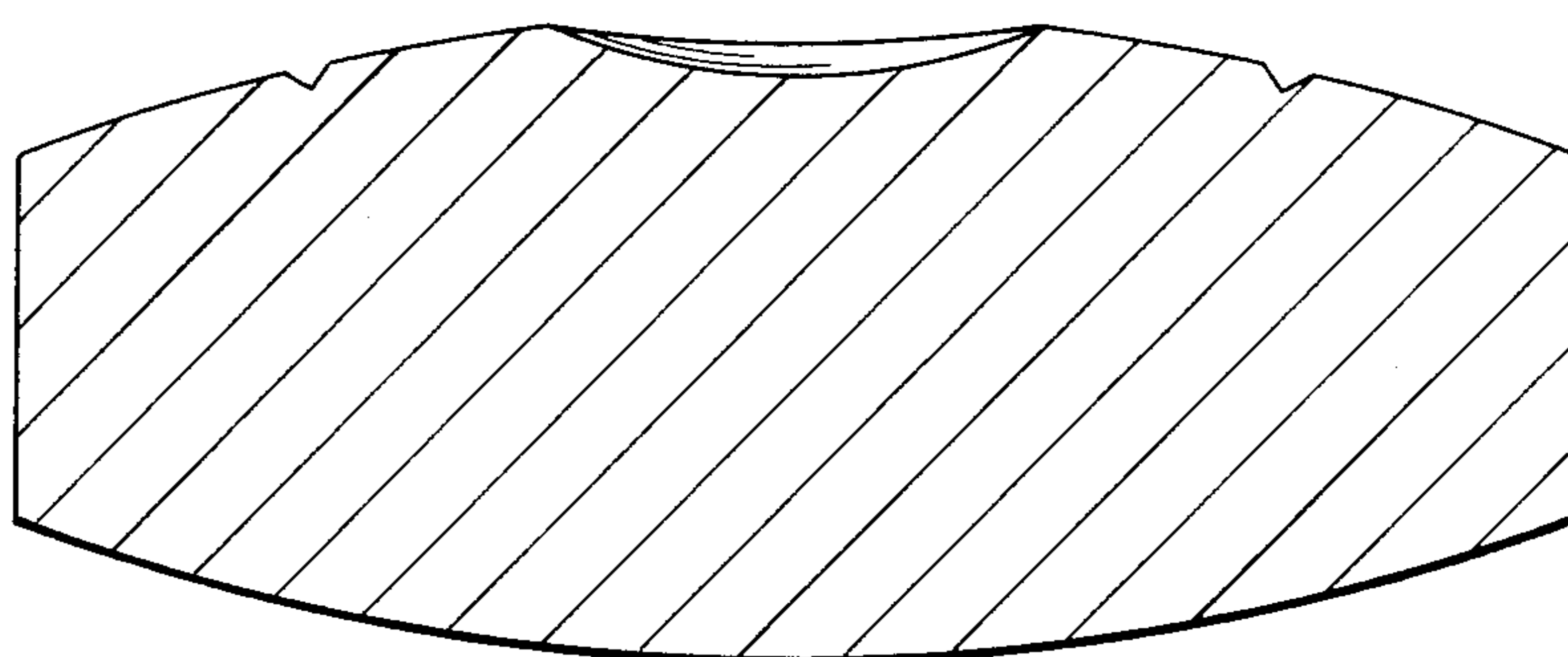
