FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an exercise leotard showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;

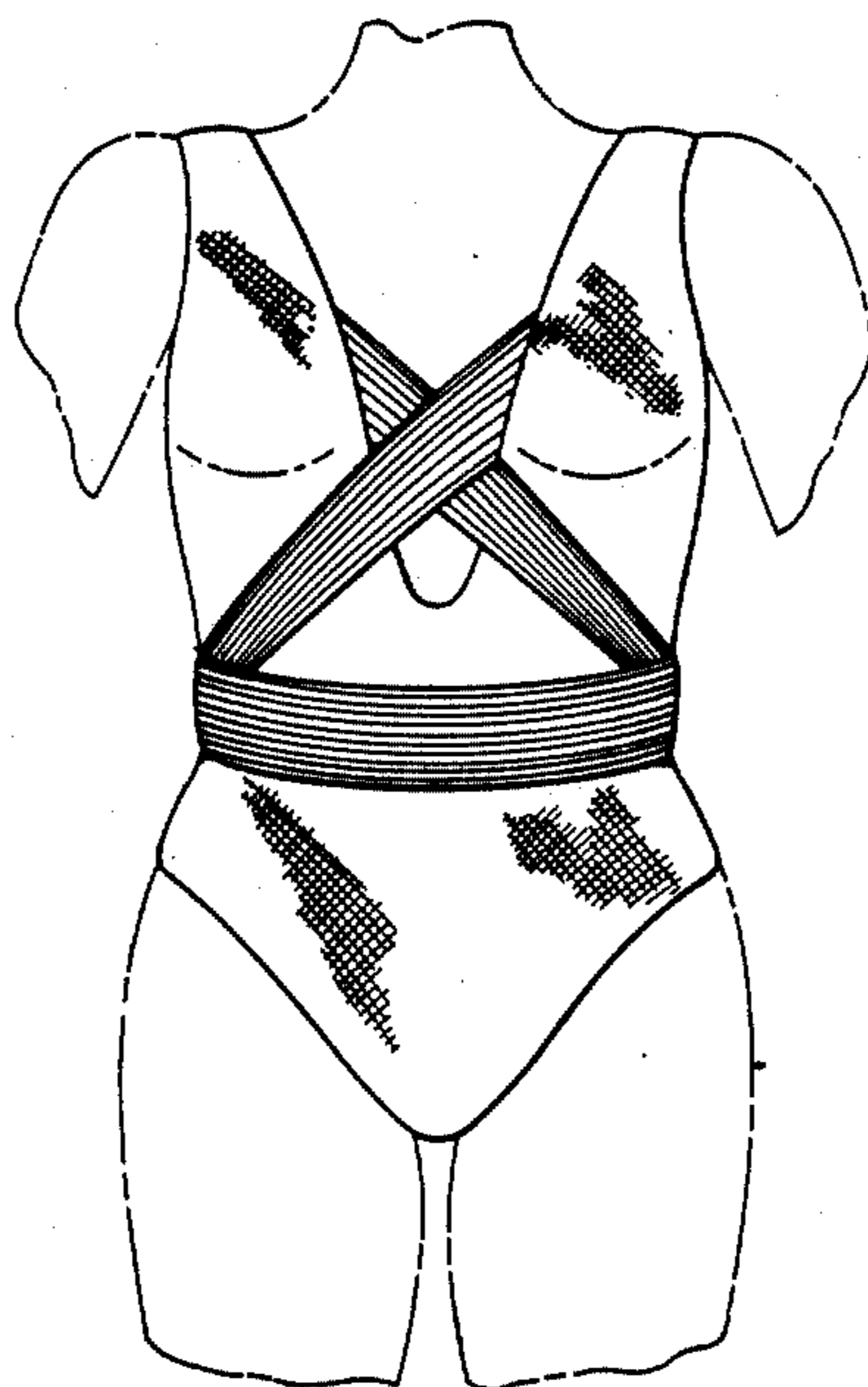
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

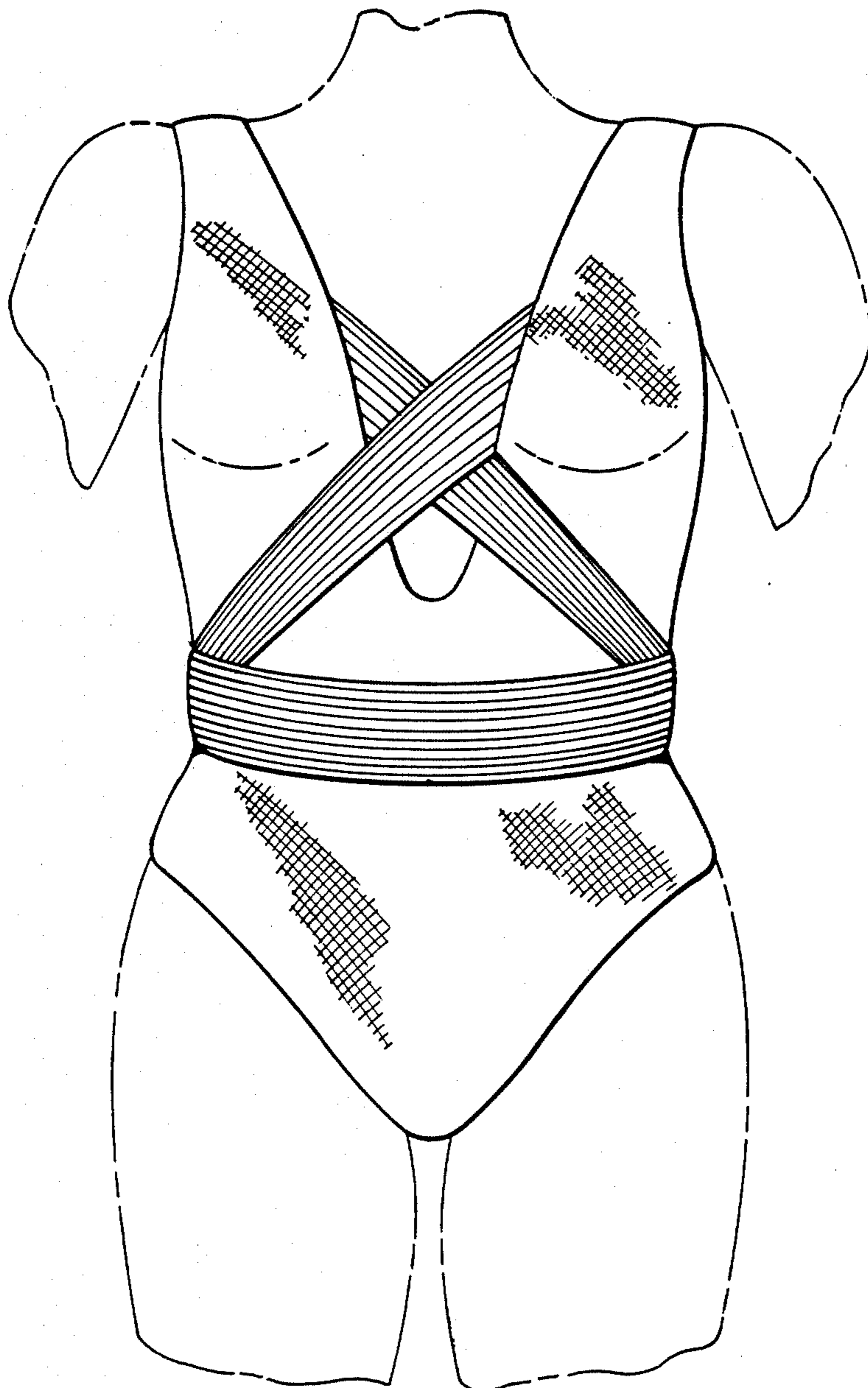
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of that shown in FIG. 4; and

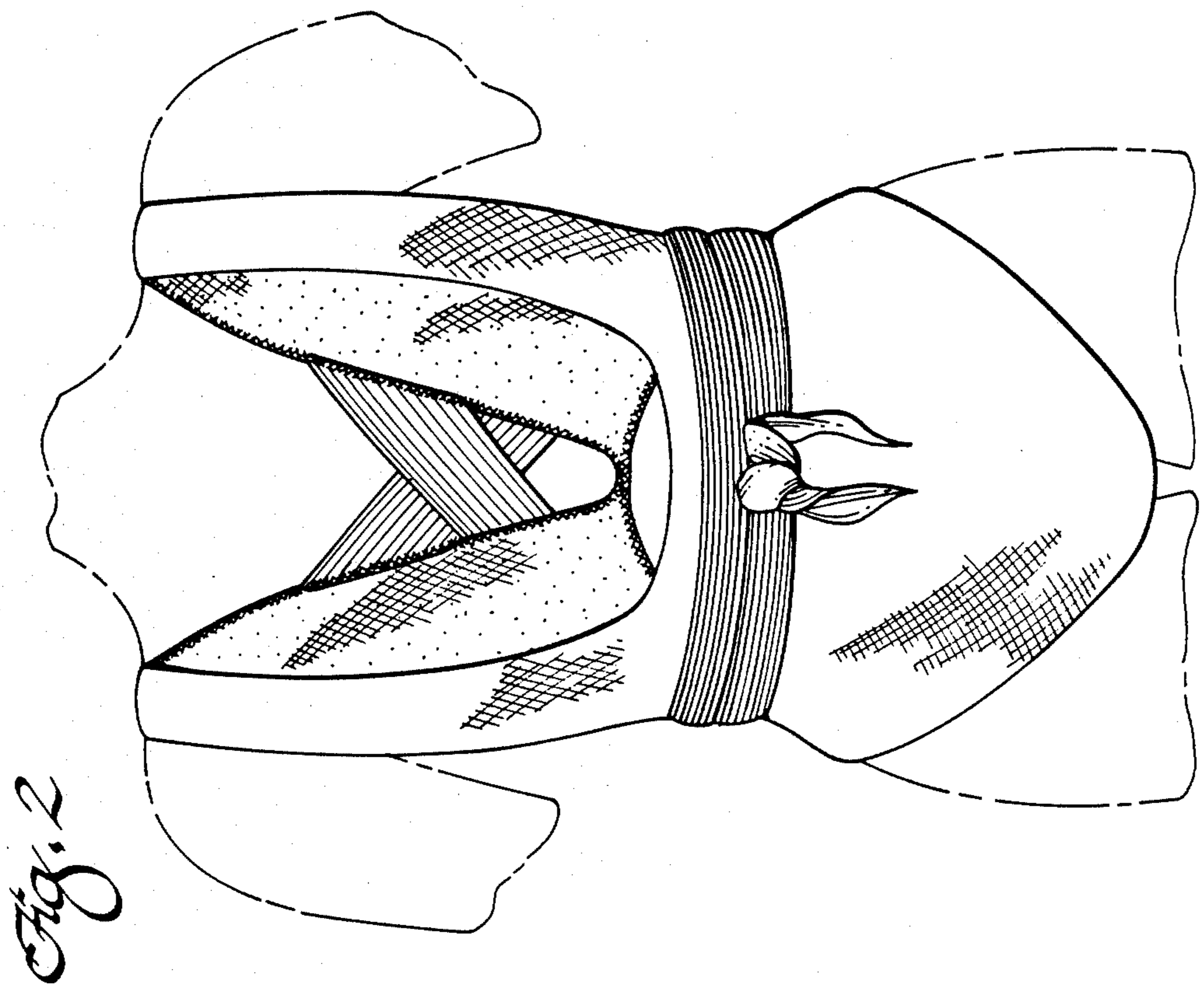
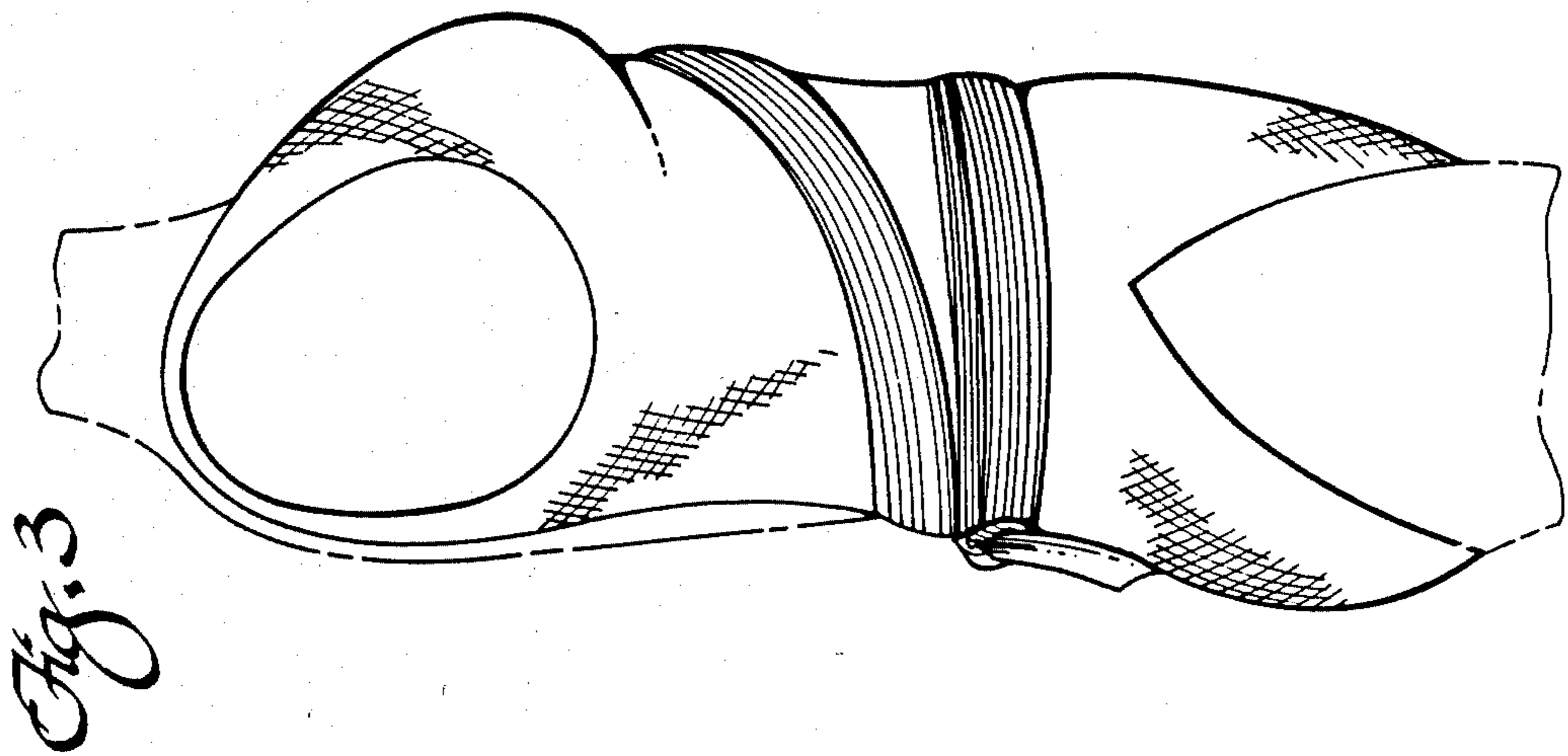
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of that shown in FIG. 4.

The human figure is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



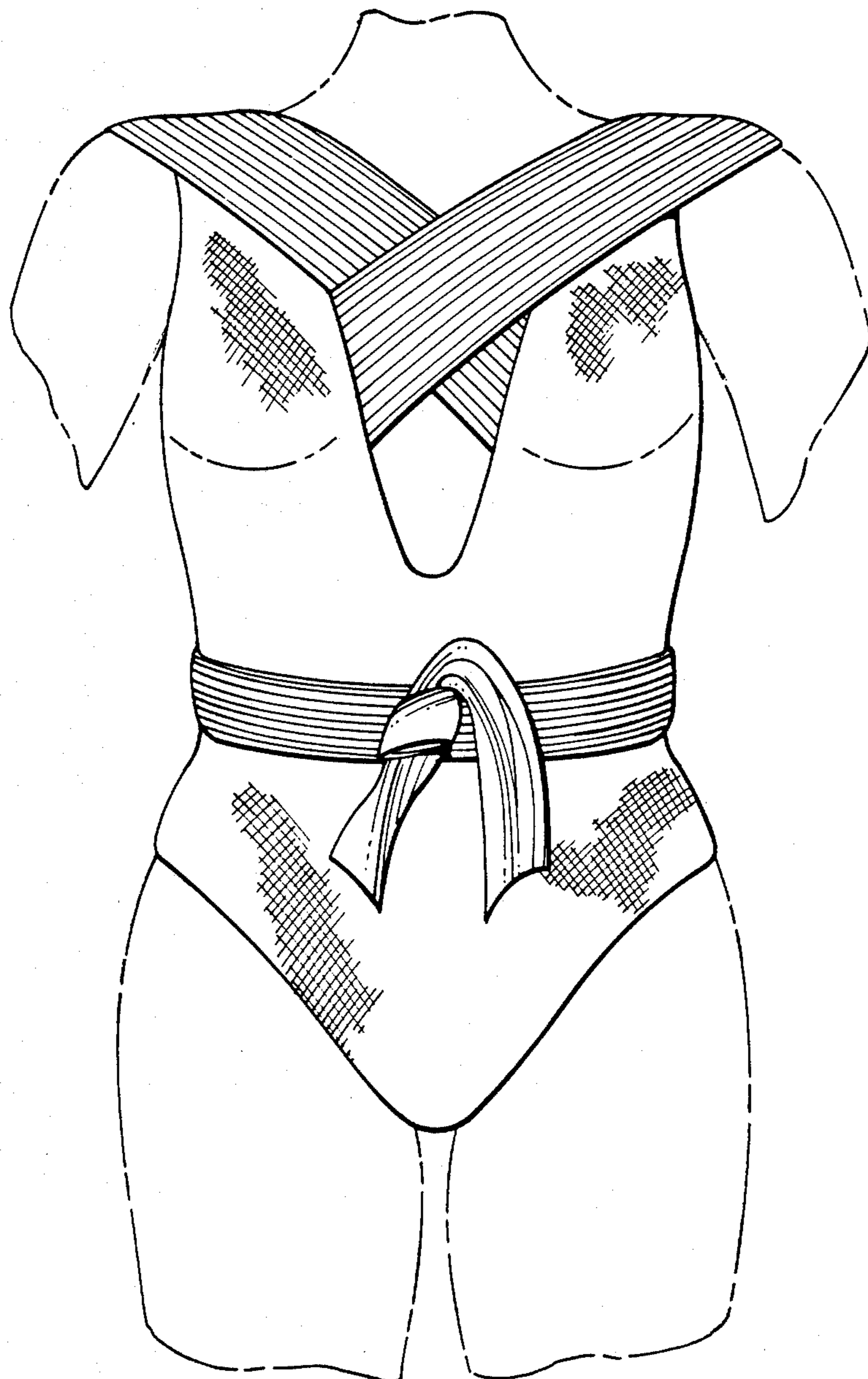

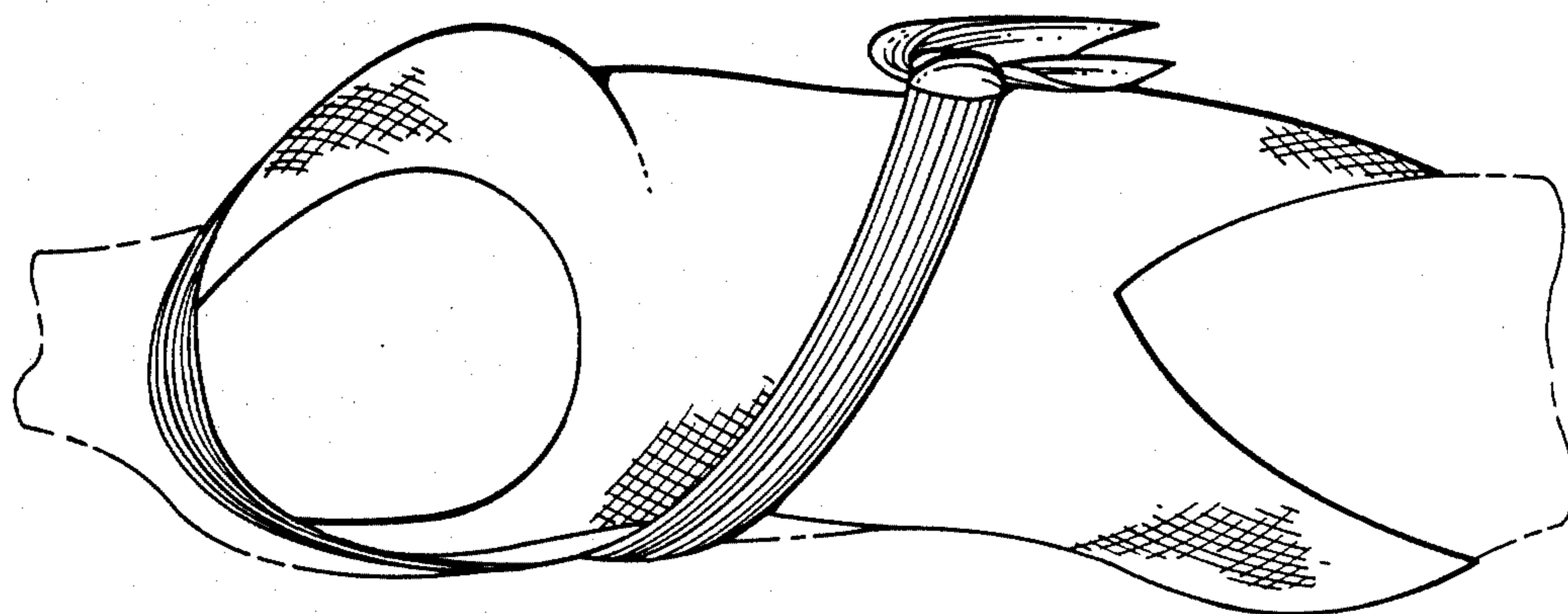

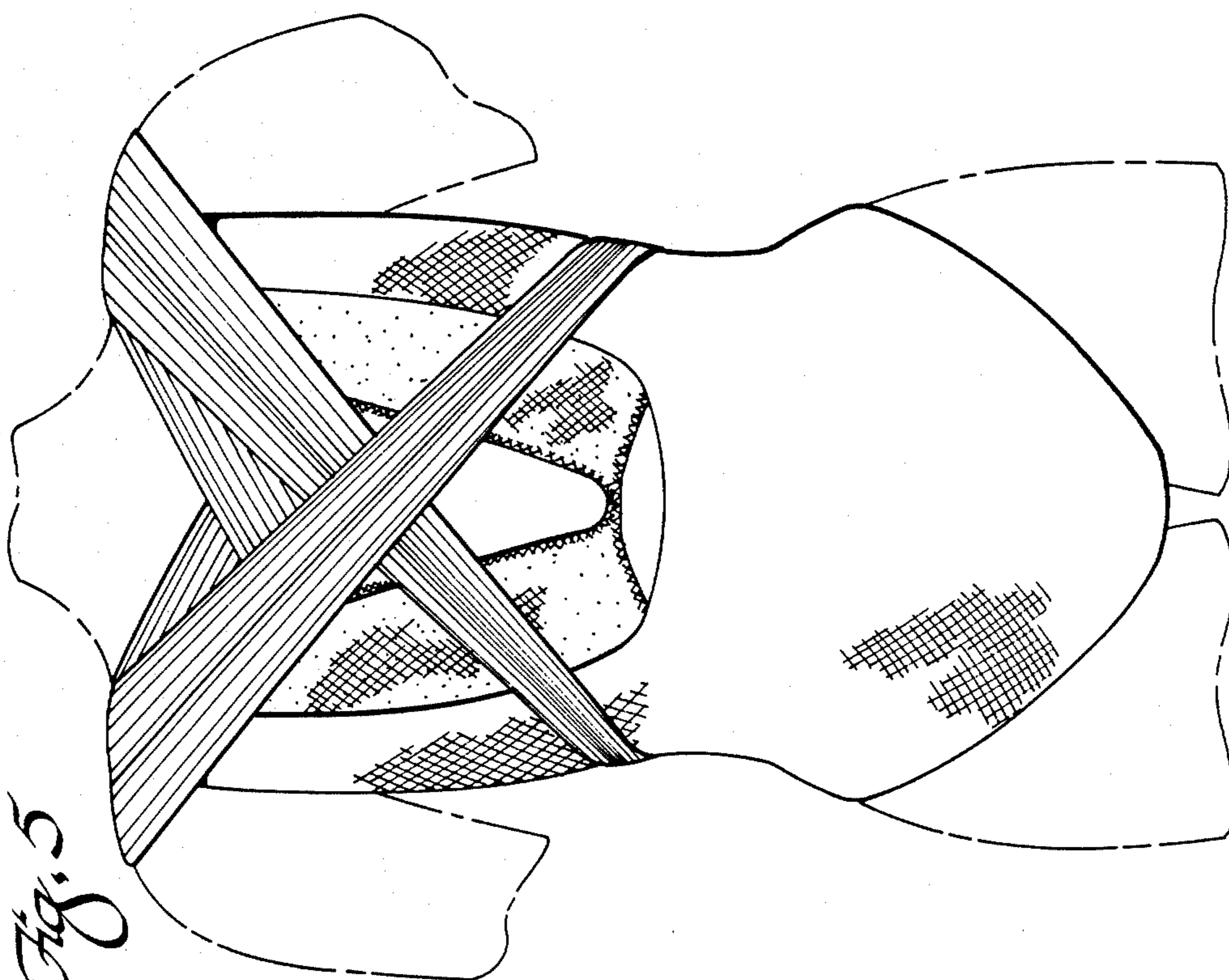
