DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a seating unit showing my design;

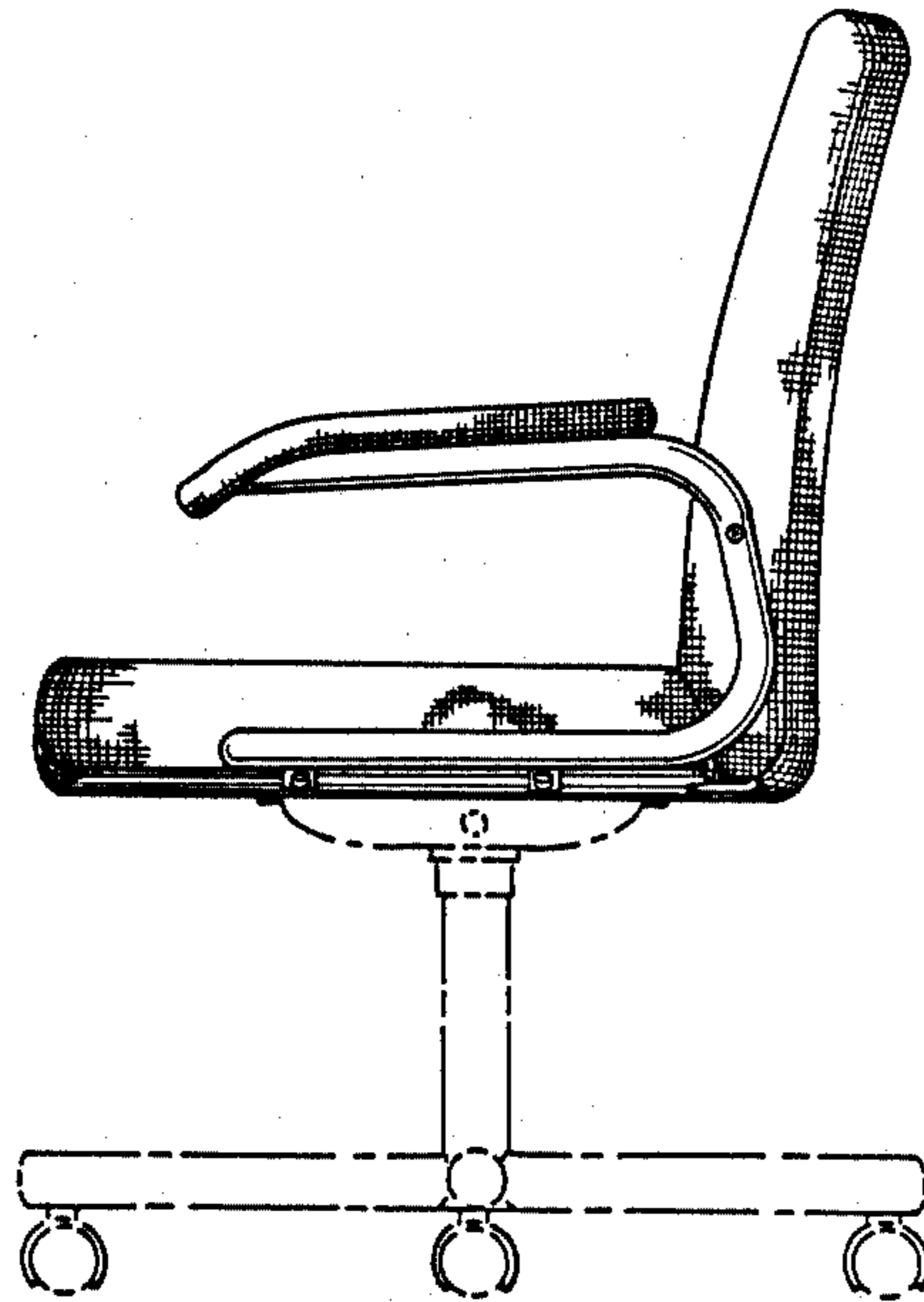
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

The broken lines depicting a pedestal in FIGS. 1 and 2 have been shown for illustrative purposes only.



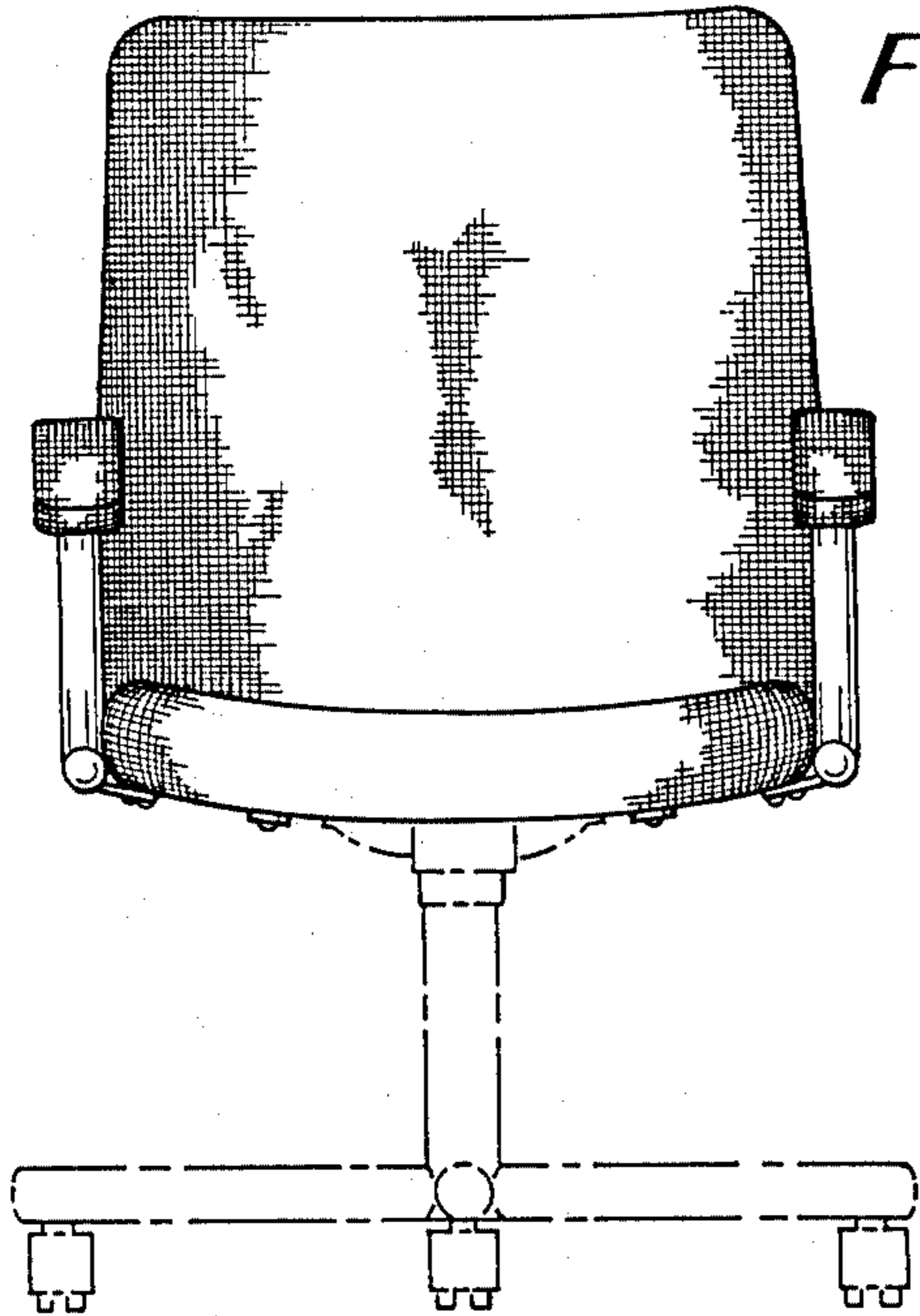

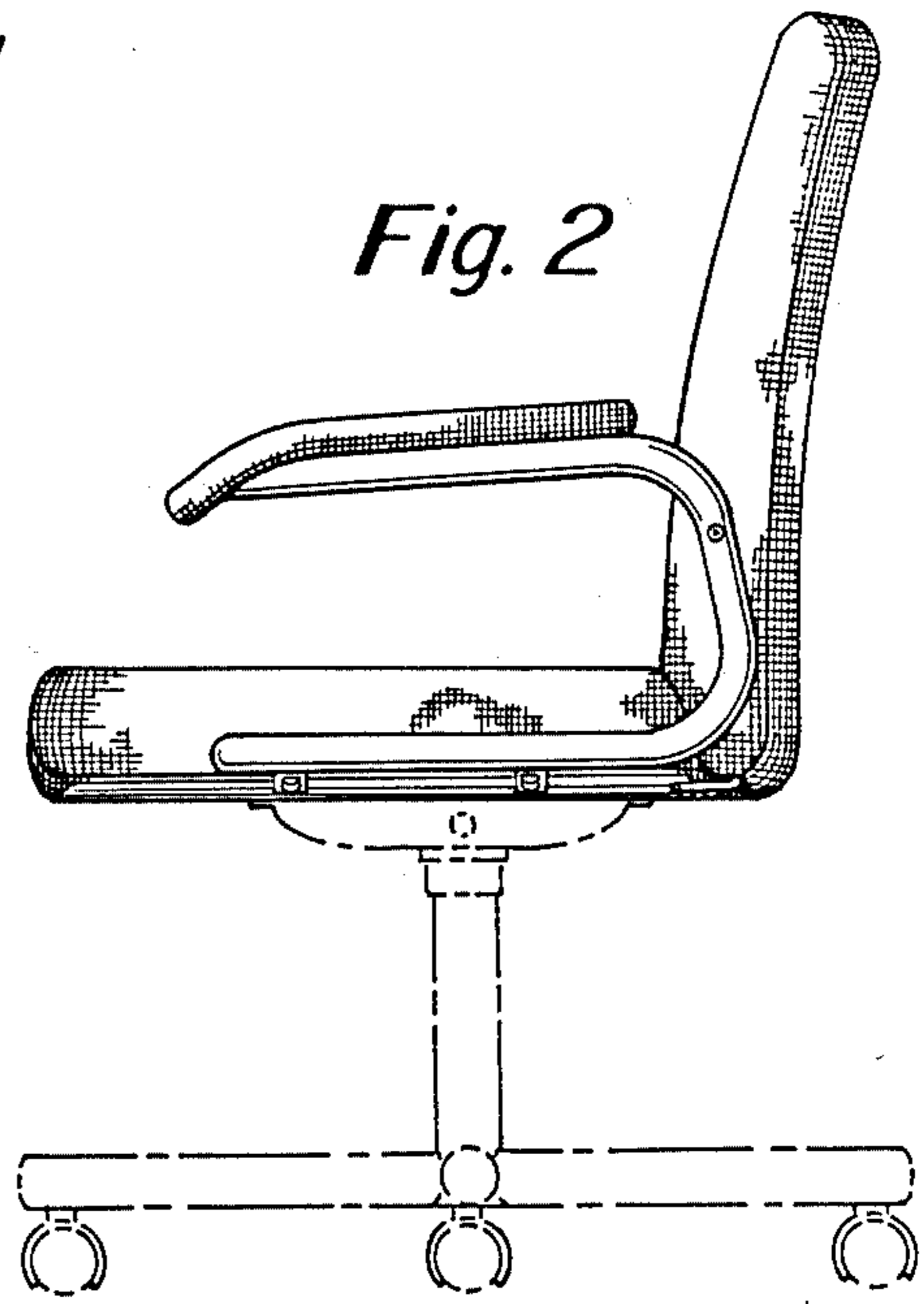

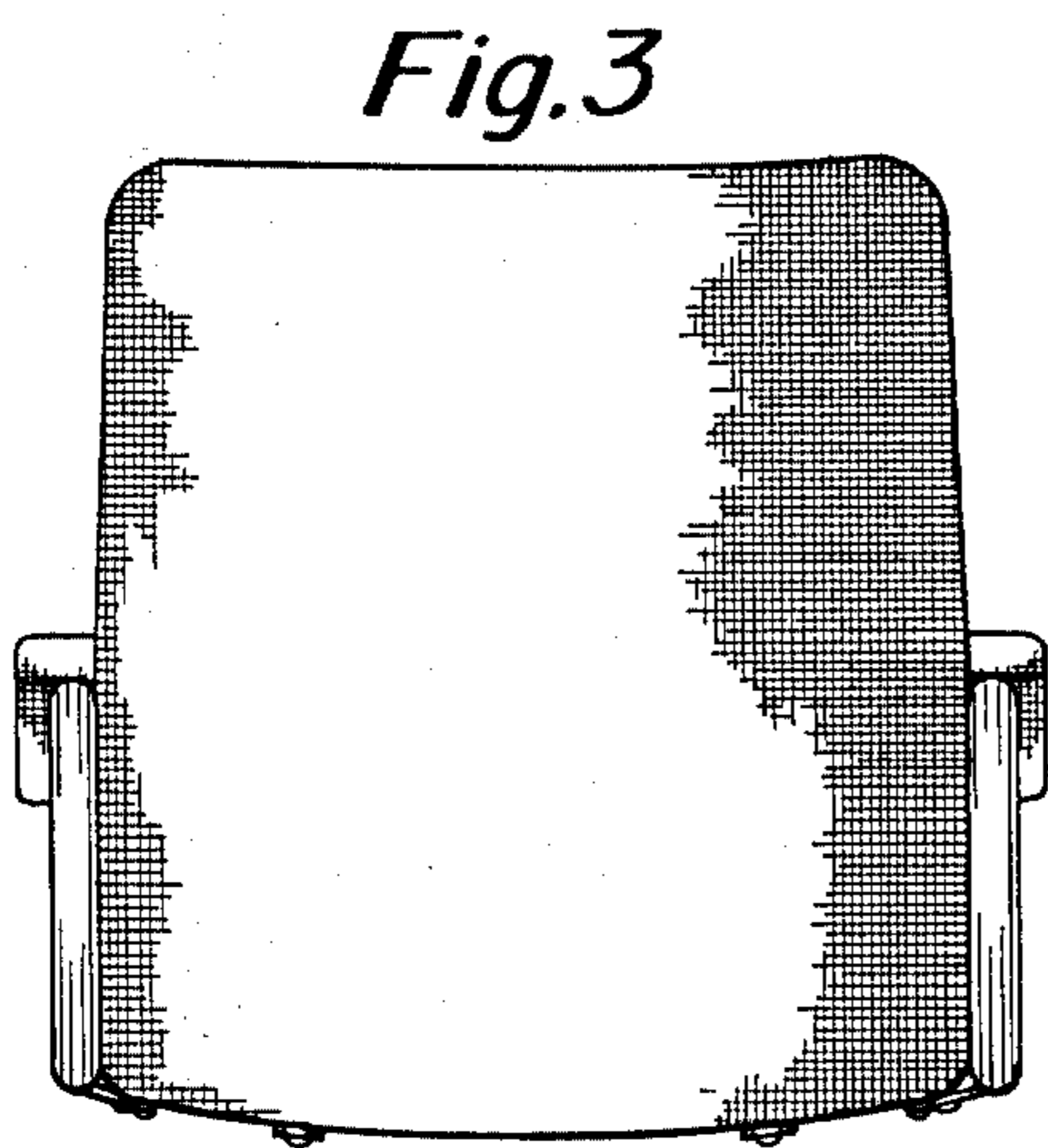

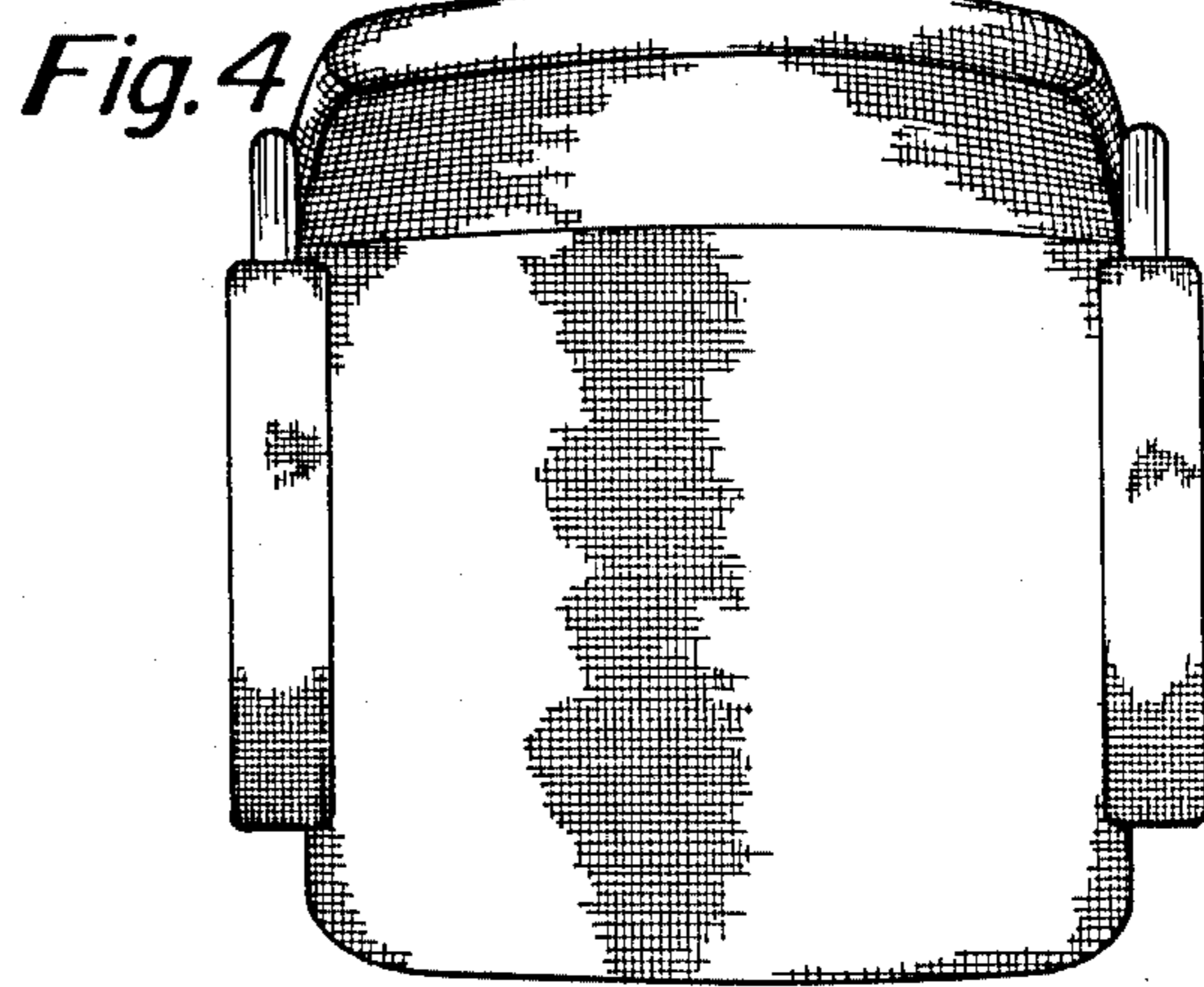

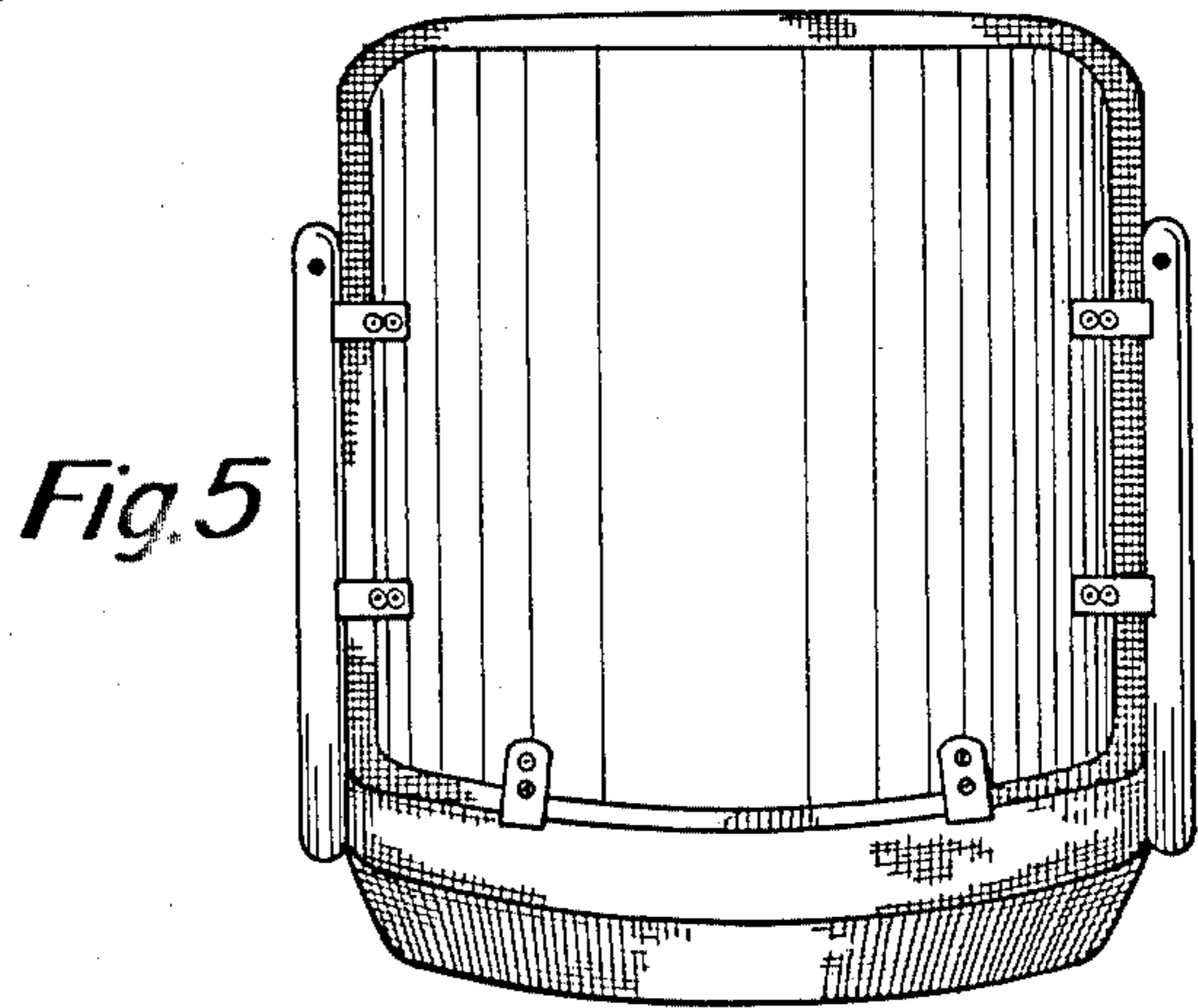
