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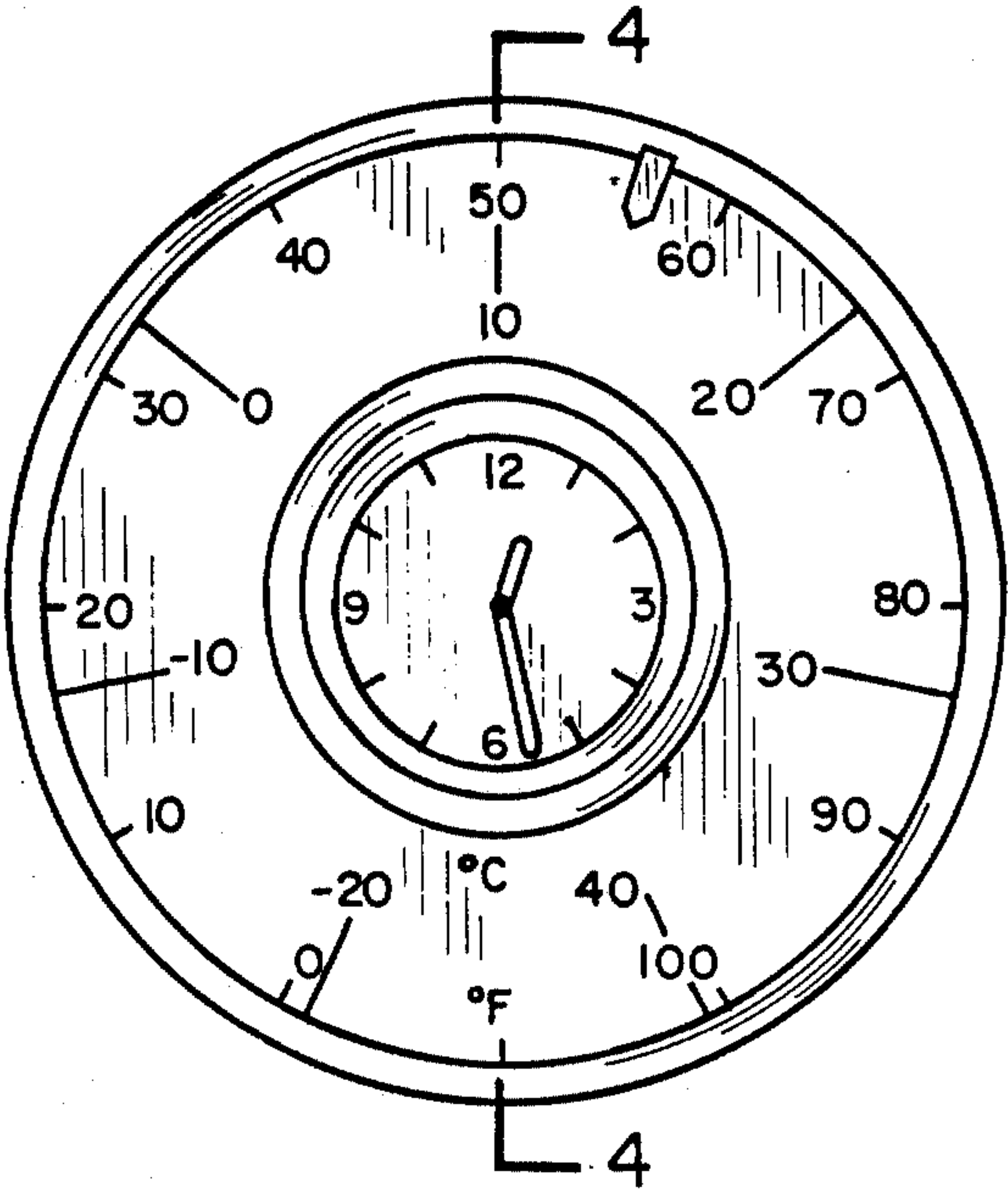

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined clock and thermometer showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, this right side, top and bottom sides are identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 4—4 of FIG. 1.



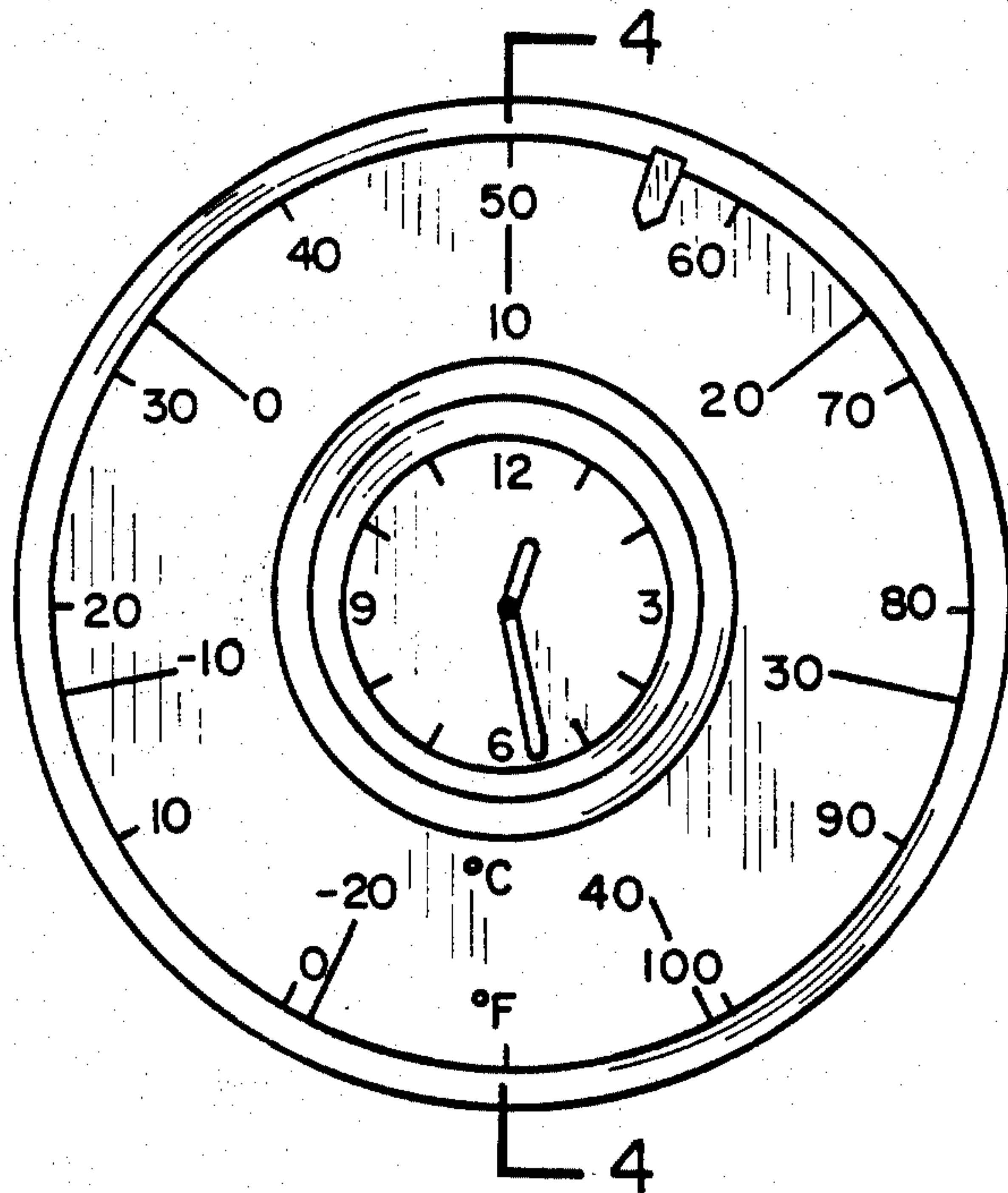

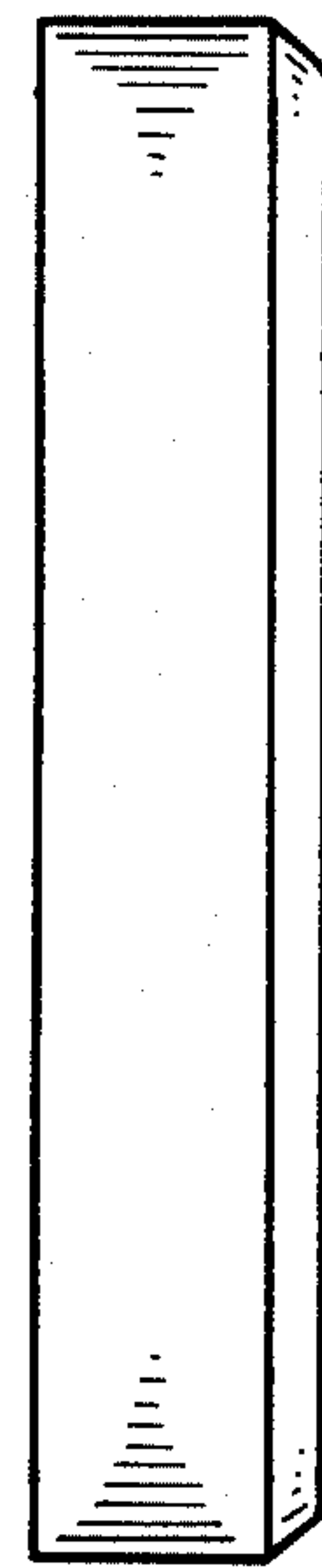

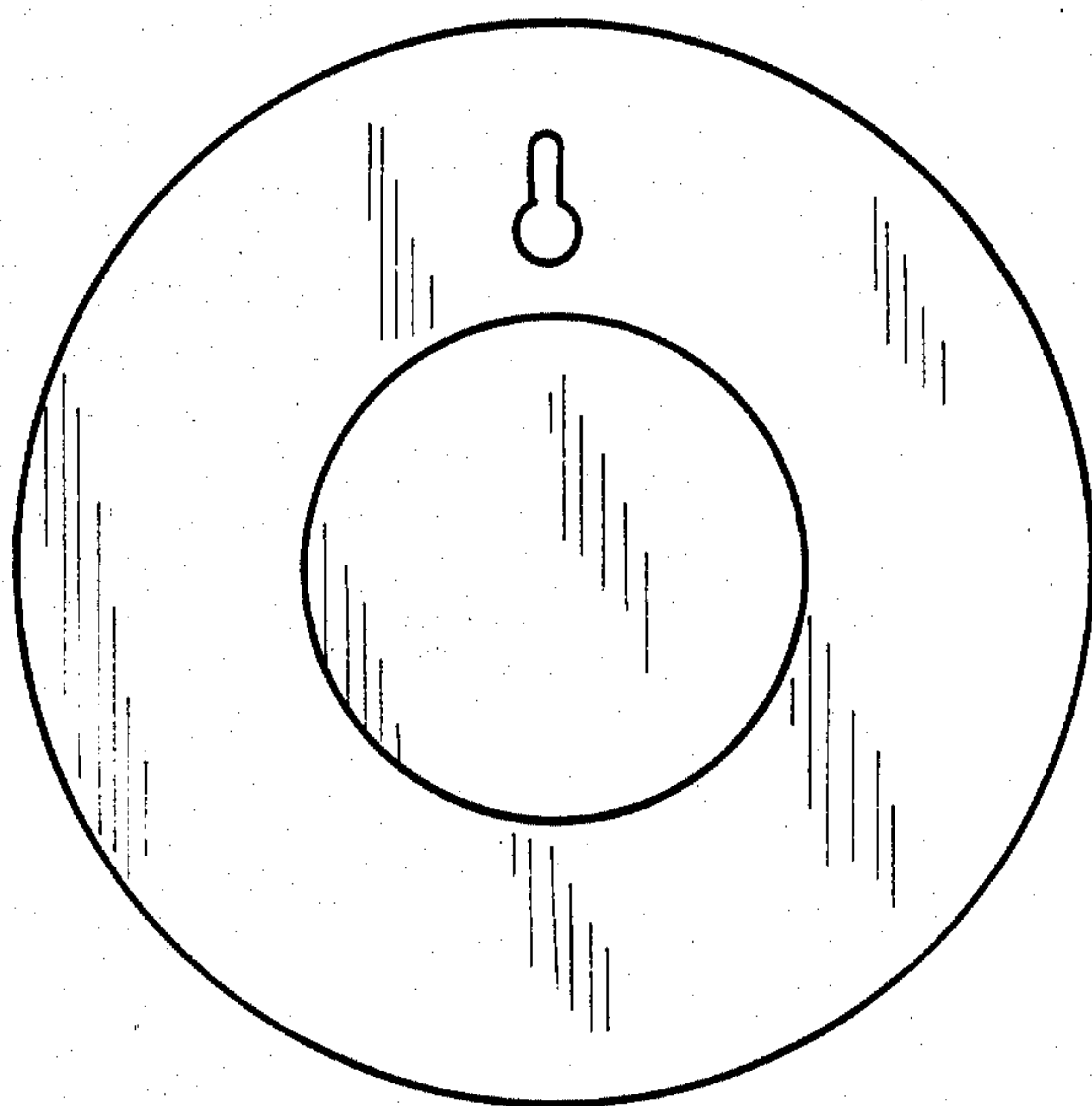
