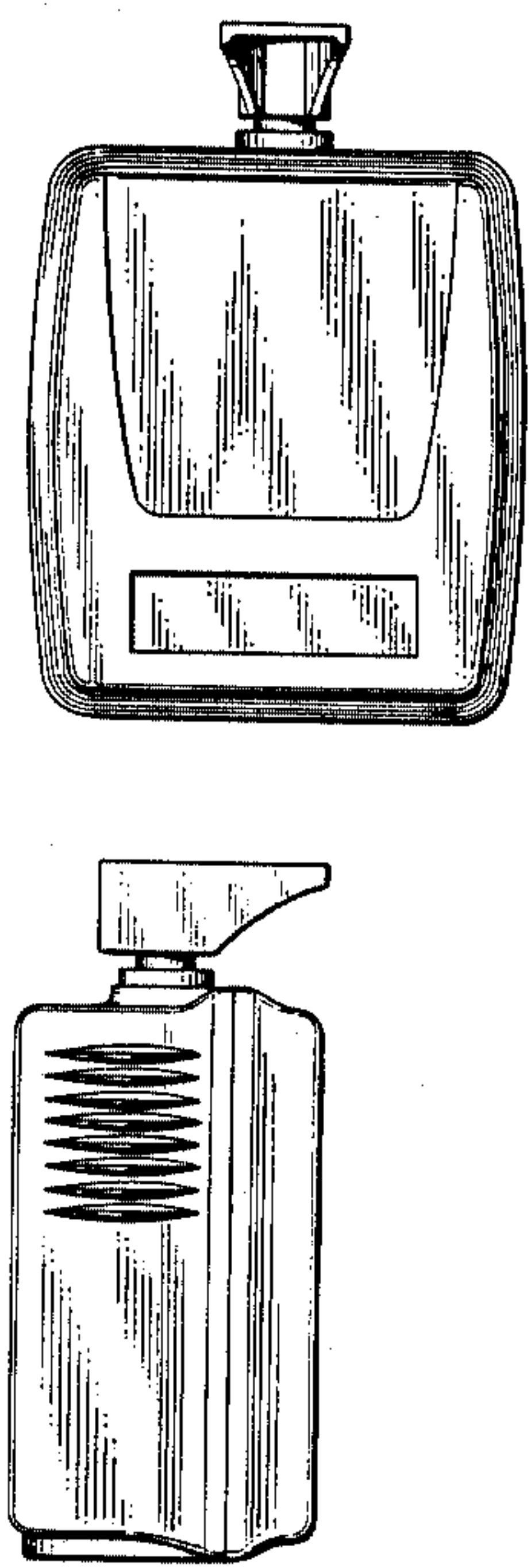

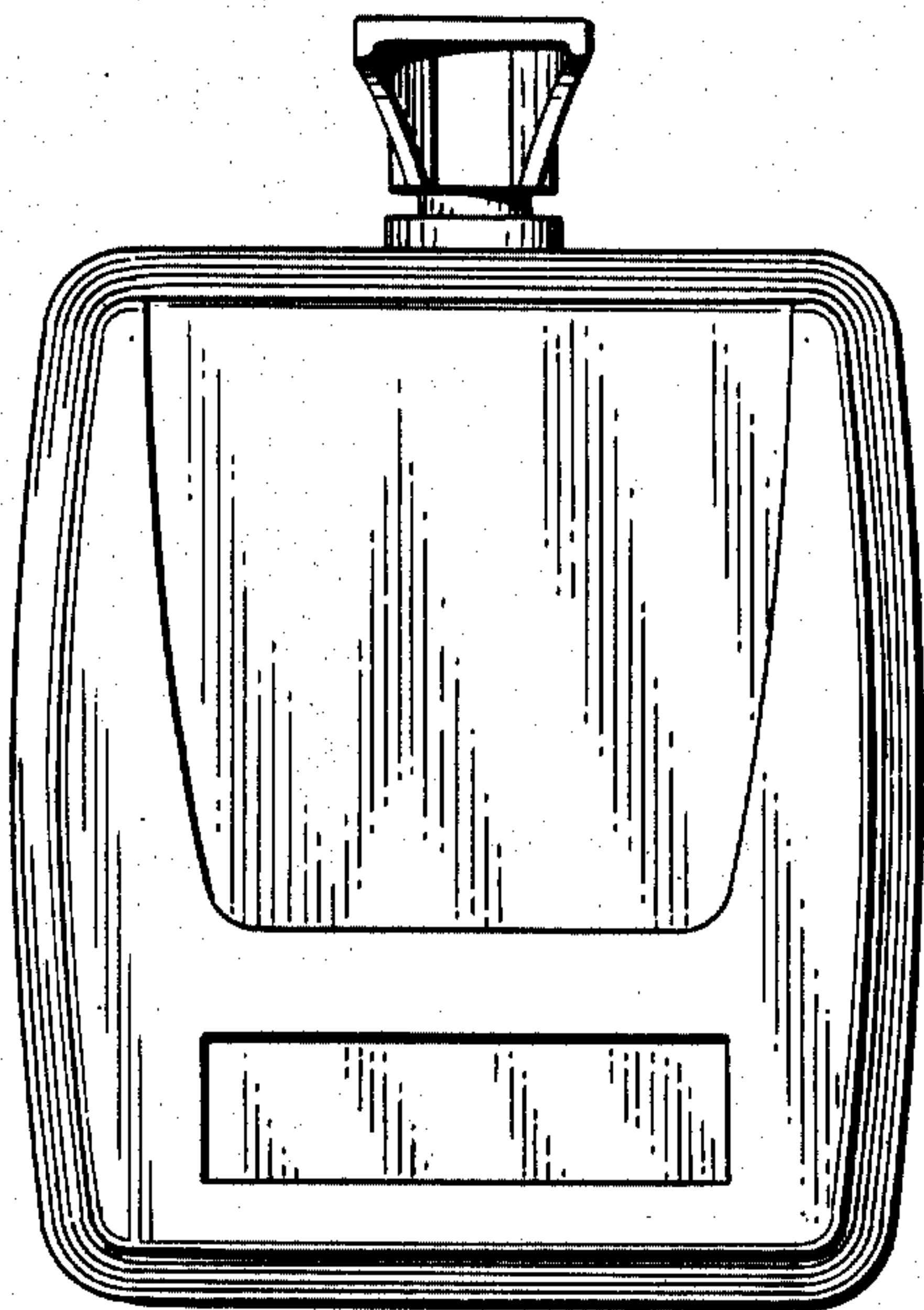

as shown and described.

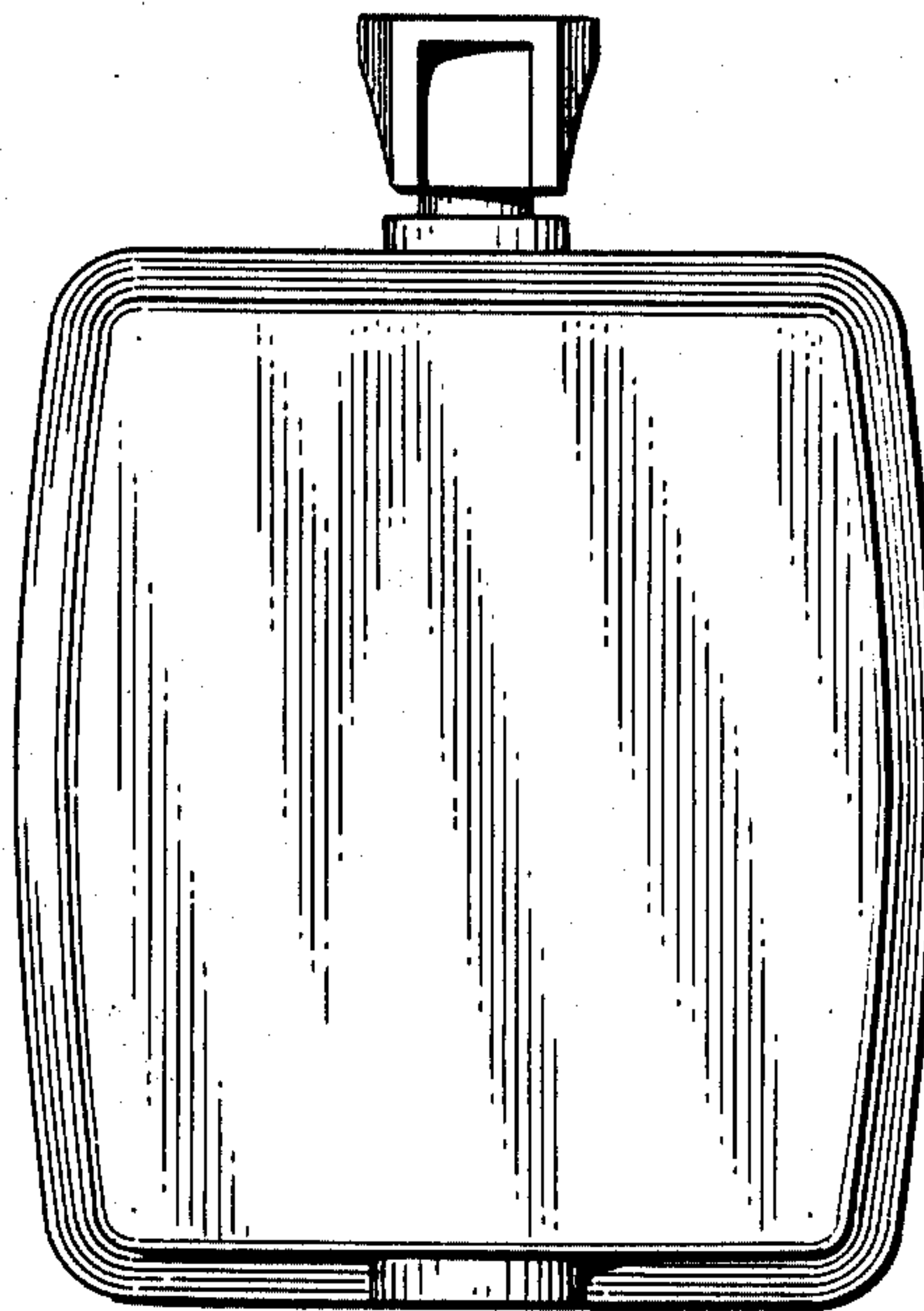
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof.

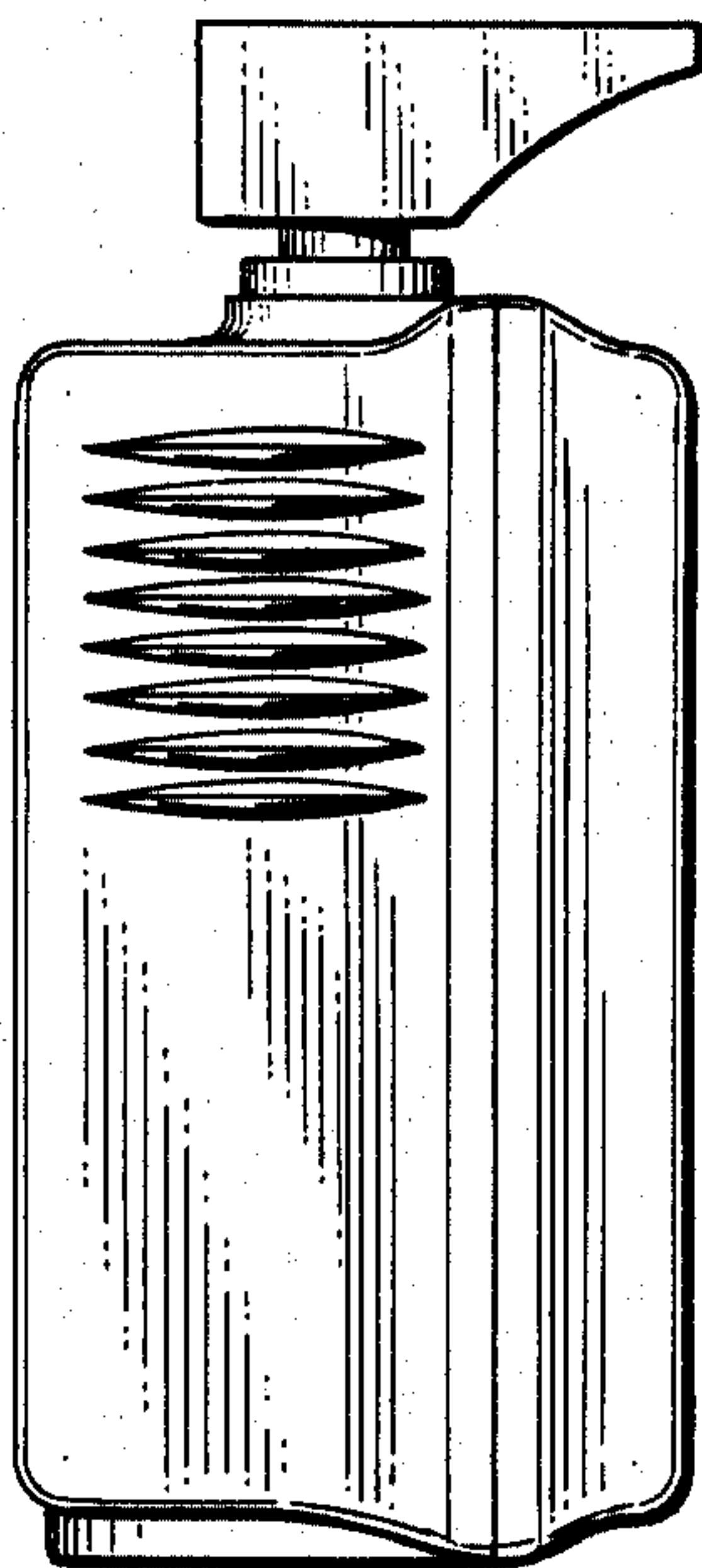




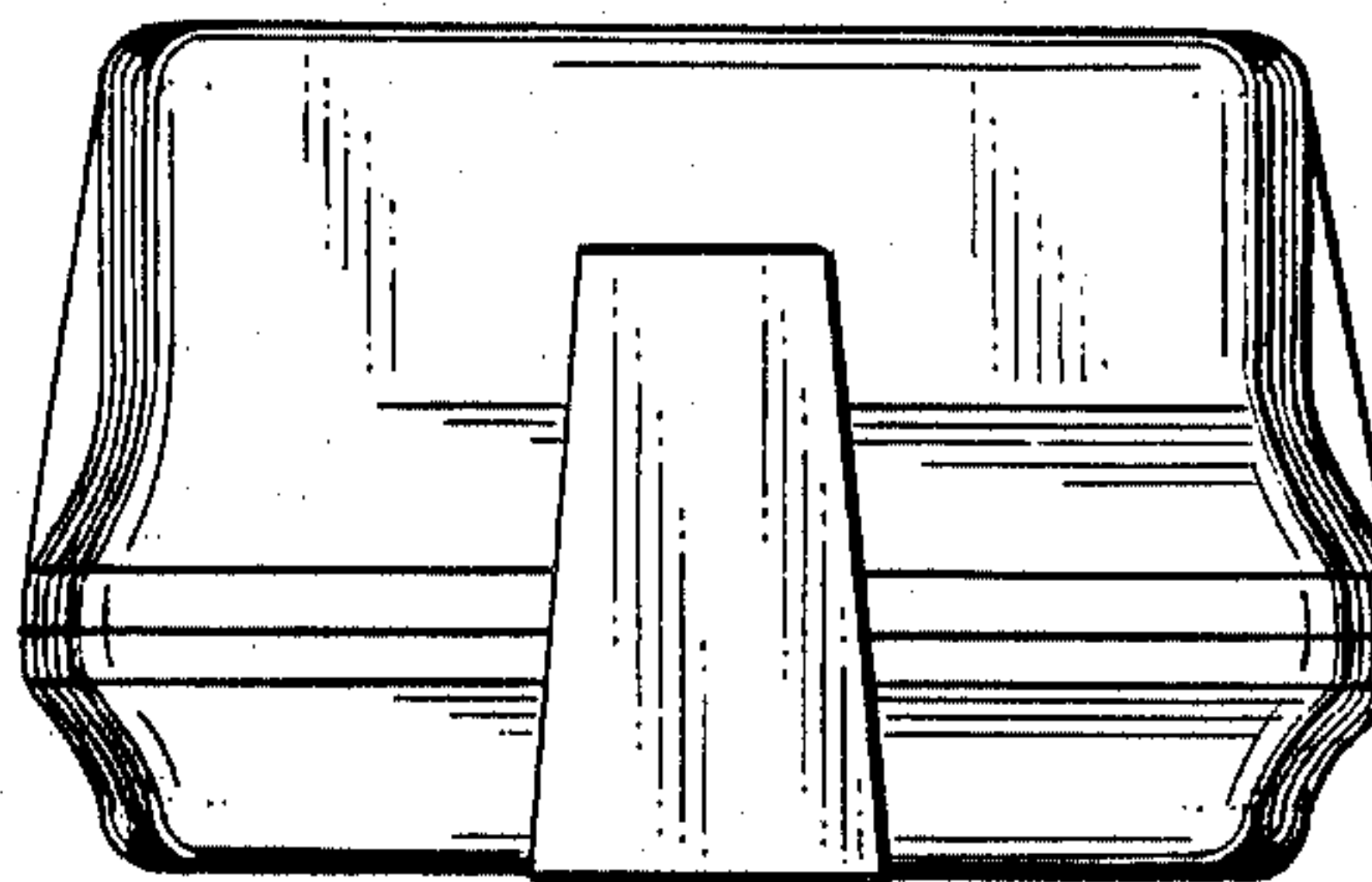

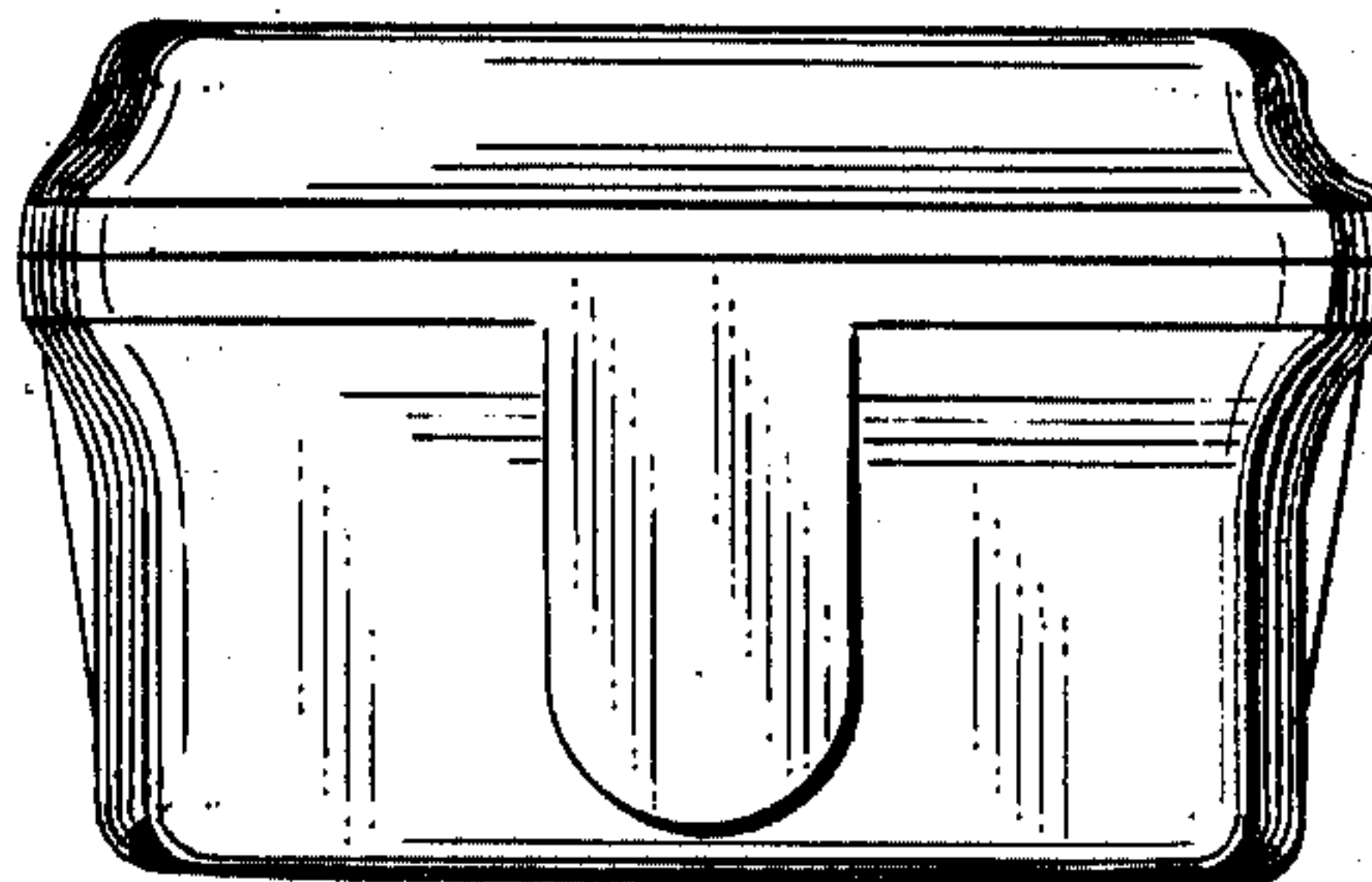

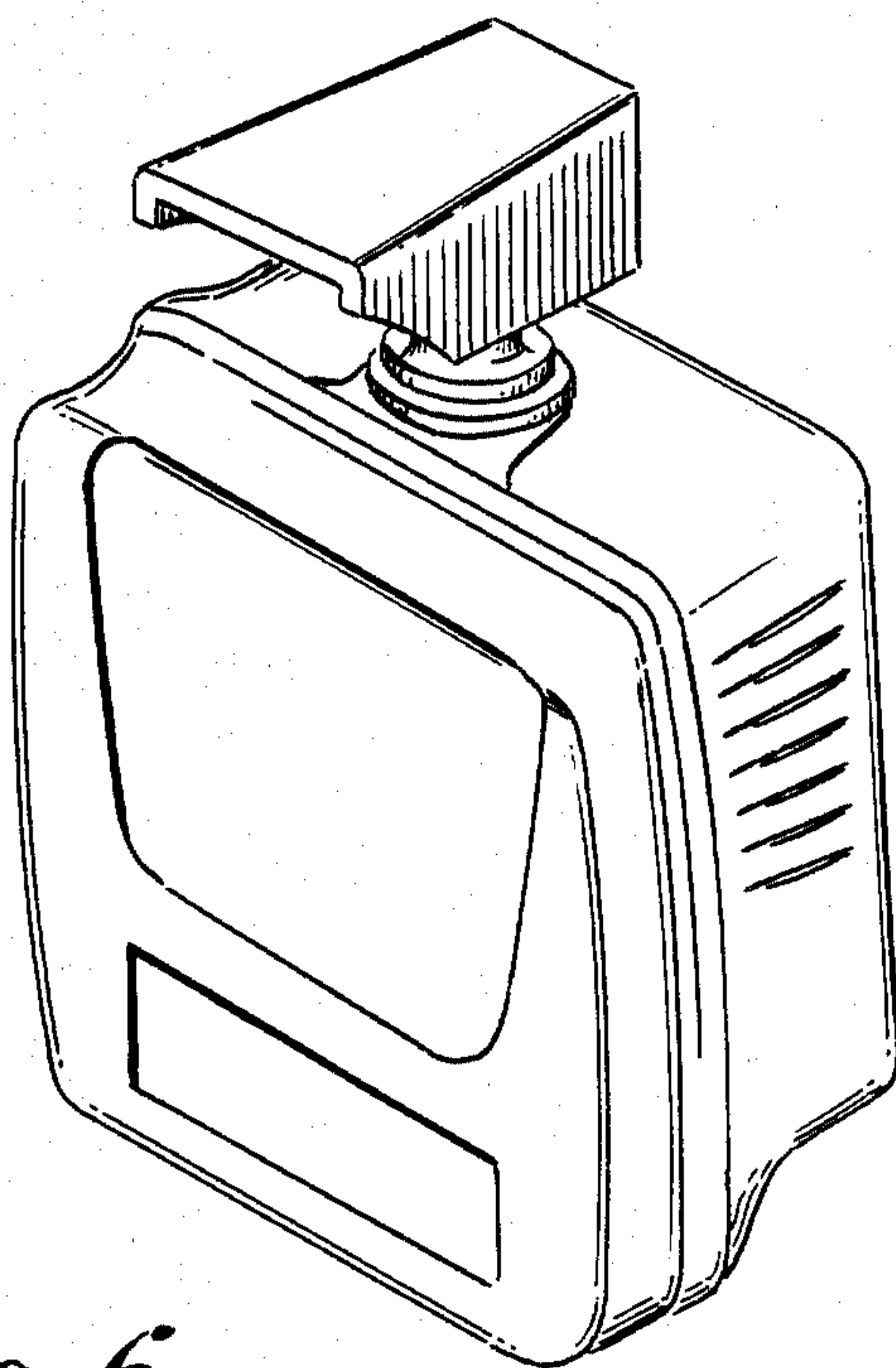

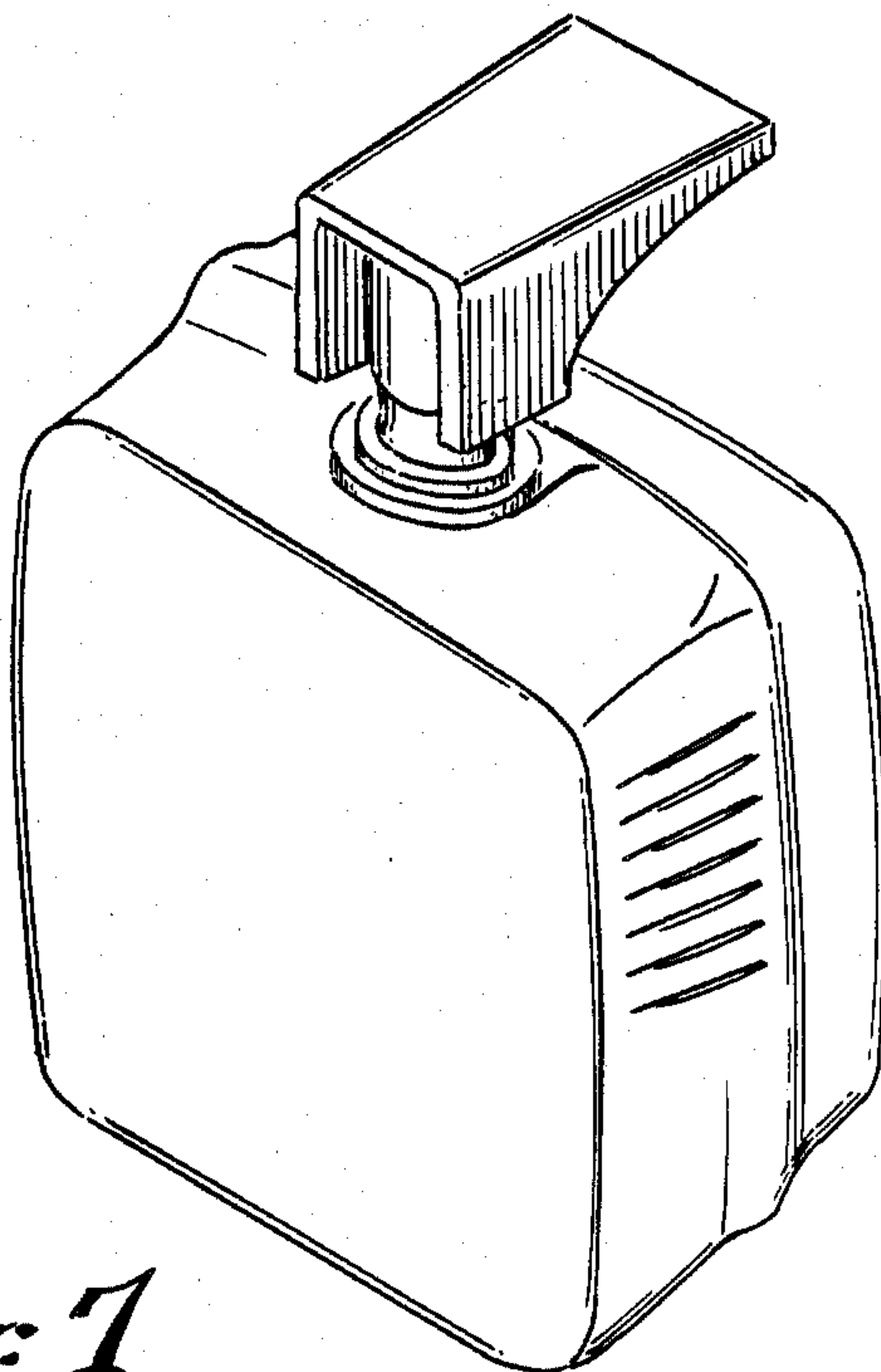
