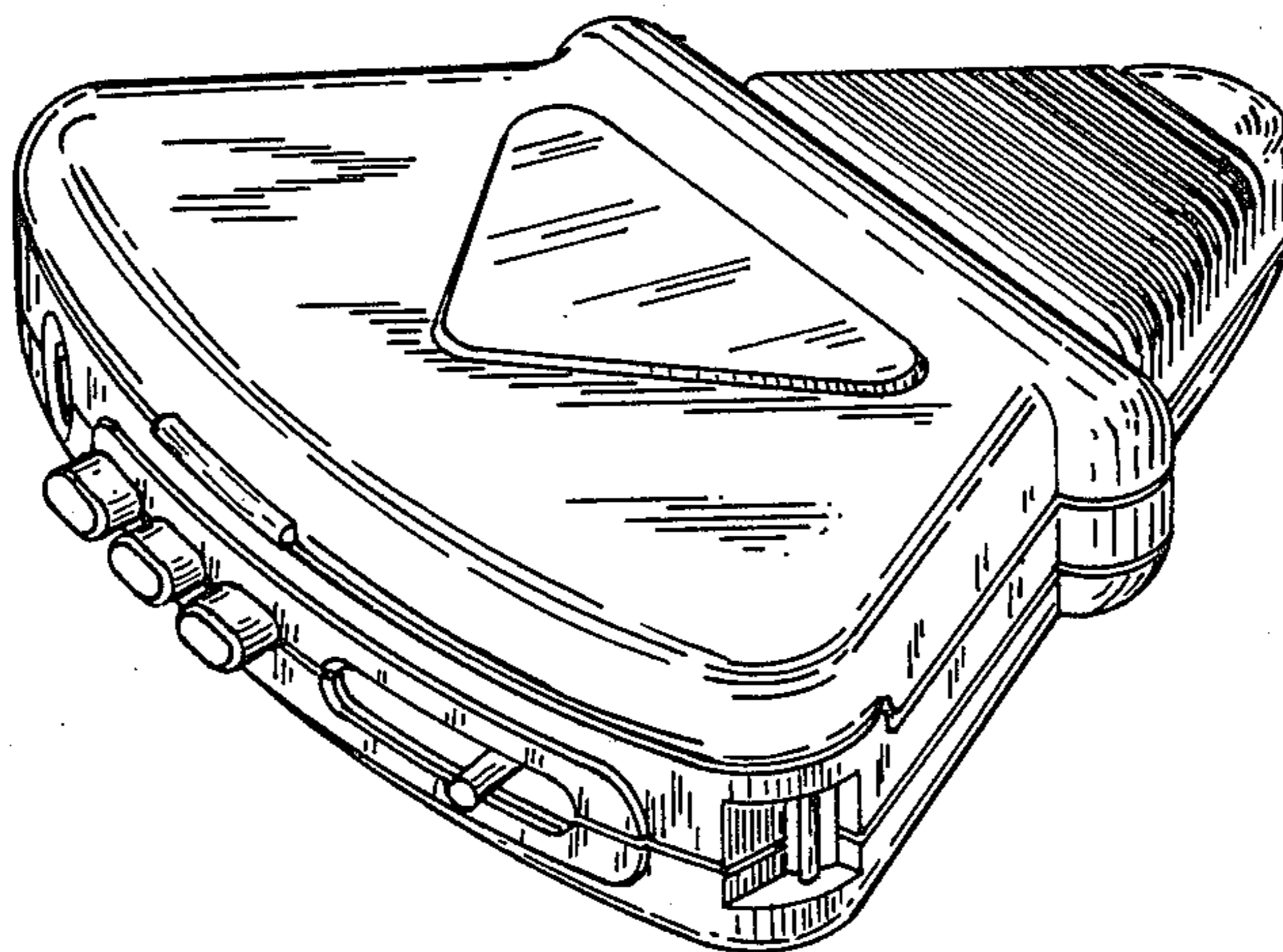

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a cassette-player showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



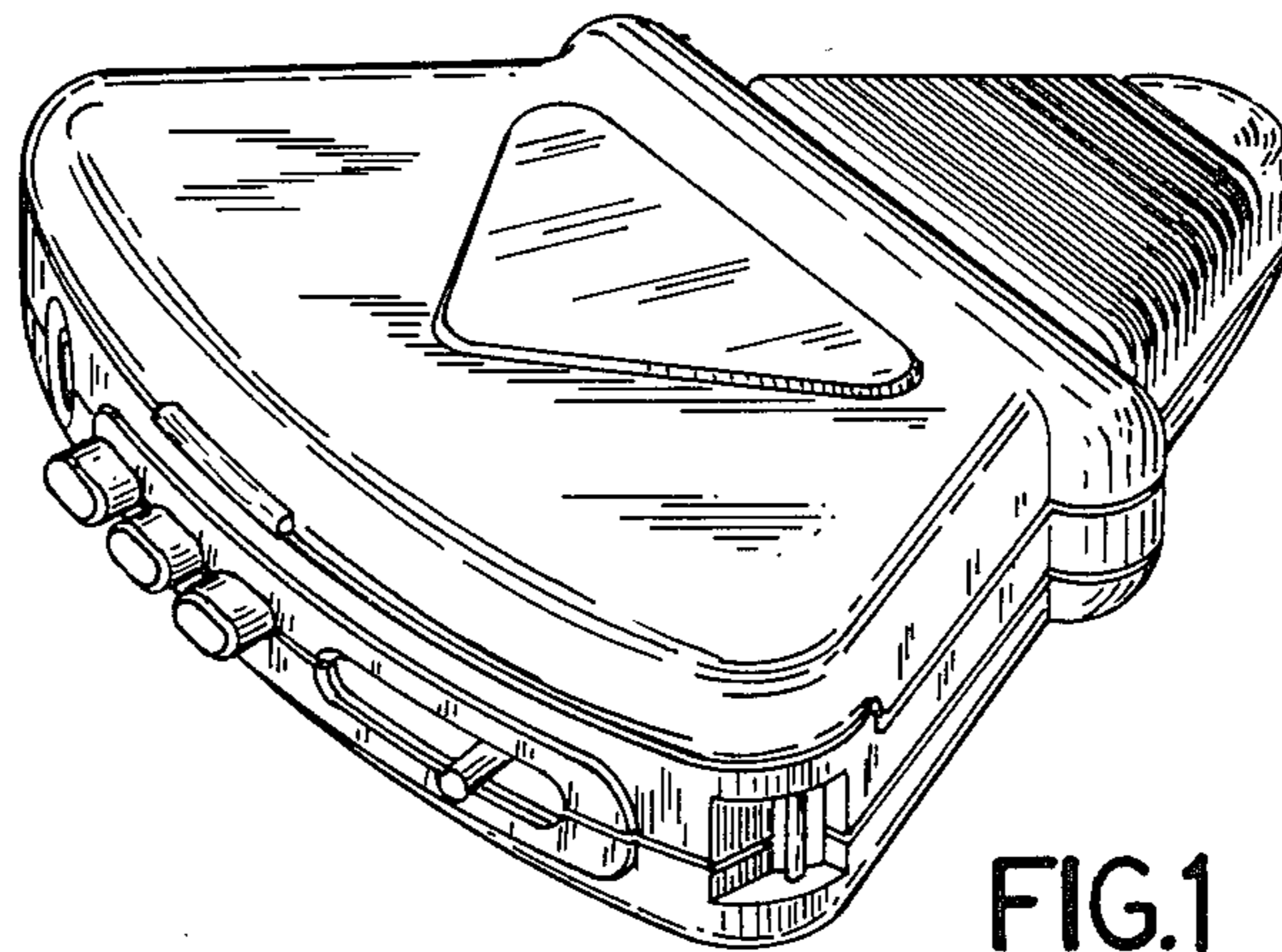

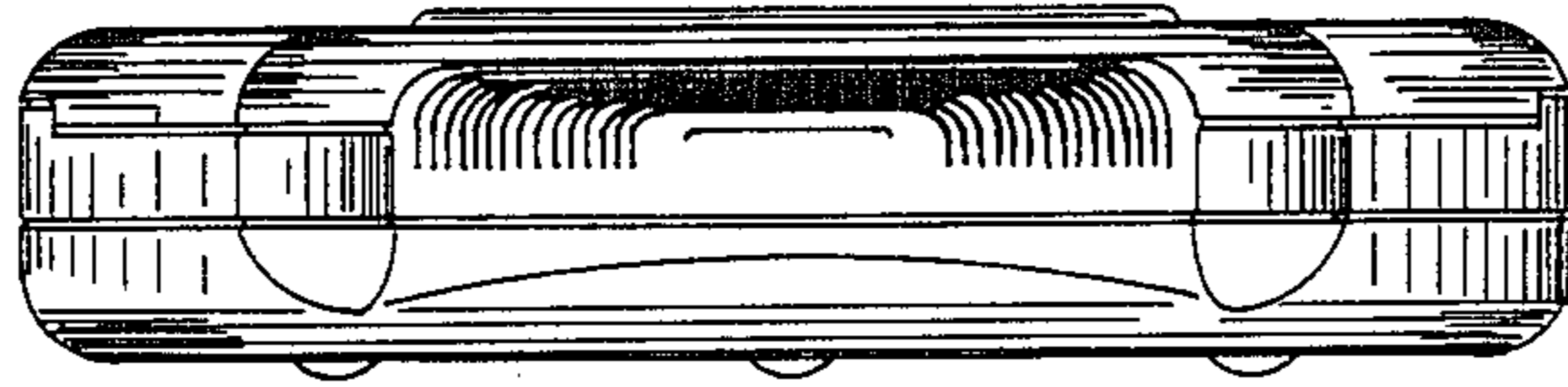

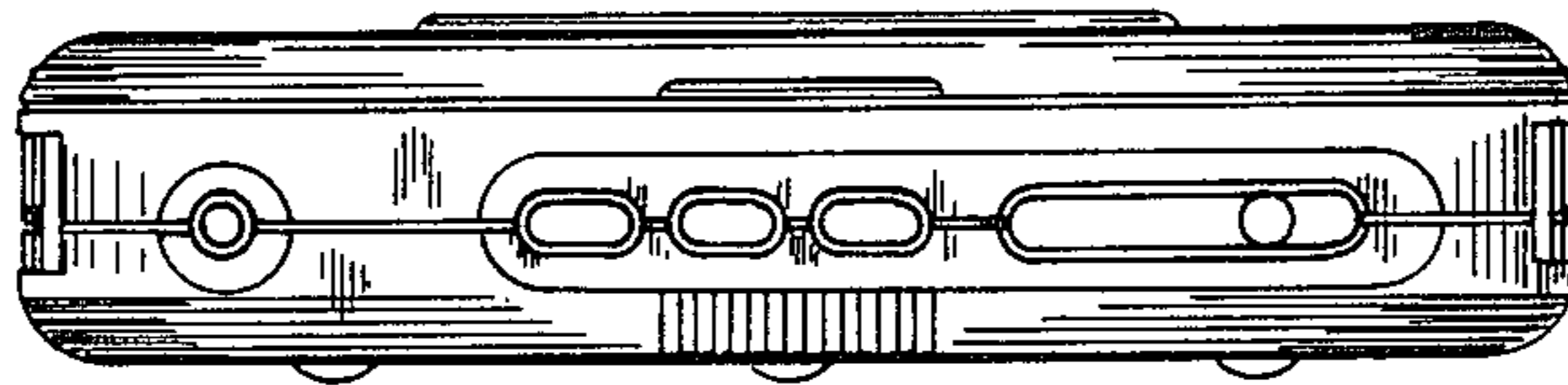

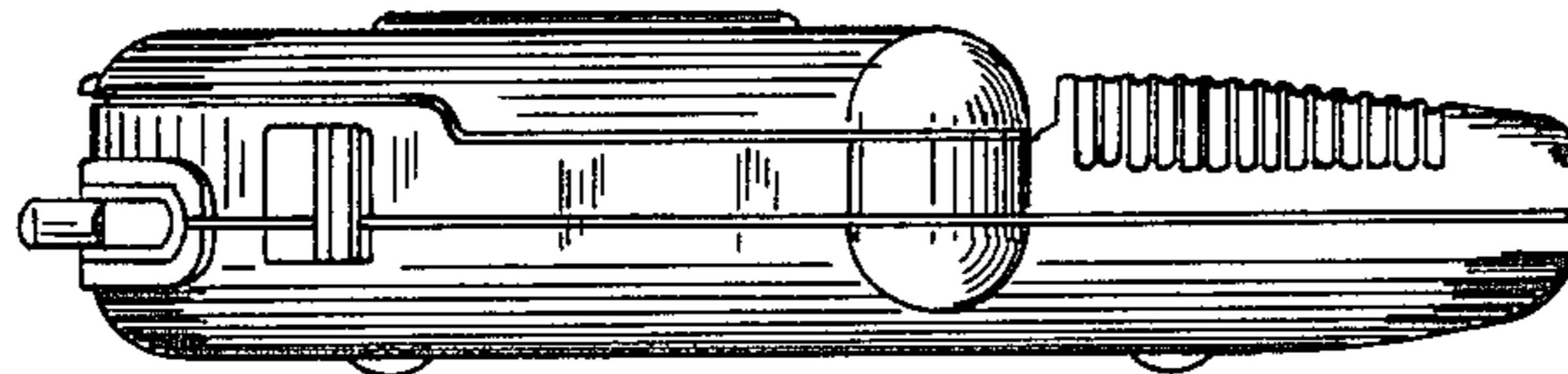

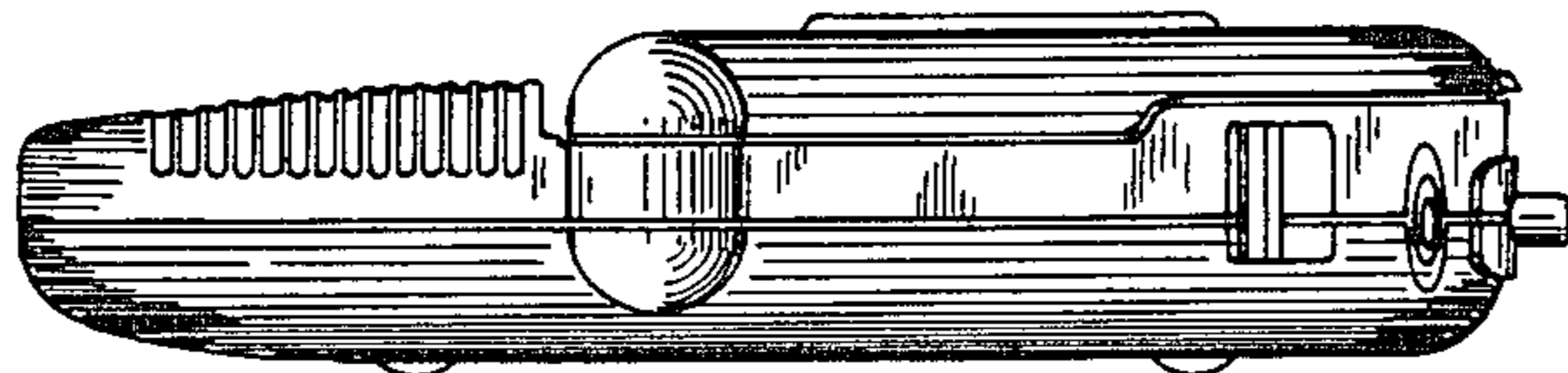

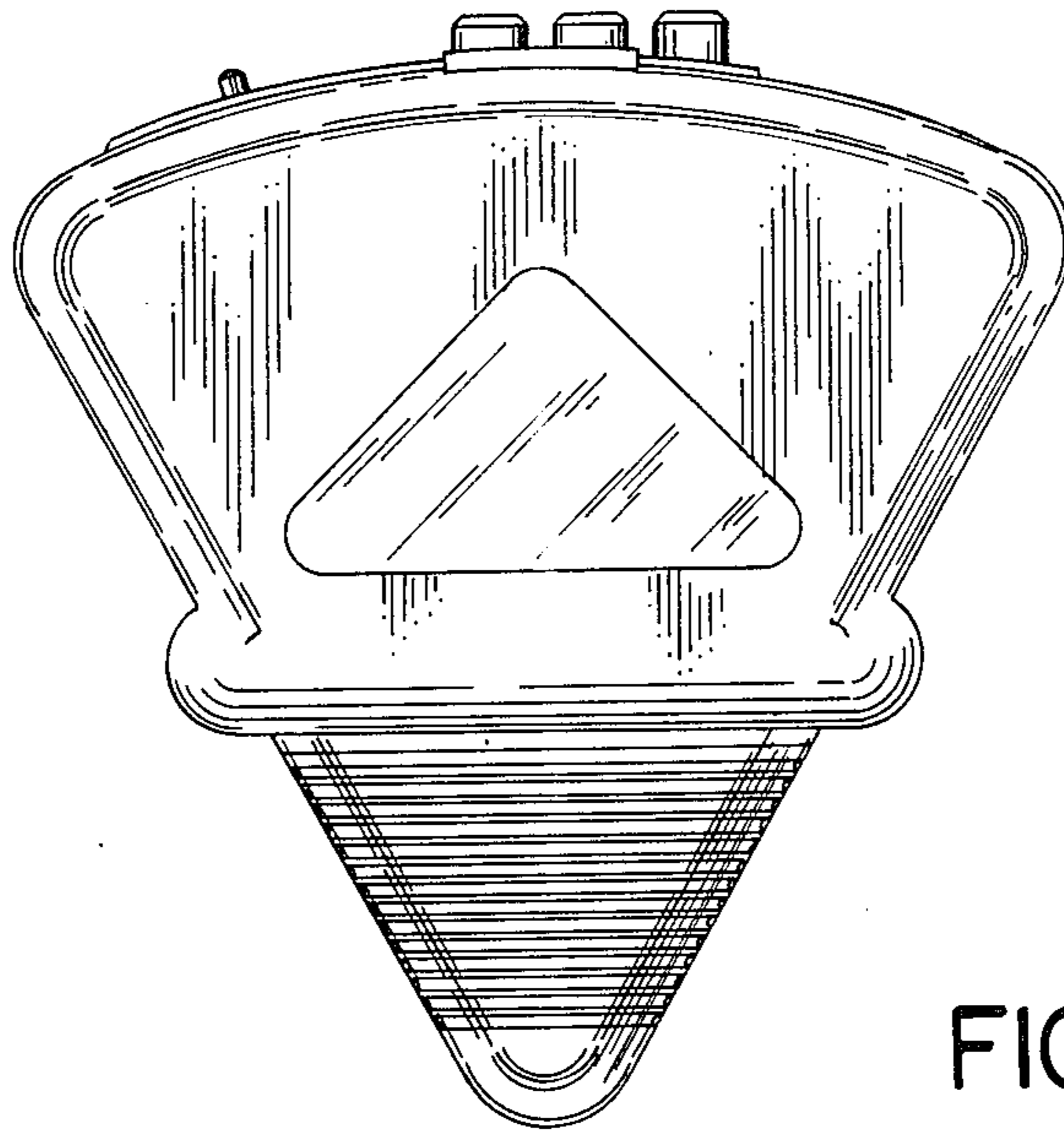

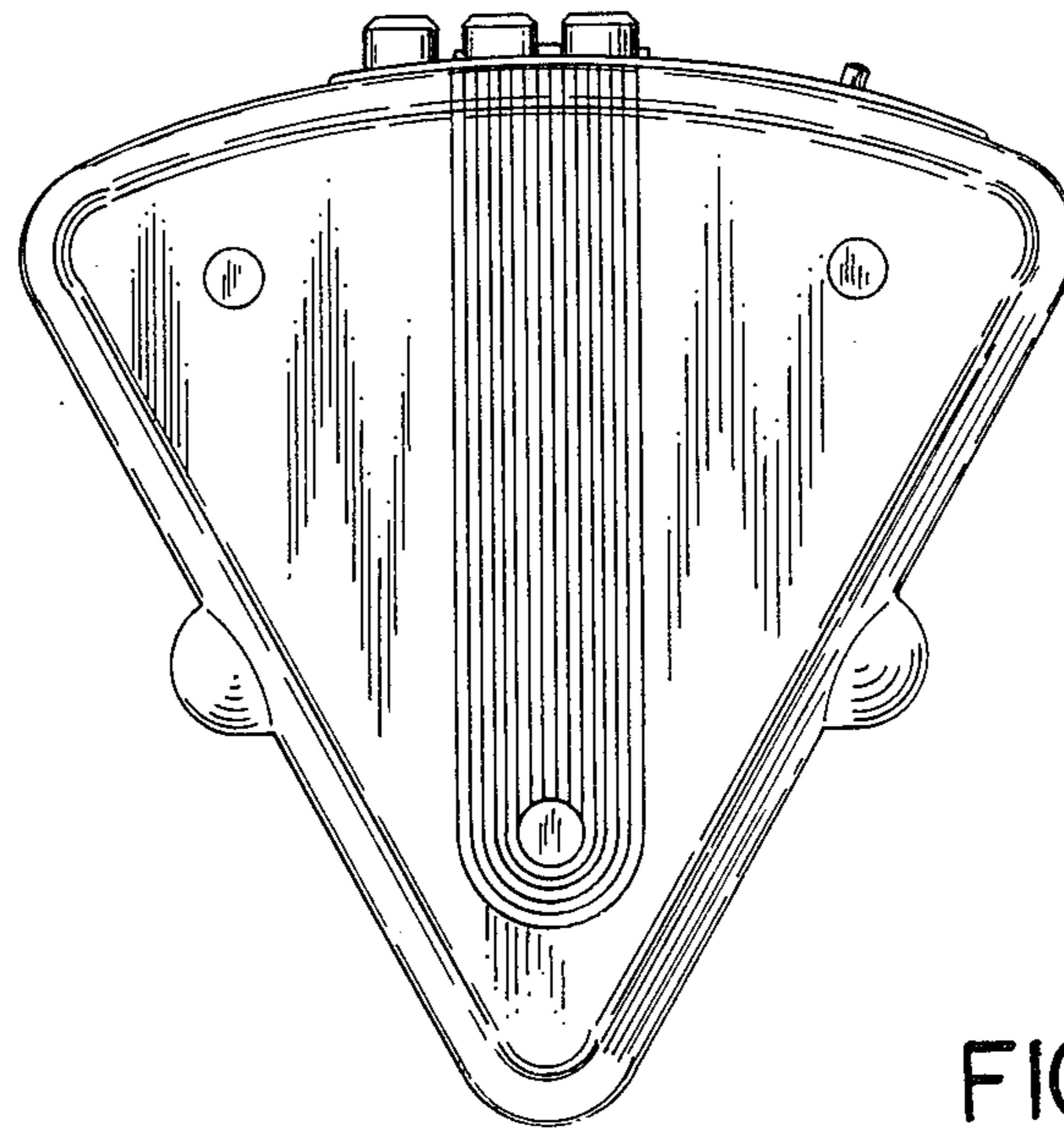
