FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;

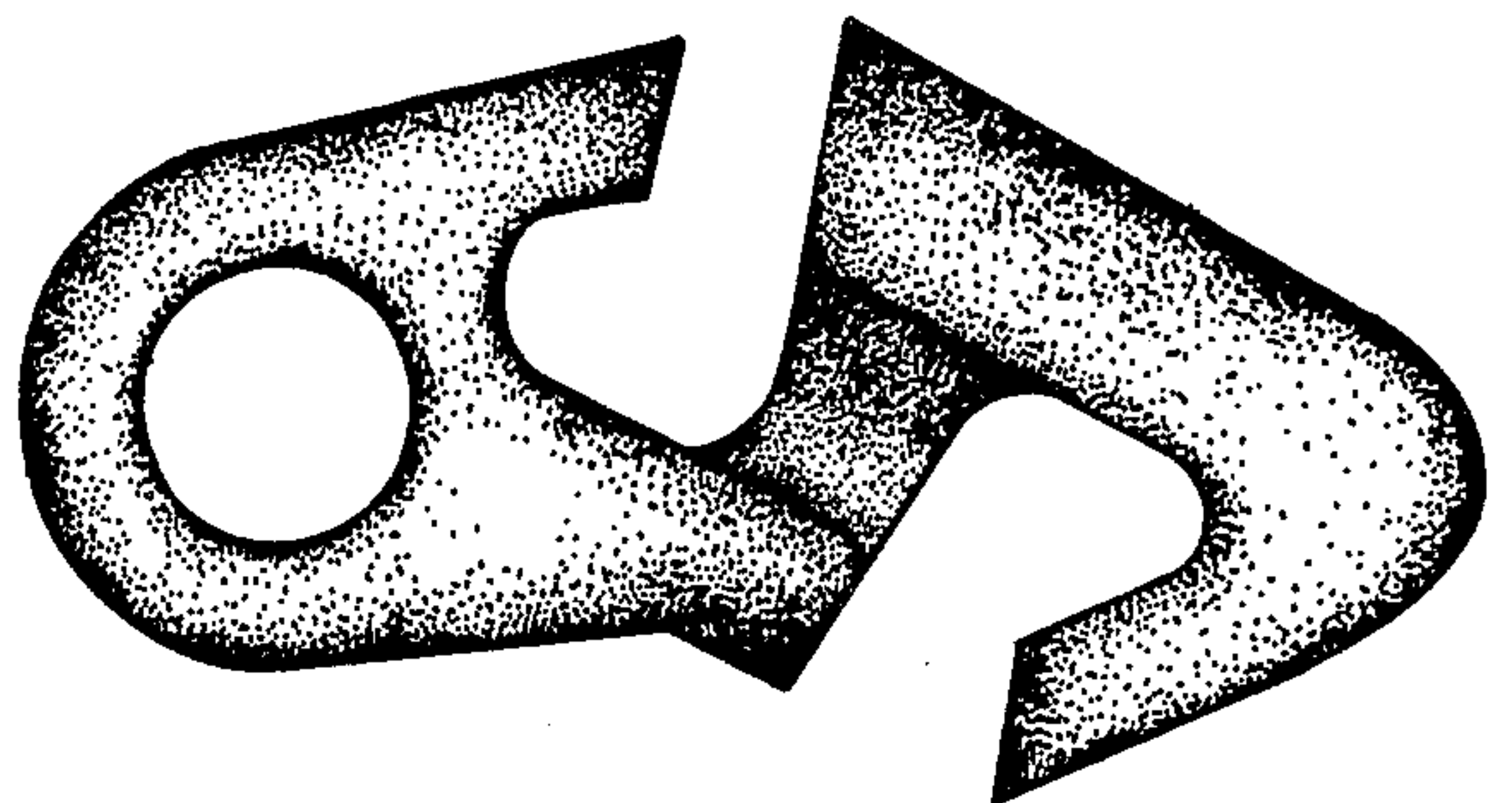
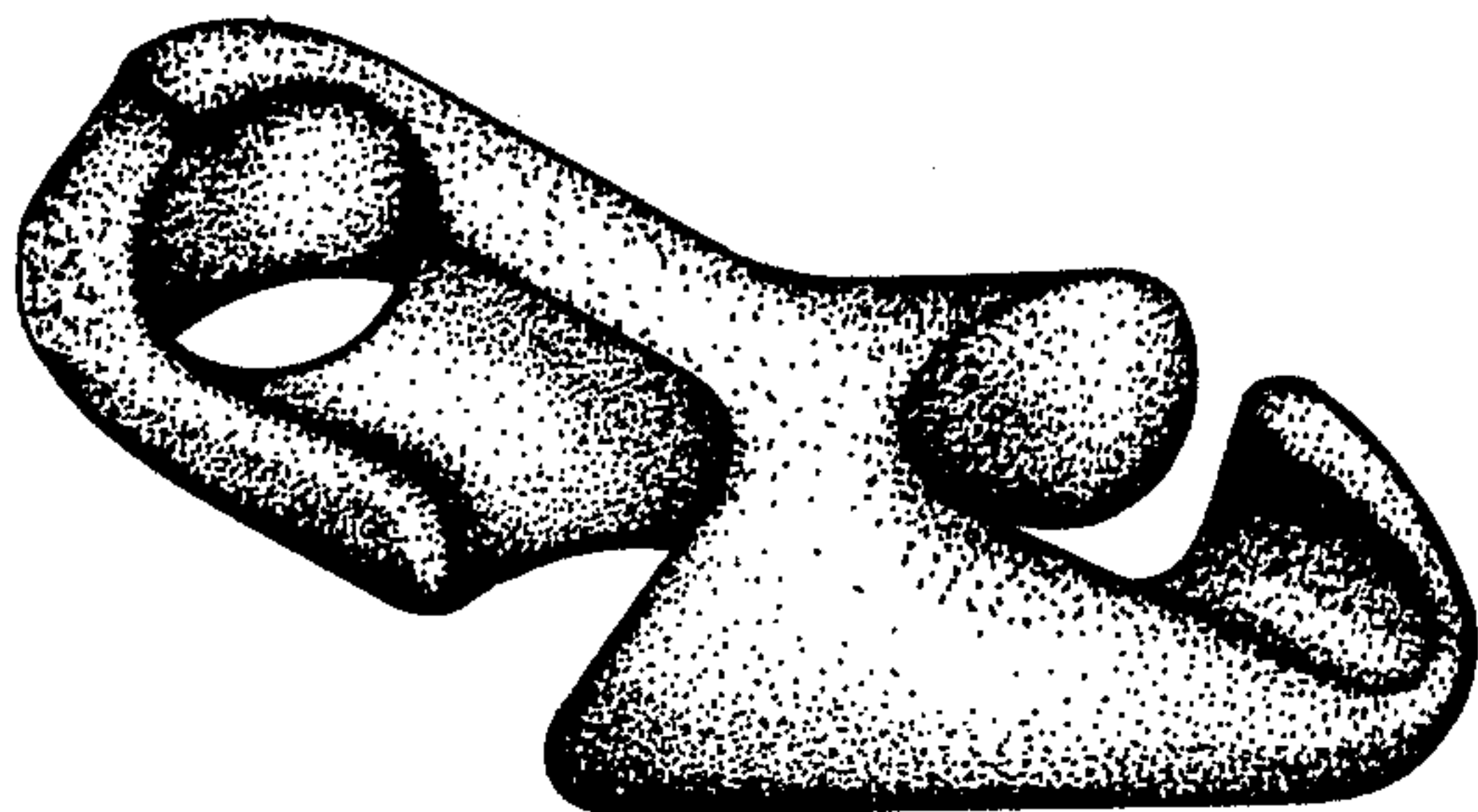
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of rope in FIGS. 2 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



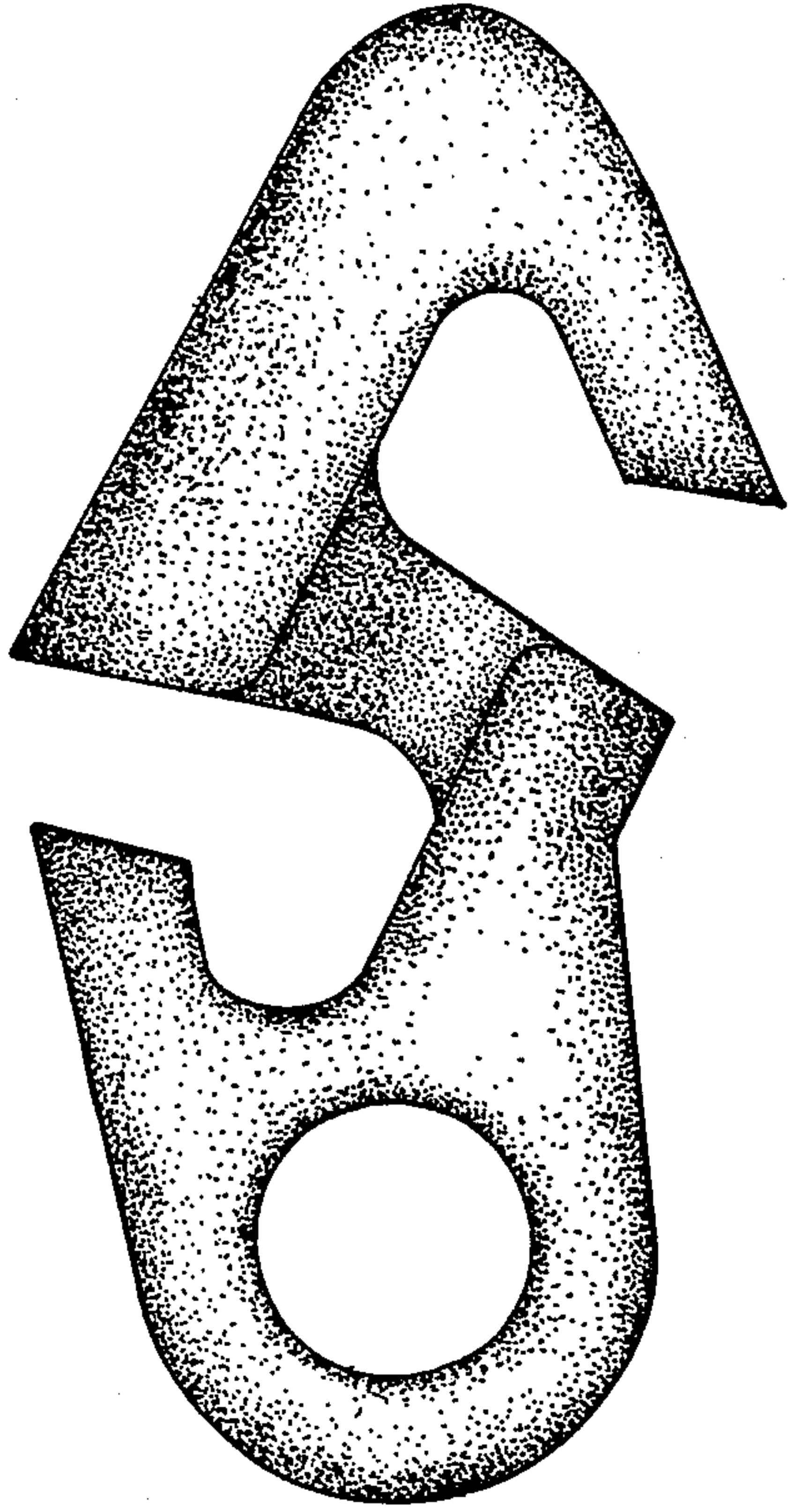

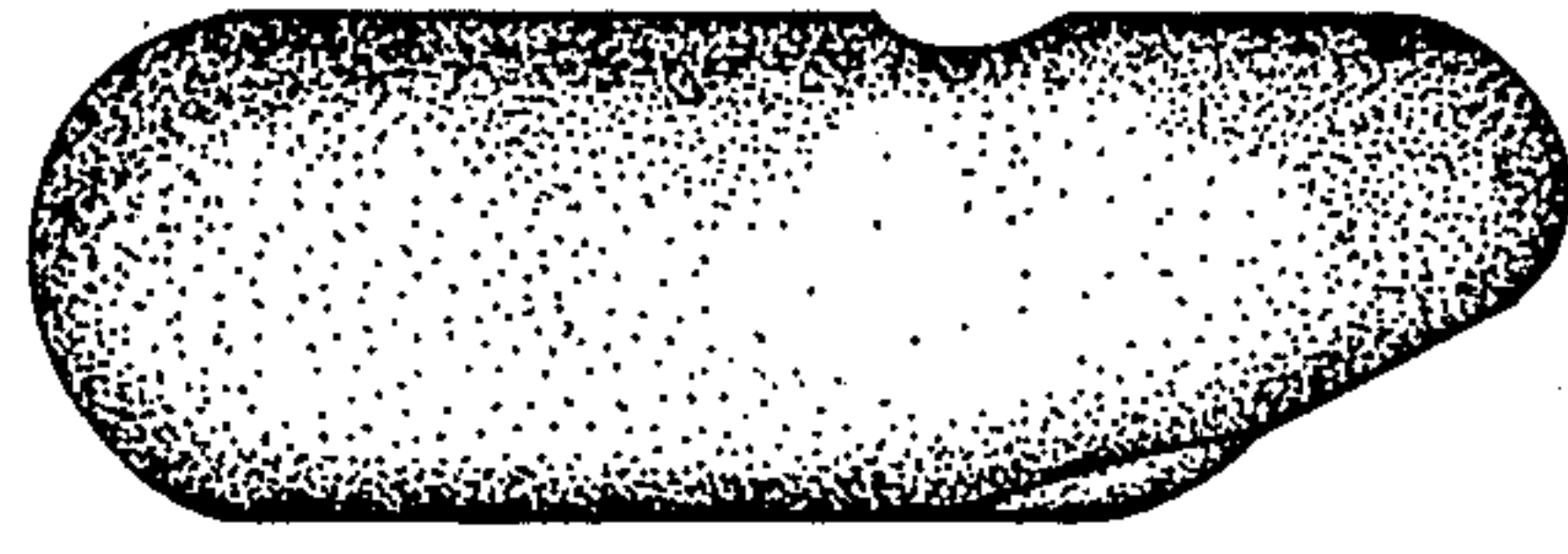

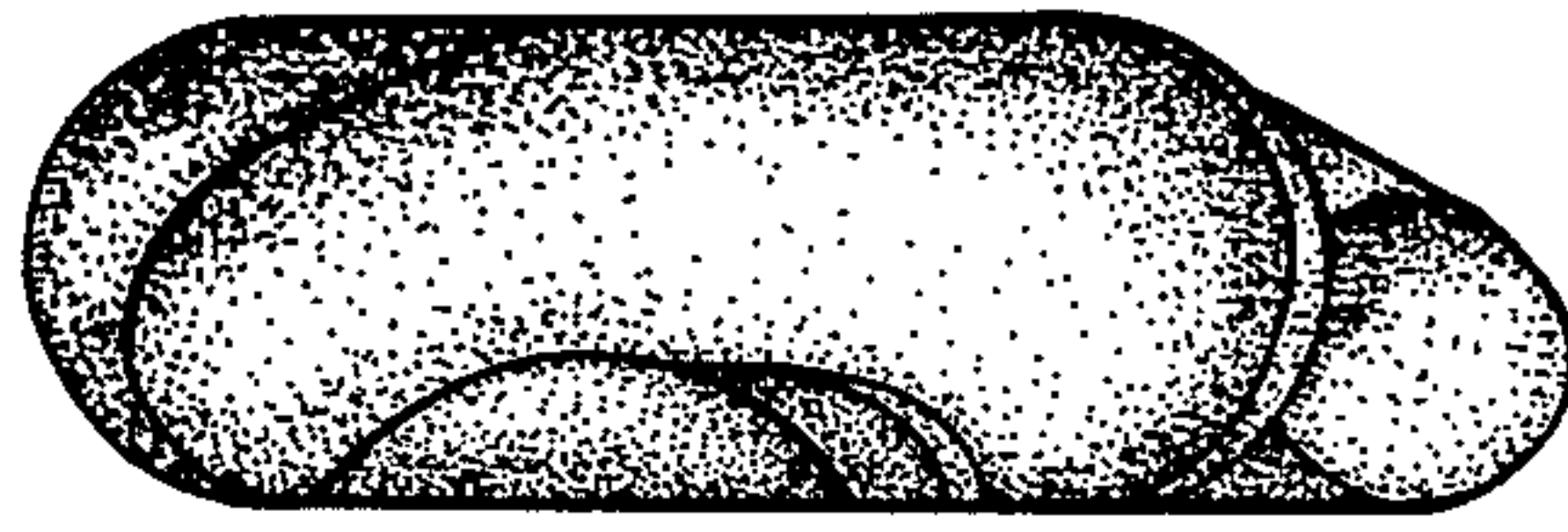

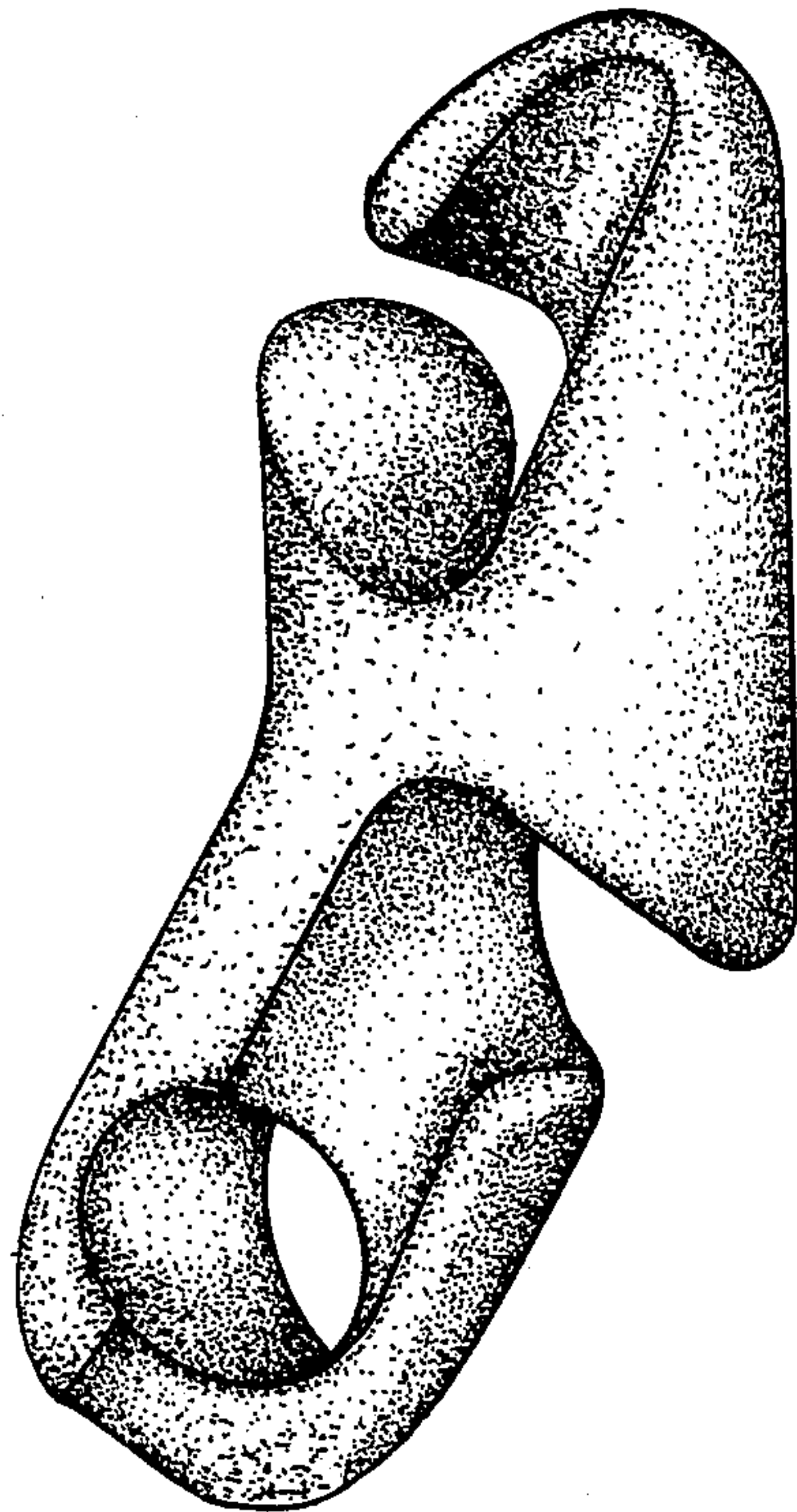

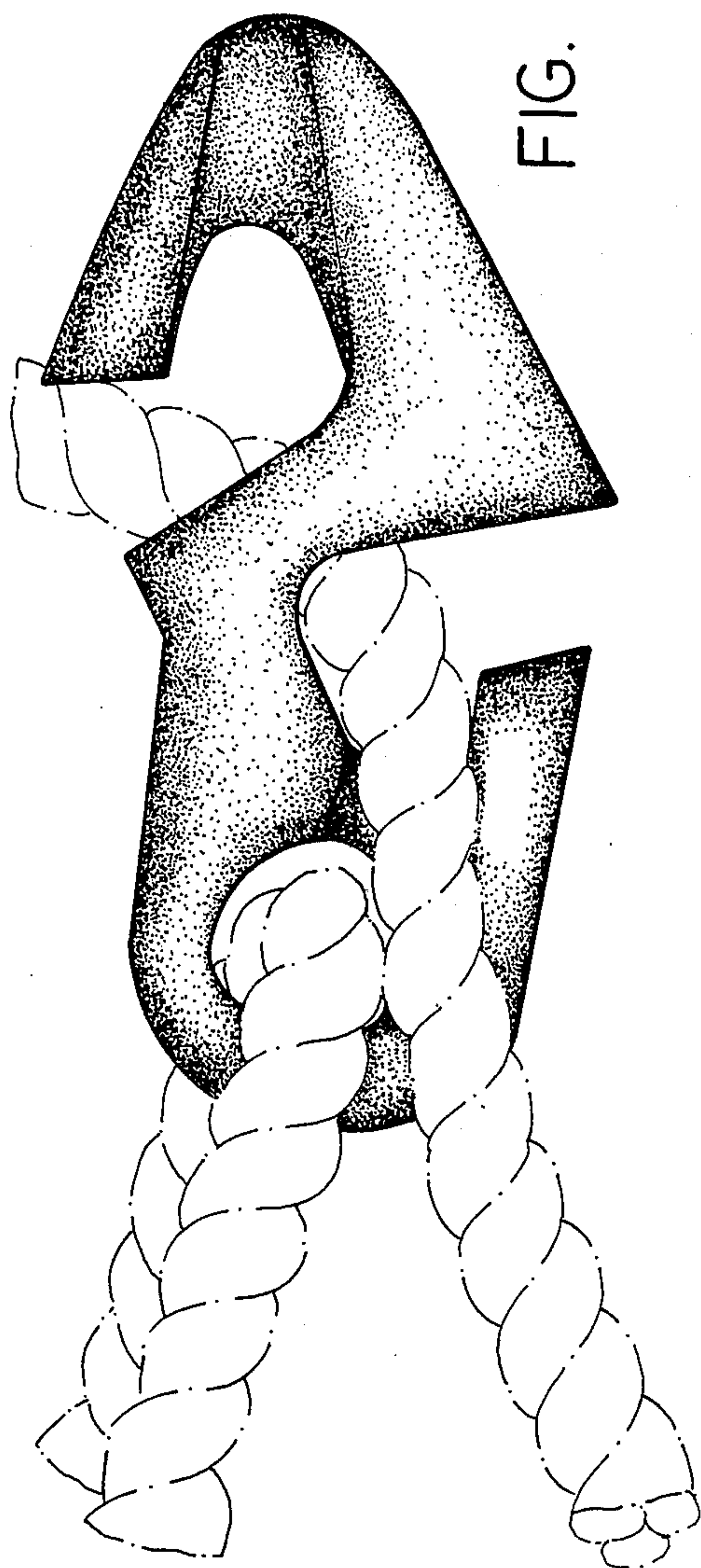

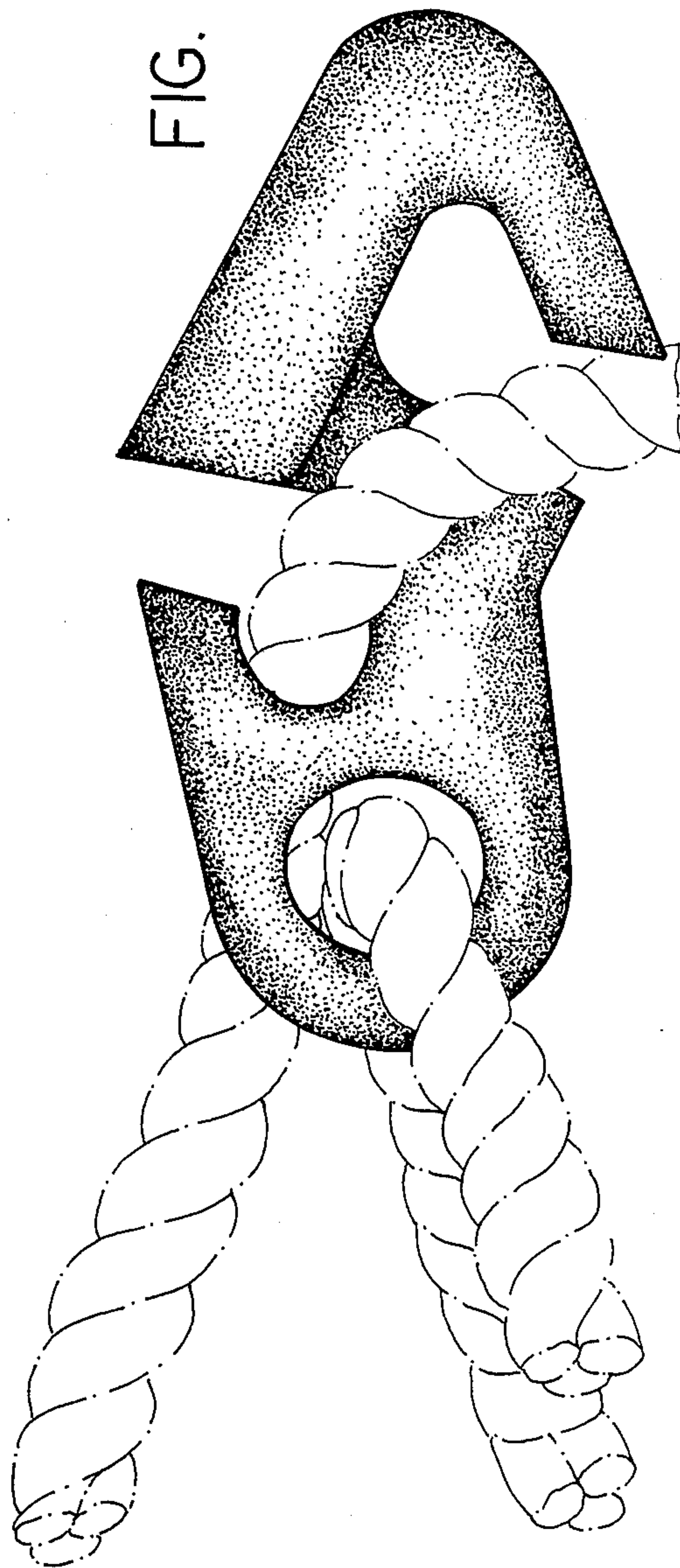

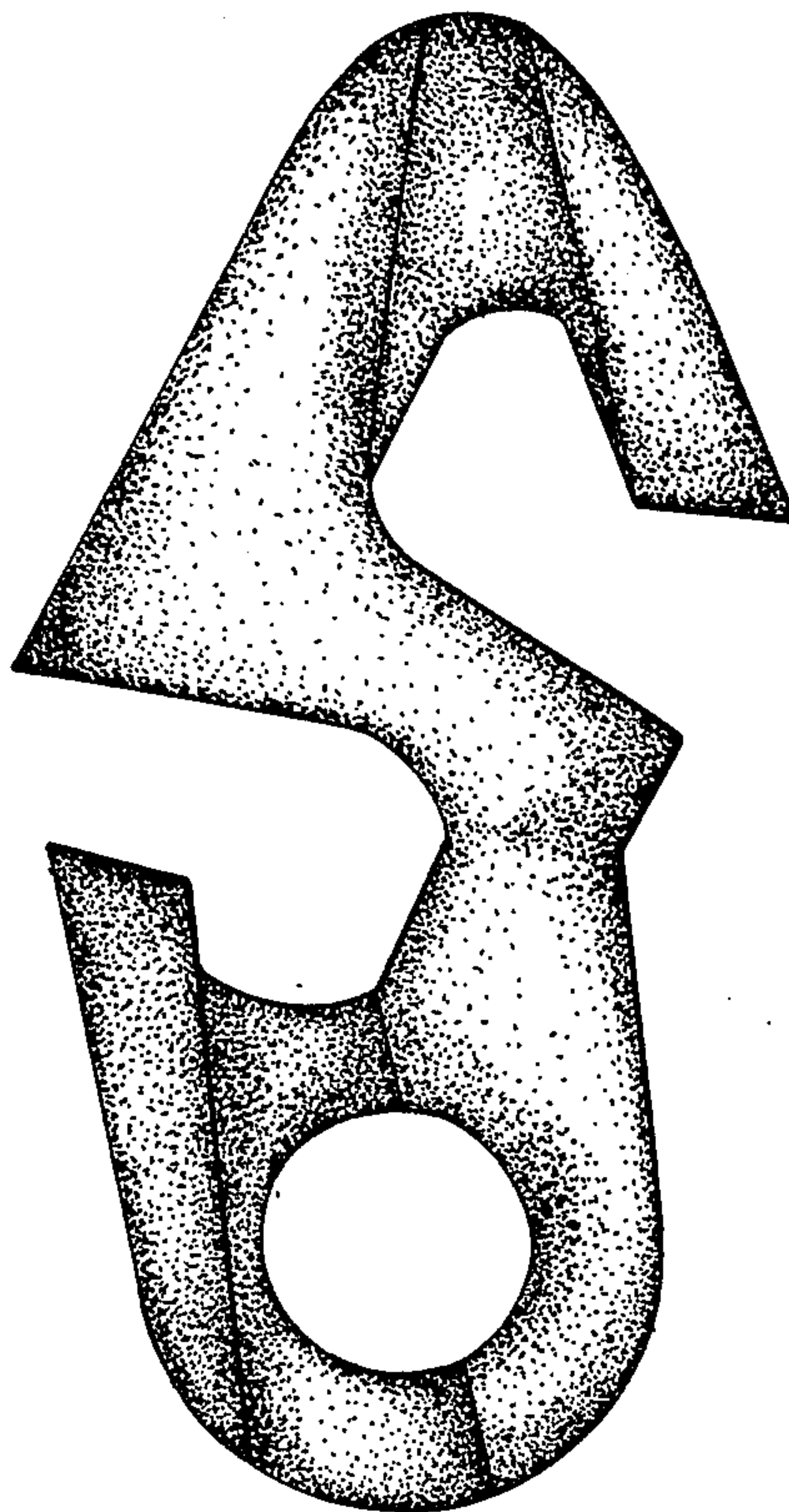
