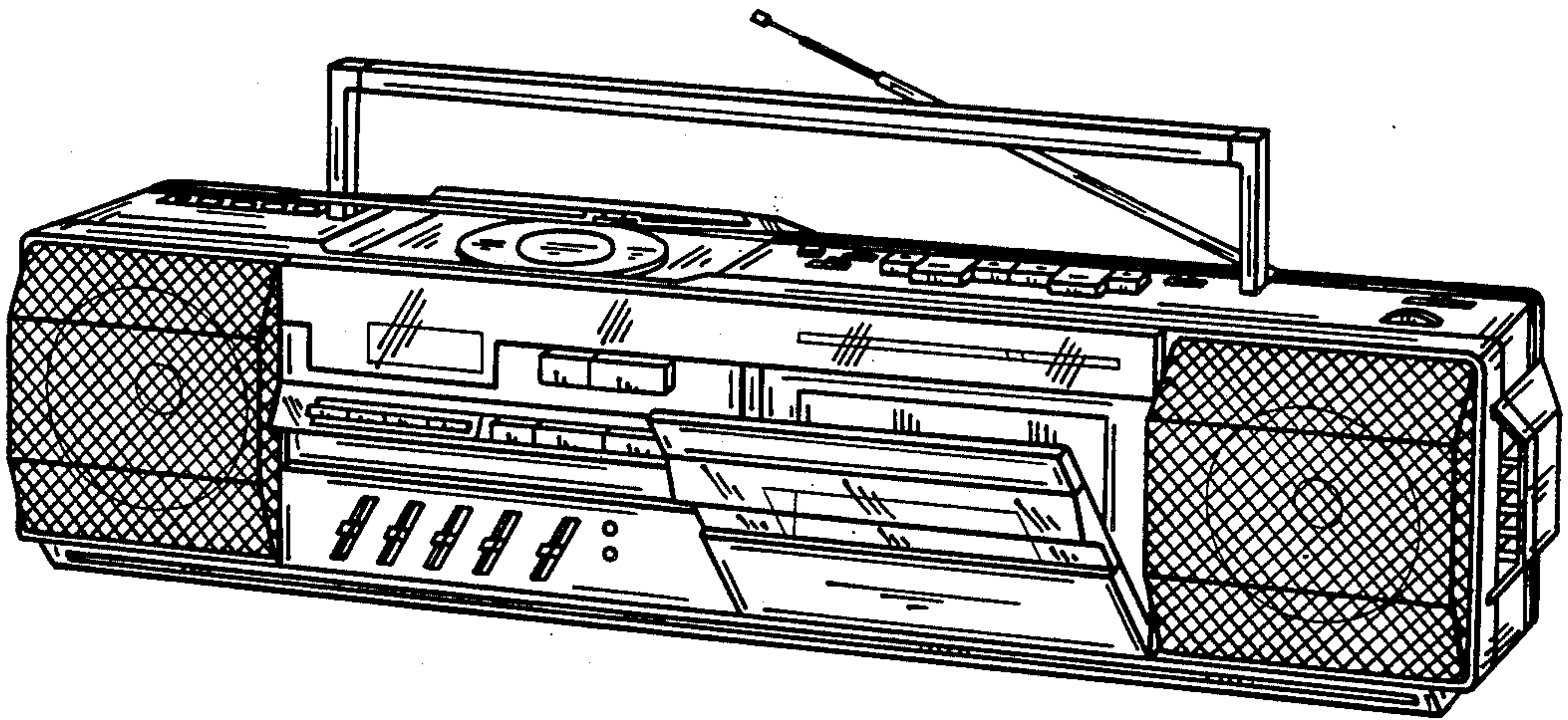

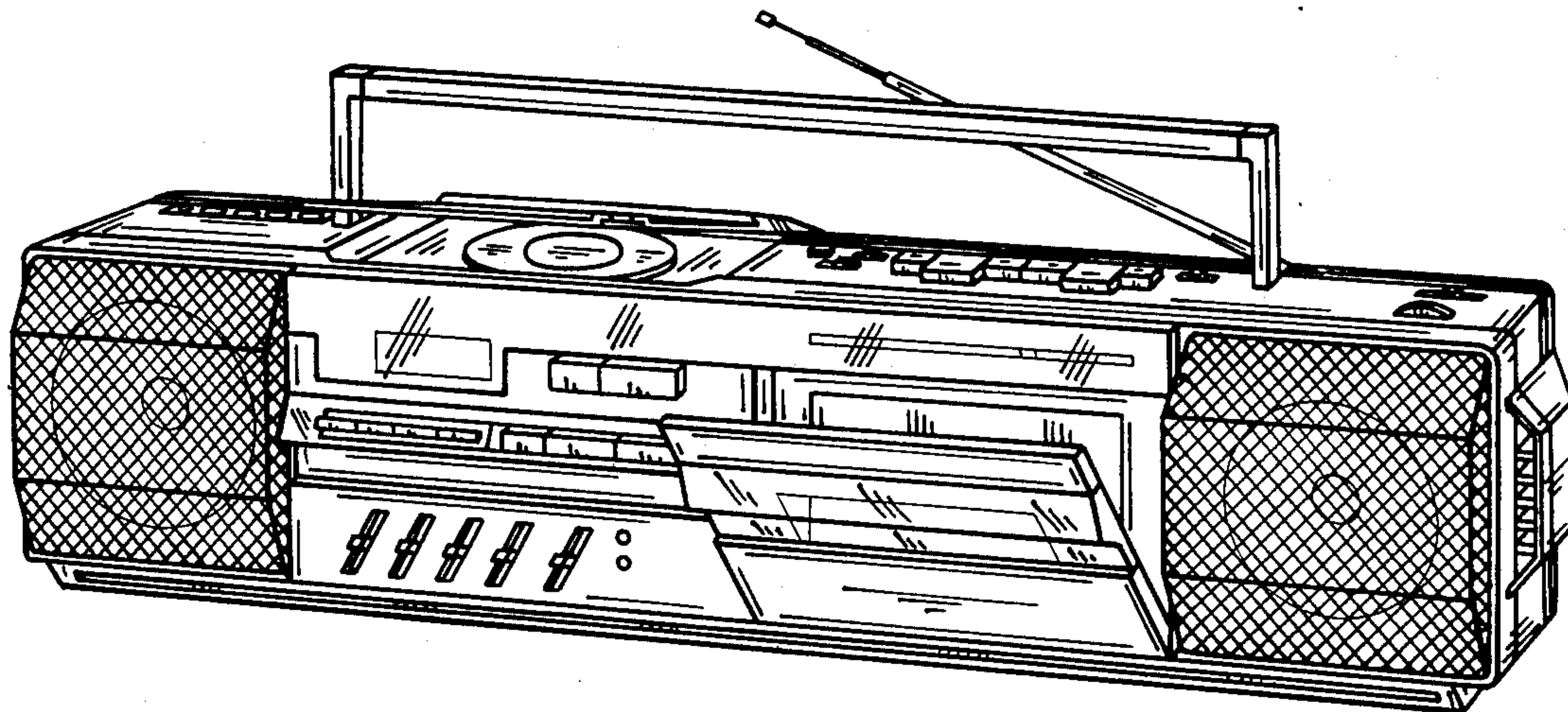
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined tape recorder, digital audio player and radio, as shown and described.

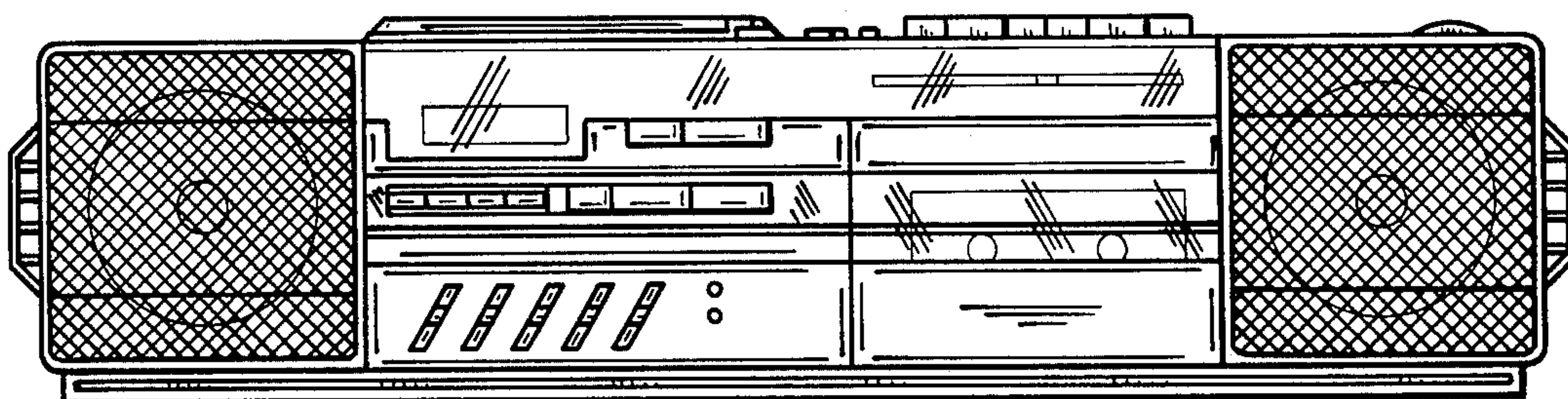
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of the combined tape recorder digital audio player and radio showing our new design with the antenna and handle raised and cassette holder extended; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

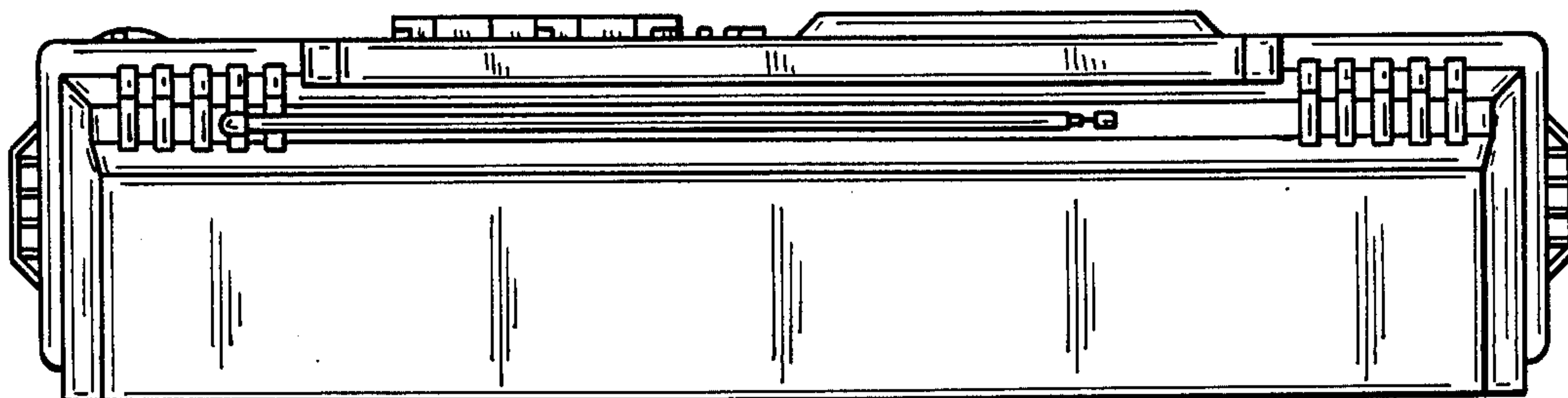




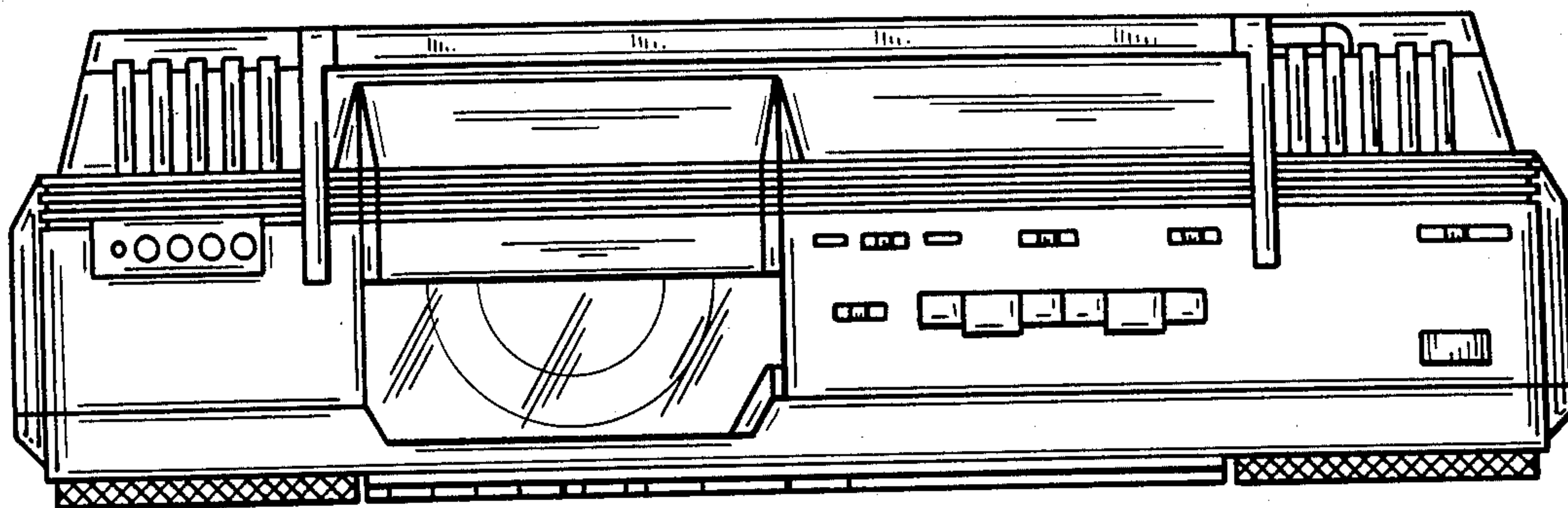

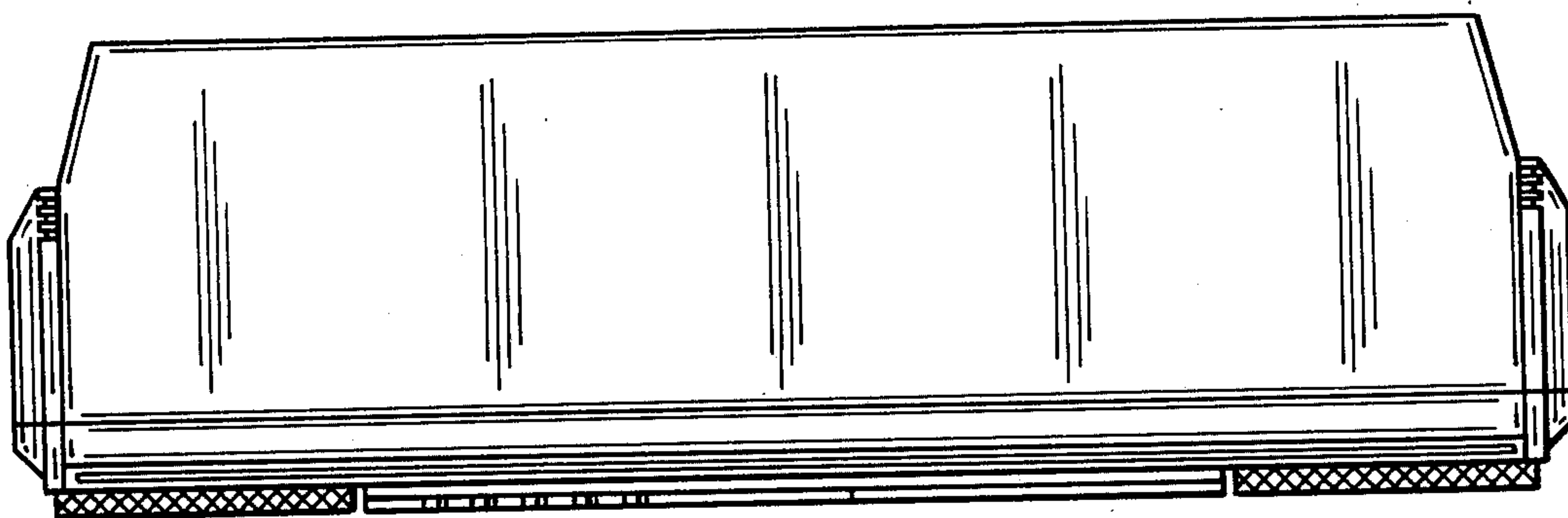

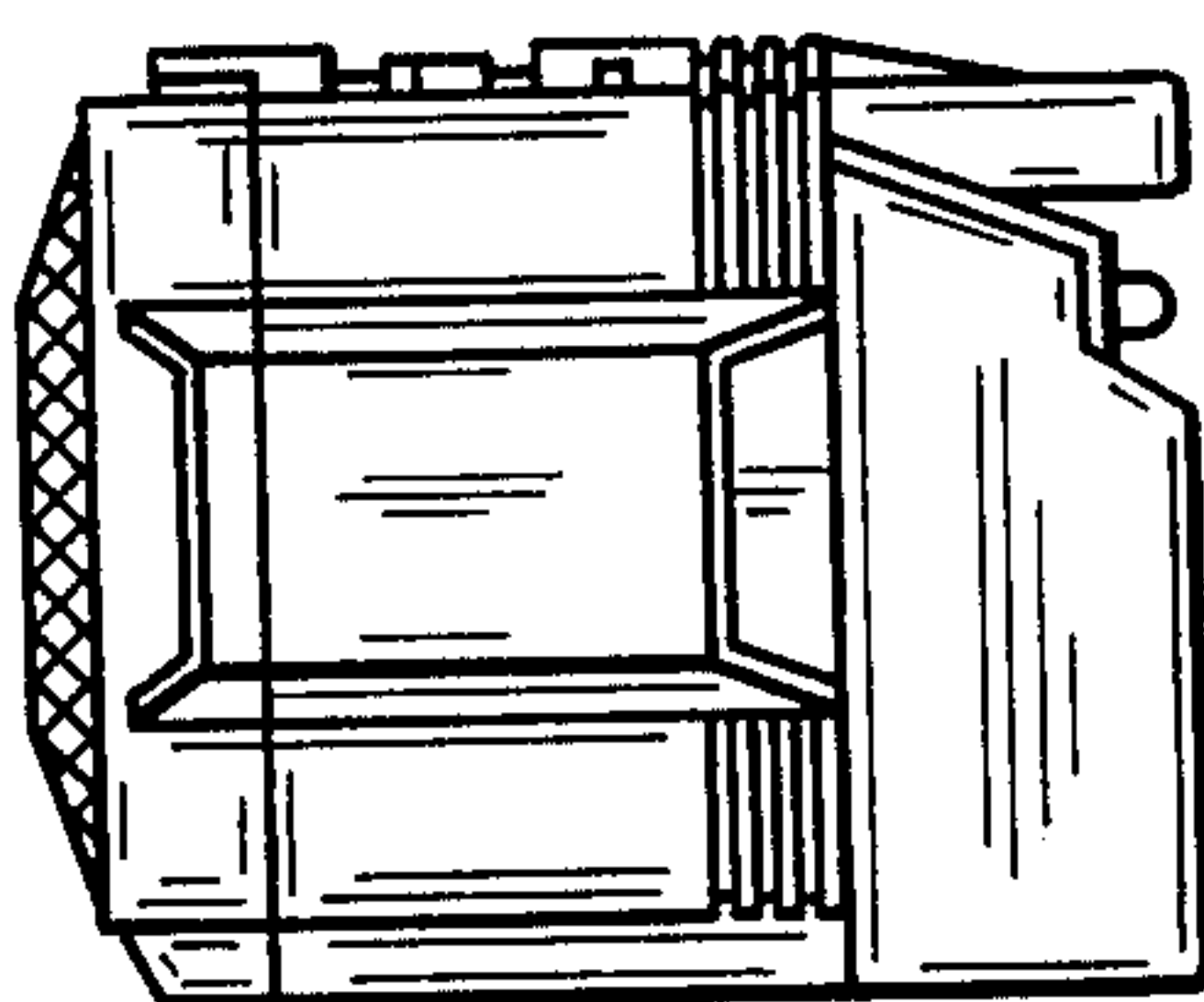

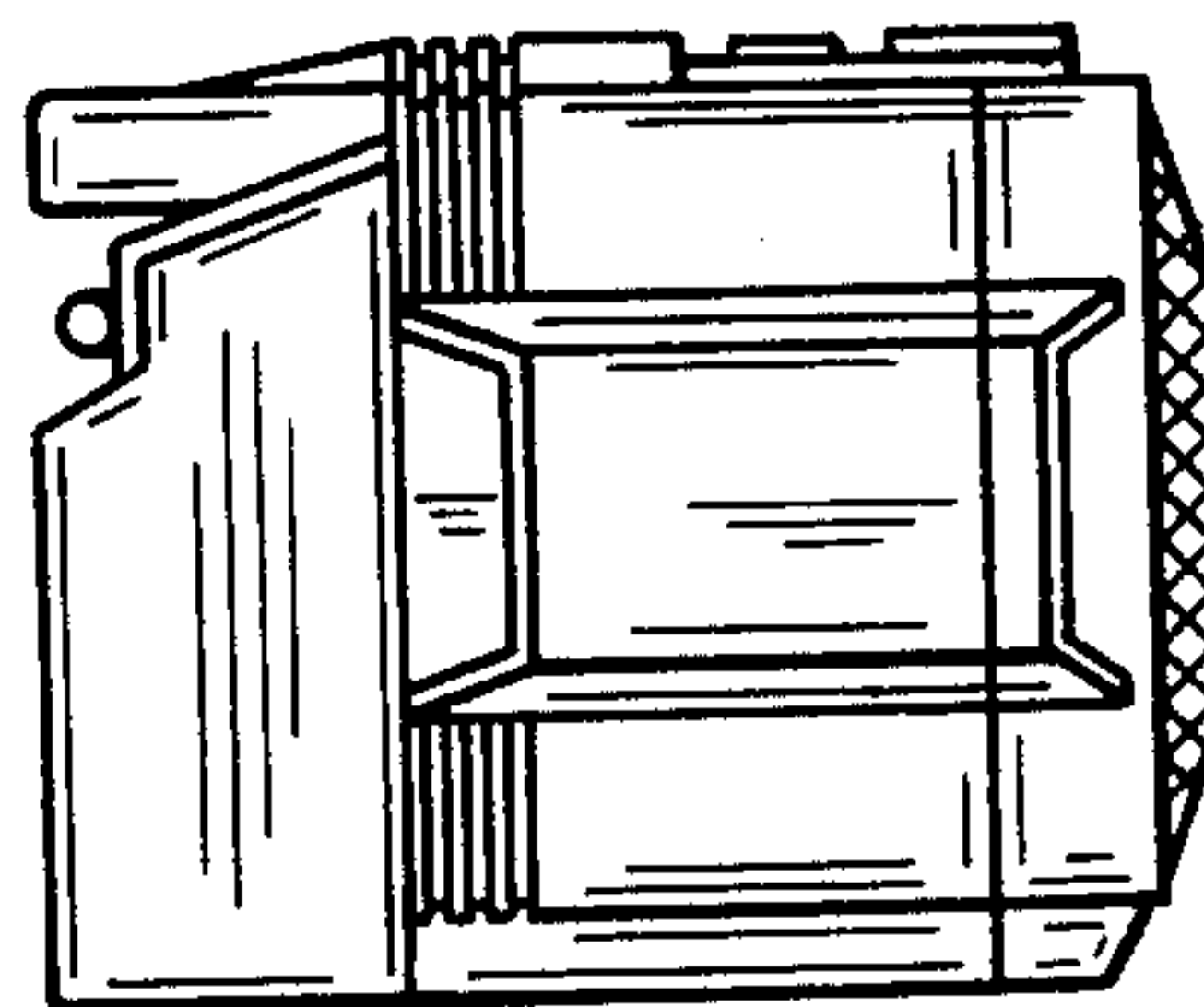
