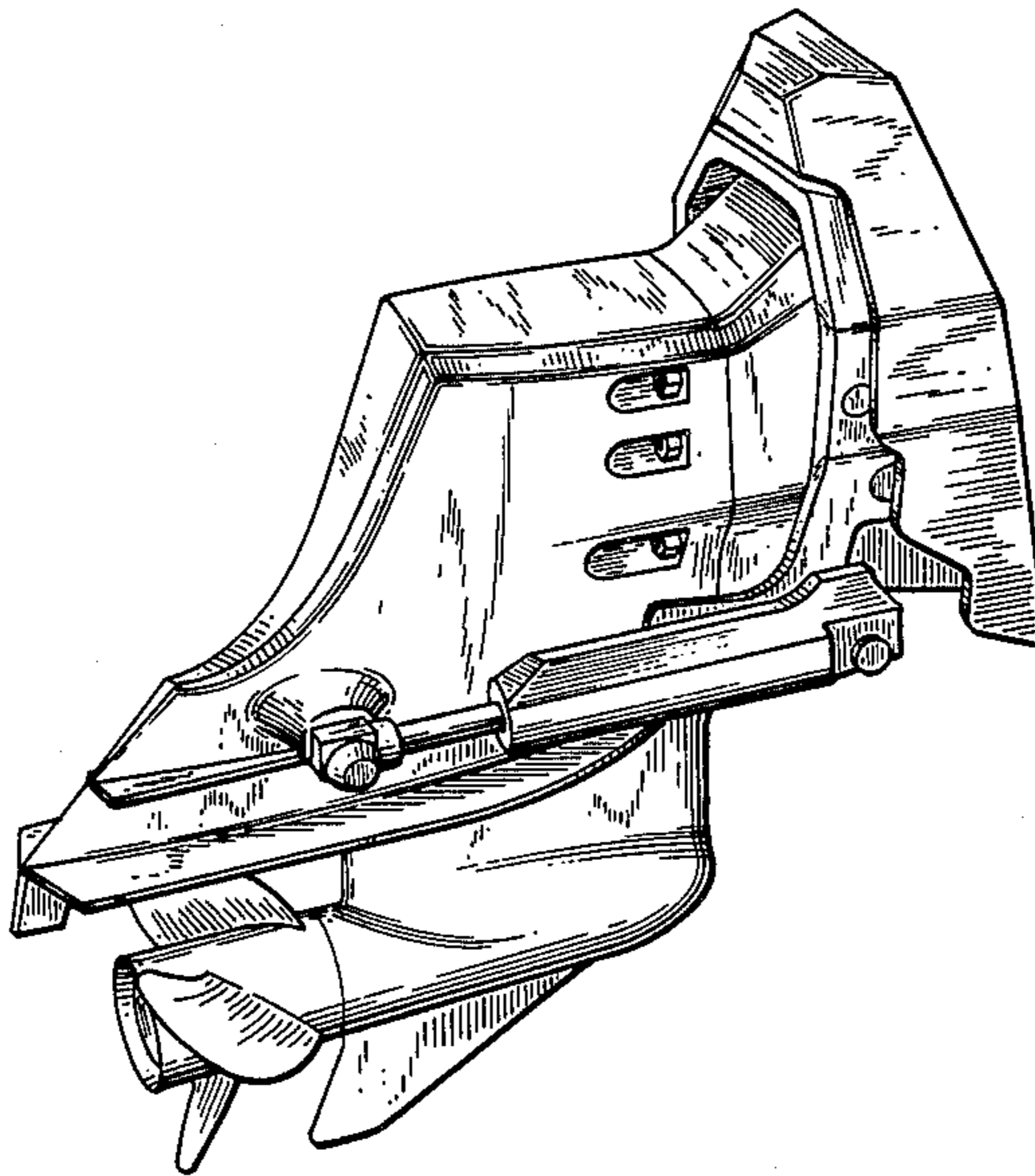

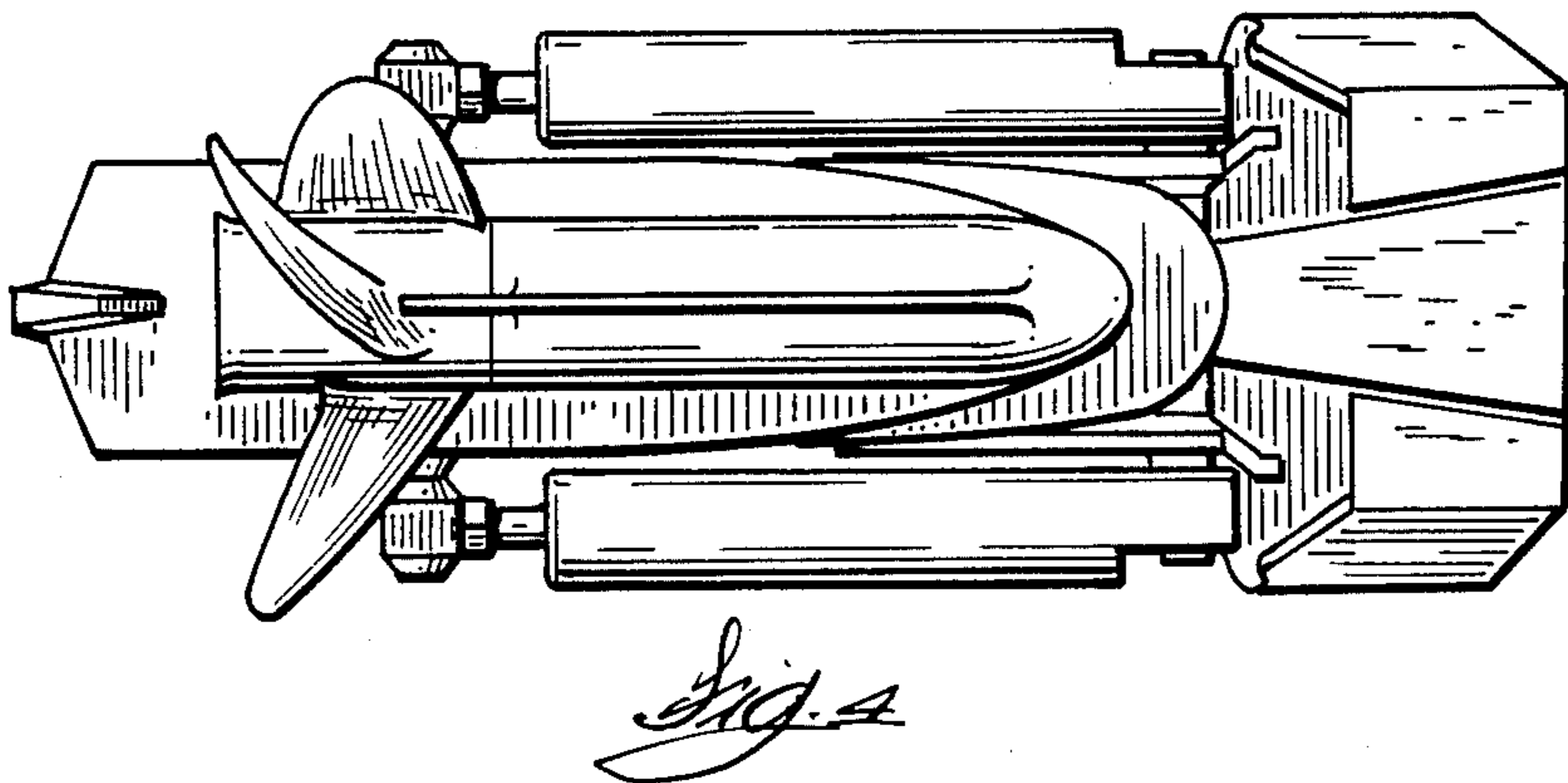
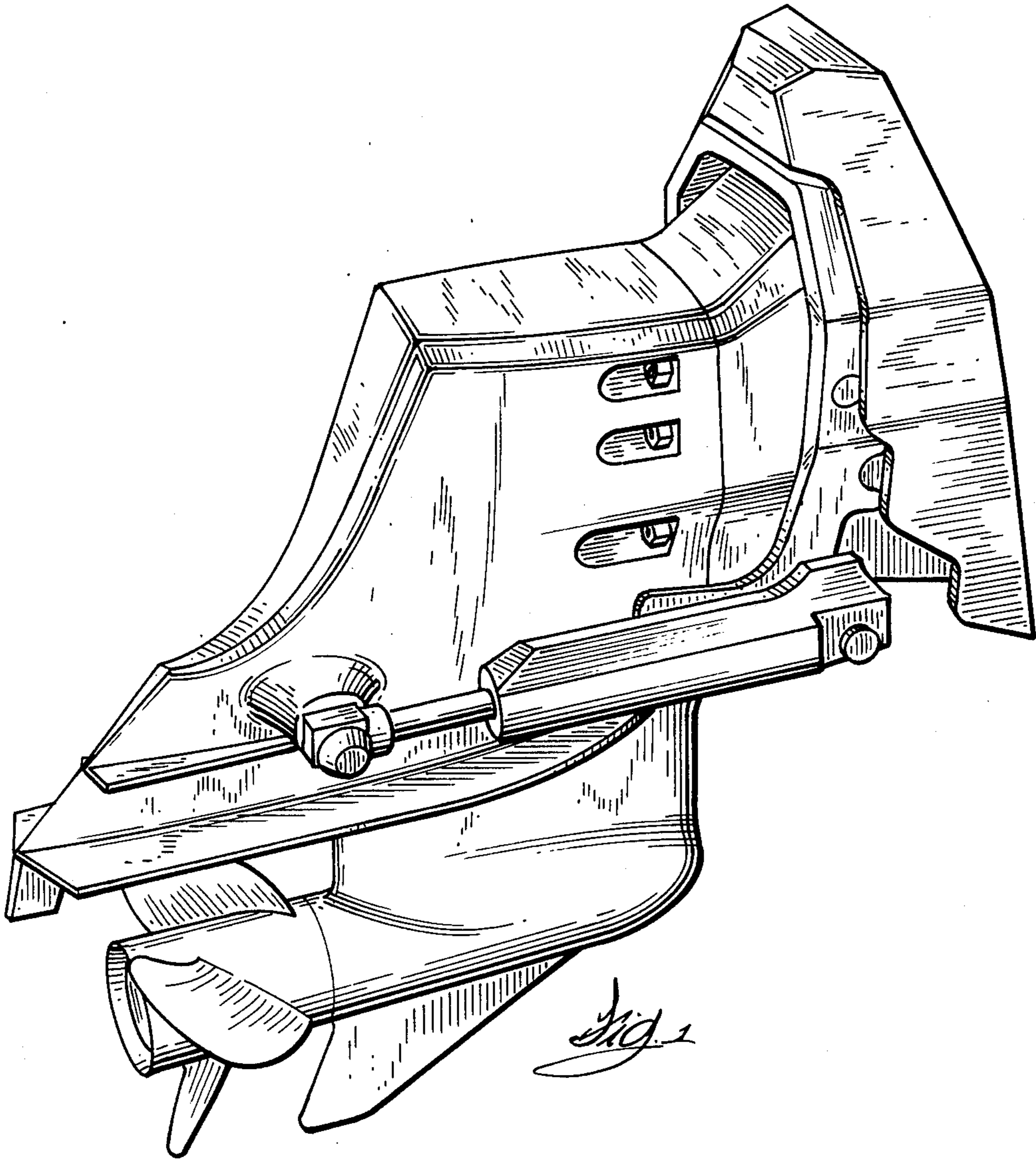

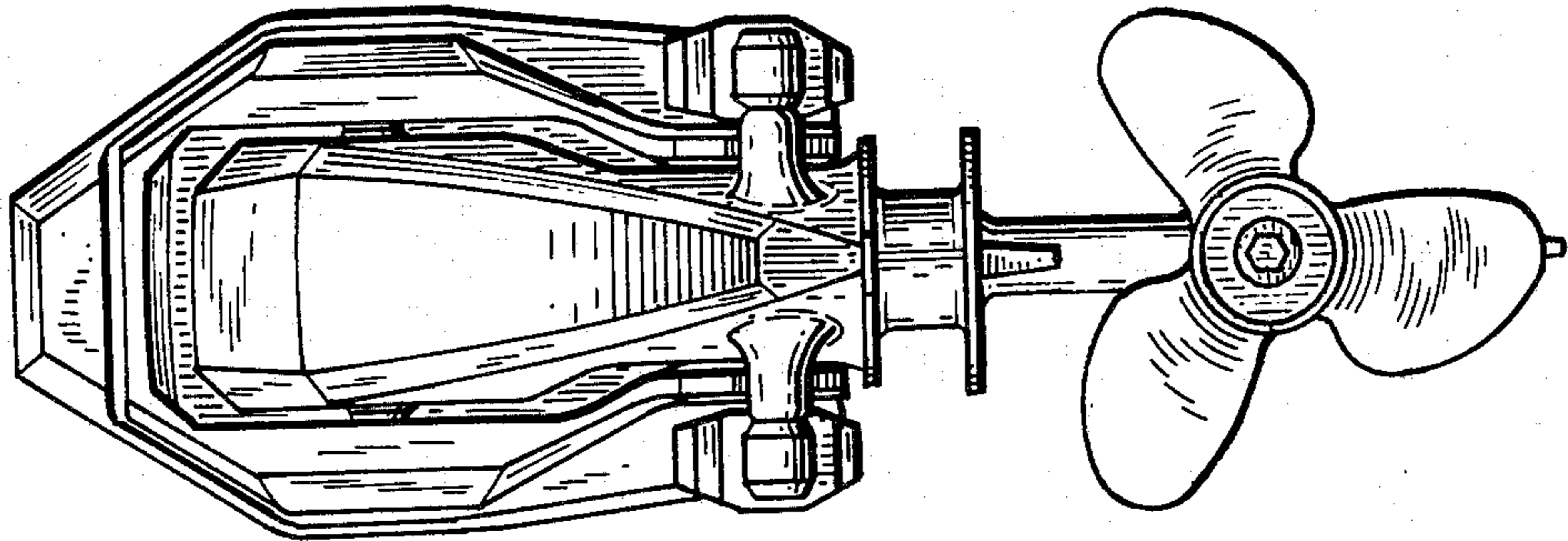
The ornamental design for a marine sterndrive engine,

DESCRIPTION

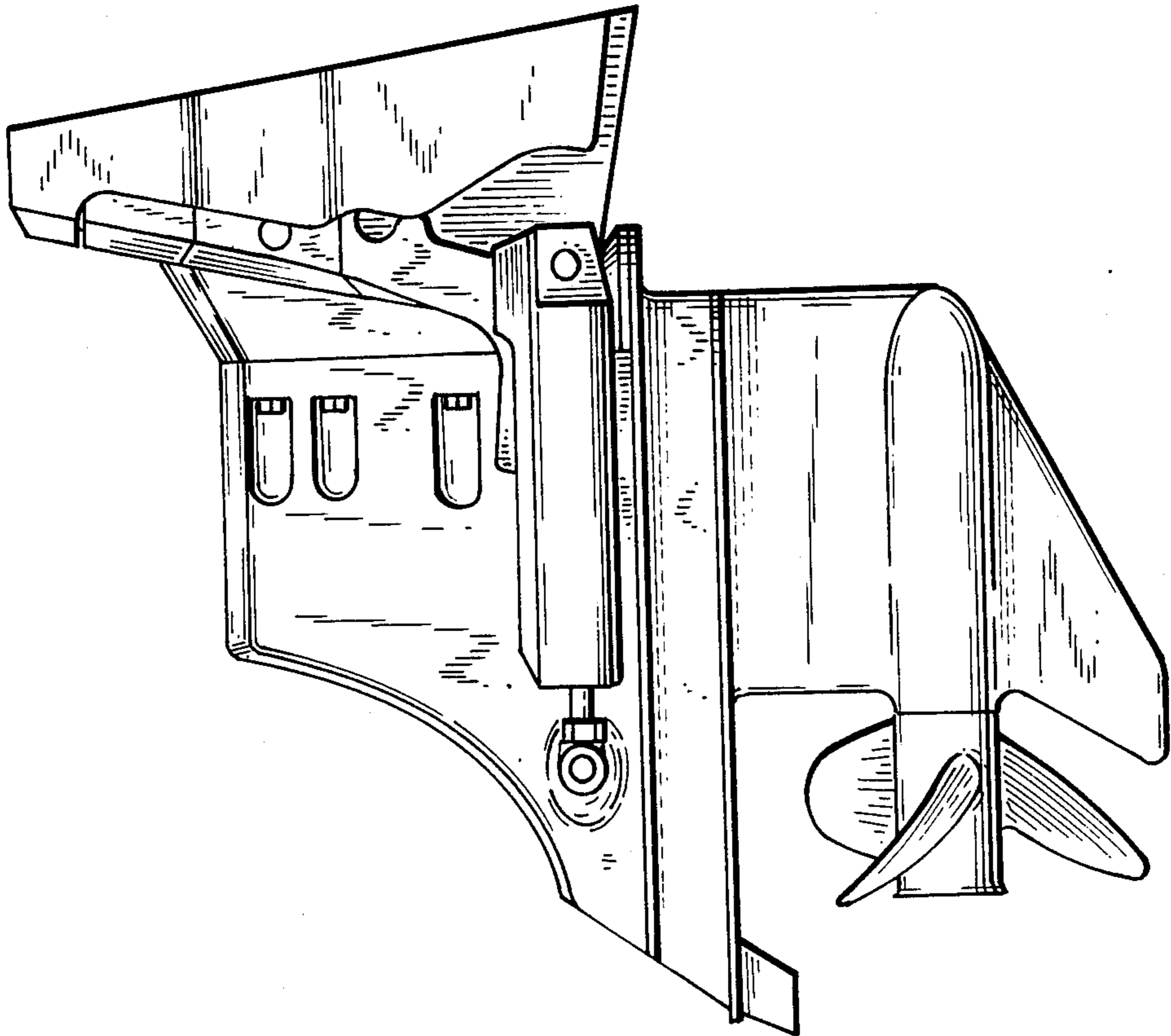
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a marine sterndrive

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



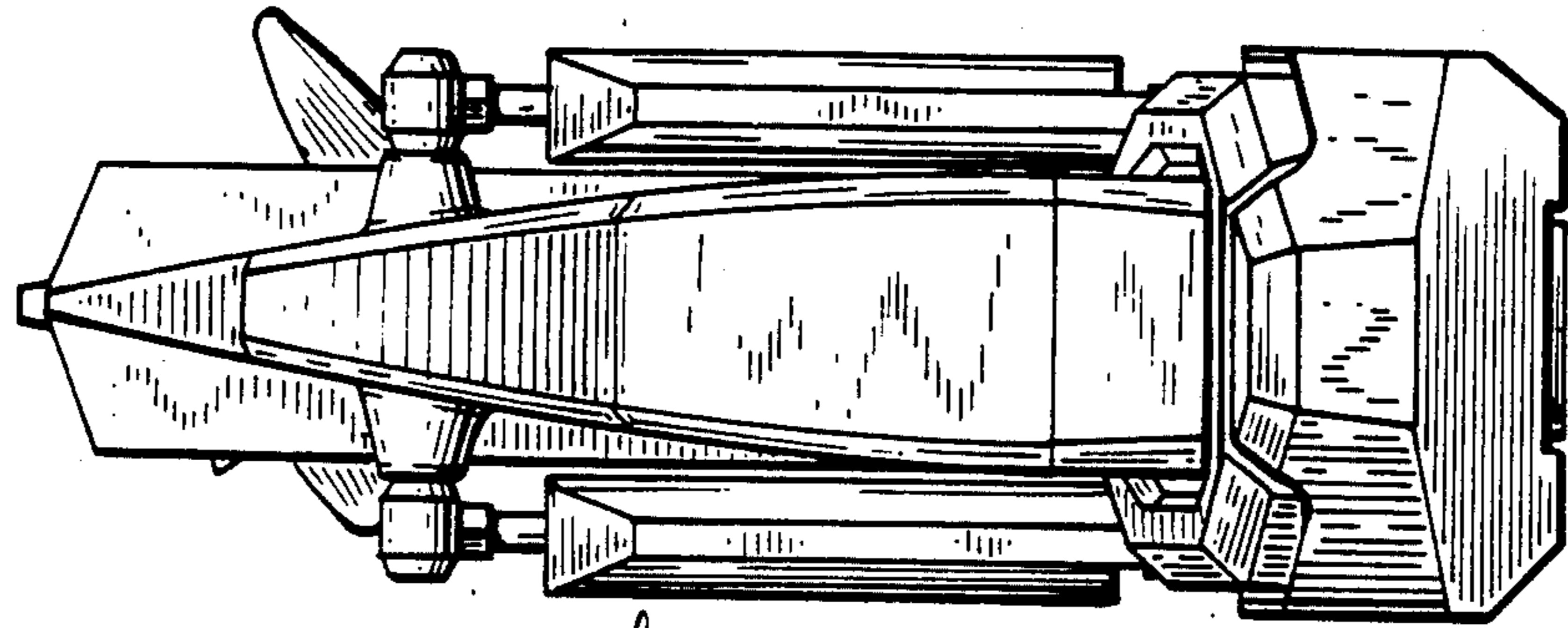




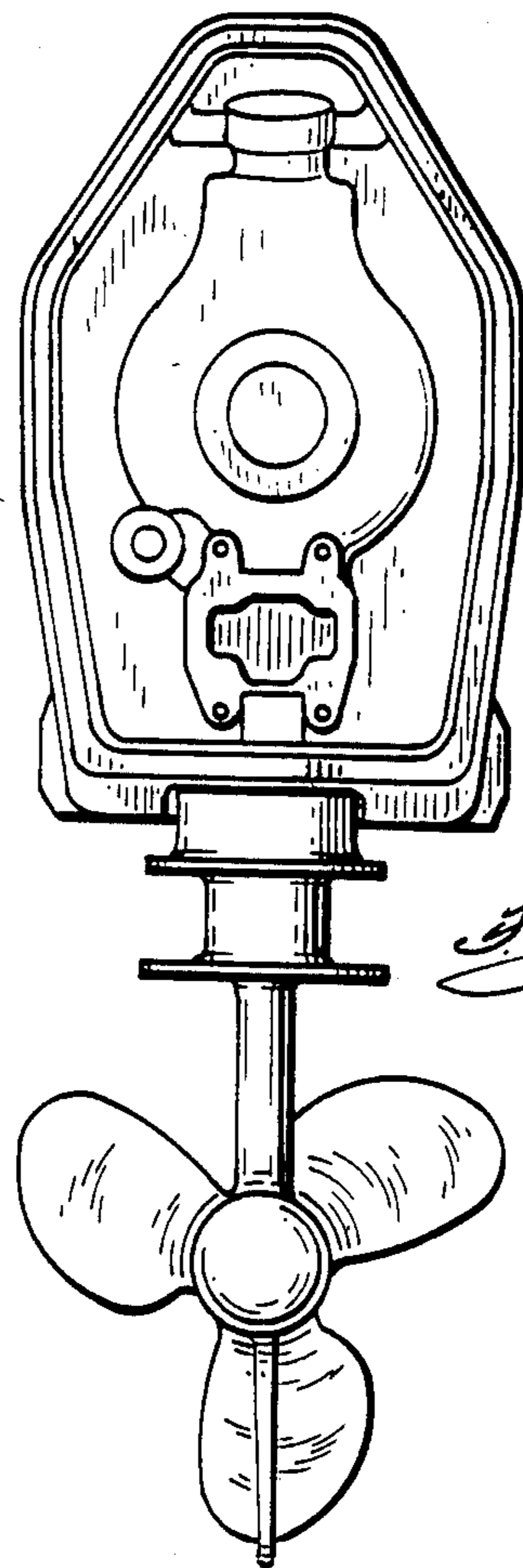
