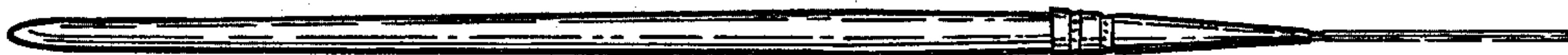

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fingernail striping brush, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fingernail striping brush showing our new design, all sides being identical; FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational thereof showing the brush ferrule and the approximately twelve, equal length, long untapered bristles which form the brush; FIG. 3 is an enlarged elevational view thereof as seen from the bristle end.



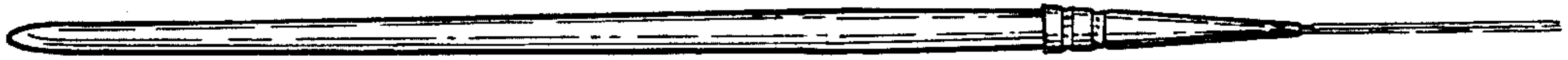

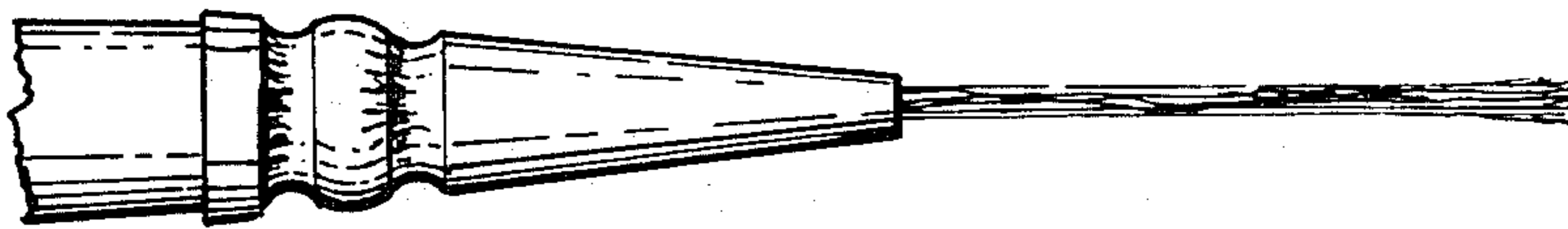

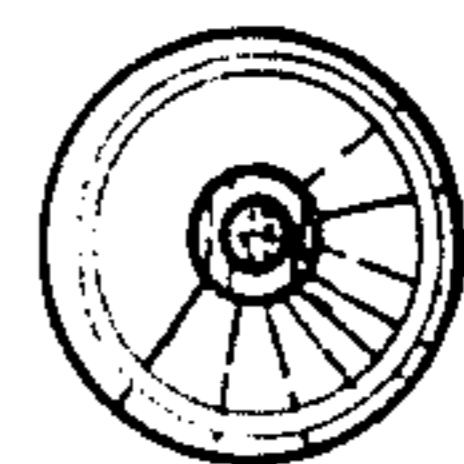
