[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable musician's chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an adjustable musician's chair showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view similar to FIG. 2 but wherein the seat cushion is shown in a lowered position; and
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view similar to FIG. 5 but wherein the seat cushion is shown in lowered position.

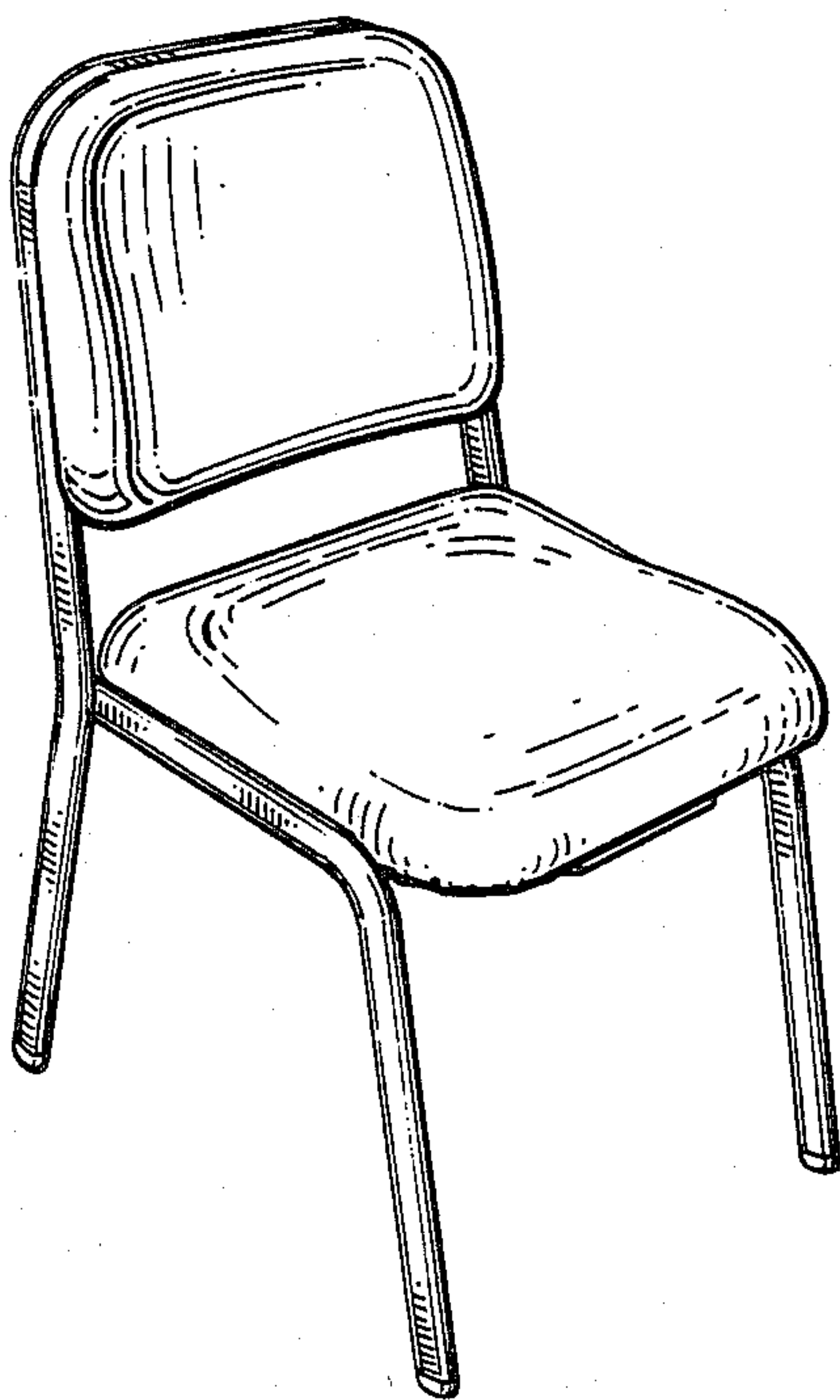

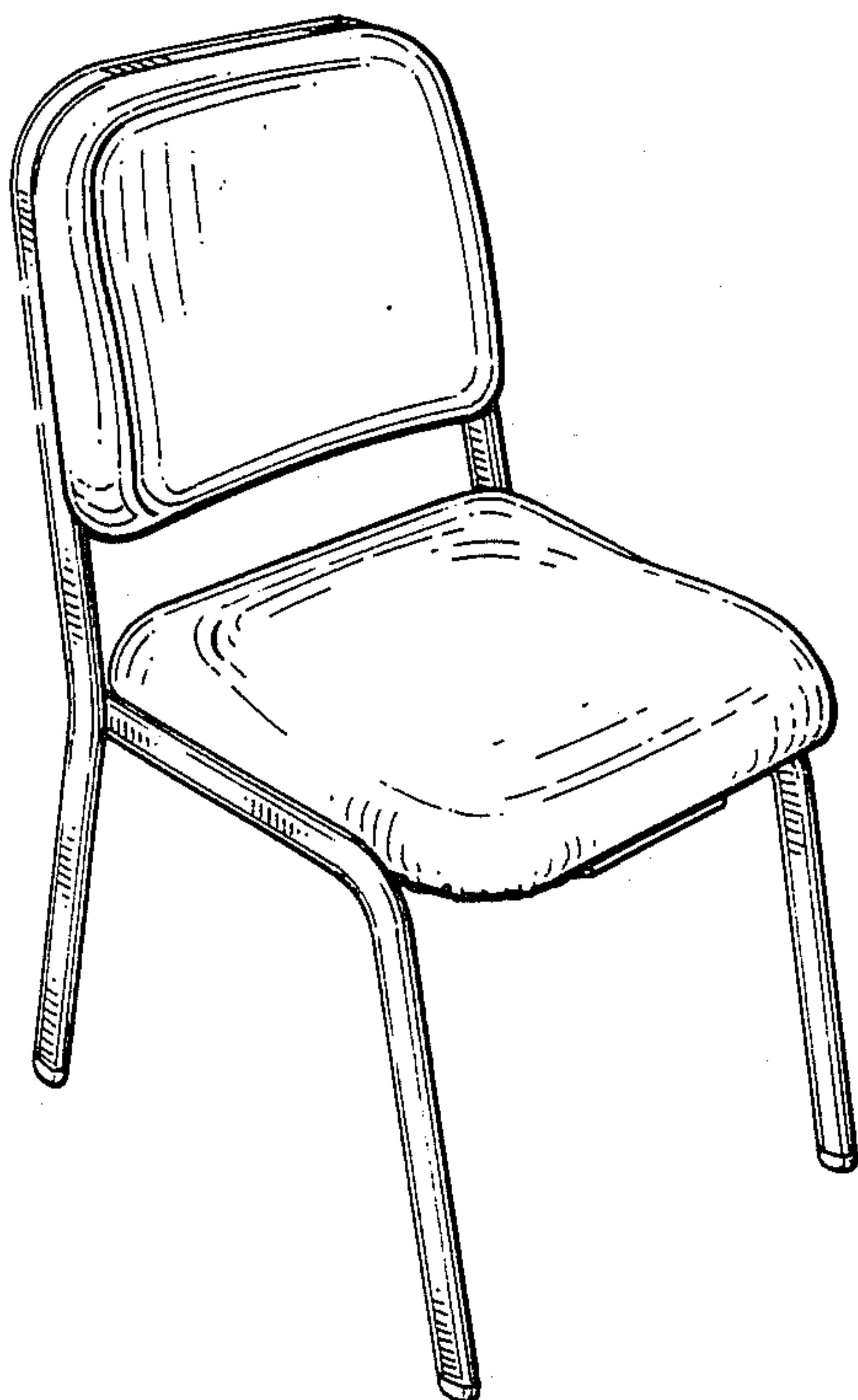

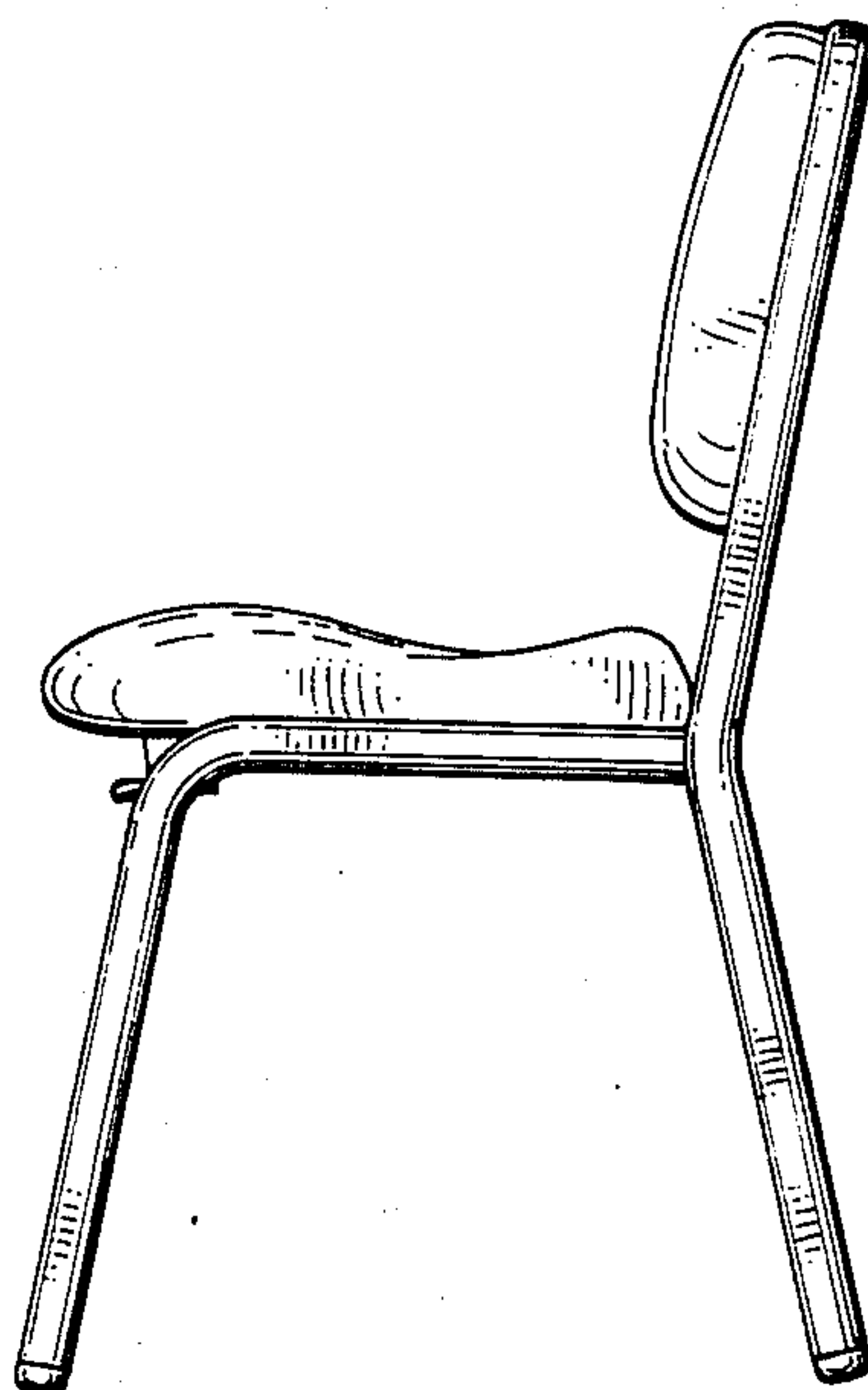

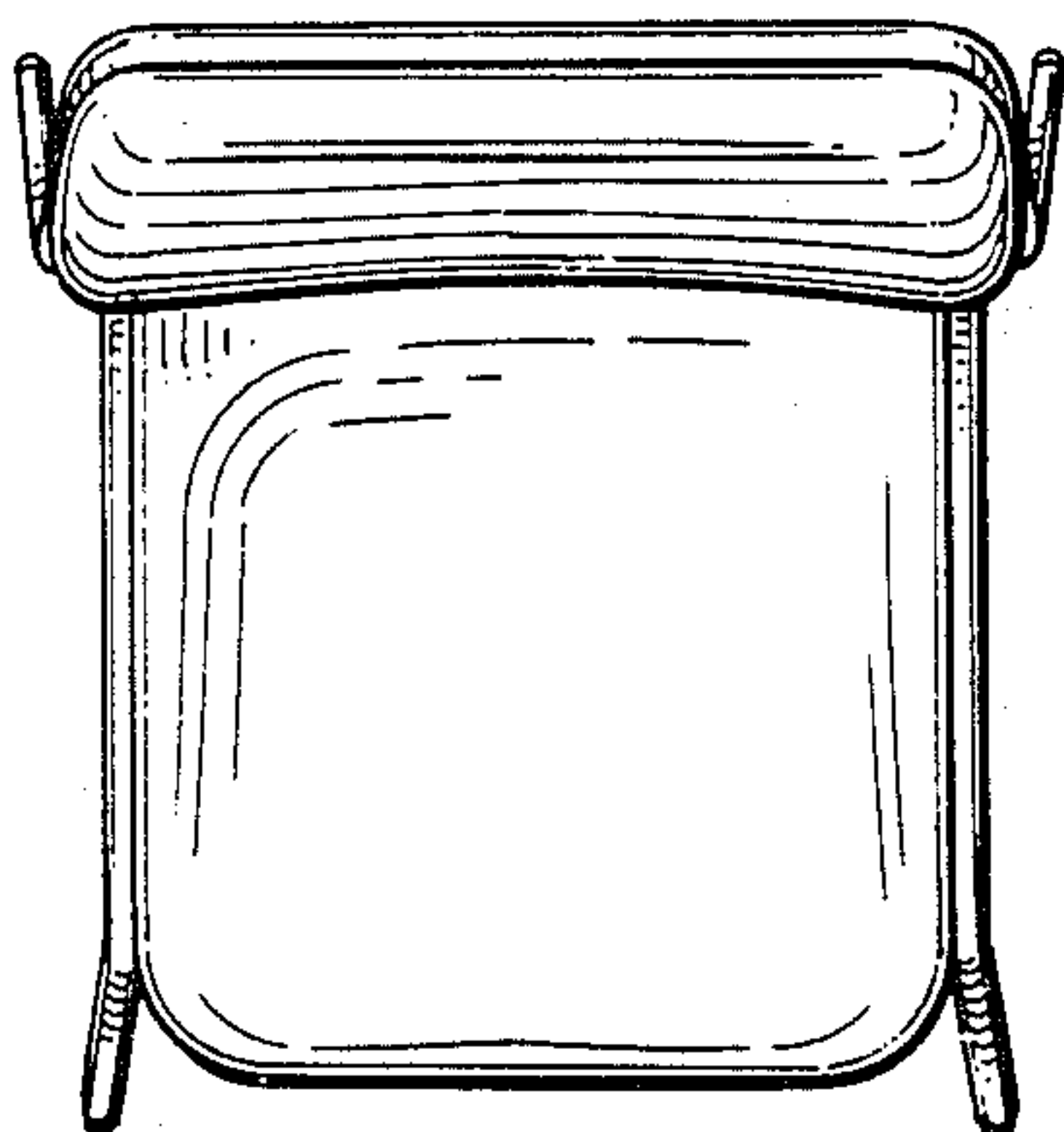

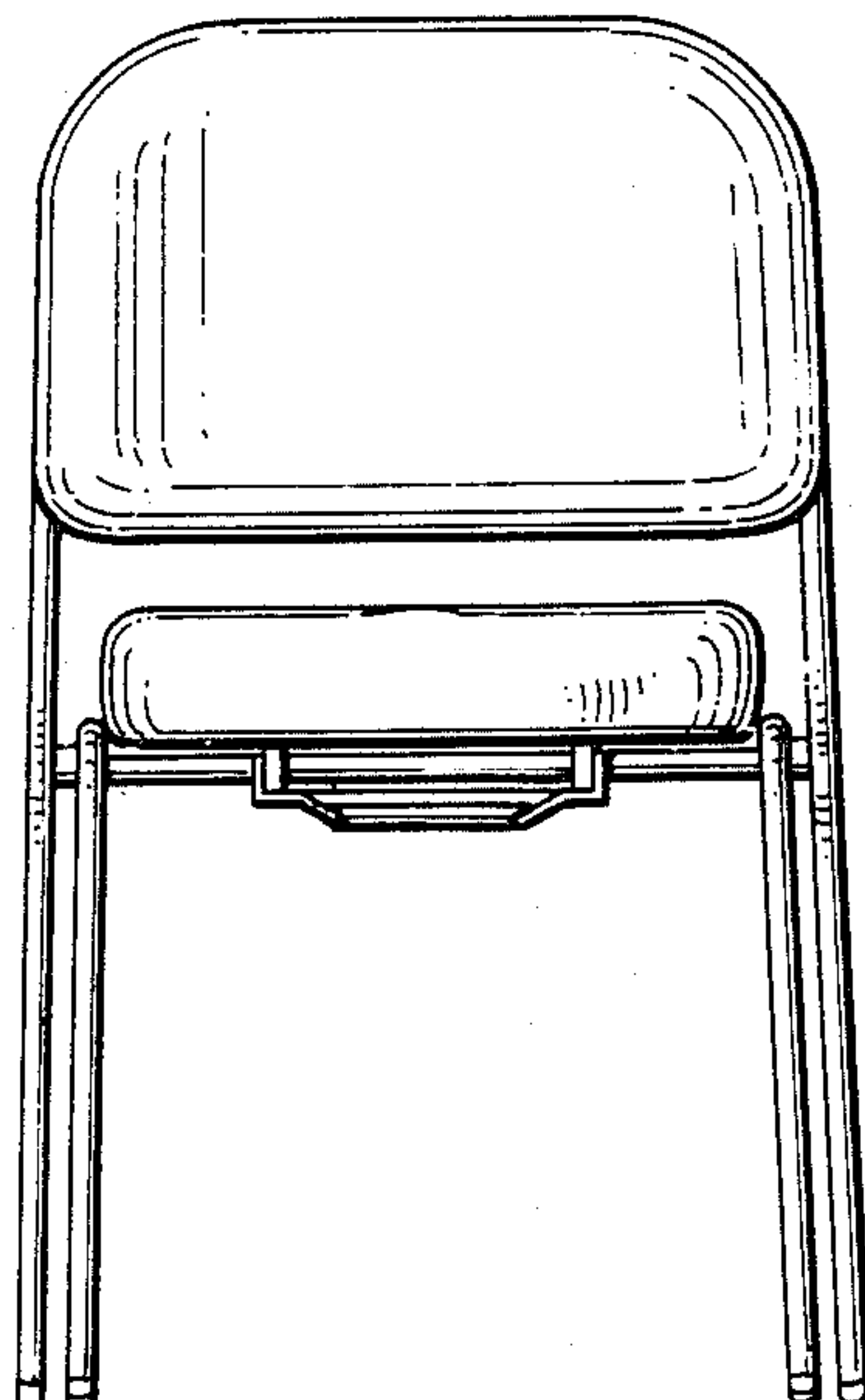

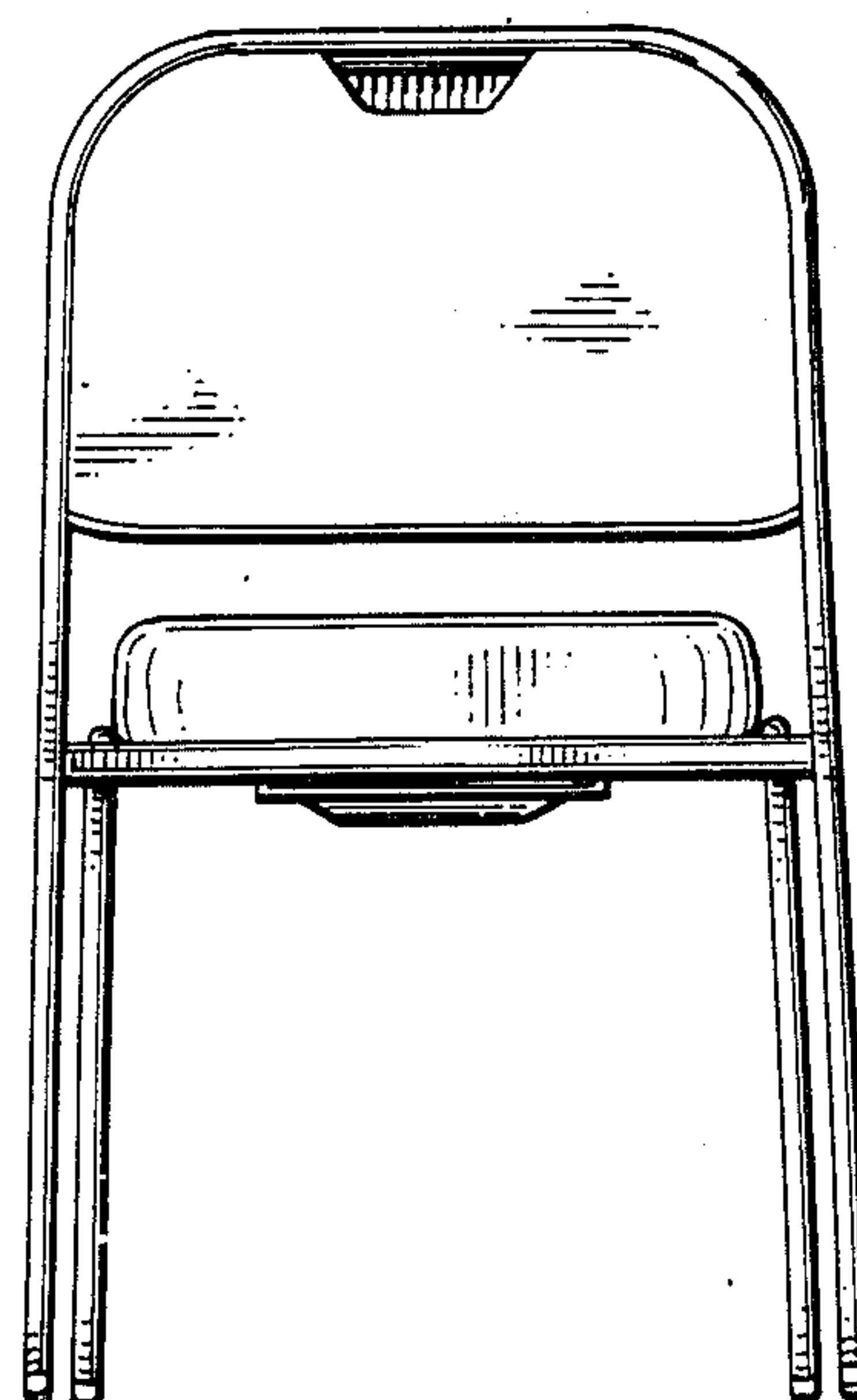

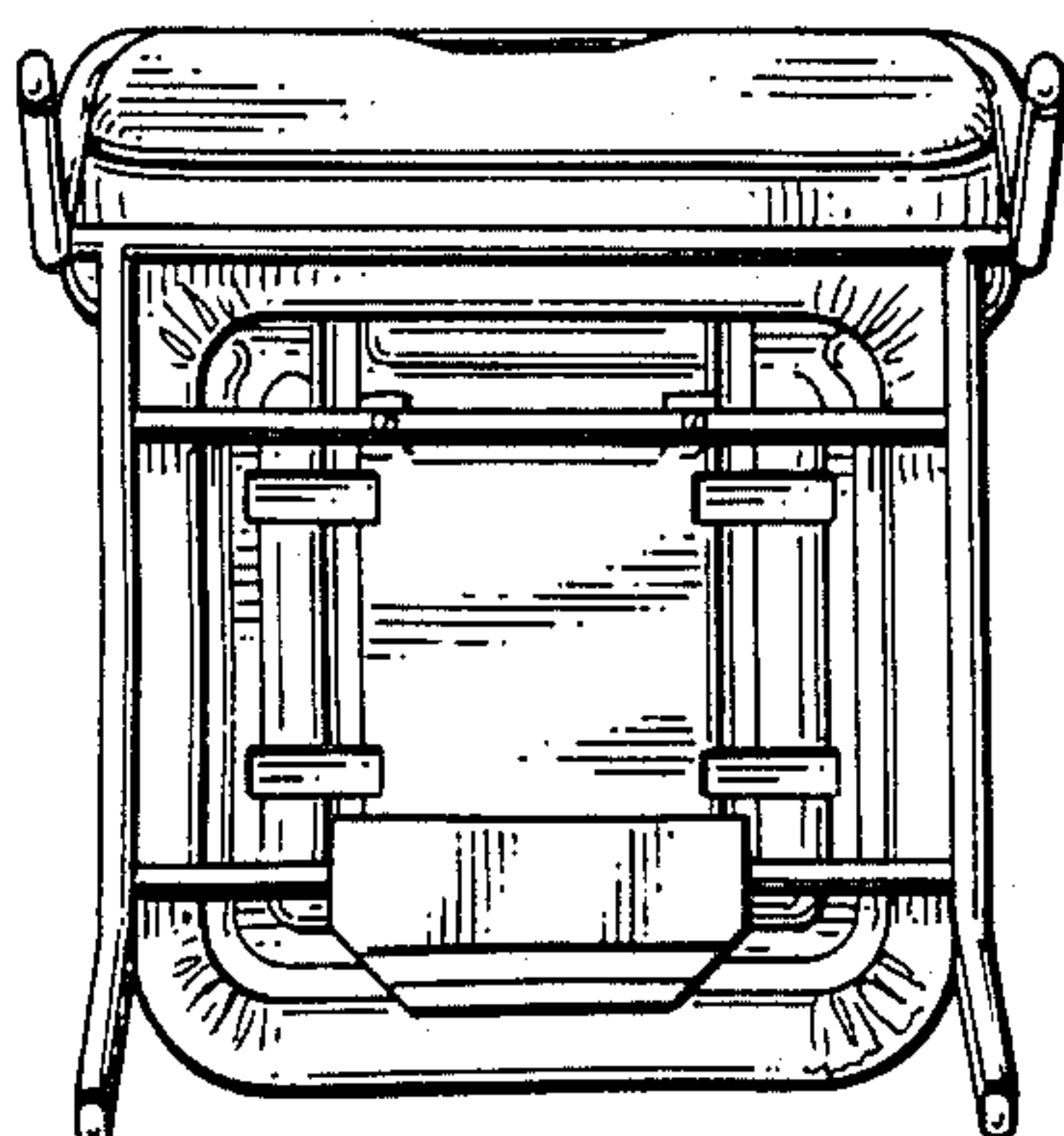

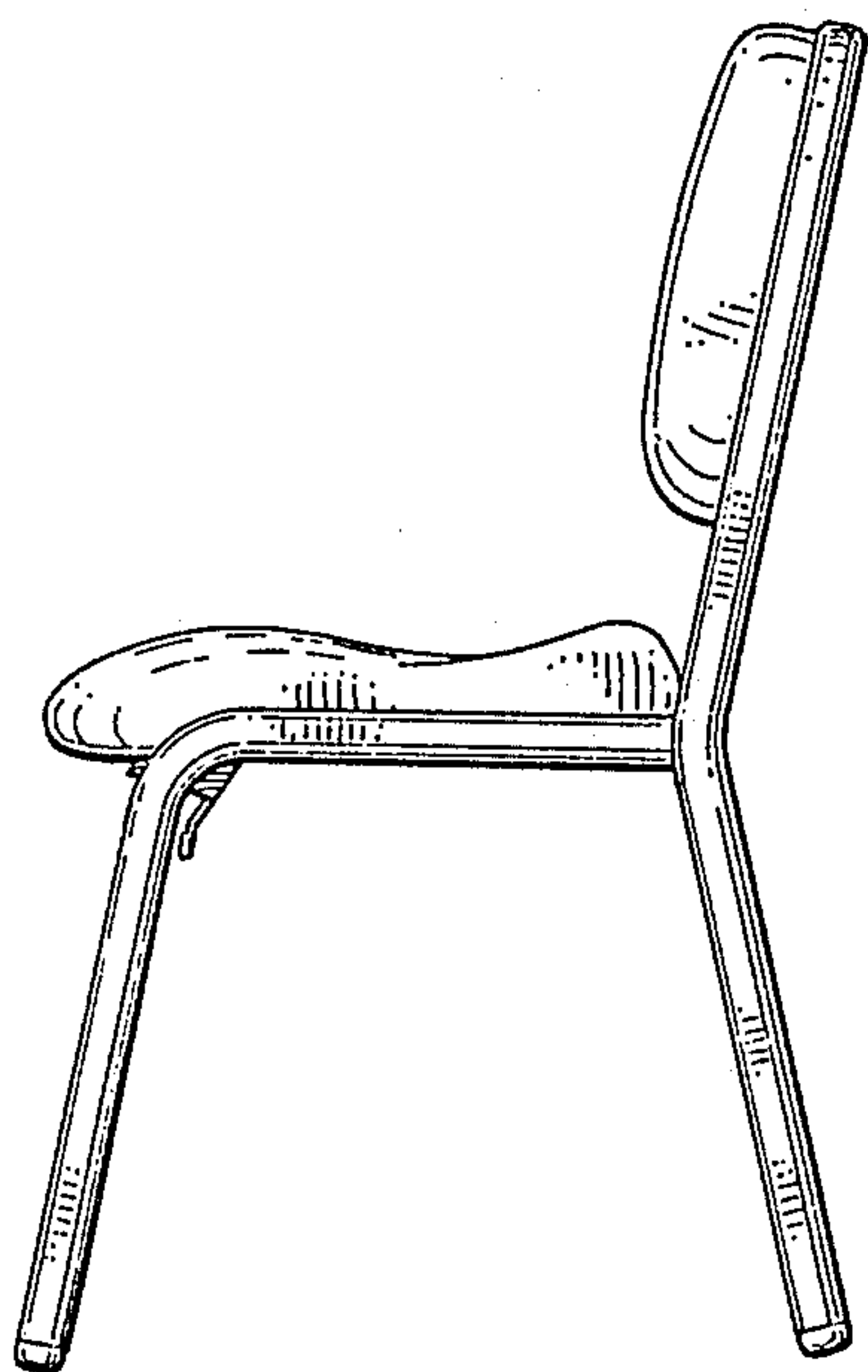
