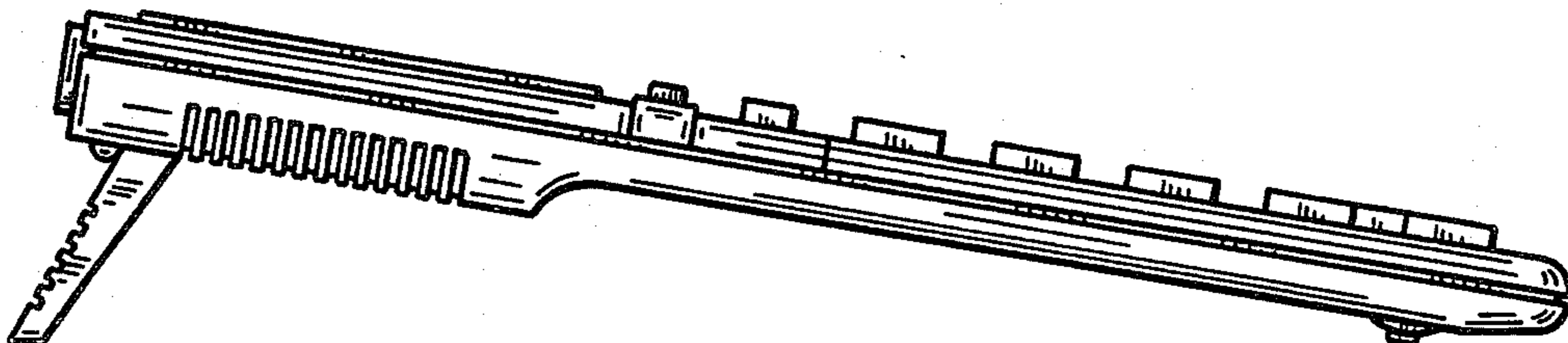
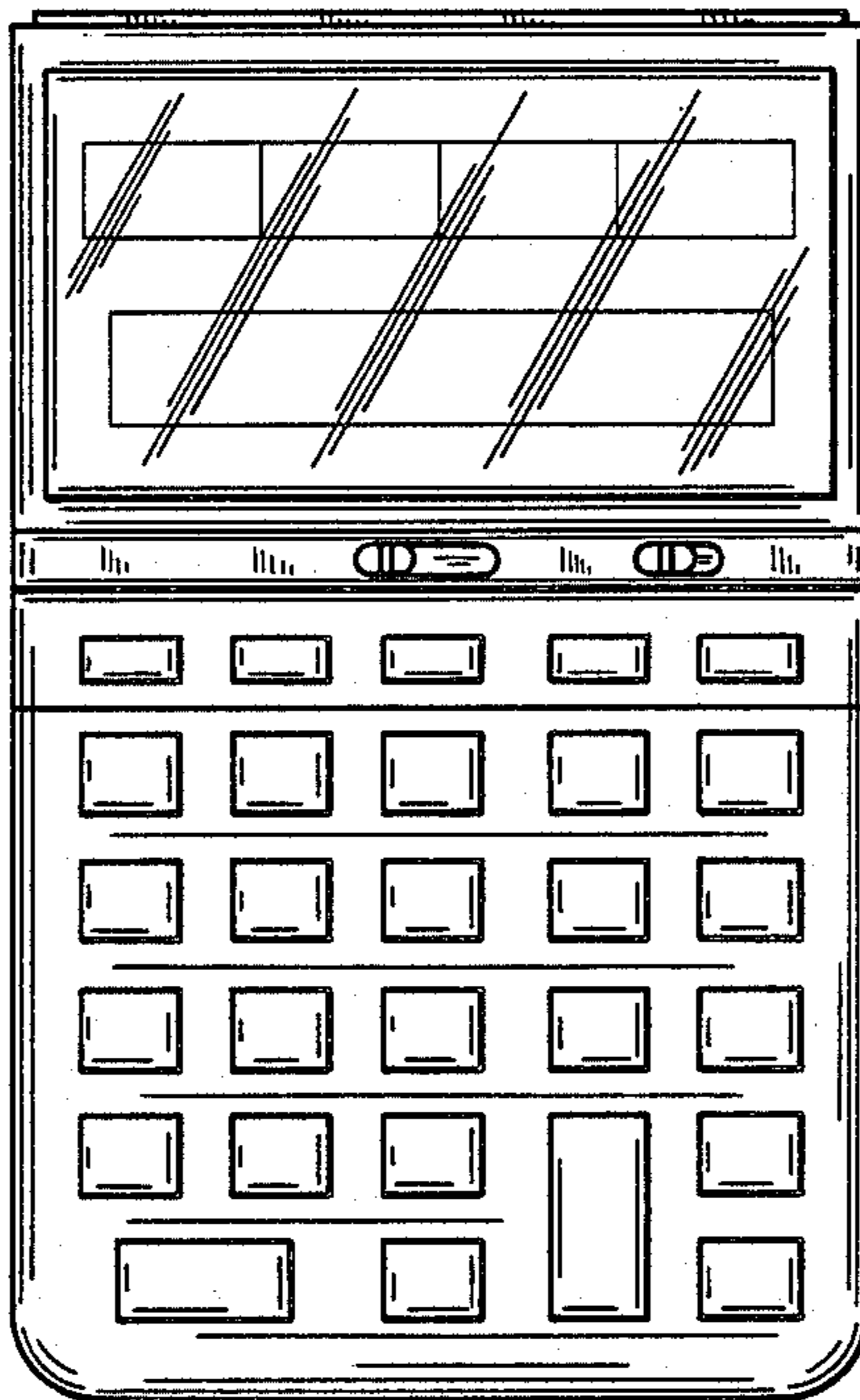

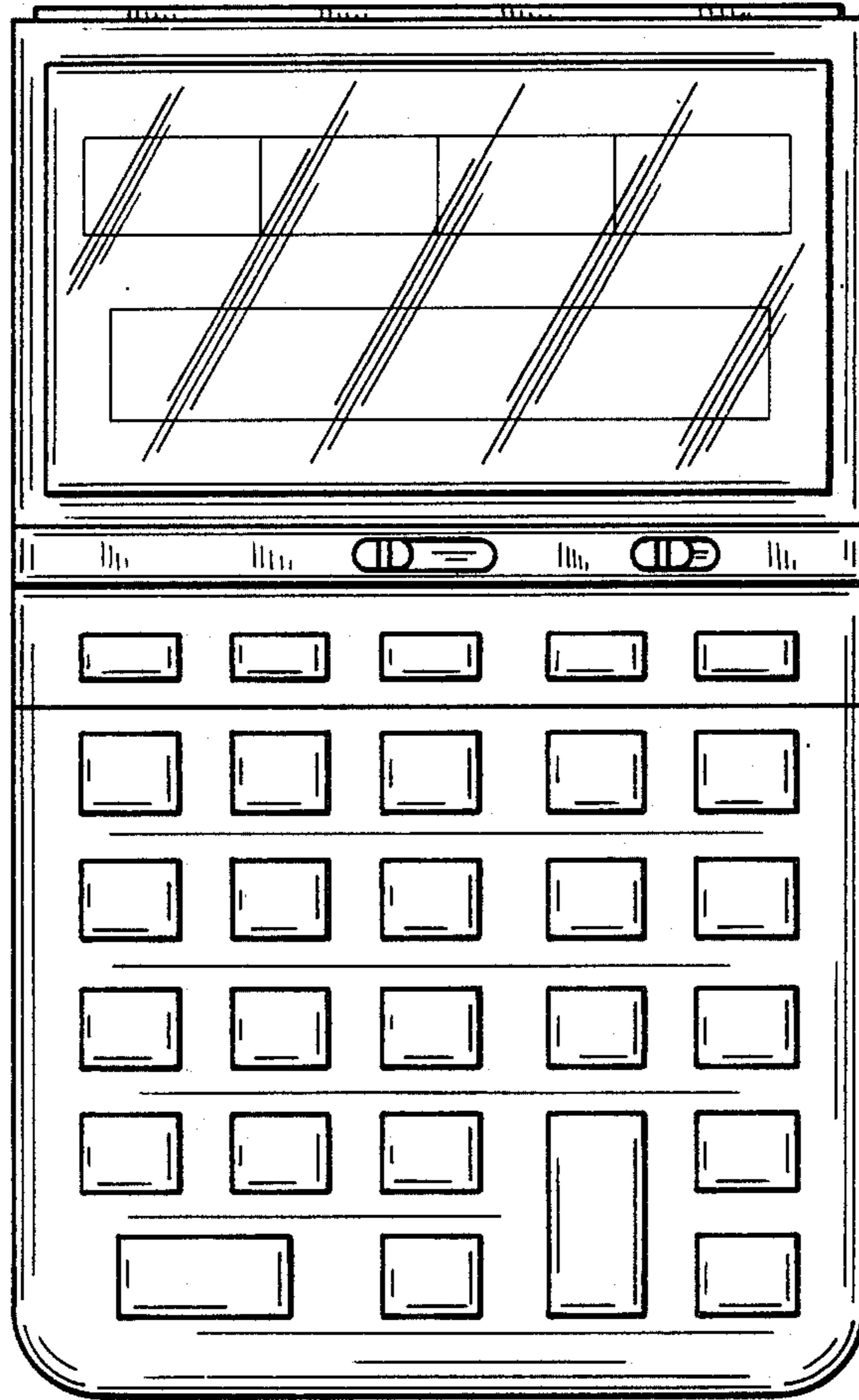
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof with the legs extended.

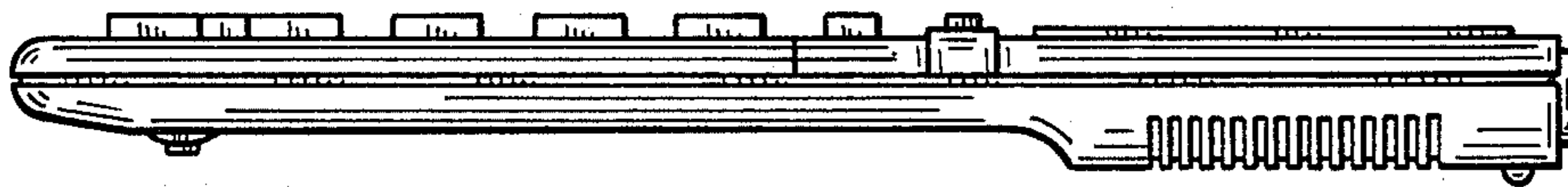




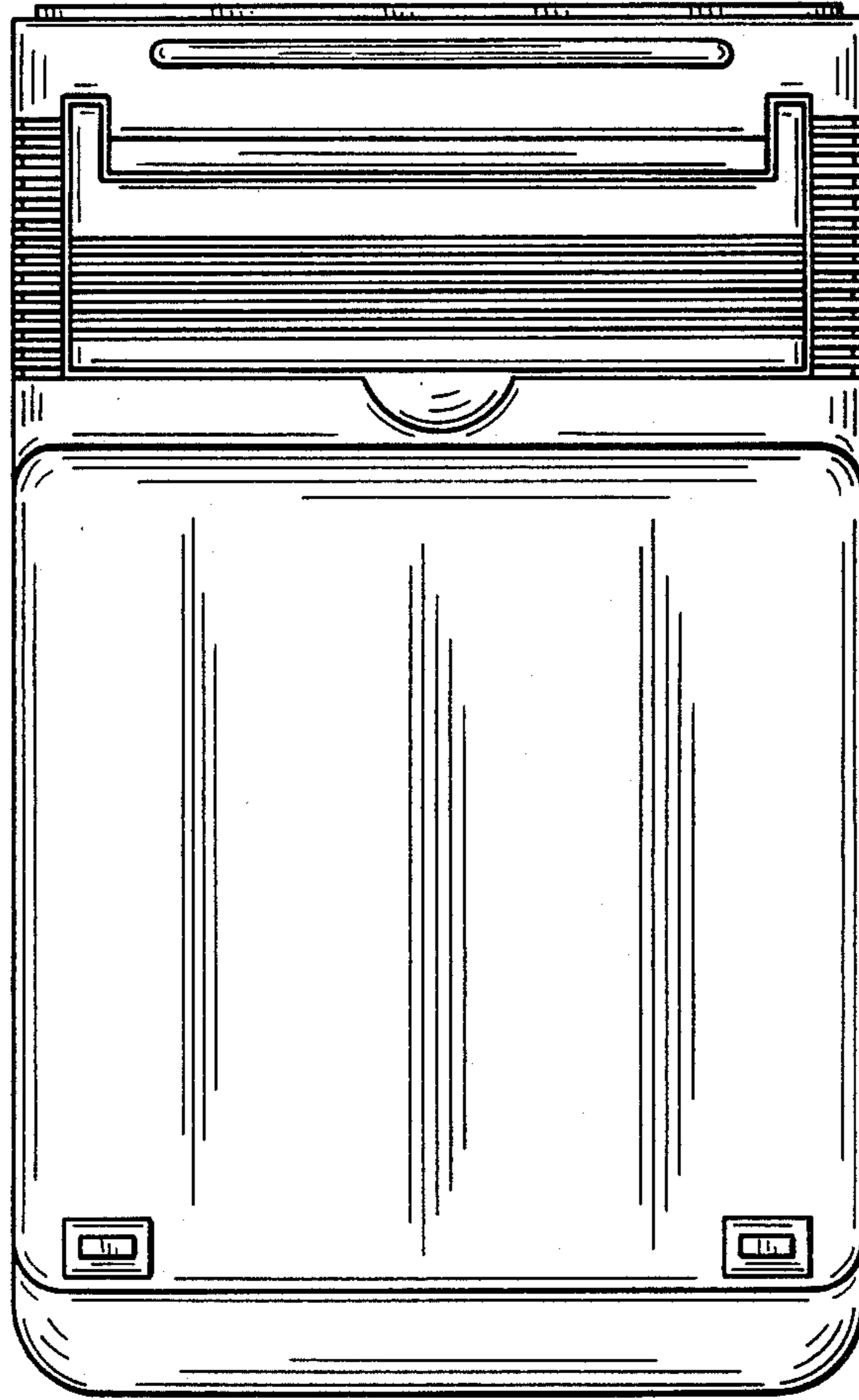

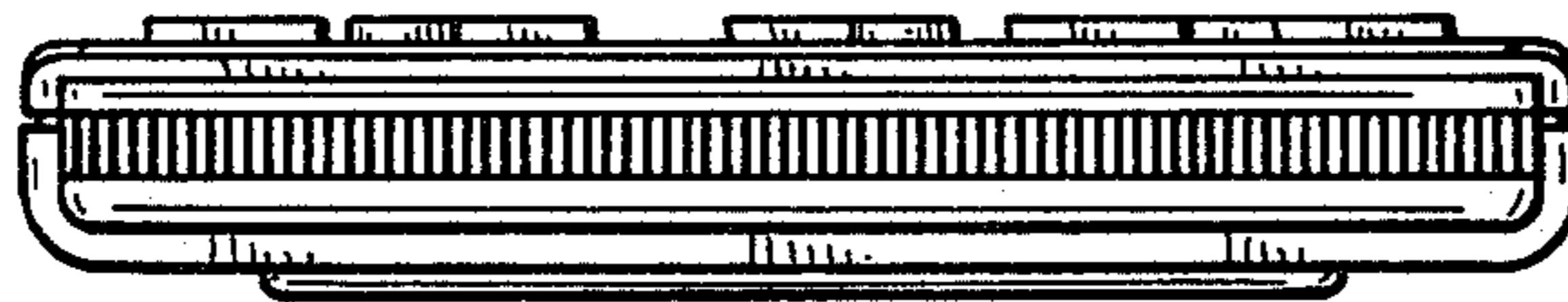

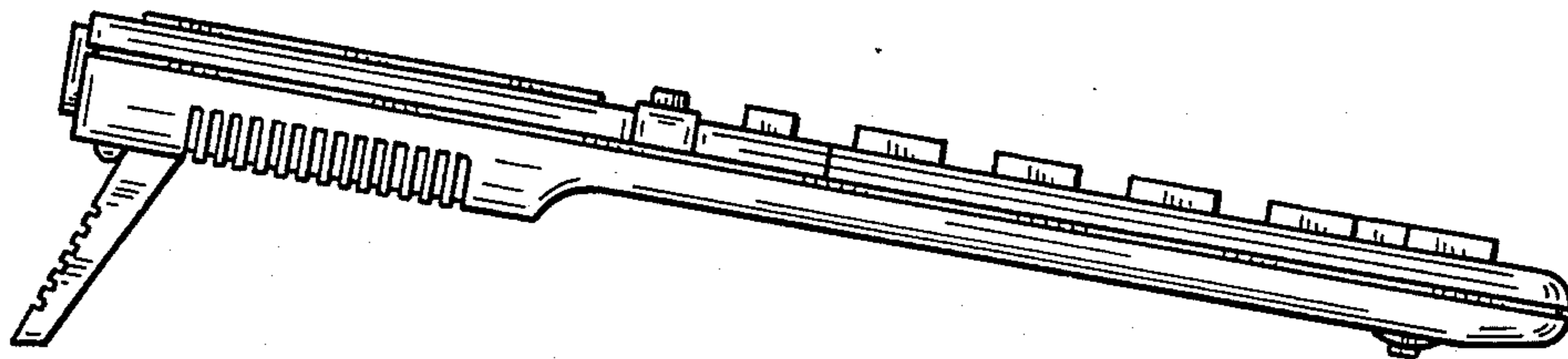
