[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a leg extension exercise station, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leg extension exercise station showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the inner face of the canopy thereof.
