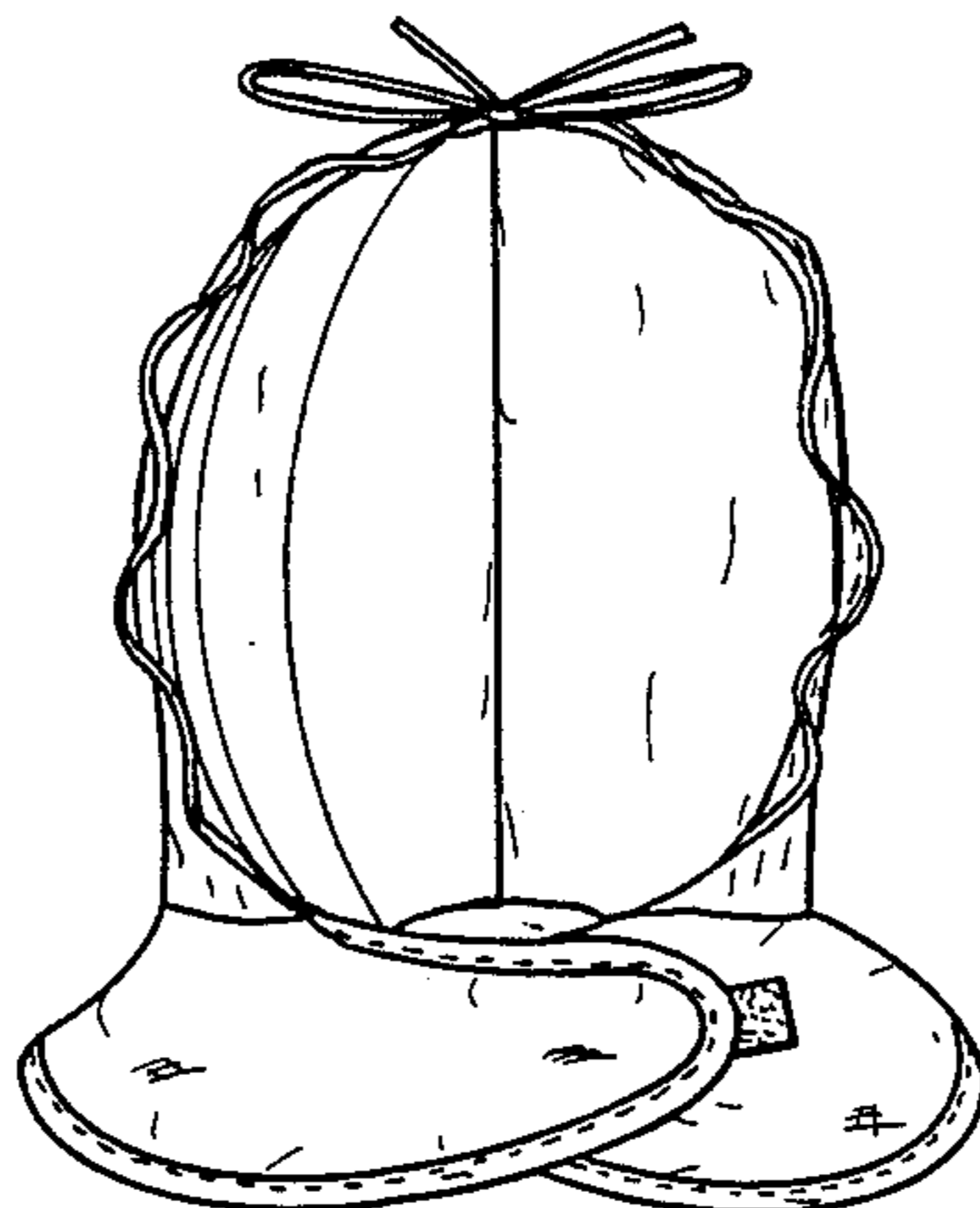
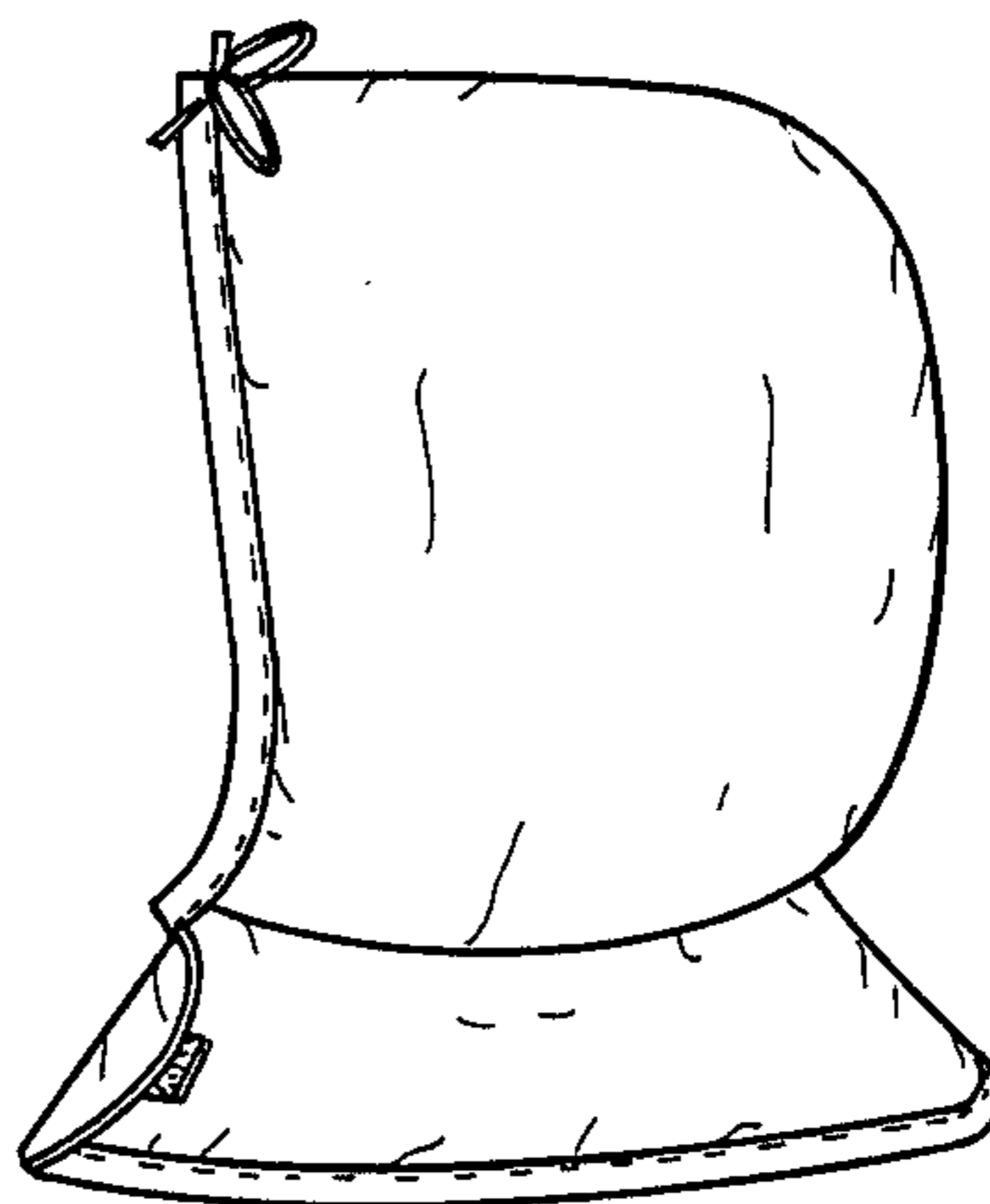

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable hat for an infant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an adjustable hat for an infant showing my new design, the broken line showing of an infant is for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view with the collar open; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view with the collar portion in a second adjustment position; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the adjustable hat for an infant shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof.



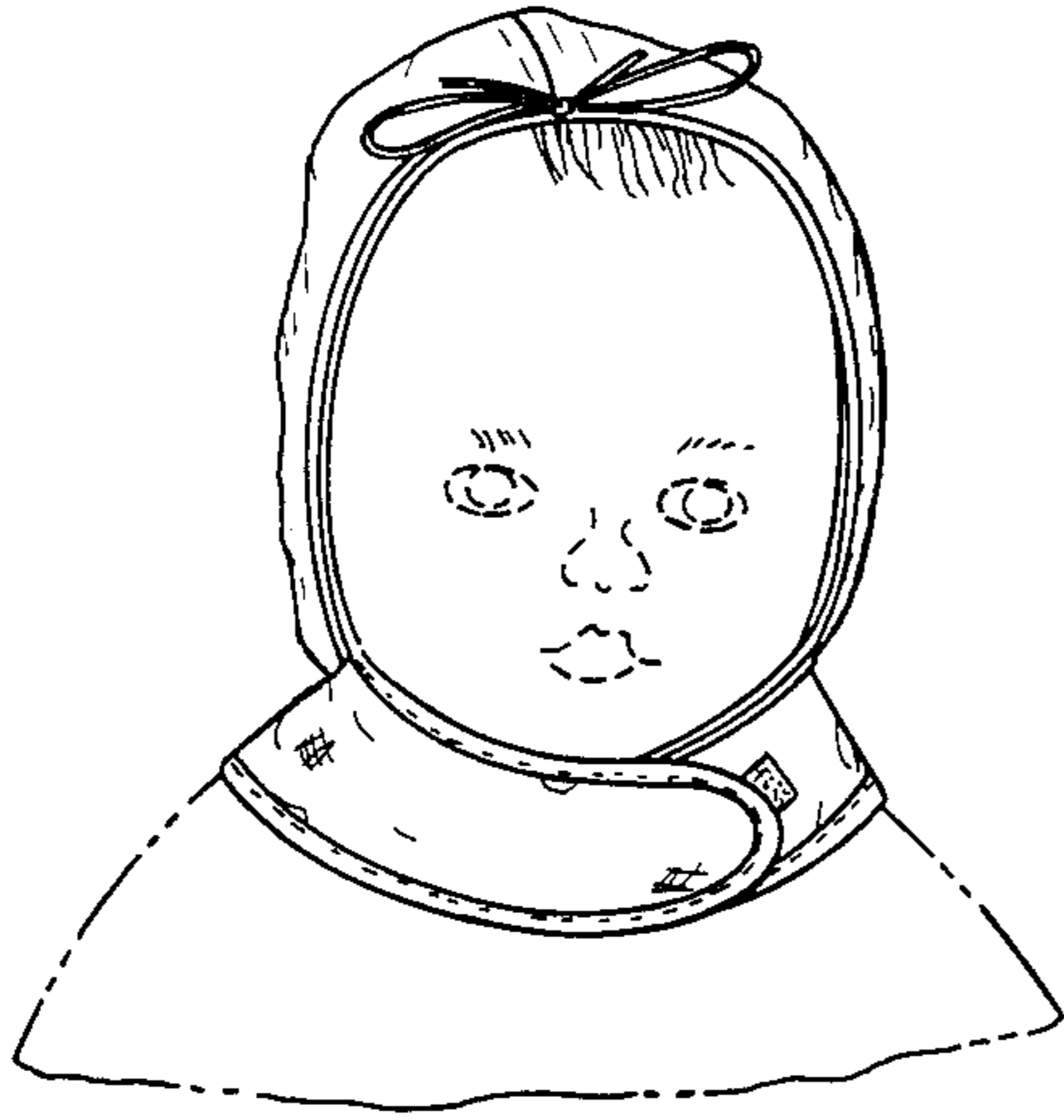

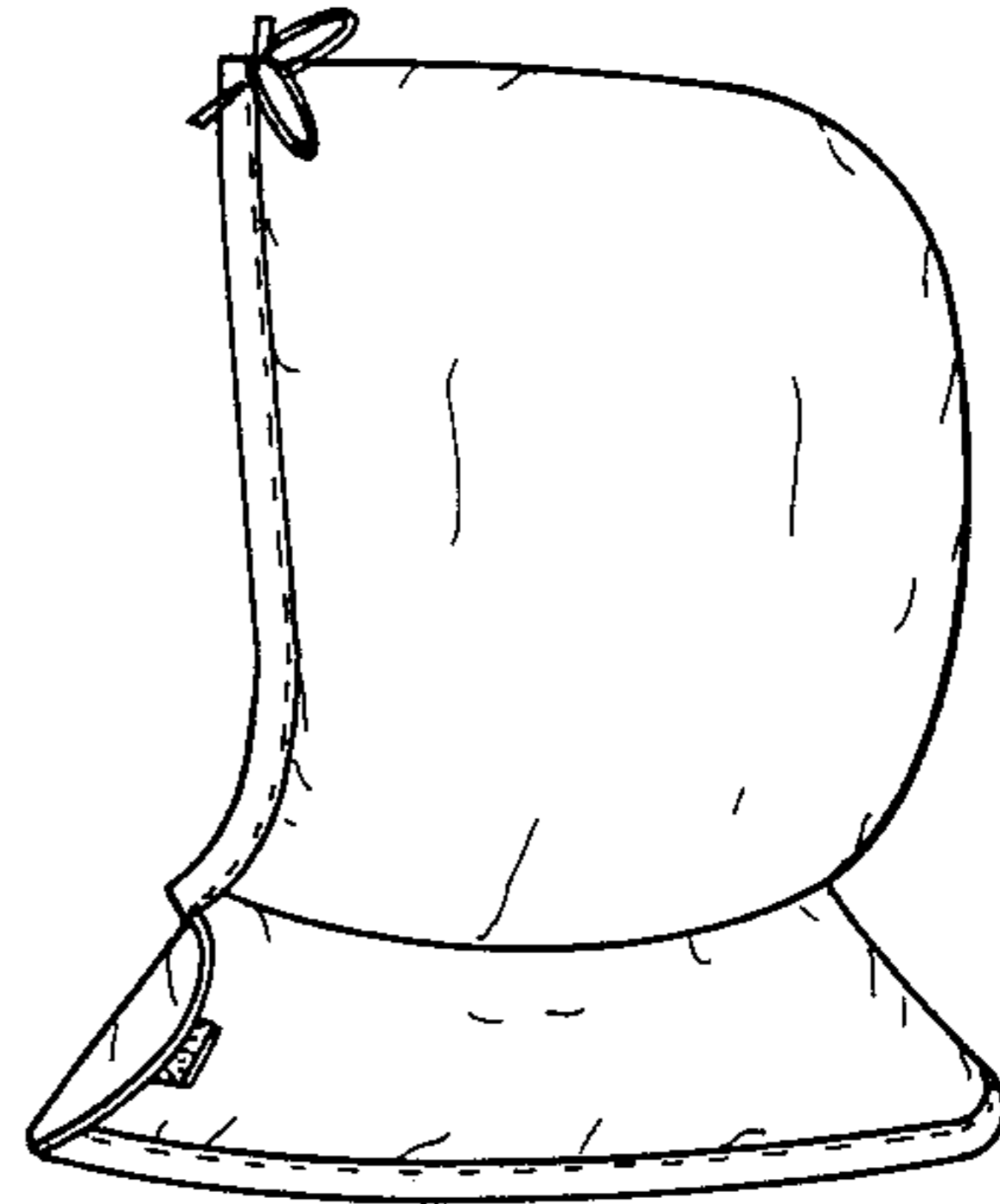

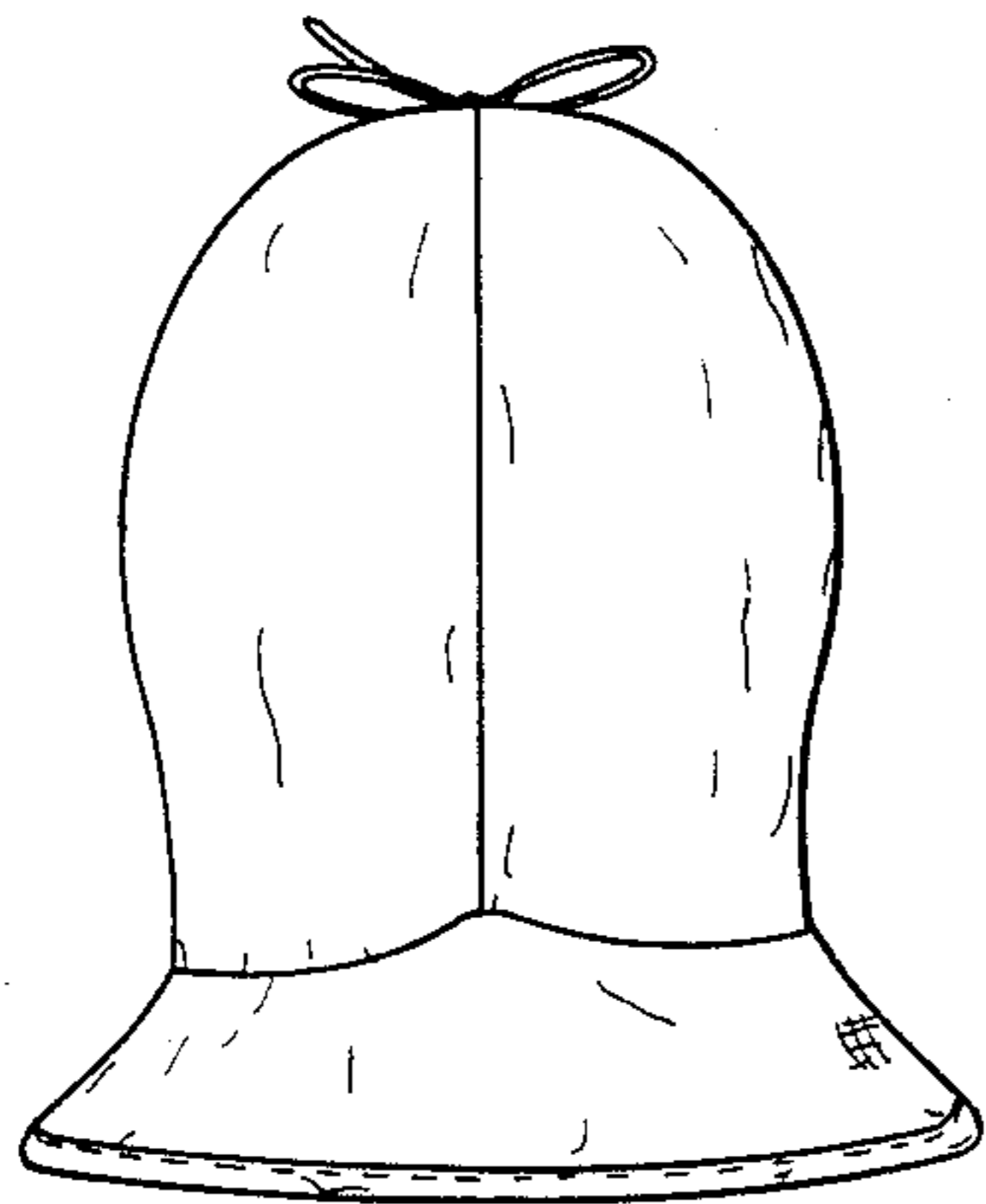

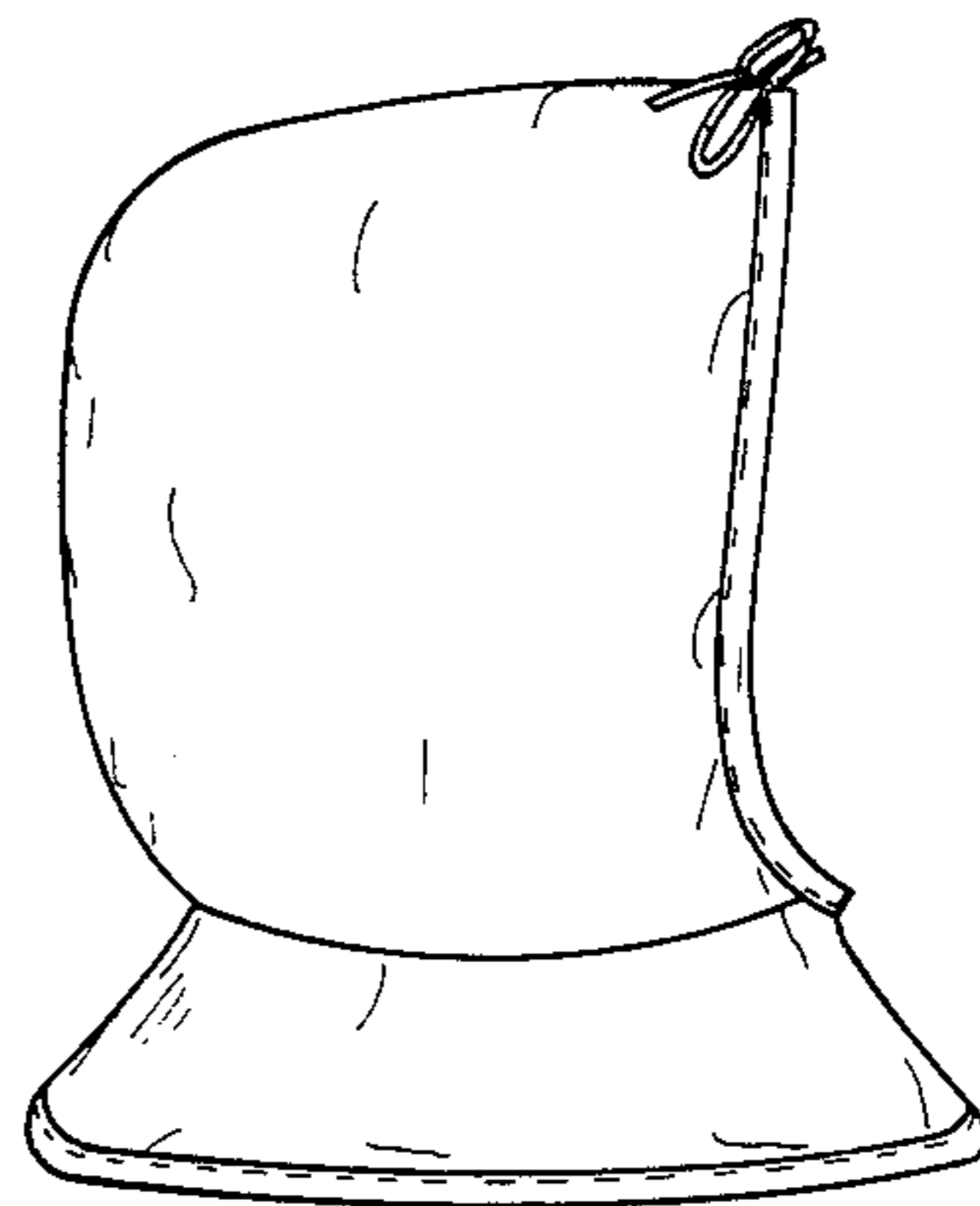

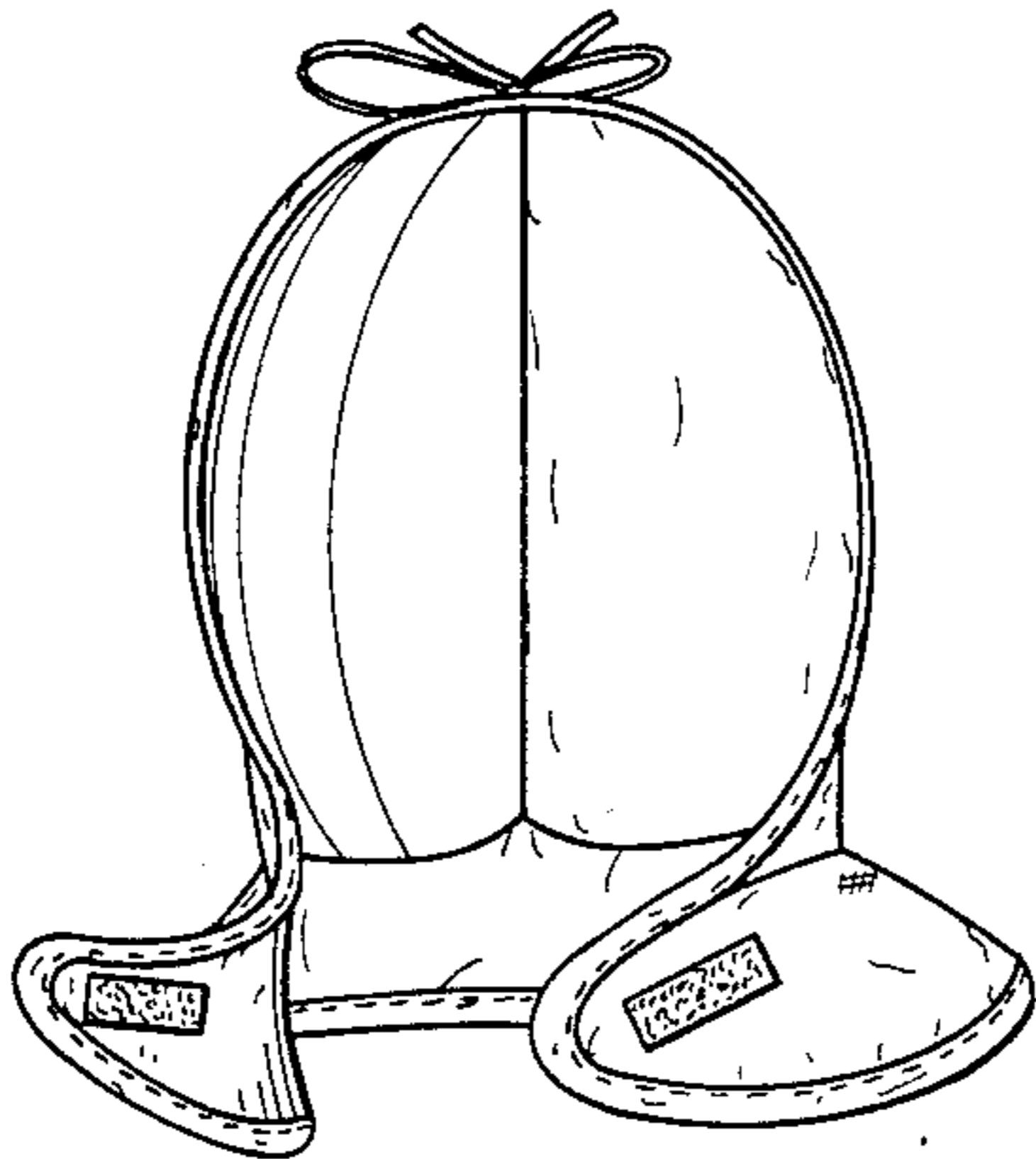

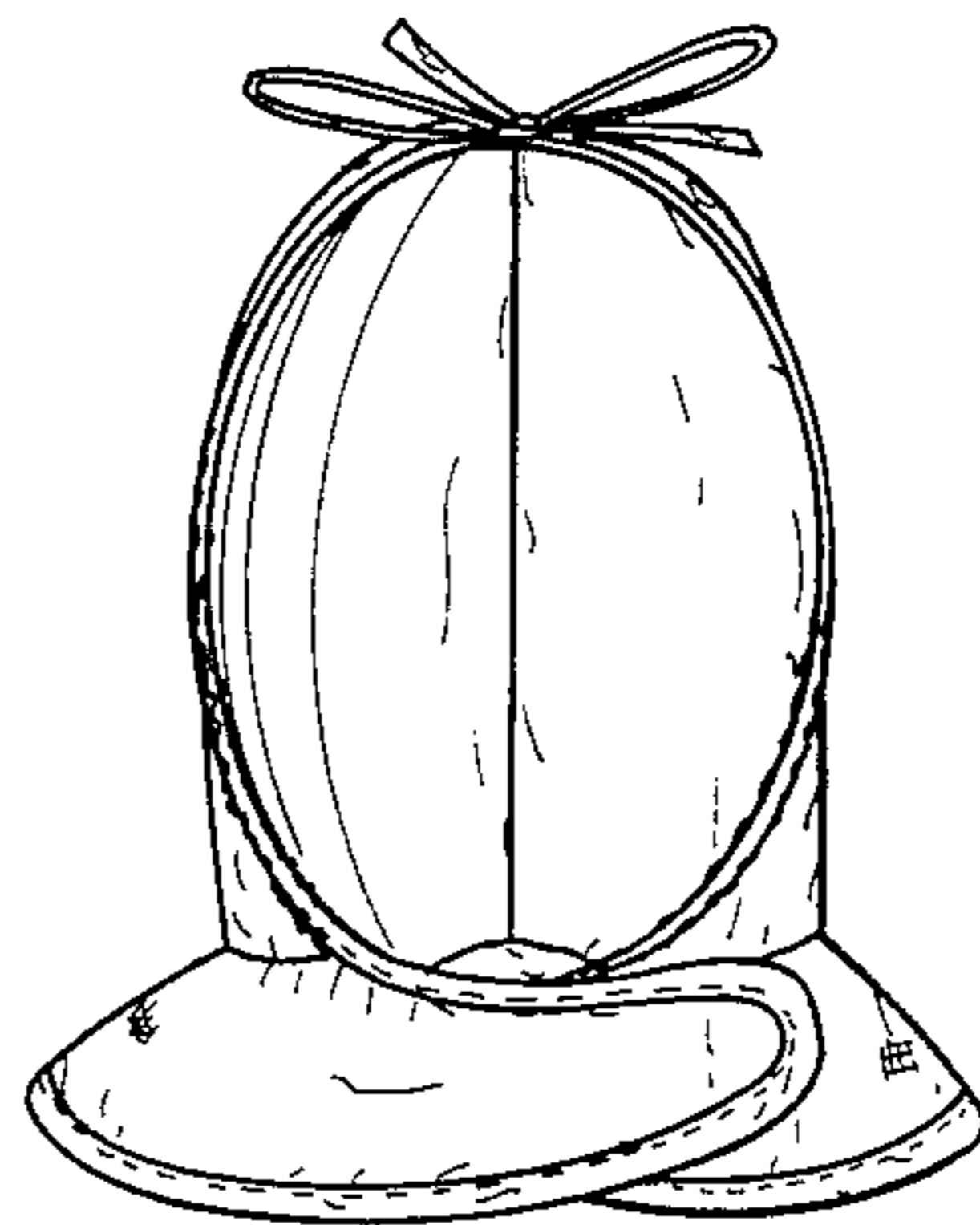

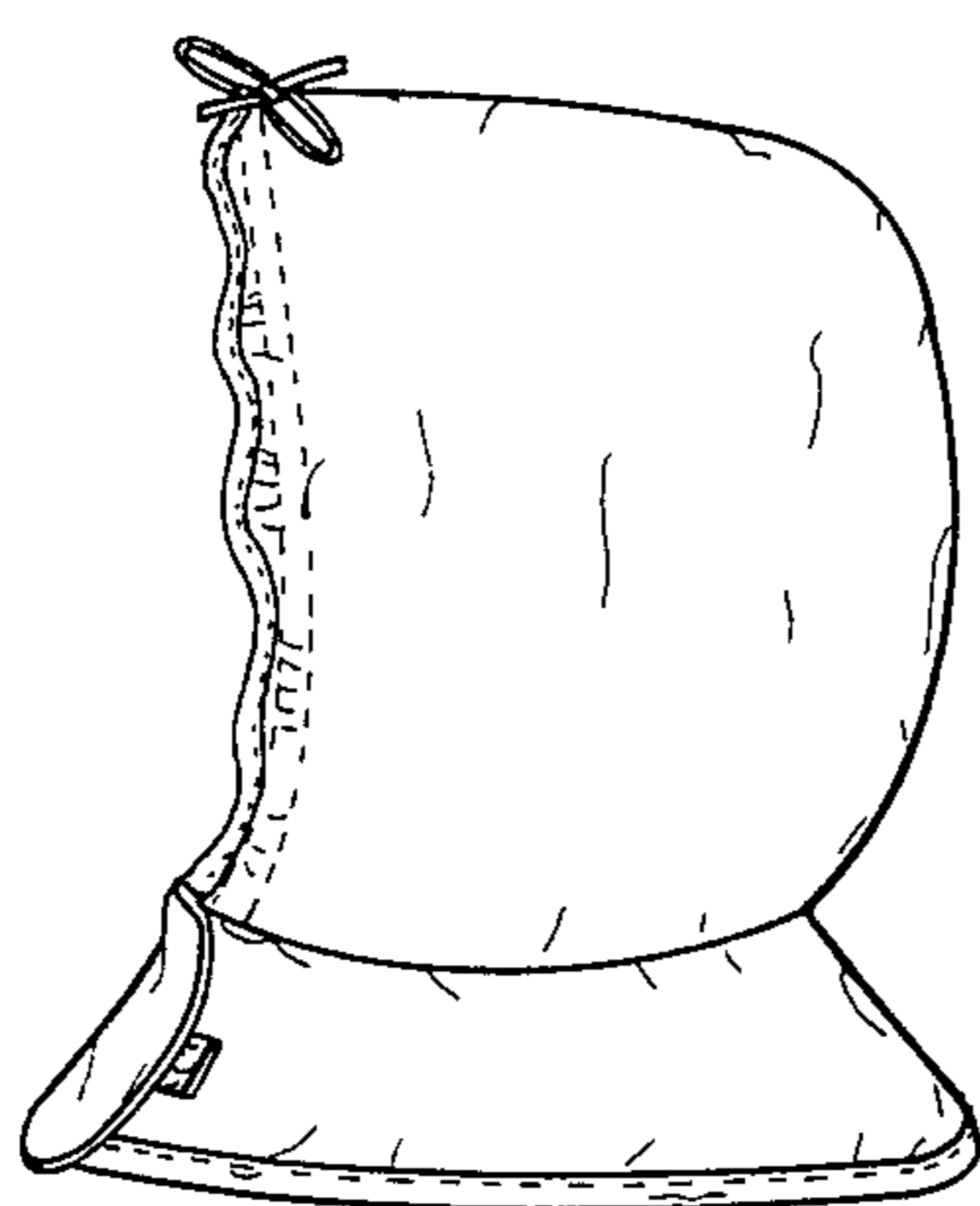
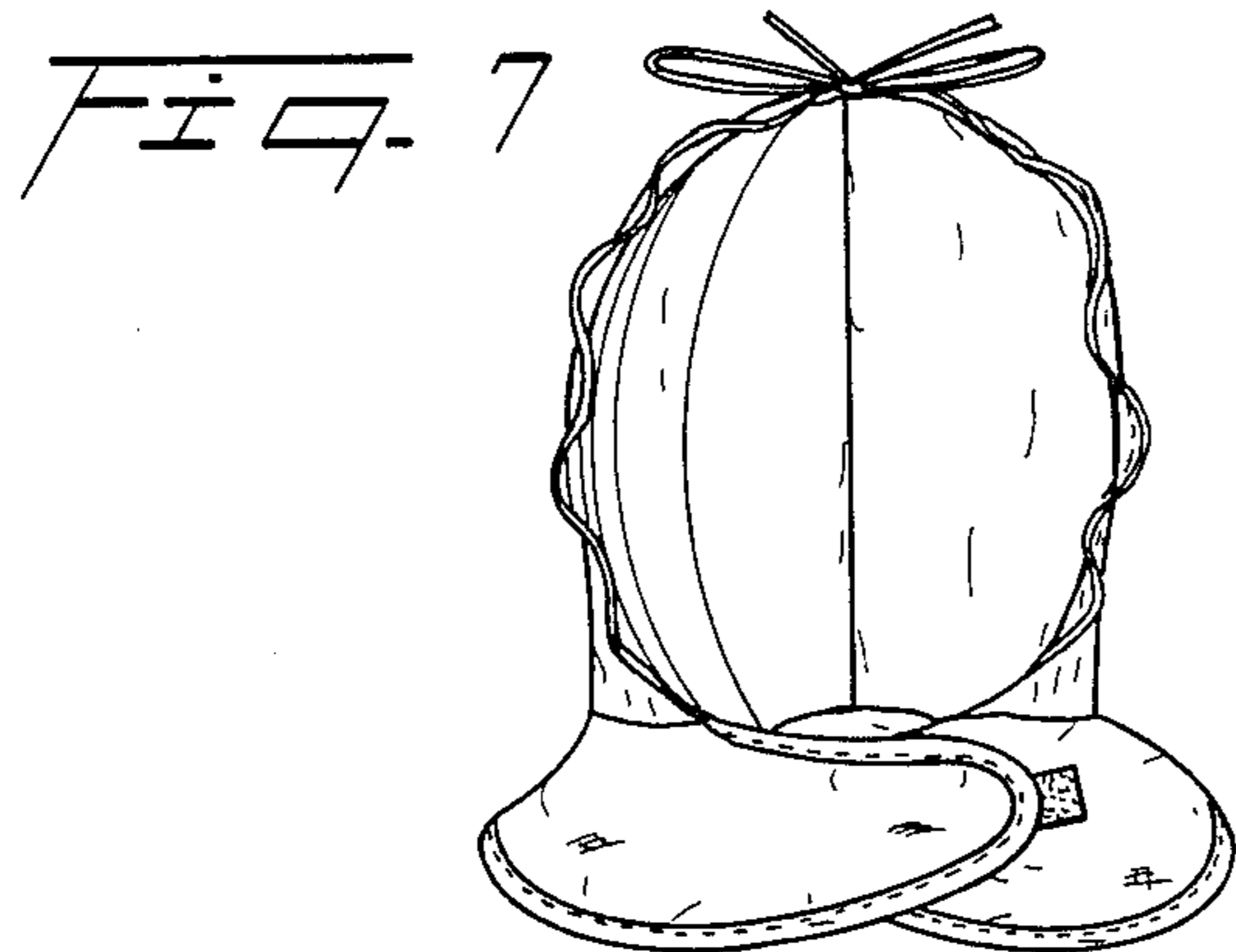

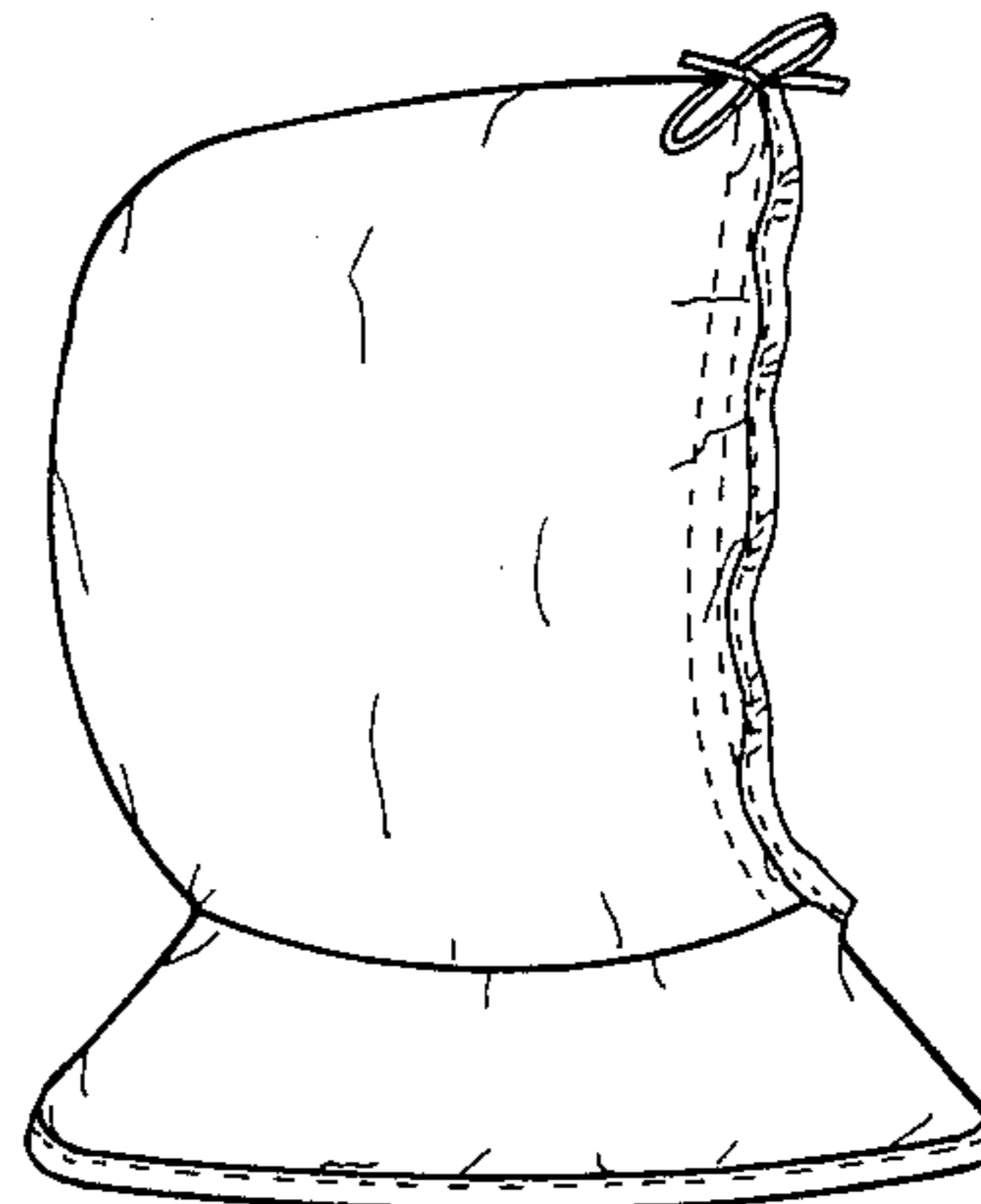

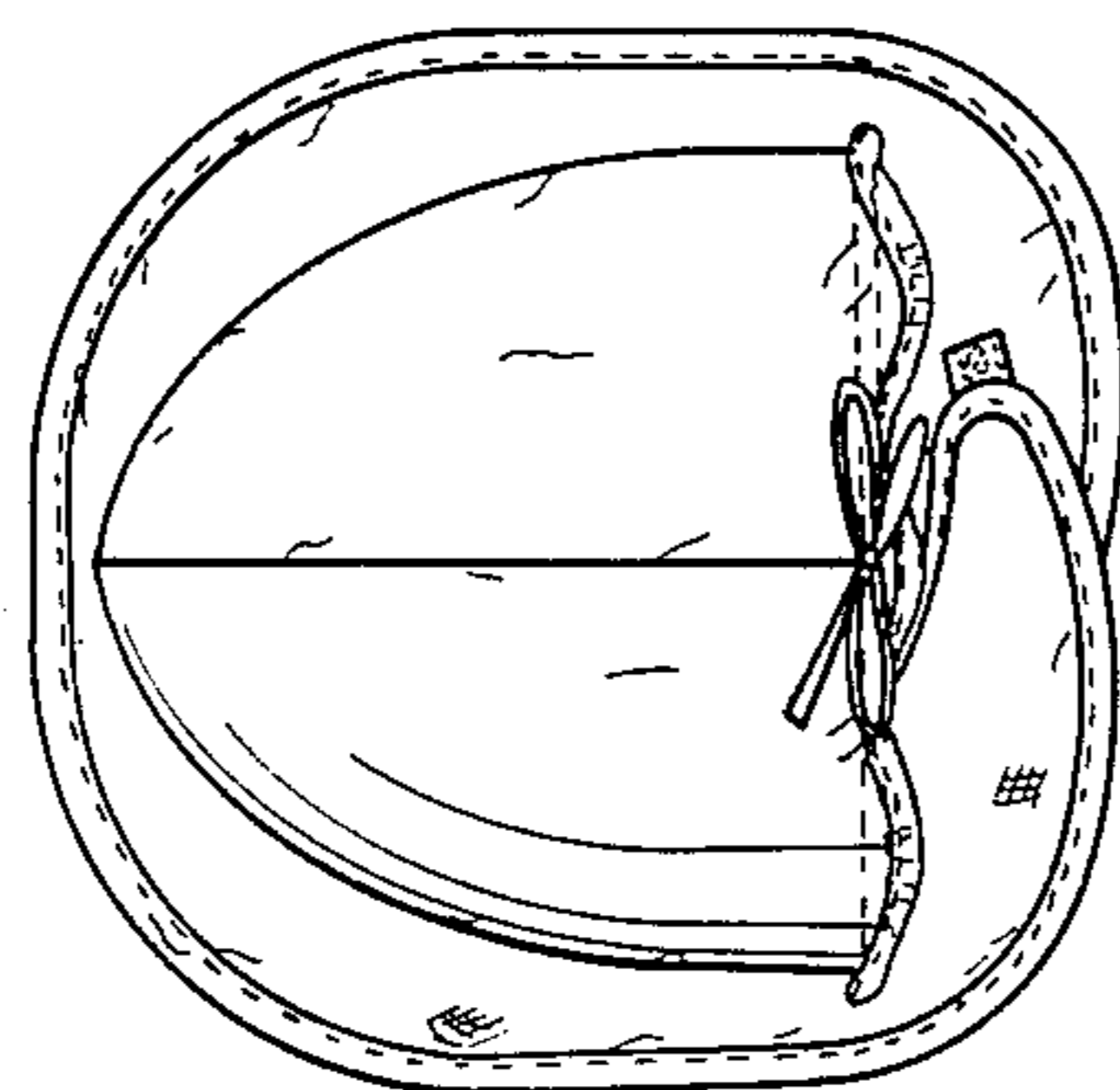
