DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a hand manipulated exercise device, showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;


FIG. 8 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of yet another embodiment of a hand manipulated exercise device, showing a further variation of my new design;


FIG. 10 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;


FIG. 11 is a bottom view thereof; and


FIG. 12 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image.
















