DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an air filter housing for mounting on an internal combustion engine showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged, fragmentary, vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is an enlarged front and right side perspective view thereof, the undisclosed bottom being plain and unornamented.
