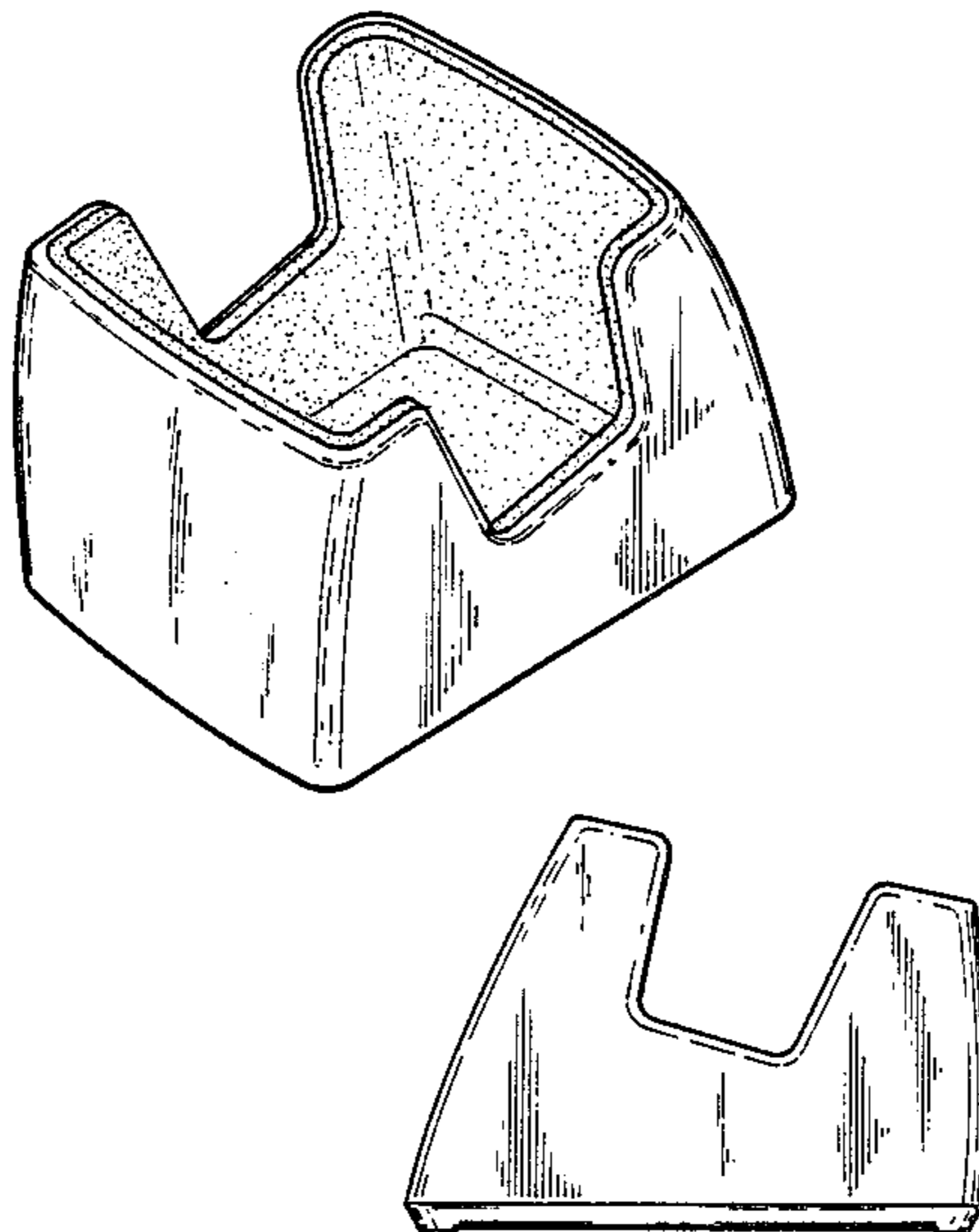

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view for a bar code scanner holder showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



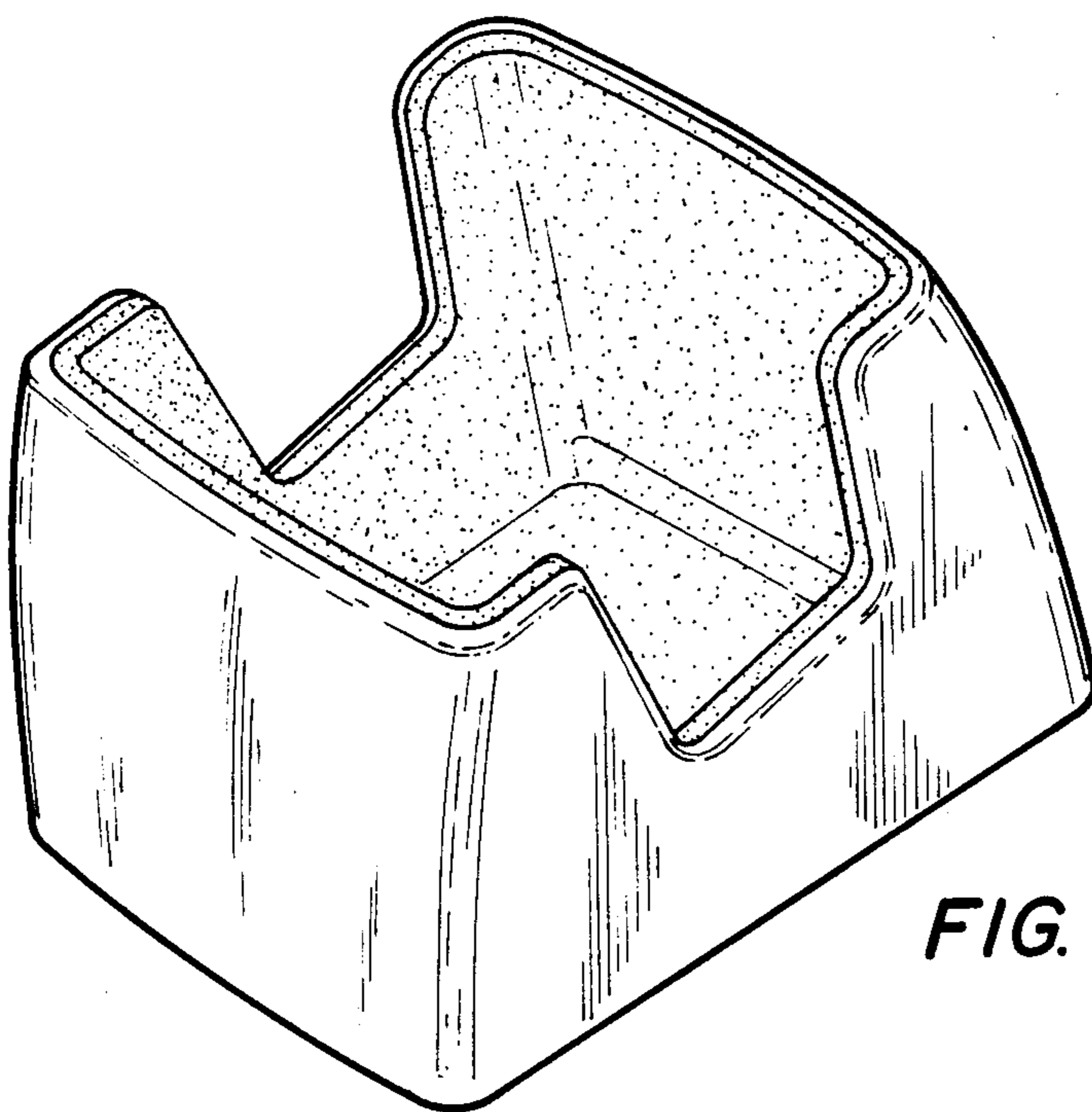

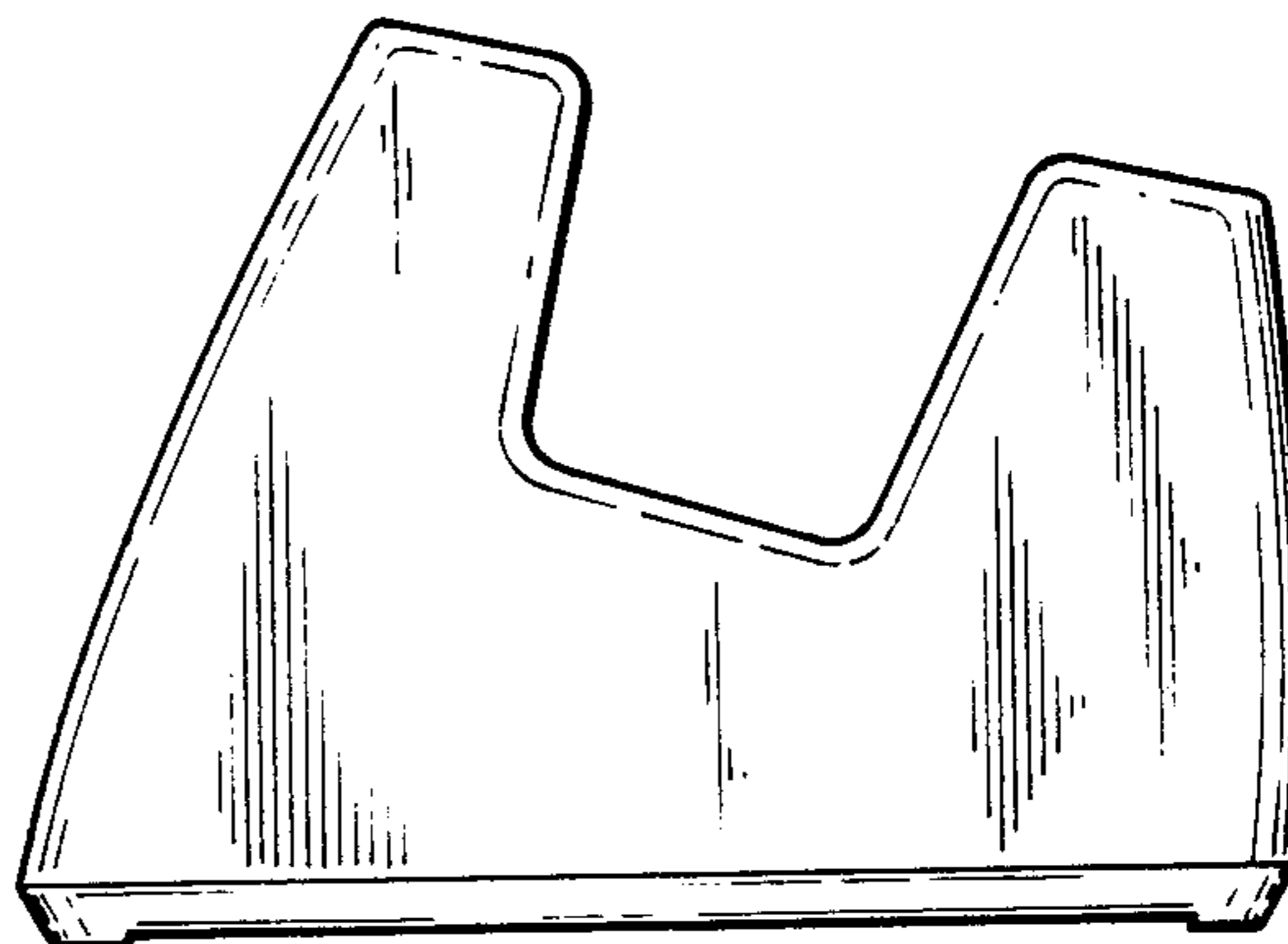

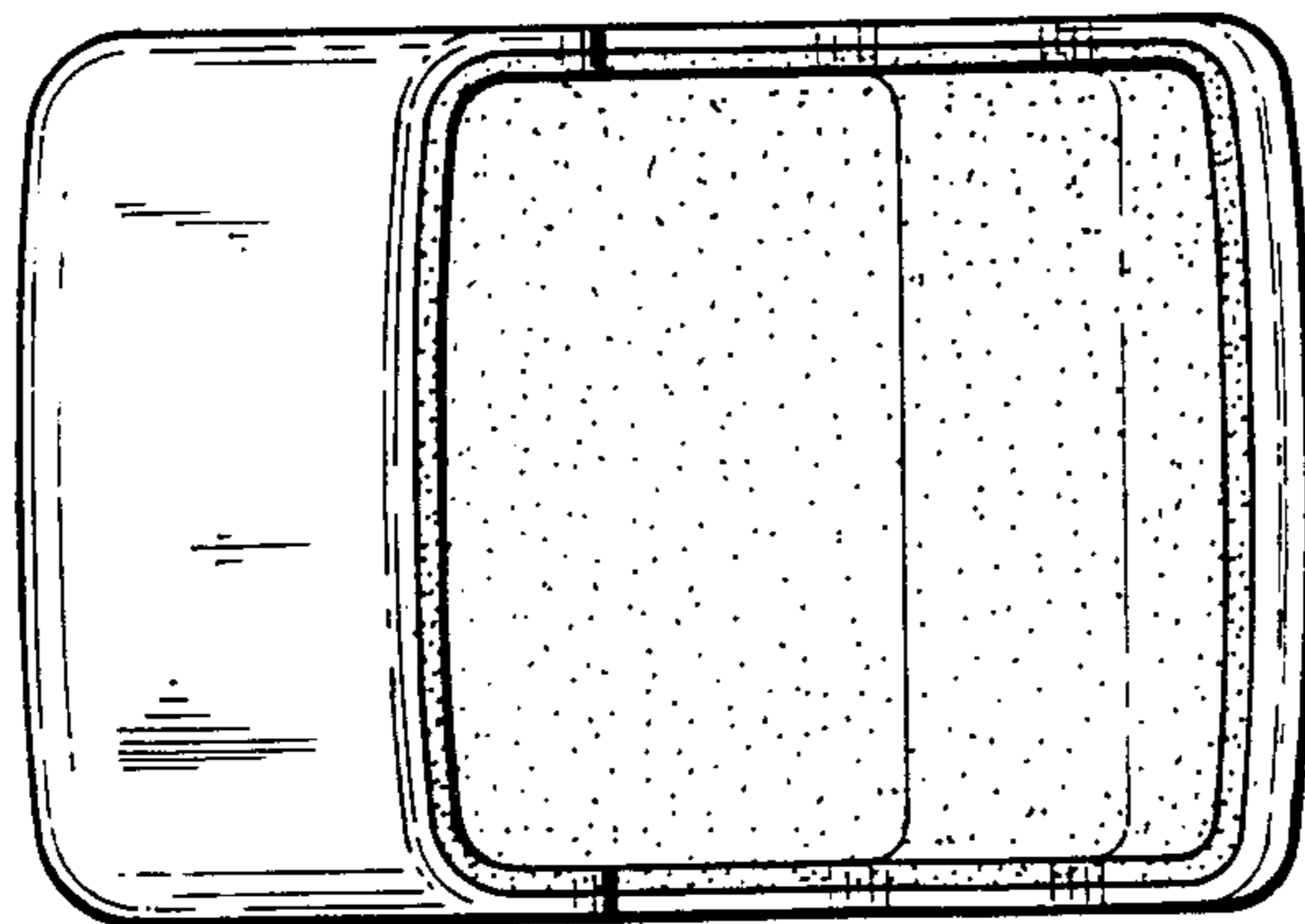

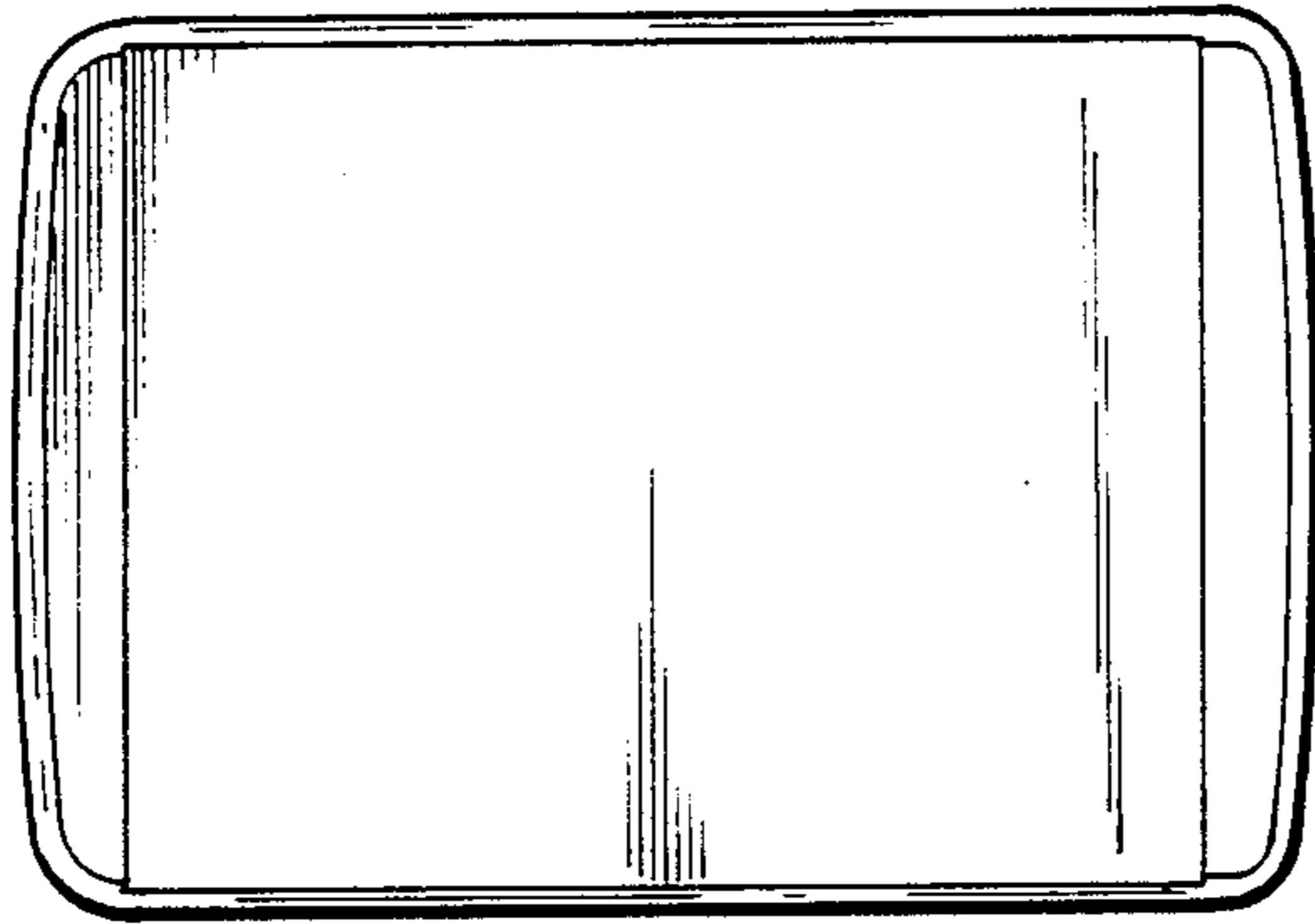

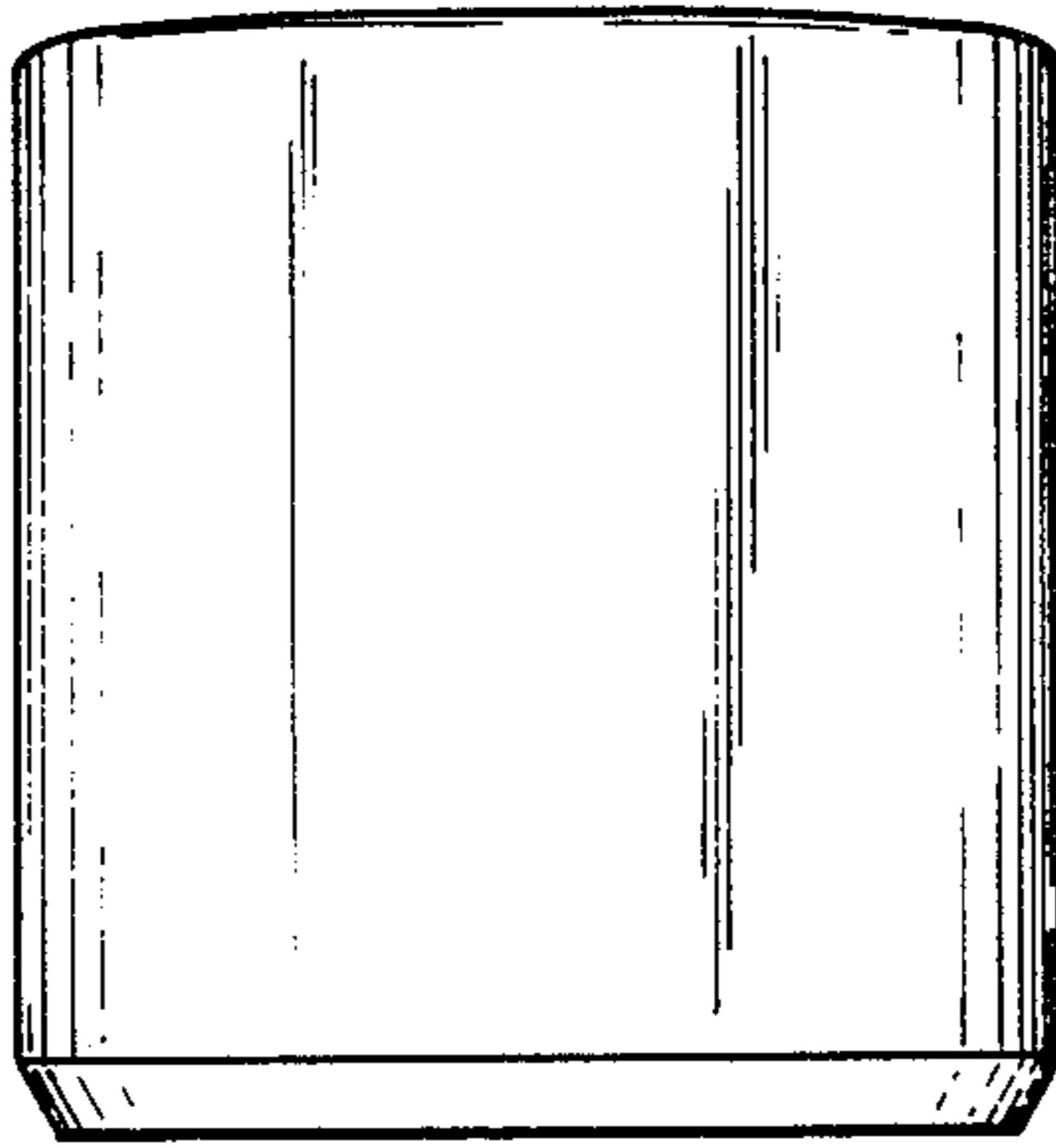

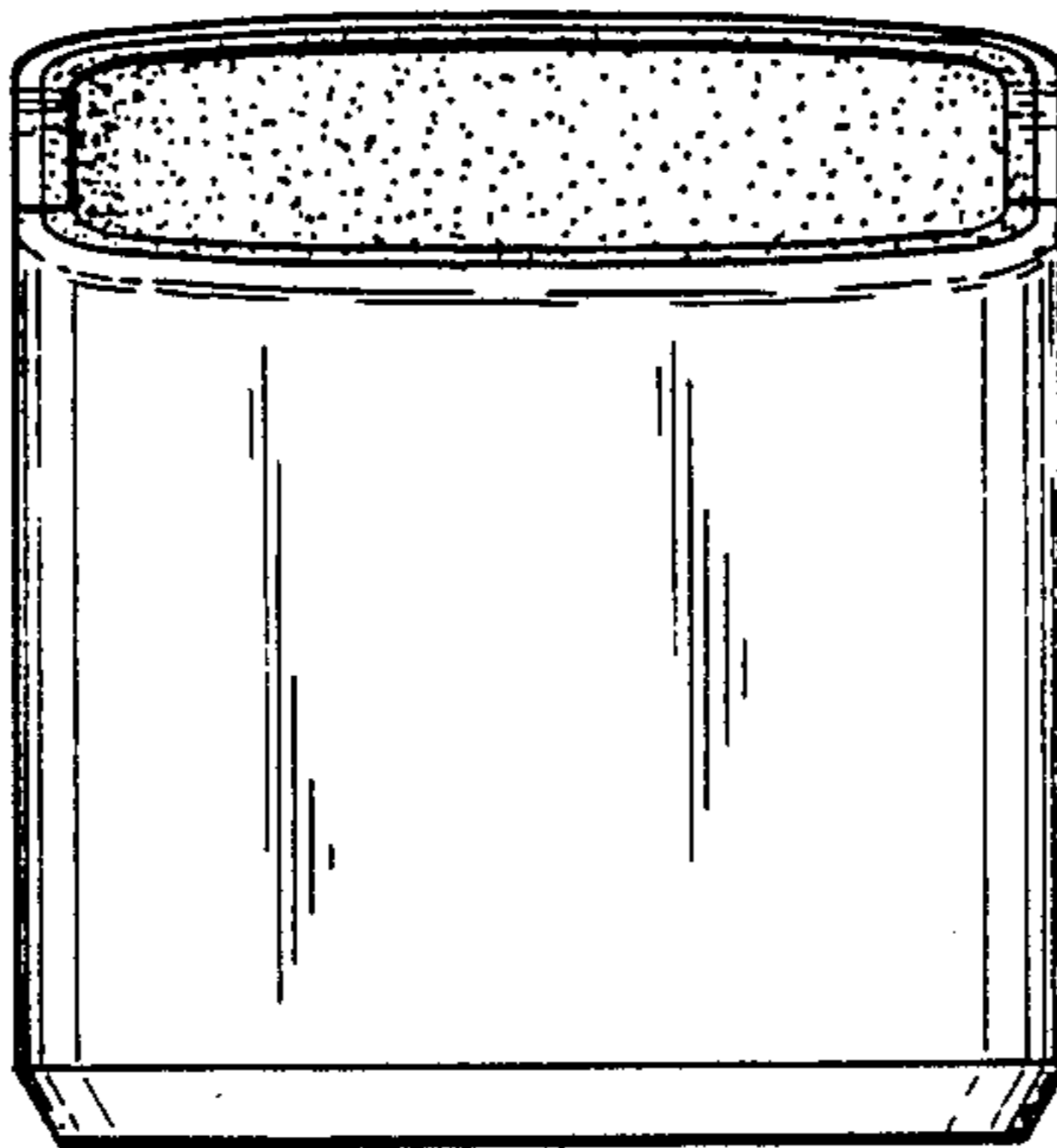
