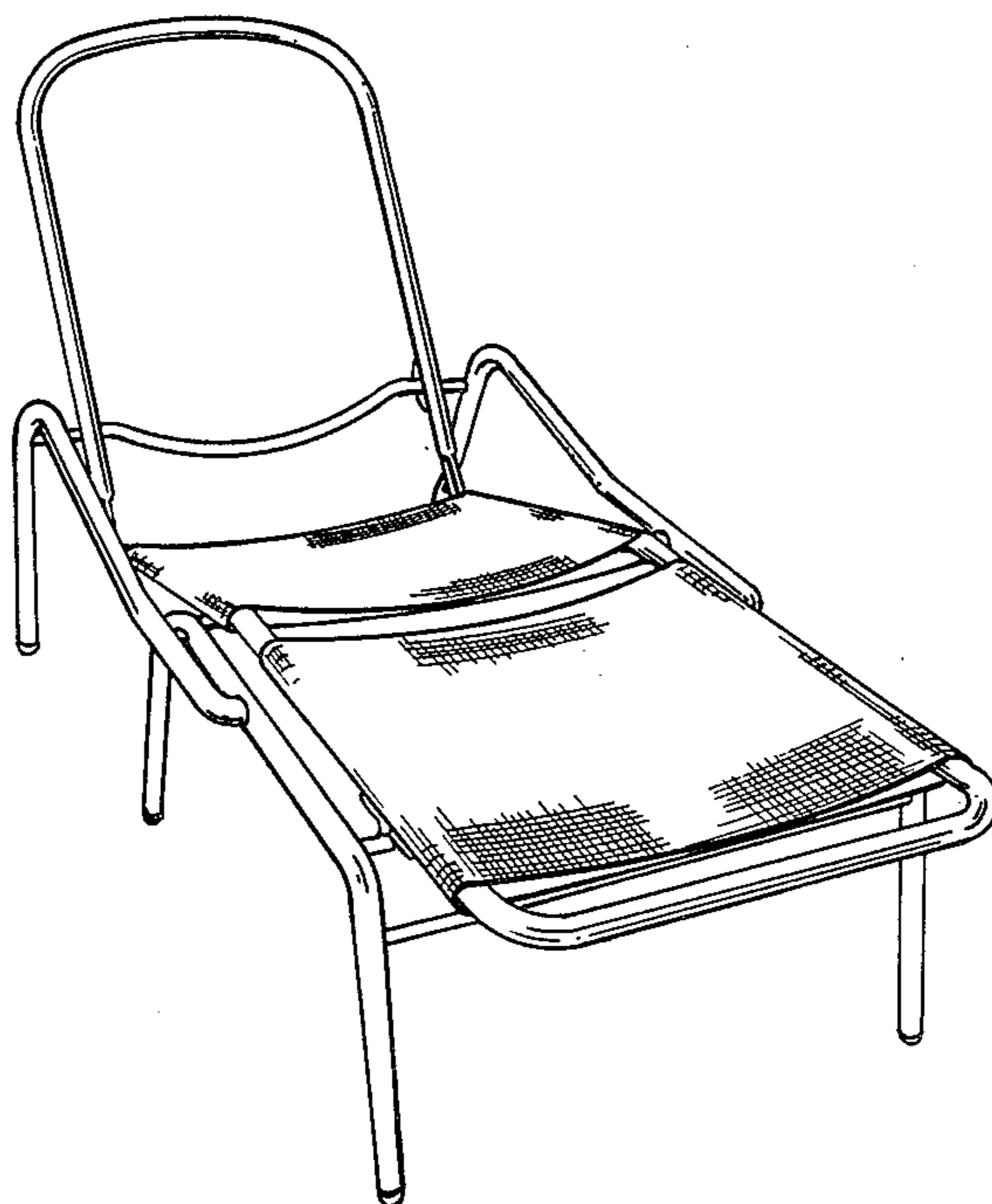

The ornamental design for a frame for a chaise lounge or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for a chaise lounge or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



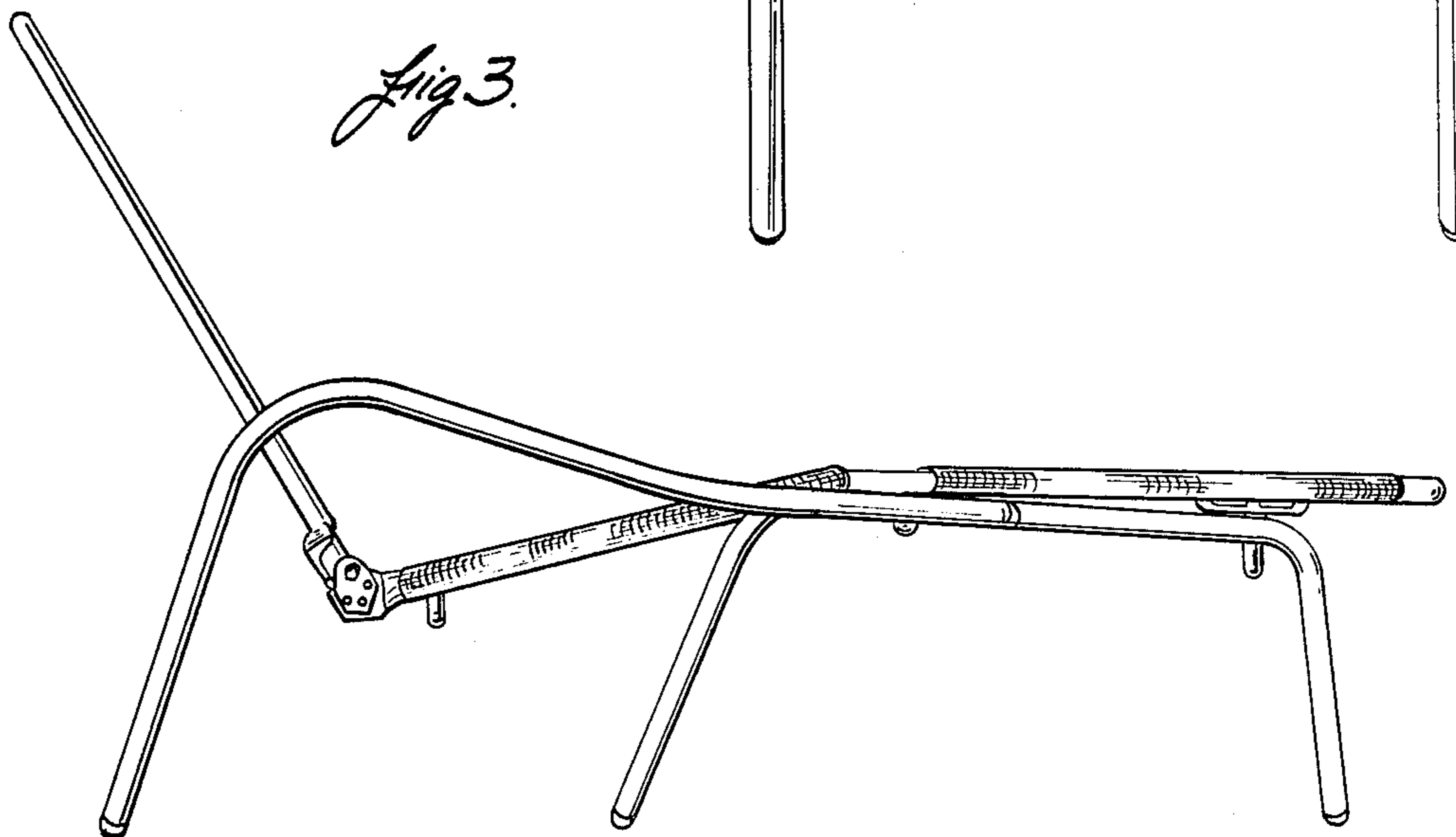
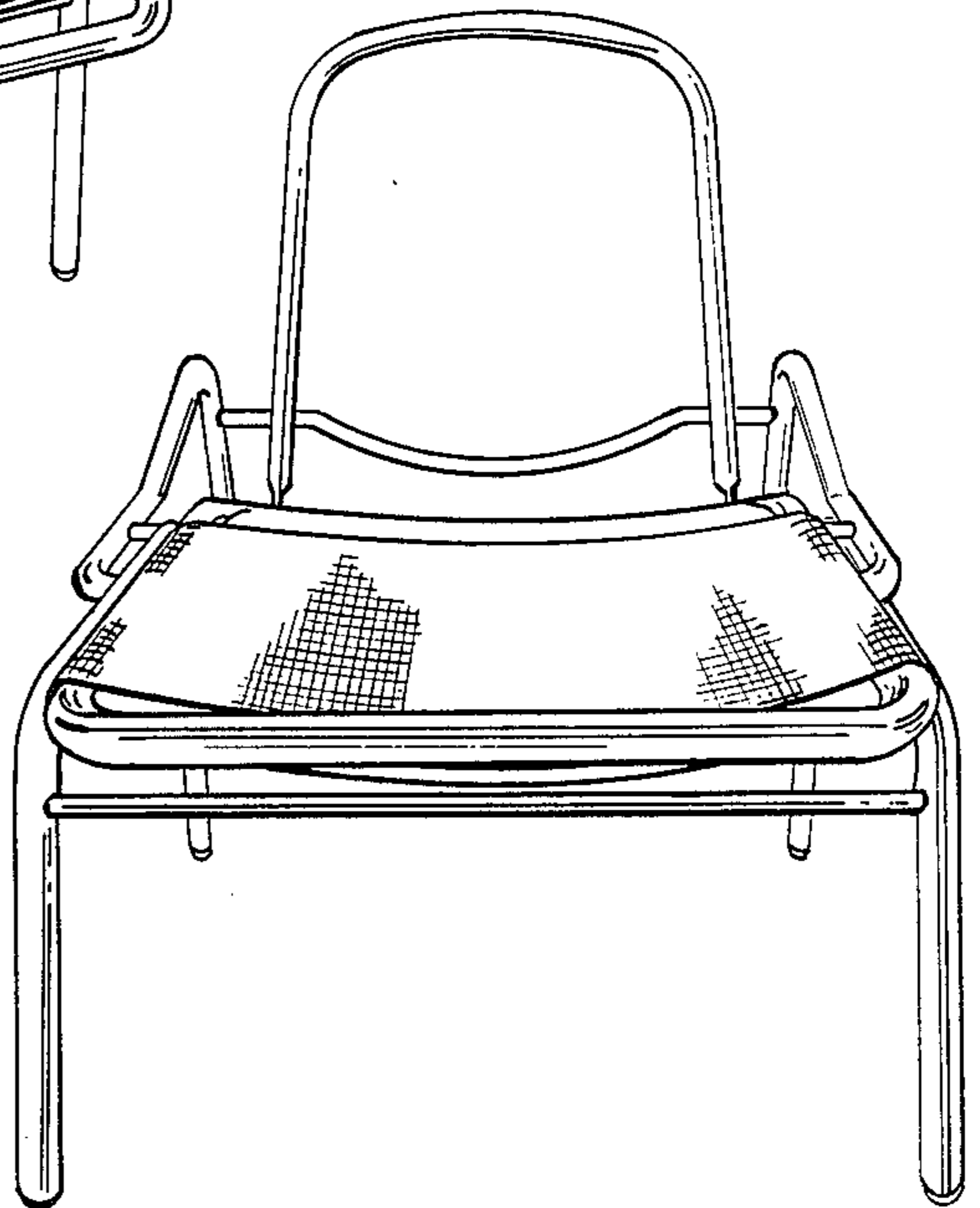
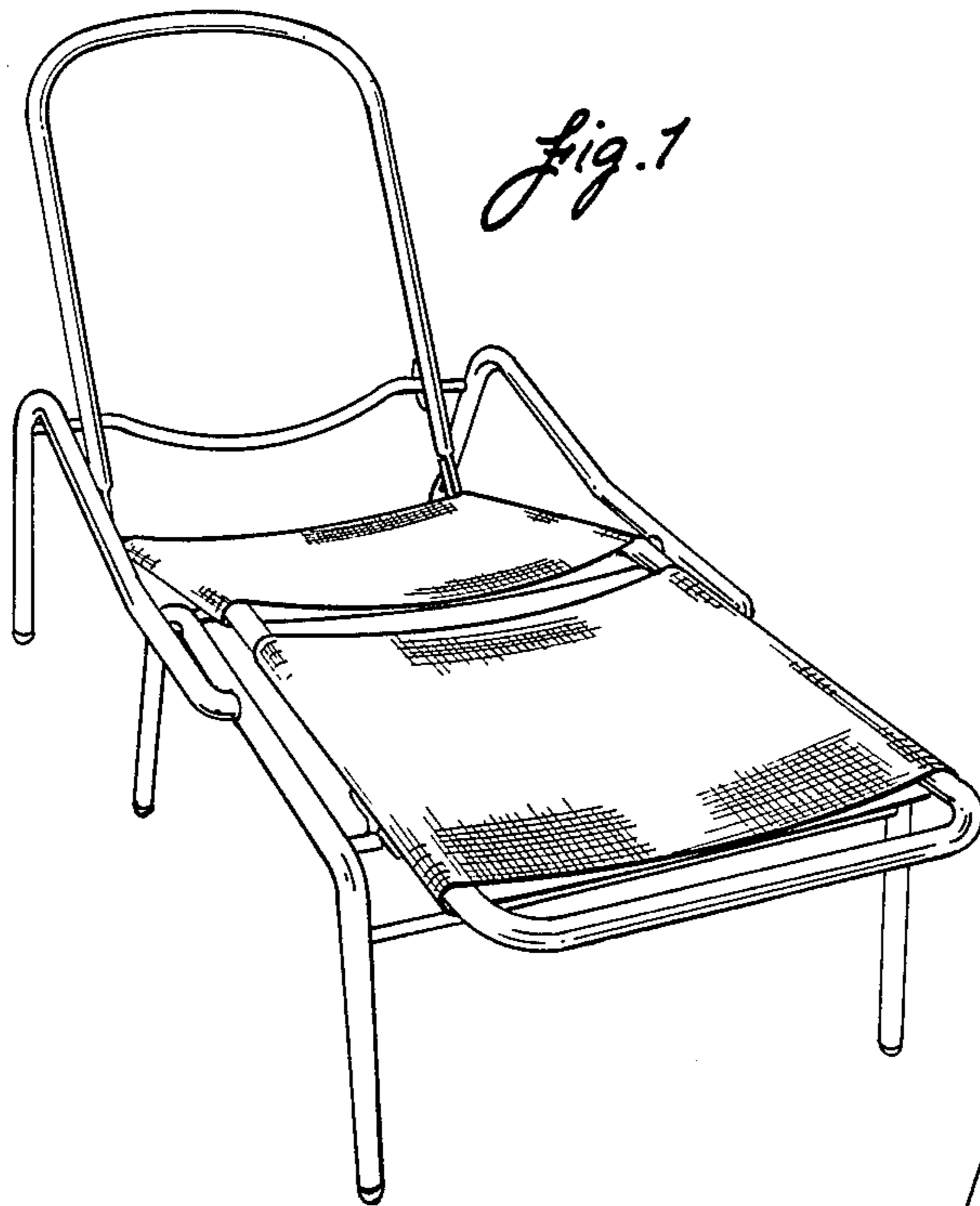

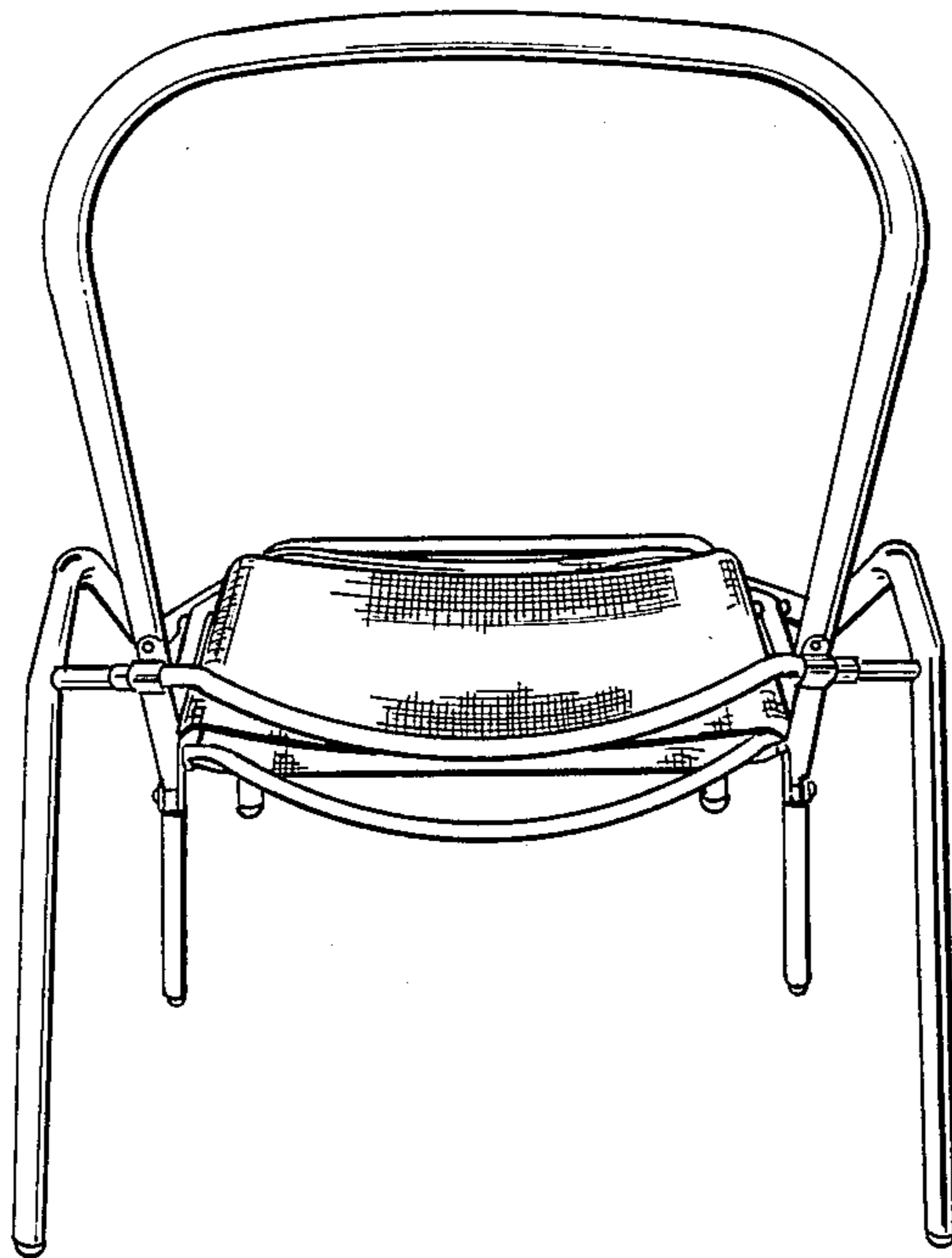

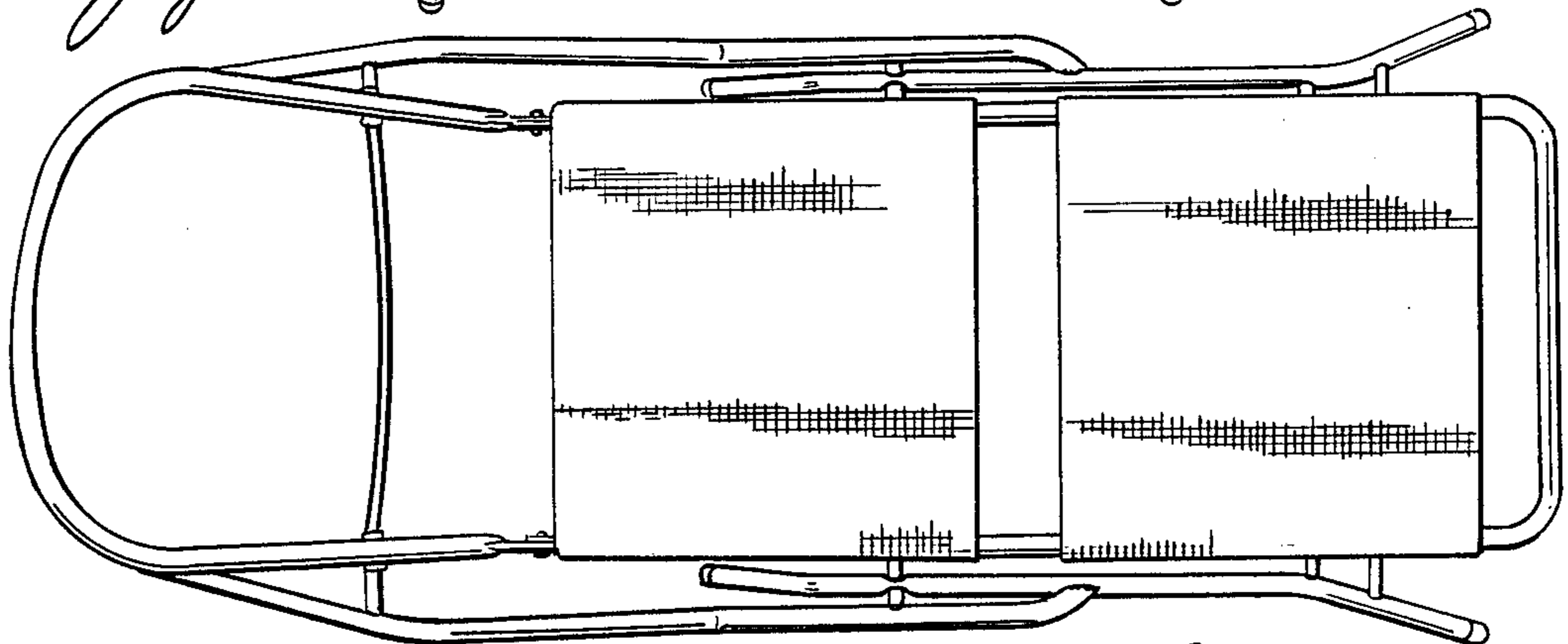
