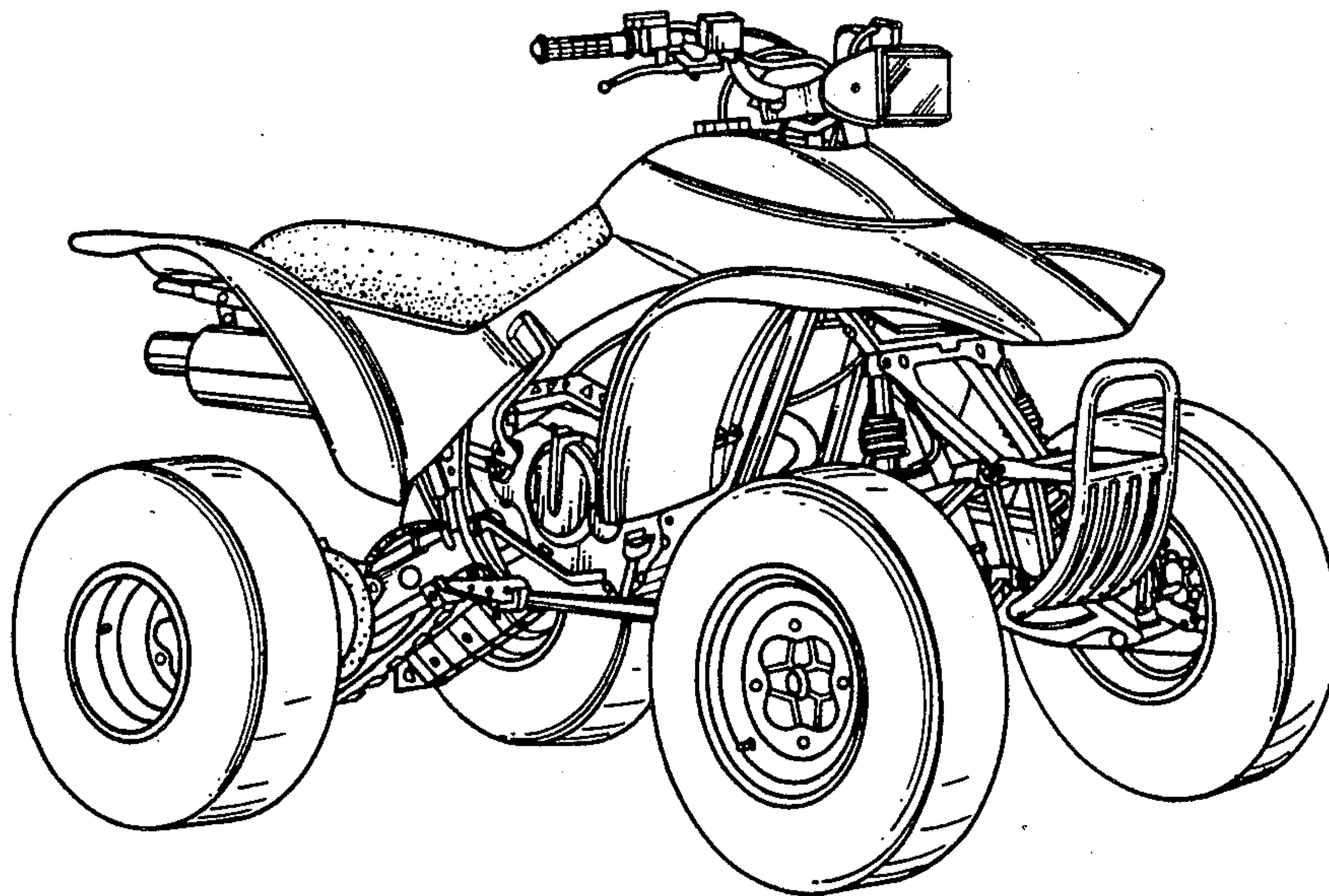

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a four-wheeled motorcycle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevation view of the right side thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.



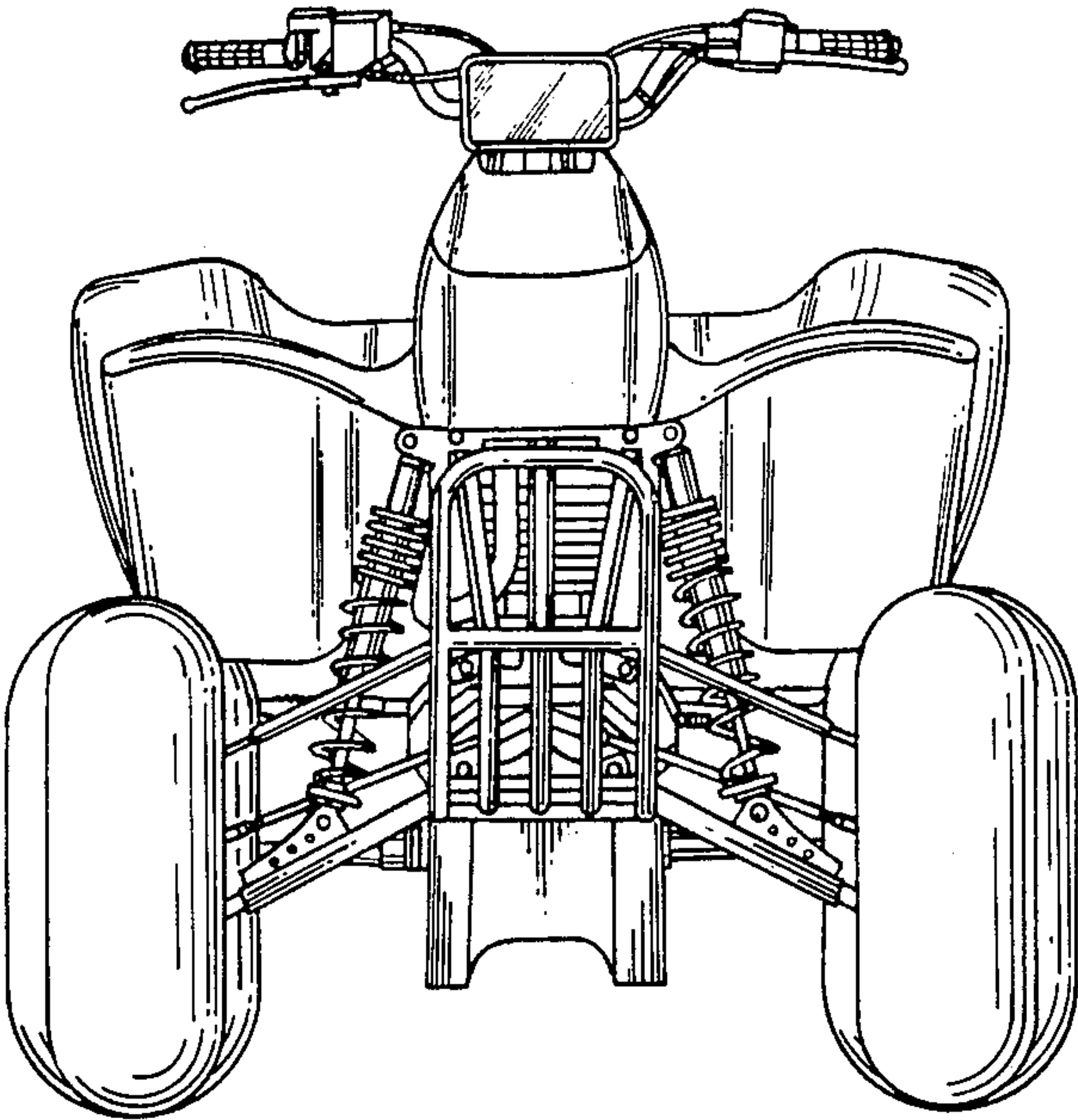

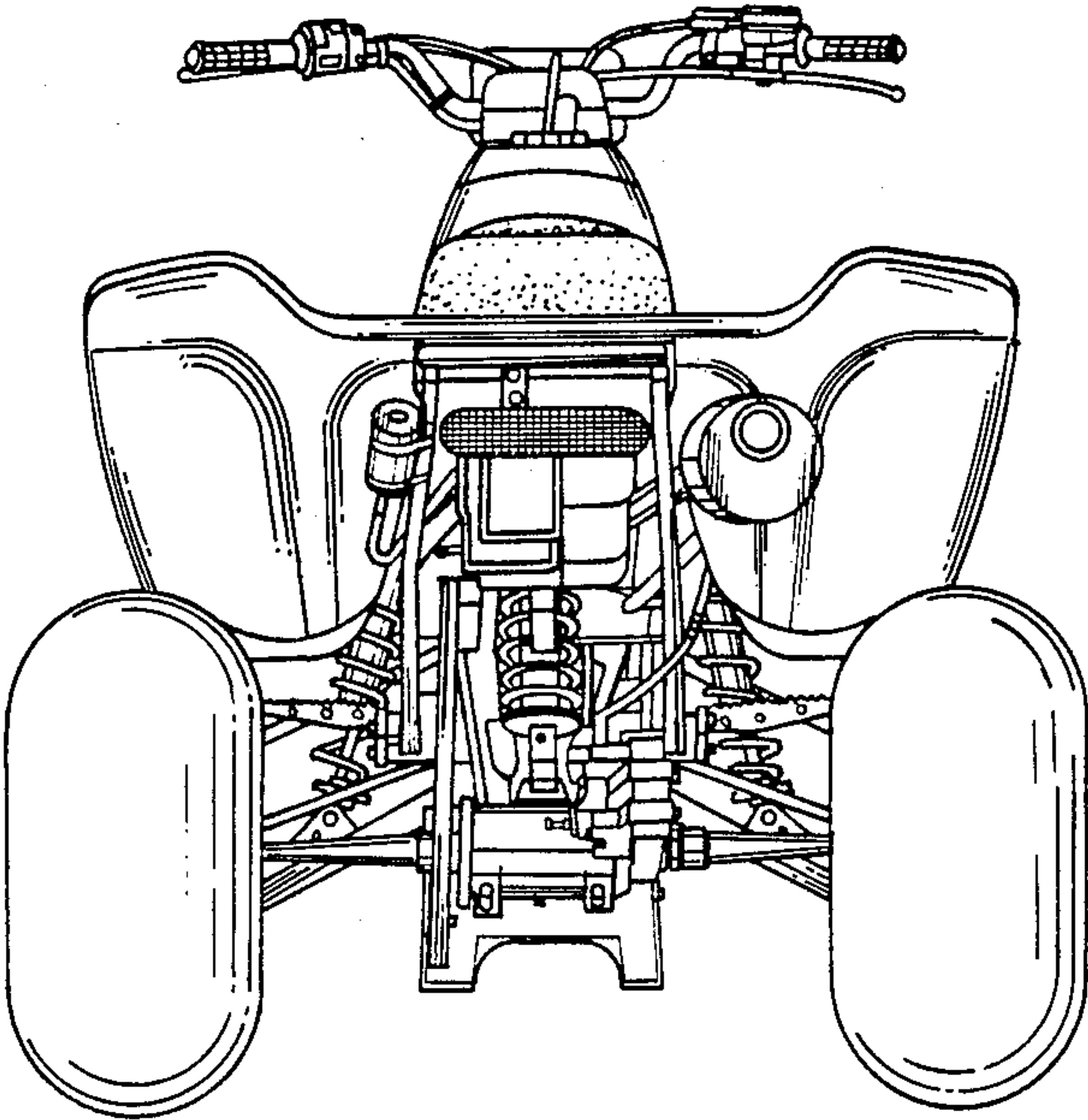
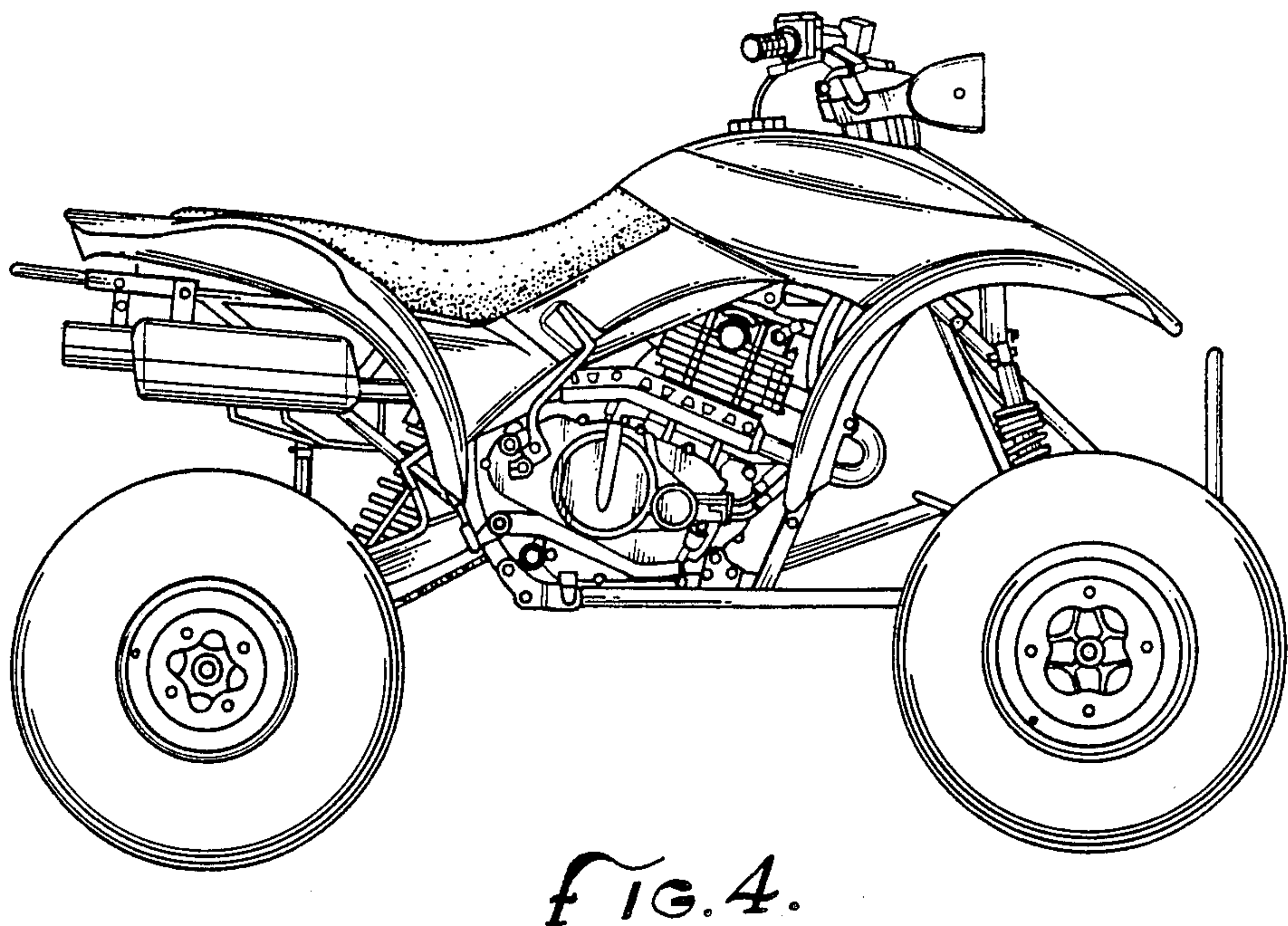
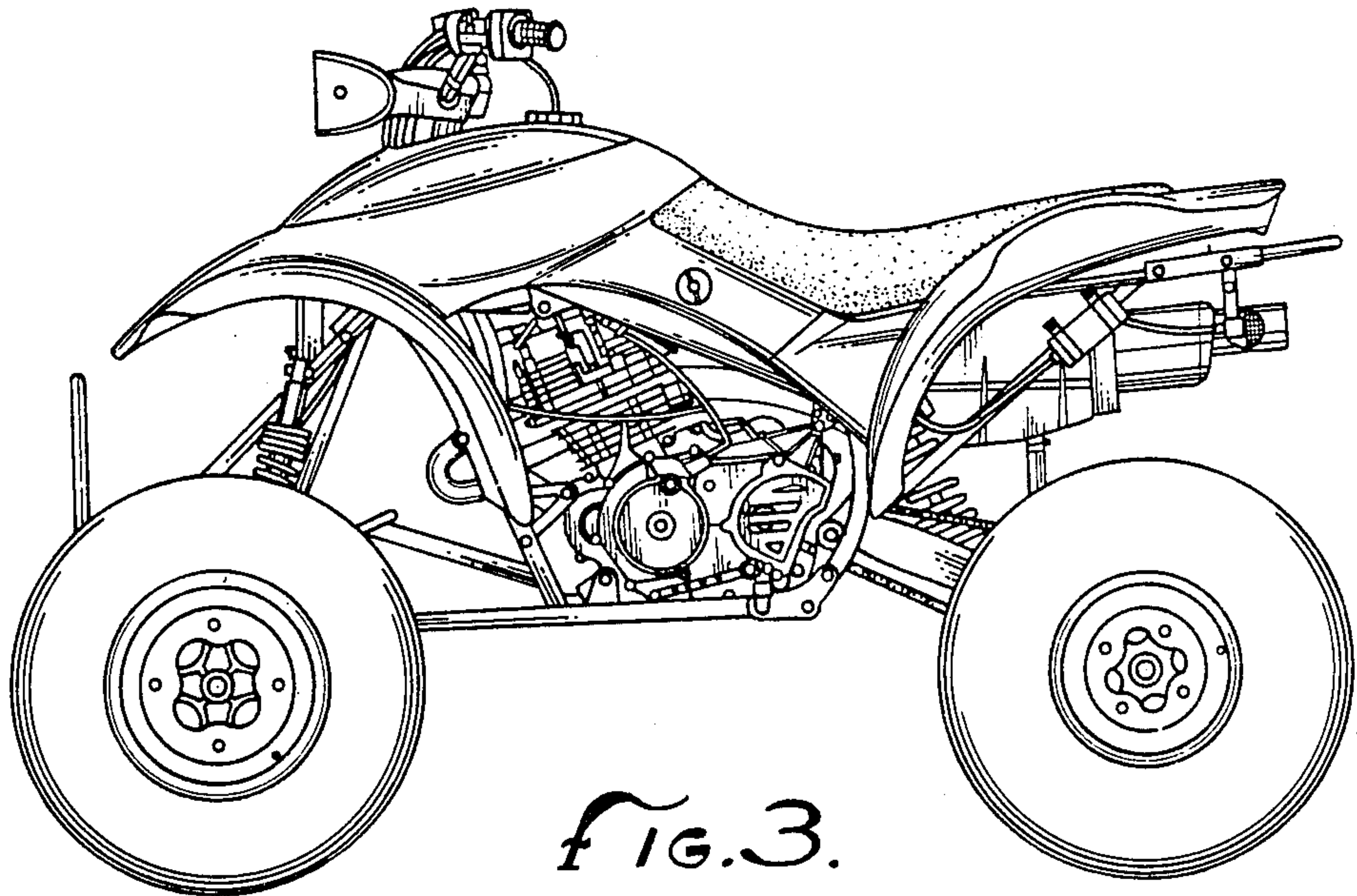

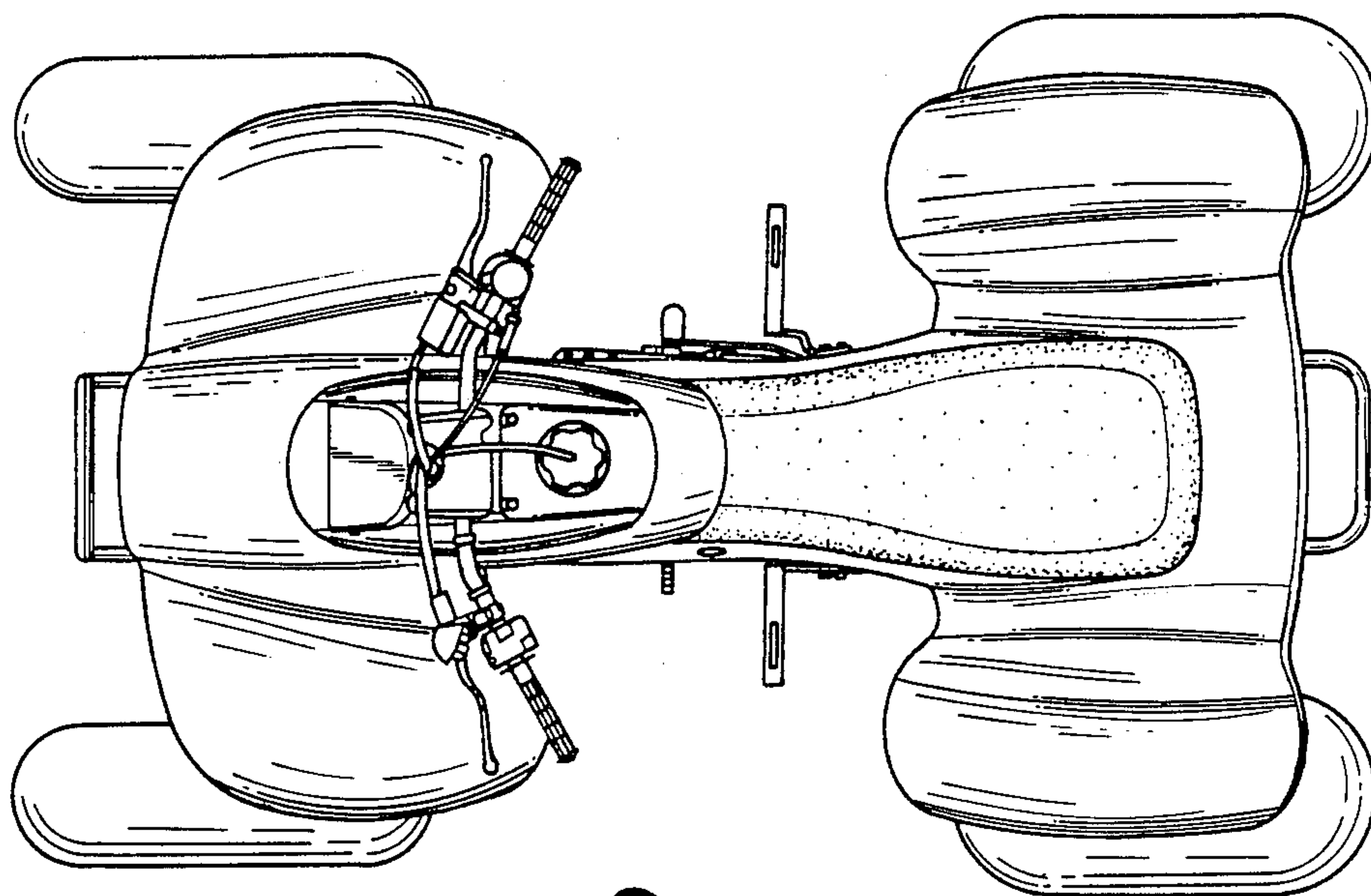

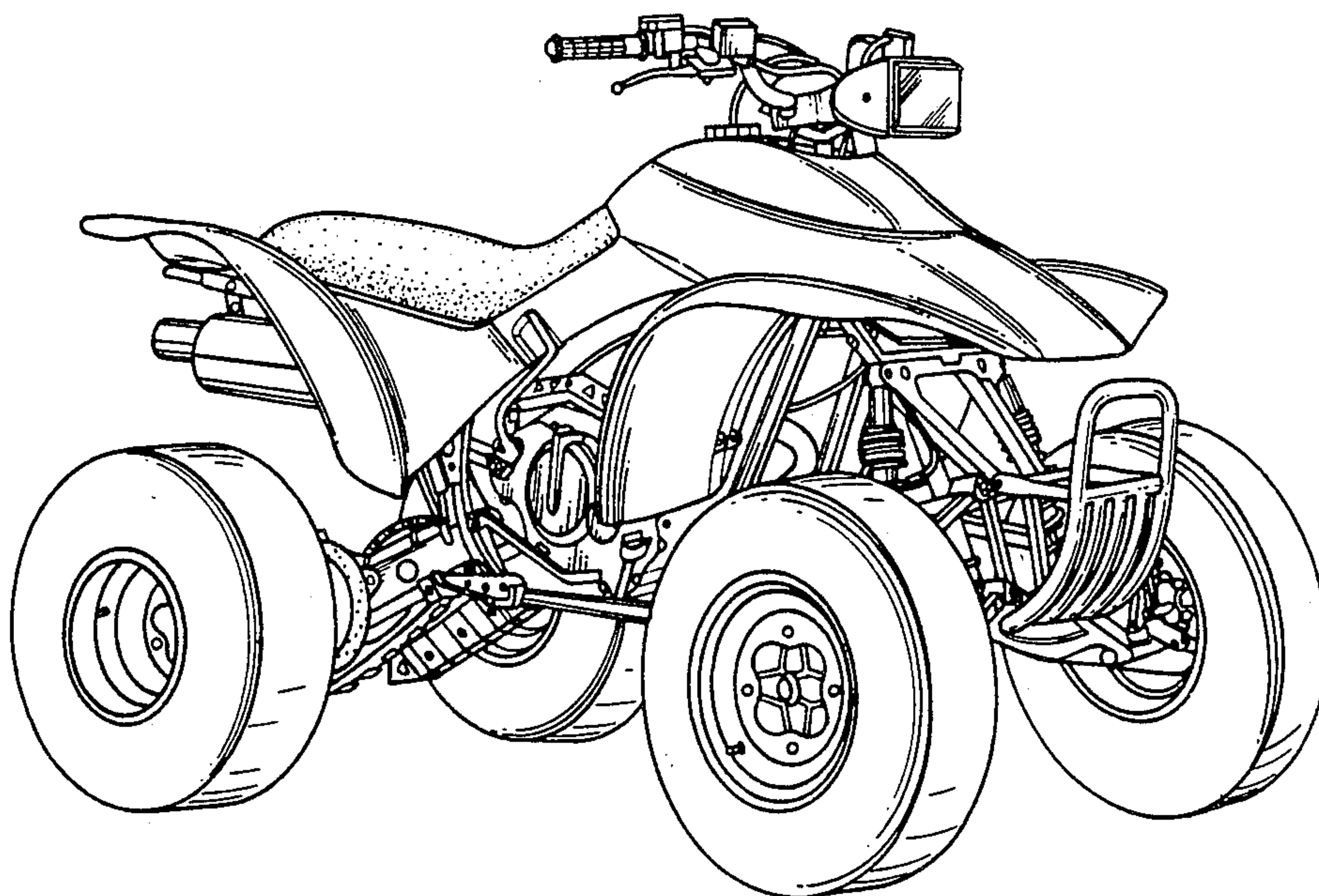
