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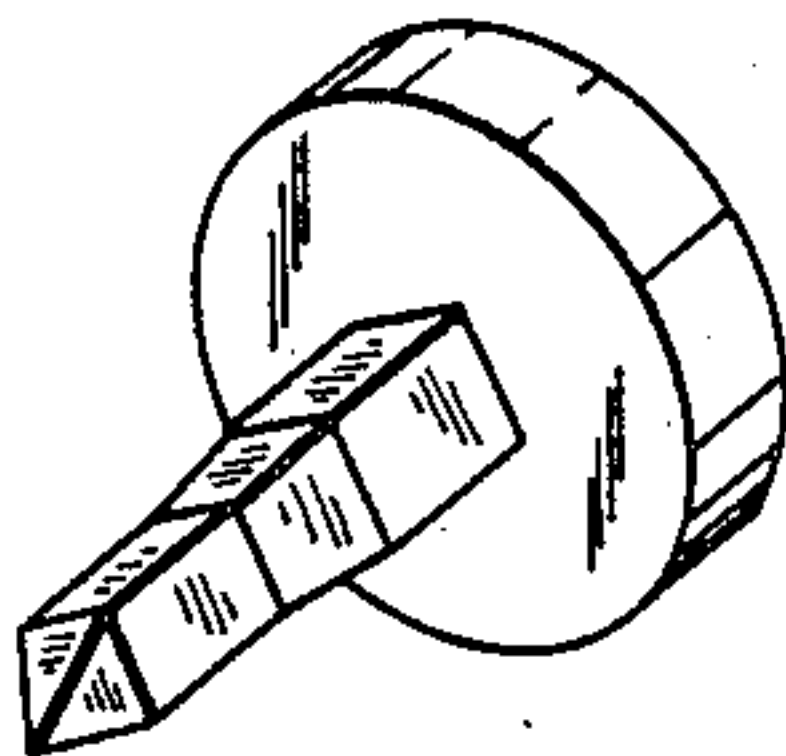
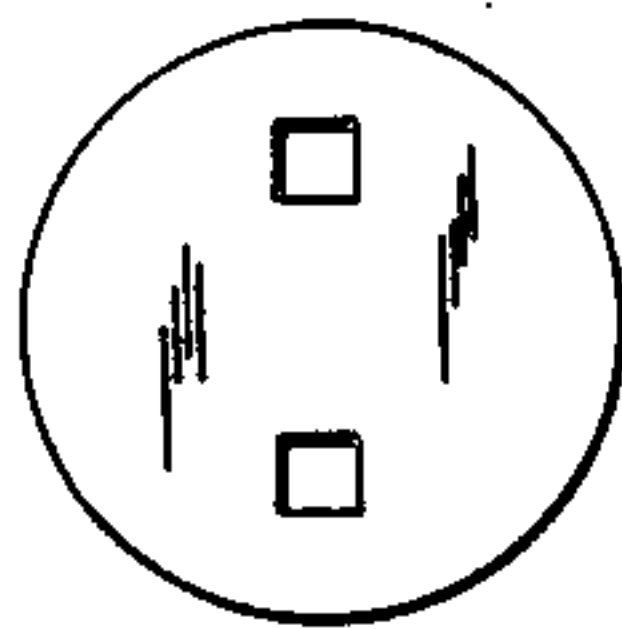

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, and all sides being identical.



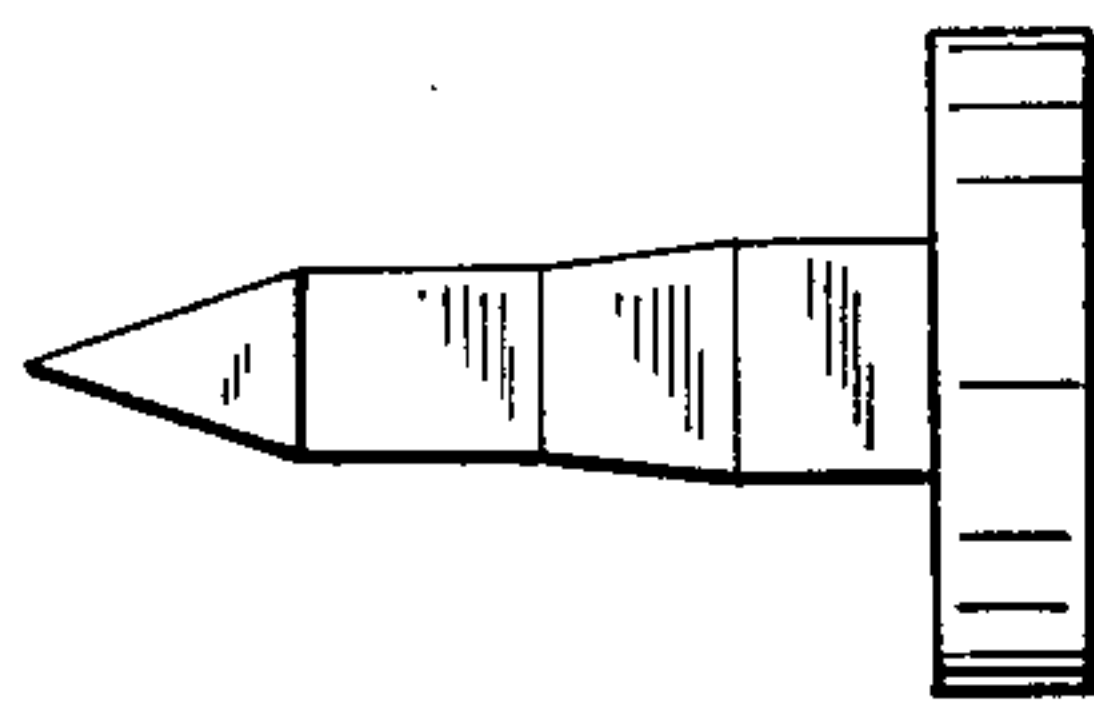

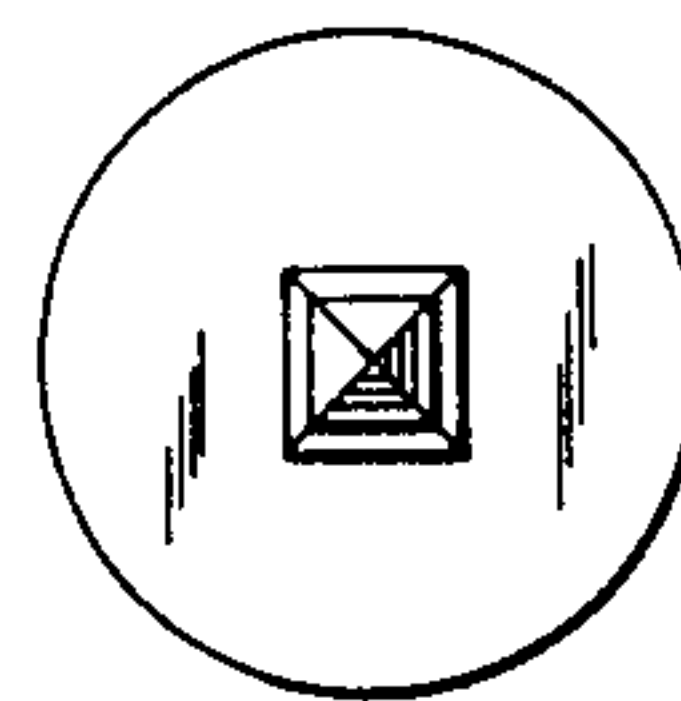

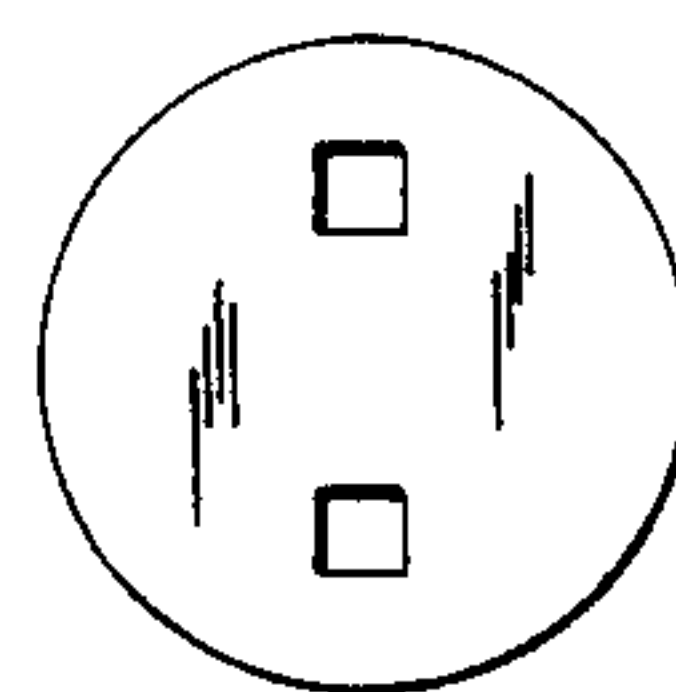

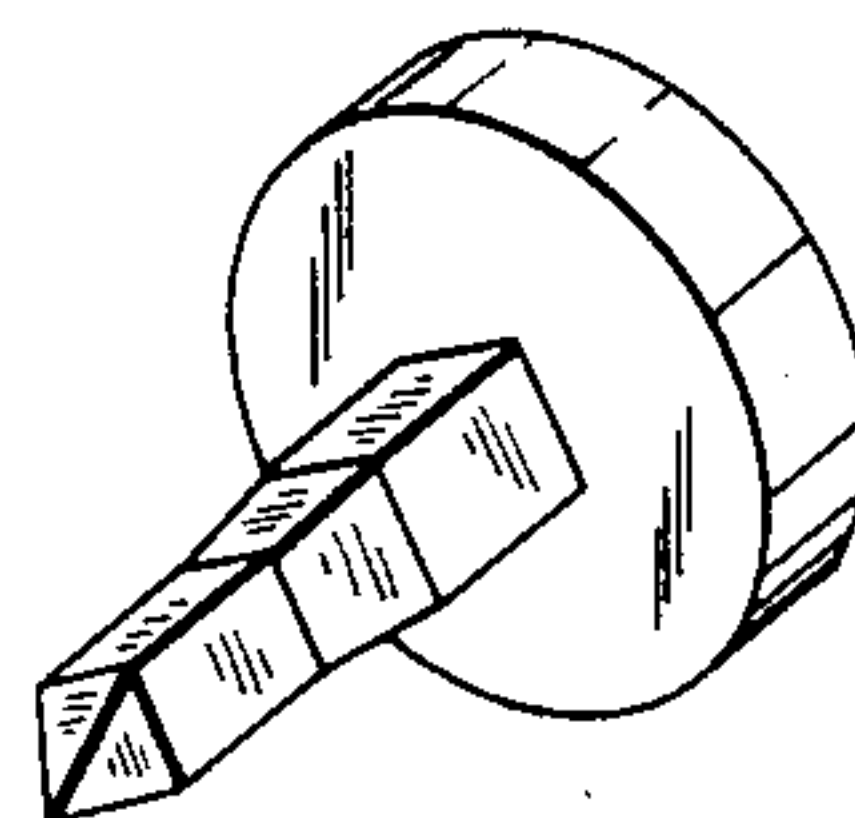
