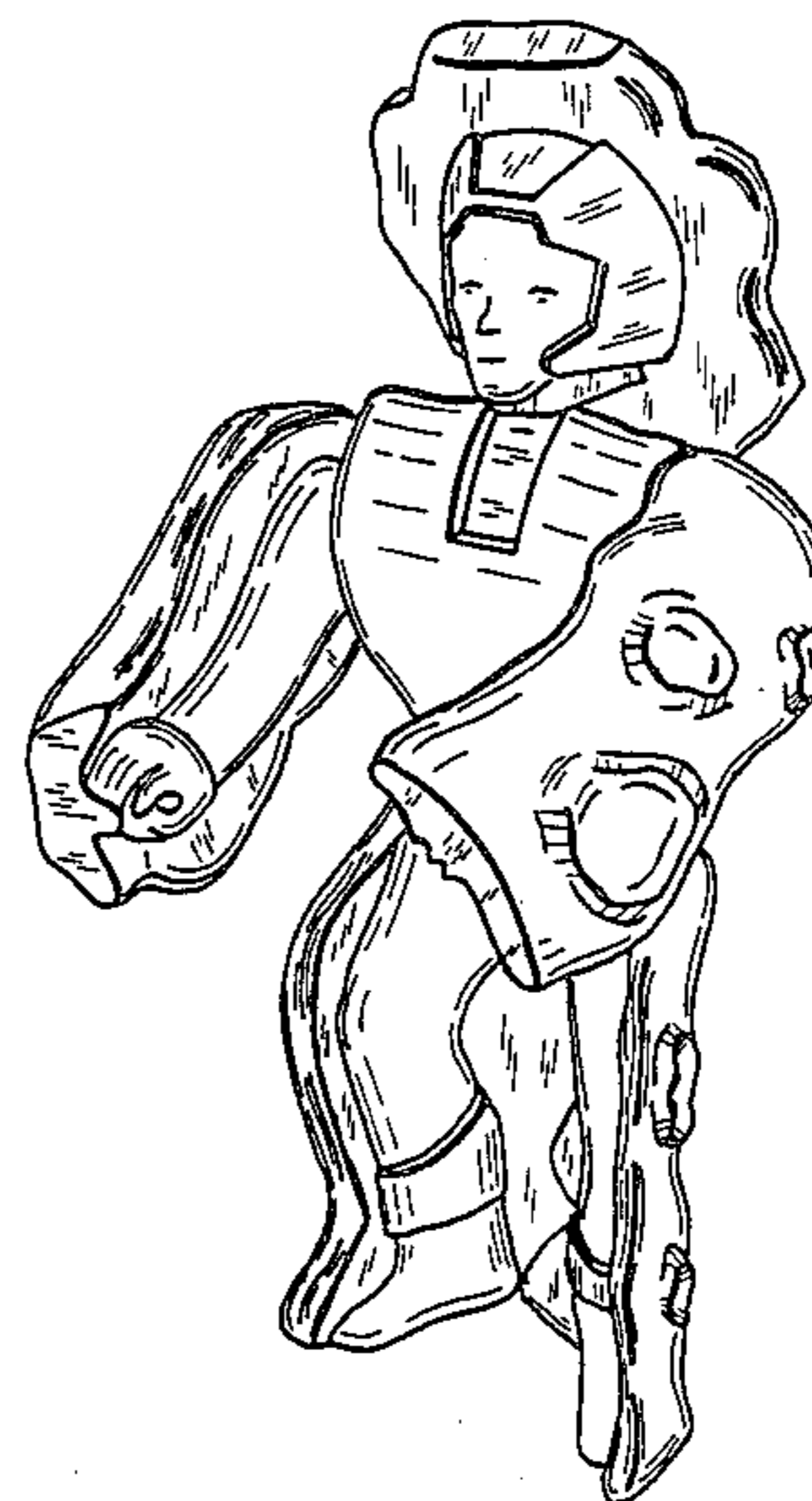
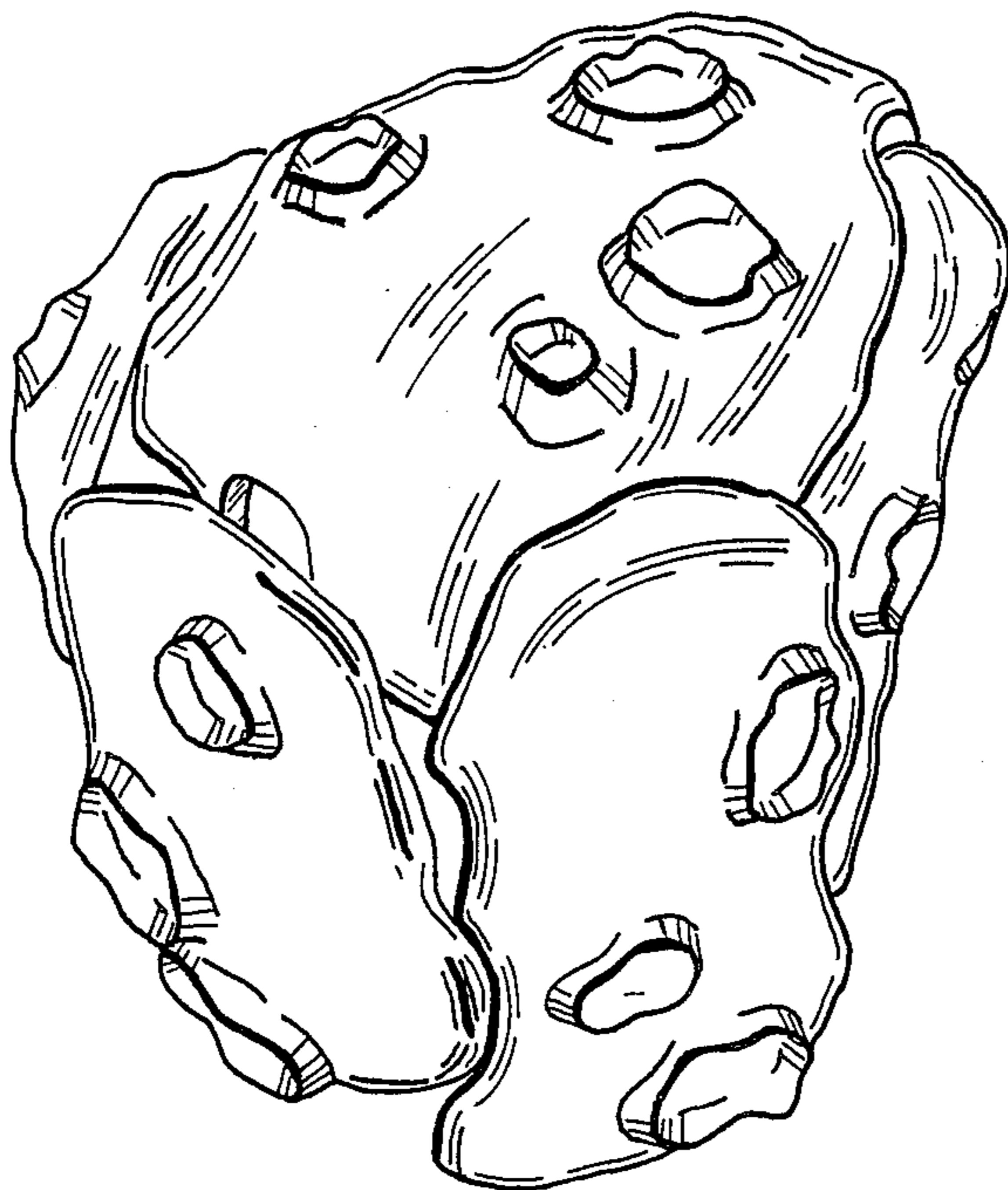

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a reconfigurable humanoid toy with simulated crater surface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a reconfigurable humanoid toy with simulated crater surface showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left front perspective view of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 4 reconfigured in the form of a humanoid toy;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 5;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 5; and
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5.



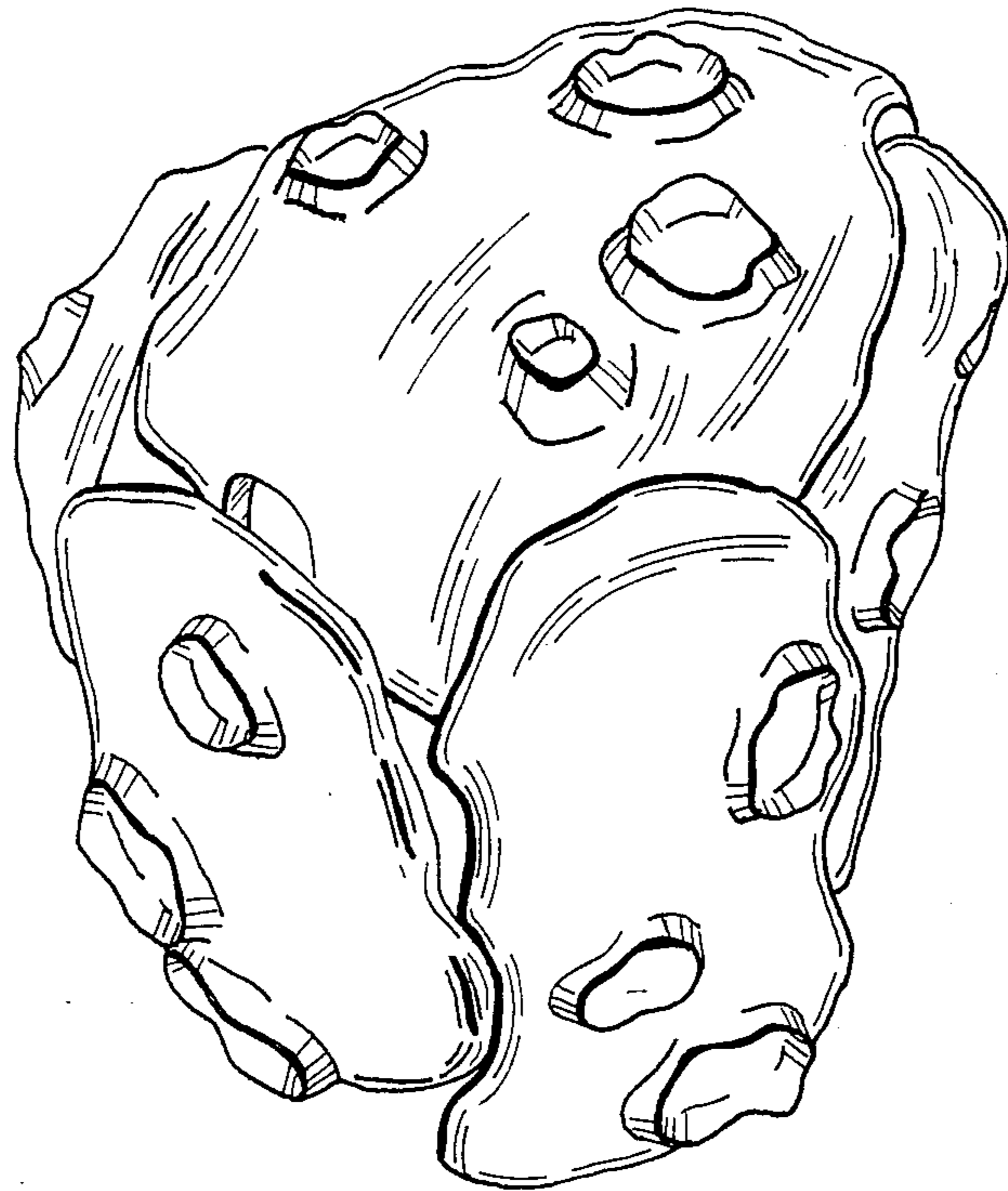

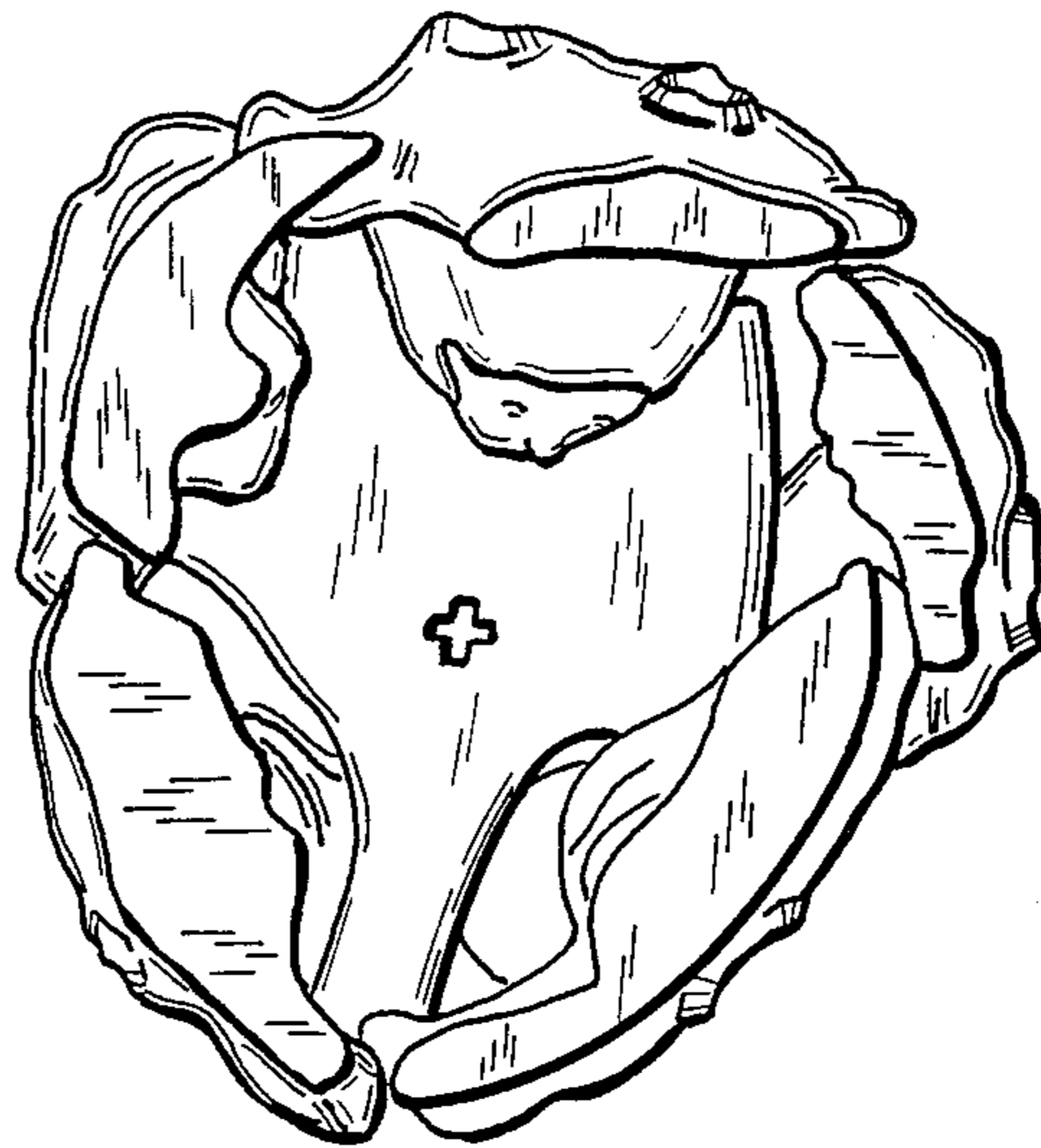

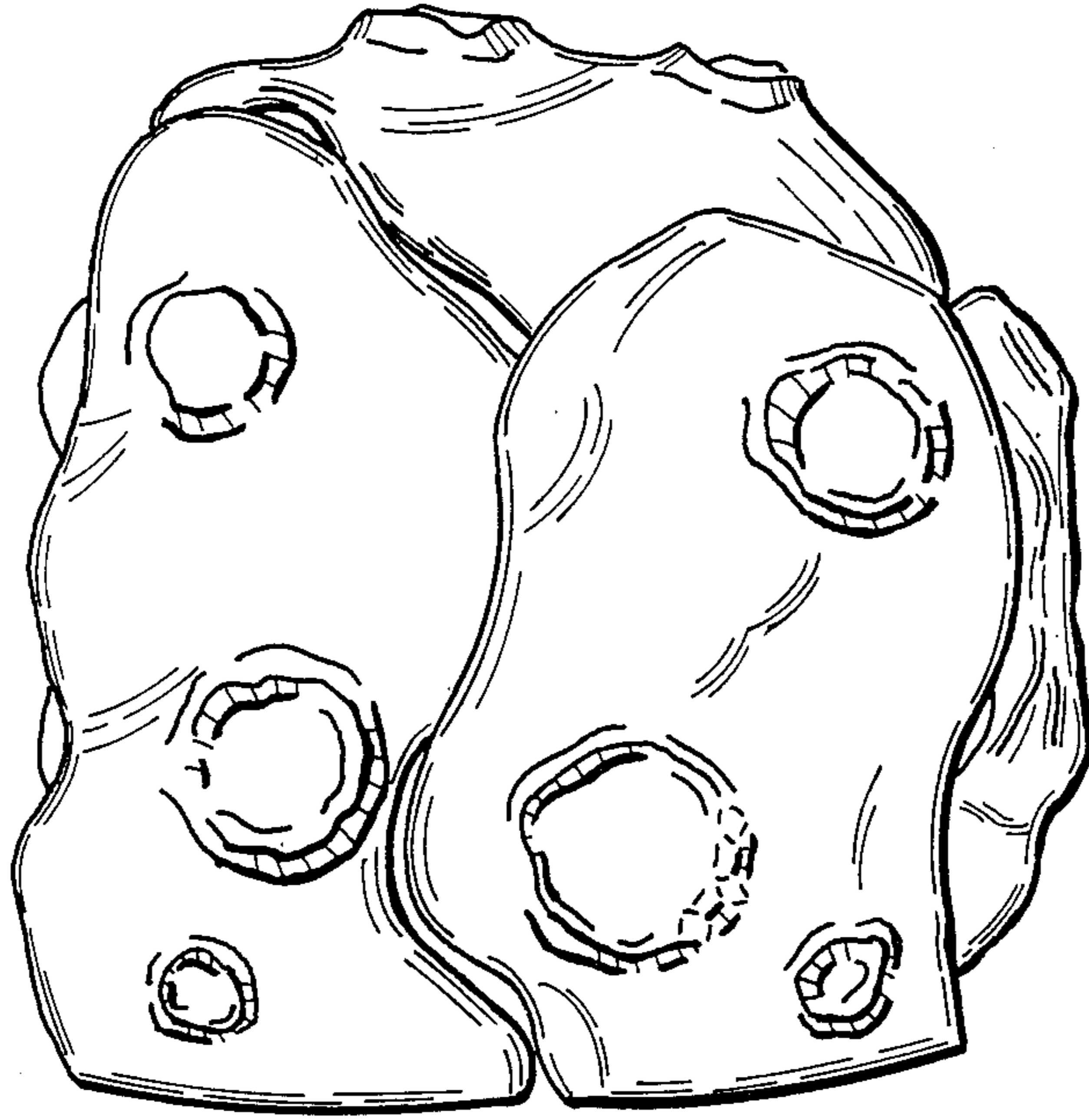

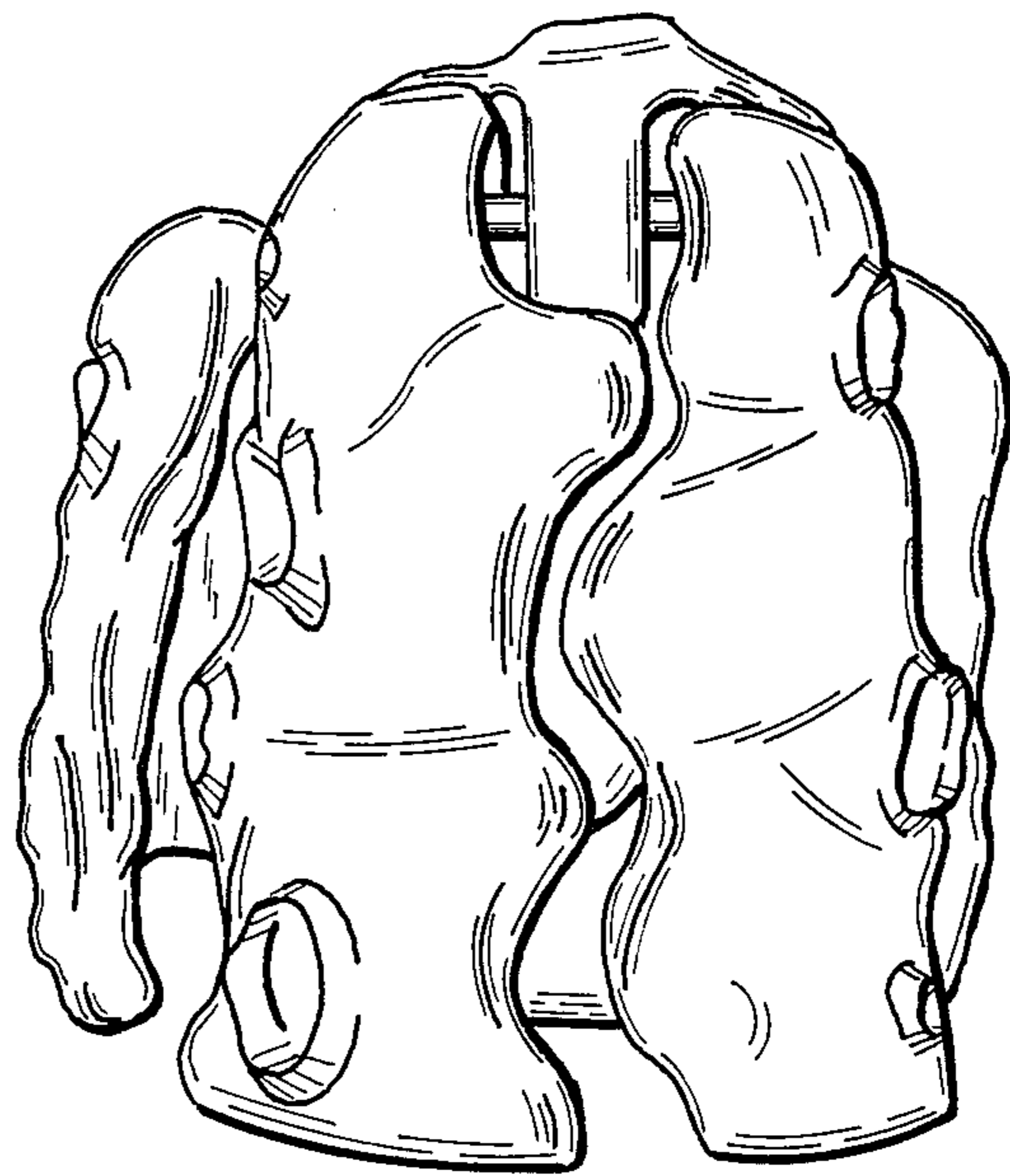

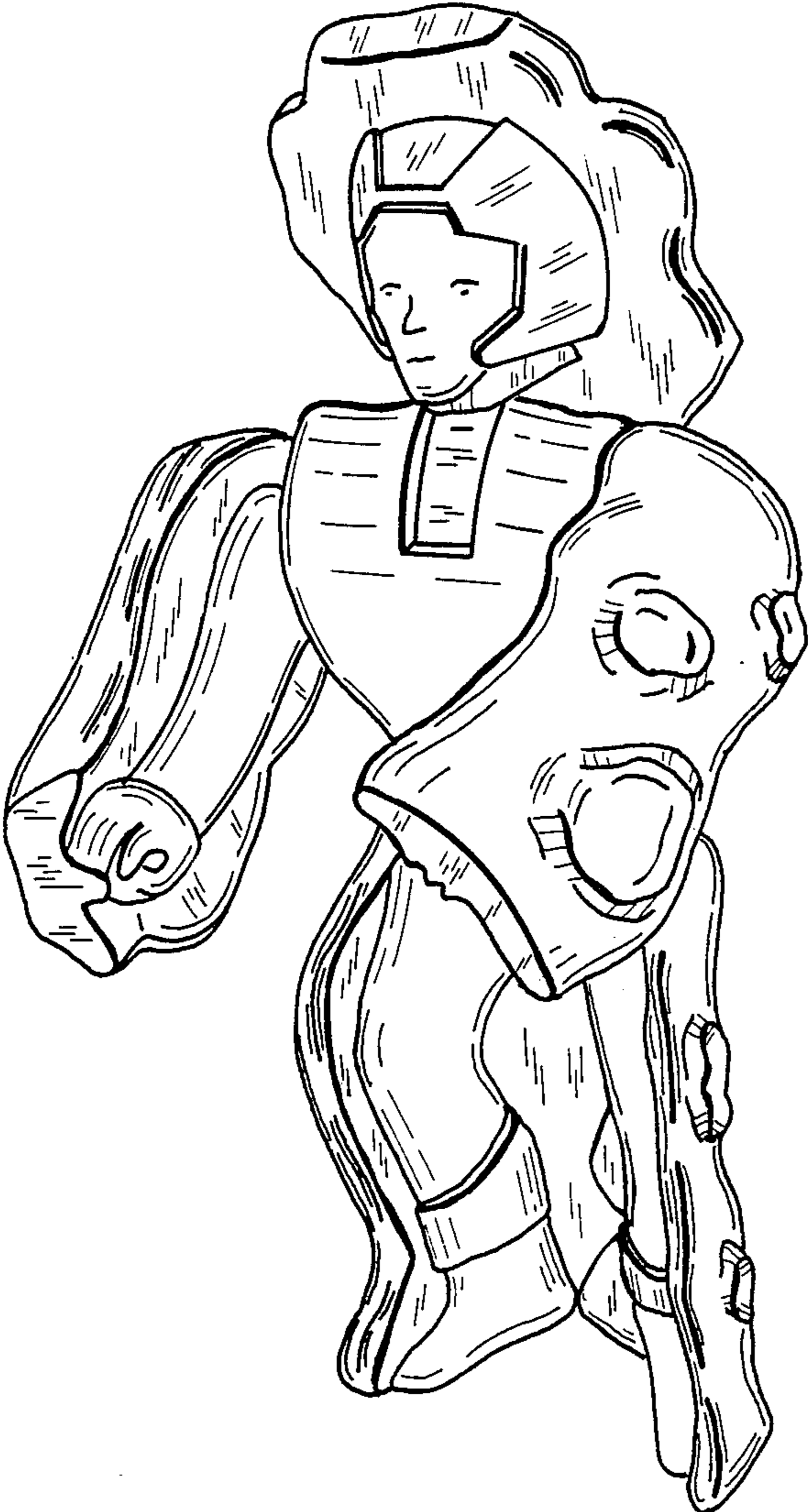

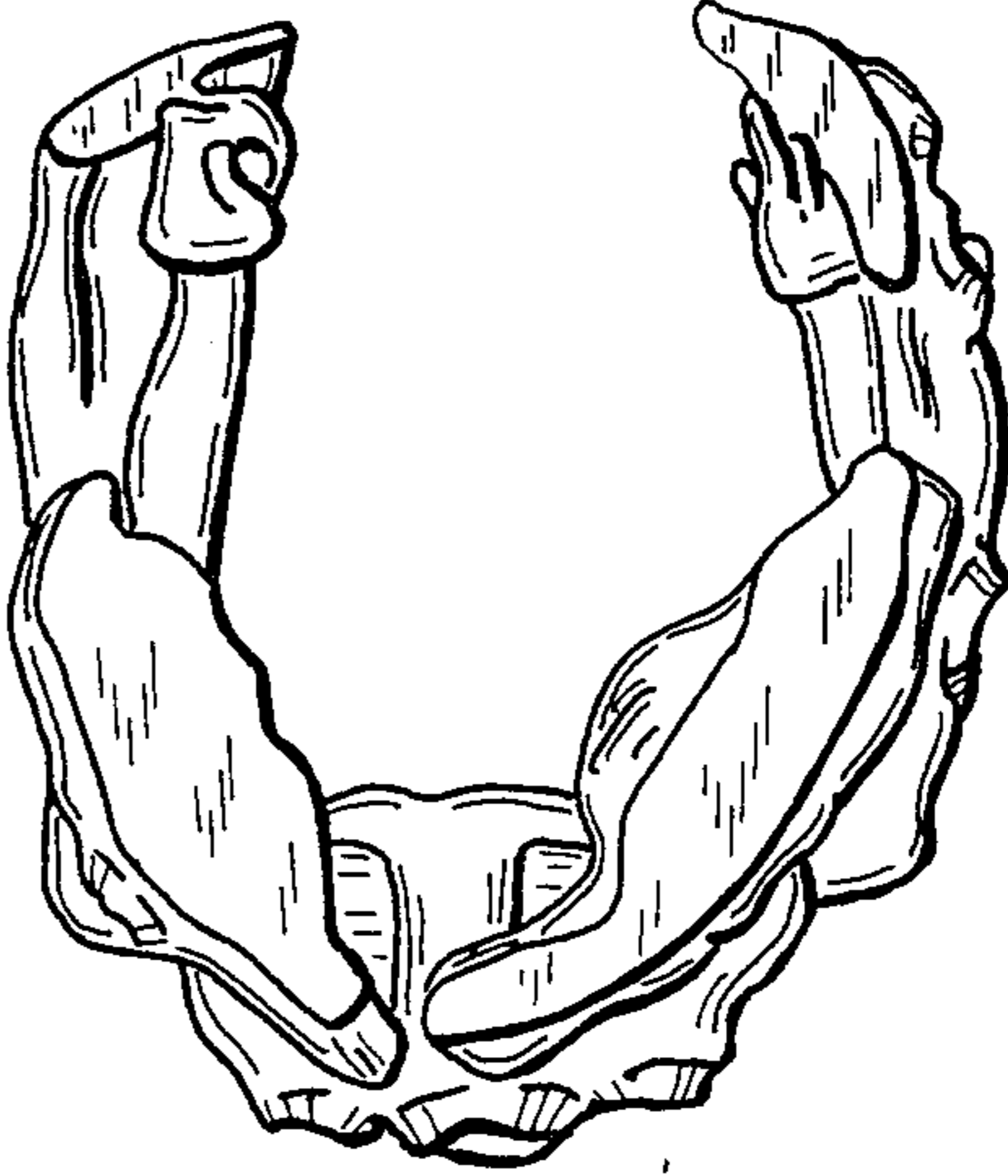

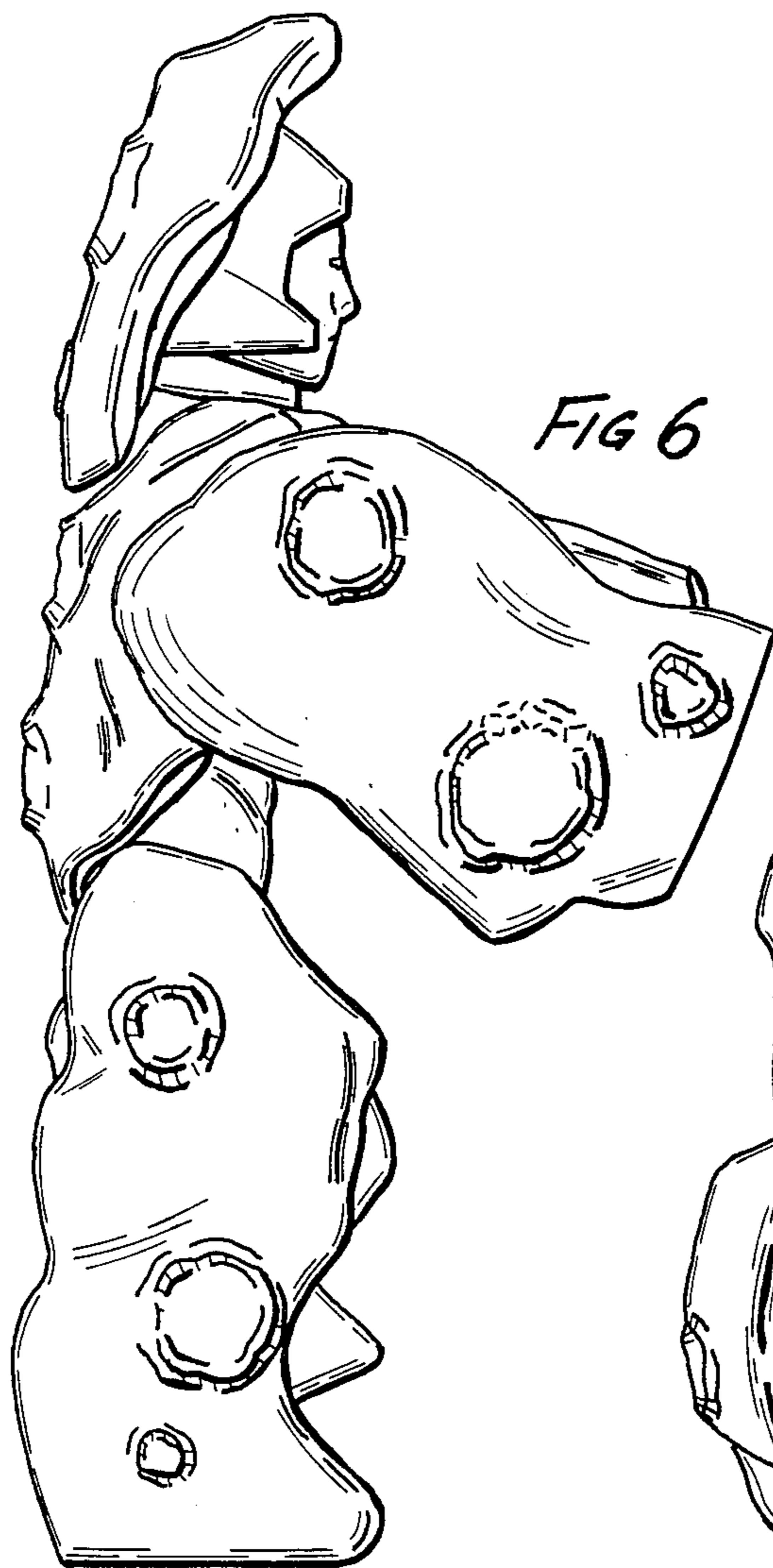

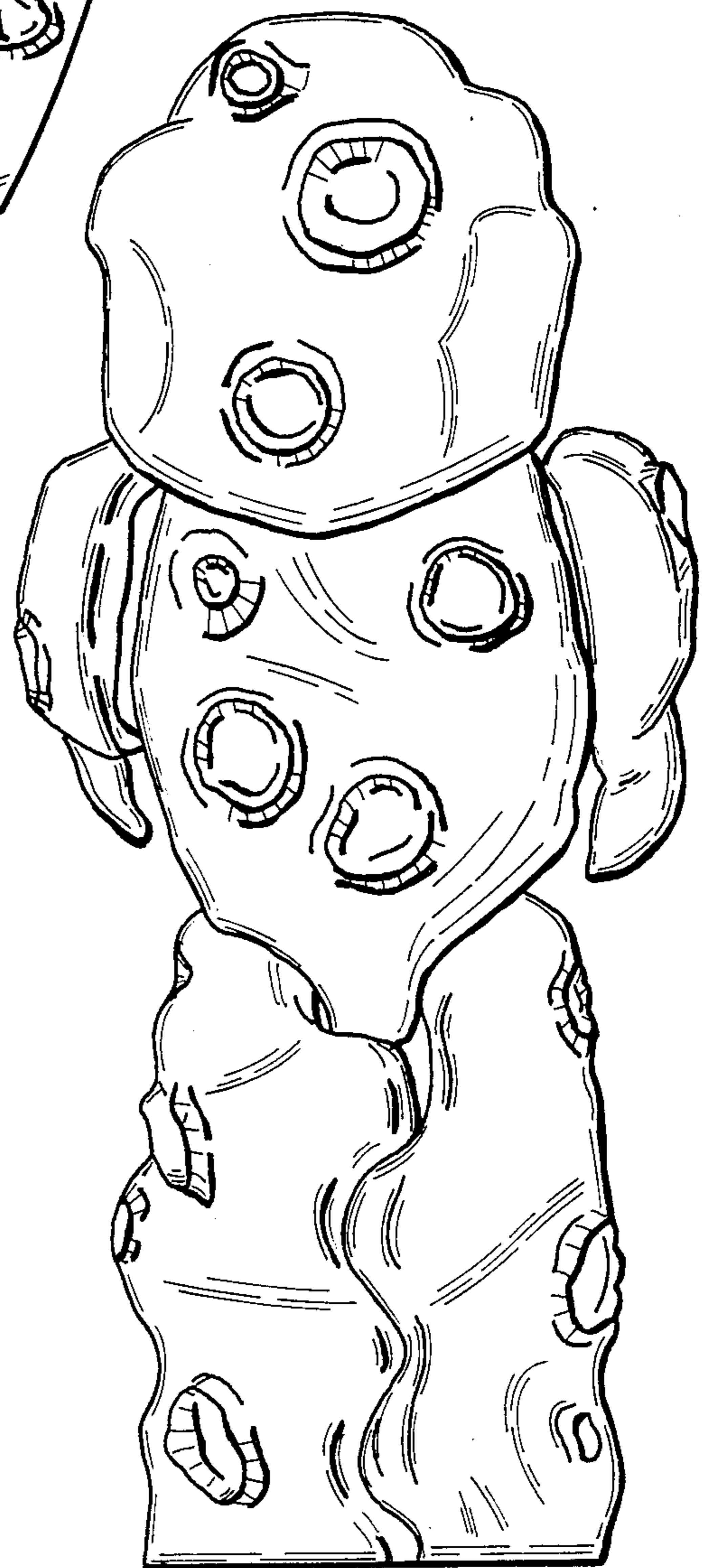
