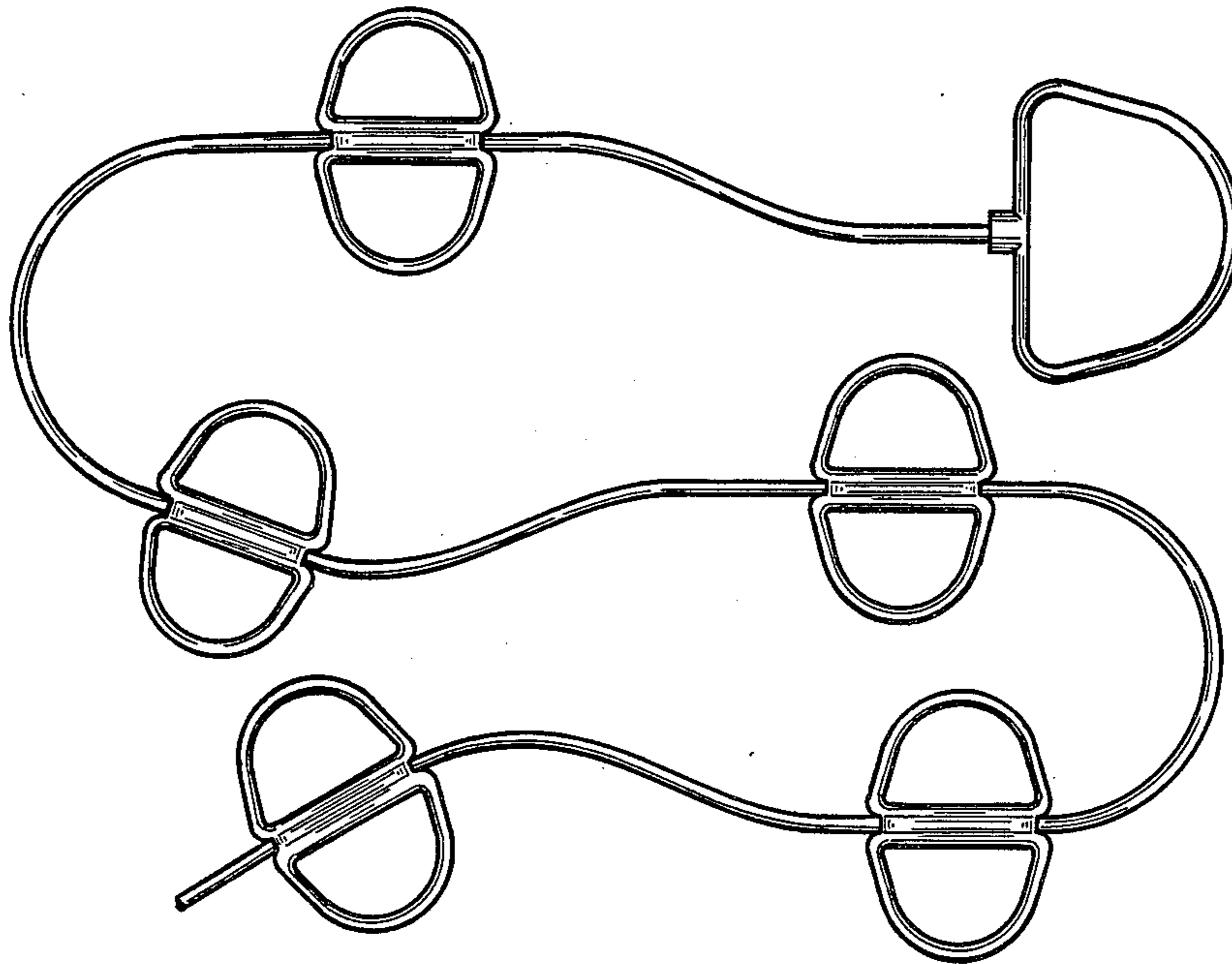

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a teacher's guidance rope for leading small children or handicapped individuals during evacuations or group excursions, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a teacher's guidance rope for leading small children or handicapped individuals during evacuations or group excursions, the bottom plan view being a mirror image of that shown.



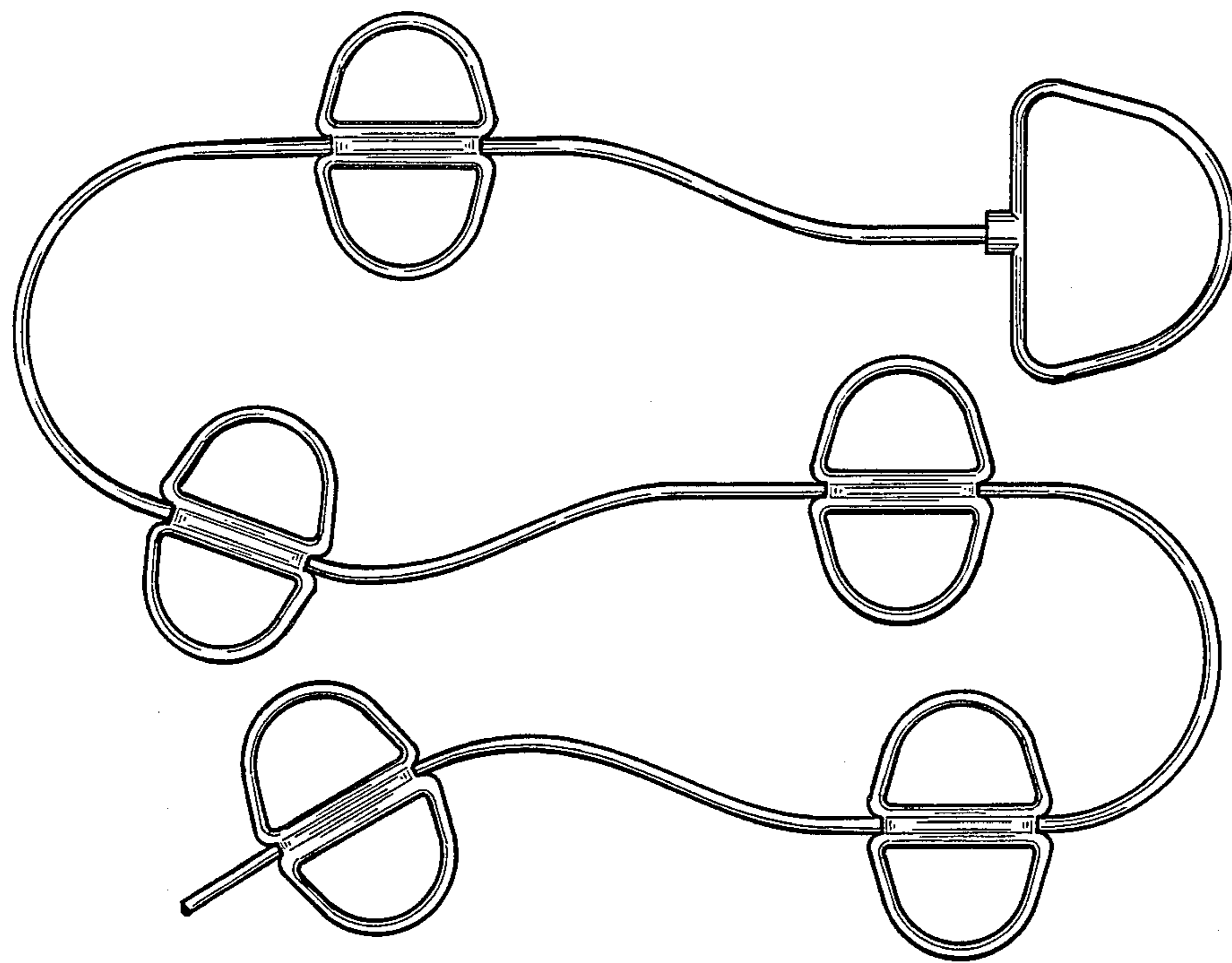
