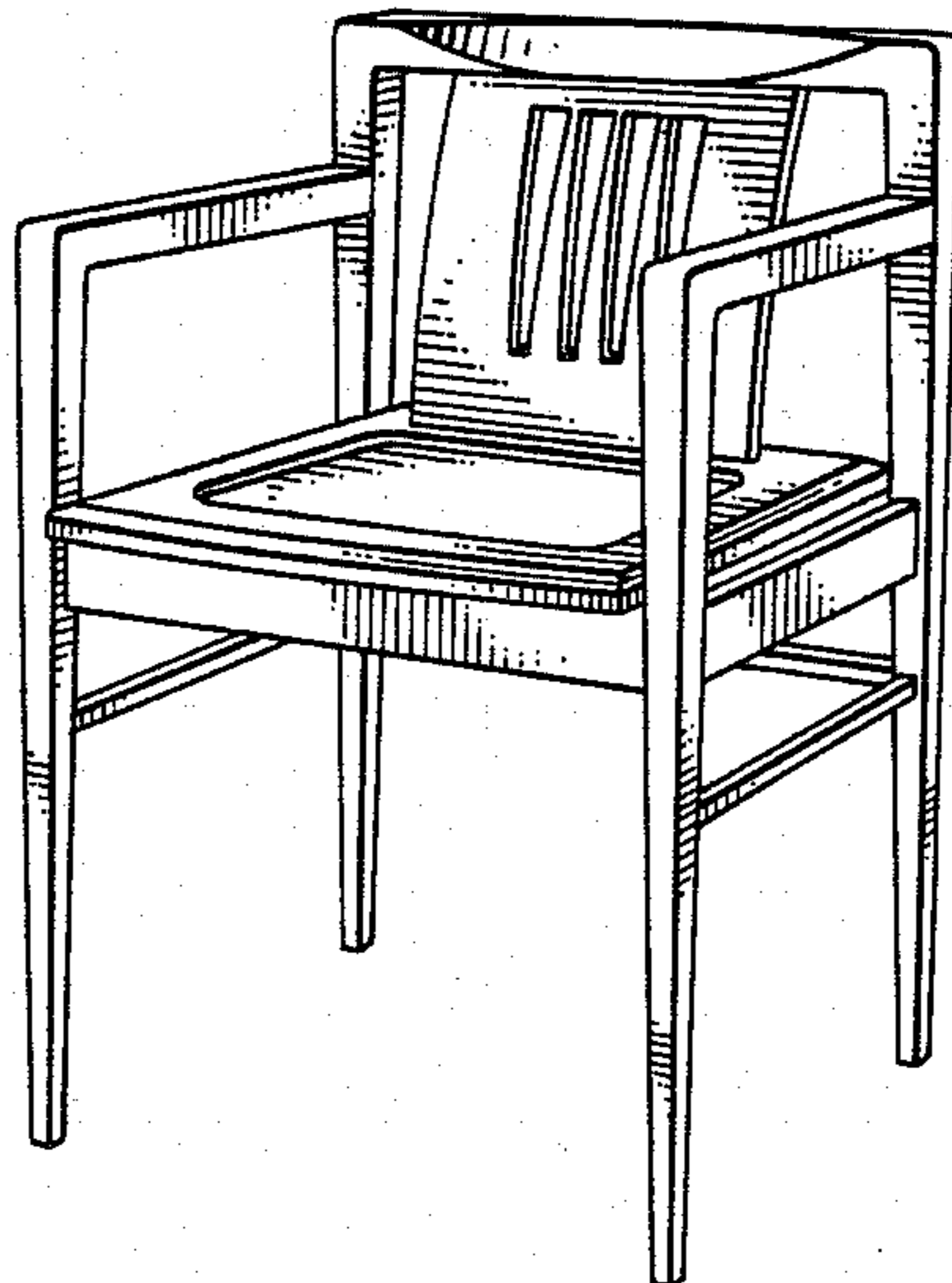

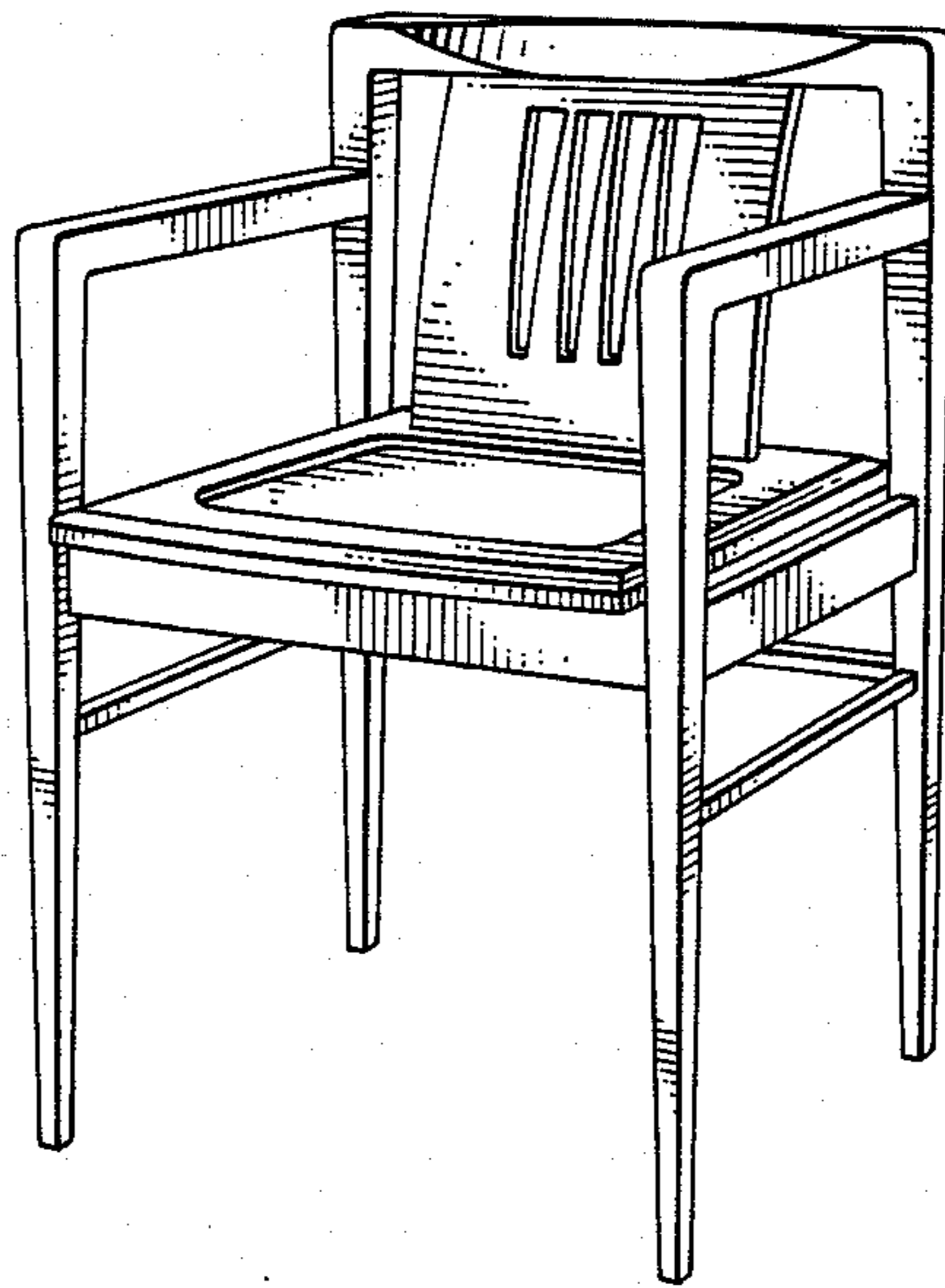
The ornamental design for a chair or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

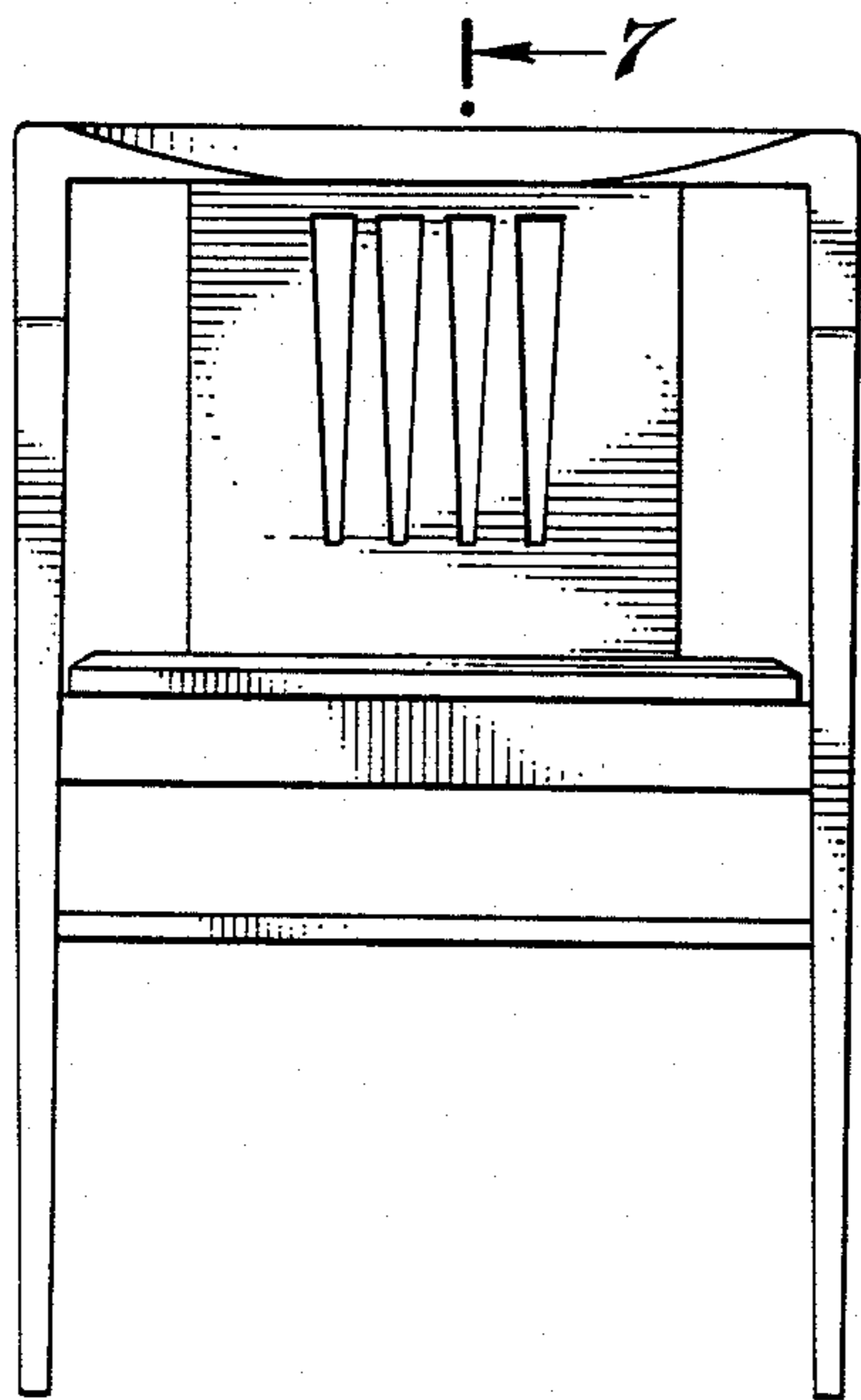
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our design;

 FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 2;  
 FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a chair showing second embodiment of our design;  
 FIG. 9 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a third embodiment of our design;  
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the FIG. 9 embodiment;  
 FIG. 11 is a side elevational view of the FIG. 9 embodiment, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 12 is a top plan view of the FIG. 9 embodiment; and  
 FIG. 13 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a fourth embodiment of our design.



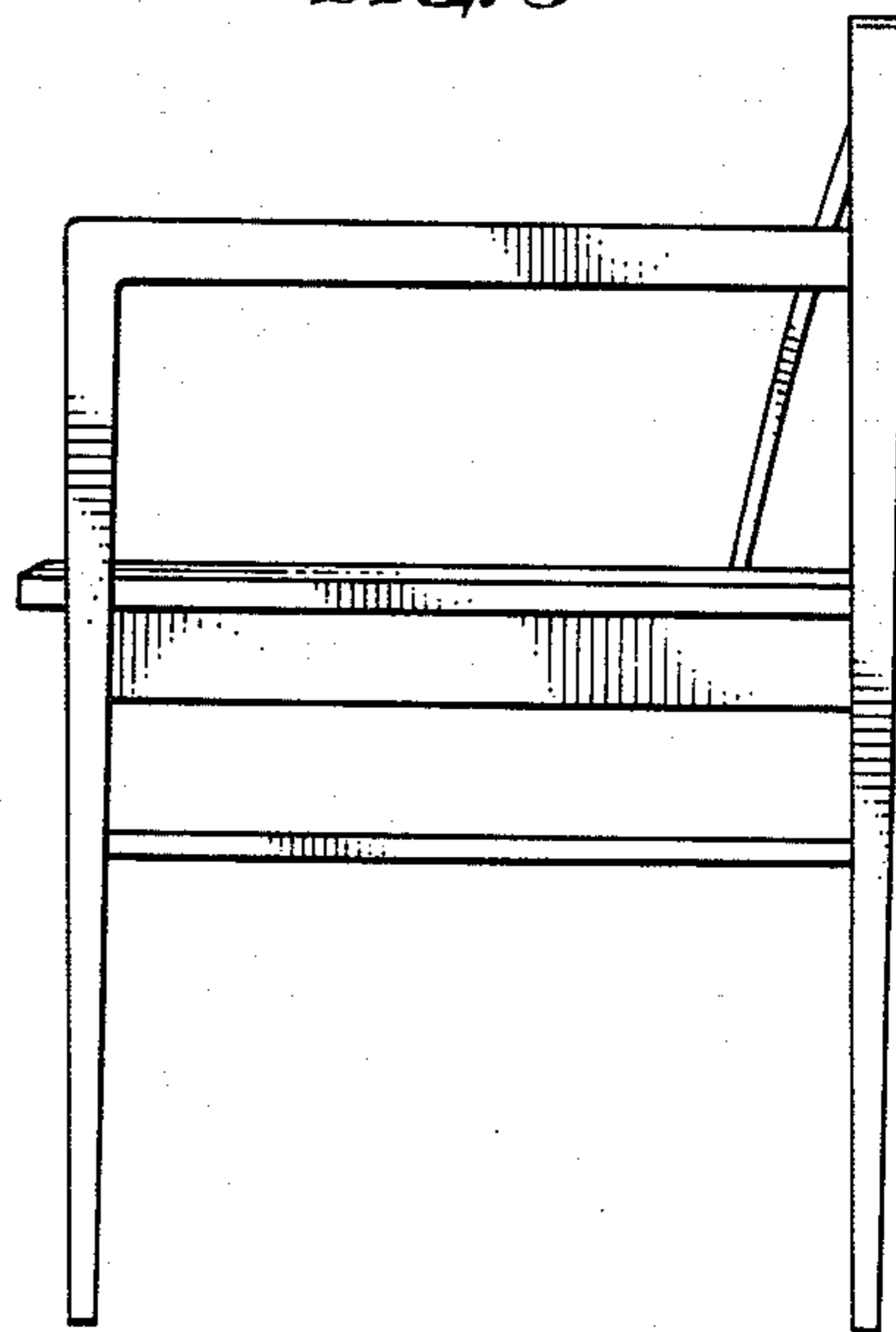

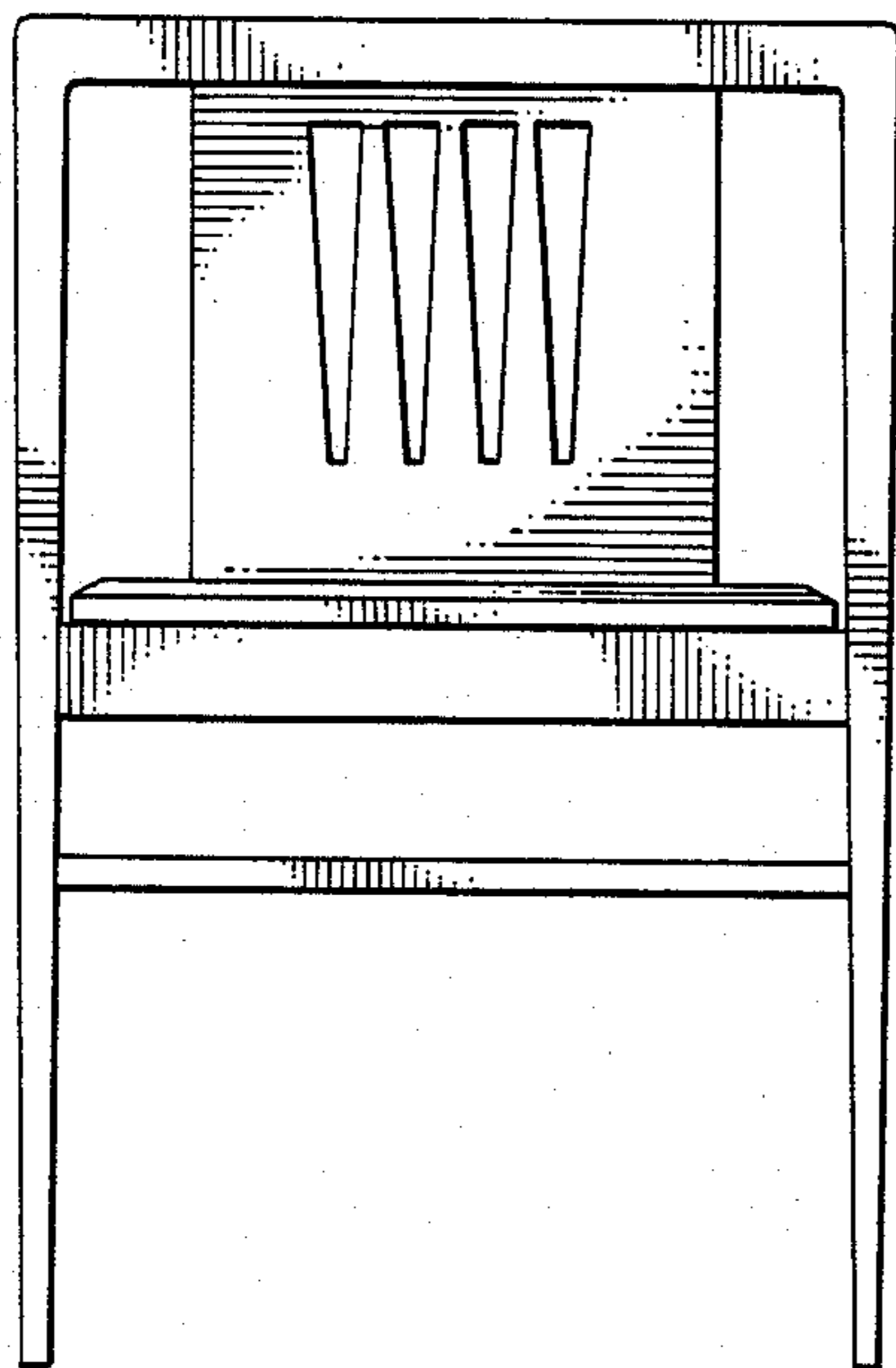

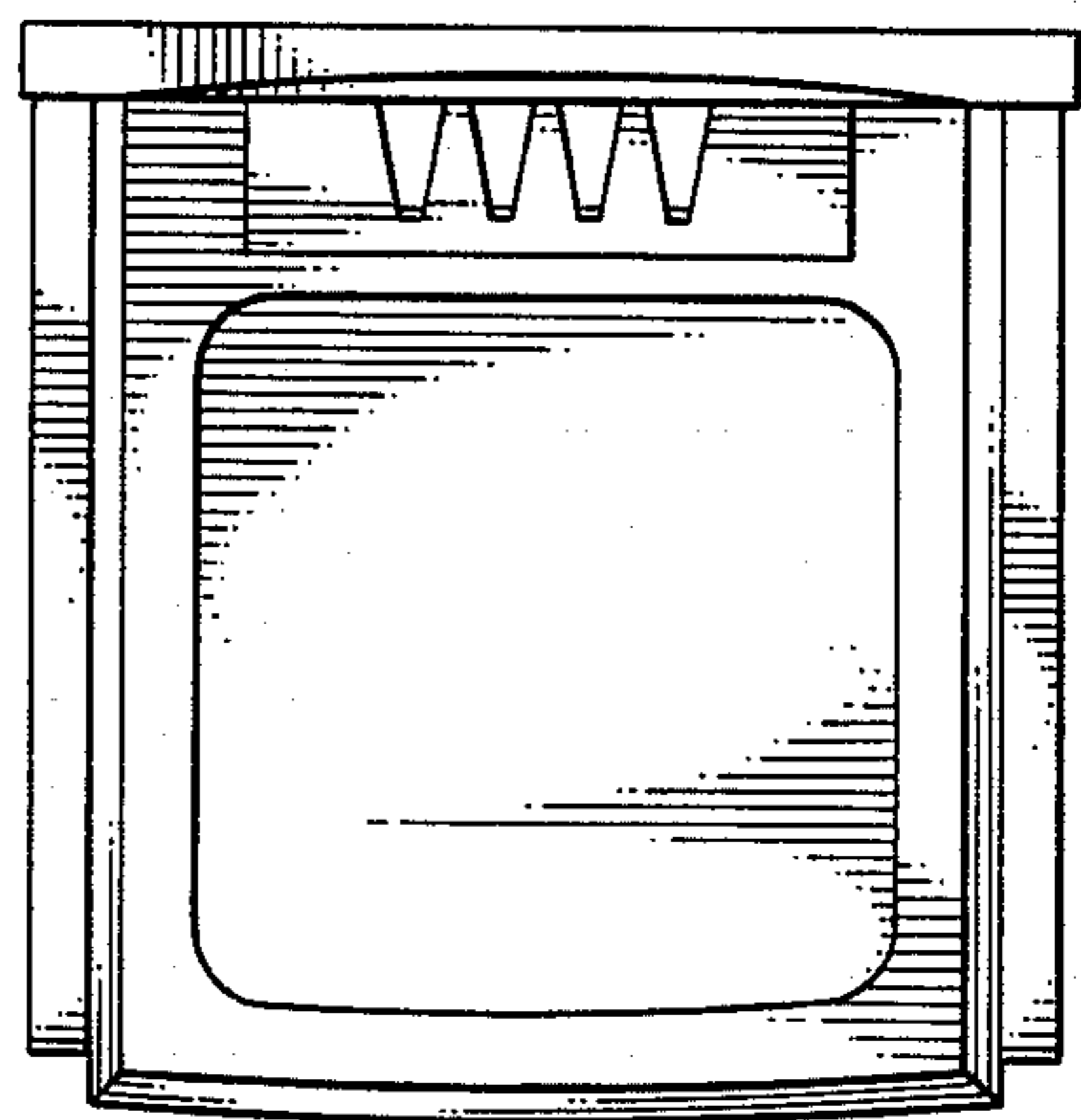

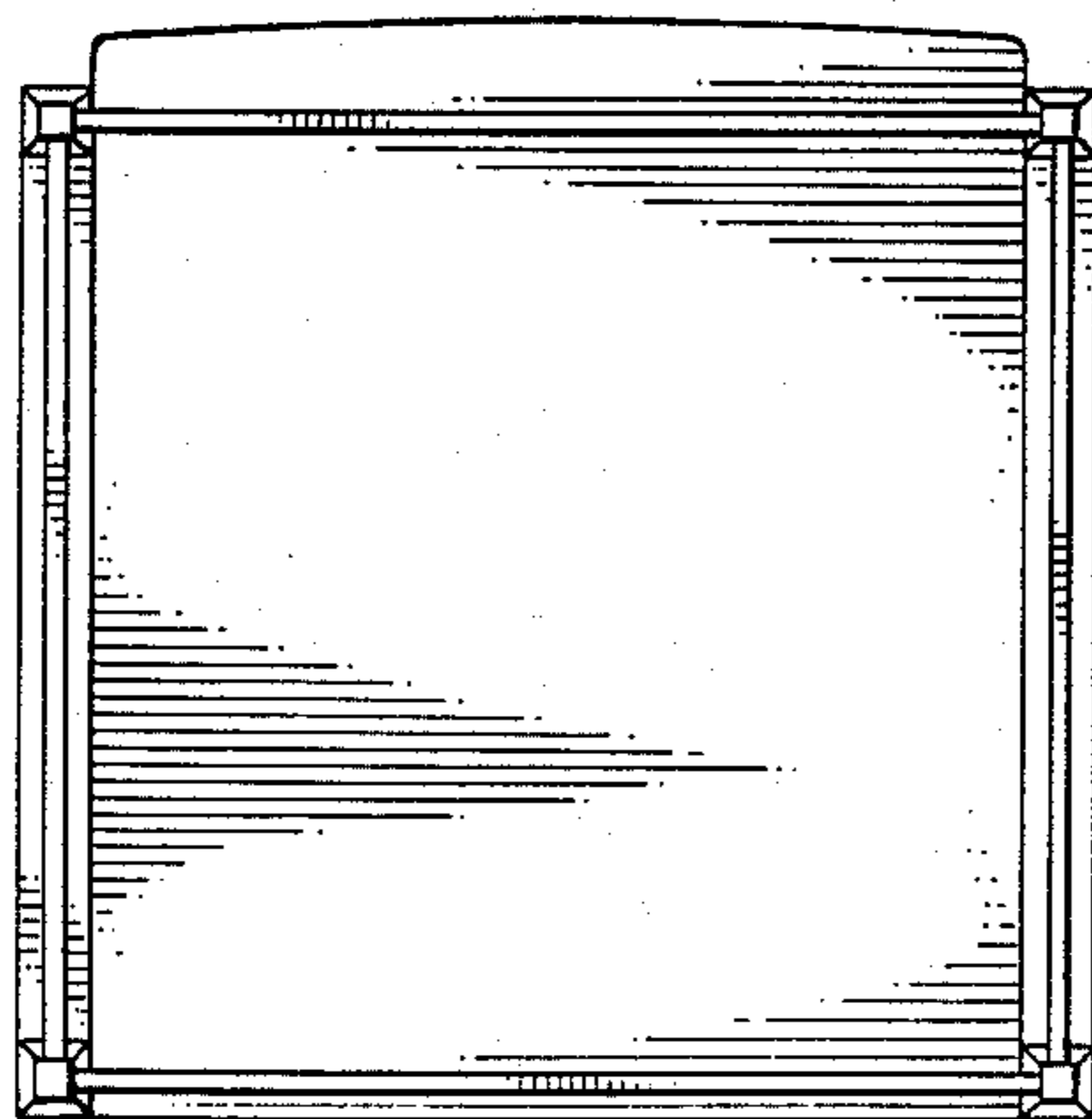

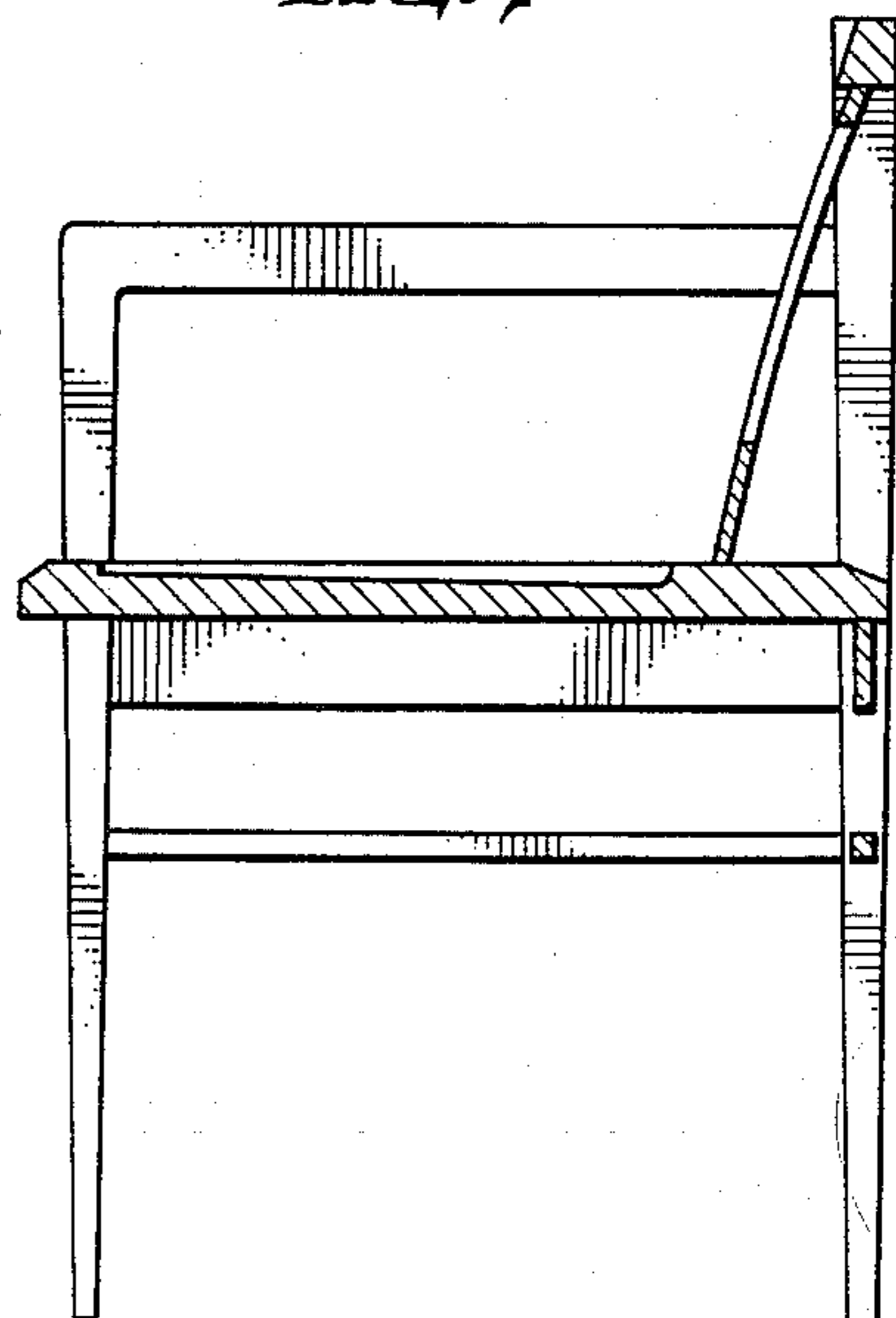

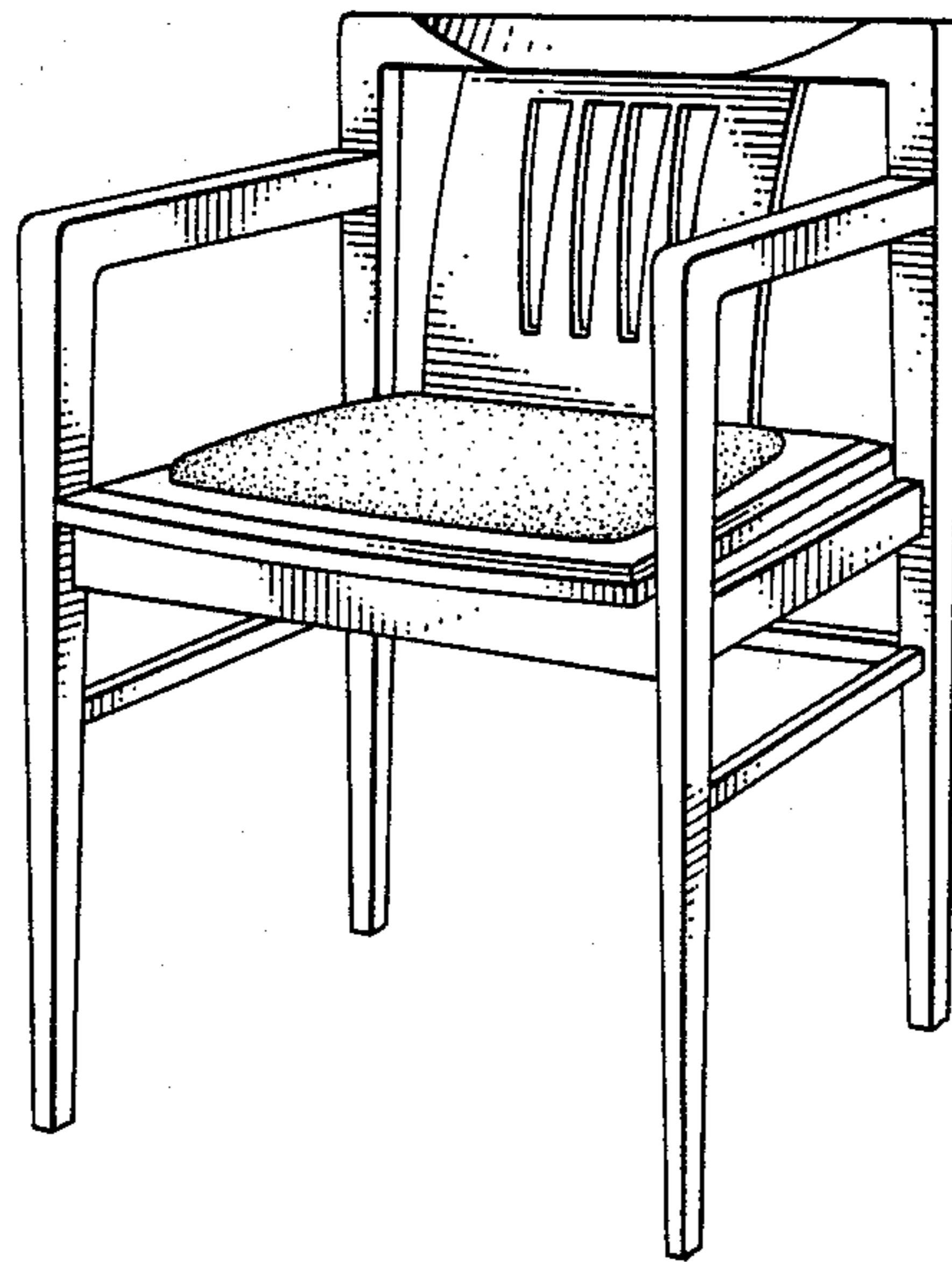

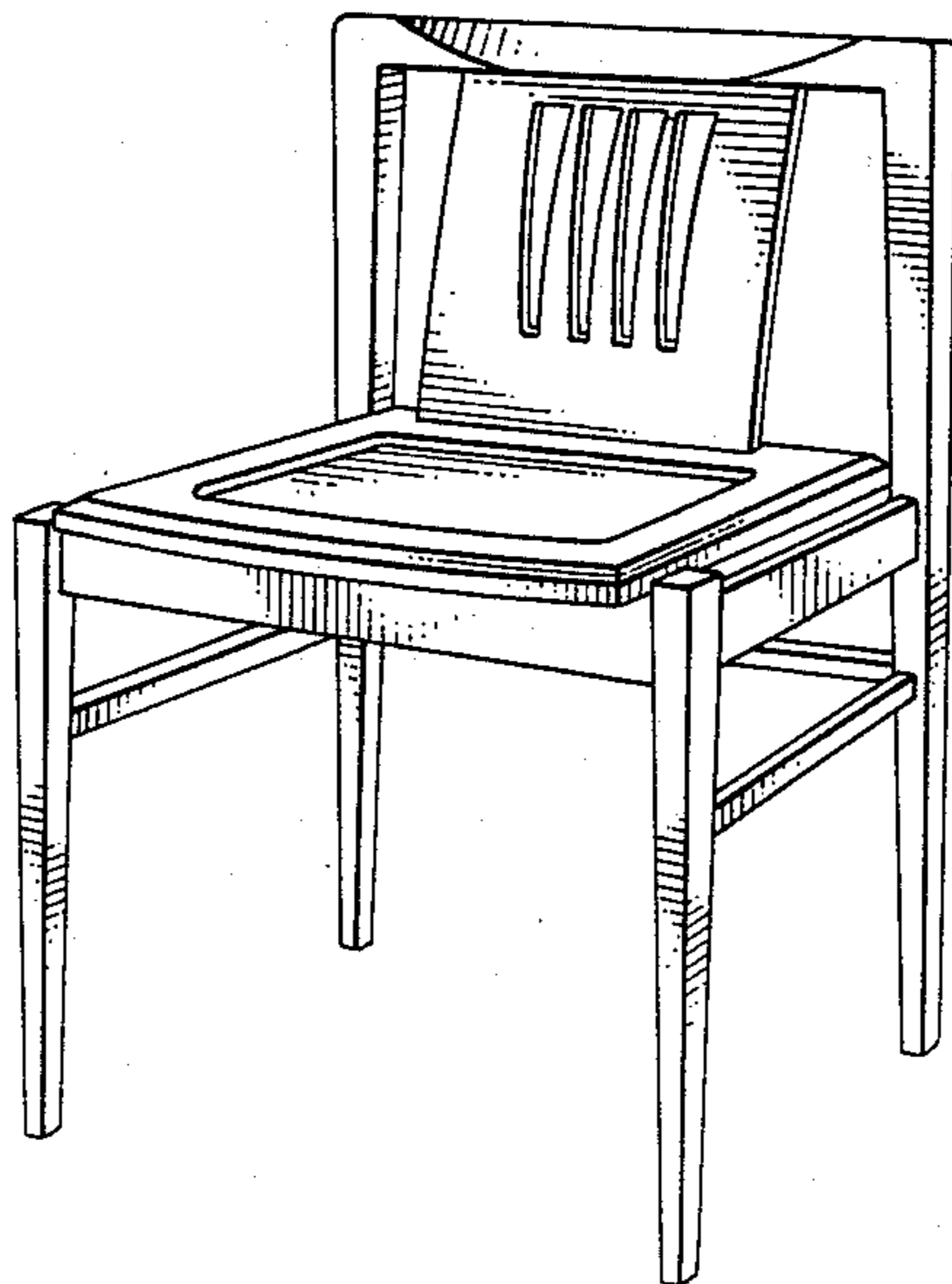

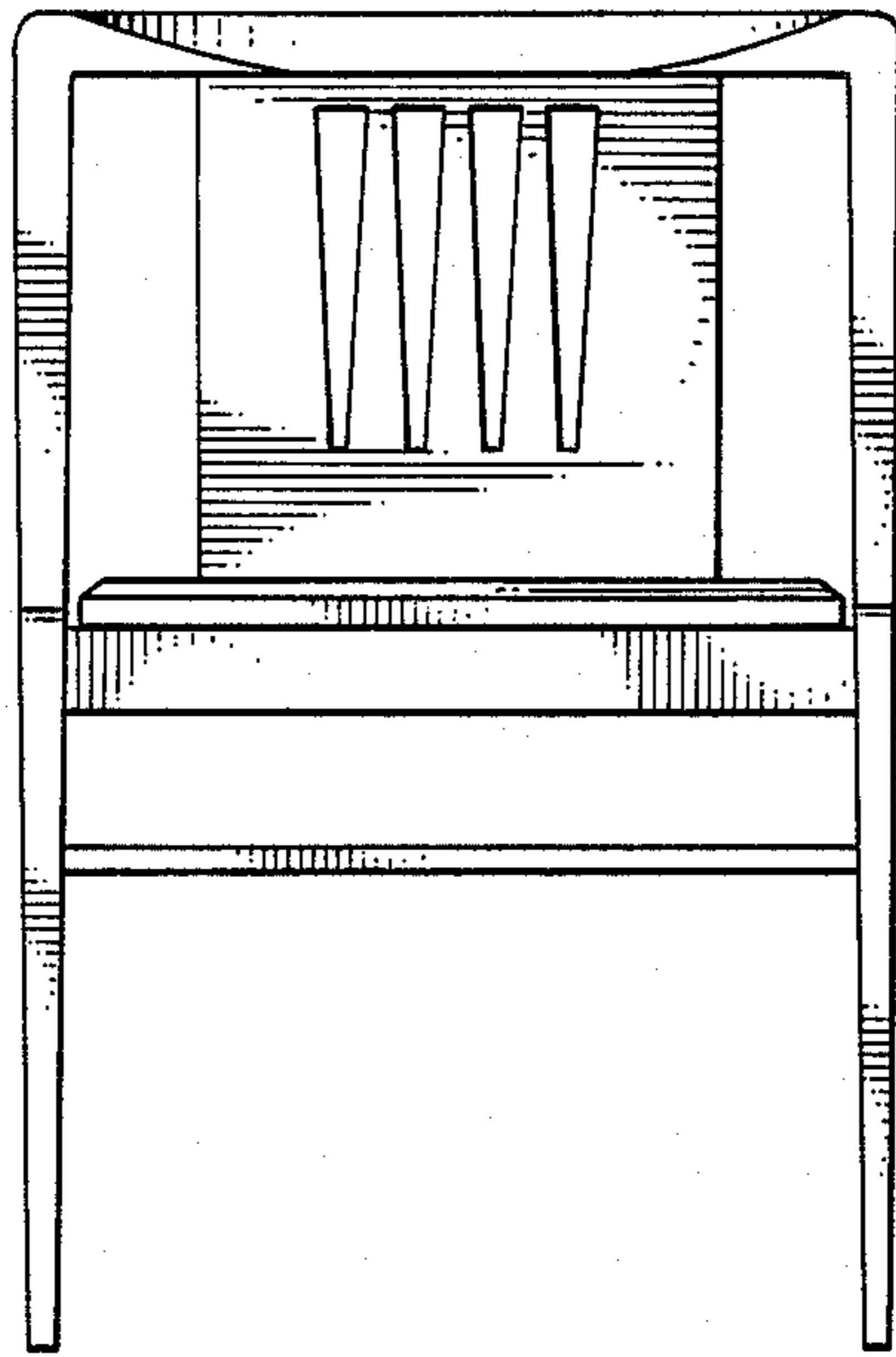

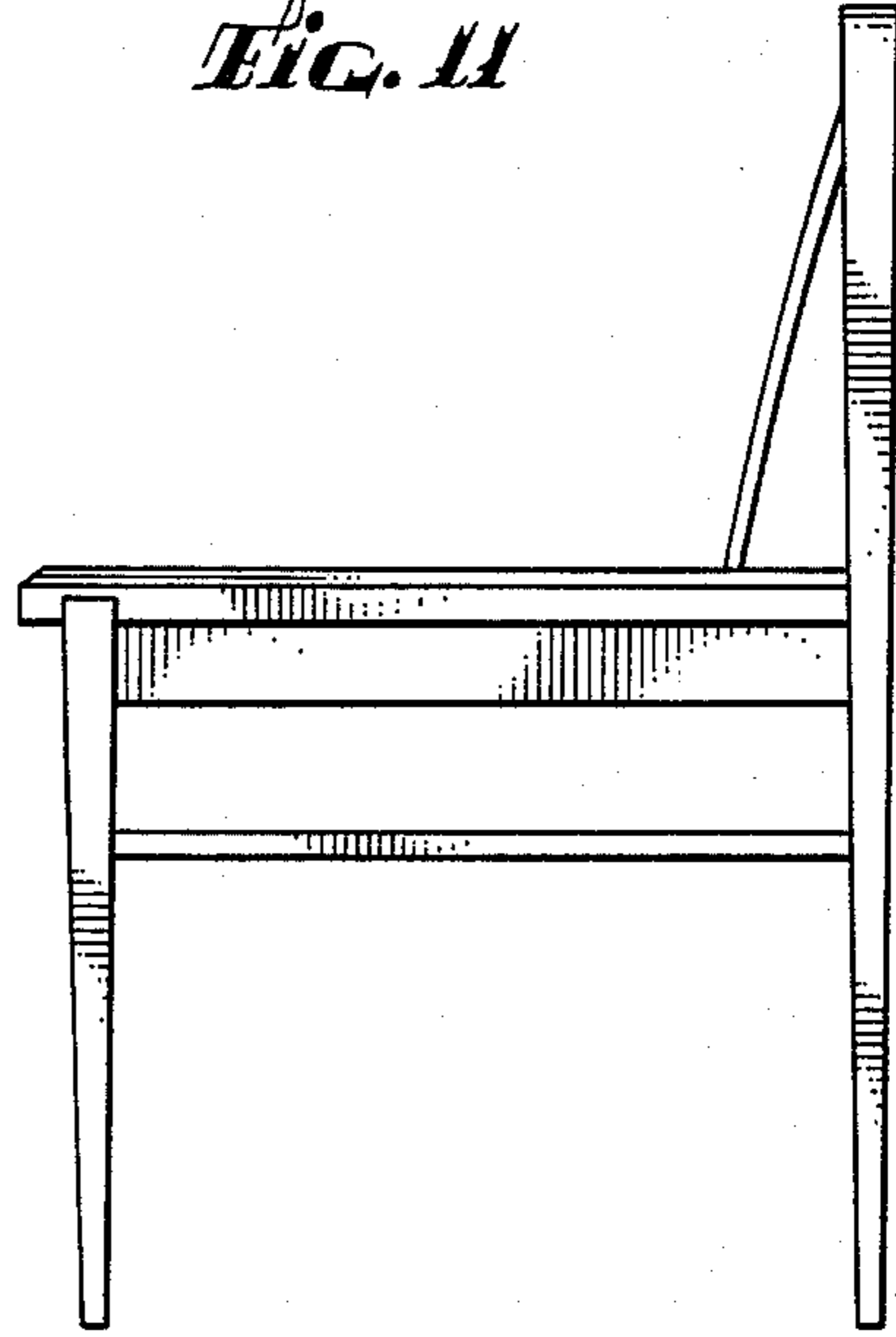

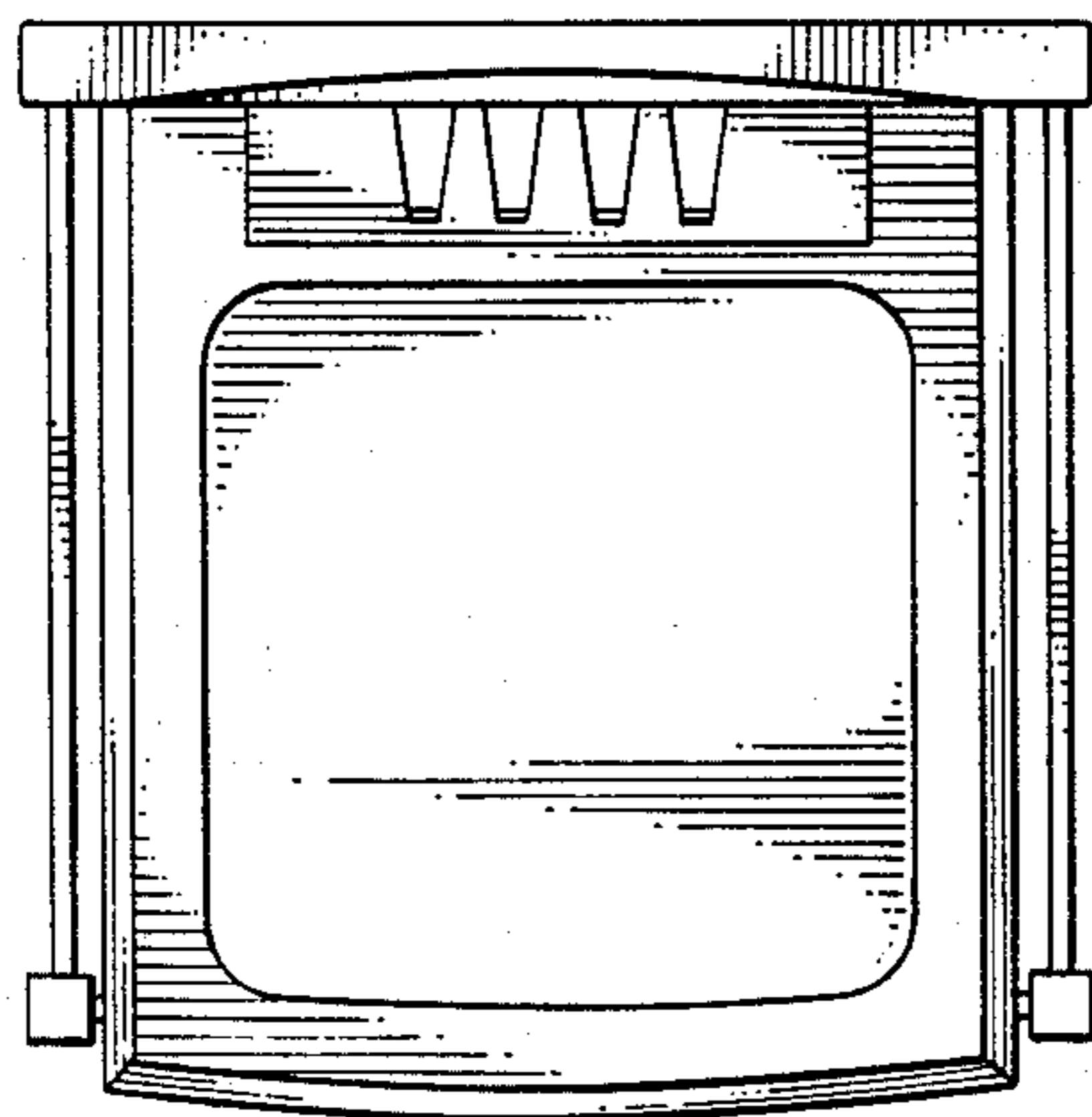
