DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a watch showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof with a typical time indicator activated;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof in a non-activated condition;














