FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a combined tape player and radio showing my new design, illustrated with the tape compartment door open;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

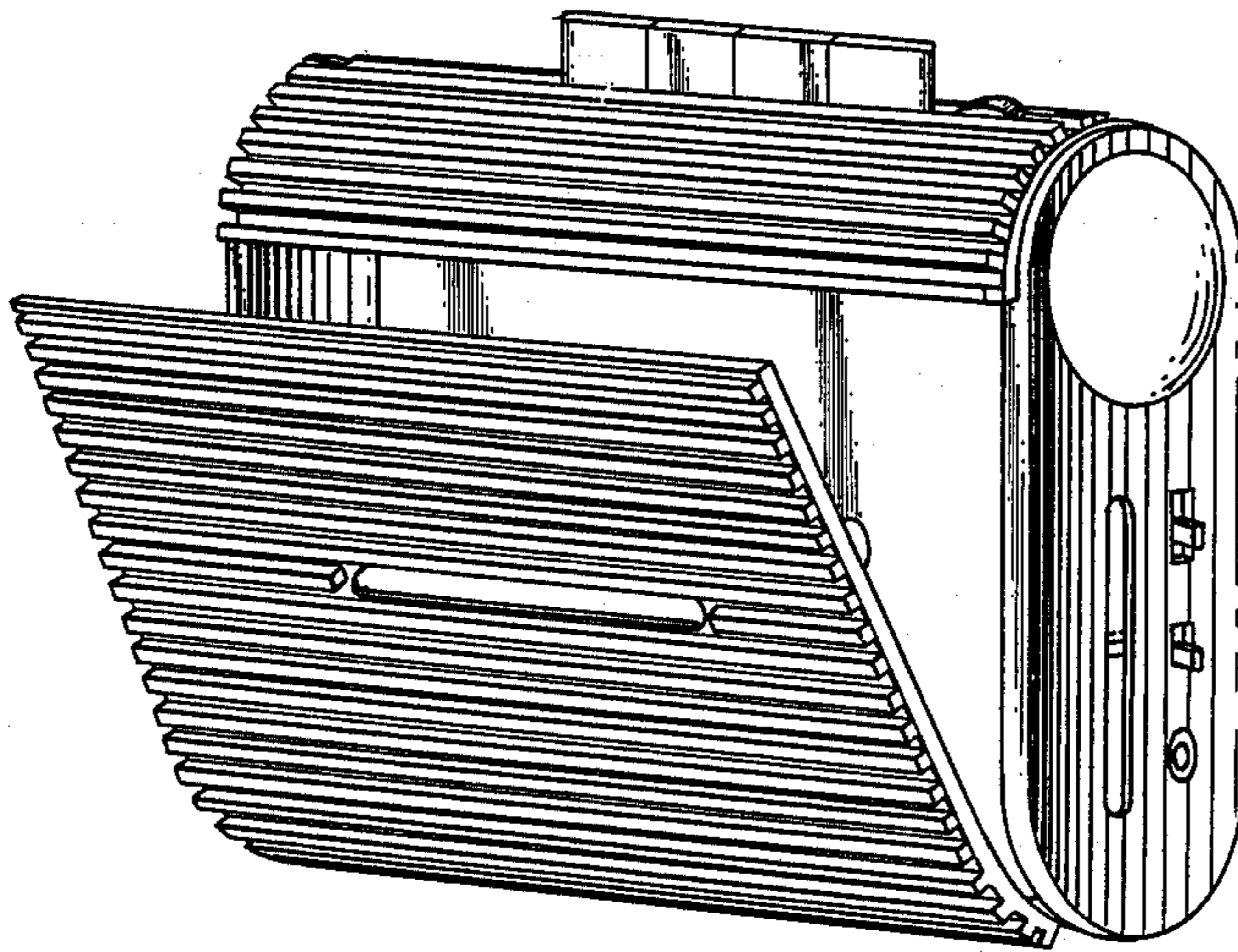
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



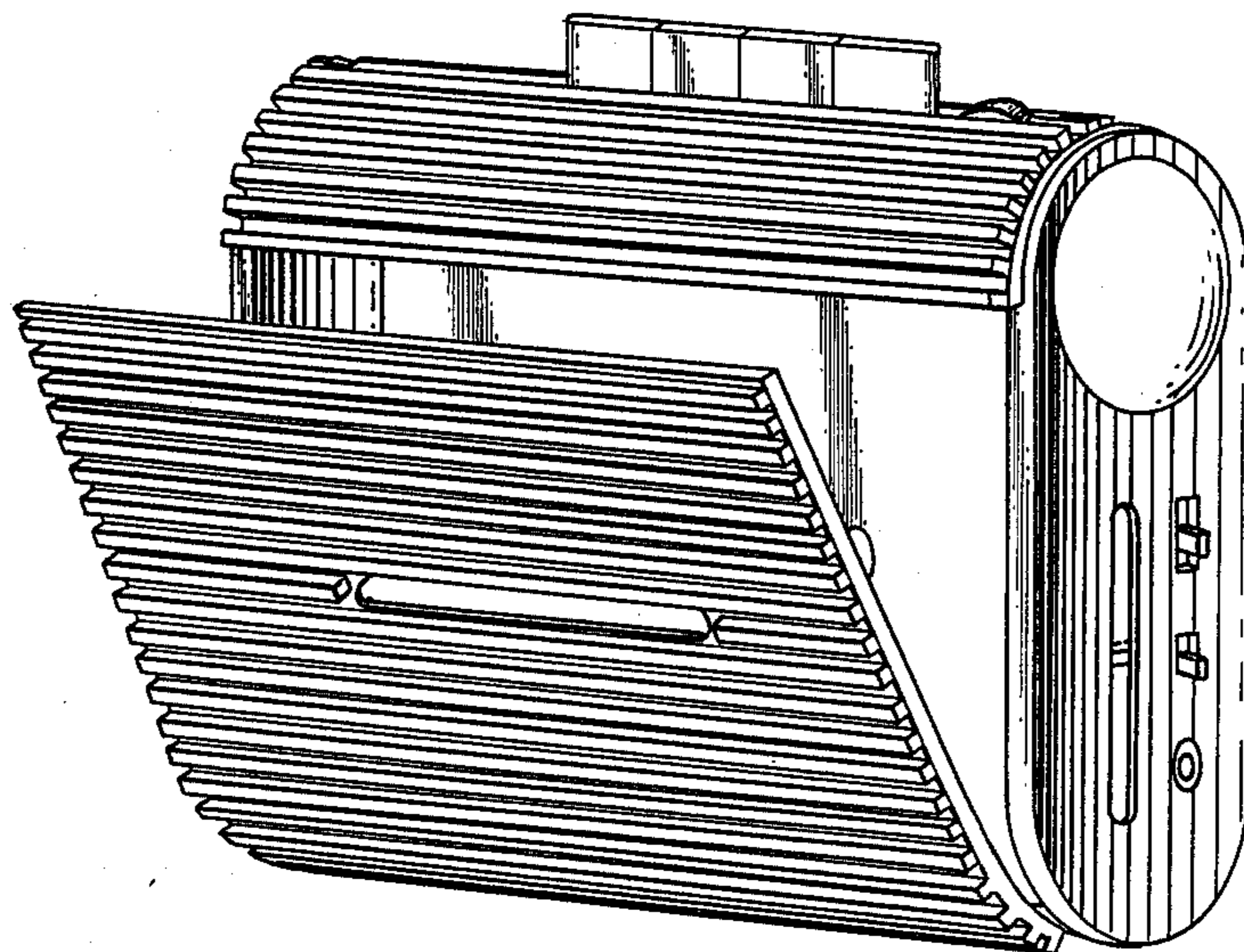

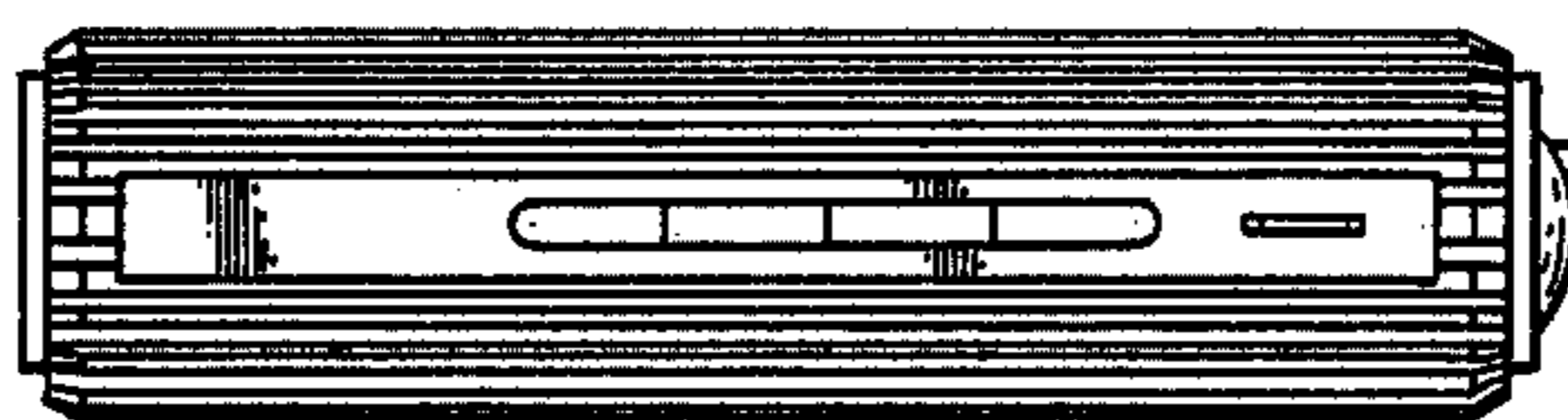

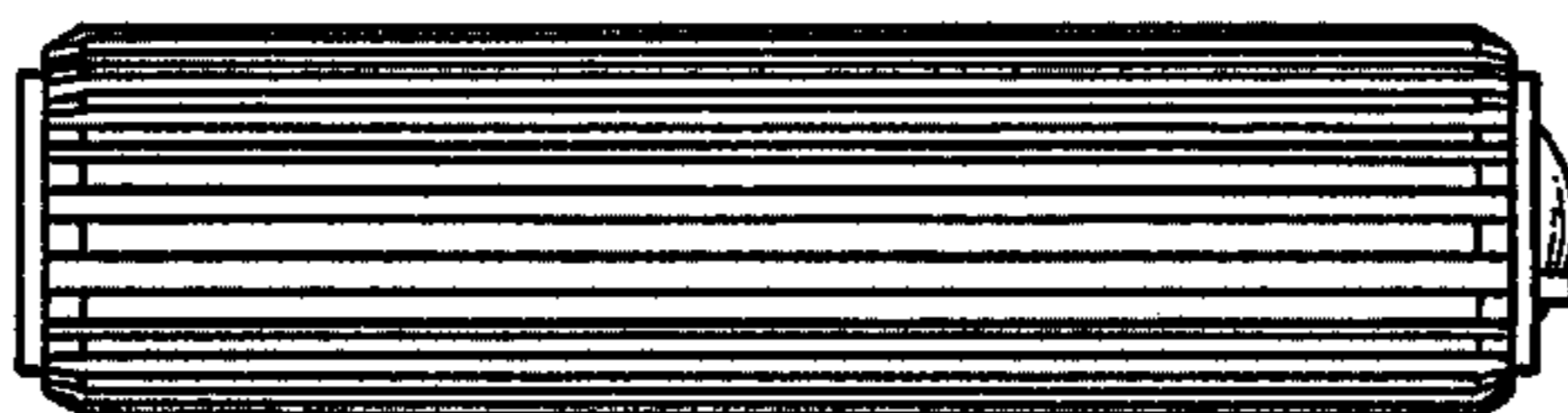

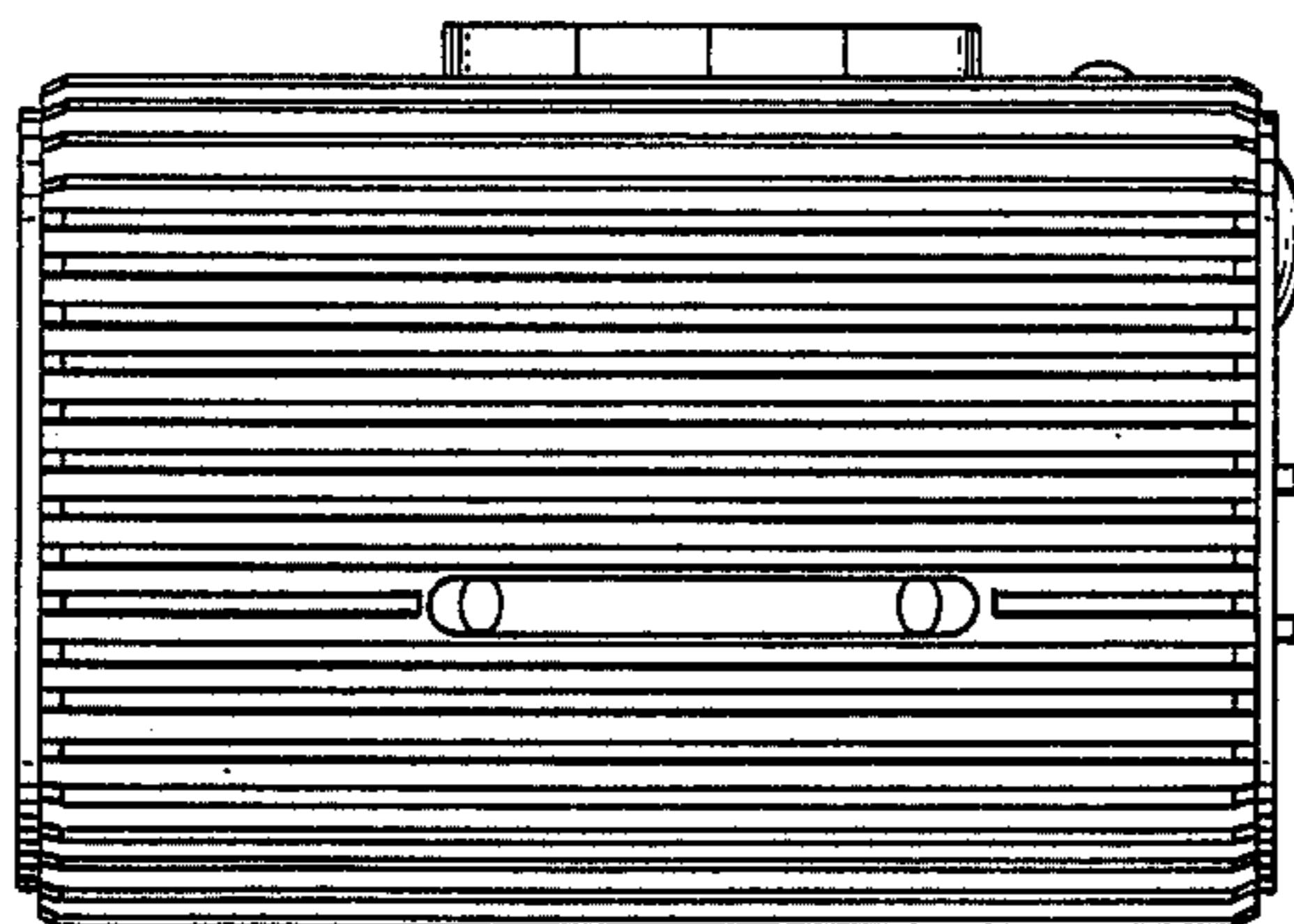

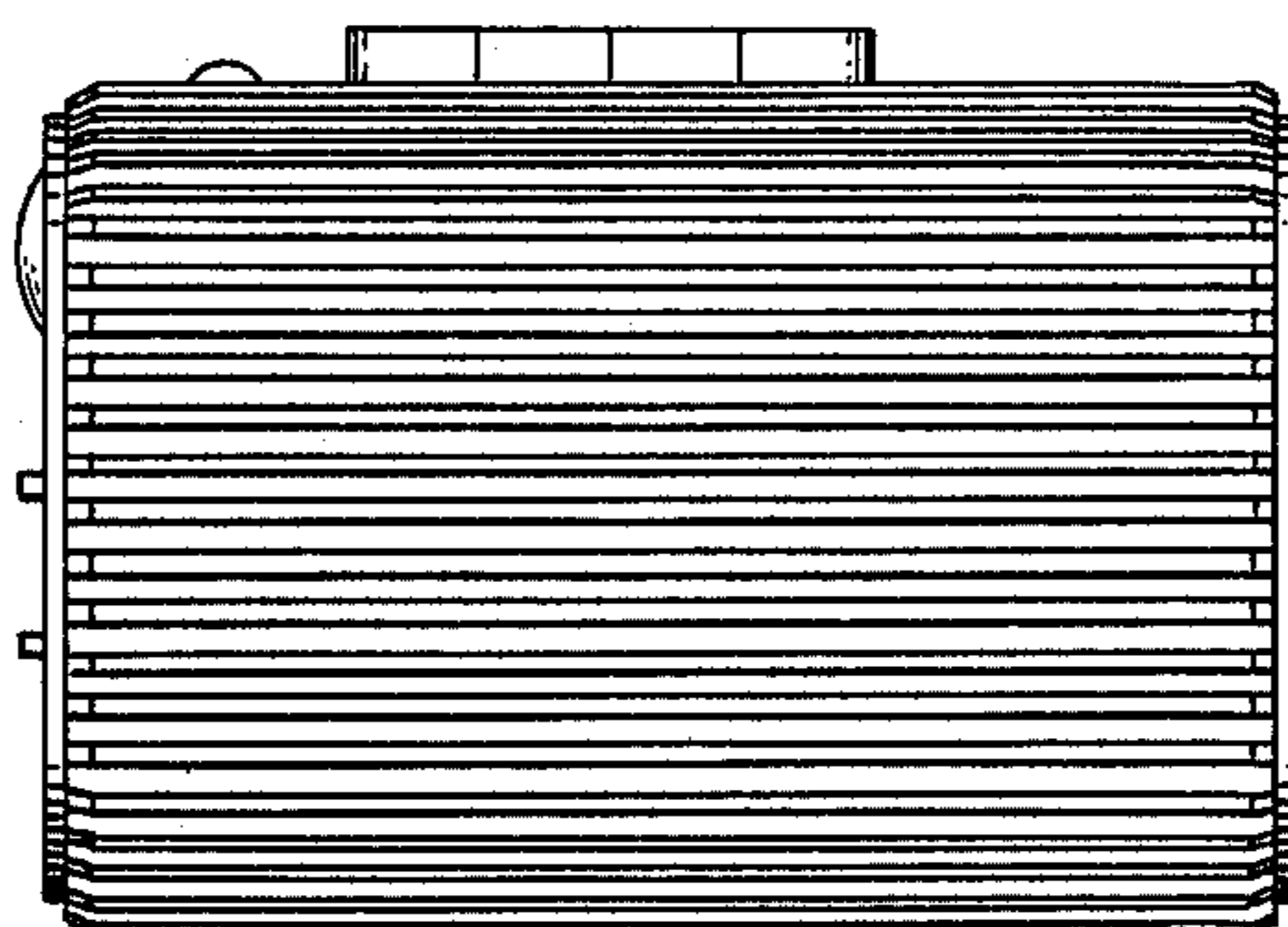

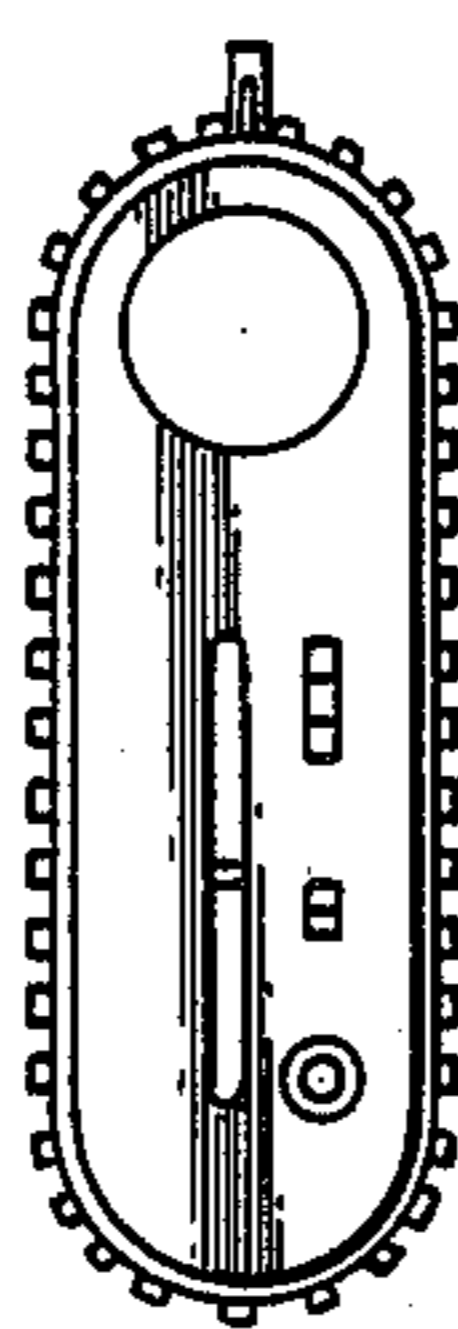

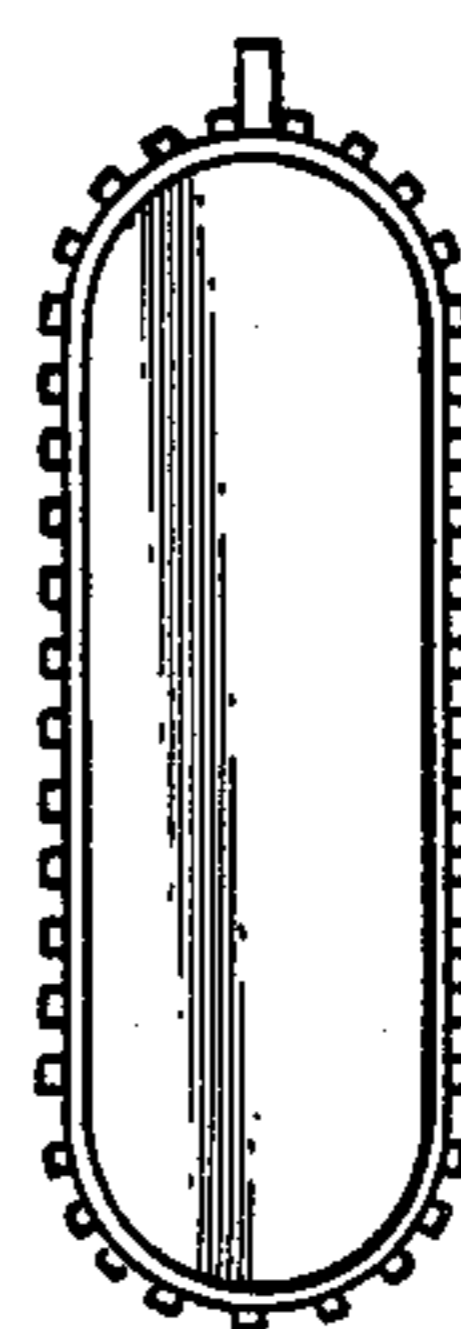
