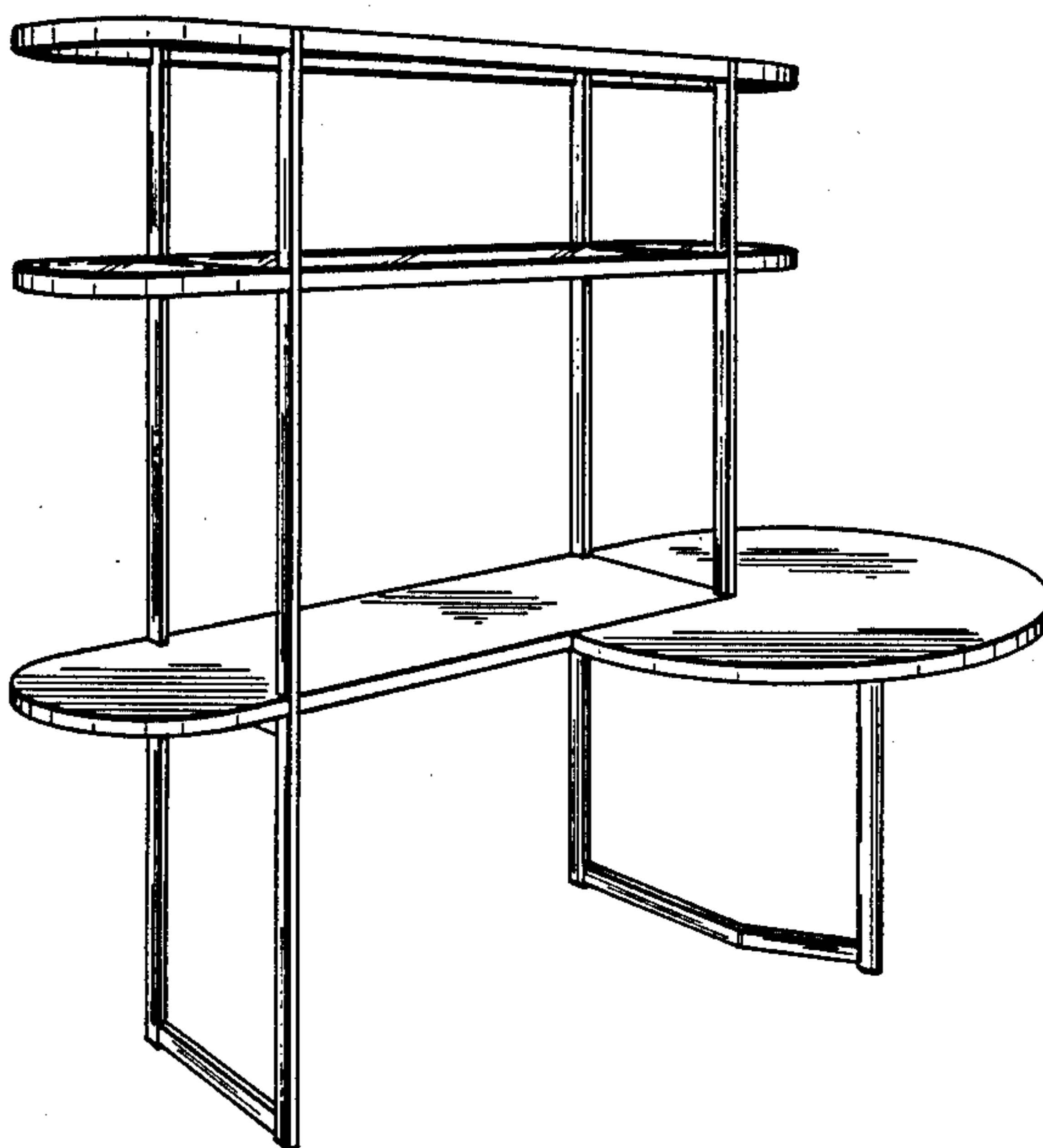

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined etagere and table showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



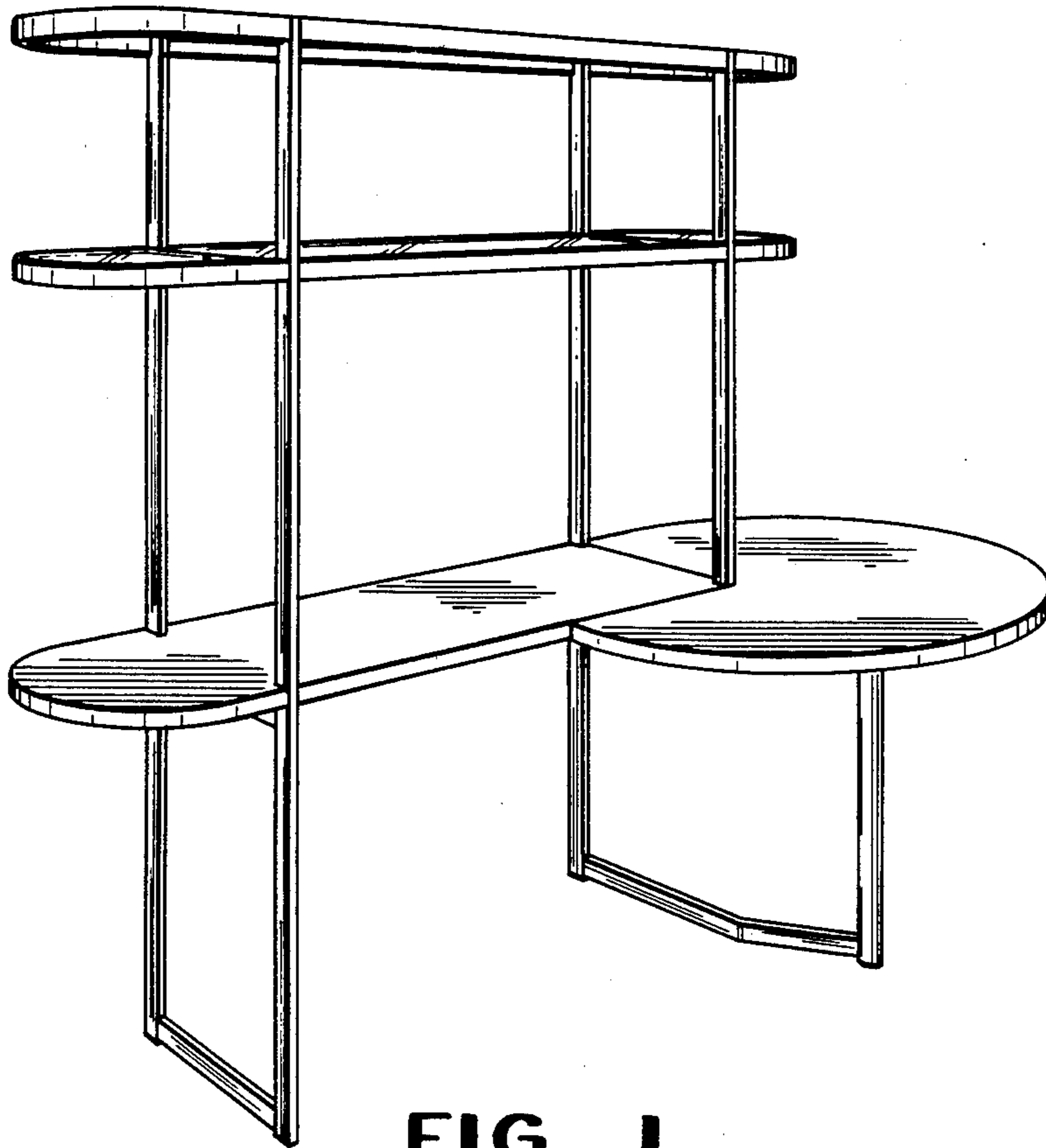

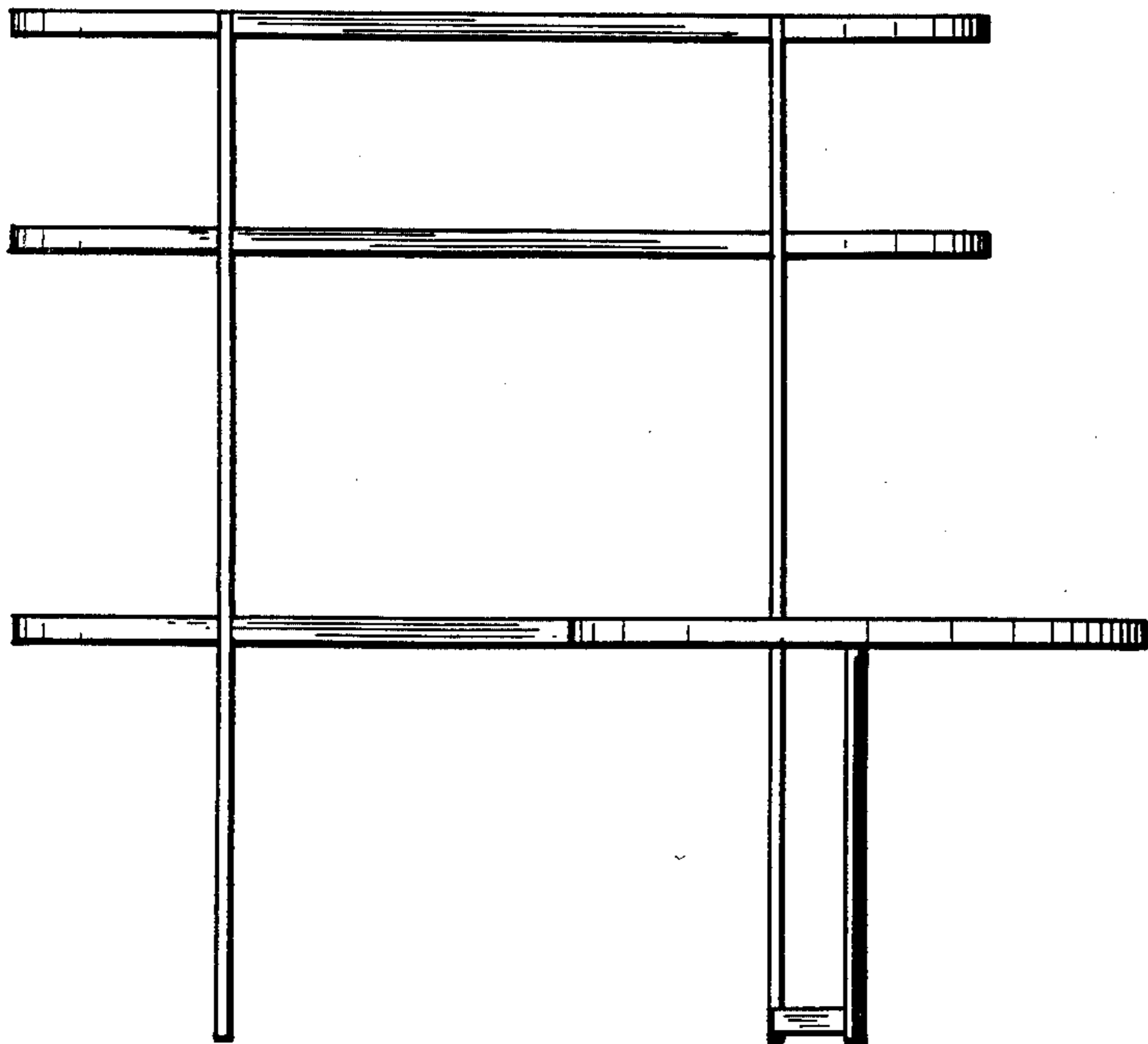

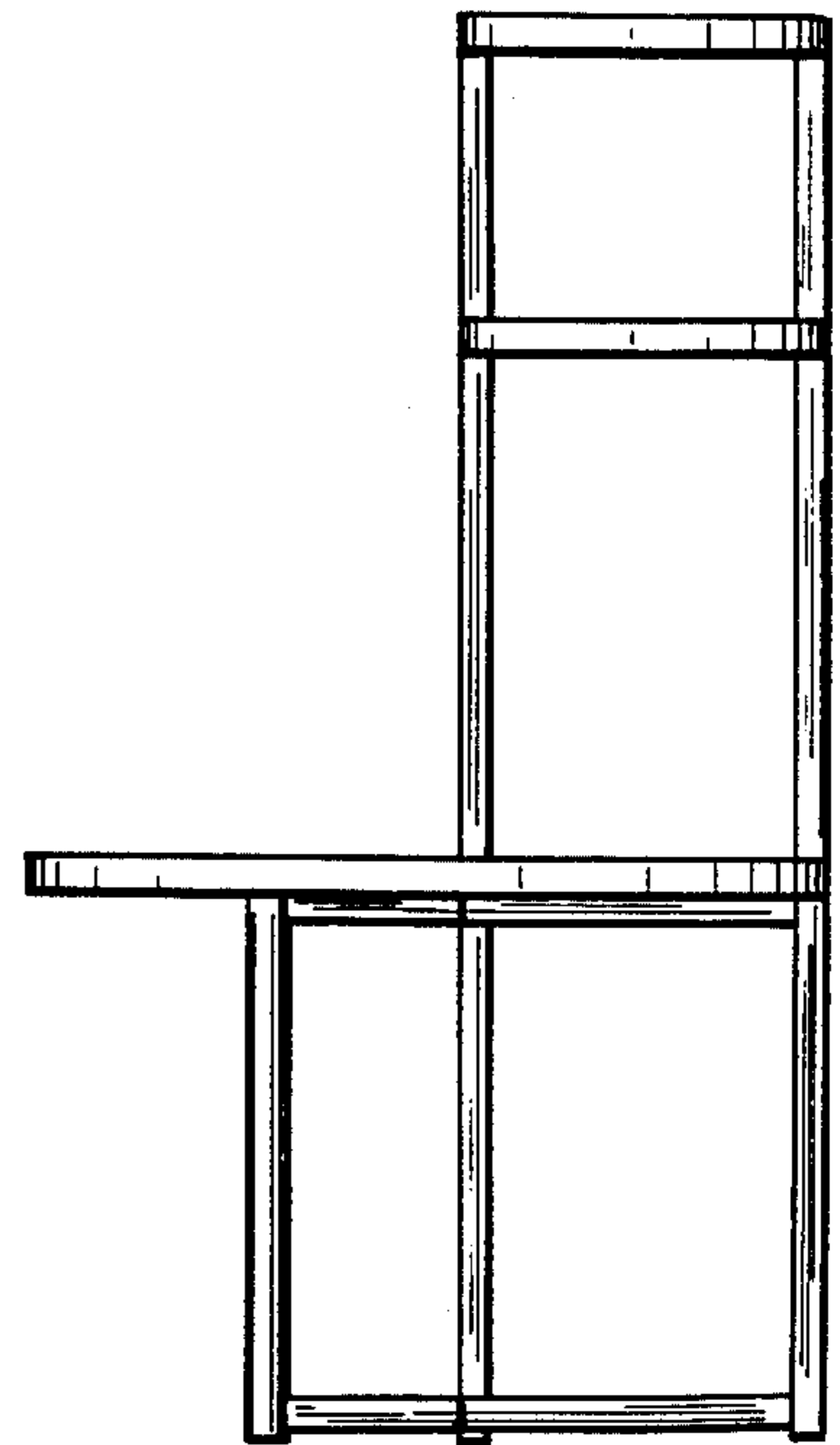

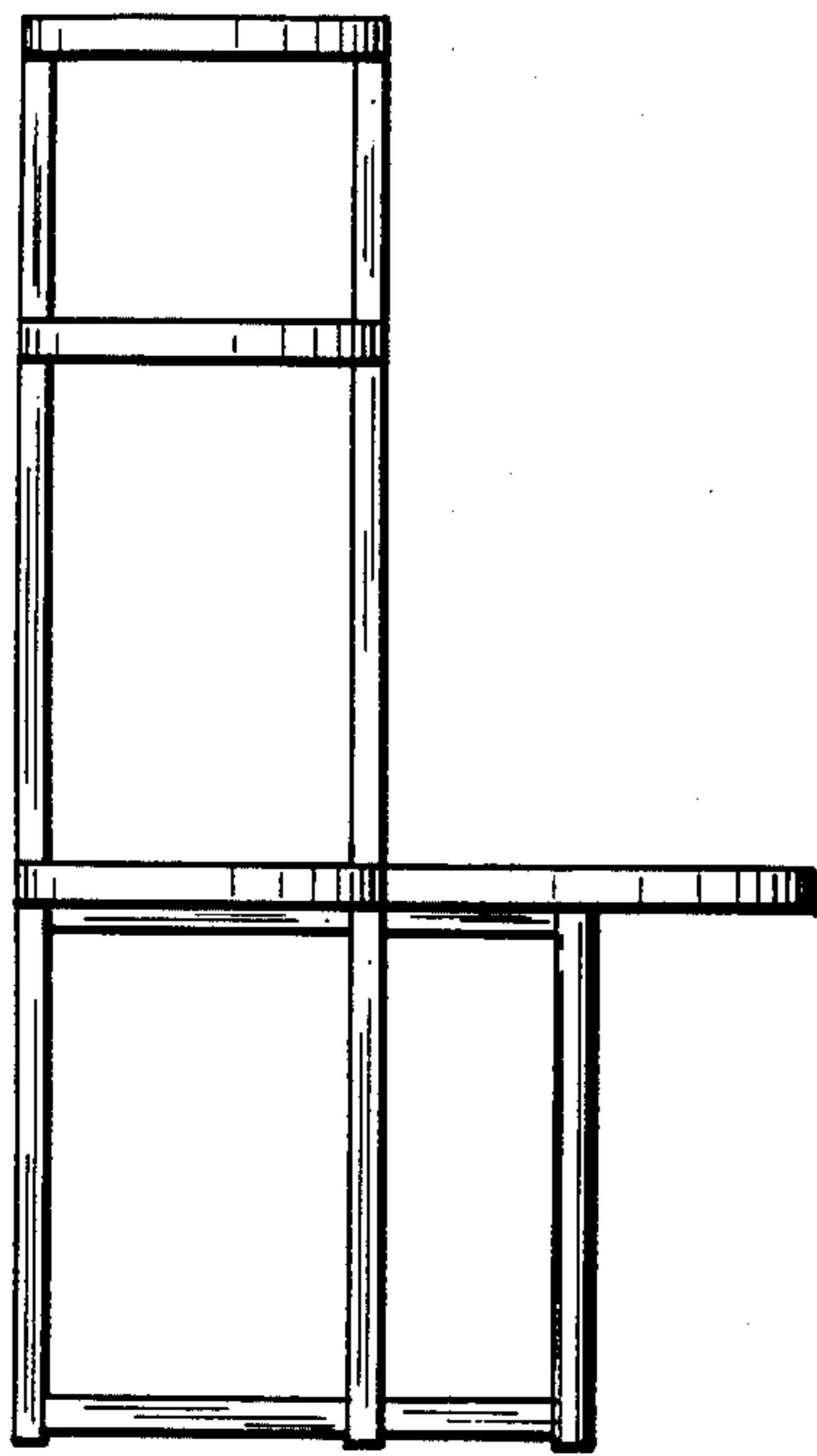

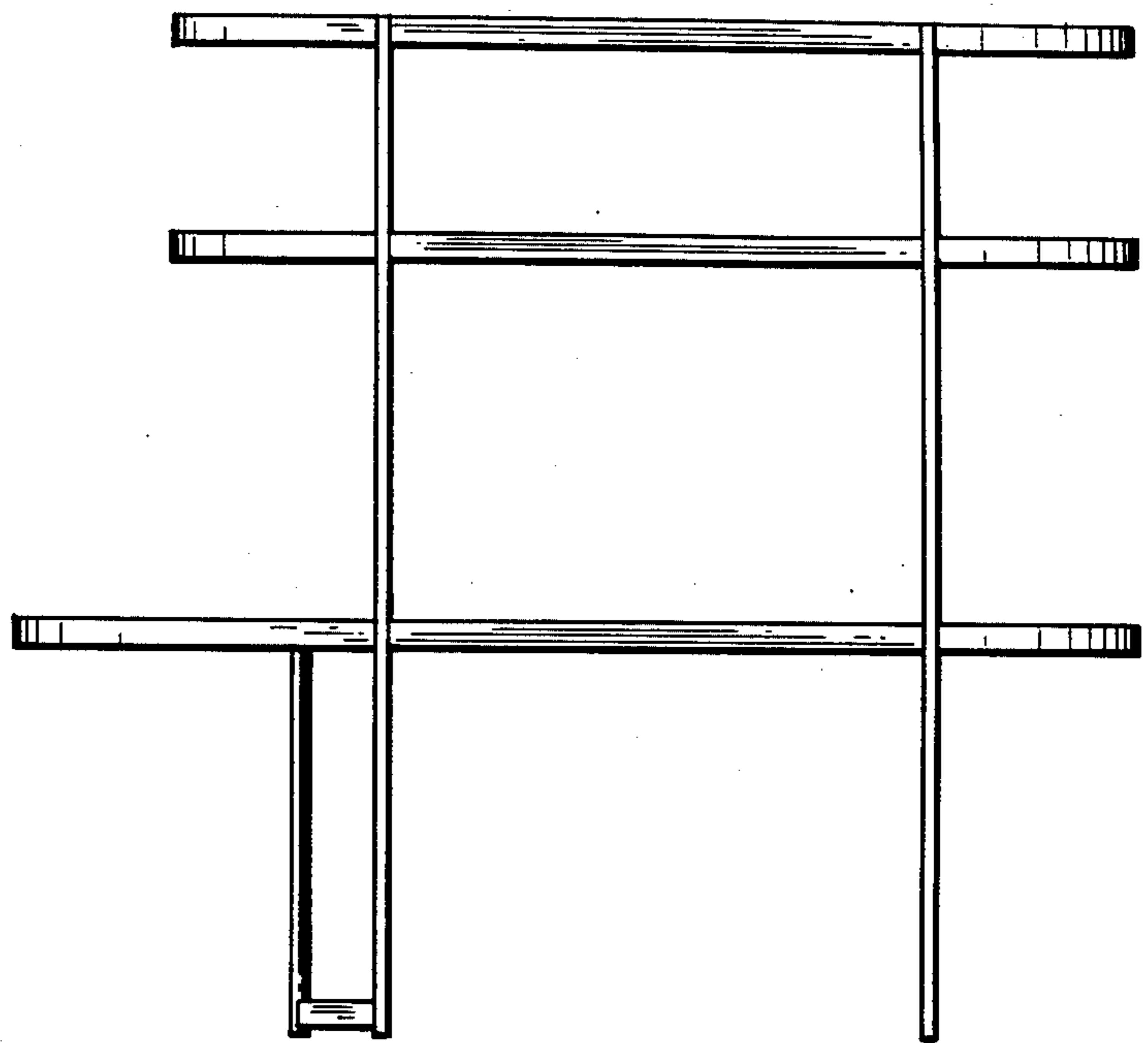

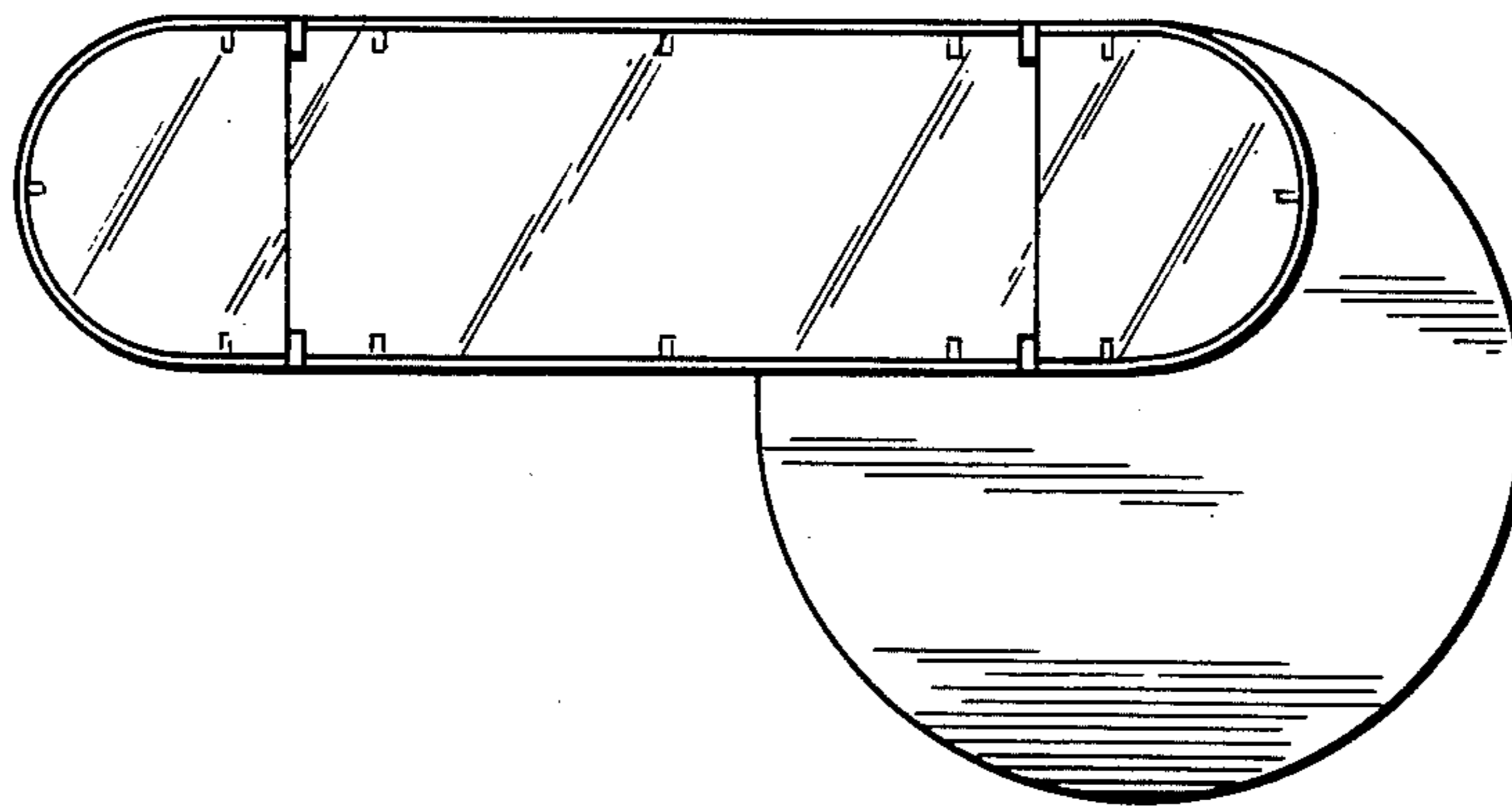
