[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an entree plate, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an entree plate showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a right end view thereof.

The side and end opposite those shown in FIGS. 1 and 4 are similar to the side and end shown.

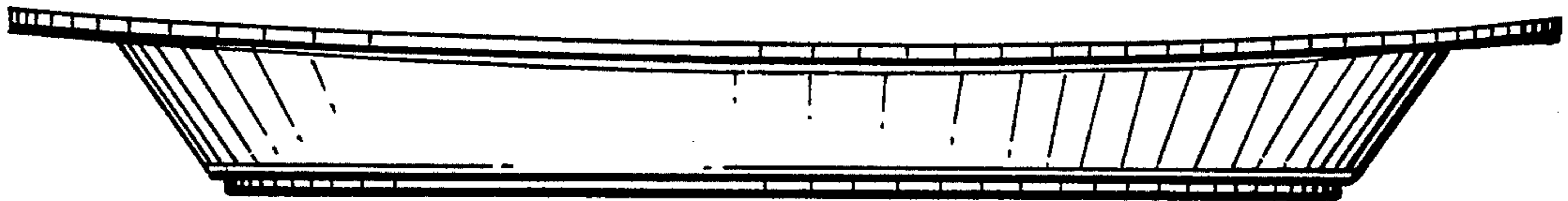

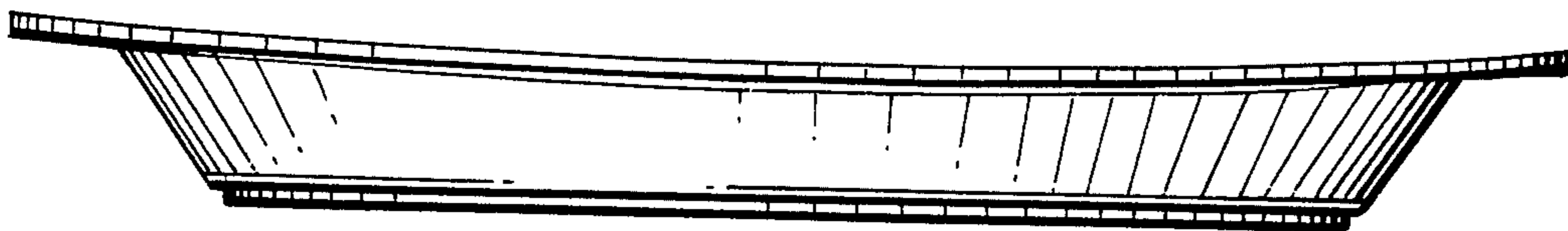

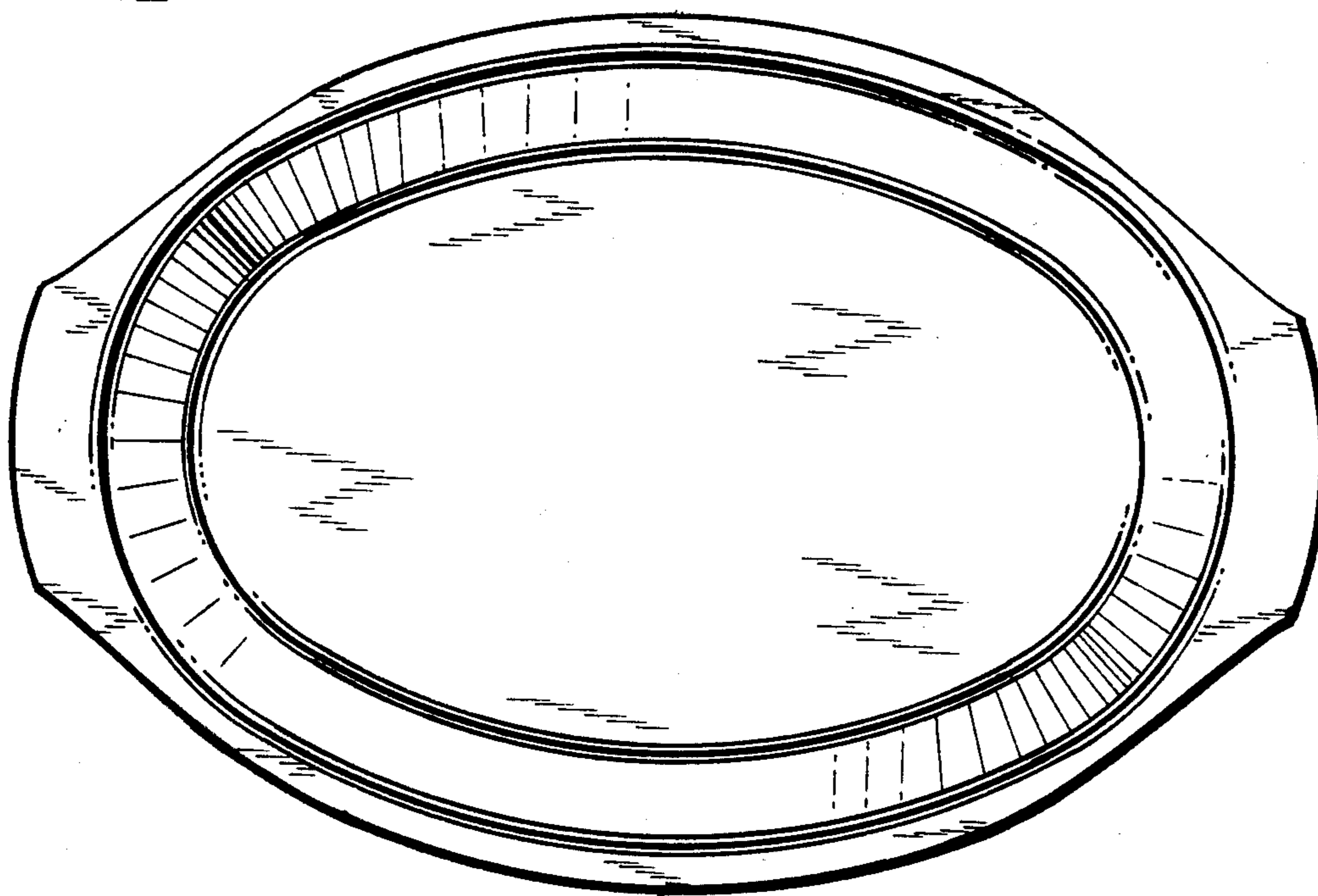
