[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a memory card for a computer system, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the memory card for a computer system showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

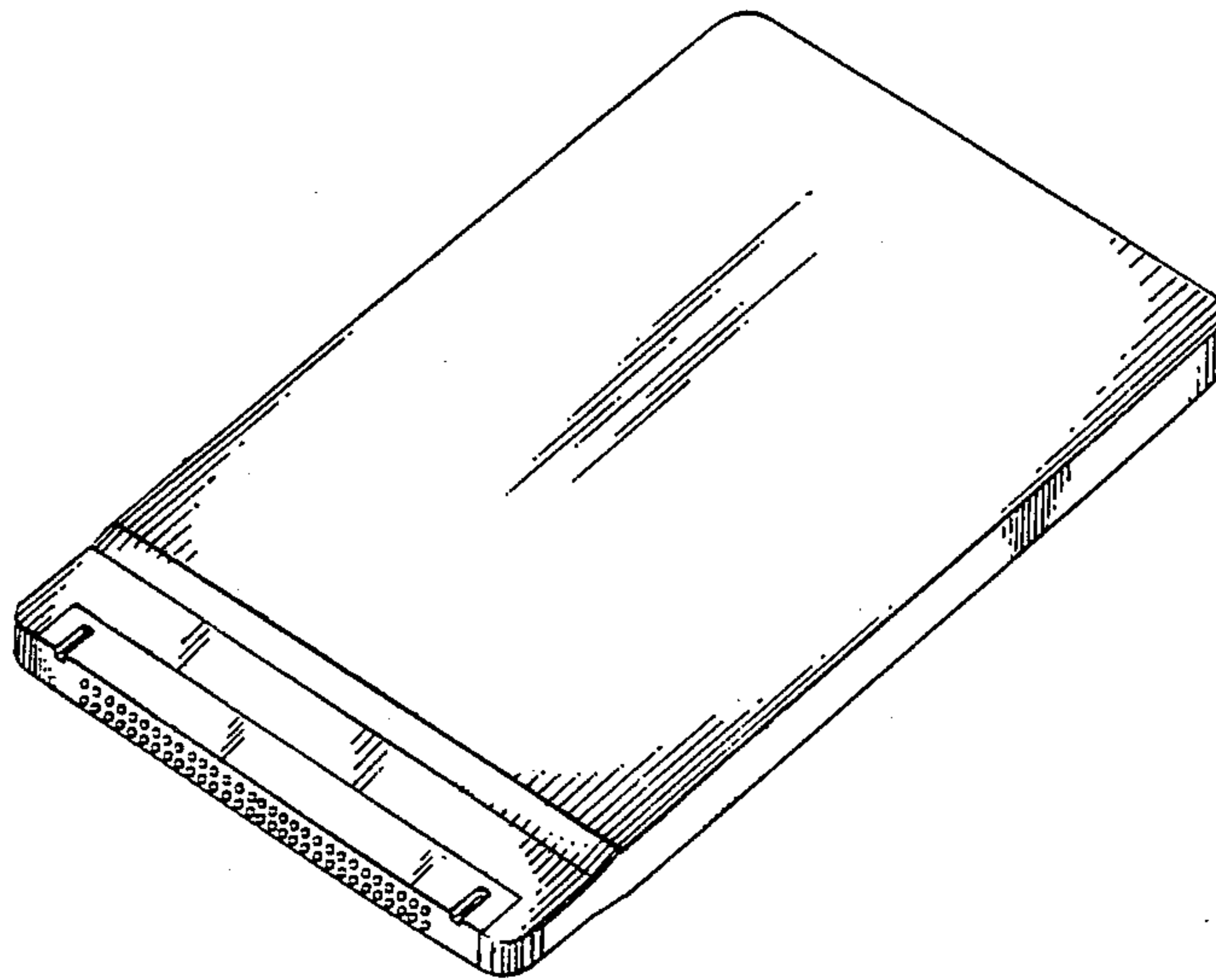

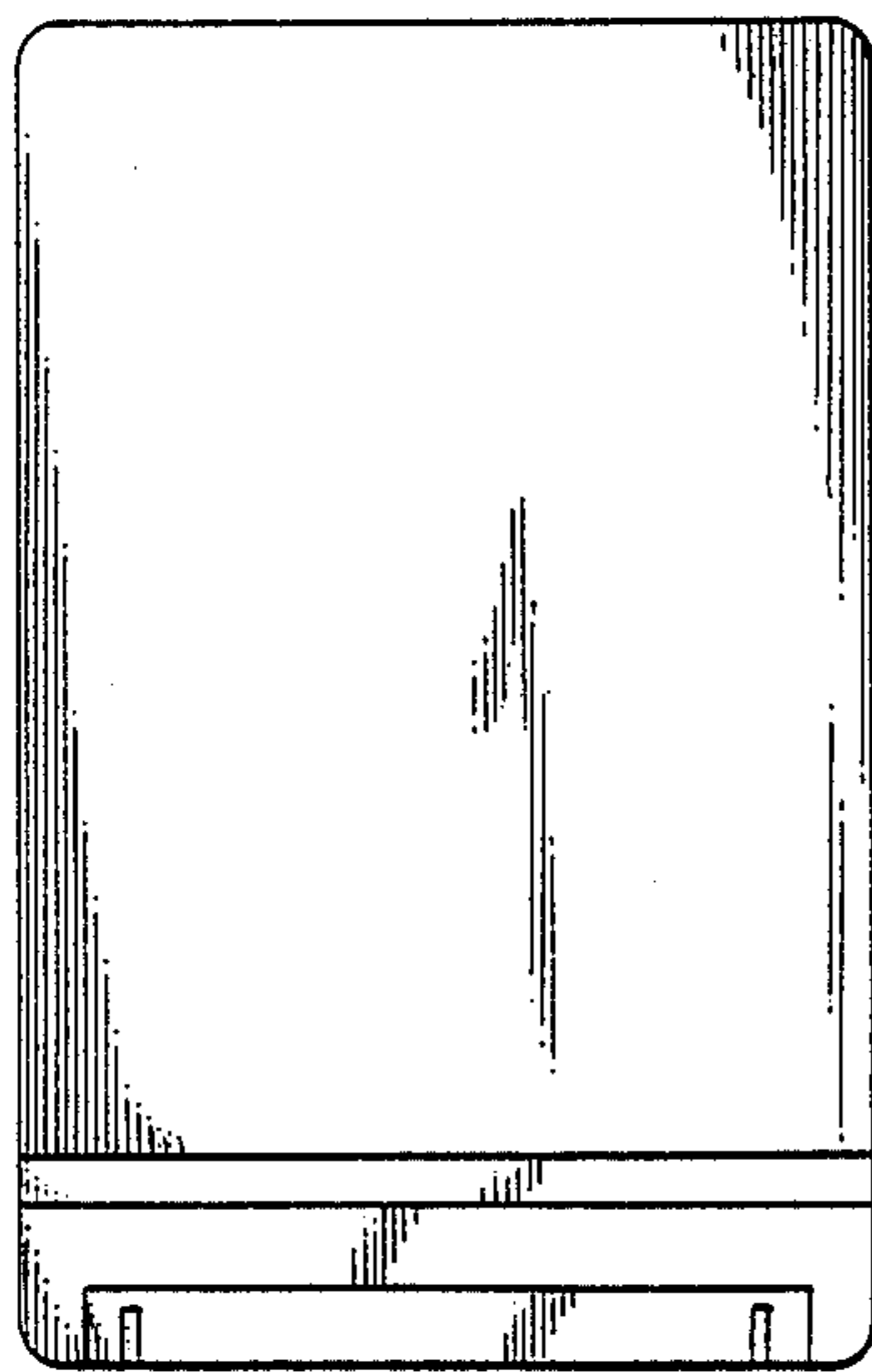

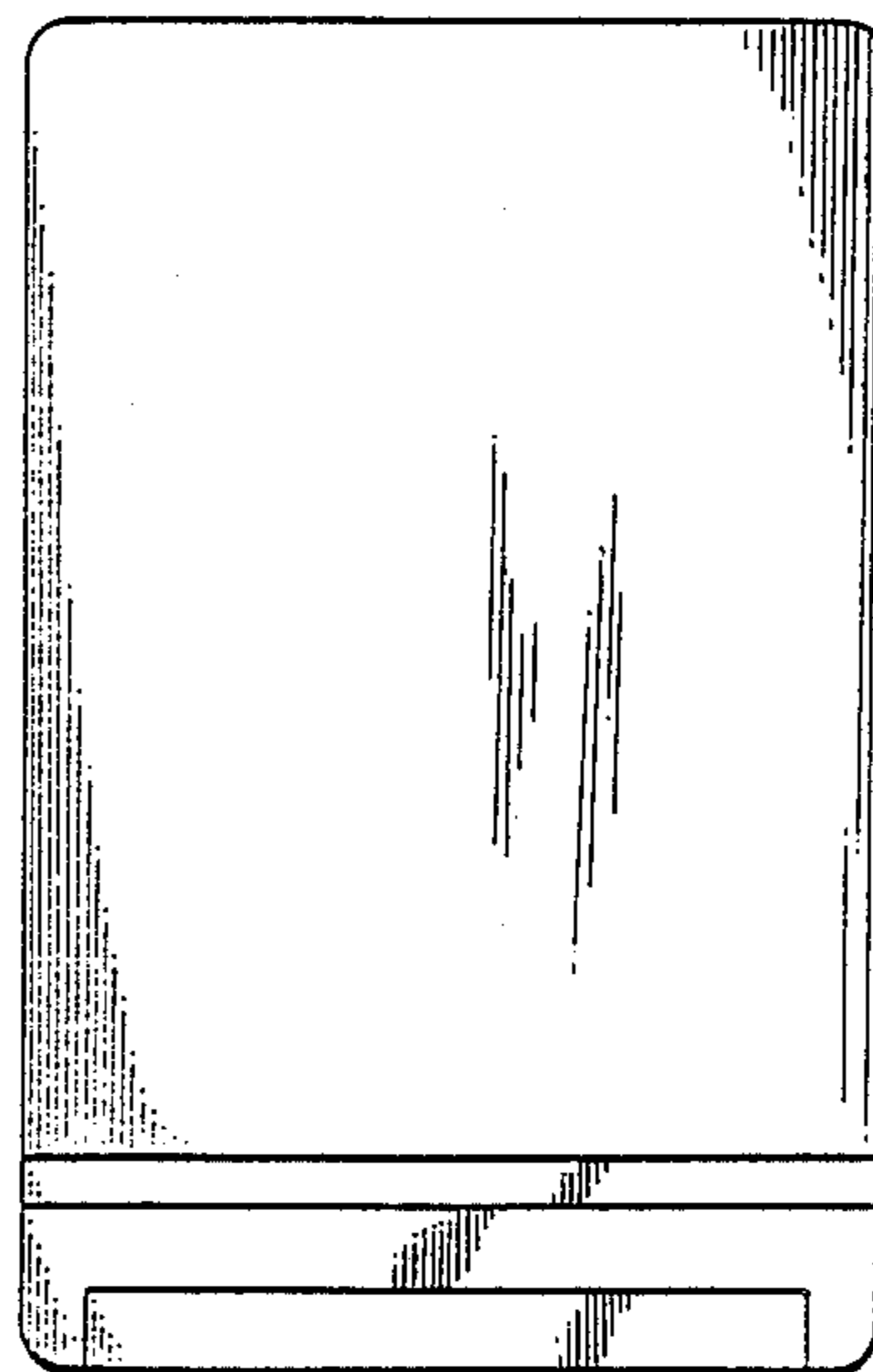
