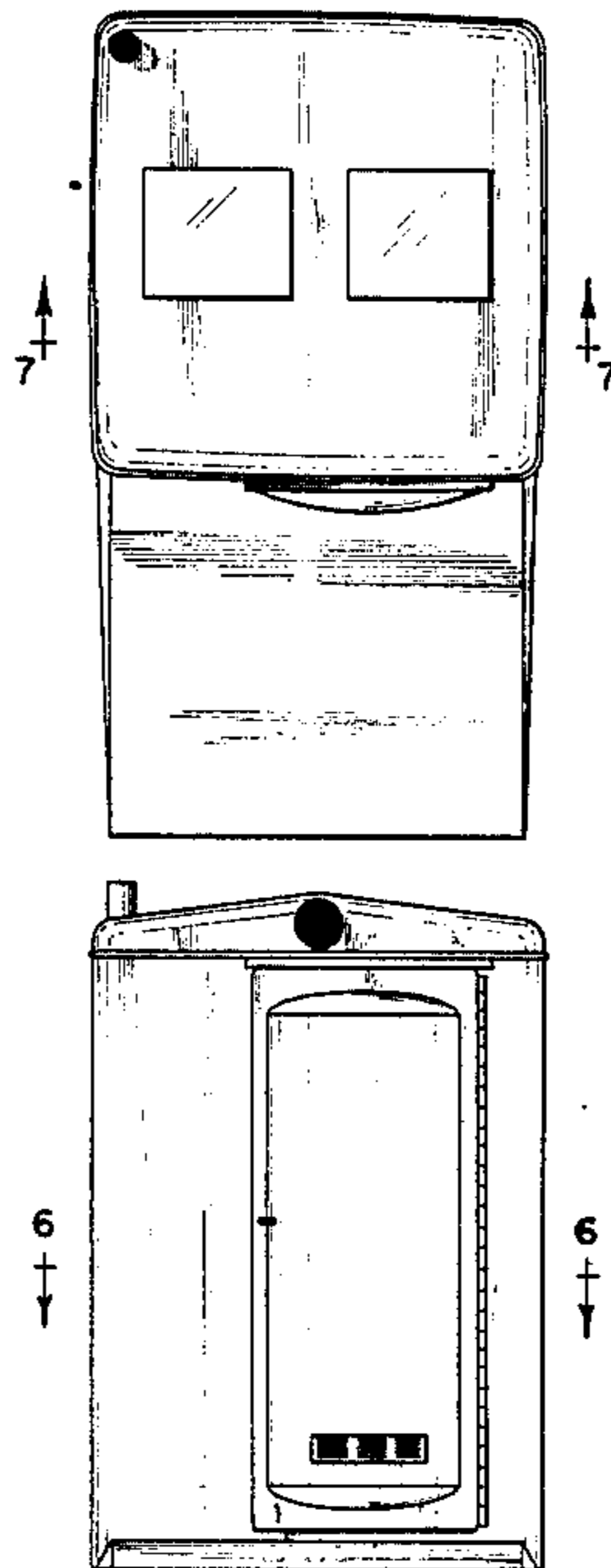

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a portable toilet for handicapped individuals showing my new design.
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.
 FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 2.



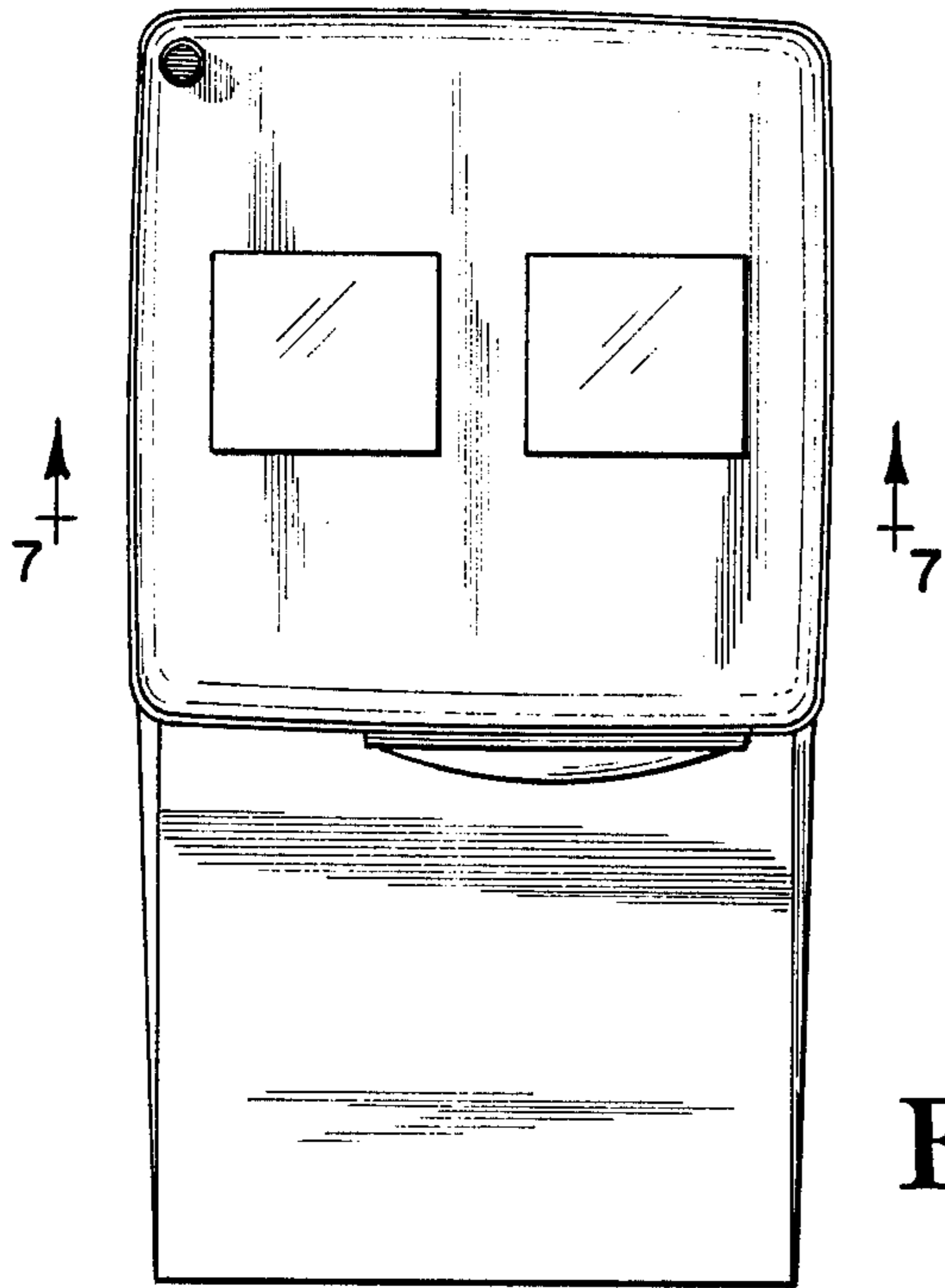

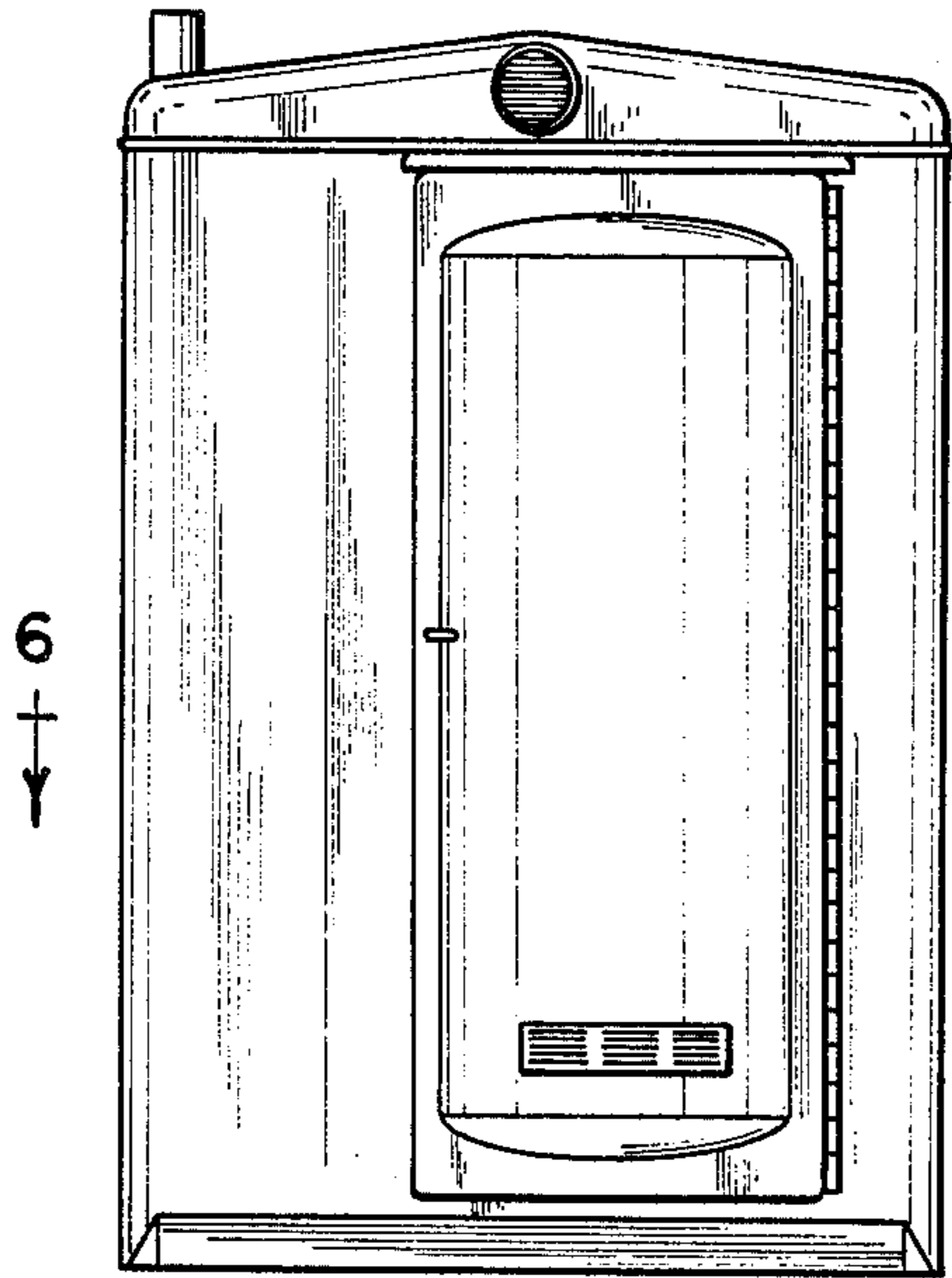

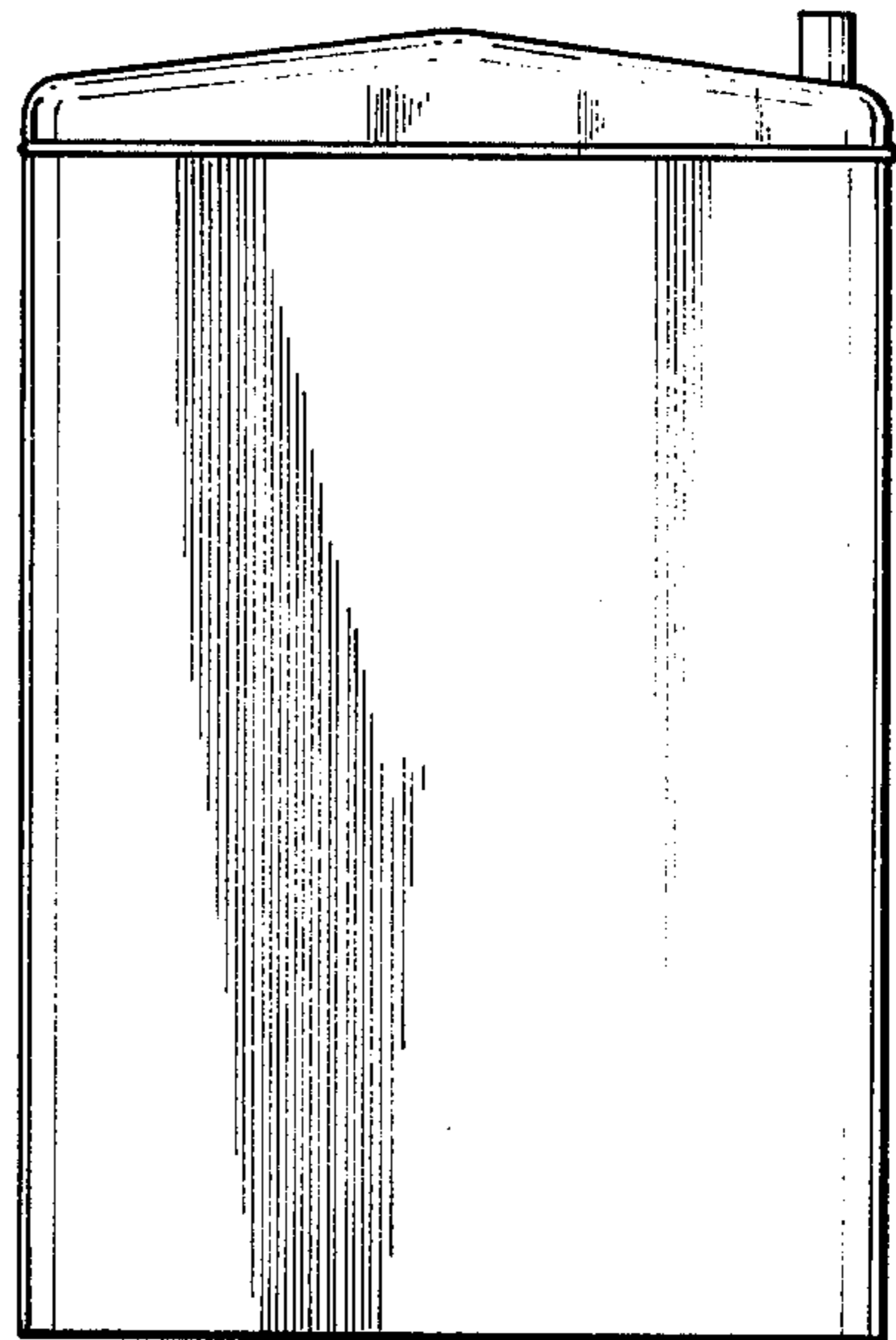

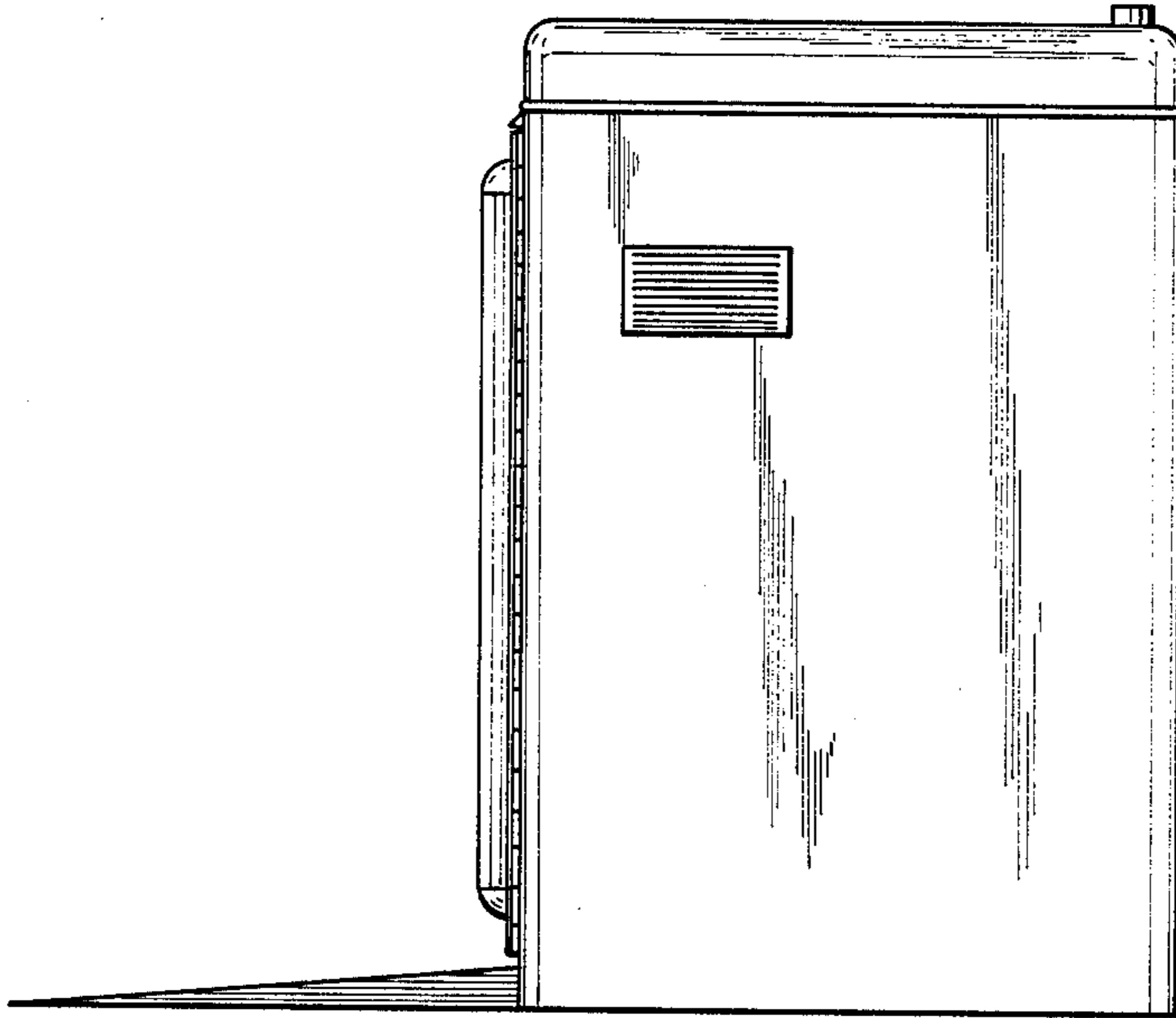

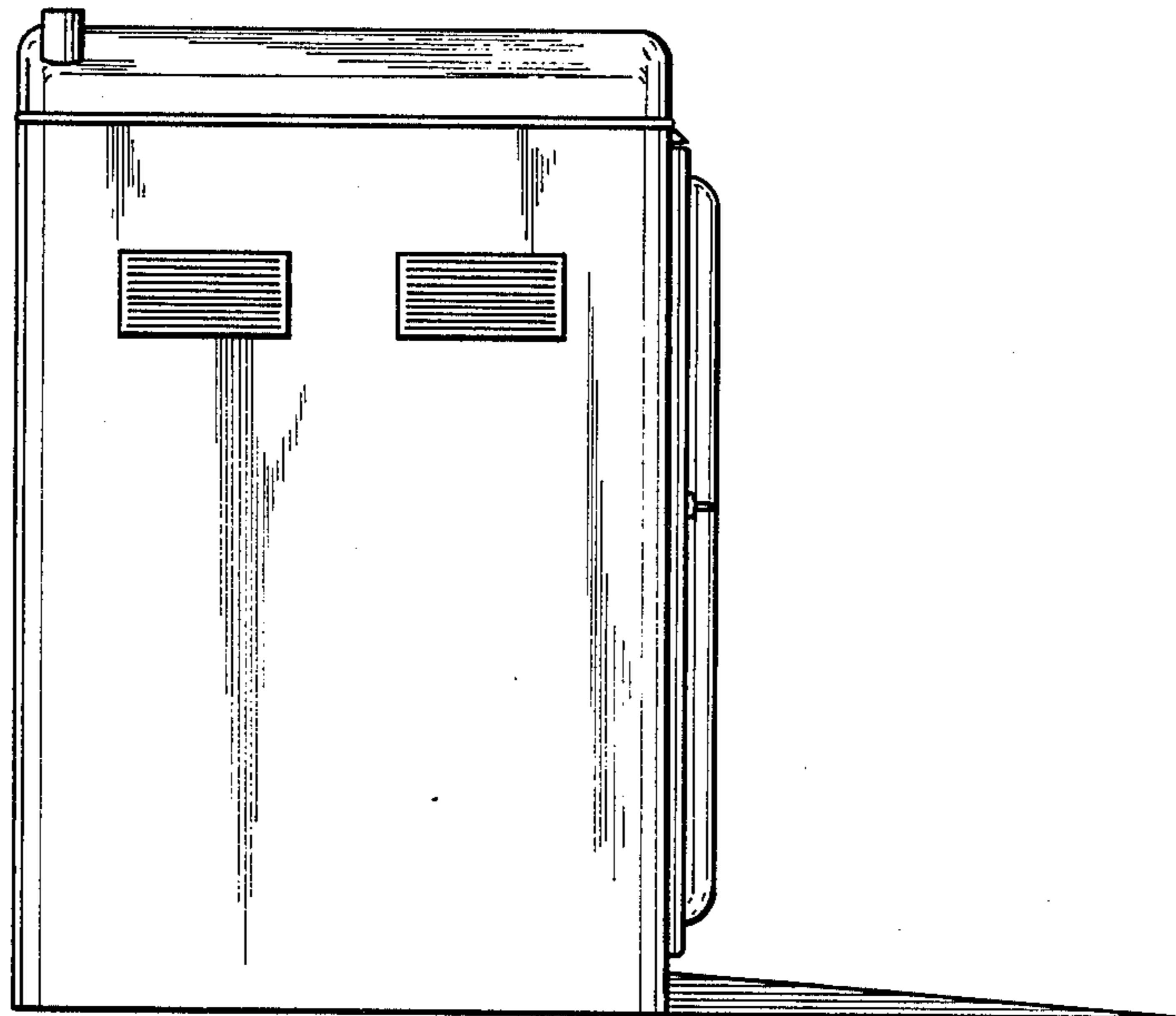

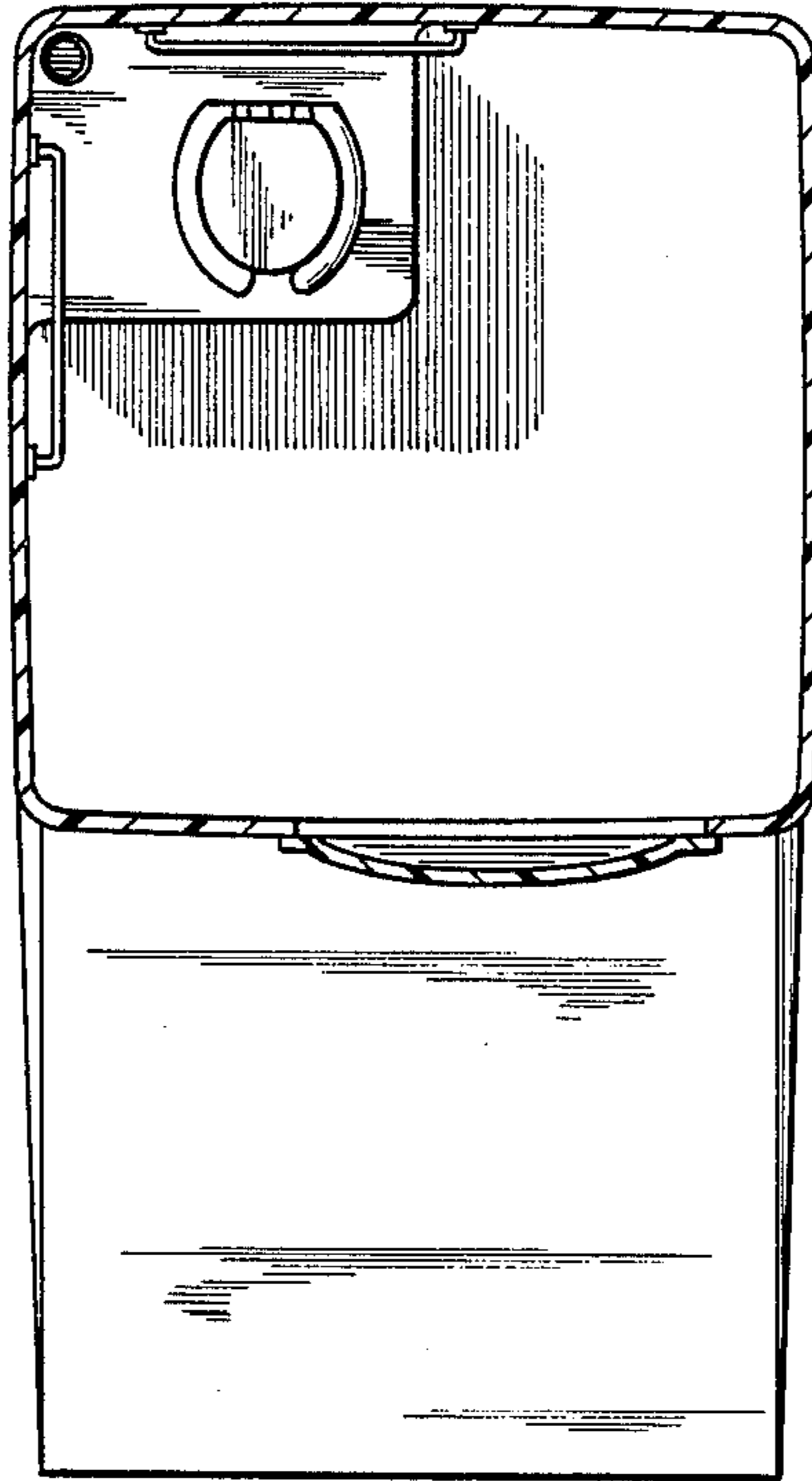

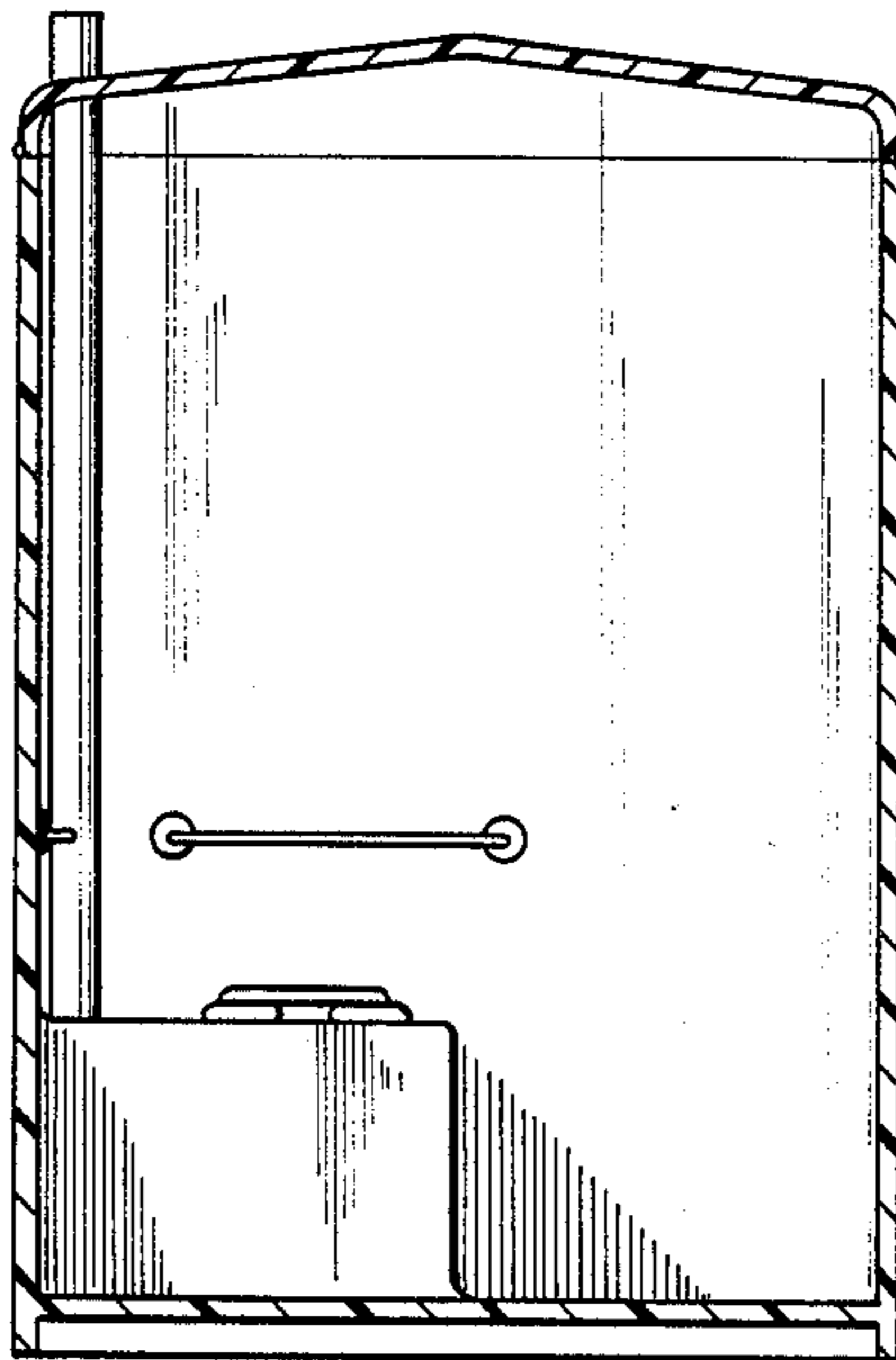
