FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

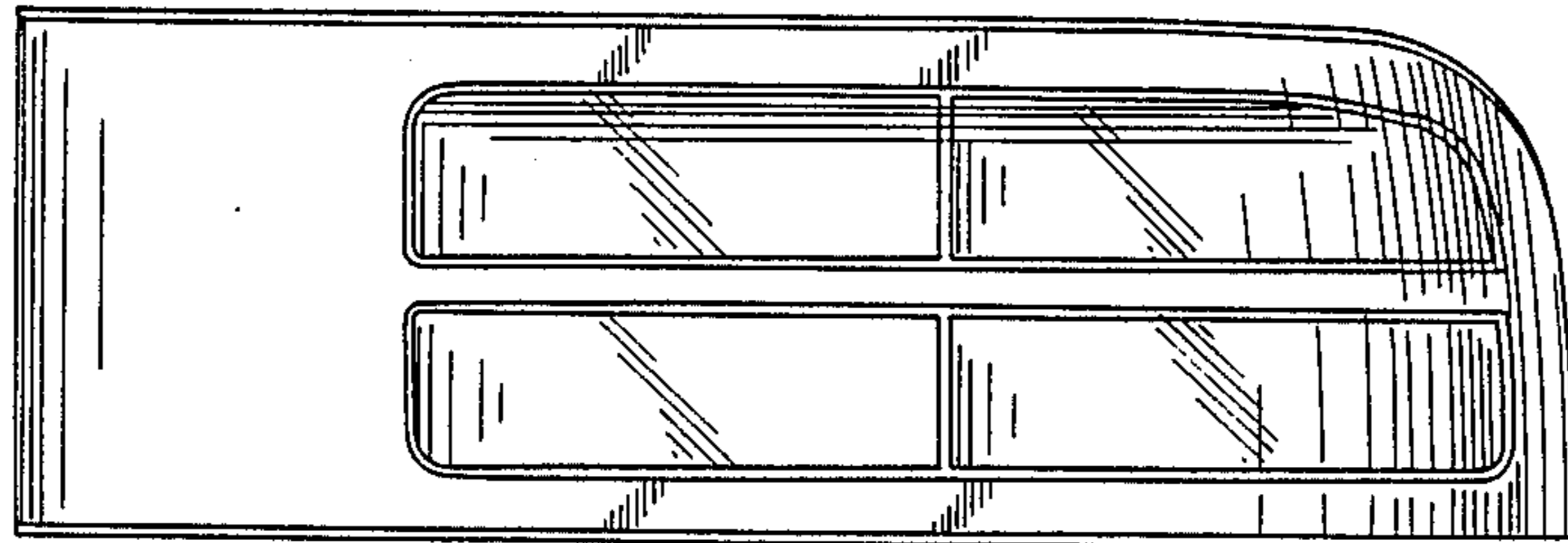
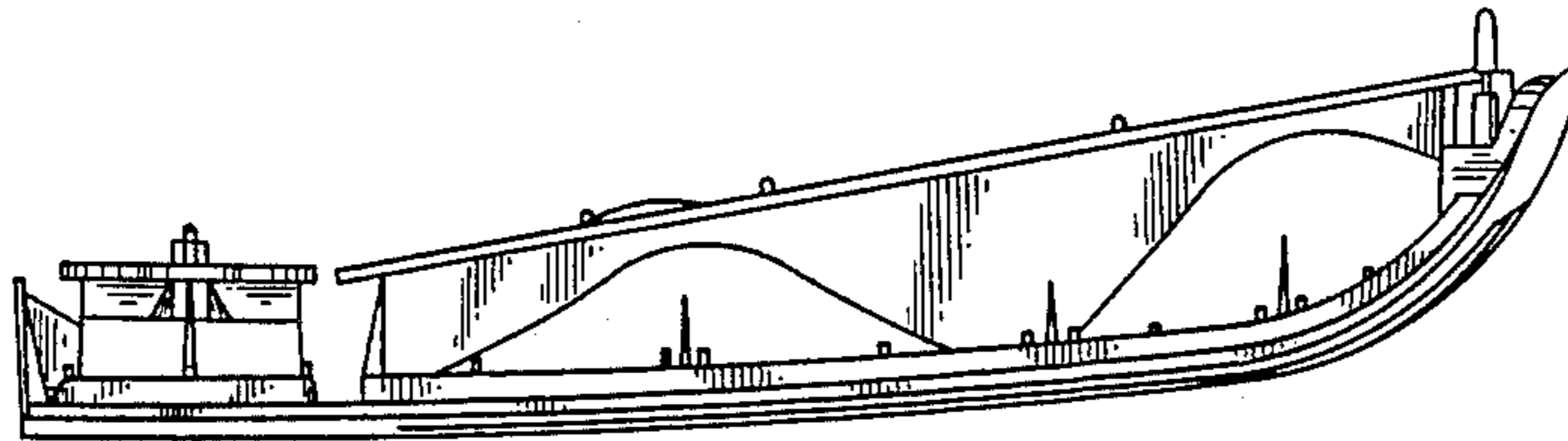

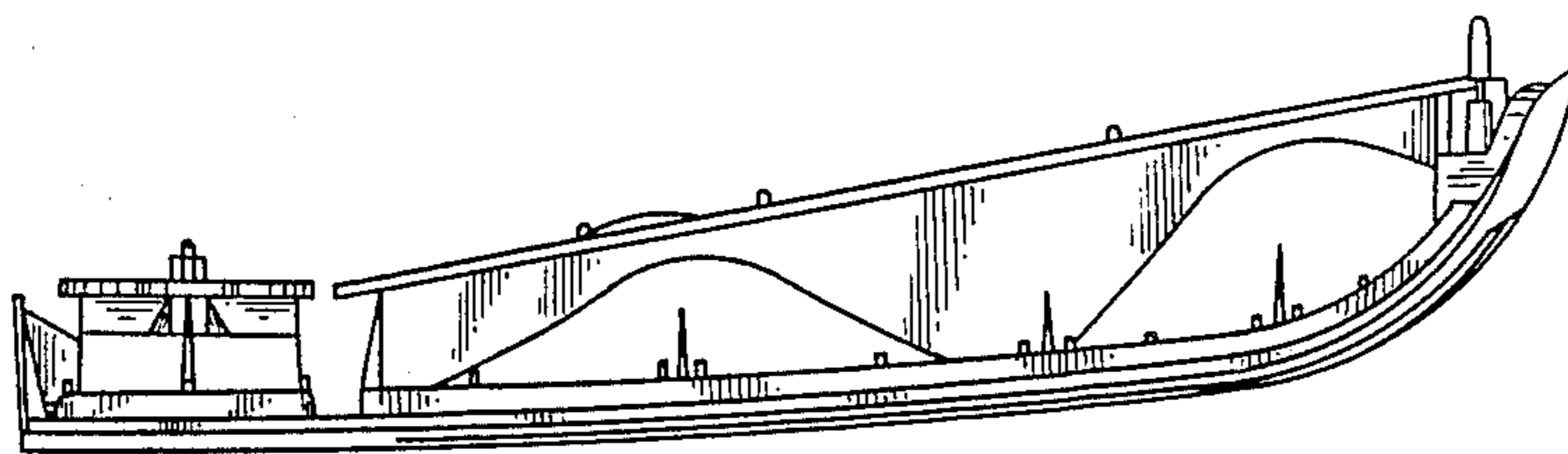

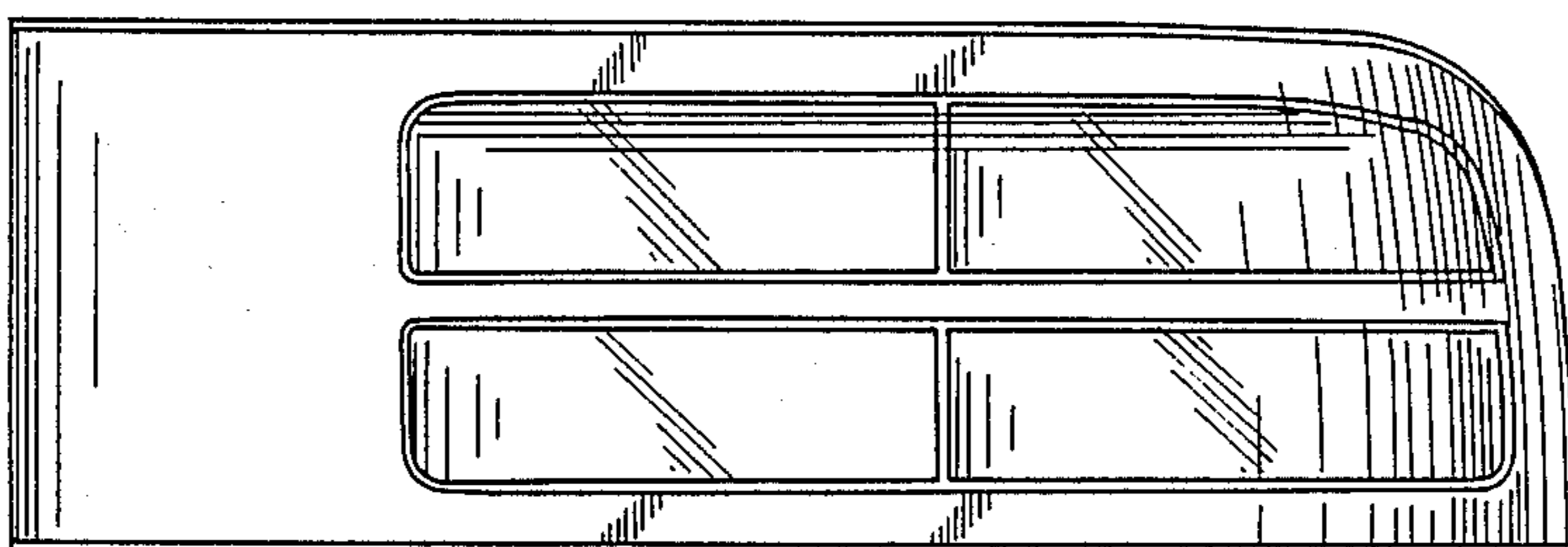

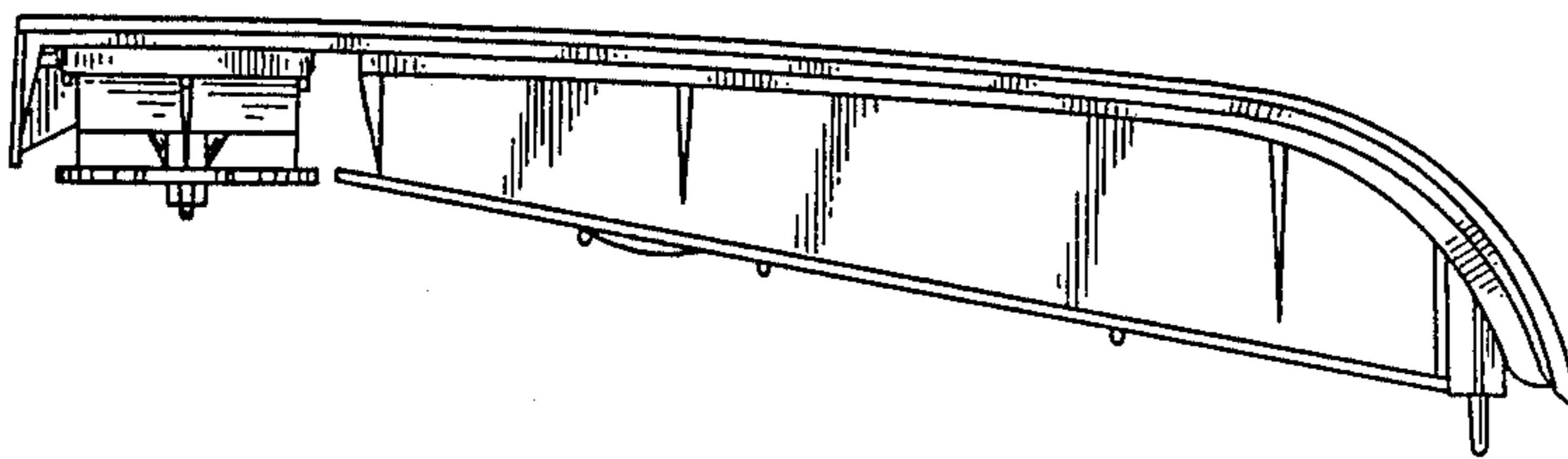

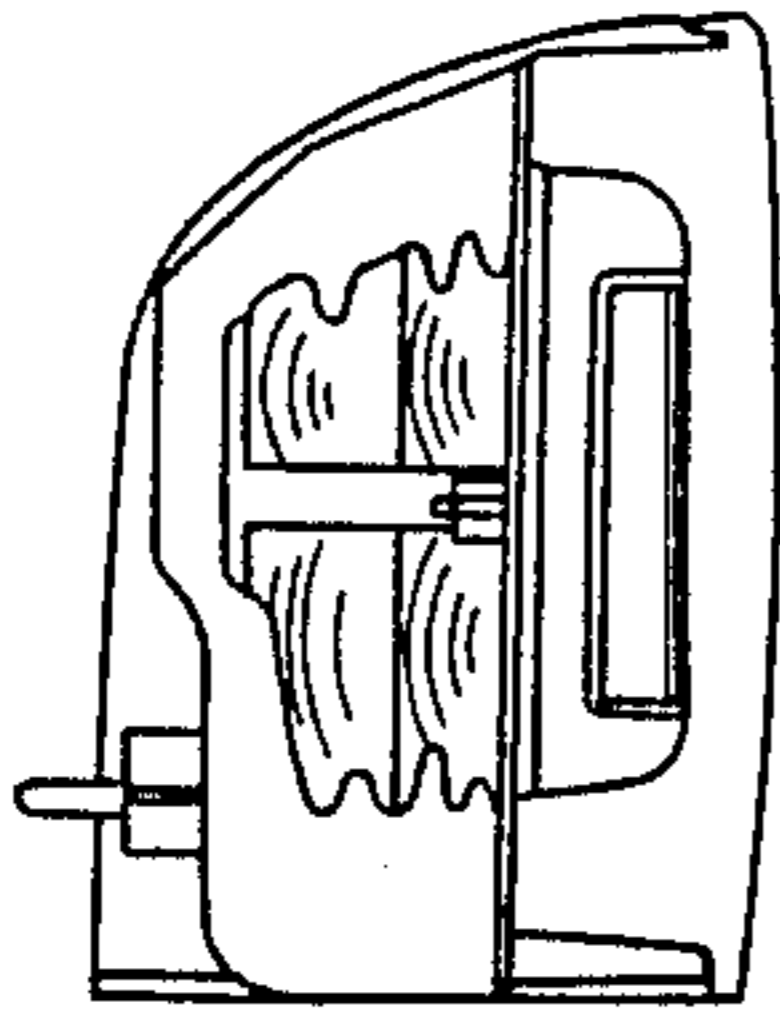

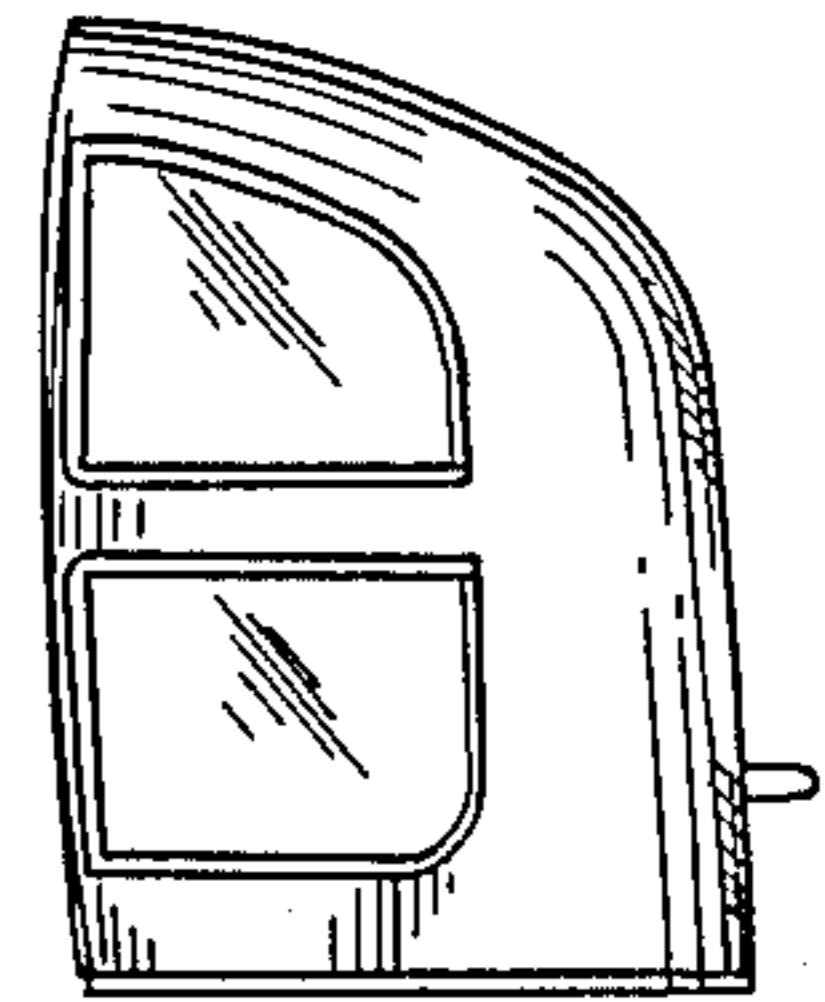

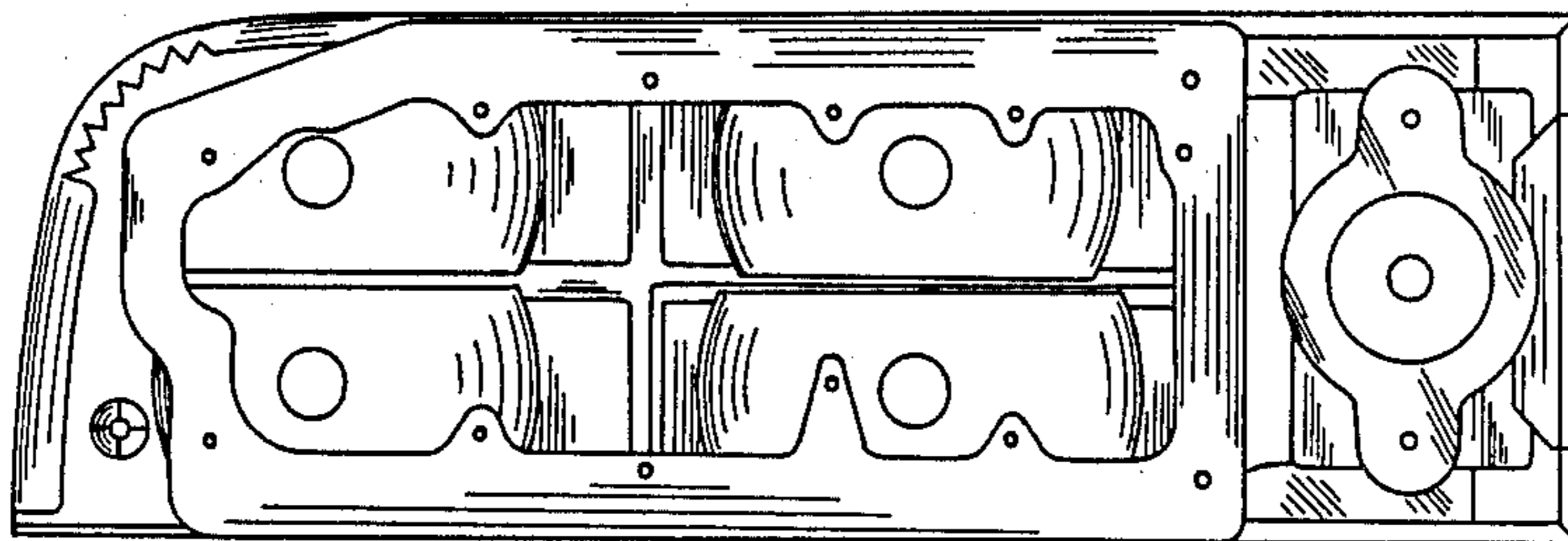
