The ornamental design for an electric lint remover for cutting fabric pills, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electric lint remover for cutting fabric pills, showing my new design and shown without the cap;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof shown with the cap;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof with the cap.

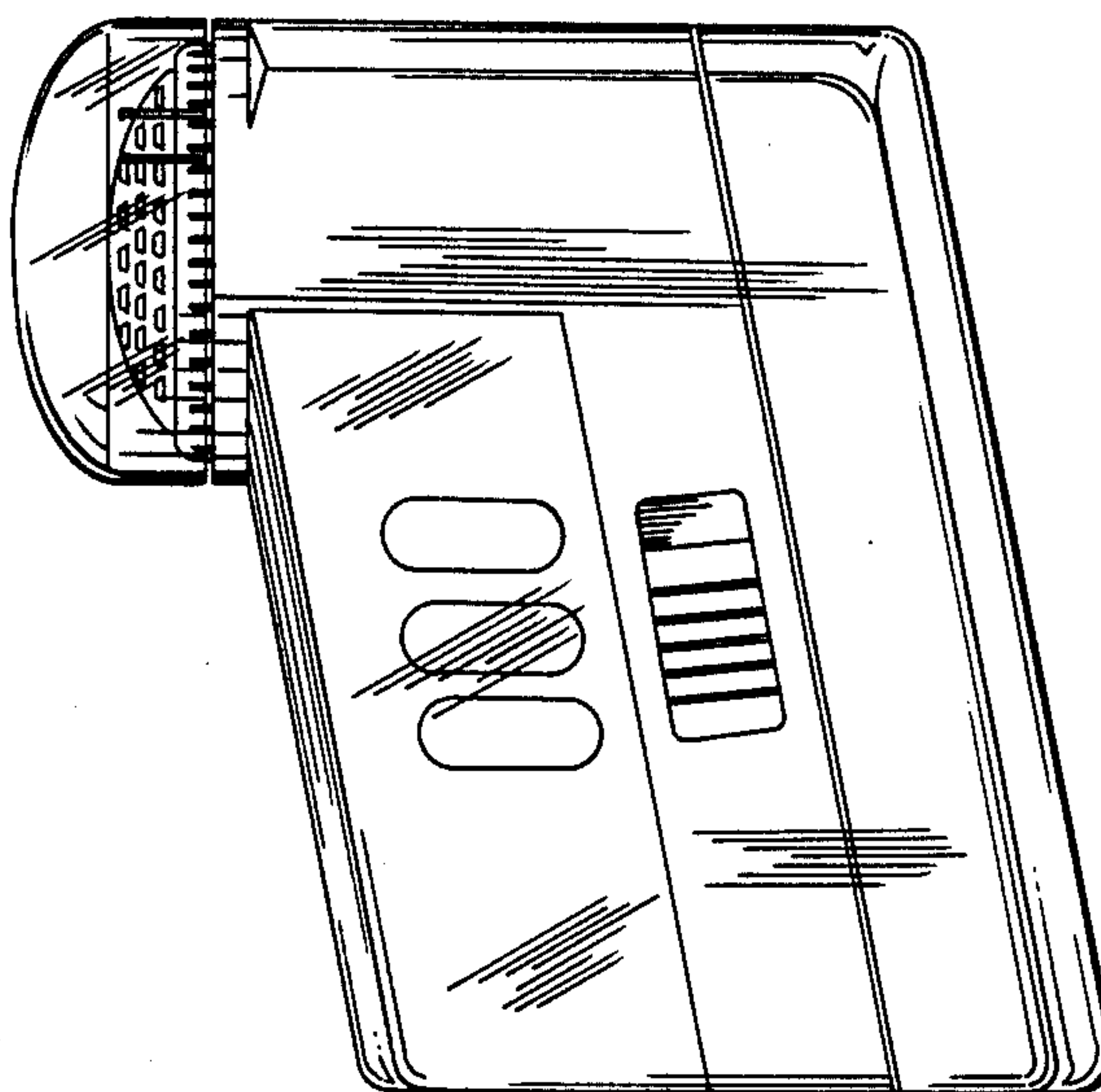

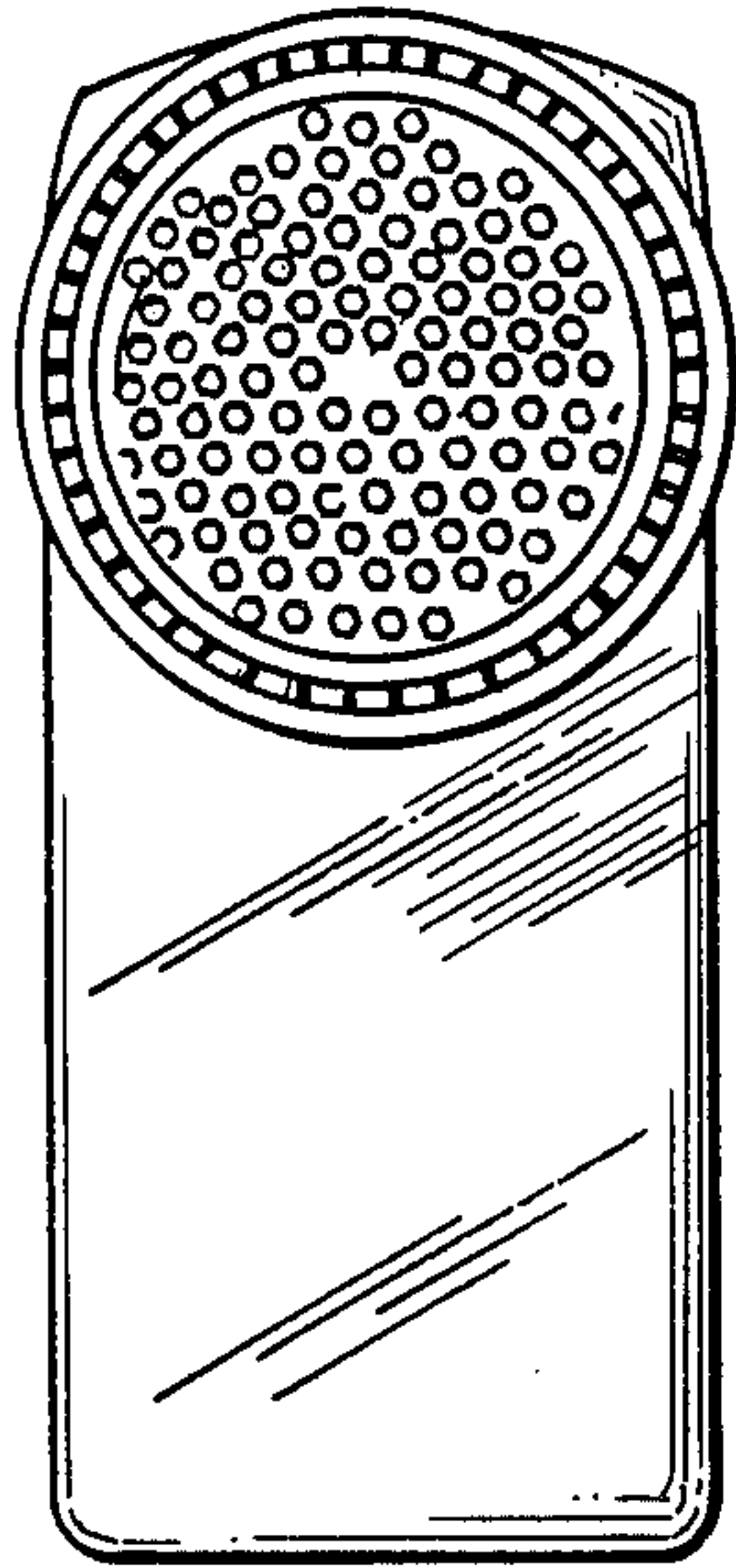

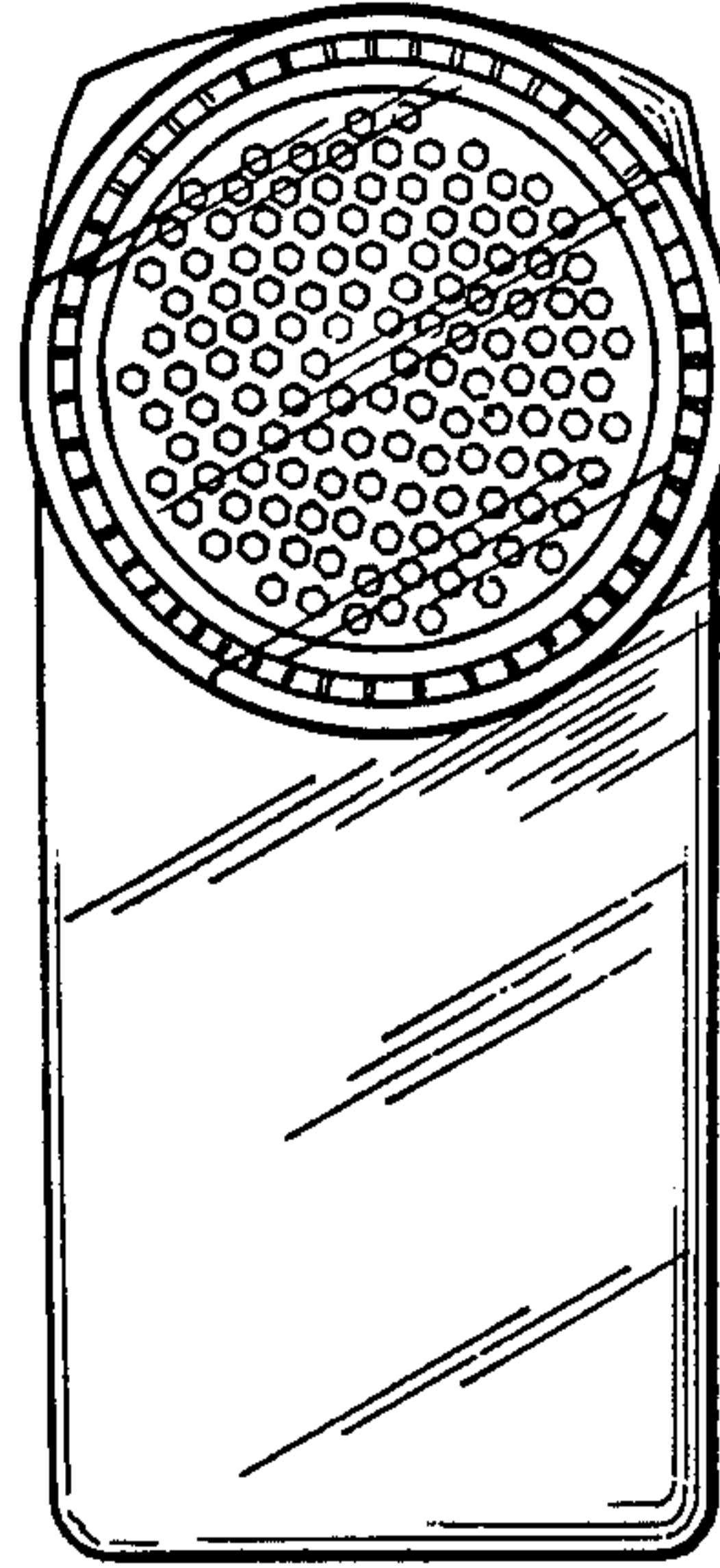

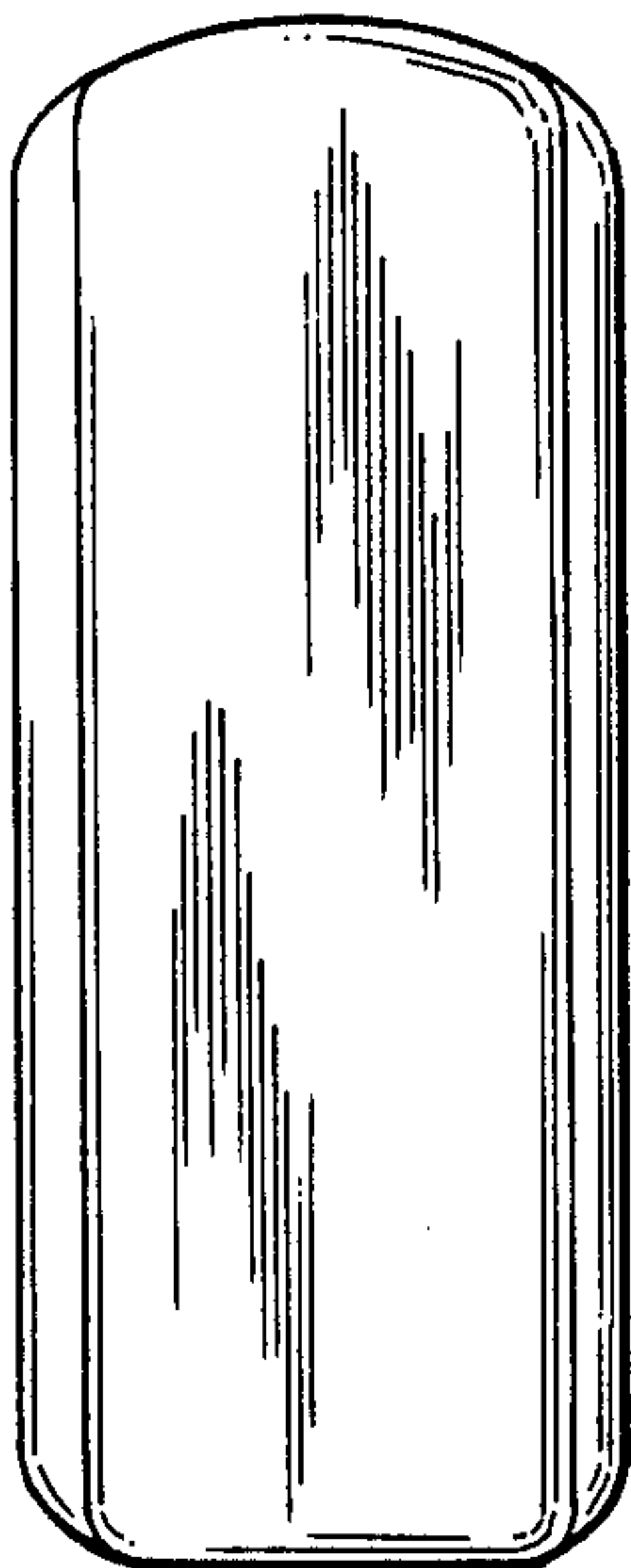
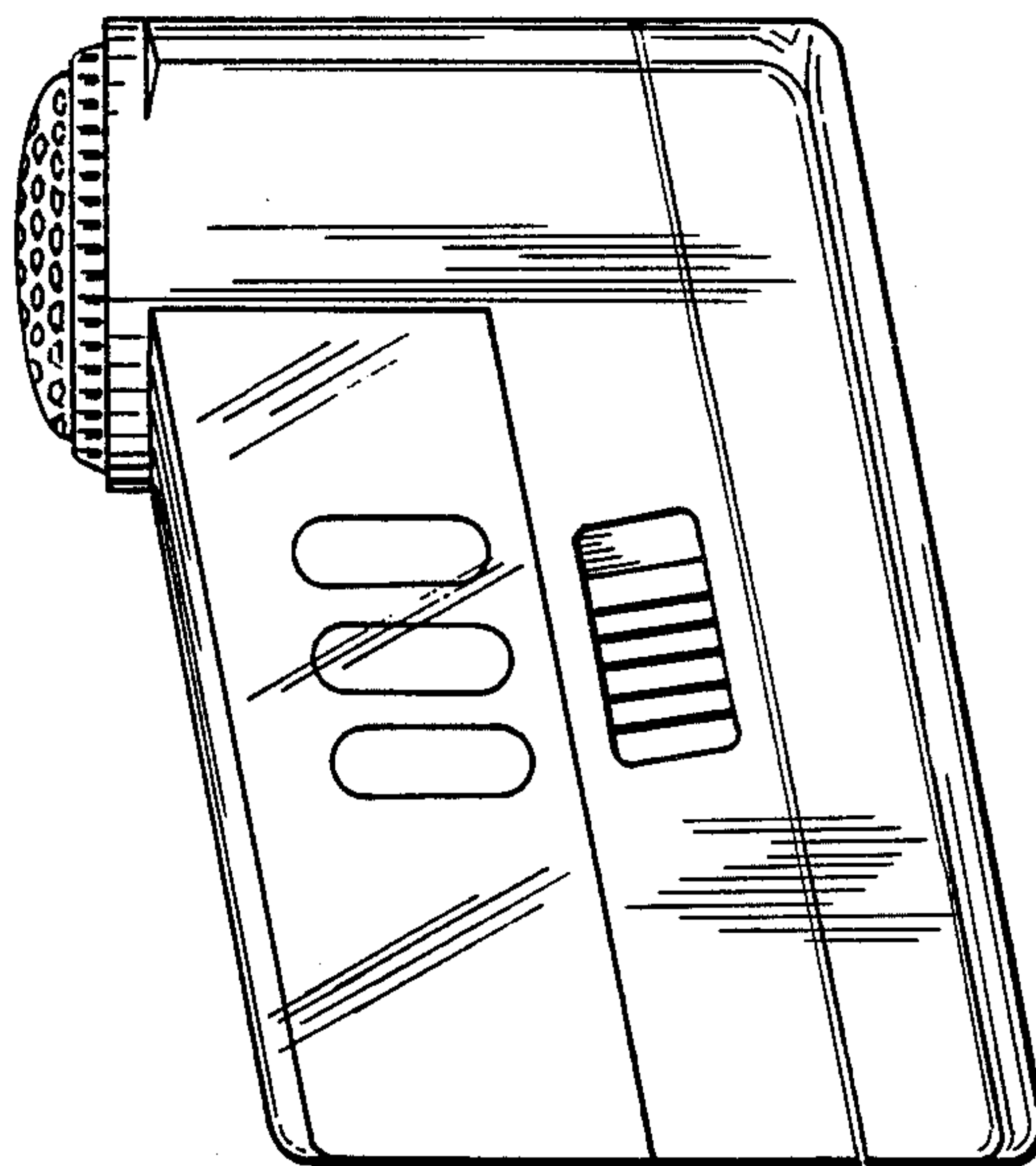

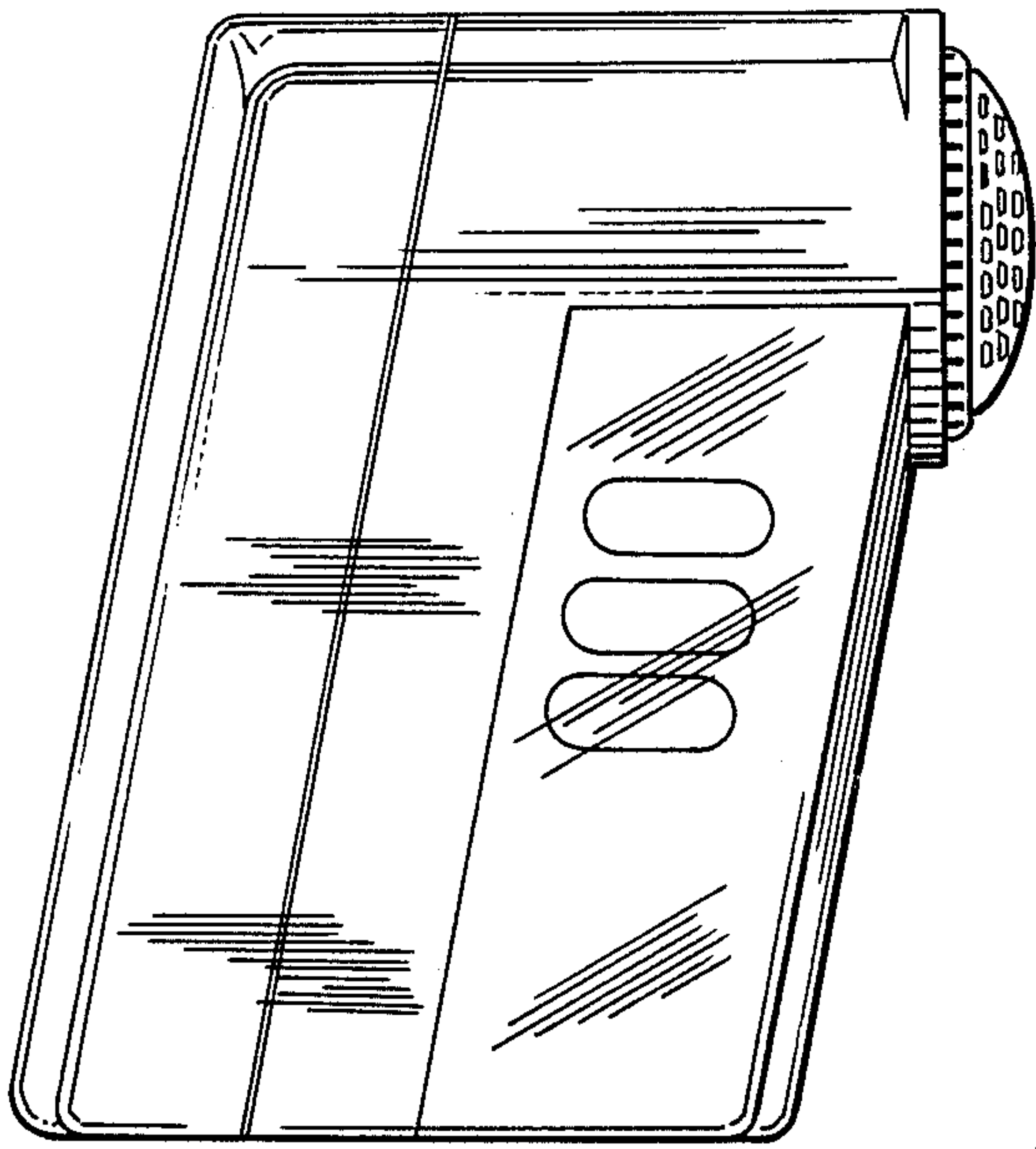

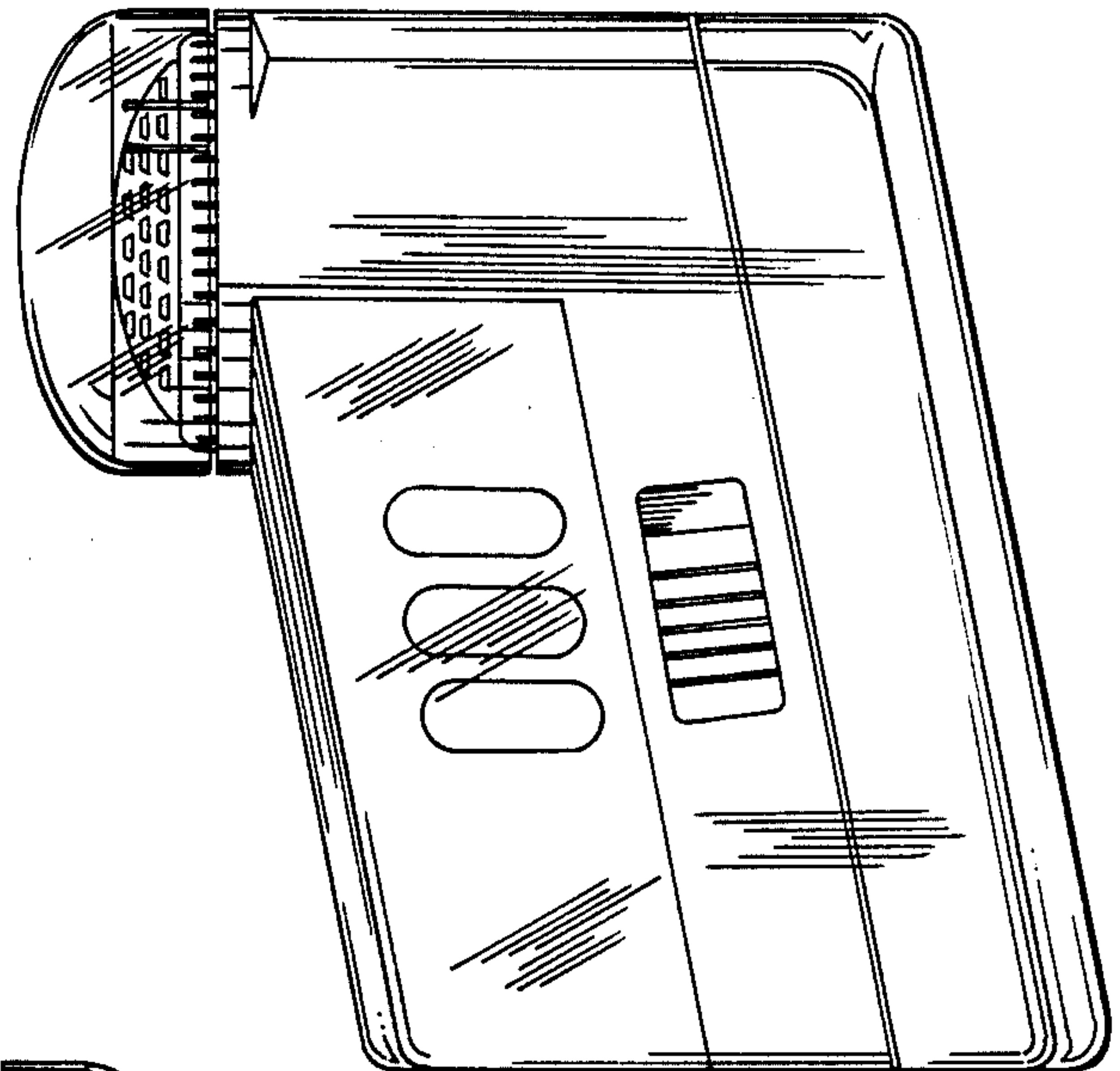

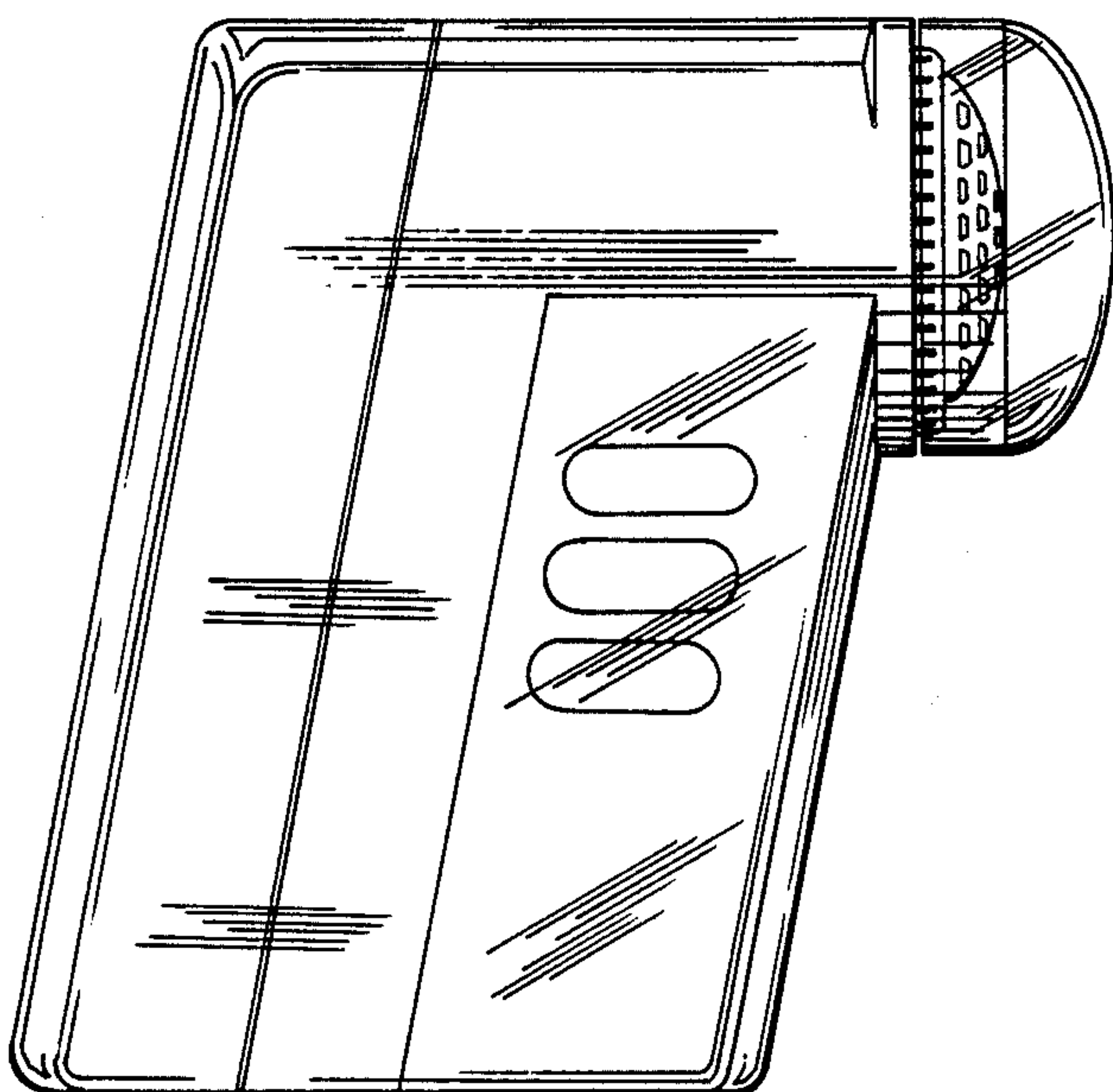

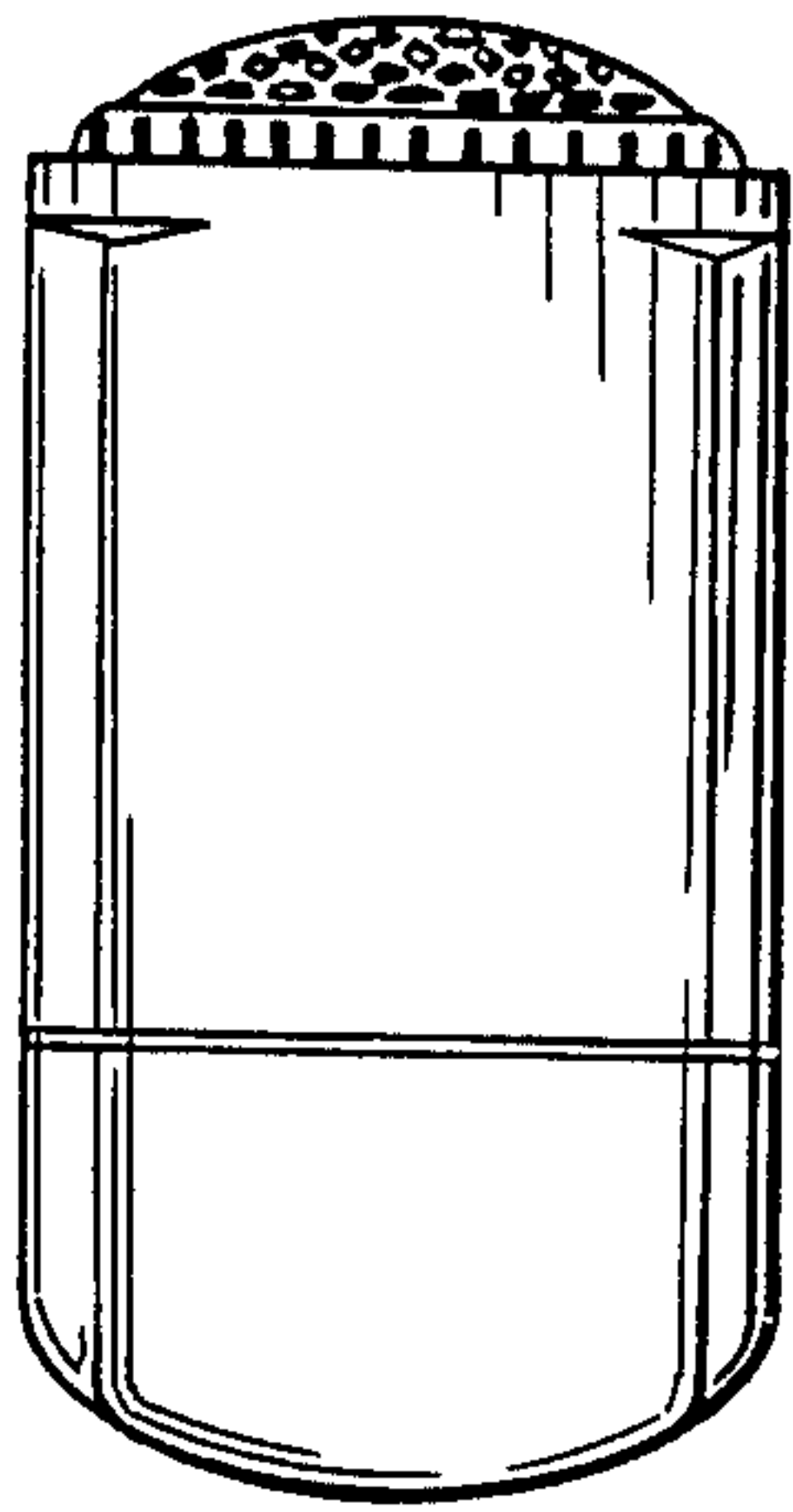

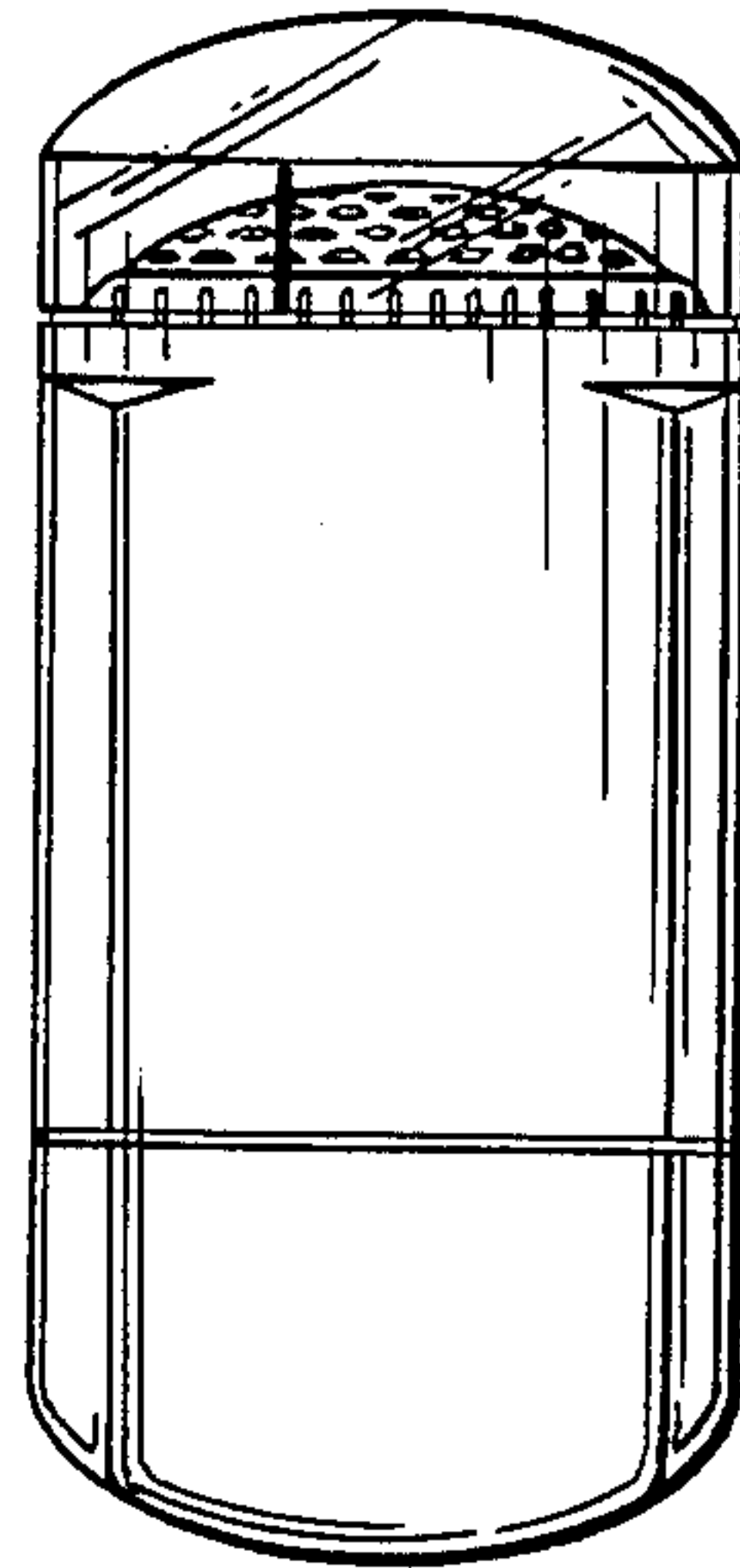

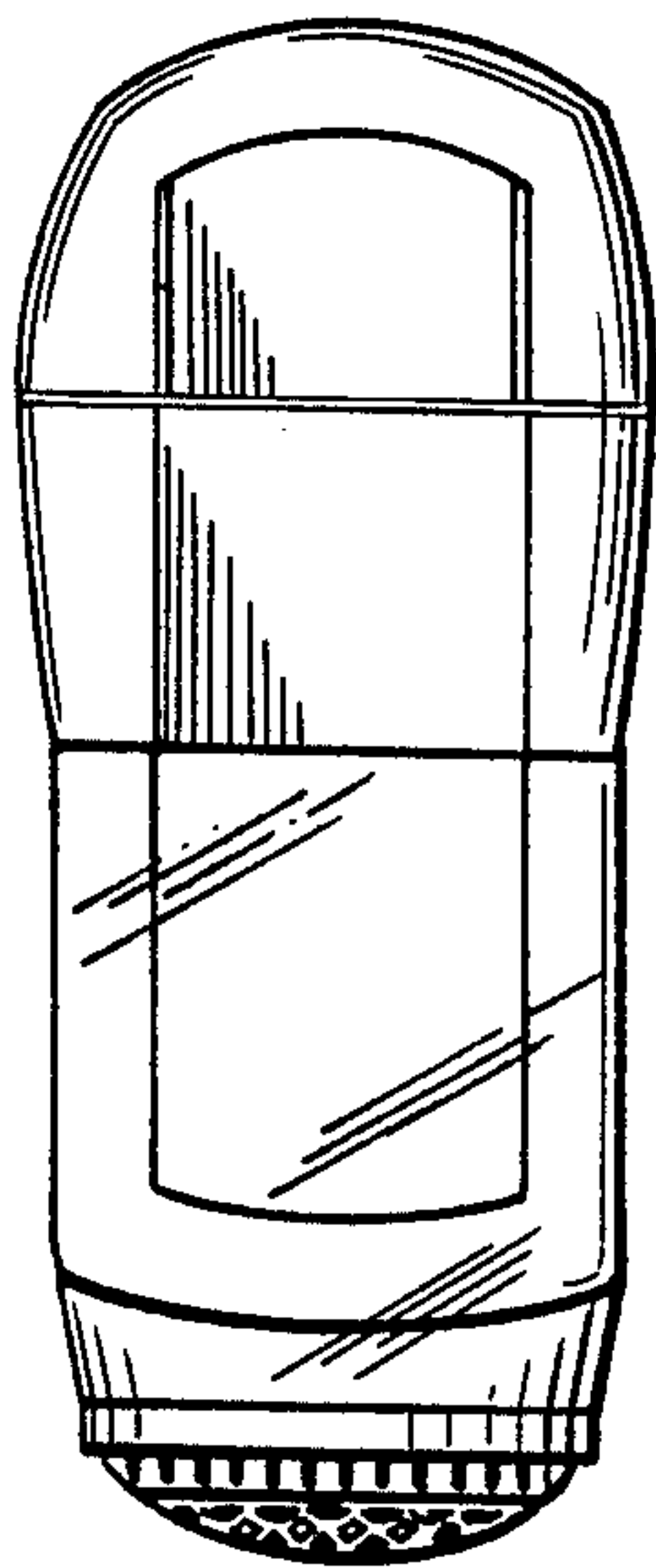

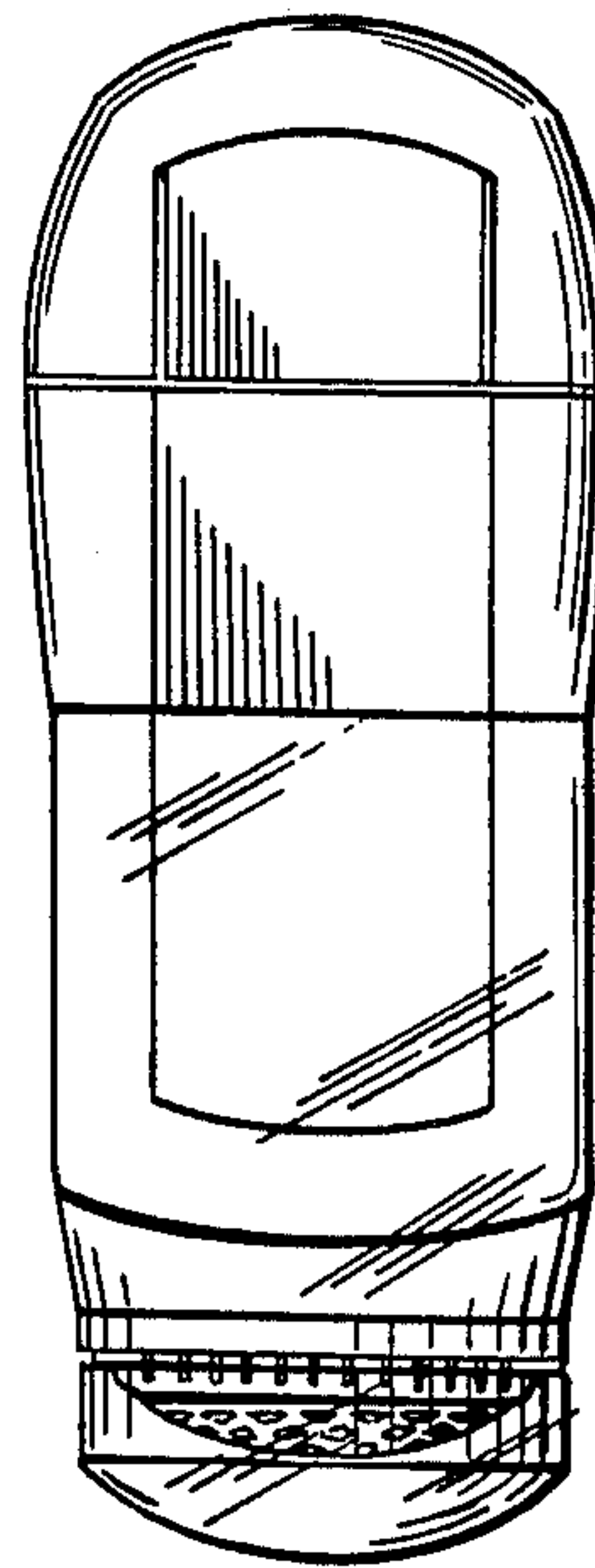
