[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an animal feces scoop, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an animal feces scoop showing our new design, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof. The broken line representation of a disposable bag in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.

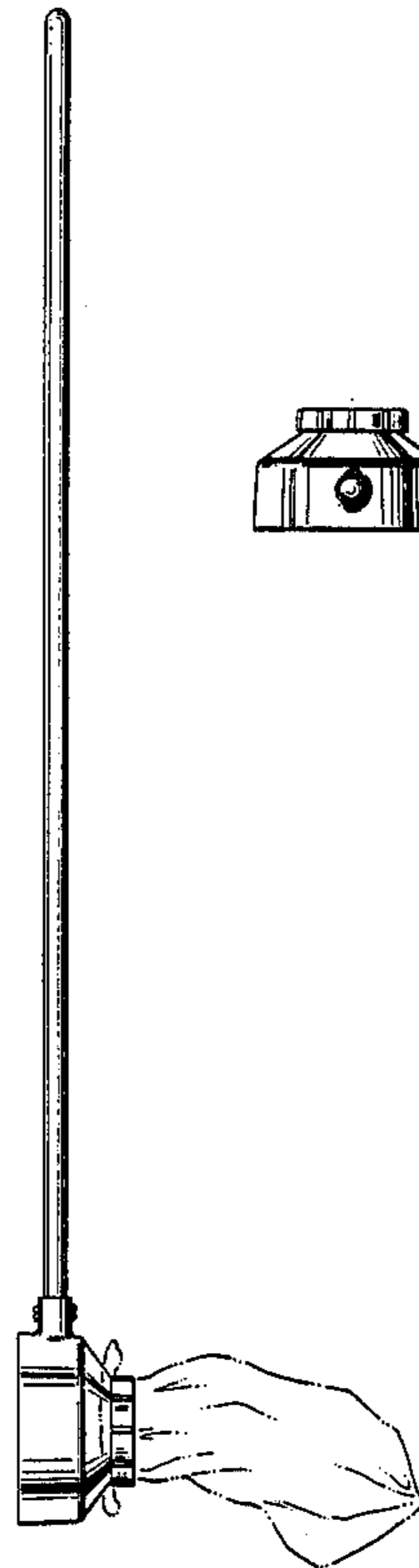

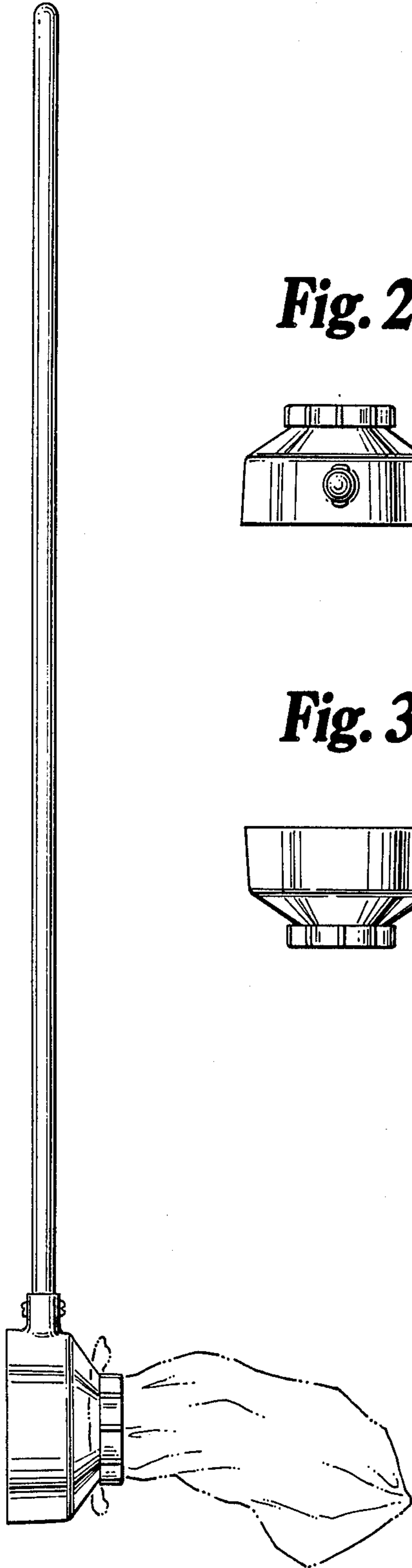

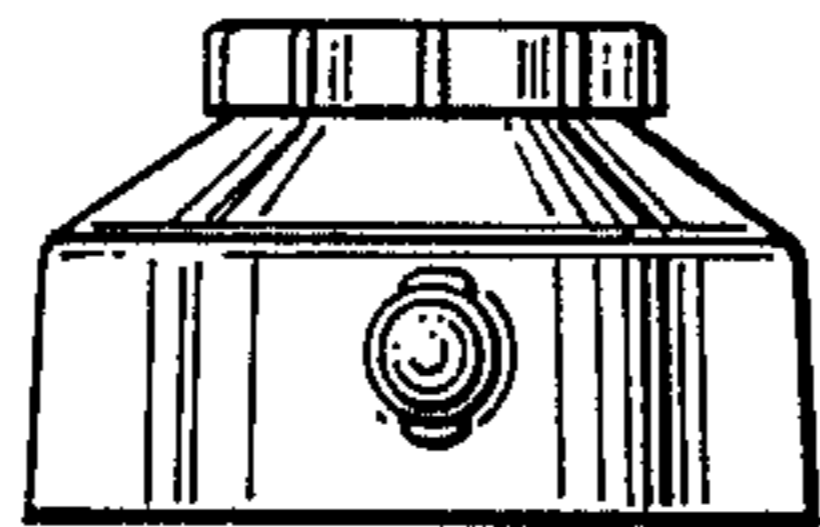

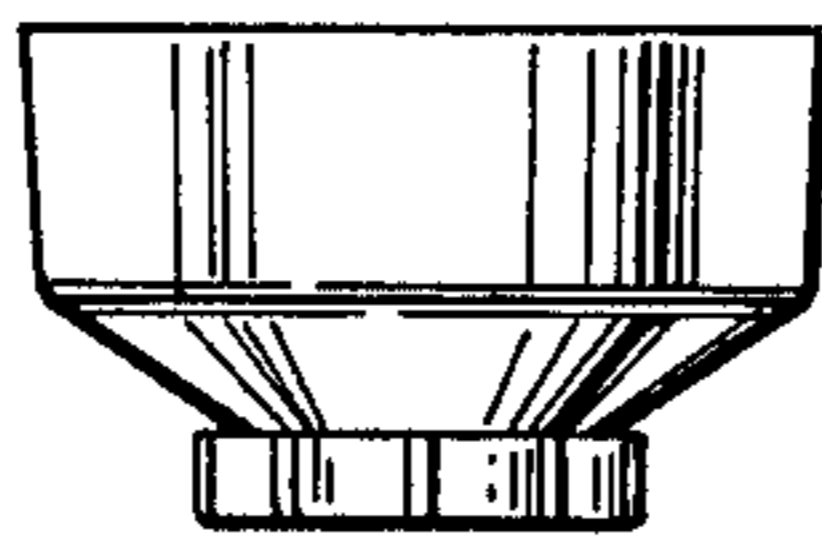

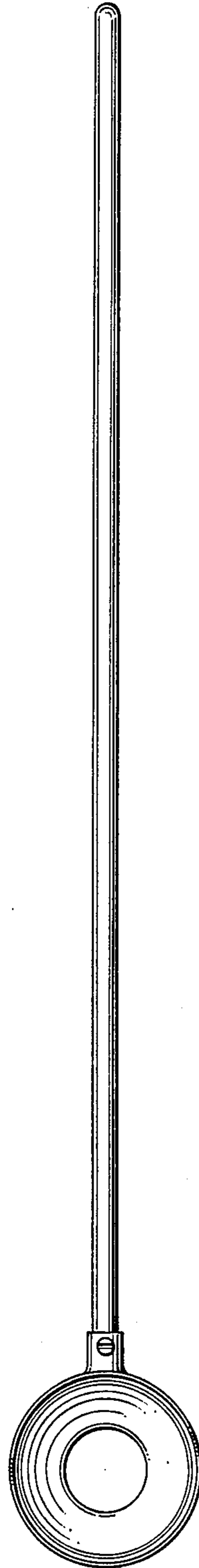
