**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a welder's coveralls showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a left side perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side perspective view thereof; and  
 FIG. 5 is a partial cross-sectional view of the interior thereof, taken along the plane of line 5—5 in FIG. 4.

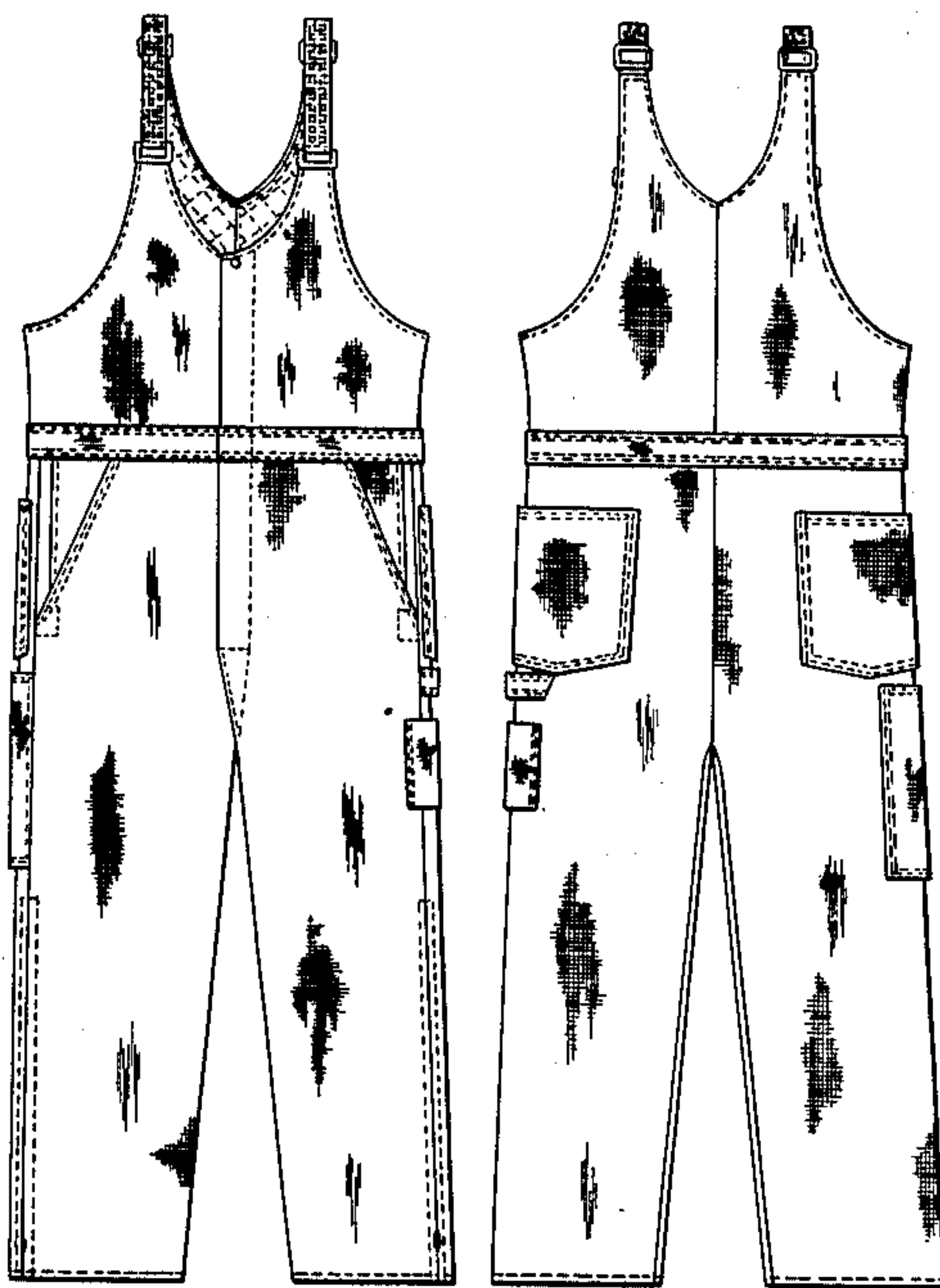

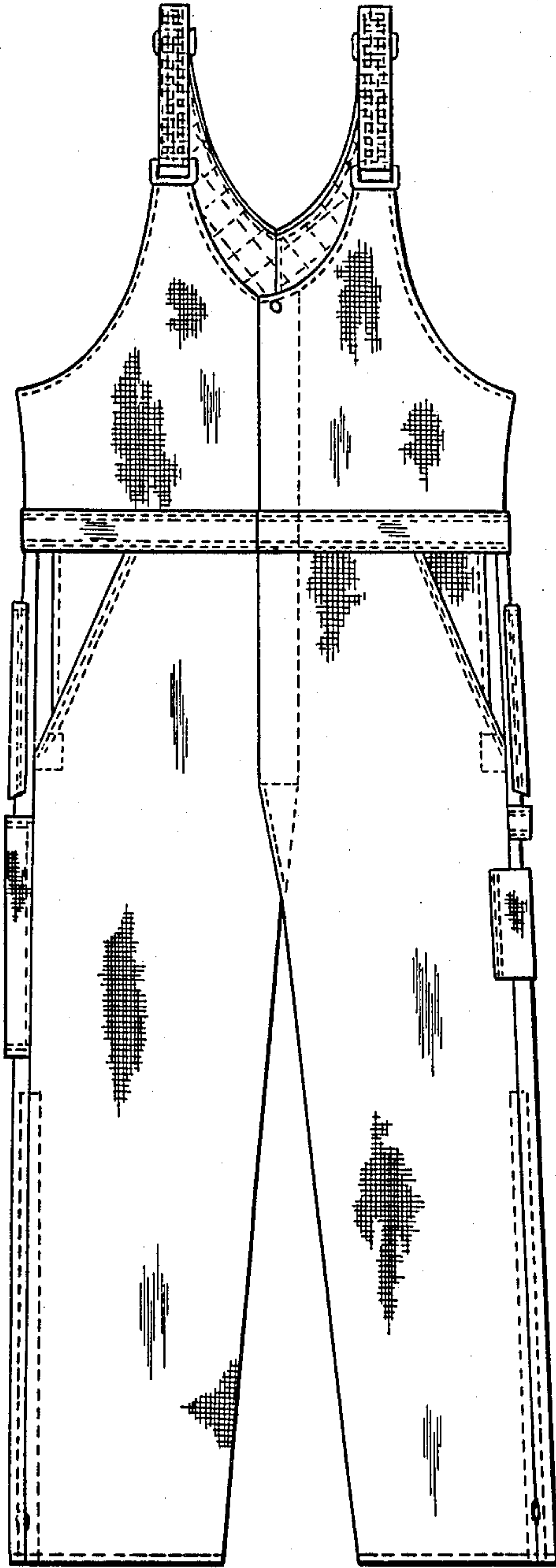
