 The left side elevation is identical to FIG. 1.

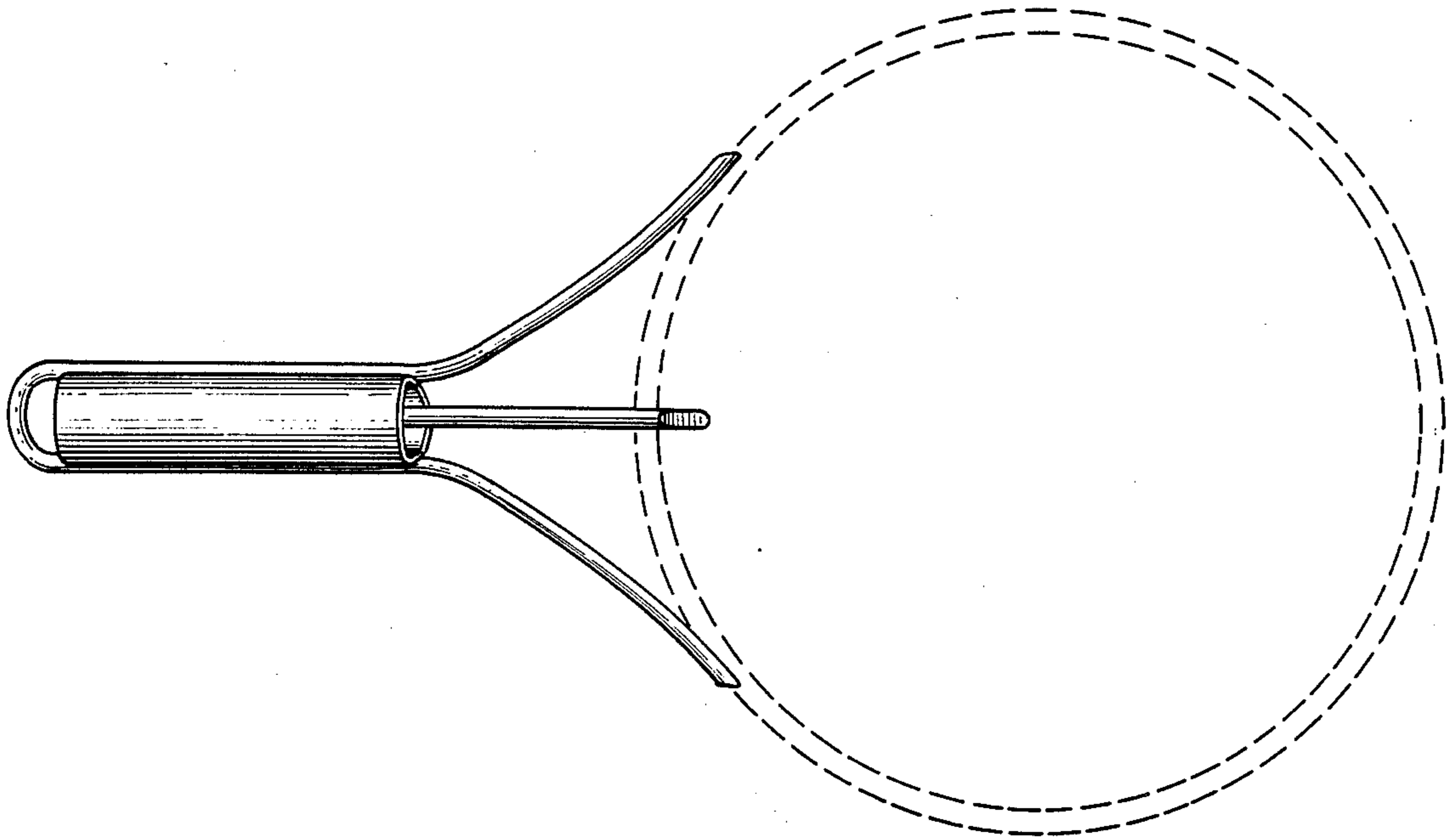

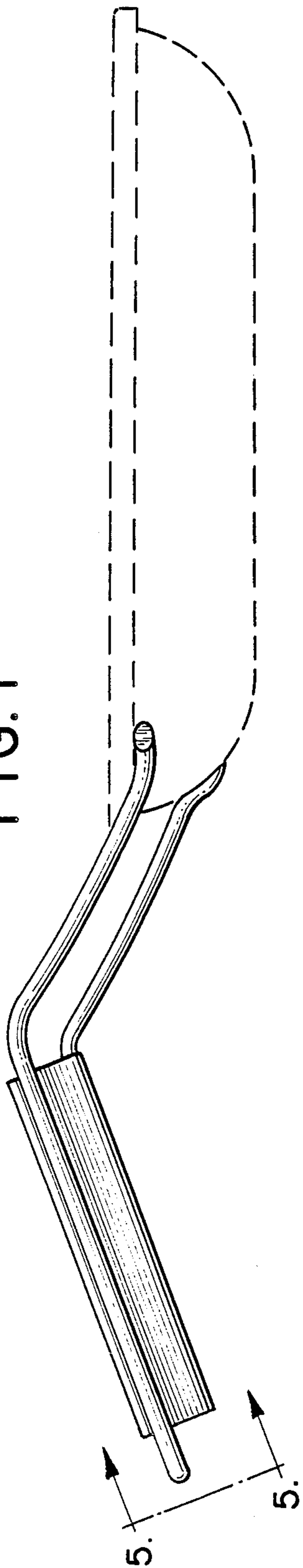

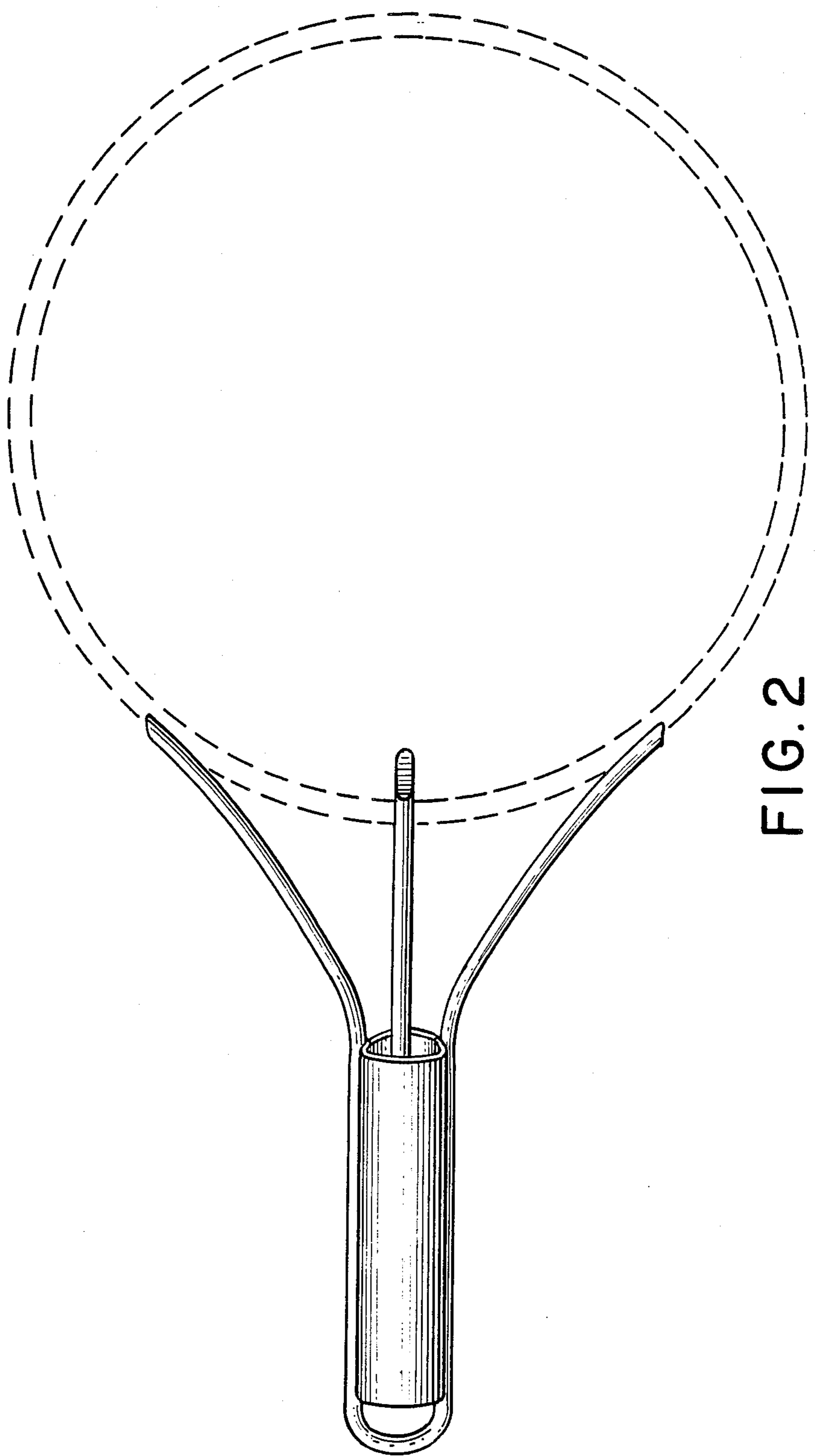

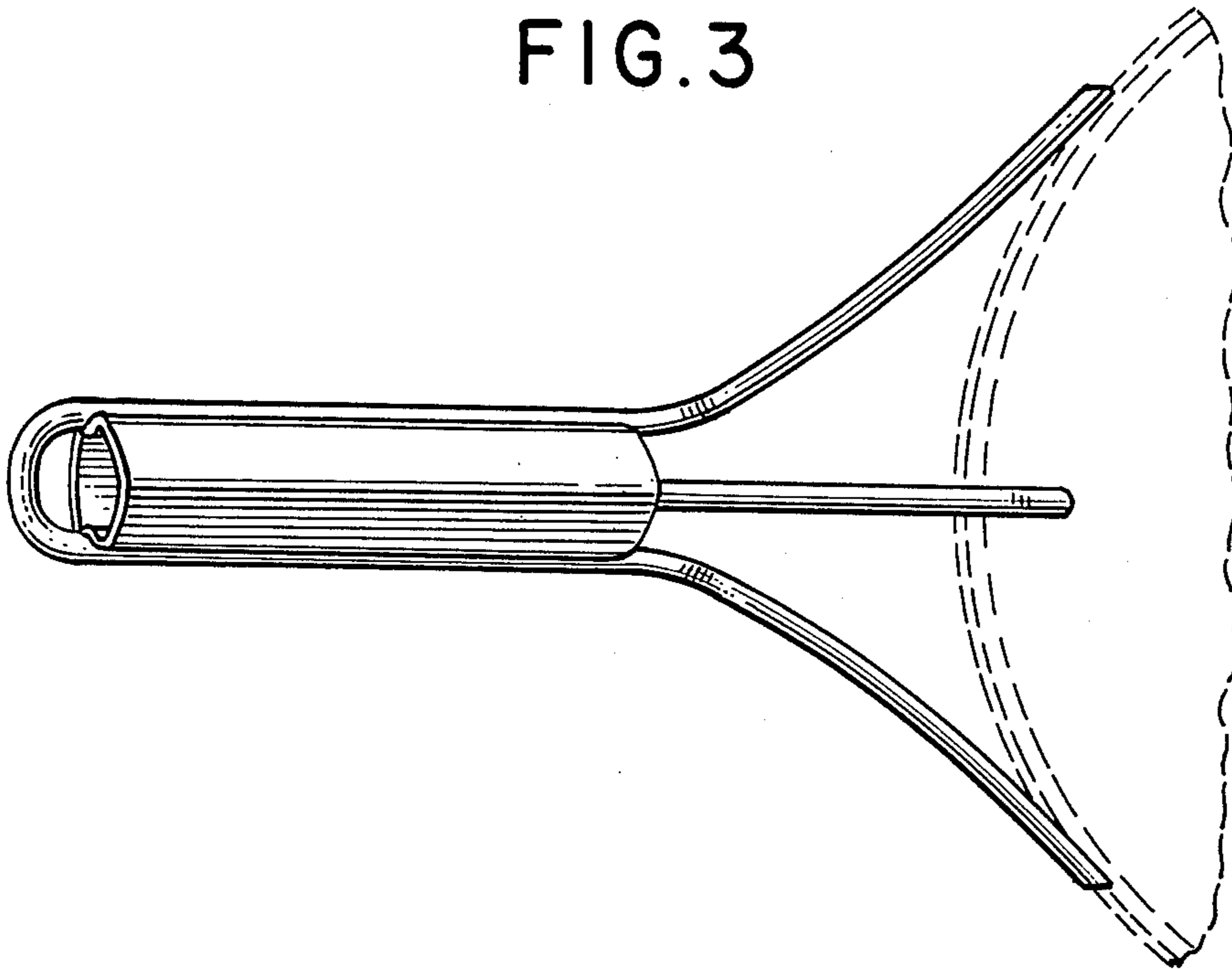

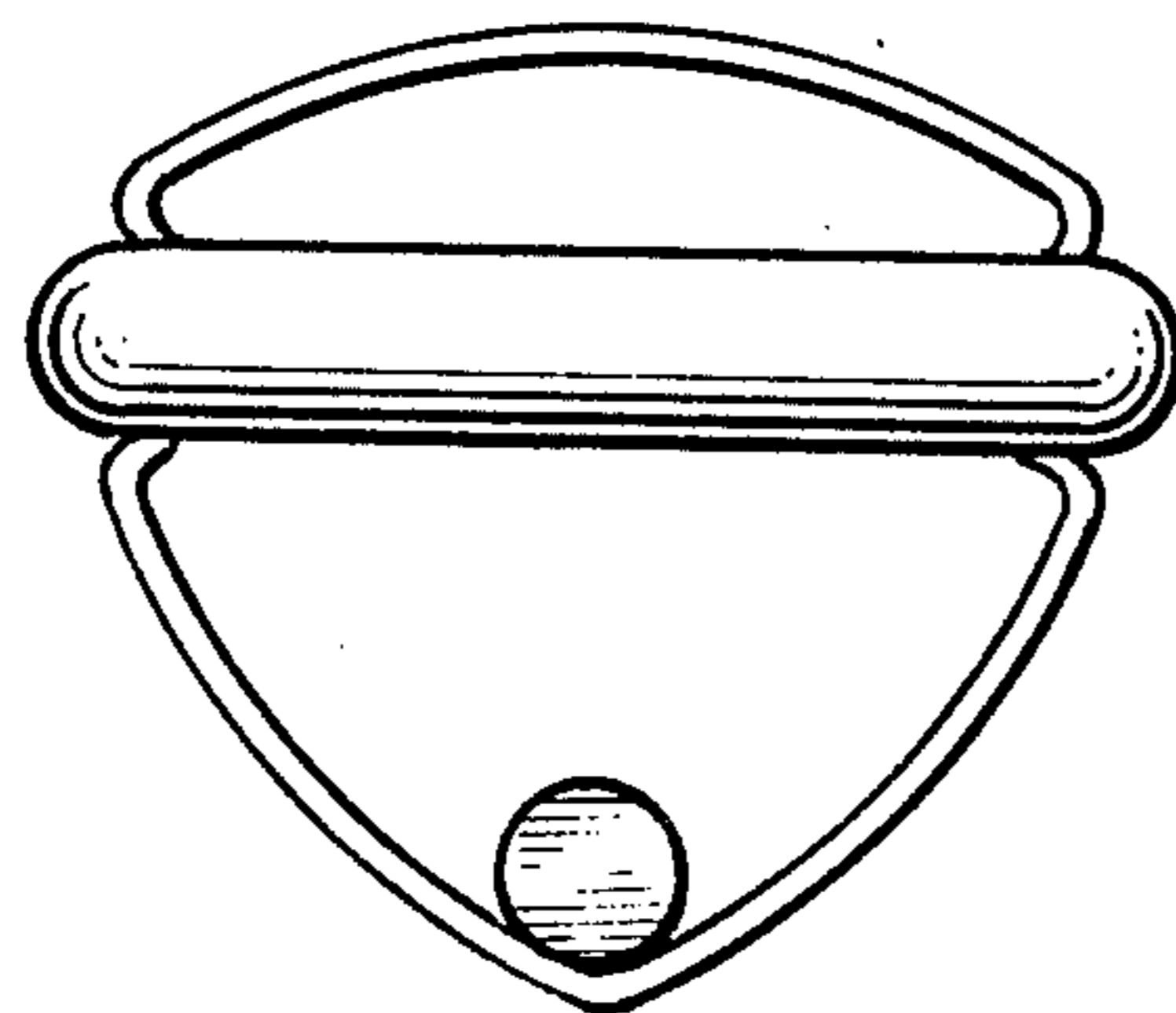
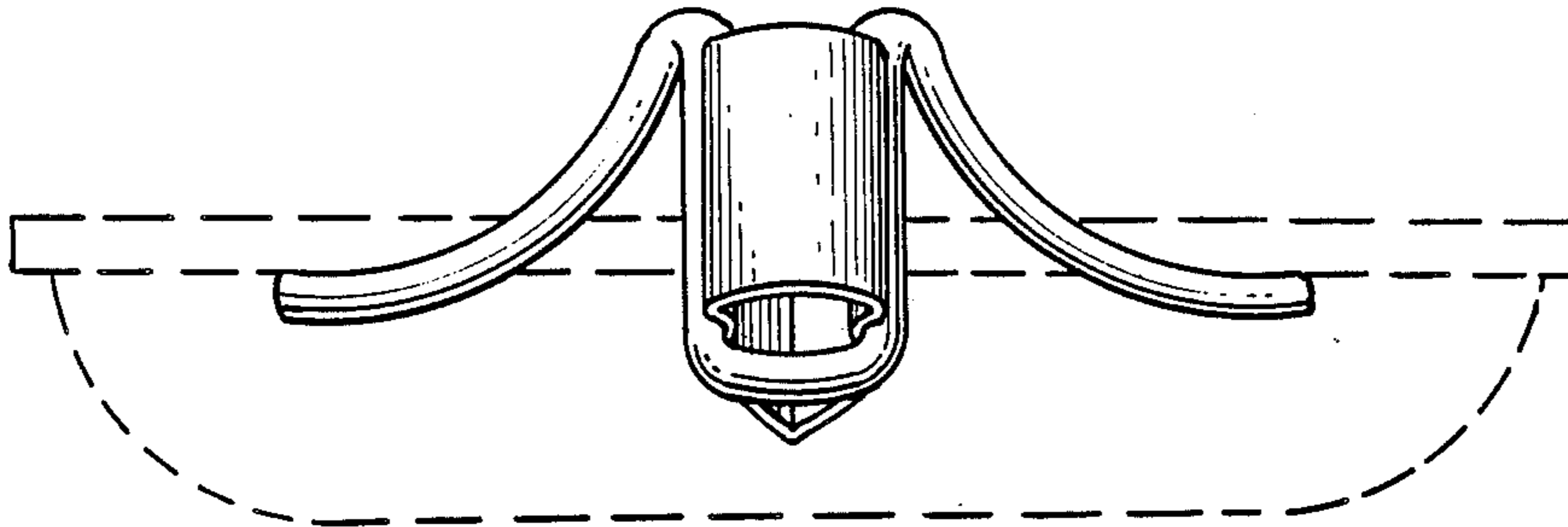
